Betting Basics

Some essentials to get you started with making a wager.

1 How to wager



Place your bet by visiting a teller, or using a self-serve terminal.

To place a bet here are just 5 things you need to know:

- 1 Name of racetrack (choose from any track in the simulcast feeds)
- 2 Number of the race
- 3 Amount of your bet (e.g. \$2)
- 4 Type of bet (see step 2)
- 5 Horse's number (see step 4)

Once you have decided what you want to bet, head to the nearest seller's window and use the sample statement as your guide:

Hello, (Racetrack), race 6, \$2 to WIN on Horse #4

How to use a self-serve terminal:

- 1 Swipe your Cash Card/Insert Cash
- 2 Enter the initial PIN #1234 (then choose a new PIN)
- 3 Press/Tap the track you would like to bet: (defaults to current race)
- 4 Tap the Horse Number: **#4**
- 5 Press/Tap the Bet Type: **WIN**
- 6 Press/Tap the Bet Amount: **\$2**
- 7 Press/Tap the Race Number: **Race #6**
- 8 Press Green **"Make BET"** button
- 9 Press/Tap the **"Finish with Receipt"** button
- 10 Be sure to check your ticket to confirm it's the bet you wanted

To get a Cash Card or for assistance ask a teller, or a staff member.

2 Types of bets



Single horse bets (minimum \$2.00 bet is required)

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Win	U U U	Your horse must finish 1st; payoff determined by the win odds.
Place	U U	Your horse must finish 1st or 2nd; payoffs better than to show.
Show	U	Your horse must finish 1st, 2nd, or 3rd; modest payoffs.

Exotic multiple-horse bets

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Exacta*	U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st and 2nd in exact order; riskier bet that can pay a little or a lot, depending on the horses' odds.
Daily double	U U U U U	Pick the winners of two designated consecutive races.
Pick 3, Win 4, Pick 5, Pick 6	U U U U U U	Select the winners of a designated set of consecutive races. The wager must be made prior to the start of the first race in the multi-race wager.
Triactor*	U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in exact order; can be expensive to play if you use a lot of horses.
Superfecta*	U U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th; big payoff possible.

* Exotic bets require the horses to finish in the EXACT order you select, unless you "BOX" the bet, in which case your selections can finish in any order.

All of the numbers and letters in the program might seem confusing or overwhelming at first, but focusing on these sections makes choosing a horse simple.

- 1 Horse's number in the race
- 2 Horse's post position colour
- 3 Horse's colour, sex, age, sire (father), dam (mother), sire of the dam
- 4 Morning line odds
- 5 Horse's name
- 6 Driver and Driver Record (Name, # of wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, winning %)
- 7 Trainer information
- 8 Horse's Lifetime record (with best win time, track size, track, age, lifetime wins and lifetime earnings)
- 9 Horse's current record (# of races, # wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, and money earned)

4 The odds



Odds are also important to consider when choosing your horse. Horses that are thought to have a better chance of winning will typically have lower odds.

Morning line odds

Odds listed in the race program are the "morning line" odds. These are predictions of how the public will bet on the race. They are set by the track's handicapper when the race program is published, before the wagering starts.

The actual odds will be posted on the **Television** or in-field on the **Tote Board** before the race; they change up until post time, depending on how customers are betting on each horse in the race.

Calculating a \$2 win prize

To calculate a win prize, find the Odds of a horse on the **Television** or **Tote Board** (in-field board).

Multiply the first number by 2, then divide that number by the second digit (if there is one), and then add \$2. Simple as that!

Helpful facts for betting

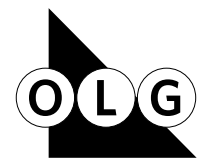
- Some racetracks have a television simulcast commentator who tries to identify winning horses (handicaps) between the races. Listen and see if you can pick up any good tips to bet on.
- A good betting method is to choose horses with current odds two to three times higher than their morning line odds.

3 Tips to remember

WIN BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 32% of the time
 PLACE BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 53% of the time
 SHOW BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 67% of the time

Race 1 Selections

THE HORSEPLAYERS JOURNAL by Robert Reid Jr.

#7 D A MAGIC MIKE made up ground to finish third in Hi-5 mandatory payout event last week and rounded out the trifecta at 9/2 after getting away eighth from post-12 in the second-tier. He was nearly 11 lengths off the lead at the quarter pole and blasted home in 28 seconds flat on the heels of a back-half in 56.4. This son of McWicked will now make his second try out of the barn of trainer Matt Dupuis after returning to this circuit from Rideau Carleton and was second or better in nine straight at that venue before his most recent effort. He will have leading driver James MacDonald aboard for a follow-up steer and should appreciate getting his nose back on the gate, despite the outside draw. Giving him the edge to kick off the card.

#5 D A CAPTAINOBVIOUS exits the same race as the one above and went a long way on the lead in that contest before he drifted to the outside of the track in the stretch. He was passed by pocket-sitter Givitygivitygity along the cones and was almost three lengths in arrears to that rival at the wire when he completed the exacta at 4-1. This son of Captain Crunch is just four or 34 since making his lifetime debut last August but has 22 on the board finishes over that span. He will have Tyler Borth calling the shots for the first time and figures to come out firing from post-five.

#8 ALWAYS B MELMAN was shut out in each of his last two and most recently dropped back down to NW22750L but was beaten by double-digit lengths to the streaking Hollywood Deo. He was fourth or better in his first two attempts in that class in November and enjoyed back-to-back victories in softer spots at the beginning of that month. This son of Always B Miki has hit the board in seven of his 15 lifetime tries and will be racing for a claiming tag for the first time in his career in order to participate in this Pop-Up Series. He has enough early foot to get forwardly placed from the outermost post in the contest and is capable of hitting the ticket.

#2 JIMSUN has won three in a row at The Raceway in London and scored by a combined margin of 10 lengths over the course of those victories. His price tag will be increased by \$12,000 while trying his luck on the big track for the first time and has hit the board in 15 of his first 25 career attempts on the B-tracks. This son of Big Jim might try to push out for early position from an inside draw and has captured three of his five outings when Lorne House is in the sulky. He is an intriguing option and is worth a look if the price is right.

Race 2 Selections

THE HORSEPLAYERS JOURNAL by Robert Reid Jr.

#6 CHARMBO STORMY was on the rim for most of her mile last week and kept pushing forward for the lead before touching down on the engine near the top of the far turn. She stopped the clock in a new lifetime mark of 1:53.4 as the 9/5 favorite and now won four in a row. This daughter of Sportswriter notched five of her seven victories this season in her last six outings and has now hit the board in 16 of her 39 tries in 2024. She has been on a roll for her new connections since getting snagged for \$8,000 at Western Fair on November 22nd and has our call to extend her streak to five.

#7 BETTER BE DONNA N exits the same race as the one above and made gains in the late stages of that dash after getting away last off the switch from post-10. She was 12 lengths off the lead at the opening marker but was able to grab a lesser share in fifth after improving five spots before the wire. This 39-time winner has picked up a prize in four of her last seven but had to settle for minor awards in those efforts. She has all kinds of back-class to rely on with \$616,215 in career earnings and has enough tactical speed to go forward off the gate. She will likely be closer to the action this time around and has upset potential.

#5 FATED FIRE sat an inside trip after getting away fourth off the gate from the pole position in the first leg of this series but was able to punch through along the pylons in the stretch and sparked an upset at 19-1. She tripped the timer in 1:54.4 with a 27.2 kicker and will have top teamster James MacDonald aboard for an encore performance. This 13-time winner should be feeling good about herself coming into this and has now lit the lamp in three of her last eight overall. She shifts out four spots on the gate to post-five and doubling-up is not out of the question.

#2 ONE LAST BET exits the same race as the one above and chopped-out the middle fractions in that dash before fading back to fourth in the dying strides. She disappointed as the 7/5 favorite after she drifted off the cones in the lane but has not finished worse than fourth in seven of her last eight since making the trek back to Ontario from Manitoba. #2 CENTURY JAZZ only missed four cheques in 24 attempts at Rideau Carleton in 2024 and picked up a lesser share in fifth when going postward in NW30000L in his latest. He kept driving to the lead from post-four in NW2 two starts ago and kept his rivals at bay by half a length in 1:59.1 on a five-eighths of a mile surface that was two seconds off. This son of Bettors Delight hit the board in 12 of his 24 attempts in 2024 and will now race under the care of conditioner Shayne Barrington when making his debut on this circuit. He was J-Mac's choice over the one below and gets top billing.

#7 BALLYKEEL PAINTER disappointed at 65 cents to the dollar at The Raceway in London on December 16th and was a long way out of it the early going after getting away seventh off the switch. He had to settle for fourth at the finish but managed to convert at even shorter prices in his previous two spins around that half-mile oval. This son of Dali gets back on the big track for the first time since July and gets Bob McClure back between the wheels. He can bounce back in a big way but has missed more than two weeks between appearances.

#8 ARAGONITE was three-wide through the first turn after leaving hard off the gate from post-seven last week and did not clear to the lead until the field straightened-out on the backstretch. He held court into the stretch but got leg weary in the lane before dropping back to eighth under the wire. This son of Sportswriter won two in a row before that and could not have been more dominant in victory on December 20th when he scored by more than four lengths in 1:54.2. He loses Austin Sorrie to the one below and picks up Jonathan Drury in the sulky.

#4 CHOICE IS YOURS made a break in stride at the start in his latest but that came as a result of interference after he came together with D A Captainobvious. He appeared to have some steering issues before that mishap and did not have much of a chance after he got away 10th off the switch. This son of Courtly Choice rallied for fifth in a race topped by the one above six nights earlier and can be competitive with this group with a more favorable journey. He retains Austin Sorrie in the sulky and can pick up a decent chunk.

He got the nod from that top teamster over four others in the contest and looms as a major danger.

#5 DAPPER FELLA held on by a head at 7-1 at Flamboro Downs last Saturday night and had to move three-wide around a rival with steering issues on the backside for the final time before forging his way to the lead from the first-over position. He fended off Abc in the final strides and has now hit the board in each of his last three since getting claimed by conditioner Malik Smith here at Mohawk Park for \$8,000 on December 5th. This 12-time winner was passed over by J-Mac in favor of the one above and picks up Travis Cullen at the controls for the second time in his career. He is among the top contenders and merits respect.

#3 MISTER REBBILY A is entered to come back on just two days rest after a scheduled start at The Raceway in London last Monday night and we do not know how he fared in that contest at the time of writing this. He only missed by a nose in a Pop-Up Event consolation on December 19th and has picked up a prize in each of his last 12 overall. This 27-time winner will have Bob McClure at the helm for the first time and has proven to be versatile in his racing style. He should be included on the bottom end of the exotics.

He stepped his back-half in 56.3 with a final quarter in 28 seconds flat and had not raced in more than three months prior to that outing. This son of Bettors Delight can benefit from getting on a regular rotation and slides in a couple of spots on the gate to the eight-hole. He is making his second try under the care of conditioner Gerard Demers and gets reunited with driver Phil Hudon.

#3 CEREAL KILLER was game in defeat when he only missed by a head to our top pick after making a first-over bid from third on the spin for home. He has now hit the board in four of his last five but has not tasted victory since October 21st at Western Fair. This 13-time winner was three for 38 last season but had 17 top-three finishes over that span. He gets to work from another favorable draw and can pick up a sizable slice with the right kind of trip.

#8 JOHNSTOWN JET has walked away empty-handed in each of his last three and was beaten by double-digit lengths in all of those efforts in the bottom condition class. He completed the trifecta at 37-1 in a dash that won by Southwind Sambucca before that and has claimed the show spot in two of his six tries for trainer Kyle Bossence since relocating north of the border. This son of Dragon Again will now race for a price tag for the first time in order to participate in this series and picks up the driving services of Austin Sorrie. He must overcome the outermost post in the contest but does not look out of place with this group.

#2 RISE N GRIND got away seventh off the gate from post-two in a Hi-5 mandatory payout event on Boxing Day and gapped-out on the swing for home before finding more in deep stretch to earn a minor award in fifth. She was spotted third-over on the backside for the final time and was pushed out four-wide on the final turn before making good gains in the lane. This daughter of Dali had to settle for fourth at nearly 12-1 but has raced better than advertised in recent outings. She has not missed a cheque in her last nine since getting claimed by trainer Darryl Laver and will appreciate getting her nose back on the gate with post-five. Giving her a whirl and hoping for value.

#7 SAULSBROOK ANNIE has hit the board in 11 of her last 16 and has gotten her picture taken in three of those outings but two of those victories came on the B-tracks at Grand River Raceway and Rideau Carleton, respectively. She was a gutsy winner here at Mohawk Park on November 14th and went a long way on the lead in her latest before getting picked up by Grand Circuit. This daughter of Hes Watching must overcome the outermost post in the contest but has all kinds of early foot and will likely be looking to cross over in front of her rivals before the first turn. She will likely take significant support on the tote board and can be right there at the finish.

#2 JEWELS DIAMONDEYES was scratched out a scheduled start on December 27th at Western Fair and will now make her debut under the care of conditioner Brett Lester. She has earned a cheque in 11 of her last 13 overall but went winless in 23 tries in 2024 after taking down six of her 13 attempts as a rookie the year before. This daughter of Betterthancheddar had hit the board in 14 of her 36 lifetime tries and will have Brett MacDonald calling the shots for the first time. She might benefit from getting another change of scenery and is worth including in the exotic wagers.

#1 SAULSBROOK DIVA made a break in stride at the start on December 19th at Flamboro Downs and took herself out of contention as the 1/5 odds-n choice of the betting public. She was never a factor when getting away eighth off the switch here at Mohawk Park two weeks earlier but notched back-to-back trips to victory lane in late November at Western Fair. This daughter of Big Jim has hit the board in 17 of her 22 career attempts and picks up the driving services of Bob McClure for the first time. She does not look out of place against this group.

#6 GOLDEN LEADER kept driving to the lead from post-nine last week and made front on the first tune before making every call a winning one after that. She held a healthy margin throughout before scoring by nearly a pair of lengths at the wire and returned more than 3-1 to her backers when she tripped the beam in 1:55.2. This 24-time winner has won two in a row and has not been worse than second in any of her last four overall. She moves in a few spots on the gate and has our call to triple-up in the finale.

#4 GOLDIES ROCKIN was second-best to the one above in her latest and inherited the two-hole when the one below jumped it off as the field straightened-out on the backside. She was clearly the best of the rest when nearly four lengths ahead of our fourth choice in third and has hit the board in six of her last 12 overall. This 21-time winner is making her fourth start off the claim for trainer Gerard Demers and will likely be in the mix throughout from post-four. She picks up Tyler Borth in the bike for the first time and is one of our main players underneath.

#8 FEARLESS SHELIA blasted off the wings of the gate from post-10 last week and was the first one down to the pylons before releasing our top choice to the engine. She squandered a pocket trip when she made a miscue on the backside and was distanced from her rivals after that mishap. This 21-time winner has lit the lamp in six of her last 12 and moves in two spots on the gate, despite still having the outermost post in the contest. She will have top teamster James MacDonald aboard for a follow-up steer and looms as a logical danger.

#1 KEEN CATHY exits the same race as the three above and rallied for the show spot in that contest to round out the trifecta at 12-1. She stepped home in 28.4 on the heels of a back-half in 58.1 and has been fourth or better in each of her last three since moving north of the border to race under the care of conditioner Darryl Laver. This daughter of World of Rocknroll will work from the pole position this time around and gets Garrett Rooney between the wheels for the first time. She can pick up another piece.

#7 MY ONLY SUNSHINE had not raced in nearly a month before her sixth-place finish at Flamboro Downs on December 5th but has now missed almost another month of action going into tonight's tilt. She will now be offered for the price of \$11,000 in this claiming handicap event and fits in nicely with this group. This 10-time winner will have Billy Davis at the controls this time around and will likely be making noise when it matters most. She might need to get one under her feet but is worth utilizing on the bottom end of the trifecta and super.

CONDITIONS AND ALLOWANCES IN HARNESS RACING - IMPORTANT TO KNOW

The conditions of a race determine whether a horse is eligible to enter. For example many races are restricted to horses that have won a certain number of races or a certain amount of money in a specified number of starts. Many races are restricted to horses entered to be "claimed" (offered for sale) at a specific price.

Allowances in the claiming price itself are given to colts and geldings, four-year-olds and younger and to mares, five-year-olds and younger.

The purpose of the allowance is to keep younger horses more competitive when racing against older and more experienced rivals. Mares are given extra consideration in claiming events because of their potential as broodmares.

The accompanying chart shows what the allowances are, but an example may make them easier to understand. The chart indicates that three-year-olds receive a 50% allowance in claiming races. This means that a three-year-old entered in a \$20,000 claiming race carries an actual claiming price of \$30,000 (50% higher).

Fillies and mares receive an additional 25% allowance in claiming races. Details of the race conditions and claiming price (if any) are given at the top of each race in the program.

ALLOWANCES FOR PURSE EARNINGS

When Fillies/Mares compete against Colts/Geldings (normally on the trot) Fillies/Mares will receive an additional 25% on the condition of the race. ie: nw \$5,000 (FM \$6,250) last 5 or \$12,000 (FM \$15,000) last 10 starts.

C.P.M.A. Regulation Changes

Effective January 1st 2012
CPMA will be instituting several new rule changes with regards to the following pari-mutuel pools:

Pick Pools

- If there are no winners in any leg of a Pick N pool, the entire pool is refunded.
- If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners.
- A pool is no longer refunded if the 1st leg in the pool is cancelled or declared no contest.
- Pick-3: If at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: If at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.

EXPLANATION OF THE LASIX PROGRAM

After careful study and consultation with Ontario Horsemen's groups, racetrack operators and veterinarians, Agriculture Canada and the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario passed legislation allowing the controlled (or supervised) administration of furosemide, more commonly called "Lasix". "Lasix" is used to alleviate the symptoms of exercise induced pulmonary hemorrhaging in racing horses. Horses will undergo an endoscopic examination of the trachea by a veterinarian licensed by the Ontario Racing Commission and endorsed by an official veterinarian before being allowed on the medication list. Once qualified, horses will be treated with "Lasix" within four hours plus or minus 15 minutes of a scheduled race in a secure retention area under the super vision of racing officials.

All horses on "Lasix" must remain on the program for a minimum of 100 days while racing in this jurisdiction.

- L** Denotes horses treated with Lasix.
- (L)** Denotes horses treated with Lasix today who were not so treated for their last start.
- (L)** Denotes horses treated with Lasix for their last start but not so treated today.

A complete version of the CPMA regulations can be found at <http://laws-lois.justice.gc.ca/en/regulations/SOR-91-365/>. All tickets should be held until the result of the race is declared official and prices are posted.

No person under the age of 18 shall purchase or cash a ticket or voucher.

A claim of receiving an incorrect payment or incorrect change must be made to the Mutuel office of the association within twenty four hours of buying or cashing a valid ticket or voucher.

No ruling made by the Stewards/Judges or the Ontario Racing Commission with regard to distribution of purse money or the placing of horses in the order of finish, after the race has been declared official, shall have any bearing on the pay-out prices or distribution of pari-mutuel pools.

Change boards and Photo Finish display monitors are located in the Grandstand. In addition, Photo Finish pictures are shown on the closed-circuit television system. Customers are reminded that mutuel clerks are responsible for all shortages. When making a wager, customers must present sufficient funds at the time of purchase to cover the wagers requested.

ENTRIES AND MUTUEL FIELDS

"Entry" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled or considered as the same betting interest. The most common reason for the coupling of horses in an Entry is the fact that they are owned by the same person.

"Mutuel Field" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled because the number of horses in the race exceeds the number which can be handled separately by the pari-mutuel system. Subject to the Regulations, a bet on one horse of an Entry or Mutuel Field shall be considered a bet on all horses in that Entry or Mutuel Field.

DAILY DOUBLE BETTING (INCLUDING LATE DOUBLE)

A Daily Double bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of the two races specified for the Daily Double. Tickets not selecting the winner of the first half of the Daily Double and all tickets in the second half of the Daily Double not coupled with the declared official winner of the first half of the Daily Double are not winners and are not refunded no matter what circumstances affect the running of the second half of the Daily Double.

Should a horse or horses (not coupled with another starter) be excused from starting in the second race of the Daily Double after the first race of the Daily Double has closed for betting, holders of all Daily Double tickets on such horses, coupled with the winner of the first Daily Double race, shall participate in a Consolation Double pool. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

EXACTA (Also known as Exactor)/TRIFECTA (Also known as Tractor)/SUPERFECTA

An Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first two, three and four horses respectively, representing different betting interests to finish in the exact official order of finish, in the race on which the pool is operated.

SWINGER (Also known as OMNI)

A Swinger is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select horses to finish in any order from the official first 3 positions.

JACKPOT HI-5

A Jackpot Hi-5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners in the specified Jackpot Hi-5 race. If there are races that have an entry, (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B), Jackpot Hi-5 will not offer a wager consisting of both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in a Jackpot Hi-5, the payout would be 1st, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th.

That jackpot portion of the pool will only be paid out if there is a single winning ticket. If there are multiple winning tickets that have correctly chosen the first 5 runners of the race, they will receive 50% of the pool for that day. The other 50% will go over into the Jackpot carryover. If there are no winning tickets with the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners, 100% of the current day's pool will be carried over into the Jackpot.

PICK 3 & PICK-4 BETTING

The Pick 3 & Pick 4 bets are betting transactions in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of three or four successive races specified for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 respectively. Winning tickets for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 are determined in the following sequence: A) winners of all legs, B) most winners, then refund. If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners. If there are no winners in any leg of a pool, the entire pool is refunded.

PICK 5 BETTING

The Pick 5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of five successive races specified for the Pick 5 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 5 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 5.

PICK 3, PICK 4 & PICK 5 SCRATCHES

In the event a Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 ticket designates as a selection a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the Stewards/Judges to be a non-starter in any of the races comprising the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 the favourite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection. In the event that the money bet in the win pool for two or more favourites is identical, the selection with the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non-starting selection.

However, if a scratch occurs in any leg of the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 pools before the pool is closed, a ticket including the scratched horse may be cancelled.

REFUNDS

Subject to the Regulations, all monies in all pools on a race are refunded in the event that the race is cancelled, declared off or declared no contest, and all monies bet on a horse are refunded if the horse is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start. These refunds will be communicated to the public through various means such as betting terminals, video display, change boards and our website. The Pick(n) pool shall be cancelled and all Pick(n) wagers for the individual performance shall be refunded if:

- Pick-3: at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

Where a horse that is part of an Entry is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start and at least one horse of that Entry receives a fair start in the race, all tickets purchased on the Entry remain valid and the purchase price of any such ticket shall not be refunded.

COMMON POOL WAGERING (INTERTRACK BETTING)

In the unlikely event of a communications or computer system failure that prevents pools from merging with the host track's pools before the end of a race, CPMA regulations require that the site must refund all tickets for that race. This refund will be communicated to the public through various means such as video displays, change boards and messages on our website.

FAIR START

If a horse has reached the Fair Start Pole (located 200 feet before the Starting Pole) by the time the mobile gate has reached the Starting Pole, that horse is deemed to have had a fair start. It makes no difference whether or not the horse is on or off stride at that precise moment. Under current policy and regulations, which are designed to be as fair as possible to all bettors on all starters, there is no Recall - a repeat of the entire starting procedure - when a horse does not reach the Fair Start Pole before the gate reaches the Starting Pole. Monies bet on such a horse are refunded in accordance with the regulation concerning refunds.

LOST & OLD TICKETS

WEG issued tickets or vouchers are valid indefinitely, however, they cannot be cashed at a mutuel teller after 2 years from date of issue. Please mail tickets, along with your name and address, to Mutuel Manager, P.O. Box 156, Rexdale, Ontario, M9W 5L2, keeping a photocopy for future reference.

For "Lost Tickets" originally sold at a Woodbine Entertainment Group racetrack or Teletheatre, please enquire at the Mutuel office at Woodbine, Greenwood Teletheatre, or Mohawk. Policy may be subject to change retroactively in the event regulatory bodies amend existing regulations.

ASSOCIATION PERCENTAGE AND TAXATION/LEVY

The Woodbine Entertainment Group deducts and retains the following percentages from wagers placed at our own licensed sites which are then shared with the horsepeople, host and simulcast associations and the Ontario Racing Commission.

WOODBINE/MOHAWK LIVE: Win, Place & Show: 13.65%. Swinger 14.7%. Trifecta & Pick 4: 21.7%. Double & Exacta 17.2%. Jackpot Hi-5 & Pick 5: 11.7%. All other 23.0%

Horsepeople receive a further 2% on all wagers, except Trifecta wagering where it is 4%. The Ontario Provincial Government retains 0.5% on all bets placed in Ontario. The Canadian Government (through a revolving fund cost recovery basis) retains 0.8% on all wagers placed in Canada for provision of drug control, and audit services.
