Betting Basics

Some essentials to get you started with making a wager.

1 How to wager



Place your bet by visiting a teller, or using a self-serve terminal.

To place a bet here are just 5 things you need to know:

- 1 Name of racetrack (choose from any track in the simulcast feeds)
- 2 Number of the race
- 3 Amount of your bet (e.g. \$2)
- 4 Type of bet (see step 2)
- 5 Horse's number (see step 4)

Once you have decided what you want to bet, head to the nearest seller's window and use the sample statement as your guide:

Hello, (Racetrack), race 6, \$2 to WIN on Horse #4

How to use a self-serve terminal:

- 1 Swipe your Cash Card/Insert Cash
- 2 Enter the initial PIN #1234 (then choose a new PIN)
- 3 Press/Tap the track you would like to bet: (defaults to current race)
- 4 Tap the Horse Number: **#4**
- 5 Press/Tap the Bet Type: **WIN**
- 6 Press/Tap the Bet Amount: **\$2**
- 7 Press/Tap the Race Number: **Race #6**
- 8 Press Green **"Make BET"** button
- 9 Press/Tap the **"Finish with Receipt"** button
- 10 Be sure to check your ticket to confirm it's the bet you wanted

To get a Cash Card or for assistance ask a teller, or a staff member.

2 Types of bets



Single horse bets (minimum \$2.00 bet is required)

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Win	U U U	Your horse must finish 1st; payoff determined by the win odds.
Place	U U	Your horse must finish 1st or 2nd; payoffs better than to show.
Show	U	Your horse must finish 1st, 2nd, or 3rd; modest payoffs.

Exotic multiple-horse bets

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Exacta*	U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st and 2nd in exact order; riskier bet that can pay a little or a lot, depending on the horses' odds.
Daily double	U U U U U	Pick the winners of two designated consecutive races.
Pick 3, Win 4, Pick 5, Pick 6	U U U U U U	Select the winners of a designated set of consecutive races. The wager must be made prior to the start of the first race in the multi-race wager.
Triactor*	U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in exact order; can be expensive to play if you use a lot of horses.
Superfecta*	U U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th; big payoff possible.

* Exotic bets require the horses to finish in the EXACT order you select, unless you "BOX" the bet, in which case your selections can finish in any order.

Race 1 Selections

THE HORSEPLAYERS JOURNAL by Robert Reid Jr.

#5 ONE LAST BET crossed over for the early lead off the gate from post-six last week but was relegated to fourth on the backside before taking a shuffle back to seventh before coming forward to finish fourth in the stretch. She was just over a length away from Chiefs Dream Girl at the wire and held on by a head two starts ago when she delivered as a lukewarm favorite at the bottom condition level. This 19-time winner has only missed one cheque in 32 attempts this season and will once again start from the center of the gate with post-five. She will have Louis-Philippe Roy aboard for a follow-up steer and has our nod to kick off the card.

#2 POWDER PLAY has not raced since November 29th and kept driving to the lead from post-five in that dash before yielding to a pair of rivals on the backstretch. She disappointed at 75 cents to the dollar when she faded back to eighth under the wire and was beaten by a wide margin to Twin B Tipster. This 12-time winner went a long way on the lead before that but gave way to Carsons Gouda in the lane and has only mustered one prize in her last six overall. This 12-time winner might benefit from getting freshened-up for a few weeks and will likely push out for early position from an inside draw. She figures to offer an opportunity to take back value for those that supported her last time but need to get a start under her feet.

#4 ELLAS REASON A was never a factor on November 22nd when she got away sixth off the switch from post-nine but rallied for the show spot the week prior when she rounded out the trifecta at 27-1. She earned a cheque in four straight prior to her most recent effort and has been more than competitive in higher classifications earlier in the season. This 10-time winner should appreciate sliding down to post-four and has been hampered with the eight-hole or worse in four of her last six. She was scratched out of a scheduled start on December 14th but fits in nicely with this group.

#8 GOUDAWON finished seventh last week after mixing it up in the early stages and was only three lengths in arrears to Chiefs Dream Girl after taking support to the tune of 7/2. She picked up a prize in eight straight before that and was second-best to Settn A Precedent in NW3640L3 at Flamboro Downs two back when trying to go all the way on the engine. This 15-time winner got the nod from Tyler Borth over two others in the contest and can be in the mix throughout. She can pick up a decent chunk.

#4 PROHIBITION LEGAL made multiple moves on her way to victory on December 7th and paced away from her rivals in deep stretch before she stopped the clock in 1:52 flat on a track that was two seconds off. She returned 7/5 to her backers and got held up in traffic in her previous two outings after she missed nearly a month of action. This 13-time winner will likely be handled aggressively again tonight and is just \$61 away from \$150,000 in earnings this season. She should be feeling good about herself and gets the edge over her stablemate in what should end up being a two-horse affair.

#1 SILVER LABEL has been the runner-up in each of his last two and disappointed as the race-favorite at even-money or less in both of those contests. She was at a pace disadvantage last time out when her stablemate above had the jump on her from the get-go and has hit the board in nine of her last 10 tries here at Mohawk Park. This 25-time winner's five victories this season have all come at this venue and she is just \$66 short of \$300,000 in earnings for 2024. She will have J-Mac aboard for a follow-up steer and completes a strong one-two punch for the combination of trainer Nick Gallucci and owner/breeder Millar Farms.

#6 DABARNDAWGSWATCHIN came around our top choice to briefly seize control on the backside last week but then had no answers for that rival when she accelerated past her again on the spin for home. She had to settle for the show spot and was three lengths in arrears from the one above in second but was still clearly the best of the rest when nearly four lengths better than the one below. This 25-time winner sparked an upset at 10-1 in this class on November 23rd and has hit the board in each of her last six outings at Mohawk Park. She has been getting along well with Trevor Henry and is the logical choice to complete the trifecta.

#3 HUNTRESS exits the same race as the three above and got away in the early pocket behind our top selection before getting relegated to third near the midway marker. She began to tire on final turn and was nine lengths in arrears at the finish when she completed the superfecta at odds of 11-1. This 37-time winner likely needed that start after being on the sidelines for a few weeks and has earned a cheque in 14 of her last 15 overall. She can bounce back with a better performance but the bottom end of the trifecta or super is likely her ceiling.

#7 SO MUCH MORE faded back to seventh after making a first-over bid from fourth when she dropped down to this class and took support to the tune of 3-1 last week. She had missed three weeks going into that effort and has typically done her best work when racing on a regular rotation. This 74-time winner went postward in the F&M-Preferred in each of her previous two and was last victorious at this level when she got up by a neck on October 25th to complete a two-race win-streak. She moves out a few spots on the gate to post-seven and can rebound in a big way.

#4 ANGOSTURA HANOVER was spotted on the cover of the one above in the second-over position in her latest and swung wide at the top of the stretch but had to settle for a minor award in fifth at 15-1. She fired home in 26.3 on the heels of a back-half in 54.4 but could not get near Shes Got It All and was only beaten by a length in third eight nights earlier in a race that was topped by Caviar N Crackers. This 11-time winner has earned a cheque in all but one of her 31 starts this season and should appreciate sliding back down to a favorable spot on the gate with post-four after having the eight-hole or worse in four of her last five. She looms as a danger but has not tasted victory since June.

#5 LEE LOO emerged as the runner-up to to a well-meant Shes Got It All last week and was in the three-hole for much of that mile before getting up the inside of the one below to round out the exacta at 30-1. She has been no worse than second in each of her last two and blew up the tote board at 22-1 in the class below this on December 7th. This 16-time winner has been in good order for trainer Gregg McNair after she missed a few weeks of action and will once again have Billy Davis Jr at the reins. She has enough tactical speed to give herself options off the gate from post-five and can land somewhere on the ticket.

#3 CENTURY JAMILA exits the same race as the three above and was sent to the early lead in that dash before getting covered up by Shes Got It All on the backside. She tracked that rival from the pocket but could not come forward in the lane when angled to the outside and lost a couple of positions when she faded back to fourth under the wire. This 11-time winner was only beaten by a neck to Caviar N Crackes two back and has picked up a prize in each of her last four at this level since relocating north of the border to race under the care of conditioner Dave Menary. She will likely continue to get forwardly placed when sliding in a few starting spots to post-three and can be in the mix throughout.

#10 HONOLULU VACATION earned a minor award when he stepped up to the class above this last week and was perfectly spotted in the second-over position but could only get as far as third before dropping back a couple of spots in the dying strides. He drops back down to the class where he won two of his previous three and will be reunited with driver Mike Whelan, who piloted him to victory on both of those occasions. This son of Betterthancheddar must overcome a dreadful draw from post-10 but has proven he can be versatile in his racing style. His tricky starting spot should help inflate his price and he is worth a try on top.

#4 HOLLYWOOD DEO was a winner at first asking on December 6th and returned 7/2 to his backers after he grinded down the pacesetter from the first-over position. He forged to a clear lead when asked to do so in deep stretch and stopped the clock in 1:57.2 on a track that was one second off. This son of Captaintreacheraus was not under any urging when he held on by a head in his qualifier on November 29th and will now take a step up the class ladder to NW22750L. He has double-up potential.

#1 T H BOOMTOWN has won seven in a row in Charlottetown and scored by open lengths in six of those dashes. He was one for 11 to begin his career when racing in Delaware before that and has now relocated to Ontario to race under the care of conditioner Tyler Moore. This son of Captain Crunch was scratched out of a scheduled start at The Raceway in London due to the weather on December 15th and will now make his debut on the big track. He will have Bob McClure calling the shots for the first time but might need to get one under his feet after being off for nearly a month between appearances.

#7 HES STILL WATCHING rallied from off the pace to be third in his latest and was within a few lengths of heavy-favorite Smokin Hot Dude when he completed the trifecta at 26-1. He has picked up a prize in nine of his last 13 and not gotten away better than sixth in any of his last seven. This son of Hes Watching will have Travis Cullen aboard for a follow-up steer and will likely be making noise when it matters most. He can pick up a decent chunk.

#6 HOW MUCH gamely chased Settn A Precedent to the wire last week but had to settle for second as the 3/2 favorite after being stacked-up third-over on the bend for home. She has shown she can be more than competitive when coming from behind in recent efforts and was strong in victory at this level on November 22nd when he was handled more aggressively to make front near the midway marker. This 10-time winner has hit the board in each of her last four and gets to come right back in this class because she will once again carry the optional price tag of \$50,000. She will have the luxury of leaving from post-six for the second straight start and will have Trevor Henry aboard for a follow-up steer. The pick.

#8 MAJOR LEAGUE N has won four in a row at Flamboro Downs and held on by a neck or less in each of her last two in the F&M-Preferred on that half-mile oval. She was not bet down to favoritism in any of those victories and will now return to the big track for the first time since the beginning of June. This 46-time winner should be brimming with confidence and can be tough to get past when she is at her best. She might take flight off the gate from post-eight and is one of our main players underneath.

#2 GLENBORO was moving well at the end of her mile last week when she improved to fourth before the finish after getting away seventh off the switch and completed the superfecta at 22-1. She flashed home in 27.1 on the heels of a back-half in 55.4 and had not raced in more than two weeks going into that effort. This 12-time winner delivered as the 1/9 favorite when she made every call a winning one from the pole position in NW3605L3 at Flamboro Downs on November 28th and has hit the board in 20 of her last 40 outings overall. She slides down to the inside of the gate and might go forward off the switch this time out while racing back on a regular schedule.

#3 FLIGHT CREW N exits the same race as the one above and was just ahead of that rival at the wire when she rounded out the trifecta at 17-1. She has claimed the show spot in each of her last two and could not have been more dominant in victory on November 15th in a softer spot where she scored by nearly six lengths and stopped the clock in 1:53.3. This 14-time winner has trended in the right direction for trainer Paul Thomas Court and will have Jody Jamieson back between the wheels this evening. She can be in the mix throughout and should be included on the bottom end of all of the exotic wagers.

#6 BLAZING CRUISER was a \$97,000 yearling purchase at the Lexington Select sale that will be making the first start of his career for trainer Rodney Hughes. He is the fifth foal out of the Roll With Joe mare Pleasant Roll and all four of his siblings of racing age have made at least two trips to the winner's circle. This son of Sweet Lou was moving sweetly in the late stages of his lone qualifier on December 13th and was under tight lines to Todd Ratchford when only missing by a head to Twin B Alliance at the wire. He will have the advantage of working from the winningest post on the circuit and has our call to get the job done at first asking.

#1 LONGSHOT PANIC had to wait for room in the stretch last week after sitting in the three-hole for much of the mile and did not shake loose until the dying strides of that contest. He was just a head away from victory in a three-across finish and rounded out the trifecta at odds of 21-1. This son of Betterthancheddar has been fourth or better in nine of his last 12 since moving to the care of conditioner Wayne Smith and will get back on a regular schedule after missing a month before his latest. He might be able to navigate another cozy trip when sliding back down to the pole position and looks threatening.

#9 WILLIE B was a \$40,000 yearling purchase at the Lexington Select sale that will be sent out for his lifetime debut by trainer Tony Beaton. He is the fourth foal out of the Grinfromeartoear mare Smokin N Grinin, who won 34 times in her career and banked nearly \$300,000. This son of Bettors Delight exits the same morning prep as our top selection and finished two lengths away from the winner in fourth, while pacing his own mile in 2:00.3 on a track that was one second off. He comes into this with a pair of qualifiers to his credit and races for strong connections but faces the difficult task of leaving from the outermost post in the contest.

#4 CONTROLTHEOUTCOME picked up a lesser share last week when he improved a spot before the wire after getting away sixth off the switch. He finished two positions better than he did two starts ago when he made his circuit debut and was the runner-up in three straight starts at Flamboro Downs in November. This son of Control The Moment will likely be making noise when it matters most and can pick up a sizable slice with the right kind of trip. He is worth including on the bottom end of the exotics.

#7 BEACH CRUISER was moving best of all in deep stretch last week in a division of the Valedictory but had to settle for fourth at 58-1 when two lengths back of the winner Wallace Hartley. He blasted home in 26.3 off a back-half in 54.1 and will now make the transition to NW2. He had to qualify near the end of November after getting on the vet's list 12 nights earlier but has progressed nicely through his first two tries on the big track. This son of Yankee Cruiser has hit the board in 10 of his 19 career attempts and was Bob McClure's choice over the one below. He will likely get activated sooner in the mile this time around and gets the nod on top.

#4 MANHAWK was an impressive winner last week after he was first-over for a long way and bullied his way to the front in the stretch before kicking clear of his rivals. He scored by nearly three lengths at odds of 3-1 and stopped the clock in 1:55.3 in less than ideal conditions. This son of Stag Party now has 16 top-two finishes from his last 30 outings but was passed over by Bob McClure in favor of the one above. He will have Jonathan Drury at the helm for the second time and can be right there at the wire.

#6 ZEBS KRAFTY was sent to the early lead from post-six on December 7th but was relegated to third on the backside before slipping to the outside in the third-over position on the final turn. He came forward again in the stretch and was inching-in on his rivals in the dying strides but had to settle for third at 6-1. This son of Betterthancheddar has hit the board in seven of his last 15 overall and will have the luxury of leaving from the winningest post at Mohawk Park for the fifth time in six starts. He will have Travis Cullen aboard for a follow-up steer and figures to get every chance to land somewhere on the ticket.

#3 ULYSSES was fourth to our second choice last week after being limbed-out briefly on the first turn from post-nine and then stayed put on the pylons for much of the way after that. He was surrounded by horses in the late stages and was victorious by a nose two back, despite suffering interference just before the finish. This son of Racing Hill should appreciate sliding back down towards the inside of the gate with post-three and will once again have Tyler Borth at the reins. He will likely make his presence felt at some point in the mile and should not be ignored.

#7 STOPWATCH has gone a long way on the lead in each of his last two but was only clipped by a head in his most recent effort when Rule The West came to call in the final strides. He was beaten by a wider margin before that when he had no answers for Hes Still Watching in deep stretch but will now race back on a regular rotation after missing three weeks of action going into this latest. This son of Hes Watching has hit the board in five of his six tries as a sophomore and might have found the right spot to break through for the first victory of his career. He might prove too tough to catch this time out and gets top billing.

#8 ADMIRAL DEO has hit the board in each of his last four and has only finished out of the top-three in one of his six lifetime tries. He only missed by a neck to Lucky Dancer on November 28th in a race where he disappointed as the 6/5 favorite and has been the runner-up in both of his efforts where he was sent off as the choice of the betting public. This son of Captaintreacherous has missed more than three weeks between outings but can be more than competitive against this group off the bench. He must overcome a tricky draw from post-eight but still looms as a danger.

#9 BETTERDEALMEIN got caught in deep stretch by both Hollywood Deo and Redland Wrangler on December 6th after he held a healthy margin on his foes for much of the mile. He did not give way until deep into the stretch and was within a couple of lengths of an impressive debut winner. This son of Bettors Delight has claimed the show spot in each of his two tries on this circuit since making the move from the east coast to race under the care of conditioner Jodie Cullen and has not missed the board in any of his five career attempts. He has enough tactical speed to overcome the outermost post in the contest but must avoid a taxing trip.

#6 TWIN B ALLIANCE is a homebred for Twinbrook Limited that will be making his lifetime debut for trainer Francis Dumouchel. He is half-brother to both Twin B Echo (10, \$148,663, 1:52.2) and Pearl Snaps (15, \$205,906, 1:49.4). This son of Always B Miki was second or better in each of his two qualifiers in preparation for this effort but those came more than two months apart. He held on by a head over Blazing Cruiser on December 13th and will have the advantage of starting from post-six in his first try under the lights.

#5 POWERTRAIN was second-best to the streaking Ervin Hanover last week and was more than three lengths in arrears to that rival at the finish, despite sprinting home in 25.2 off a back-half in 53.1. He will not have to worry about that dominant foe this time around and has hit the board in three of his last four but has a couple of vet scratches due to sickness scattered amongst those efforts. This 13-time winner notched a pair of victories over that span and blew up the tote board at nearly 35-1 in the top condition class on October 12th. He can be the boss of this group but will likely attract a lot of attention at the windows.

#1 FORTIFY exits the same race as the one above and was nearly seven lengths behind Ervin Hanover when he completed the superfecta in fourth at 7-1. He has hit the board in seven of his last 10 since returning to Ontario to race under the care of conditioner Rene Bourassa and has racked-up five victories over that span. This 29-time winner can benefit from getting back on a regular schedule and will likely be pushing out for early position with rail control. He can step up with a better effort this time out and is our main player underneath.

#4 SAULSBROOK VICTOR has walked away empty-handed in each of his last three but was impressive in victory from the dreaded 10-hole in this class before that. He has won three of his last seven and will now race on lasix for the first time after missing nearly a month of action. This 27-time winner moves back up to the Preferred ranks but does not look out of place against this group. He is worth a look if the price is right.

#3 POSEIDON SEELSTER sat a perfect two-hole trip to Ervin Hanover last week but could not stay with that rival in the lane and ended up being more than a length away from our top choice in third. He has hit the board in five of his last six and was gutsy in victory two back when he would not be denied in NW18700L5. This 19-time winner has enjoyed success in this classification and should appreciate going up against a softer group this time around. He can grab a share.

#8 NO MONEY HONEY has been the runner-up in two of her last three and most recently overcame an overland trip before she rounded out the exacta at 58-1. She moves in one spot on the gate tonight after having the nine-hole or worse in three of her last four and has been getting along well with driver Jody Jamieson. This daughter of All Bets Off would benefit from some pace to chase and might be able to get past her rivals in deep stretch. She will only offer a fraction of the price she offered last time out but still has our top honors.

#9 FIRSTOFANERA has only mustered one prize in her last seven overall and that came by the way of a fifth-place finish in this class two starts ago. She went a long way on the lead on that occasion before getting leg weary in the lane and faded much sooner in the mile last time out when she set the first panel in 26.4. This 12-time winner will be reunited with leading driver James MacDonald and they combined for a victory in a tougher spot on September 20th. She continues to have poor luck at the post draw with the nine-hole but should not be taken lightly.

#2 BETTER BE DONNA N has earned a trip of minor awards in her last six but sparked an upset at 8-1 before that when competing against tougher rivals. She can benefit from getting back down to the inside of the gate but has not been as consistent as she was in previous seasons. This 39-time winner might flash her early foot from post-two and has all kinds of back-class to rely on with more than \$615,000 in career earnings. She gets Jonathan Drury back between the wheels and can be in the mix throughout.

#10 CHELSIS CHOICE rallied for third last week after getting away eighth off the gate and was on the rim through the middle stages before pacing home in 28.1 on the heels of a back-half in 57 seconds flat. She is just three for 63 in the win-column over the last couple of years but 16 times over that span. This daughter of Big Jim might be able to work way into the race in deep stretch and can help spice up the bottom end of the trifecta and super at a price.

#5 LAMBORGHINI LOU got back to victory lane on December 7th when getting his third try in this class and scored by nearly a pair of lengths when he stopped the clock in 1:53.4 over a surface that was two seconds off. He converted as the 3/2 favorite after he was sixth at a slightly higher price the week prior and has now been no worse than second in 23 of his 31 attempts this season. This 13-time winner will have Tyler Borth aboard for an encore performance but has missed a week between appearances. He has proven to be versatile in his racing style and is prime candidate to double-up.

#8 A CLASS YANKEE was only beaten by half a length in a preliminary leg of the Valedictory last week and was within half a length of Brudon at the finish after he blasted home in 25.4 on the heels of a back-half in 54 seconds flat. He has hit the board in five of his last six since returning to Mohawk Park and his two victories over that span came by the slimmest of margins. This son of Always B Miki has been in good order for Team Whelan but must overcome the outermost post in the contest. He typically does his best work in the lane and looms as a logical danger.

#1 FASNACHT HANOVER was never a factor on November 9th after he was taken back to ninth off the gate from post-nine in this class but was just over four lengths away from the one above in last at the wire. He won two of his previous four at this level before that but made a miscue in a qualifier on December 13th when getting a tightener in before his return to the races. This son of Stay Hungry might need to get one under his feet after missing six weeks of action but can make his presence felt if his trip is sweet enough from the pole position. He will have Billy Davis Jr calling the shots for the first time under the lights and is worth utilizing in the exotics.

#7 SERGEANT SLAUGHTER tried his luck in the top open claiming handicap class on the circuit last week and closed nicely to be fourth after getting away ninth off the gate from post-eight. He now returns to NW3 where he will once again carry an optional price tag of \$60,000 and was a well-meant winner on the front-end at this level on November 30th. This son of Big Jim has only missed a cheque in two of his 19 tries this season and might go back to getting forwardly placed when moving in a position on the gate to post-seven. He is not without a chance.

#3 MYULTIMATE SNOWY A will be making his first start in North America after making the trek to these parts from Australia and will now race under the care of conditioner Kyle Fellows. He is nine for 27 in his career with 16 on the board finishes and comes into this Canadian debut with a winning qualifier to his credit. This son of Sweet Lou scored by more than six lengths in 1:54.2 on a track that was one second off and retains J-Mac in the sulky while racing on lasix for the first time. He ticks a lot of boxes and has our vote of confidence in the finale.

#5 JACK PANIC finished fifth in a compact field of six in the Preferred last week and was more than seven lengths behind the streaking Ervin Hanover at the finish. He now drops back down to the class where he has hit the board in each of his last five but has been camera-shy this season with just three victories from 41 attempts. This 12-time winner hit the board 18 times over that span and will have options off the gate from post-five. He has been a consistent performer in the middle condition ranks and can be right there at the finish.

#7 LIVINTHEBEACHLIFE rounded out the superfecta at 9-1 when he stepped back up to this level in his latest and was just over three lengths away from Whatchulookin At at the wire. He won three in a row while climbing up the ladder before that, albeit he had to share victory with Hp Lis Shadow on December 7th when they could not be separated on the line. This 25-time winner has enough tactical speed to get forwardly placed from post-seven but has shown he can be versatile in his racing style. He can keep trending in the right direction and can hit the ticket.

#2 KOLBY TWO STEP exits the same race as our second choice and was the only one that rival beat in that Preferred event. He trailed throughout and has now been shut out in each of his last three. This 12-time winner gets back down to a more palatable spot and was third in this class on November 16th. He can also benefit from getting back on a regular schedule and might come out firing from an inside draw.

#1 THE GREEK FREAK would not be denied victory in the class below this last week and will now be making his third start back after being away from the races for more than two months. He has hit the board in 14 of his 35 tries this season and does not look out of place when taking a step upwards in competition. This 18-time winner just surpassed \$100,000 in earnings in 2024 and will likely make his presence felt at some point in the mile. He is among the chances but we prefer him in the underneath positions of the exotics.

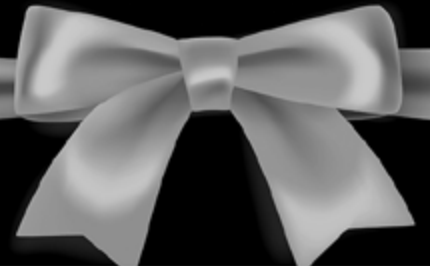

C O N D I T I O N S A N D A L L O W A N C E S I N H A R N E S S R A C I N G - I M P O R T A N T T O K N O W

The conditions of a race determine whether a horse is eligible to enter. For example many races are restricted to horses that have won a certain number of races or a certain amount of money in a specified number of starts. Many races are restricted to horses entered to be "claimed" (offered for sale) at a specific price.

Allowances in the claiming price itself are given to colts and geldings, four-year-olds and younger and to mares, five-year-olds and younger.

The purpose of the allowance is to keep younger horses more competitive when racing against older and more experienced rivals. Mares are given extra consideration in claiming events because of their potential as broodmares.

The accompanying chart shows what the allowances are, but an example may make them easier to understand. The chart indicates that three-year-olds receive a 50% allowance in claiming races. This means that a three-year-old entered in a \$20,000 claiming race carries an actual claiming price of \$30,000 (50% higher).

Fillies and mares receive an additional 25% allowance in claiming races. Details of the race conditions and claiming price (if any) are given at the top of each race in the program.

When Fillies/Mares compete against Colts/Geldings (normally on the trot) Fillies/Mares will receive an additional 25% on the condition of the race. ie: nw \$5,000 (FM \$6,250) last 5 or \$12,000 (FM \$15,000) last 10 starts.

C.P.M.A. Regulation Changes

Effective January 1st 2012
CPMA will be instituting several new rule changes with regards to the following pari-mutuel pools:

Pick Pools

- If there are no winners in any leg of a Pick N pool, the entire pool is refunded.
- If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners.
- A pool is no longer refunded if the 1st leg in the pool is cancelled or declared no contest.
- Pick-3: If at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: If at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.

EXPLANATION OF THE LASIX PROGRAM

After careful study and consultation with Ontario Horsemen's groups, racetrack operators and veterinarians, Agriculture Canada and the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario passed legislation allowing the controlled (or supervised) administration of furosemide, more commonly called "Lasix". "Lasix" is used to alleviate the symptoms of exercise induced pulmonary hemorrhaging in racing horses. Horses will undergo an endoscopic examination of the trachea by a veterinarian licensed by the Ontario Racing Commission and endorsed by an official veterinarian before being allowed on the medication list. Once qualified, horses will be treated with "Lasix" within four hours plus or minus 15 minutes of a scheduled race in a secure retention area under the super vision of racing officials.

All horses on "Lasix" must remain on the program for a minimum of 100 days while racing in this jurisdiction.

- (L)** Denotes horses treated with Lasix for their last start but not so treated today.

RULES AND INFORMATION REGARDING CANADIAN HARNESS AND FOREIGN SEPARATE POOL EVENTS

GENERAL

All pari-mutuel pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with the regulations and directives as issued by Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada ("the Regulations"), under the approval and supervision of the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency. The Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency can be contacted at 1-800-268-8835 or 613-759-6100 or Email: cpmawebacpm@agr.gc.ca. A complete version of the CPMA regulations can be found at <http://laws-lois.justice.gc.ca/en/regulations/SOR-91-365/>. All tickets should be held until the result of the race is declared official and prices are posted.

No person under the age of 18 shall purchase or cash a ticket or voucher.

A claim of receiving an incorrect payment or incorrect change must be made to the Mutuel office of the association within twenty four hours of buying or cashing a valid ticket or voucher.

No ruling made by the Stewards/Judges or the Ontario Racing Commission with regard to distribution of purse money or the placing of horses in the order of finish, after the race has been declared official, shall have any bearing on the pay-out prices or distribution of pari-mutuel pools.

Change boards and Photo Finish display monitors are located in the Grandstand. In addition, Photo Finish pictures are shown on the closed-circuit television system. Customers are reminded that mutuel clerks are responsible for all shortages. When making a wager, customers must present sufficient funds at the time of purchase to cover the wagers requested.

ENTRIES AND MUTUEL FIELDS

"Entry" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled or considered as the same betting interest. The most common reason for the coupling of horses in an Entry is the fact that they are owned by the same person.

"Mutuel Field" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled because the number of horses in the race exceeds the number which can be handled separately by the pari-mutuel system. Subject to the Regulations, a bet on one horse of an Entry or Mutuel Field shall be considered a bet on all horses in that Entry or Mutuel Field.

DAILY DOUBLE BETTING (INCLUDING LATE DOUBLE)

A Daily Double bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of the two races specified for the Daily Double. Tickets not selecting the winner of the first half of the Daily Double and all tickets in the second half of the Daily Double not coupled with the declared official winner of the first half of the Daily Double are not winners and are not refunded no matter what circumstances affect the running of the second half of the Daily Double.

Should a horse or horses (not coupled with another starter) be excused from starting in the second race of the Daily Double after the first race of the Daily Double has closed for betting, holders of all Daily Double tickets on such horses, coupled with the winner of the first Daily Double race, shall participate in a Consolation Double pool. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

EXACTA (Also known as Exactor)/TRIFECTA (Also known as Tractor)/SUPERFECTA

An Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first two, three and four horses respectively, representing different betting interests to finish in the exact official order of finish, in the race on which the pool is operated.

SWINGER (Also known as OMNI)

A Swinger is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select horses to finish in any order from the official first 3 positions.

JACKPOT HI-5

A Jackpot Hi-5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners in the specified Jackpot Hi-5 race. If there are races that have an entry, (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B), Jackpot Hi-5 will not offer a wager consisting of both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in a Jackpot Hi-5, the payout would be 1st, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th.

That jackpot portion of the pool will only be paid out if there is a single winning ticket. If there are multiple winning tickets that have correctly chosen the first 5 runners of the race, they will receive 50% of the pool for that day. The other 50% will go over into the Jackpot carryover. If there are no winning tickets with the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners, 100% of the current day's pool will be carried over into the Jackpot.

PICK 3 & PICK-4 BETTING

The Pick 3 & Pick 4 bets are betting transactions in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of three or four successive races specified for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 respectively.

Winning tickets for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 are determined in the following sequence: A) winners of all legs, B) most winners, then refund. If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners. If there are no winners in any leg of a pool, the entire pool is refunded.

PICK 5 BETTING

The Pick 5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of five successive races specified for the Pick 5 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 5 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 5.

PICK 3, PICK 4 & PICK 5 SCRATCHES

In the event a Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 ticket designates as a selection a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the Stewards/Judges to be a non-starter in any of the races comprising the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 the favourite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection. In the event that the money bet in the win pool for two or more favourites is identical, the selection with the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non-starting selection.

However, if a scratch occurs in any leg of the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 pools before the pool is closed, a ticket including the scratched horse may be cancelled.

REFUNDS

Subject to the Regulations, all monies in all pools on a race are refunded in the event that the race is cancelled, declared off or declared no contest, and all monies bet on a horse are refunded if the horse is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start. These refunds will be communicated to the public through various means such as betting terminals, video display, change boards and our website. The Pick(n) pool shall be cancelled and all Pick(n) wagers for the individual performance shall be refunded if:

- Pick-3: at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

Where a horse that is part of an Entry is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start and at least one horse of that Entry receives a fair start in the race, all tickets purchased on the Entry remain valid and the purchase price of any such ticket shall not be refunded.

COMMON POOL WAGERING (INTERTRACK BETTING)

In the unlikely event of a communications or computer system failure that prevents pools from merging with the host track's pools before the end of a race, CPMA regulations require that the site must refund all tickets for that race. This refund will be communicated to the public through various means such as video displays, change boards and messages on our website.

FAIR START

If a horse has reached the Fair Start Pole (located 200 feet before the Starting Pole) by the time the mobile gate has reached the Starting Pole, that horse is deemed to have had a fair start. It makes no difference whether or not the horse is on or off stride at that precise moment. Under current policy and regulations, which are designed to be as fair as possible to all bettors on all starters, there is no Recall - a repeat of the entire starting procedure - when a horse does not reach the Fair Start Pole before the gate reaches the Starting Pole. Monies bet on such a horse are refunded in accordance with the regulation concerning refunds.

LOST & OLD TICKETS

WEG issued tickets or vouchers are valid indefinitely, however, they cannot be cashed at a mutuel teller after 2 years from date of issue. Please mail tickets, along with your name and address, to Mutuel Manager, P.O. Box 156, Rexdale, Ontario, M9W 5L2, keeping a photocopy for future reference.

For "Lost Tickets" originally sold at a Woodbine Entertainment Group racetrack or Teletheatre, please enquire at the Mutuel office at Woodbine, Greenwood Teletheatre, or Mohawk. Policy may be subject to change retroactively in the event regulatory bodies amend existing regulations.

ASSOCIATION PERCENTAGE AND TAXATION/LEVY

The Woodbine Entertainment Group deducts and retains the following percentages from wagers placed at our own licensed sites which are then shared with the horsepeople, host and simulcast associations and the Ontario Racing Commission.

WOODBINE/MOHAWK LIVE: Win, Place & Show: 13.65%. Swinger 14.7%. Trifecta & Pick 4: 21.7%. Double & Exacta 17.2%. Jackpot Hi-5 & Pick 5: 11.7%. All other 23.0%

Horsepeople receive a further 2% on all wagers, except Trifecta wagering where it is 4%. The Ontario Provincial Government retains 0.5% on all bets placed in Ontario. The Canadian Government (through a revolving fund cost recovery basis) retains 0.8% on all wagers placed in Canada for provision of drug control, and audit services.
