Betting Basics

Some essentials to get you started with making a wager.

1 How to wager



Place your bet by visiting a teller, or using a self-serve terminal.

To place a bet here are just 5 things you need to know:

- 1 Name of racetrack (choose from any track in the simulcast feeds)
- 2 Number of the race
- 3 Amount of your bet (e.g. \$2)
- 4 Type of bet (see step 2)
- 5 Horse's number (see step 4)

Once you have decided what you want to bet, head to the nearest seller's window and use the sample statement as your guide:

Hello, (Racetrack), race 6, \$2 to WIN on Horse #4

How to use a self-serve terminal:

- 1 Swipe your Cash Card/Insert Cash
- 2 Enter the initial PIN #1234 (then choose a new PIN)
- 3 Press/Tap the track you would like to bet: (defaults to current race)
- 4 Tap the Horse Number: **#4**
- 5 Press/Tap the Bet Type: **WIN**
- 6 Press/Tap the Bet Amount: **\$2**
- 7 Press/Tap the Race Number: **Race #6**
- 8 Press Green **"Make BET"** button
- 9 Press/Tap the **"Finish with Receipt"** button
- 10 Be sure to check your ticket to confirm it's the bet you wanted

To get a Cash Card or for assistance ask a teller, or a staff member.

2 Types of bets



Single horse bets (minimum \$2.00 bet is required)

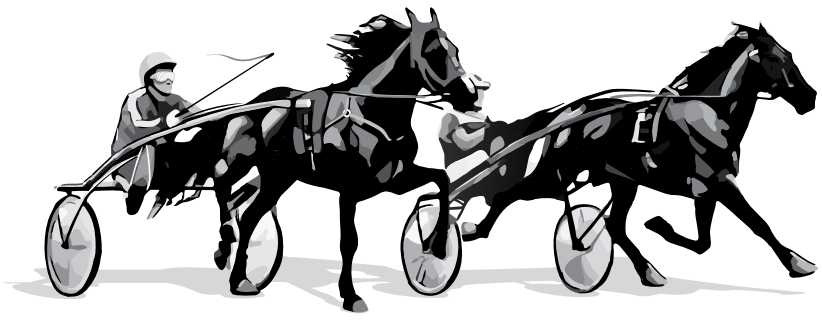
Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Win	U U U	Your horse must finish 1st; payoff determined by the win odds.
Place	U U	Your horse must finish 1st or 2nd; payoffs better than to show.
Show	U	Your horse must finish 1st, 2nd, or 3rd; modest payoffs.

Exotic multiple-horse bets

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Exacta*	U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st and 2nd in exact order; riskier bet that can pay a little or a lot, depending on the horses' odds.
Daily double	U U U U U	Pick the winners of two designated consecutive races.
Pick 3, Win 4, Pick 5, Pick 6	U U U U U U	Select the winners of a designated set of consecutive races. The wager must be made prior to the start of the first race in the multi-race wager.
Triactor*	U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in exact order; can be expensive to play if you use a lot of horses.
Superfecta*	U U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th; big payoff possible.

* Exotic bets require the horses to finish in the EXACT order you select, unless you "BOX" the bet, in which case your selections can finish in any order.

All of the numbers and letters in the program might seem confusing or overwhelming at first, but focusing on these sections makes choosing a horse simple.

- Horse's number in the race
- Horse's post position colour
- Horse's colour, sex, age, sire (father), dam (mother), sire of the dam
- Morning line odds
- Horse's name
- Driver and Driver Record (Name, # of wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, winning %)

- Trainer information
- Horse's Lifetime record (with best win time, track size, track, age, lifetime wins and lifetime earnings)
- Horse's current record (# of races, # wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, and money earned)

4 The odds



Odds are also important to consider when choosing your horse. Horses that are thought to have a better chance of winning will typically have lower odds.

Morning line odds

Odds listed in the race program are the "morning line" odds. These are predictions of how the public will bet on the race. They are set by the track's handicapper when the race program is published, before the wagering starts.

The actual odds will be posted on the **Television** or in-field on the **Tote Board** before the race; they change up until post time, depending on how customers are betting on each horse in the race.

Calculating a \$2 win prize

To calculate a win prize, find the Odds of a horse on the **Television** or **Tote Board** (in-field board).

Multiply the first number by 2, then divide that number by the second digit (if there is one), and then add \$2. Simple as that!

Odds	1/2	2/1	7/2	5/1	10/1

Helpful facts for betting

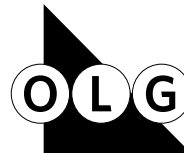
- Some racetracks have a television simulcast commentator who tries to identify winning horses (handicaps) between the races. Listen and see if you can pick up any good tips to bet on.
- A good betting method is to choose horses with current odds two to three times higher than their morning line odds.

3 Tips to remember

WIN BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 32% of the time
PLACE BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 53% of the time
SHOW BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 67% of the time

Race 1 Selections

THE HORSEPLAYERS JOURNAL by Robert Reid Jr.

#9 OH BROTHER got away third off the gate from post-five last week and slipped to the outside in the second-over position on the bend for home before brushing past his rivals in the stretch. He trotted away to score by nearly three lengths at the finish and stopped the clock in 1:57.1 over a surface that was one second off. This son of Greenshoe has hit the board in three straight and has been getting along well with driver Trevor Henry. He must overcome a more difficult draw when shifting out to the nine-hole but should be confident coming into this and has our call to double-up in the opener.

#4 STEAMER was one we were fond of in his latest when he had to step up to this level and went a long way on the engine before giving way to the one above in the lane. He set honest fractions before getting leg weary in the late stages and was the best of the rest when he completed the exacta at 5-1. This son of Resolve won two in a row by a combined margin of more than eight lengths before that and will have Bob McClure aboard for a follow-up steer. He should be better acclimated to this level of competition and can be right there at the wire.

#7 MOUNDS FOR ALL rallied for fourth last week after he got away seventh off the switch but was nearly five lengths in arrears to our top pick at the finish. He rounded out the superfecta at odds of 47-1 and will now be making his third start back after a layoff of seven months. This son of Swan For All was passed over by James MacDonald for Perfect Angel and will have Jonathan Drury between the wheels for the third consecutive outing. He should be ready to show his best and is worth a look if the price is right.

#3 FABULOUS FREDDIE exits the same race as the three above and made a break in stride just after the start of that contest after taking support to the tune of 6-1. He was just one for 21 last season but has hit the board in 10 of his 29 career attempts. This son of Alarm Detector was the runner-up to Drebin at this level on December 20th but has had to settle for the bottom spot on the superfecta in five of his last eight overall. He will likely have a flat line as his top priority but can still grab a share.

#5 SHOOT THE WHISKEY was first-over for a long way last week after landing in the four-hole off the switch and did well to finish second to a dominant winner in Lyons Bettorday. She tipped her hand to that effort when she rallied for a minor award in fifth after getting away last off the gate from post-10 two starts ago and has hit the board in four of her last seven. This 29-time winner slides in another few spots on the gate and has proven to be versatile in her racing style. She does not have to worry about the one that bested her last time and gets our top honors against this group.

#3 CHIEFS DREAM GIRL was scratched due to injury when she was entered in the class above this on January 3rd and claimed the place spot at 18-1 in this class the week prior. She has been second or better in three of her last four but only made three trips to victory lane in 44 attempts in 2024. This 16-time winner had 17 top-three finishes over that span and fits in nicely with this group. She will likely make her presence felt at some point in the mile and looms as a major danger.

#1 WILDCAT STAR has not raced since November 29th after she was scratched due to sickness on December 14th but has not been worse than fourth in her last four at this level. She claimed the place spot to Caviar N Crackers on November 1st and could not have been more dominant in victory in a softer spot before that. This 11-time winner has lit the lamp in five of her nine tries with J-Mac in the sulky and might be able to navigate a cozy trip from the pole position. She can do damage against his bunch if she is ready to roll and is worth keeping an eye on.

#4 VIOLETS RAINBOW was just a length behind our top choice last week when she rounded out the trifecta at 35-1 but was ninth or worse in her previous two after dropping down to this class. She has picked up a prize in four of her last six since relocating north of the border to race under the care of conditioner Isaac Waxman and will have Jonathan Drury at the helm for a follow-up steer. This 20-time winner will have options off the gate from post-four and should be included in all of the exotic wagers.

He delivered as the favorite in both of those efforts and will now take another slight step upwards to NW2. This son of Captaintreacherous has not raced in nearly two weeks but should be oozing confidence coming into this. He will work from the pole position and gets the nod to remain undefeated.

#5 BEACH CRUISER has earned a minor award in three of his last four and was fifth in each of his last two tries at this level over that span. He was a long way back from a dominant winner in R J Ringo in his latest but just over a length away from Ulysses on December 21st. This son of Yankee Cruiser moves out one spot to the center of the gate and will have leading driver James MacDonald calling the shots for the first time. He looks threatening in this spot and the price might be right.

#4 PURELY WICKED returned to the winner's circle last week after going on the attack in the first-over position from the three-hole on the spin for home and converted as the even-money favorite when he paced away to a comfortable margin before the finish. He steps up another notch on the class ladder but fits in nicely with this group.

He picked up a prize in 10 of his 11 tries before that and rounded out the trifecta at 19-1 in a contest that was topped by T H Boomtown on December 28th. This son of Bettors Delight is just one for 22 in his career but hit the board in nine of his 21 attempts last year. He starts from another inside draw after having back-to-back 10-holes at the end of December and will be reunited with driver Doug McNair, who piloted him to consecutive second-place finishes in the two previous times they were paired together.

He delivered as the 9/5 favorite in that contest and tipped his hand to that effort when he closed from off the pace to be third at 23-1 on December 28th. This son of Bettors Delight has hit the board in seven of his eight lifetime tries and gets Travis Cullen back between the wheels for tonight's tilt. He is among the chances but might take more support than we are willing to get behind.

#8 DARRELL made every call a winning one from post-two at Flamboro Downs on Boxing Day and tripped the timer in 1:56.3 on that half-mile oval. He has been fourth or better in his last three since relocating to Ontario from the east coast to race out of the barn of trainer Doug Hie and will now try his luck on the larger track configuration of Mohawk Park for the first time. This son of Pang Shui has hit the board in 11 of his 18 career attempts and will once again have Phil Hudon at the helm. He should offer some value on the tote board and is not without a chance.

#4 WHATCHULOOKIN AT set legit fractions through the first three panels on a track that was one second off in his latest and faded back to third as the 9/5 favorite in a dash that was topped by Poseidon Seelster. He got up by a head two weeks prior when he stepped up to this level and has gotten his picture taken in three of his last five. This 13-time winner slides down three spots on the gate to post-four and can benefit from getting back on a regular rotation. He will have Trevor Henry aboard for a follow-up steer and gets top billing.

#3 NO CONTROL is an intriguing option when making his second start back after a lengthy layoff and likely needed his most recent effort when he trailed throughout last week in this class after being taken to the back of the pack off the gate. He has since moved to the barn of trainer Kyle Fellows and will have leading driver James MacDonald calling the shots for the first time under the lights. This son of Control The Moment was second or better in eight of his 13 attempts last season and was just over \$5,000 shy of \$250,000 in earnings. He can take a big step forward in this spot and looms as the main danger.

#2 PACINO HANOVER exits the same race as the two above and sat in the three-hole for much of the mile before getting past our top choice for the place spot in deep stretch. He has hit the board in five of his last seven and was last victorious in a middle condition class on December 21st. This 12-time winner moves in a few spots on the gate to post-two and might be able to navigate another favorable journey. He should not be left off the bottom end of the exotics.

#1 WHICHWAYTOTHEBEACH dominated his rivals on the front-end in NW17250L5 last week and scored by nearly four lengths when he tripped the beam in 1:52.3 on a surface that was one second off. He has only missed a cheque in one of his last 17 overall but had to settle for a lesser share in his last attempt at this level on December 21st. This 25-time winner will have Travis Henry aboard for an encore performance and can be more than competitive in this compact field of six with anything close to his best. He won three in a row in the Preferred ranks in the summer and cannot be ruled out.

#5 HOWMAC MAXIMUS is one that we are willing to come back to after he had to settle for second to the one below last week as the odds-on choice of the betting public. He followed that rival to the outside from the three-hole near the top of the far turn and then engaged in battle in the stretch but was three quarters of a length away from victory at the wire. This 15-time winner has been second or better in six of his last seven overall and sparked an upset at 13-1 on December 20th when he lit the lamp in a preliminary round of a Pop-Up Series. He will start from the center of the gate for the fifth straight start and once again gets the nod on top.

#6 WIND BLOWN pushed out from post-two in his latest to secure a two-hole trip behind Foxhunt and then popped the pocket on the bend for home before forging his way to the lead in the lane. He managed to shake off the challenge of the one above and returned 4-1 to his backers when he stopped the clock in 1:54.2. This 29-time winner has gotten his picture taken in two of his last three and will be making his third start under the care of conditioner Tony Beaton. He will have the advantage of starting from post-six this time around and has repeat potential.

#3 PIPEWRENCH CHARLIE exits the same race as the two above and did not have much of a chance in that contest when he got away last off the gate from post-10 and was more than 15 lengths off the lead at the quarter pole. He improved to fifth before the wire when he stepped home in 29 seconds flat on the heels of a back-half in 56.4 and has picked up a prize in four of his last five. This 19-time winner has not been as consistent as he once was but should appreciate getting major post-relief with the three-hole. He is worth keeping an eye on but the bottom end of the exotics is likely his ceiling.

#7 HOWMAC VICTOR claimed the show spot at nearly 35-1 in a dash that was topped by Nighttime Dancer on December 30th and has now picked up a prize in five straight. He lit up the board at nearly 13-1 when he made a triumphant return to Mohawk Park in the bottom condition on December 23rd but shifts towards the outside of the gate in tonight's tilt. This 12-time winner hit the board in 15 of his 35 attempts last season and will have Trevor Henry aboard for a follow-up steer. He can pick up another piece.

#4 MYULTIMATE SNOWY A has been fourth or better in his last three since making the trek to North America from Australia but disappointed as the 6/5 favorite or less in two of those outings. He went postward in NW17250L5 in those efforts and should appreciate dropping down a notch on the class ladder to NW8000L5. This son of Sweet Lou will be making his fourth try under the care of conditioner Kyle Fellows and will have top teamster James MacDonald back between the wheels. He might be hard to hold off in this spot and has our call to emerge victorious in the finale.

#2 CODE CRACKER exits the same race as the one above and was never a factor in that contest after he got away last off the gate from post-10 and was 17 lengths off the lead at the opening marker. He advanced a couple of positions before the wire to finish eighth at 116-1 and picked up a prize in each of his previous seven tries before that. This 16-time winner has been second or better in three of his last six and only gets to drop down to this level because he will carry the optional price tag of \$50,000. He figures to be much closer to the action this evening and can threaten for the lion's share with the right kind of trip.

#8 LEGION SEELSTER was second-best to Hungry Man last week and was a length away from that rival at the wire when he completed the exacta as the 7/5 favorite. He had to settle for a lesser share in fifth two back after he made a first-over bid from third on the spin for home and was beaten by more than eight lengths to race-favorite Codename Cigar Box. This 27-time winner has hit the board in four of his last seven and enjoyed back-to-back victories near the end of November. He should offer an opportunity to take back value for those that supported him last time and can land somewhere on the ticket.

#3 DUPREE HANOVER exits the same race as the one above and rallied for third in that dash after he got away seventh off the switch. He has crossed the wire in that position in each of his last two but was placed back to fourth through disqualification for a pylon violation on December 28th. This son of Stay Hungry has hit the board in three straight and slides back down to a favorable spot on the gate with post-three. He gets reunited with driver Doug McNair and is among the chances.

#5 SAULSBROOK IAN returned to victory lane in the class below this last week and converted off a pocket trip when he stopped the clock in 1:54 flat on a track that was one second off. He offered nearly 3-1 to his supporters and had not tasted victory since the end of July on the east coast. This 18-time winner should have his confidence back and gets Travis Henry at the helm for an encore performance. He will have options off the switch when once again working from the center of the gate and can pick up a slice.

CONDITIONS AND ALLOWANCES IN HARNESS RACING - IMPORTANT TO KNOW

The conditions of a race determine whether a horse is eligible to enter. For example many races are restricted to horses that have won a certain number of races or a certain amount of money in a specified number of starts. Many races are restricted to horses entered to be "claimed" (offered for sale) at a specific price.

Allowances in the claiming price itself are given to colts and geldings, four-year-olds and younger and to mares, five-year-olds and younger.

The purpose of the allowance is to keep younger horses more competitive when racing against older and more experienced rivals. Mares are given extra consideration in claiming events because of their potential as broodmares.

The accompanying chart shows what the allowances are, but an example may make them easier to understand. The chart indicates that three-year-olds receive a 50% allowance in claiming races. This means that a three-year-old entered in a \$20,000 claiming race carries an actual claiming price of \$30,000 (50% higher).

Fillies and mares receive an additional 25% allowance in claiming races. Details of the race conditions and claiming price (if any) are given at the top of each race in the program.

C.P.M.A. Regulation Changes

Effective January 1st 2012
CPMA will be instituting several new rule changes with regards to the following pari-mutuel pools:

Pick Pools

- If there are no winners in any leg of a Pick N pool, the entire pool is refunded.
- If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners.
- A pool is no longer refunded if the 1st leg in the pool is cancelled or declared no contest.
- Pick-3: If at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: If at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.

EXPLANATION OF THE LASIX PROGRAM

After careful study and consultation with Ontario Horsemen's groups, racetrack operators and veterinarians, Agriculture Canada and the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario passed legislation allowing the controlled (or supervised) administration of furosemide, more commonly called "Lasix". "Lasix" is used to alleviate the symptoms of exercise induced pulmonary hemorrhaging in racing horses. Horses will undergo an endoscopic examination of the trachea by a veterinarian licensed by the Ontario Racing Commission and endorsed by an official veterinarian before being allowed on the medication list. Once qualified, horses will be treated with "Lasix" within four hours plus or minus 15 minutes of a scheduled race in a secure retention area under the super vision of racing officials.

All horses on "Lasix" must remain on the program for a minimum of 100 days while racing in this jurisdiction.

- L** Denotes horses treated with Lasix.
- (L)** Denotes horses treated with Lasix today who were not so treated for their last start.
- (L)** Denotes horses treated with Lasix for their last start but not so treated today.

RULES AND INFORMATION REGARDING CANADIAN HARNESS AND FOREIGN SEPARATE POOL EVENTS

GENERAL

All pari-mutuel pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with the regulations and directives as issued by Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada ("the Regulations"), under the approval and supervision of the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency. The Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency can be contacted at 1-800-268-8835 or 613-759-6100 or Email: cpmawebacpm@agr.gc.ca. A complete version of the CPMA regulations can be found at <http://laws-lois.justice.gc.ca/en/regulations/SOR-91-365/>. All tickets should be held until the result of the race is declared official and prices are posted.

No person under the age of 18 shall purchase or cash a ticket or voucher.

A claim of receiving an incorrect payment or incorrect change must be made to the Mutuel office of the association within twenty four hours of buying or cashing a valid ticket or voucher.

No ruling made by the Stewards/Judges or the Ontario Racing Commission with regard to distribution of purse money or the placing of horses in the order of finish, after the race has been declared official, shall have any bearing on the pay-out prices or distribution of pari-mutuel pools.

Change boards and Photo Finish display monitors are located in the Grandstand. In addition, Photo Finish pictures are shown on the closed-circuit television system. Customers are reminded that mutuel clerks are responsible for all shortages. When making a wager, customers must present sufficient funds at the time of purchase to cover the wagers requested.

ENTRIES AND MUTUEL FIELDS

"Entry" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled or considered as the same betting interest. The most common reason for the coupling of horses in an Entry is the fact that they are owned by the same person.

"Mutuel Field" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled because the number of horses in the race exceeds the number which can be handled separately by the pari-mutuel system. Subject to the Regulations, a bet on one horse of an Entry or Mutuel Field shall be considered a bet on all horses in that Entry or Mutuel Field.

DAILY DOUBLE BETTING (INCLUDING LATE DOUBLE)

A Daily Double bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of the two races specified for the Daily Double. Tickets not selecting the winner of the first half of the Daily Double and all tickets in the second half of the Daily Double not coupled with the declared official winner of the first half of the Daily Double are not winners and are not refunded no matter what circumstances affect the running of the second half of the Daily Double.

Should a horse or horses (not coupled with another starter) be excused from starting in the second race of the Daily Double after the first race of the Daily Double has closed for betting, holders of all Daily Double tickets on such horses, coupled with the winner of the first Daily Double race, shall participate in a Consolation Double pool. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

EXACTA (Also known as Exactor)/TRIFECTA (Also known as Tractor)/SUPERFECTA

An Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first two, three and four horses respectively, representing different betting interests to finish in the exact official order of finish, in the race on which the pool is operated.

SWINGER (Also known as OMNI)

A Swinger is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select horses to finish in any order from the official first 3 positions.

JACKPOT HI-5

A Jackpot Hi-5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners in the specified Jackpot Hi-5 race. If there are races that have an entry, (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B), Jackpot Hi-5 will not offer a wager consisting of both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in a Jackpot Hi-5, the payout would be 1st, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th.

That jackpot portion of the pool will only be paid out if there is a single winning ticket. If there are multiple winning tickets that have correctly chosen the first 5 runners of the race, they will receive 50% of the pool for that day. The other 50% will go over into the Jackpot carryover. If there are no winning tickets with the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners, 100% of the current day's pool will be carried over into the Jackpot.

PICK 3 & PICK-4 BETTING

The Pick 3 & Pick 4 bets are betting transactions in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of three or four successive races specified for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 respectively.

Winning tickets for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 are determined in the following sequence: A) winners of all legs, B) most winners, then refund. If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners. If there are no winners in any leg of a pool, the entire pool is refunded.

PICK 5 BETTING

The Pick 5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of five successive races specified for the Pick 5 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 5 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 5.

PICK 3, PICK 4 & PICK 5 SCRATCHES

In the event a Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 ticket designates as a selection a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the Stewards/Judges to be a non-starter in any of the races comprising the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 the favourite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection. In the event that the money bet in the win pool for two or more favourites is identical, the selection with the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non-starting selection.

However, if a scratch occurs in any leg of the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 pools before the pool is closed, a ticket including the scratched horse may be cancelled.

REFUNDS

Subject to the Regulations, all monies in all pools on a race are refunded in the event that the race is cancelled, declared off or declared no contest, and all monies bet on a horse are refunded if the horse is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start. These refunds will be communicated to the public through various means such as betting terminals, video display, change boards and our website.

The Pick(n) pool shall be cancelled and all Pick(n) wagers for the individual performance shall be refunded if:

- Pick-3: at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

Where a horse that is part of an Entry is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start and at least one horse of that Entry receives a fair start in the race, all tickets purchased on the Entry remain valid and the purchase price of any such ticket shall not be refunded.

COMMON POOL WAGERING (INTERTRACK BETTING)

In the unlikely event of a communications or computer system failure that prevents pools from merging with the host track's pools before the end of a race, CPMA regulations require that the site must refund all tickets for that race. This refund will be communicated to the public through various means such as video displays, change boards and messages on our website.

FAIR START

If a horse has reached the Fair Start Pole (located 200 feet before the Starting Pole) by the time the mobile gate has reached the Starting Pole, that horse is deemed to have had a fair start. It makes no difference whether or not the horse is on or off stride at that precise moment. Under current policy and regulations, which are designed to be as fair as possible to all bettors on all starters, there is no Recall - a repeat of the entire starting procedure - when a horse does not reach the Fair Start Pole before the gate reaches the Starting Pole. For "Lost Tickets" originally sold at a Woodbine Entertainment Group racetrack or Teletheatre, please enquire at the Mutuel office at Woodbine, Greenwood Teletheatre, or Mohawk. Policy may be subject to change retroactively in the event regulatory bodies amend existing regulations.

ASSOCIATION PERCENTAGE AND TAXATION/LEVY

The Woodbine Entertainment Group deducts and retains the following percentages from wagers placed at our own licensed sites which are then shared with the horsepeople, host and simulcast associations and the Ontario Racing Commission.

WOODBINE/MOHAWK LIVE: Win, Place & Show: 13.65%. Swinger 14.7%. Trifecta & Pick 4: 21.7%. Double & Exacta 17.2%. Jackpot Hi-5 & Pick 5: 11.7%. All other 23.0%

Horsepeople receive a further 2% on all wagers, except Trifecta wagering where it is 4%. The Ontario Provincial Government retains 0.5% on all bets placed in Ontario. The Canadian Government (through a revolving fund cost recovery basis) retains 0.8% on all wagers placed in Canada for provision of drug control, and audit services.
