Betting Basics

Some essentials to get you started with making a wager.

1 How to wager



Place your bet by visiting a teller, or using a self-serve terminal.

To place a bet here are just 5 things you need to know:

- 1 Name of racetrack (choose from any track in the simulcast feeds)
- 2 Number of the race
- 3 Amount of your bet (e.g. \$2)
- 4 Type of bet (see step 2)
- 5 Horse's number (see step 4)

Once you have decided what you want to bet, head to the nearest seller's window and use the sample statement as your guide:

Hello, (Racetrack), race 6, \$2 to WIN on Horse #4

How to use a self-serve terminal:

- 1 Swipe your Cash Card/Insert Cash
- 2 Enter the initial PIN #1234 (then choose a new PIN)
- 3 Press/Tap the track you would like to bet: (defaults to current race)
- 4 Tap the Horse Number: **#4**
- 5 Press/Tap the Bet Type: **WIN**
- 6 Press/Tap the Bet Amount: **\$2**
- 7 Press/Tap the Race Number: **Race #6**
- 8 Press Green **"Make BET"** button
- 9 Press/Tap the **"Finish with Receipt"** button
- 10 Be sure to check your ticket to confirm it's the bet you wanted

To get a Cash Card or for assistance ask a teller, or a staff member.

2 Types of bets



Single horse bets (minimum \$2.00 bet is required)

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Win	U U U	Your horse must finish 1st; payoff determined by the win odds.
Place	U U	Your horse must finish 1st or 2nd; payoffs better than to show.
Show	U	Your horse must finish 1st, 2nd, or 3rd; modest payoffs.

Exotic multiple-horse bets

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Exacta*	U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st and 2nd in exact order; riskier bet that can pay a little or a lot, depending on the horses' odds.
Daily double	U U U U U	Pick the winners of two designated consecutive races.
Pick 3, Win 4, Pick 5, Pick 6	U U U U U U	Select the winners of a designated set of consecutive races. The wager must be made prior to the start of the first race in the multi-race wager.
Triactor*	U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in exact order; can be expensive to play if you use a lot of horses.
Superfecta*	U U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th; big payoff possible.

* Exotic bets require the horses to finish in the EXACT order you select, unless you "BOX" the bet, in which case your selections can finish in any order.

#7 MAINTENANCE MAN made a first-over bid from fourth on the far turn last week and then forged his way to the lead in the lane before kicking away from pacesetter below in deep stretch. He scored by more than two lengths in 1:55.2 when dropping down to this level and had only mustered one lesser share in his previous three tries in the claiming handicap class above this after getting claimed back by trainer Garry Merner for \$9,000 at Flamboro Downs on November 21st. This 21-time winner has hit the board in seven of his 12 tries over three stints for this outfit and gets jammed right back for the same tag he was offered for last time out. He will have Bob McClure aboard for an encore performance and looks like a prime candidate to double-up.

#5 MACH SILVER exits the same race as the one above and went a long way on the lead in that contest before giving way to that rival in the stretch. He was clearly the best of the rest when more than two lengths clear of our fourth choice at the finish and completed the exacta at odds of 5-1. This 26-time winner has been the runner-up in six of his last seven and has not finished worse than that position in 11 of his last 12 overall. He figures to come out firing from the center of the gate and can continue his trend of being second-best.

#4 KEEPAMERICAGREAT made a break in stride on the backside in the class above this on December 30th and was sent off at more than 24-1 in that dash before getting away seventh off the switch from the pole position. He captured a consolation for a Pop-Up Series 11 nights earlier at 6-1 and scored by open lengths when pacing to a season's best clocking of 1:54.2. This 11-time winner should appreciate dropping down a level and gets reunited with driver Tyler Borth. He can bounce back in a big way and should be included in the exotic wagers.

#2 HERVEY HANOVER claimed the show spot last week but was nearly five lengths in arrears to Berens Weapon when he rounded out the trifecta at 3-1. He was fourth at 7-1 in the claiming handicap class above this on December 9th and shared victory with Happy Neighs in a dead heat in a condition claimer before that. This 25-time winner slides down to the inside of the gate with post-two and will once again have Billy Davis Jr giving the commands. He can grab a share.

#4 ALLSTAR PLAYBOY swept past his foes with a powerful three-wide move on the swing for home and was stuck behind a dawdling rival in the third-over position before flipping the switch. He paced away to win by more than two lengths in that round of this series and tripped the timer in a new lifetime mark of 1:55.2. This son of Stag Party lit the lamp for the first time since the end of July but has managed to hit the board in 14 of his 34 career attempts. He will have leading driver James MacDonald aboard for an encore performance and has our call to repeat.

#5 SPORTY BEE jumps into the second leg of this Pop-Up Series and could not have gotten a tougher journey in the Hi-5 mandatory payout event on Boxing Day when he got hung out to dry in the first-up position when trying to brush to the lead on the backstretch. He faded back to last under the wire as the 2-1 favorite and was only beaten by half a length to D A Captainobvious at a slightly shorter price on December 6th. This son of Sportswriter can benefit from getting a week off between outings and picks up Tyler Borth in the bike for the first time. He will be looking for a softer trip this time around and looms as a major danger.

#3 OUTRAGEOUS SHOW followed the cover of our top choice after getting away sixth off the gate but could not stay with that rival on the final turn before emerging to be the best of the rest in deep stretch. He could not deliver as the lukewarm favorite at nearly 3-1 but paced home in 28.2 on the heels of a back-half in 56.2. This son of Hes Watching has made steady progress through his three attempts for trainer Ron MacDonald and might get activated sooner in the mile this time out. He can hit the ticket.

#6 VOLTAGE BLUE CHIP claimed the show spot in two of his last four while going postward in NW3 and most recently raced from off the pace in a contest that was topped by R J Ringo. He was 14 lengths behind that pumped-up foe at the finish and chopped-out the first three panels on December 1st before fading to third in a race that was won by Manhawk. This son of American Ideal will now race for a price tag for the first time at this venue and will have Doug McNair calling the shots this time around. He starts from the winningest post at Mohawk Park and cannot be left off the bottom end of the exotics.

#4 DM SNAKEPLISSKEN has only mustered one minor award in his last six and was beaten by a wide margin in last on December 20th after walking home in 31.2. He has since moved to the care of conditioner Kyle Fellows and was fourth to Fashion Forward in a qualifier on January 3rd. This son of Betterthancheddar stepped his back-half in 58.1 with a final quarter in 28.4 and got his picture taken in four of his 15 appearances last season. He might be able to trend back in the right direction for his new barn and fits in nicely with this group.

#7 CHEDDAR DUHARAS claimed the show spot to D A Captainobvious in the first leg of this series, albeit he was more than 12 lengths in arrears to that rival at the finish. He paced his final panel in 28.3 on the heels of a back-half in 58.1 and completed the trifecta at 53-1. This son of Betterthancheddar must overcome the outermost post in the contest but typically races from off the pace. He gets Tyler Borth back between the wheels and that teamster piloted him to a maiden-breaking score just over a year ago.

#1 ALWAYS B MELMAN made a break in stride before the start last week and was never able to get back in contention at odds of 42-1. He has been shut out in each of his last three but is just five outings removed from notching back-to-back victories in early November. This son of Always B Miki slides down to the pole position in the second round of this series and goes up against a softer group this evening. He will likely try to push out for early position with rail control and is among the main chances.

#2 LA BARBE was parked first-over for much of the mile in his latest but did well to stick around for a lesser share in fifth. He was 11th in his circuit debut the week prior when he faced a tougher bunch in a Hi-5 mandatory payout affair and was never able to make his presence felt at more than 80-1 after having to start from the second-tier. This son of Sunshine Beach moves out one spot to post-two and can be in the mix throughout. He can pick up a sizable slice with the right kind of trip.

#4 BETTORHOLDONTIGHT got away last off the gate in each of his last two when priced for the maximum price tag of \$11,000 in a claiming handicap event. He was only able to improve a couple of positions in his most recent effort but made up significant ground two back when he was able to pick up a smaller share in fifth. This son of Bettors Delight is making his third start back after missing three months of action and gets reunited with top teamster James MacDonald, who has guided him to a trio of victories in the past. He should also appreciate getting down to a softer spot and can mow down this group in the late stages.

#2 MACH JACOBS has spent his last six racing for a tag of \$12,000 or more in a much tougher claiming handicap class and has finished third in two of his last three at that level. He has picked up a prize in three of his last four since moving to the barn of trainer Kyle Fellows but was just one for 38 last season. This 19-time winner hit the board 16 times over that span and will have Doug McNair calling the shots for the first time. He should much prefer the company he keeps in this condition claimer while getting discounted by \$4,000 and looms as a logical danger.

#3 PASSIONATE PRINCE went a long way on the lead last week and held a healthy margin through the first three panels before giving way to Berens Weapon in the lane. He rounded out the exacta at 17-1 and has been the runner-up in three of his last four. This 19-time winner picks up the driving services of Billy Davis Jr for the first time and might try similar tactics when moving in a couple of spots on the gate to post-three. He can land somewhere on the ticket.

#9 BAYLOR BOBBY disappointed as the race-favorite in each of his last two when competing in a Pop-Up Series here at Mohawk Park and was placed up to sixth from seventh in a consolation for that added-money event on December 19th. He could not deliver at 75 cents to the dollar the week prior and had to settle for the show spot in a race that was won by Odds On Carmel. This son of Armbr Baylor was passed over by J-Mac for our top selection and will have Brett MacDonald at the helm for the first time. He must overcome a tricky draw from post-nine but will likely be making noise when it matters most.

#9 CHARMBO STORMY has won five a row and will be looking for a sweep of the series after taking down both of the preliminary legs of this Pop-Up Event as the 9/5 favorite or less. She made every call a winning one in her latest before holding on by half a length and was on the rim for most of her journey in the opening round before setting a new lifetime mark of 1:53.4. This 17-time winner has not been worse than third in her last six since getting claimed for \$8,000 by trainer Jared Mann on November 22nd but must start from a more difficult spot on the gate when shifting out the nine-hole for the final. She figures to be oozing confidence and has our call to extend her streak to six.

#8 REDLANDBETHANYJEAN brushed to the lead on the backside last week and then held court the rest of the way until having a two-length cushion on her rivals at the wire. She only missed by half a length to the one above in the first round of this series and has been second or better in each of her last four overall. This 15-time winner has shown versatility in her racing style and has enough tactical speed to give herself options off the gate from post-eight. She has been racing at the top of her game for conditioner Tyler Moore and continues to get along well with driver Bob McClure.

#7 FATED FIRE slipped up the cones to spark an upset at 19-1 in the opening round of this series and then could not have worked out a sweeter trip last time out. She tracked our top pick from the two-hole for the duration of that mile but was still a length down at the finish when she completed the exacta at nearly 2-1. This 13-time winner gets a slight post position edge on the two above and has shown she can race from anywhere over the course of her career. She will have J-Mac aboard for a third straight start and should be included in all of the exotic wagers.

#6 CHOCOLATEFORLUNCH is an intriguing option after she rallied for the place spot underneath our second choice in her latest and blew up the bottom end of the exacta at a massive 55-1. She mixed it up in the early going from post-eight on Boxing Day and cannot be faulted for dropping back to eighth at the finish. This daughter of Dali is making her third start off the claim for trainer Derick Anderson and gets Trevor Henry back between the wheels. She will have the luxury of leaving from post-six and has upset potential.

#3 D A MAGIC MIKE was one we were fond of last week in the first leg of this series but was unable to get near D A Captainobvious after sitting a perfect pocket trip behind that rival. He disappointed at 80 cents to the dollar but was clearly the best of the rest when 11 lengths in front of Cheddar Duharas in third. This son of McWicked did well to be third in a Hi-5 mandatory payout event on Boxing Day after he had to start from the second-tier with post-12 and has now hit the board in 11 straight. He racked-up six victories over that span and can get the better of this group which is void of the one that bested him last time. Top call.

#4 BALLYKEEL PAINTER sat fourth for much of the mile in the opening round of this added-money event and then bullied his way to the lead in the lane after being shown clearance on the outside. He scored by nearly two lengths when he stopped the clock in 1:56.1 at odds of 9/2 and had not raced in nearly three weeks going into that effort. This son of Dali has captured three of his last five since moving to the barn of trainer Zachary Carroll and will have Bob McClure aboard for an encore performance. He figures to be feeling good about himself and is our main player underneath.

#2 JIMMY WHISPERS rallied for the place spot after being sixth for most of his journey last week and got within a couple of lengths of that rival when he banged home in 28 seconds flat off a back-half in 56.1. He is making his fourth start back after a hiatus of nearly two months and gets Tyler Borth aboard for a follow-up steer. This son of Big Jim lit the lamp in five of his 27 tries last season and can benefit from getting back on a regular rotation this evening. He can land somewhere on the ticket.

#6 ADRIATICO HANOVER exits the same race as the two above and finished third in that contest after getting away fifth off the gate. He moved to the outside on the cover of our second choice at the top of the final turn and rounded out the trifecta at nearly 30-1. This son of Stay Hungry has hit the board in three of his last four and will have the advantage of starting from post-six this time out. He picks up the driving services of Billy Davis Jr for the first time and can pick up a decent chunk.

#2 LILLY CLARE was taken back to last off the gate from post-five in the first leg of this series but made a spirited move on the bend for home before getting forced wide near the top of the far turn. She kept digging to the wire to be second to pocket-sitter P L Rinchenia at nearly 14-1 and paced her own mile in 1:55.4 off a back-half in 57.3. This daughter of Dali has hit the board in three of her last four and has not missed a cheque in any of her last 10 since getting claimed by trainer Darryl Laver at the end of September. She slides in a couple of spots on the gate to post-two and might be able to come out on top if she progresses in a follow-up try on the big track.

#6 VENDETTA BLUE CHIP has not raced since December 19th after getting scratched out of a NW3 event on January 3rd due to a stable error. She got nailed by a neck as the heavy-favorite to longshot Ideal Entry in her latest spin around the track but reeled-off four straight wins before that and fits in nicely in this Pop-Up Series. This daughter of Bettors Delight has only missed the board in one of her 13 career attempts and has been second or better in 11 of those efforts. She will work from the winningest post at Mohawk Park and got the nod from leading driver James MacDonald over three others in the contest.

#4 FANCY LETTERING was first-over for a long way last week before she forged her way to the lead near the head of the stretch but had no answers for the late legs of Allsmokeandmirrors in the lane. She was three lengths in arrears to that rival at the wire but did well to battle back for second after taking support to the tune of 9/5. This daughter of Stag Party has hit the board in three of her last four and went most of the way on the engine before converting as the even-money favorite when getting class-relief on December 5th. She will now race off the claim for conditioner Joe Pereira and gets reunited with driver Doug McNair, who piloted her to victory in NW2 at Georgian Downs last August.

#5 LE BEC FIN earned a minor award by finishing fifth in NW3 at 38-1 in her latest and was the runner-up in NW2 before that when getting sent off at odds of 16-1. She got off the schneid last season on December 12th when she clicked for her lone victory of 2024 in NW1 at this venue and is now two for 35 in her career. This daughter of Control The Moment has 14 top-three finishes over that span and should appreciate facing condition claimers when jumping into this series in the second leg. She will have Todd Ratchford at the reins for a follow-up steer and fits in nicely with this group.

#5 MENDING FENCES has been shut out in five of her last six and could not make her presence felt in either of the first two legs of this series. She was second or better in four straight here at Mohawk Park in the fall and was not beaten by more than a neck in any of those efforts. This daughter of Artspeak will be reunited with driver Doug McNair and they have combined for six victories in the past. She will likely have her gas pedal pressed off the switch from the center of the gate when going up against fellow also-rans in this consolation event and is worth a whirl on top.

#3 ROYAL TELL took support to the tune of 5/2 in the opening round of this series but had to settle for sixth after being in that position for most of her journey. She had since returned to Flamboro Downs to once again carry an optional claiming tag of \$13,000 and only missed by three quarters of a length to Sports Duchess after getting away fifth from the trailing post. This 10-time winner has been second or better in five of her last six on that half-mile oval and will get her nose on the gate from post-three when getting back on the big track. She can play a major role against this group and can threaten with a reasonable trip.

#6 BETTER BE DONNA N got away seventh or worse in both of the preliminary legs of this series but was only able to snag a lesser share two weeks ago when she improved to fifth after getting away last off the gate from post-10. She has only mustered four minor awards in her last nine overall but gets top teamster James MacDonald between the wheels for tonight's tilt. They have teamed-up for a pair of victories in 11 tries together and she has all kinds of back-class to rely on more than \$616,000 in earnings in her career. She will have the luxury of leaving from post-six and might have found the right spot to get back in the win-column.

#2 GETTING EUCHRED was sixth when she jumped into this series in the second round last week and that marked her first attempt over this surface in more than two months. She had hit the board in three straight going into that effort and has picked up a prize in eight of her last nine overall. This 19-time winner gets reunited with Tyler Borth and they have gotten their picture taken together on four occasions. She can make her presence felt throughout and is worth including on the bottom end of the trifecta and super.

She returned 9/5 to her backers when she tripped the beam in 1:55.2 and was fourth in each of her previous two before that. This daughter of Bettors Delight will once again start from the center of the gate with post-five and has Billy Davis Jr aboard for an encore performance. She might be able to work out a similar trip this evening and looks like a prime candidate to double-up.

#9 SAULSBROOK ANNIE exits the same race as the one above and blasted off the wings of the gate from post-seven before setting a hot tempo through the first three panels. She disappointed as the odds-on choice when she faded back to third at the finish but has managed to hit the board in 12 of her last 17. This daughter of Hes Watching got her picture taken in three of those outings and will likely once again take flight off the switch when sliding out another two spots on the gate. She will have J-Mac aboard for a follow-up steer and this dash might unfold in similar fashion.

#3 HOT COE COE claimed the show spot when racing from off the pace in the first leg of this series and was more than three lengths behind Allsmokeandmirrors when she completed the trifecta at 14-1. She had not raced in nearly three weeks going into that effort and has been fourth or better in her last six overall. This pacing daughter of My Mvp is just two starts removed from back-to-back victories at The Raceway in London and will once again have Bob McClure calling the shots. She can hit the ticket.

#2 SAULSBROOK FEISTY did not have much of a chance in her latest when she got away eighth off the gate from post-seven in NW2 but managed to maintain her position in third after getting away in the three-hole from the pole position two back. She was victorious on the front-end at Flamboro Downs before that and has hit the board in three of her last four since Dale Spence took over the driving duties. This 10-time winner has 17 top-three finishes from 25 career attempts and can do some damage against this bunch with the right kind of trip. She is worth keeping an eye on but might take more support than we are willing to get behind.

#7 GOLDEN LEADER has won three in a row and scored by a combined margin of more than five lengths across those victories. She has made every call a winning one in her last two and most recently delivered at 35 cents to the dollar when she stopped the clock in 1:56.3. This 25-time winner has changed hands in four of her last five and will now race off the claim for trainer Shayne Barrington. She will have Trevor Henry giving the commands for the first time under the lights and is hard to look past at what will surely be a short price.

#4 DEL DIGGITY would not be denied when racing for an \$8,000 price tag at The Raceway in London on January 1st and was first-over for a long way in the dash before forging her way to the lead in lane. She has not missed a cheque in her last 23 overall and is just four outings removed from being second or better in four straight at this venue. This 30-time winner should have her confidence back and is just over \$11,000 away from \$200,000 in lifetime earnings. She can never be ruled out and should offer some value on the board when getting back on the big track.

#9 FEARLESS SHELIA was second-best to our top pick last week and tracked that rival from the two-hole for the duration of that mile. She was not able to get within a length of that heavy-favorite before the wire but now has a flat line to her credit after she squandered a similar trip with a break in stride on Boxing Day. This 21-time winner has hit the board in 13 of her last 17 overall and has only been worse than fourth on one occasion over that span. She should have no trouble utilizing her early foot to get forwardly placed from another tricky spot on the gate and can be in the mix throughout.

#10 MY ONLY SUNSHINE came from a long way off the pace to be third at 32-1 in her latest and was able to get within a couple of lengths of our top pick at the finish. She was sixth two back when racing off the bench at Flamboro Downs and got a tough trip on the rim before getting tired in the late stages. This 10-time winner is making her third start back after missing nearly a month of action but must overcome the dreaded 10-hole. She will have Billy Davis Jr aboard for a follow-up steer and figures to be making noise when it matters most.

#2 GOLDIES ROCKIN exits the same race as the two above and finished sixth in that appearance after getting away in the three-hole from post-four. She was the runner-up to our first selection on Boxing Day and was victorious off the claim for trainer Gerard Demers on December 12th. This 21-time winner gets to work from the inside of the gate and might be able to navigate a cozy trip from post-two. She has rebound potential and should not be taken lightly.

CONDITIONS AND ALLOWANCES IN HARNESS RACING - IMPORTANT TO KNOW

The conditions of a race determine whether a horse is eligible to enter. For example many races are restricted to horses that have won a certain number of races or a certain amount of money in a specified number of starts. Many races are restricted to horses entered to be "claimed" (offered for sale) at a specific price.

Allowances in the claiming price itself are given to colts and geldings, four-year-olds and younger and to mares, five-year-olds and younger.

The purpose of the allowance is to keep younger horses more competitive when racing against older and more experienced rivals. Mares are given extra consideration in claiming events because of their potential as broodmares.

The accompanying chart shows what the allowances are, but an example may make them easier to understand. The chart indicates that three-year-olds receive a 50% allowance in claiming races. This means that a three-year-old entered in a \$20,000 claiming race carries an actual claiming price of \$30,000 (50% higher).

Fillies and mares receive an additional 25% allowance in claiming races. Details of the race conditions and claiming price (if any) are given at the top of each race in the program.

ALLOWANCES FOR PURSE EARNINGS

When Fillies/Mares compete against Colts/Geldings (normally on the trot) Fillies/Mares will receive an additional 25% on the condition of the race. ie: nw \$5,000 (FM \$6,250) last 5 or \$12,000 (FM \$15,000) last 10 starts.

C.P.M.A. Regulation Changes

Effective January 1st 2012
CPMA will be instituting several new rule changes with regards to the following pari-mutuel pools:

Pick Pools

- If there are no winners in any leg of a Pick N pool, the entire pool is refunded.
- If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners.
- A pool is no longer refunded if the 1st leg in the pool is cancelled or declared no contest.
- Pick-3: If at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: If at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.

EXPLANATION OF THE LASIX PROGRAM

After careful study and consultation with Ontario Horsemen's groups, racetrack operators and veterinarians, Agriculture Canada and the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario passed legislation allowing the controlled (or supervised) administration of furosemide, more commonly called "Lasix". "Lasix" is used to alleviate the symptoms of exercise induced pulmonary hemorrhaging in racing horses. Horses will undergo an endoscopic examination of the trachea by a veterinarian licensed by the Ontario Racing Commission and endorsed by an official veterinarian before being allowed on the medication list. Once qualified, horses will be treated with "Lasix" within four hours plus or minus 15 minutes of a scheduled race in a secure retention area under the super vision of racing officials.

All horses on "Lasix" must remain on the program for a minimum of 100 days while racing in this jurisdiction.

- (L)** Denotes horses treated with Lasix today who were not so treated for their last start.
- (L)** Denotes horses treated with Lasix for their last start but not so treated today.

RULES AND INFORMATION REGARDING CANADIAN HARNESS AND FOREIGN SEPARATE POOL EVENTS

GENERAL

All pari-mutuel pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with the regulations and directives as issued by Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada ("the Regulations"), under the approval and supervision of the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency. The Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency can be contacted at 1-800-268-8835 or 613-759-6100 or Email: cpmawebacpm@agr.gc.ca. A complete version of the CPMA regulations can be found at <http://laws-lois.justice.gc.ca/en/regulations/SOR-91-365/>.

All tickets should be held until the result of the race is declared official and prices are posted.

No person under the age of 18 shall purchase or cash a ticket or voucher.

A claim of receiving an incorrect payment or incorrect change must be made to the Mutuel office of the association within twenty four hours of buying or cashing a valid ticket or voucher.

No ruling made by the Stewards/Judges or the Ontario Racing Commission with regard to distribution of purse money or the placing of horses in the order of finish, after the race has been declared official, shall have any bearing on the pay-out prices or distribution of pari-mutuel pools.

Change boards and Photo Finish display monitors are located in the Grandstand. In addition, Photo Finish pictures are shown on the closed-circuit television system. Customers are reminded that mutuel clerks are responsible for all shortages. When making a wager, customers must present sufficient funds at the time of purchase to cover the wagers requested.

ENTRIES AND MUTUEL FIELDS

"Entry" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled or considered as the same betting interest. The most common reason for the coupling of horses in an Entry is the fact that they are owned by the same person.

"Mutuel Field" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled because the number of horses in the race exceeds the number which can be handled separately by the pari-mutuel system. Subject to the Regulations, a bet on one horse of an Entry or Mutuel Field shall be considered a bet on all horses in that Entry or Mutuel Field.

DAILY DOUBLE BETTING (INCLUDING LATE DOUBLE)

A Daily Double bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of the two races specified for the Daily Double. Tickets not selecting the winner of the first half of the Daily Double and all tickets in the second half of the Daily Double not coupled with the declared official winner of the first half of the Daily Double are not winners and are not refunded no matter what circumstances affect the running of the second half of the Daily Double.

Should a horse or horses (not coupled with another starter) be excused from starting in the second race of the Daily Double after the first race of the Daily Double has closed for betting, holders of all Daily Double tickets on such horses, coupled with the winner of the first Daily Double race, shall participate in a Consolation Double pool. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

EXACTA (Also known as Exactor)/TRIFECTA (Also known as Tractor)/SUPERFECTA

An Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first two, three and four horses respectively, representing different betting interests to finish in the exact official order of finish, in the race on which the pool is operated.

SWINGER (Also known as OMNI)

A Swinger is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select horses to finish in any order from the official first 3 positions.

JACKPOT HI-5

A Jackpot Hi-5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners in the specified Jackpot Hi-5 race. If there are races that have an entry, (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B), Jackpot Hi-5 will not offer a wager consisting of both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in a Jackpot Hi-5, the payout would be 1st, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th.

That jackpot portion of the pool will only be paid out if there is a single winning ticket. If there are multiple winning tickets that have correctly chosen the first 5 runners of the race, they will receive 50% of the pool for that day. The other 50% will go over into the Jackpot carryover. If there are no winning tickets with the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners, 100% of the current day's pool will be carried over into the Jackpot.

PICK 3 & PICK-4 BETTING

The Pick 3 & Pick 4 bets are betting transactions in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of three or four successive races specified for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 respectively.

Winning tickets for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 are determined in the following sequence: A) winners of all legs, B) most winners, then refund. If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners. If there are no winners in any leg of a pool, the entire pool is refunded.

PICK 5 BETTING

The Pick 5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of five successive races specified for the Pick 5 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 5 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 5.

PICK 3, PICK 4 & PICK 5 SCRATCHES

In the event a Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 ticket designates as a selection a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the Stewards/Judges to be a non-starter in any of the races comprising the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 the favourite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection. In the event that the money bet in the win pool for two or more favourites is identical, the selection with the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non-starting selection.

However, if a scratch occurs in any leg of the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 pools before the pool is closed, a ticket including the scratched horse may be cancelled.

REFUNDS

Subject to the Regulations, all monies in all pools on a race are refunded in the event that the race is cancelled, declared off or declared no contest, and all monies bet on a horse are refunded if the horse is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start. These refunds will be communicated to the public through various means such as betting terminals, video display, change boards and our website.

The Pick(n) pool shall be cancelled and all Pick(n) wagers for the individual performance shall be refunded if:

- Pick-3: at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

Where a horse that is part of an Entry is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start and at least one horse of that Entry receives a fair start in the race, all tickets purchased on the Entry remain valid and the purchase price of any such ticket shall not be refunded.

COMMON POOL WAGERING (INTERTRACK BETTING)

In the unlikely event of a communications or computer system failure that prevents pools from merging with the host track's pools before the end of a race, CPMA regulations require that the site must refund all tickets for that race. This refund will be communicated to the public through various means such as video displays, change boards and messages on our website.

FAIR START

If a horse has reached the Fair Start Pole (located 200 feet before the Starting Pole) by the time the mobile gate has reached the Starting Pole, that horse is deemed to have had a fair start. It makes no difference whether or not the horse is on or off stride at that precise moment. Under current policy and regulations, which are designed to be as fair as possible to all bettors on all starters, there is no Recall - a repeat of the entire starting procedure - when a horse does not reach the Fair Start Pole before the gate reaches the Starting Pole. Monies bet on such a horse are refunded in accordance with the regulation concerning refunds.

LOST & OLD TICKETS

WEG issued tickets or vouchers are valid indefinitely, however, they cannot be cashed at a mutuel teller after 2 years from date of issue. Please mail tickets, along with your name and address, to Mutuel Manager, P.O. Box 156, Rexdale, Ontario, M9W 5L2, keeping a photocopy for future reference.

For "Lost Tickets" originally sold at a Woodbine Entertainment Group racetrack or Teletheatre, please enquire at the Mutuel office at Woodbine, Greenwood Teletheatre, or Mohawk. Policy may be subject to change retroactively in the event regulatory bodies amend existing regulations.

ASSOCIATION PERCENTAGE AND TAXATION/LEVY

The Woodbine Entertainment Group deducts and retains the following percentages from wagers placed at our own licensed sites which are then shared with the horsepeople, host and simulcast associations and the Ontario Racing Commission.

WOODBINE/MOHAWK LIVE: Win, Place & Show: 13.65%. Swinger 14.7%. Trifecta & Pick 4: 21.7%. Double & Exacta 17.2%. Jackpot Hi-5 & Pick 5: 11.7%. All other 23.0%

Horsepeople receive a further 2% on all wagers, except Trifecta wagering where it is 4%. The Ontario Provincial Government retains 0.5% on all bets placed in Ontario. The Canadian Government (through a revolving fund cost recovery basis) retains 0.8% on all wagers placed in Canada for provision of drug control, and audit services.
