Betting Basics

Some essentials to get you started with making a wager.

1 How to wager



Place your bet by visiting a teller, or using a self-serve terminal.

To place a bet here are just 5 things you need to know:

- 1 Name of racetrack (choose from any track in the simulcast feeds)
- 2 Number of the race
- 3 Amount of your bet (e.g. \$2)
- 4 Type of bet (see step 2)
- 5 Horse's number (see step 4)

Once you have decided what you want to bet, head to the nearest seller's window and use the sample statement as your guide:

Hello, (Racetrack), race 6, \$2 to WIN on Horse #4

How to use a self-serve terminal:

- 1 Swipe your Cash Card/Insert Cash
- 2 Enter the initial PIN #1234 (then choose a new PIN)
- 3 Press/Tap the track you would like to bet: (defaults to current race)
- 4 Tap the Horse Number: **#4**
- 5 Press/Tap the Bet Type: **WIN**
- 6 Press/Tap the Bet Amount: **\$2**
- 7 Press/Tap the Race Number: **Race #6**
- 8 Press Green **"Make BET"** button
- 9 Press/Tap the **"Finish with Receipt"** button
- 10 Be sure to check your ticket to confirm it's the bet you wanted

To get a Cash Card or for assistance ask a teller, or a staff member.

2 Types of bets



Single horse bets (minimum \$2.00 bet is required)

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Win	U U U	Your horse must finish 1st; payoff determined by the win odds.
Place	U U	Your horse must finish 1st or 2nd; payoffs better than to show.
Show	U	Your horse must finish 1st, 2nd, or 3rd; modest payoffs.

Exotic multiple-horse bets

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Exacta*	U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st and 2nd in exact order; riskier bet that can pay a little or a lot, depending on the horses' odds.
Daily double	U U U U U	Pick the winners of two designated consecutive races.
Pick 3, Win 4, Pick 5, Pick 6	U U U U U U	Select the winners of a designated set of consecutive races. The wager must be made prior to the start of the first race in the multi-race wager.
Triactor*	U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in exact order; can be expensive to play if you use a lot of horses.
Superfecta*	U U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th; big payoff possible.

* Exotic bets require the horses to finish in the EXACT order you select, unless you "BOX" the bet, in which case your selections can finish in any order.

THE HORSEPLAYERS JOURNAL by Robert Reid Jr.

#8 INDUSTRIALISTS was a \$12,000 yearling purchase at the Lexington Select sale that will be sent out for his lifetime debut by trainer Herb Holland. He trotted away to an easy score in his lone qualifier on January 10th and was five lengths away from his closest pursuer when he stopped the clock in 2:03.3 on a track that was one second off. This son of Muscle Hill blasted home in 28 seconds flat on the heels of a back-half in 1:00.2 but must start from an outside draw in his first try under the lights. He looks like he is ready to roll at first asking and gets the nod on top to kick off the card.

#6 WHEELIN N STEALIN has been second or better in each of his last three and most recently made every call a winning one in a maiden-breaking score at Flamboro Downs on December 28th. He tripped the timer in 2:03.2 on a half-mile oval that was off by two seconds and delivered as the 1/9 favorite in that dash. This son of Wheelin N Dealin was only beaten by a neck to Magics Angel Eyes in this class just over a couple of weeks earlier and has only missed one cheque in his 12 career attempts. He will have the luxury of leaving from post-six and should offer some value on the board.

#2 SOUTHWIND CAPONE was a \$14,000 yearling purchase at the Lexington Select sale that will be making the first start of his career for conditioner Shannon Henry. He is the eighth foal out of Counter Pointe (5, \$239,710, 1:57.3) and has five siblings that have made over \$100,000 each. This son of Muscle Hill was held together in the late stages of a morning prep on January 3rd and trotted his own mile in 2:00.3 when nearly five lengths in arrears to a six-time winner in Mass Money. He works from an inside draw and can land somewhere on the ticket.

#9 SPICE TRIX made a break in stride in his lifetime debut on December 19th after being sent off at odds of 63-1 and was also unable to stay on his gait in a pair of qualifiers last June. He has since moved to the barn of trainer Mark Etsell and was a \$50,000 yearling purchase at the Lexington Select sale. This son of Trixtion has three siblings that have banked over \$200,000 each but will have to overcome the outermost post in the contest. He is an intriguing option at what figures to be a decent number and is worth keeping an eye on.

Race 2 Selections

THE HORSEPLAYERS JOURNAL by Robert Reid Jr.

#7 MACH SILVER blew his rivals away on the engine last week and opened a wide margin on the final turn before scoring by more than four lengths at the finish. He returned 5/2 to his backers and has been second or better in 12 of his last 13 overall. This 27-time winner's price has been increased by \$1,000 for tonight's tilt and shifts out four spots on the gate. He will likely once again take flight off the gate from post-seven and looks like a prime candidate to double-up.

#6 QUAN BLUE CHIP has tried his luck in the bottom condition in each of his last two and took support to the tune of 5/2 on December 30th before rounding out the trifecta in a race that was topped by Dr Joe. He finished ninth in his subsequent effort at much longer odds and will now once again race for a claiming tag of \$8,000. This 30-time winner was the runner-up to G A Speedy Sammy in the final of a Pop-Up Series on December 19th and was strong in victory in the opening round of that added-money event two weeks prior. He will have the advantage of starting from post-six and looms as a danger.

#4 KEYSTONE TENACIOUS has finished eighth in each of his last two when going postward in the class above this and faded back to that position after being on the rim through the middle panels just a few nights ago. He gets discounted by another \$4,000 when coming back on just two days of rest and is making his third start for trainer Jodie Cullen after relocating to this circuit from Alberta. This 29-time winner has hit the board in 68 of his 157 lifetime tries and has more than \$455,000 in earnings. He moves out a few spots off the rail and should much prefer the company he keeps this evening.

#3 MACH JACOBS delivered as the 4/5 odds-on favorite last week when he dropped down to an \$8,000 condition claimer after spending six straight at the level above this. He was gutsy in victory when getting past a determined Passionate Prince after making a first-over bid but now meets tougher foes when racing for the same price tag in this opening claiming handicap class. This 20-time winner has hit the board in three of his last five and will have Doug McNair aboard for a follow-up steer. He should have his confidence back after going just one for 38 last year and can pick up a decent chunk.

#2 MUSCLE BRANCH has hit the board in each of her two career attempts and was five lengths in arrears to race-favorite Neverlose Felix as the definitive second-choice in the betting in her most recent effort. She was at a pace disadvantage to that rival when she was second-over on the final turn and had too much ground to make up when having to settle for the place spot. This daughter of Muscle Hill was third in her lifetime debut at 4-1 before that and will slide in four spots on the gate to post-two. She looks like she is ready to graduate but will attract a lot of attention on the tote board.

#3 MEGA GENEROUS got away seventh off the switch when making the first start of his career last week and was third-over on the spin for home before making a miscue in the stretch. He was poised to make a forward move in the lane when he made that break in stride and was second to Collector S in his lone qualifier on December 27th, albeit he was 13 lengths behind that rival at the finish. This son of Trixton trotted his own mile in 2:00.2 with a 29.1 kicker on that occasion and will slide in five spots on the gate to post-three. This son of Looklikeeachpndale produced a decent qualifying effort to be fourth on January 3rd and stepped his own mile in 2:00.4 on a track that was one second off. He might need to get a start under his feet before he is ready for his best but is still worth utilizing on the bottom end of the exotics.

He will have Doug McNair calling the shots for the first time and is our clear choice on top.

#3 SPORTY BEE was moving well on the wide side in the late stages in his latest and nearly got within a length of winner Voltage Blue Chip when he rounded out the superfecta at 5-1. He disappointed as the 2-1 favorite in Hi-5 mandatory payout event two weeks earlier but was first-up for a long way in the dash before fading back to last under the wire. This son of Sportswriter will have Tyler Borth aboard for a follow-up steer and can benefit from getting back on a regular rotation. He will likely be making noise when it matters most and is one of our main players underneath.

#10 CHEDDAR DUHARAS was third in each of the two preliminary legs of this Pop-Up Series and was within a couple of lengths of Always B Melman last time out. He was sent off at 9/2 in that contest and took that support after he claimed the show spot at long odds to D A Captainobvious the week prior. This son of Betterthancheddar is just two for 33 in his career but has hit the board 10 times over that span. He picks up the driving services of Austin Sorrie for the first time but faces the difficult task of starting from the dreaded 10-hole.

#1 DM SNAKEPLISSKEN exits the same race as the one above and rallied for fifth in that contest after he was taken back to seventh off the switch. He was 11 lengths off the lead at the opening marker and paced his back-half in 58 seconds flat with a final quarter in 29.1. This son of Betterthancheddar is making a follow-up try under the care of conditioner Kyle Fellows and can take another step forward when getting back on a regular schedule. He might be able to navigate a cozy trip from the pole position and should not be taken lightly.

This son of Captain Crunch is five for 35 in his career but those victories have all come in his last 13 tries and he has only missed the board in one of those efforts. He has been racing at the top of this game for trainer Victor Puddy and looms as a logical threat.

#8 VOLTAGE BLUE CHIP held on by a head at 60 cents to the dollar when he jumped into the second leg of this series last week and lit the lamp for the first time since April of last year. He spent his previous five appearances in NW2 and has managed to hit the board in three of his last six since relocating north of the border to race under the care of conditioner Gregg McNair. This son of American Ideal will have son Doug at the helm for an encore performance but shifts out a couple of spots on the gate to post-eight. He should be feeling good about himself and is among the chances if he can avoid a taxing trip.

#9 ALLSTAR PLAYBOY exits the same race as the one above and was the one we were fond of in that dash but finished third after going on the attack against that rival from the first-over position on the bend for home. He executed an impressive three-wide brush to the front from fifth two back in the opening round of this event and scored by open lengths when he paced his way to a new career best clocking of 1:55.2. This son of Stag Party has picked up a prize in six of his last seven and gets reunited with driver Tyler Jones. He might get overlooked on the odds board this time around and is not without a chance.

She was shut out in each of her previous three at that level but converted as an odds-on choice of the betting public in NW1 on December 6th. This son of Spinfiniti shifts back to the outside of the gate for tonight's tilt and was passed over by Bob McClure in favor of the one above. She gets Tyler Jones back between the wheels and might be able to build off that most recent effort.

#7 WIFEY SAID SO rolled out wide at the top of the far turn and then charged to the lead in the lane before winning by more than three lengths. She came from a long way off the pace in that victory after getting away ninth off the gate and returned 11-1 to her backers when she tripped the timer in 1:58 flat. This daughter of Sunshine Beach has earned a cheque in 13 of her last 14 and has been second or better in three of her last five. She should be confident coming into this but will only offer a fraction of the price this time out.

#10 MY ONLY SUNSHINE was taken to the back of the bus off the gate in each of her last two and made up good ground to hit the ticket in both of those efforts at odds of 32-1 or more. She was three lengths behind the one above in second in her latest and was closer to Golden Leader two back when claiming the show spot. This 10-time winner must once again overcome the dreaded 10-hole but has been getting along well with driver Billy Davis Jr. She will likely once again be making noise when it matters most and should not be taken lightly.

#1 DEL DIGGITY exits the same race as the two above and was first-over for a long way in that dash before having to settle for third at 5-1. She had every right to get leg weary in the stretch and will now race off the claim for trainer/driver Guy Gagnon. This 30-time winner has picked up a prize in 24 straight and has hit the board in 10 of her last 14. She got her picture taken five times over that span and can never be ruled out at this level.

#3 CHEDDARISBETTER has only mustered one minor award in her last three since moving north of the border to race under the care of conditioner Carmen Auciello. She was never a factor when getting away ninth off the switch in the second leg of a Pop-Up Series last time out and will have her price tag slashed by \$8,000 but will now take on open claimers in this handicap event. This daughter of Betterthancheddar will have Tyler Borth at the reins for a follow-up steer and might get activated sooner in the mile this time around. She is worth including on the bottom end of the trifecta and super.

#8 FASHION FORWARD was fourth last week after getting forwardly placed off the gate from post-eight and was in the two-hole for much of the mile before getting jammed-up in the pocket behind a tiring pacesetter in the stretch. She has been second or better in seven of her last 10 overall and will be making her second try out of the barn of trainer Tyler Moore. This 10-time winner can benefit from getting back on a regular rotation after missing more than a month of action and will have Bob McClure aboard for a second straight start. She is worth a look if the price is high enough.

CONDITIONS AND ALLOWANCES IN HARNESS RACING - IMPORTANT TO KNOW

The conditions of a race determine whether a horse is eligible to enter. For example many races are restricted to horses that have won a certain number of races or a certain amount of money in a specified number of starts. Many races are restricted to horses entered to be "claimed" (offered for sale) at a specific price.

Allowances in the claiming price itself are given to colts and geldings, four-year-olds and younger and to mares, five-year-olds and younger.

The purpose of the allowance is to keep younger horses more competitive when racing against older and more experienced rivals. Mares are given extra consideration in claiming events because of their potential as broodmares.

The accompanying chart shows what the allowances are, but an example may make them easier to understand. The chart indicates that three-year-olds receive a 50% allowance in claiming races. This means that a three-year-old entered in a \$20,000 claiming race carries an actual claiming price of \$30,000 (50% higher).

Fillies and mares receive an additional 25% allowance in claiming races. Details of the race conditions and claiming price (if any) are given at the top of each race in the program.

ALLOWANCES FOR PURSE EARNINGS

When Fillies/Mares compete against Colts/Geldings (normally on the trot) Fillies/Mares will receive an additional 25% on the condition of the race. ie: nw \$5,000 (FM \$6,250) last 5 or \$12,000 (FM \$15,000) last 10 starts.

C.P.M.A. Regulation Changes

Effective January 1st 2012
CPMA will be instituting several new rule changes with regards to the following pari-mutuel pools:

Pick Pools

- If there are no winners in any leg of a Pick N pool, the entire pool is refunded.
- If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners.
- A pool is no longer refunded if the 1st leg in the pool is cancelled or declared no contest.
- Pick-3: If at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: If at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.

EXPLANATION OF THE LASIX PROGRAM

After careful study and consultation with Ontario Horsemen's groups, racetrack operators and veterinarians, Agriculture Canada and the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario passed legislation allowing the controlled (or supervised) administration of furosemide, more commonly called "Lasix". "Lasix" is used to alleviate the symptoms of exercise induced pulmonary hemorrhaging in racing horses. Horses will undergo an endoscopic examination of the trachea by a veterinarian licensed by the Ontario Racing Commission and endorsed by an official veterinarian before being allowed on the medication list. Once qualified, horses will be treated with "Lasix" within four hours plus or minus 15 minutes of a scheduled race in a secure retention area under the super vision of racing officials.

All horses on "Lasix" must remain on the program for a minimum of 100 days while racing in this jurisdiction.

- (L)** Denotes horses treated with Lasix for their last start but not so treated today.

RULES AND INFORMATION REGARDING CANADIAN HARNESS AND FOREIGN SEPARATE POOL EVENTS

GENERAL

All pari-mutuel pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with the regulations and directives as issued by Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada ("the Regulations"), under the approval and supervision of the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency. The Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency can be contacted at 1-800-268-8835 or 613-759-6100 or Email: cpmawebacpm@agr.gc.ca. A complete version of the CPMA regulations can be found at <http://laws-lois.justice.gc.ca/en/regulations/SOR-91-365/>. All tickets should be held until the result of the race is declared official and prices are posted.

No person under the age of 18 shall purchase or cash a ticket or voucher.

A claim of receiving an incorrect payment or incorrect change must be made to the Mutuel office of the association within twenty four hours of buying or cashing a valid ticket or voucher.

No ruling made by the Stewards/Judges or the Ontario Racing Commission with regard to distribution of purse money or the placing of horses in the order of finish, after the race has been declared official, shall have any bearing on the pay-out prices or distribution of pari-mutuel pools.

Change boards and Photo Finish display monitors are located in the Grandstand. In addition, Photo Finish pictures are shown on the closed-circuit television system. Customers are reminded that mutuel clerks are responsible for all shortages. When making a wager, customers must present sufficient funds at the time of purchase to cover the wagers requested.

ENTRIES AND MUTUEL FIELDS

"Entry" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled or considered as the same betting interest. The most common reason for the coupling of horses in an Entry is the fact that they are owned by the same person.

"Mutuel Field" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled because the number of horses in the race exceeds the number which can be handled separately by the pari-mutuel system. Subject to the Regulations, a bet on one horse of an Entry or Mutuel Field shall be considered a bet on all horses in that Entry or Mutuel Field.

DAILY DOUBLE BETTING (INCLUDING LATE DOUBLE)

A Daily Double bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of the two races specified for the Daily Double. Tickets not selecting the winner of the first half of the Daily Double and all tickets in the second half of the Daily Double not coupled with the declared official winner of the first half of the Daily Double are not winners and are not refunded no matter what circumstances affect the running of the second half of the Daily Double.

Should a horse or horses (not coupled with another starter) be excused from starting in the second race of the Daily Double after the first race of the Daily Double has closed for betting, holders of all Daily Double tickets on such horses, coupled with the winner of the first Daily Double race, shall participate in a Consolation Double pool. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

EXACTA (Also known as Exactor)/TRIFECTA (Also known as Tractor)/SUPERFECTA

An Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first two, three and four horses respectively, representing different betting interests to finish in the exact official order of finish, in the race on which the pool is operated.

SWINGER (Also known as OMNI)

A Swinger is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select horses to finish in any order from the official first 3 positions.

JACKPOT HI-5

A Jackpot Hi-5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners in the specified Jackpot Hi-5 race. If there are races that have an entry, (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B), Jackpot Hi-5 will not offer a wager consisting of both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in a Jackpot Hi-5, the payout would be 1st, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th.

That jackpot portion of the pool will only be paid out if there is a single winning ticket. If there are multiple winning tickets that have correctly chosen the first 5 runners of the race, they will receive 50% of the pool for that day. The other 50% will go over into the Jackpot carryover. If there are no winning tickets with the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners, 100% of the current day's pool will be carried over into the Jackpot.

PICK 3 & PICK-4 BETTING

The Pick 3 & Pick 4 bets are betting transactions in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of three or four successive races specified for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 respectively.

Winning tickets for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 are determined in the following sequence: A) winners of all legs, B) most winners, then refund. If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners. If there are no winners in any leg of a pool, the entire pool is refunded.

PICK 5 BETTING

The Pick 5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of five successive races specified for the Pick 5 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 5 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 5.

PICK 3, PICK 4 & PICK 5 SCRATCHES

In the event a Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 ticket designates as a selection a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the Stewards/Judges to be a non-starter in any of the races comprising the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 the favourite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection. In the event that the money bet in the win pool for two or more favourites is identical, the selection with the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non-starting selection.

However, if a scratch occurs in any leg of the Pick 3, Pick 4 or Pick 5 pools before the pool is closed, a ticket including the scratched horse may be cancelled.

REFUNDS

Subject to the Regulations, all monies in all pools on a race are refunded in the event that the race is cancelled, declared off or declared no contest, and all monies bet on a horse are refunded if the horse is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start. These refunds will be communicated to the public through various means such as betting terminals, video display, change boards and our website.

The Pick(n) pool shall be cancelled and all Pick(n) wagers for the individual performance shall be refunded if:

- Pick-3: at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

Where a horse that is part of an Entry is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start and at least one horse of that Entry receives a fair start in the race, all tickets purchased on the Entry remain valid and the purchase price of any such ticket shall not be refunded.

COMMON POOL WAGERING (INTERTRACK BETTING)

In the unlikely event of a communications or computer system failure that prevents pools from merging with the host track's pools before the end of a race, CPMA regulations require that the site must refund all tickets for that race. This refund will be communicated to the public through various means such as video displays, change boards and messages on our website.

FAIR START

If a horse has reached the Fair Start Pole (located 200 feet before the Starting Pole) by the time the mobile gate has reached the Starting Pole, that horse is deemed to have had a fair start. It makes no difference whether or not the horse is on or off stride at that precise moment. Under current policy and regulations, which are designed to be as fair as possible to all bettors on all starters, there is no Recall - a repeat of the entire starting procedure - when a horse does not reach the Fair Start Pole before the gate reaches the Starting Pole. Monies bet on such a horse are refunded in accordance with the regulation concerning refunds.

LOST & OLD TICKETS

WEG issued tickets or vouchers are valid indefinitely, however, they cannot be cashed at a mutuel teller after 2 years from date of issue. Please mail tickets, along with your name and address, to Mutuel Manager, P.O. Box 156, Rexdale, Ontario, M9W 5L2, keeping a photocopy for future reference.

For "Lost Tickets" originally sold at a Woodbine Entertainment Group racetrack or Teletheatre, please enquire at the Mutuel office at Woodbine, Greenwood Teletheatre, or Mohawk. Policy may be subject to change retroactively in the event regulatory bodies amend existing regulations.

ASSOCIATION PERCENTAGE AND TAXATION/LEVY

The Woodbine Entertainment Group deducts and retains the following percentages from wagers placed at our own licensed sites which are then shared with the horsepeople, host and simulcast associations and the Ontario Racing Commission.

WOODBINE/MOHAWK LIVE: Win, Place & Show: 13.65%. Swinger 14.7%. Trifecta & Pick 4: 21.7%. Double & Exacta 17.2%. Jackpot Hi-5 & Pick 5: 11.7%. All other 23.0%

Horsepeople receive a further 2% on all wagers, except Trifecta wagering where it is 4%. The Ontario Provincial Government retains 0.5% on all bets placed in Ontario. The Canadian Government (through a revolving fund cost recovery basis) retains 0.8% on all wagers placed in Canada for provision of drug control, and audit services.
