# Betting Basics

Some essentials to get you started with making a wager.

## 1 How to wager



Place your bet by visiting a teller, or using a self-serve terminal.

### To place a bet here are just 5 things you need to know:

- 1 Name of racetrack (choose from any track in the simulcast feeds)
- 2 Number of the race
- 3 Amount of your bet (e.g. \$2)
- 4 Type of bet (see step 2)
- 5 Horse's number (see step 4)

Once you have decided what you want to bet, head to the nearest seller's window and use the sample statement as your guide:

**Hello, (Racetrack), race 6, \$2 to WIN on Horse #4**

### How to use a self-serve terminal:

- 1 Swipe your Cash Card/Insert Cash
- 2 Enter the initial PIN #1234 (then choose a new PIN)
- 3 Press/Tap the track you would like to bet: (defaults to current race)
- 4 Tap the Horse Number: **#4**
- 5 Press/Tap the Bet Type: **WIN**
- 6 Press/Tap the Bet Amount: **\$2**
- 7 Press/Tap the Race Number: **Race #6**
- 8 Press Green **"Make BET"** button
- 9 Press/Tap the **"Finish with Receipt"** button
- 10 Be sure to check your ticket to confirm it's the bet you wanted

To get a Cash Card or for assistance ask a teller, or a staff member.

## 2 Types of bets



### Single horse bets (minimum \$2.00 bet is required)

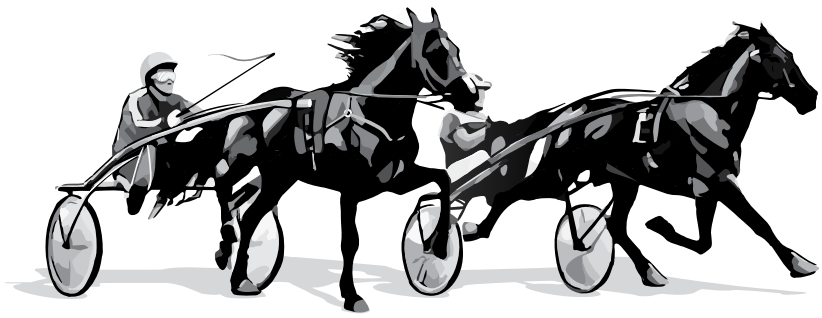
Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Win	U U U	Your horse must finish 1st; payoff determined by the win odds.
Place	U U	Your horse must finish 1st or 2nd; payoffs better than to show.
Show	U	Your horse must finish 1st, 2nd, or 3rd; modest payoffs.

### Exotic multiple-horse bets

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Exacta*	U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st and 2nd in exact order; riskier bet that can pay a little or a lot, depending on the horses' odds.
Daily double	U U U U U	Pick the winners of two designated consecutive races.
Pick 3, Win 4, Pick 5, Pick 6	U U U U U U	Select the winners of a designated set of consecutive races. The wager must be made prior to the start of the first race in the multi-race wager.
Triactor*	U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in exact order; can be expensive to play if you use a lot of horses.
Superfecta*	U U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th; big payoff possible.

\* Exotic bets require the horses to finish in the EXACT order you select, unless you "BOX" the bet, in which case your selections can finish in any order.

All of the numbers and letters in the program might seem confusing or overwhelming at first, but focusing on these sections makes choosing a horse simple.

- 1 Horse's number in the race
- 2 Horse's post position colour
- 3 Horse's colour, sex, age, sire (father), dam (mother), sire of the dam
- 4 Morning line odds
- 5 Horse's name
- 6 Driver and Driver Record (Name, # of wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, winning %)
- 7 Trainer information
- 8 Horse's Lifetime record (with best win time, track size, track, age, lifetime wins and lifetime earnings)
- 9 Horse's current record (# of races, # wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, and money earned)

# 4 The odds



Odds are also important to consider when choosing your horse. Horses that are thought to have a better chance of winning will typically have lower odds.

### Morning line odds

Odds listed in the race program are the "morning line" odds. These are predictions of how the public will bet on the race. They are set by the track's handicapper when the race program is published, before the wagering starts.

The actual odds will be posted on the **Television** or in-field on the **Tote Board** before the race; they change up until post time, depending on how customers are betting on each horse in the race.

### Calculating a \$2 win prize

To calculate a win prize, find the Odds of a horse on the **Television** or **Tote Board** (in-field board).

Multiply the first number by 2, then divide that number by the second digit (if there is one), and then add \$2. Simple as that!

Odds	1/2	2/1	7/2	5/1	10/1
Pays	\$3.00	\$6.00	\$9.00	\$12.00	\$22.00

**Helpful facts for betting**

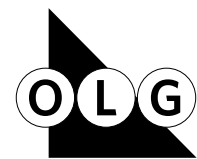
- Some racetracks have a television simulcast commentator who tries to identify winning horses (handicaps) between the races. Listen and see if you can pick up any good tips to bet on.
- A good betting method is to choose horses with current odds two to three times higher than their morning line odds.

**3 Tips to remember**

WIN BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 32% of the time  
 PLACE BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 53% of the time  
 SHOW BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 67% of the time

Woodbine Entertainment and its' employees are honoured to engage in the sport of horse racing and entertainment activities in the meeting place of Etobicoke. Woodbine Racetrack is located within the traditional and treaty Lands of the Mississaugas of the Credit. Known as Aadoobiigok, the "Place of the Alders" in Michi Saagiig language, the region is uniquely situated along the Humber River Watershed, which historically provided an integral connection for Anishinaabe, Haudenosaunee, and Wendat peoples between the Ontario Lakeshore and Lake Simcoe/Georgian Bay regions. **#4 FILLY BOO** is one that we are willing to come back to after she got shuffled back to eighth on the swing for home after getting away sixth off the switch. She came forward a couple of spots again before the wire and caught our eye on December 12th when she closed from off the pace to be second when making the first start of her career. This daughter of Crazy Wow slides down to a favorable spot on the gate after having the seven-hole or worse in her two outings so far and might get activated sooner on the mile this time out. She has a maturity edge over the three below at the age of three and gets the edge on top to kick off the card.

**#6 SPEED OF SOUND** was a \$6,000 yearling purchase at the Lexington select sale that will now be making her lifetime debut for trainer Dominic Gladu. She comes into this with a pair of qualifiers to her credit and was the runner-up in both of those morning preps. This daughter of Tactical Landing was most recently just over two lengths behind Belvedere Franklin and stepped her own mile in 2:00.4 with a 28.2 kicker. She will have the luxury of leaving from post-six and looms as a danger.

**#7 GREEN MONSTER** hit the board in each of his last four and has not been worse than fourth in any of his six career attempts. He was the runner-up to longshot Spin For Life in his latest after landing in seventh off the gate and has come from a long way off the pace in all of his six tries so far. This son of Green Manalishi S has been sent off at 7/2 or less in each of his last five and figures to take support on the tote board again this evening. He will be making noise when it matters most and his stock rises if there is some pace to chase.

**#3 MUSCLE BRANCH** was a \$50,000 yearling purchase at Harrisburg that will be making the first start of her career for trainer Matt Bax. She is a half-sister to Meadowbranch Ricky, who has gotten his picture taken 29 times in his career and has banked nearly \$450,000 in earnings. This daughter of Muscle Hill was beaten by a wide margin in a qualifier on June 21st before going on the shelf and now exits the same morning prep that our second choice comes out of. She was fourth in that contest after she trotted home in 28 seconds flat off a back-half in 58.4 and is worth keeping an eye on.

**#7 ULTRA** was never a factor last week when she sat eighth throughout in a race that was won by Zebs Breaking Dawn and had not raced in three weeks going into that effort. She was scratched due to transportation issues on December 5th but won two in a row before that in the class above this. This 11-time winner can benefit from getting back on a regular rotation and figures to fly under the radar on the tote board. She has hit the board in 19 of her 39 starts this season and is worth a whirl on top.

**#6 GRAND CIRCUIT** worked out a two-hole trip last week and found room along the pylons in the lane but had to settle for fifth at odds of 5/2. She went into that effort off a pair of dominant qualifying victories at Flamboro Downs and will now be making her second try under the care of conditioner Jodie Cullen. This daughter of Always A Virgin races back on a regular schedule and should appreciate getting down to the lower \$20,000 condition claiming class. She figures to get forwardly placed from the winningest post on the circuit and looks threatening.

**#3 SAULSBROOK ANNIE** set hot fractions in the early stages last week and fought gamely in the stretch before giving way to a pair of rivals in Ideal Entry and Vendetta Blue Chip. She was only beaten by three quarters of a length at the finish and completed the trifecta at 7/2. This daughter of Hes Watching has hit the board in seven of her last eight and was victorious at this level in the middle of November. She will surely have her gas pedal pressed off the switch and can be in the mix throughout.

**#2 P L RINCHENIA** exits the same race as the one above and was spotted second-over on the spin for home before only getting beaten by just over a length in fourth. She was sent off at 17-1 in that dash after being 74-1 while racing off the bench six nights earlier and will now make her third start back after missing more than three months of action. This daughter of Bettors Delight moves out one spot off the rail and picks up the driving services of Trevor Henry for the first time in her career. She will likely continue to drop in odds again tonight and should be included in all of the exotic wagers.

He was moving best of all in deep stretch when he moved into fourth before the finish at 3-1 and trotted his back-half in 58.2 with a final quarter in 28.1. This son of International Moni will slide down four positions on the gate to post-two and can benefit from getting real race experience under his belt. He will be hard pressed to get into as much trouble this time around and is our play of the day.

**#8 GAELIC PIPER** exits the same race as the one above and fired off the wings of the gate from post-10 in that contest to secure the early pocket behind race-favorite Stonebridge Glee. He tracked that rival from that position throughout the mile and was two lengths in arrears under the wire when he completed the exacta at odds of 7/2. This son of Alarm Detector fended off a pair of rivals for the place spot, including the one above, but is just one for 37 in the win-column in his career. He has hit the board in 17 of his 27 tries as a sophomore and will now be making his third start out of the barn of trainer Chantal Mitchell. Using underneath.

**#9 C KAN TROT** was handled aggressively off the gate last week and held the lead into the first turn before she released 9/5 favorite Sequence Hanover to the engine. She was stuck behind that rival when he shortened stride at the head of the stretch and angled out behind a wall of horses before getting clearance to finish third at 3-1. This daughter of Wheeling N Dealin had not raced in nearly two months after she was scratched due to injury on November 7th and will be making a follow-up attempt under the care of conditioner/driver Michiel Vanderkemp. She must overcome the outermost post in the contest this time around but can take another step forward when getting back on a regular schedule.

**#6 STORMONT FRIENDLY** exits the same race as the one above and was more than two lengths in arrears to that rival when she rounded out the superfecta at 27-1. She sat an inside trip in that contest after getting away fifth from the pole position and will now have the advantage of working from post-six. This daughter of Kadabra is another that can benefit from getting back on a regular rotation and has finished fourth or better in seven of her last 10 overall. She can grab a share.

**#7 ARAGONITE** could not have been more dominant in victory last week when he scored by more than four lengths in 1:54.2 at 55 cents to the dollar in the class below this. He has won two in a row at that level and will be making his second start under the care of conditioner Carmen Auciello. This son of Sportswriter has hit the board in nine of his 19 career attempts and will be reunited with driver Austin Sorrie, who has guided him to the winner's circle on two occasions over this surface. He should be brimming with confidence and has our call to triple-up.

**#9 HAPPY NEIGHS** was first-over for a long way in his latest and forged his way to the lead in the lane before having a three quarters of a length cushion over his rivals at the wire. He stopped the clock in 1:54.1 and returned more than 8-1 to his backers. This 10-time winner has been second or better in each of his last four tries on the big track but shifts out to a tricky spot on the gate with post-nine. He will have Trevor Henry at the controls for the fifth time and has repeat potential.

**#2 HESTONATOR** exits the same race as the one above and came from a long way off the pace in that tilt before rounding out the superfecta in fourth at 13-1. He came home in 28 seconds flat on the heels of a back-half in 56.2 and had hit the board in four straight going into that effort. This son of Heston Blue Chip won by a neck in the class below this on November 21st and continues to get along well with driver JR Plante. He can benefit from getting major post-relief on the inside of the gate and will likely get activated sooner in the mile this time around.

**#1 P L QUICKSAND** kept driving to the lead from post-four on December 15th at Flamboro Downs and then held court the rest of the way before winning by nearly two lengths at the finish. He delivered at 65 cents to the dollar and hit the board in six of his last 10 on that half-mile oval. This son of Bettors Delight returns to Mohawk Park for the first time in nearly a year and will have leading driver James MacDonald in tow for the first time. He might be able to work out a cozy trip from the pole position and is worth including on the bottom end of the exotics.

**#5 CHARMBO STORMY** has won three in a row at Flamboro Downs and has not been worse than third in her last four since being snagged for \$8,000 by trainer Jared Mann. She has lit the lamp in four of her last five on the B-tracks and scored by a combined margin of more than 13 lengths over the course of the victories. This 15-time winner has hit the board in 15 of her last 35 but walked away empty-handed in her last five tries here at Mohawk Park. She has been on a roll for her new connections and gets top billing in this opening round of a Pop-Up Series.

**9 BIG DIAMOND** was taken back to seventh last week and came forward in the late stages but was surrounded by horses and finished sixth after being in tight quarters in the dying strides. She banged home in 27.2 off a back-half in 55.4 and likely needed that softer trip after she vied for the early lead on December 5th before fading back to last in the lane. This 29-time winner hit the board in three straight prior to that and will be reunited with driver Louis-Philippe Roy, who piloted her to a pair of victories in the five times they have been paired together. She figures to be brave coming into this but must overcome a tricky draw from post-nine.

**#4 SHARE THE MOMENT** exits the same race as our top selection and claimed the show spot in that dash after sitting a pocket trip. She has hit the board in each of her last seven and enjoyed back-to-back victories at that half-mile venue in early November. This 31-time winner gets Travis Cullen back between the wheels and has shown versatility in her racing style throughout her career. She should not be underestimated.

**#8 CHOCOLATEFORLUNCH** is an intriguing option after she faded back to last in the final of a previous Pop-Up Event on December 19th and tried a wide move on the bend for home in that contest at odds of more than 30-1. She crawled home in 32.3 but rallied for the place spot one week earlier at less than a third of that price on the board and has finished in the top three in eight of her last 13 overall. This daughter of Dali will now race off the claim for trainer Derrick Anderson and will have Trevor Henry at the controls for the sixth time in her career. She should offer a big number on the tote board and can help spice things up underneath.

She had to settle for a lesser share in both of the preliminary rounds of that added-money event but locked down the bottom spot of the trifecta at 6-1 in the Harvest Series Final on November 22nd. This daughter of Control The Moment has hit the board in nine of her last 11 and racked-up five victories in her last 14 overall. She will have Todd Ratchford calling the shots for the third straight start and will have the luxury of leaving from post-six. Giving her a try on top and hoping for value.

**#3 WOODMERE DELTA** claimed the show spot in NW2 last Friday night and was just a length away from the late-closing Swift Talker at the finish. She has not missed a cheque in her last three since she added hoppers to her wardrobe and picked up a couple of smaller shares in both of the first two legs of this series. This daughter of Rollwithitharry should appreciate getting to go against fellow also-rans in this consolation event and will once again work from an inside draw with post-two. She picks up the driving of Bob McClure and can threaten with the right kind of trip.

**#4 ABSOLUTION** swept the lead on the backside in NW16500L on December 20th and then held a healthy margin through the middle panels before expanding her lead in the lane. She got run down by Rose Colordglasses in the final steps and has only missed out on victory by a neck in two of her last three. This daughter of McWicked made a splash on the circuit in NW1 on November 7th and completed a two-race win-streak with that win after breaking her maiden at Flamboro Downs nine nights earlier. She has hit the board in five of her six lifetime tries and fits in nicely with this group. Phil Hudon picks up the drive.

**#4 OH A LEGEND** sat fifth for much of the mile before moving to the outside in the third-over position on the swing for home in the second round of this series and then mowed down her rivals with ease to score by more than a length going away. She was just two ticks off her lifetime mark when she stopped the clock in 1:53 flat and has now won four in a row. This daughter of Bit Of A Legend N has hit the board in eight of her last 12 since making the transition to the big track and has fired home in 27.4 or faster in all but one of those efforts. She continues to get along well with driver Tyler Borth and is hard to go against when the chips are down in the final.

**#2 FOX VALLEY TESSA** is another that will be looking for a sweep of the series after she would not be denied in both of the preliminary legs of this added-money event. She held on by a neck over odds-on favorite Always B Merry in her most recent effort and tracked that rival from the pocket in the opening round before getting past her for the victory in deep stretch. This daughter of Time To Roll has gotten her picture taken in four of her last five and has not missed out on the top three in eight straight. She has transitioned nicely to this circuit for Team Husted and looms as a danger.

**#1 MIKKI SIXX** kept driving forward from post-10 on December 13th but did not touch down on the lead until the field straightened out on the backstretch. She was immediately overtaken by Cocco Puff Powder and then went back on the attack on the swing for home before forging her way to the lead in the lane. This daughter of Always B Miki could not fend off our top pick before the finish but ran up the score on her foes in the first round one week earlier when she won by more than seven lengths in 1:54.1 on a track that was one second off. She is seven for 10 to begin her career and will have J-Mac aboard for a follow-up steer.

**#3 MISS DUTTON** ambushed her rivals off the switch from post-10 in her latest and and tripped the opening marker in 27.1 before getting covered up by the odds-on favorite Always B Merry. She got relegated to the three-hole on the final turn and then held her ground to complete the trifecta at 13-1. This daughter of Rollwithitharry was more than four lengths better than Woodmere Delta in fourth and has raced better than advertised in her two attempts on this circuit. She won eight of her last 12 tries on the east coast before making the trek to Ontario and should appreciate sliding back down to post-three for tonight's tilt.

**#2 KEEN CATHY** was taken back to seventh after getting crowded at the start in a Pop-Up Consolation and was relegated to last on the backside before moving to the outside in the fifth-over position. She was flying down the center of the track in the stretch and got within a couple of lengths of winner Is He Watching at the finish while pacing home in 28.2 on the heels of a back-half in 58.1. This daughter of World Of Rocknroll will be making her third try under the care of conditioner Darryl Laver and can navigate a more favorable journey from an inside draw. She might be able to get the measure of this group and should put us on the right side of value.

**#3 DEL DIGGITY** has raced for the optional price tag of \$13,000 in NW1500L3 at Flamboro Downs in each of her last two and was fourth or better in each of those efforts. She disappointed at 45 cents to the dollar on December 5th at that venue but got up by half a length in this class in her most recent appearance on this circuit on November 28th. This 29-time winner has been second or better in three of her four attempts out of the barn of trainer Tom Riley and has 23 top-two finishes from her last 33 tries overall. She will be reunited with driver Tyler Borth and looms as a logical threat.

**#9 GOLDEN LEADER** was dominant in victory when she took down the final of a Pop-Up Series last week and went most of the way on the engine in that dash before scoring by more than two lengths at the finish. She converted as the odds-on choice of the betting public and was the runner-up in each of the two rounds of that event. This 23-time winner was claimed back by conditioner Ron MacDonald in her latest and has now hit the board in six of her last seven overall. She gets Brett MacDonald back between the wheels but must overcome a difficult draw from post-nine this time around.

**#10 FEARLESS SHELIA** went a long way on the lead from post-two in NW1500L3 at Flamboro Downs on December 19th but could not deliver as the 6/5 favorite in that dash when she faded back to third in the stretch. She managed to light the lamp at a shorter price the week prior and will now have her price tag slashed by \$2,000 when getting back to this claiming handicap class on the big track. This 21-time winner notched back-to-back victories at this venue in November and has enough early foot to get forwardly placed from the dreaded 10-hole. She will be making her third start off the claim for trainer Amanda Fine and has gotten her picture taken the last two times that J-Mac was at the reins.

He will now look to add the Valedictory to his resume and has our call to come out on top.

**#5 SOUTHWIND INFUSION** followed the cover of Wallace Hartley on the backside on December 14th and then came around to seize control after that rival briefly touched down on the lead. He held a healthy margin into the stretch before getting nailed by that foe in the dying strides and disappointed as the 2-1 favorite in the process. This son of Always B Miki took that support after he blew up the tote board at 40-1 when he got past the one above by the slimmest of margins in the opening leg and gets Austin Sorrie back between the wheels in the final. He has 12 top-two finishes in his last 27 appearances and has been in good order for trainer Ashley Lendvoy.

**#10 A CLASS YANKEE** came from off the pace to be second to Lamborghini Lou in NW3 last Saturday night and blasted home in 26.3 on the heels of a back-half in 54.3. This son of Yankee Cruiser came from a long way off the pace to be fourth in the second leg of this series and blazed home in 26.3 off a back-half in 54.1. He will have Bob McClure aboard for a third consecutive outing and should be brave coming into this.

**#3 D A CAPTAINOBVIOUS** took flight from the 10-hole off the switch last Friday night and cleared to the lead in the first turn and reeled-off the opening quarter in 27.1. He was relegated to third on the backside and was six lengths behind winner Happy Neighs when coming in sixth under the wire. This son of Captain Crunch was the runner-up to Rocket Freight in the class above this on December 13th and will now drop back down to the spot where he held off the one below by half a length one week before that. He got the nod from Trevor Henry over our second choice and should appreciate sliding down to a favorable spot on the gate with post-three. Giving him the call to close out this Boxing Day card and top the Hi-5 in this mandatory payout event.

**#5 SPORTY BEE** was left with a lot of work to do in his latest when he got away eighth off the switch from post-10 and was stuck behind stalled cover on the swing for home before rolling wide near the top of the stretch. He managed to improve to fourth before the wire to complete the superfecta at 24-1 and was bet down to favoritism two weeks earlier when he was within half a length of the one above at the finish. This son of Sportswriter will have Tyler Jones aboard for a follow-up steer and can benefit from getting back on a regular rotation. He should also enjoy getting major post-relief on the center of the gate and can be right there at the wire.

**#2 RISE N GRIND** was beaten by a wide margin when finishing eighth or worse in each of his last two and was never a factor in either of those efforts at 26-1 or more when taking on much tougher competition. He claimed the show spot in NW2 on November 30th and picked up a prize in his first three tries off the claim for conditioner Carmen Auciello. This son of Up The Credit will now return to the class where he was snagged for \$20,000 earlier in that month but was passed over by J-Mac in favor of the one below. He picks up the driving services of Todd Ratchford for the first time and has rebound potential.

**#12 D A MAGIC MIKE** has not been worse than second in his last nine at Rideau Carleton and racked-up six victories over that span. He now returns to these parts and for the first time since September and made a break in stride in this class on September 20th before finishing eighth at 67-1. This son of McWicked was leading driver James MacDonald's choice over two others in the contest but has the difficult task of starting from the second-tier. He will likely take more support than we are willing to get behind but can make his presence felt if he can navigate a reasonable trip.

**#7 AMBITIOUS MIND** was the runner-up to a dominant winner in Aragonite last Friday night and has now picked up a cheque in eight straight. He hit the board in six of those efforts but has not tasted victory in Ontario since relocating from Trois-Rivières in Quebec. This son of Big Jim has been a consistent performer at this level and has more than enough early foot to get forwardly placed from post-seven. He can be in the mix throughout and should not be left off the bottom end of the exotic wagers.

### CONDITIONS AND ALLOWANCES IN HARNESS RACING - IMPORTANT TO KNOW

The conditions of a race determine whether a horse is eligible to enter. For example many races are restricted to horses that have won a certain number of races or a certain amount of money in a specified number of starts. Many races are restricted to horses entered to be "claimed" (offered for sale) at a specific price.

Allowances in the claiming price itself are given to colts and geldings, four-year-olds and younger and to mares, five-year-olds and younger.

The purpose of the allowance is to keep younger horses more competitive when racing against older and more experienced rivals. Mares are given extra consideration in claiming events because of their potential as broodmares.

The accompanying chart shows what the allowances are, but an example may make them easier to understand. The chart indicates that three-year-olds receive a 50% allowance in claiming races. This means that a three-year-old entered in a \$20,000 claiming race carries an actual claiming price of \$30,000 (50% higher).

Fillies and mares receive an additional 25% allowance in claiming races. Details of the race conditions and claiming price (if any) are given at the top of each race in the program.

### ALLOWANCES FOR PURSE EARNINGS

When Fillies/Mares compete against Colts/Geldings (normally on the trot) Fillies/Mares will receive an additional 25% on the condition of the race. ie: nw \$5,000 (FM \$6,250) last 5 or \$12,000 (FM \$15,000) last 10 starts.

## C.P.M.A. Regulation Changes

Effective January 1<sup>st</sup> 2012  
CPMA will be instituting several new rule changes with regards to the following pari-mutuel pools:

### Pick Pools

- If there are no winners in any leg of a Pick N pool, the entire pool is refunded.
- If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners.
- A pool is no longer refunded if the 1<sup>st</sup> leg in the pool is cancelled or declared no contest.
- Pick-3: If at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: If at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.

## EXPLANATION OF THE LASIX PROGRAM

After careful study and consultation with Ontario Horsemen's groups, racetrack operators and veterinarians, Agriculture Canada and the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario passed legislation allowing the controlled (or supervised) administration of furosemide, more commonly called "Lasix". "Lasix" is used to alleviate the symptoms of exercise induced pulmonary hemorrhaging in racing horses. Horses will undergo an endoscopic examination of the trachea by a veterinarian licensed by the Ontario Racing Commission and endorsed by an official veterinarian before being allowed on the medication list. Once qualified, horses will be treated with "Lasix" within four hours plus or minus 15 minutes of a scheduled race in a secure retention area under the super vision of racing officials.

All horses on "Lasix" must remain on the program for a minimum of 100 days while racing in this jurisdiction.

- (L)** Denotes horses treated with Lasix today who were not so treated for their last start.
- (L)** Denotes horses treated with Lasix for their last start but not so treated today.

## RULES AND INFORMATION REGARDING CANADIAN HARNESS AND FOREIGN SEPARATE POOL EVENTS

### GENERAL

All pari-mutuel pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with the regulations and directives as issued by Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada ("the Regulations"), under the approval and supervision of the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency. The Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency can be contacted at 1-800-268-8835 or 613-759-6100 or Email: [cpmawebacpm@agr.gc.ca](mailto:cpmawebacpm@agr.gc.ca). A complete version of the CPMA regulations can be found at <http://laws-lois.justice.gc.ca/en/regulations/SOR-91-365/>.

All tickets should be held until the result of the race is declared official and prices are posted.

No person under the age of 18 shall purchase or cash a ticket or voucher.

A claim of receiving an incorrect payment or incorrect change must be made to the Mutuel office of the association within twenty four hours of buying or cashing a valid ticket or voucher.

No ruling made by the Stewards/Judges or the Ontario Racing Commission with regard to distribution of purse money or the placing of horses in the order of finish, after the race has been declared official, shall have any bearing on the pay-out prices or distribution of pari-mutuel pools.

Change boards and Photo Finish display monitors are located in the Grandstand. In addition, Photo Finish pictures are shown on the closed-circuit television system. Customers are reminded that mutuel clerks are responsible for all shortages. When making a wager, customers must present sufficient funds at the time of purchase to cover the wagers requested.

### ENTRIES AND MUTUEL FIELDS

"Entry" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled or considered as the same betting interest. The most common reason for the coupling of horses in an Entry is the fact that they are owned by the same person.

"Mutuel Field" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled because the number of horses in the race exceeds the number which can be handled separately by the pari-mutuel system. Subject to the Regulations, a bet on one horse of an Entry or Mutuel Field shall be considered a bet on all horses in that Entry or Mutuel Field.

### DAILY DOUBLE BETTING (INCLUDING LATE DOUBLE)

A Daily Double bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of the two races specified for the Daily Double. Tickets not selecting the winner of the first half of the Daily Double and all tickets in the second half of the Daily Double not coupled with the declared official winner of the first half of the Daily Double are not winners and are not refunded no matter what circumstances affect the running of the second half of the Daily Double.

Should a horse or horses (not coupled with another starter) be excused from starting in the second race of the Daily Double after the first race of the Daily Double has closed for betting, holders of all Daily Double tickets on such horses, coupled with the winner of the first Daily Double race, shall participate in a Consolation Double pool. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

### EXACTA (Also known as Exactor)/TRIFECTA (Also known as Triactor)/SUPERFECTA

An Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first two, three and four horses respectively, representing different betting interests to finish in the exact official order of finish, in the race on which the pool is operated.

### SWINGER (Also known as OMNI)

A Swinger is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select horses to finish in any order from the official first 3 positions.

### JACKPOT HI-5

A Jackpot Hi-5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners in the specified Jackpot Hi-5 race. If there are races that have an entry, (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B), Jackpot Hi-5 will not offer a wager consisting of both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in a Jackpot Hi-5, the payout would be 1<sup>st</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>.

That jackpot portion of the pool will only be paid out if there is a single winning ticket. If there are multiple winning tickets that have correctly chosen the first 5 runners of the race, they will receive 50% of the pool for that day. The other 50% will go over into the Jackpot carryover. If there are no winning tickets with the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners, 100% of the current day's pool will be carried over into the Jackpot.

### PICK 3 & PICK-4 BETTING

The Pick 3 & Pick 4 bets are betting transactions in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of three or four successive races specified for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 respectively.

Winning tickets for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 are determined in the following sequence: A) winners of all legs, B) most winners, then refund. If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners. If there are no winners in any leg of a pool, the entire pool is refunded.

### PICK 5 BETTING

The Pick 5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of five successive races specified for the Pick 5 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 5 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 5.

### PICK 3, PICK 4 & PICK 5 SCRATCHES

In the event a Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 ticket designates as a selection a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the Stewards/Judges to be a non-starter in any of the races comprising the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 the favourite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection. In the event that the money bet in the win pool for two or more favourites is identical, the selection with the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non-starting selection.

However, if a scratch occurs in any leg of the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 pools before the pool is closed, a ticket including the scratched horse may be cancelled.

### REFUNDS

Subject to the Regulations, all monies in all pools on a race are refunded in the event that the race is cancelled, declared off or declared no contest, and all monies bet on a horse are refunded if the horse is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start. These refunds will be communicated to the public through various means such as betting terminals, video display, change boards and our website.

The Pick(n) pool shall be cancelled and all Pick(n) wagers for the individual performance shall be refunded if:

- Pick-3: at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

Where a horse that is part of an Entry is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start and at least one horse of that Entry receives a fair start in the race, all tickets purchased on the Entry remain valid and the purchase price of any such ticket shall not be refunded.

### COMMON POOL WAGERING (INTERTRACK BETTING)

In the unlikely event of a communications or computer system failure that prevents pools from merging with the host track's pools before the end of a race, CPMA regulations require that the site must refund all tickets for that race. This refund will be communicated to the public through various means such as video displays, change boards and messages on our website.

### FAIR START

If a horse has reached the Fair Start Pole (located 200 feet before the Starting Pole) by the time the mobile gate has reached the Starting Pole, that horse is deemed to have had a fair start. It makes no difference whether or not the horse is on or off stride at that precise moment. Under current policy and regulations, which are designed to be as fair as possible to all bettors on all starters, there is no Recall - a repeat of the entire starting procedure - when a horse does not reach the Fair Start Pole before the gate reaches the Starting Pole. Monies bet on such a horse are refunded in accordance with the regulation concerning refunds.

### LOST & OLD TICKETS

WEG issued tickets or vouchers are valid indefinitely, however, they cannot be cashed at a mutuel teller after 2 years from date of issue. Please mail tickets, along with your name and address, to Mutuel Manager, P.O. Box 156, Rexdale, Ontario, M9W 5L2, keeping a photocopy for future reference.

For "Lost Tickets" originally sold at a Woodbine Entertainment Group racetrack or Teletheatre, please enquire at the Mutuel office at Woodbine, Greenwood Teletheatre, or Mohawk. Policy may be subject to change retroactively in the event regulatory bodies amend existing regulations.

### ASSOCIATION PERCENTAGE AND TAXATION/LEVY

The Woodbine Entertainment Group deducts and retains the following percentages from wagers placed at our own licensed sites which are then shared with the horsepeople, host and simulcast associations and the Ontario Racing Commission.

**WOODBINE/MOHAWK LIVE:** Win, Place & Show: 13.65%. Swinger 14.7%. Trifecta & Pick 4: 21.7%. Double & Exacta 17.2%. Jackpot Hi-5 & Pick 5: 11.7%. All other 23.0%

Horsepeople receive a further 2% on all wagers, except Trifecta wagering where it is 4%. The Ontario Provincial Government retains 0.5% on all bets placed in Ontario. The Canadian Government (through a revolving fund cost recovery basis) retains 0.8% on all wagers placed in Canada for provision of drug control, and audit services.
