Betting Basics

Some essentials to get you started with making a wager.

1 How to wager



Place your bet by visiting a teller, or using a self-serve terminal.

To place a bet here are just 5 things you need to know:

- 1 Name of racetrack (choose from any track in the simulcast feeds)
- 2 Number of the race
- 3 Amount of your bet (e.g. \$2)
- 4 Type of bet (see step 2)
- 5 Horse's number (see step 4)

Once you have decided what you want to bet, head to the nearest seller's window and use the sample statement as your guide:

Hello, (Racetrack), race 6, \$2 to WIN on Horse #4

How to use a self-serve terminal:

- 1 Swipe your Cash Card/Insert Cash
- 2 Enter the initial PIN #1234 (then choose a new PIN)
- 3 Press/Tap the track you would like to bet: (defaults to current race)
- 4 Tap the Horse Number: **#4**
- 5 Press/Tap the Bet Type: **WIN**
- 6 Press/Tap the Bet Amount: **\$2**
- 7 Press/Tap the Race Number: **Race #6**
- 8 Press Green **"Make BET"** button
- 9 Press/Tap the **"Finish with Receipt"** button
- 10 Be sure to check your ticket to confirm it's the bet you wanted

To get a Cash Card or for assistance ask a teller, or a staff member.

2 Types of bets



Single horse bets (minimum \$2.00 bet is required)

| Bet type | Level of difficulty | Explanation and expectation |
|----------|---------------------|---|
| Win | U U U | Your horse must finish 1st; payoff determined by the win odds. |
| Place | U U | Your horse must finish 1st or 2nd; payoffs better than to show. |
| Show | U | Your horse must finish 1st, 2nd, or 3rd; modest payoffs. |

Exotic multiple-horse bets

| Bet type | Level of difficulty | Explanation and expectation |
|-------------------------------|---------------------|---|
| Exacta* | U U U U | Your horses must finish 1st and 2nd in exact order; riskier bet that can pay a little or a lot, depending on the horses' odds. |
| Daily double | U U U U U | Pick the winners of two designated consecutive races. |
| Pick 3, Win 4, Pick 5, Pick 6 | U U U U U U | Select the winners of a designated set of consecutive races. The wager must be made prior to the start of the first race in the multi-race wager. |
| Triactor* | U U U U U U U | Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in exact order; can be expensive to play if you use a lot of horses. |
| Superfecta* | U U U U U U U U | Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th; big payoff possible. |

* Exotic bets require the horses to finish in the EXACT order you select, unless you "BOX" the bet, in which case your selections can finish in any order.

Race 1 Selections

The Horseplayer's Journal by Garnet Barnsdale

#1 ABOVE MYPAYGRADE was expected to do better last week moving to an inside post and coming off a start from a wide post where he got parked the mile the week before. He probably deserved a better fate than a narrow loss after making a big third quarter move in the snow to take command and open up a nice lead. He was nailed late by a rival that tracked him down and appeared to be racing on the better part of the track late in the stretch. That was a solid effort, and I'll give him a slight nod to kick off the \$75,000 guaranteed Pick 5.

#2 VOLCANIC will no doubt go off favored as he comes into tonight's race seeking the threepeat to stay undefeated. The sophomore Big Jim colt has certainly done nothing wrong so far, first upsetting as an 8 to 1 choice on debut, then coming back to win as the favorite. In both wins he made middle moves to lead, and he was never seriously challenged after that on his way to both victories. The horse that finished second to him on February 1st came back to break his maiden last Saturday. He is the obvious one to beat for Team McNair, and he is hard to leave off Pick 5 tickets.

#3 MOOD CONTROL comes into tonight's race having won two of his last three starts. Most recently racing on a snow-covered track in the midst of a snow flurry, he was expertly handled by veteran driver J.R. Plante, who continues to impress in 2025. After dropping back early, he wisely latched onto the live cover of 3 to 5 favorite Smokin Hot Scott, rode it to the stretch, tipped out and edged past for the victory. This gelding's 27 4/5 kicker shows that he is improving, and he is in with an upset chance tonight.

#8 STEELWHEEL HANOVER was a Spot Play in this space last week that didn't work out, although he was driven aggressively and put into the Popup Final as expected. In a race that featured a lot of action and movement, he simply went too fast too soon, pacing a sub-57 middle half while taking the lead then setting the pace to the three quarters which left him with nothing left for the drive. The top three spots at the finish were taken by closers that took advantage of the stopping late pace. This four-year-old All Bets Off gelding should go better in this spot and Jody Jamieson sticks with him. He is worth a look for Tri and Super bets.

Race 2 Selections

#7 HUNGRY MAN comes in off a race where he never got involved racing in the snow after starting from a bad post at a level higher than tonight's. Him finishing 10th and last, beaten 15 3/4 lengths likely won't cause a stampede to the windows, but there are reasons to think he will be much better tonight when you look at the effort he produced two starts back racing at this level. That night, Doug McNair – who returns to the sulky tonight – fired him off the wings but classy Redwood Hanover had the clear intent of making front early and not giving up the lead. McNair rode the pocket to the lane and closed some ground on the leader without threatening to get past him. I see this five-year-old son of Hungry Man firing off the gate again tonight. He can win racing on the engine or from the pocket at this level.

#4 CODE CRACKER, coming off a dominant win at this level last week where the result was never in doubt once he took over the lead will likely go off favored here returning at the same level. He showed how sharp he is in that race by making a swift and decisive three-wide brush to the front around dueling leaders on the backstretch. Two starts back, he was in the same race as the top choice here and he raced well to finish only three quarters of a length behind that rival, who enjoyed the better trip. This six-year-old Sweet Lou gelding slipped off the pylons on the far turn, but he was required to move wide around stalled cover coming off the last turn and he lost ground while Hungry Man cut the corner. Last week, he left nothing to chance with the big middle move to the front and he is the one to beat here.

#3 WIND BLOWN stepped up to this level off a loss last week, but he still took enough support to close as the 5 to 2 second choice to Code Cracker. He was sent right to the front and stubbornly refused to let a rival take over the lead from him in the second quarter. Both got passed by a charged-up race favorite however, and he found himself in the pocket at the half. He rode that trip to a decent second place finish and he is in the mix tonight for another spot in the Tri.

#8 LIVINTHEBEACHLIFE exits the same race as the top pick, and he did pass that rival late to finish a couple of lengths ahead of him. He takes the same class drop as Hungry Man here, and he certainly fits, but he draws worst again and I'm not sure blasting off the gate will work when it looks like there are at least three rivals to his inside likely to deploy the same strategy. I see this 25-time winner floating out for a spot in the top five then rallying for a share.

#2 IVY PARK is one that I'm going to take a shot on here based on what I observed in the stretch drive of his last start on February 1st which was: "Ivy Park rallied on the far outside for fifth, moving well late but couldn't catch any of the top four". The way that race played out, he really had no chance of getting much closer with Redwood Hanover controlling the race and not allowing much of a flow to develop. He is only a one-time winner in his last 22 starts dating back to the start of the 2024 season, but I like that Louis-Phillipe Roy sticks with him. He should offer a good price tonight and he might be able to mow them down if the expected live flow develops.

#1 TOBINS CHESTER shipped from the Maritimes and race here on February 8th and he took no support despite having compiled an impressive record of 12-2-1 from 16 starts last year while earning more than \$127,000. Undeterred by the lack of support, he produced a terrific effort racing in the snow, making a bold first-over rush to the front on the final turn and just failing to hold off Sergeant Slaughter, who he faces again tonight. With that race under his belt and coming back in seven days this time, it's possible that he will be even sharper. He is in with a chance tonight, especially if he can work out a slightly better trip.

#7 DOCTOR CRUISE faces tougher here, but the way he won last week suggests he can be a player versus this group. Sitting fifth behind a slow pace at the half, he moved out on cover then exploded three-wide midway into the far turn. He paced a 26 1/5 final quarter racing in the snow to win comfortably. That is the same time that Preferred winner paced his final quarter in earlier in the card when the conditions were much better. This Illinois invader is clearly sharp, and he is worth a look for early multi-race tickets as a 10 to 1 morning line quote.

#8 SERGEANT SLAUGHTER got a good drive and trip last week to edge Tobin's Chester for a narrow win. That was his third try at this level since January 25th, and he got progressively better in each of those starts. That was his seventh win in 26 starts since the start of 2024 for the Carmen Auciello trainee who gets the widest draw here. He has shown in the past that he can overcome an outside draw, and he should be in the mix for a share in this field.

#1 KOLBY TWO STEP was seen rallying late in his most recent start which should set him up well for a more aggressive try tonight. That was his second good try in three starts at this level, he stopped on the lead in the other start after going too fast early in the mile. The 12-time winner and earner of more than \$400,000 returns quicker and he picks up James Macdonald who had his choice of two others. I think he starts his move earlier tonight and gets the job done.

#7 NIGHTIME DANCER finished ahead of the choice in that race on February 1st after leaving hard with three others who also had designs on getting positioned early. He then sat a trip to finish third. He came back a week later in tougher company and paced a 27 2/5 final quarter to stay sharp. I think Jody Jamieson will roll him leaving the gate and he could get a winning trip racing on or near the lead.

#2 NAZARE was bought by leading trainer Menary for himself and partners following his last start and it's interesting to note that this Sweet Lou gelding raced out of the Menary barn for his first 15 starts of 2024. In that stretch he took two wins, six seconds and three thirds racing mostly in classes that were much tougher than this one he is in tonight. Louis-Phillipe Roy, who drove him in eight straight starts here last spring takes the lines tonight and it is likely that he will put Nazare into the race at some point. He would be no surprise in this spot.

#8 PREMIER FIRST STAR strikes me as a longshot that can take a slice here and spice up the Tri or Super payoff (or both). Three starts back, he got trounced by 16 3/4 lengths then he rebounded to race well and finish second against a slightly tougher field. He stepped up again last week and raced close to the front throughout to finish in the Tri as a 32 to 1 shot. He is sharp and Hudon probably won't be afraid to leave with him. He is worth a look for Tri and Super bets.

#2 JIMMY HOOFA is one that I thought raced great on debut and was a bit unlucky in defeat to a more experienced rival. Starting from the widest post, he seemed as though he wanted to go forward, but four rivals to his inside had the same idea and he was forced to take back and take a seat. He followed cover to the three-quarter pole then made a wide move to the front coming off the turn and he looked like a winner. He ended up getting picked off right on the wire. That initial pari-mutuel start followed a good qualifier where he also got nailed in the final stride. He gets top billing tonight.

#7 GET A ROOM, a \$15,000 London Classic sale buy, looks like he might be a bargain purchase based on his qualifier on February 7th. In rein to a driver that had yet to make a pari-mutuel start, he was directed to take the lead leaving the gate. From there, the three-year-old Hes Watching colt set all the fractions never facing a serious challenge and paced through the wire under a hold. He dropped close to three seconds in that qualifier and looked good doing it and Doug McNair, who drove him in his first qualifier takes the lines again tonight. He would be no surprise in this spot.

#6 BEACHOFANERA was the one that provided cover for Jimmy Hoofa last week and he tired late from that third quarter exertion facing the breeze racing in the racing during a snow flurry. That race came on the heels of an impressive local debut where he smoked a field of maidens at Flamboro Downs on January 30th. He has a chance to get an easier trip here starting from the best post, and he is another in with a chance.

#8 BETTORSEETHESHOW, a homebred, took plenty of action on debut but he had the misfortune of coming up against Settheworldonfire who simply wasn't getting beaten on that night. The Menary trainee won the race for place that night and he retains the services of driver James Macdonald tonight. Starting from an outer post with several live rivals to his inside makes tonight's chore tough, however. I prefer to use him underneath in this spot.

#6 WATCHING SUNSET dropped form non-winners of three to non-winners of two last week and there were reasons to believe he would produce a winning effort in that spot. Two starts back, he started in mid pack and got shuffled back to last on the rail by the time they reach the three-quarter pole. Turning into the stretch he was sent widest, and he closed willingly down the centre of the track to just miss getting a cheque. Flash forward to last week where he made a decisive move to the front in the second quarter and led all the way from there. He steps back up to face non-winners of three now, but he is at his sharpest and he should offer a square price. Starting from the best post, I'll call him to repeat.

#3 LOOKINLIKEAMILLION raced great in two straight starts where he went off at a big price, first winning at 42 to 1, then finishing second at 9 to 1. Price will be gone now, but he is still in with a decent shot versus this group. Last week, he followed a winner home that made a decisive move at the perfect time then unleashed a 26 1/5 kicker, making it impossible for any rival to pass. This Manitoba bred has taken two wins and two seconds in eight Ontario starts since shipping east and tonight's driver Bob McClure has been a good partner for him. He won't explode the tote board in this spot, but he could win as the second or third choice.

#2 JMR SPEAK AWAY's final quarter fade last week racing in the snow can likely be forgiven. It was a strangely run race where he cut qualifier like fractions for the first three quarters then got ambushed on the outside by some rivals that kicked it into high gear and sprinted home. A more representative example of his ability can be found three starts back where he wired the field and cut faster fractions while winning at this class level. He has also shown versatility, and I think he will probably sit and rally tonight.

#5 ON TIME DELIVERY comes into this race off a solid effort where he finished second to the choice. Coming off a break in stride two starts back, he was eased off the gate and dropped in seventh, then commenced a long first-over journey before the half. He continued to gain ground, falling only three quarters of a length back in a game effort. He should be in the mix to take another good share tonight.

#1 JACK PANIC is one of the hardest trying horses on the circuit who simply is in too tough when he races at the Preferred level. That shouldn't be an issue tonight, however, as the altered six-year-old son of Sportswriter gets to take a multi-level class drop to face a field that he should handle. This comes after a series of five races at the top class where he took a cheque in four of them. Last week, he fired a 26 1/5 final quarter, so you know he is sharp. He is the one to beat here.

#10 REDWOOD HANOVER returned to his best form last week now he steps up and draws widest, but there are reasons to believe that he can repeat now that he has shown that he is sharp. He faced much tougher than these last year, and when he took his lifetime mark of 1:49-flat in July, he absolutely blew the doors off a decent conditioned field. That blowout win came with James Macdonald in the bike, and he gets the call tonight with Jonathan Drury opting for the choice. If this son of Stay Hungry can clear to the front from out there, his rivals might be in trouble.

#7 ENAVANT, a 22-time winner in just 41 starts makes his season debut at the age of nine here. While its hard to know how much he has left in his tank, some things we do know is he is a very fast racehorse that possesses a lethal brush on his best day. He missed two years of racing between the summers of 2022 and 2024, but he was ready to fire when he came back winning his first three starts in Quebec. There are other instances where he raced well coming off the shelf. He is worth a look for multi-race tickets tonight.

#9 SPEAKER OF PEACE double jumped in class last week off a win the week before and while he wasn't close to the blowout winner at the wire, he won the race for place. That was his third good effort in a row but now he draws wide. I can see him floating out for position, finding a spot in mid pack, then closing for a share. He is a good one to use on the bottom of Tri and Super bets.

#6 BOOMING ECONOMY raced better as expected last week, but he got into traffic in the third quarter similar to the 401 at 5 p.m. on Friday. When he weaved his way through and found room in the lane, he was closing best at the wire, but the winner had already made a decisive move, and he wasn't going to be caught. The Corey Giles trainee gets Louis-Philippe Roy in the bike, and he leaves from the best post. A more aggressive drive is likely in this third start back and he gets the call to notch his first win of 2025.

#7 BATTERUP HANOVER faced an impossible task at the half mile pole last week as he was shooting for a threepeat. He had only one horse beat in a 58 2/5 opening half and the leader was getting ready to sprint home and pace a faster back half and leave his rivals in his wake. This seven-year-old Betting Line gelding acquitted himself well, though, pacing a 55 2/5 back half and a final quarter in 26 4/5 to get a cheque. This is an easier spot, and I think he will get better position early in the mile. That gives him a chance, and he merits a close look for multi-race tickets.

#3 NEEDABANKLOAN is one that earned a star in trip notes two starts back in a non-winners of \$4,000 last five race when he produced a huge first-over effort in defeat and was unlucky to get beat by a rival that capitalized on a covered trip and found a seam in the stretch. Last week, he simply followed blowout winner Codename Cigar Box home as did the rest of the field. He is in a spot where he fits better and there should be a flow in this race that just never developed in last week's mile. He should be good for at least a share tonight.

#2 TYGA HANOVER is another that seems to fit better at this level that should contend for a share. Two starts back he was a game first-over winner then last week he was just in too tough. Jody Jamieson will likely put him in play leaving from an inside post and he is another possibility in a race with no standout that is likely going to be decided by pace and trip.

#1 POWERTRAIN seemed to be in good shape last week when he got down to the half in 57 1/5, but he got chased down as the pace accelerated late, and that was a strange phenomenon that played out in more than one race in the snow last Saturday night. He will likely have to contend with the same threat as last week that leaves from post four in this spot, but James Macdonald sticks with him tonight, and so will I.

#4 POSEIDON SEELSTER raced the choice into submission last week, applying consistent first-over pressure in the back half. He also provided the winning cover for upset winner Jabberwocky, who couldn't have got a better trip. Two starts back, he was visually accelerating in the final strides which showed he was reaching his sharpest form. The 20-time winner figures to be the main threat to the choice tonight.

#2 CODENAME CIGAR BOX couldn't have been any sharper last week, crushing a conditioned field and pacing one fifth of a second faster than this Preferred class. The 39-time winner, and earner of close to \$630,000 has tended to be all or nothing in 2024-25, taking 11 wins but only two other shares in 37 starts. He is razor-sharp now though, and he should be able to get position leaving the gate. I think he will trip out tonight and buck that trend by landing in the top three.

#3 WHATCHULOOKIN AT has been a steady performer in the Preferred ranks the past couple of months, taking one win and three other cheques in five starts. He had little chance last week, trying to close from sixth when the final quarter was being paced in 26 4/5. Still, he did manage to make up a length in that fast quarter which shows he is still sharp. I think he gets better position early tonight, finds a following trip, and closes for a spot in the Tri or Super.

#7 BETTERDEALMEIN comes off an impressive string of races in the recently concluded Snowshoe Series when facing much better horses than he meets in this non-winners of two or \$30,500 lifetime field. Despite coming into last week's series final off an impressive closing effort the week before where he stormed home in 26 1/5, he was let go at 12 to 1 and he closed well again to split the two co-favorites. This really is a field that he should beat, and I think he will get a more aggressive steer from regular driver Travis Cullen in this spot.

#8 REGIL BUBB came into last week's race off two impressive parked out efforts in a row, the last one resulting in an impressive maiden breaking score. He lost all chance when he broke before the start, however. Following that mishap, the four-time winner paced a strong back half, and although he had no chance of catching the top two, he did well to get up for third. Assuming he behaves tonight, I see him sitting and rallying and completing the Exacta behind the choice.

#2 PENDLETON RODEO is another that exits the Snowshoe series where he was competitive in each leg and the final. Driver Brett Macdonald wasn't afraid to send him off the gate as he was racing no worse than second at the opening quarter of all of those races. In last week's final, he led at the quarter then got shuffled out of the race. He fits better here, and he should be happy not to see the likes of A Class Yankee lined up beside him tonight. He should be part of the Tri.

#1 HEY JUDE HANOVER is only a one-time winner from 29 starts but he has taken seven slices and finished fourth eight times. He is a horse that typically is kept covered up on the inside until the stretch which typically leaves him with a good kick in the lane. He has finished fourth in three consecutive starts, at odds of 28 to 1, 65 to 1, and 30 to 1. He is a good one to use to round out Superfecta tickets.

#2 ARMOR SEELSTER dropped from 28 to 1 two weeks ago to 5 to 2 last week, and he converted with a front end win. The reason he was so heavily bet coming off a sixth-place finish on February 1st was because of the traffic he ran into during the stretch drive that night. He was crying for room with pace but got shut off and couldn't squeeze through along the pylons. There is a good chance he would have finished second if he had the room that night. Last week, new driver J.R. Plante left nothing to chance, making an early move to the front and staying there for a relatively easy win. He is sharp now and he gets the call to repeat.

#7 HIGHLANDBEACHLOVER comes out of the same race as the choice and there are some things to like about his effort that night. He blasted off from post 10 then quickly took a seat in third when it was apparent that the choice was taking no prisoners. He got backed up around the last turn when the pocket sitter started to fade, then found room between horses and eventually dove inside with pace to finish a closing third. That was a decent effort, and I could see him turning the tables tonight with the right trip.

#4 BROOKDALE JOHNNY exits a race vs. tougher where he made a first up move on the far turn trying to chase down two horses that had broken away from the field. He stalled in the stretch, now he faces easier. He gets James Macdonald in the bike tonight and he was a winner four starts back with that teamster in the bike. He is another possibility for late Pick 4 tickets.

#3 GENTLEONMYMIND comes in off two solid efforts where he was probably unlucky to get beat in both. Two starts back he made a big late charge and fell just short to classy Points North. Last week, he sat a nice pocket trip, but Pipewrench Charlie wasn't getting beat after cutting a 1:00 half. He is in the mix here in a good betting race.

#8 PIPEWRENCH CHARLIE went off as the even money favorite last week and he took control early, cut a slow half then prevailed. I think this is a tougher field, and from a wide post he is unlikely to get the same kind of trip as he did last week. I prefer to use him underneath.

CONDITIONS AND ALLOWANCES IN HARNESS RACING - IMPORTANT TO KNOW

The conditions of a race determine whether a horse is eligible to enter. For example many races are restricted to horses that have won a certain number of races or a certain amount of money in a specified number of starts. Many races are restricted to horses entered to be "claimed" (offered for sale) at a specific price.

Allowances in the claiming price itself are given to colts and geldings, four-year-olds and younger and to mares, five-year-olds and younger.

The purpose of the allowance is to keep younger horses more competitive when racing against older and more experienced rivals. Mares are given extra consideration in claiming events because of their potential as broodmares.

The accompanying chart shows what the allowances are, but an example may make them easier to understand. The chart indicates that three-year-olds receive a 50% allowance in claiming races. This means that a three-year-old entered in a \$20,000 claiming race carries an actual claiming price of \$30,000 (50% higher).

Fillies and mares receive an additional 25% allowance in claiming races. Details of the race conditions and claiming price (if any) are given at the top of each race in the program.

ALLOWANCES FOR PURSE EARNINGS

When Fillies/Mares compete against Colts/Geldings (normally on the trot) Fillies/Mares will receive an additional 25% on the condition of the race. ie: nw \$5,000 (FM \$6,250) last 5 or \$12,000 (FM \$15,000) last 10 starts.

C.P.M.A. Regulation Changes

Effective January 1st 2012
CPMA will be instituting several new rule changes with regards to the following pari-mutuel pools:

Pick Pools

- If there are no winners in any leg of a Pick N pool, the entire pool is refunded.
- If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners.
- A pool is no longer refunded if the 1st leg in the pool is cancelled or declared no contest.
- Pick-3: If at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: If at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.

EXPLANATION OF THE LASIX PROGRAM

After careful study and consultation with Ontario Horsemen's groups, racetrack operators and veterinarians, Agriculture Canada and the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario passed legislation allowing the controlled (or supervised) administration of furosemide, more commonly called "Lasix". "Lasix" is used to alleviate the symptoms of exercise induced pulmonary hemorrhaging in racing horses. Horses will undergo an endoscopic examination of the trachea by a veterinarian licensed by the Ontario Racing Commission and endorsed by an official veterinarian before being allowed on the medication list. Once qualified, horses will be treated with "Lasix" within four hours plus or minus 15 minutes of a scheduled race in a secure retention area under the super vision of racing officials.

All horses on "Lasix" must remain on the program for a minimum of 100 days while racing in this jurisdiction.

- (L)** Denotes horses treated with Lasix for their last start but not so treated today.

RULES AND INFORMATION REGARDING CANADIAN HARNESS AND FOREIGN SEPARATE POOL EVENTS

GENERAL

All pari-mutuel pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with the regulations and directives as issued by Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada ("the Regulations"), under the approval and supervision of the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency. The Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency can be contacted at 1-800-268-8835 or 613-759-6100 or Email: cpmawebacpm@agr.gc.ca. A complete version of the CPMA regulations can be found at <http://laws-lois.justice.gc.ca/eng/regulations/SOR-91-365/>.

All tickets should be held until the result of the race is declared official and prices are posted.

No person under the age of 18 shall purchase or cash a ticket or voucher.

A claim of receiving an incorrect payment or incorrect change must be made to the Mutuel office of the association within twenty four hours of buying or cashing a valid ticket or voucher.

No ruling made by the Stewards/Judges or the Ontario Racing Commission with regard to distribution of purse money or the placing of horses in the order of finish, after the race has been declared official, shall have any bearing on the pay-out prices or distribution of pari-mutuel pools.

Change boards and Photo Finish display monitors are located in the Grandstand. In addition, Photo Finish pictures are shown on the closed-circuit television system. Customers are reminded that mutuel clerks are responsible for all shortages. When making a wager, customers must present sufficient funds at the time of purchase to cover the wagers requested.

ENTRIES AND MUTUEL FIELDS

"Entry" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled or considered as the same betting interest. The most common reason for the coupling of horses in an Entry is the fact that they are owned by the same person.

"Mutuel Field" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled because the number of horses in the race exceeds the number which can be handled separately by the pari-mutuel system. Subject to the Regulations, a bet on one horse of an Entry or Mutuel Field shall be considered a bet on all horses in that Entry or Mutuel Field.

DAILY DOUBLE BETTING (INCLUDING LATE DOUBLE)

A Daily Double bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of the two races specified for the Daily Double. Tickets not selecting the winner of the first half of the Daily Double and all tickets in the second half of the Daily Double not coupled with the declared official winner of the first half of the Daily Double are not winners and are not refunded no matter what circumstances affect the running of the second half of the Daily Double.

Should a horse or horses (not coupled with another starter) be excused from starting in the second race of the Daily Double after the first race of the Daily Double has closed for betting, holders of all Daily Double tickets on such horses, coupled with the winner of the first Daily Double race, shall participate in a Consolation Double pool. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

EXACTA (Also known as Exactor)/TRIFECTA (Also known as Trifactor)/SUPERFECTA

An Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first two, three and four horses respectively, representing different betting interests to finish in the exact official order of finish, in the race on which the pool is operated.

SWINGER (Also known as OMN)

A Swinger is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select horses to finish in any order from the official first 3 positions.

JACKPOT HI-5

A Jackpot Hi-5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners in the specified Jackpot Hi-5 race. If there are races that have an entry, (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B), Jackpot Hi-5 will not offer a wager consisting of both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in a Jackpot Hi-5, the payout would be 1st, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th.

That jackpot portion of the pool will only be paid out if there is a single winning ticket. If there are multiple winning tickets that have correctly chosen the first 5 runners of the race, they will receive 50% of the pool for that day. The other 50% will go over into the Jackpot carryover. If there are no winning tickets with the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners, 100% of the current day's pool will be carried over into the Jackpot.

PICK 3 & PICK-4 BETTING

The Pick 3 & Pick 4 bets are betting transactions in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of three or four successive races specified for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 respectively.

Winning tickets for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 are determined in the following sequence: A) winners of all legs, B) most winners, then refund. If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners. If there are no winners in any leg of a pool, the entire pool is refunded.

PICK 5 BETTING

The Pick 5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of five successive races specified for the Pick 5 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 5 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 5.

PICK 6 BETTING

The Pick 6 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of six successive races specified for the Pick 6 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 6 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 6.

PICK 5 & 6 BETTING

If at least 1 race as part of the Pick 5 or 6 has been cancelled or declared "No contest", but not more than the specified below under Refunds, the net pool shall be distributed to those selecting the most # of winners and NOT include any carryover from a previous pool.

PICK 3, PICK 4, PICK 5 & PICK 6 SCRATCHES

In the event a Pick 3, Pick 4, Pick 5 or Pick 6 ticket designates as a selection a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the Stewards/Judges to be a non-starter in any of the races comprising the Pick 3, Pick 4, Pick 5 or Pick 6 the favourite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection. In the event that the money bet in the win pool for two or more favourites is identical, the selection with the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non-starting selection.

However, if a scratch occurs in any leg of the Pick 3, Pick 4, Pick 5 or Pick 6 pools before the pool is closed, a ticket including the scratched horse may be cancelled.

REFUNDS

Subject to the Regulations, all monies in all pools on a race are refunded in the event that the race is cancelled, declared off or declared no contest, and all monies bet on a horse are refunded if the horse is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start. These refunds will be communicated to the public through various means such as betting terminals, video display, changes boards and our website.

The Pick(n) pool shall be cancelled and all Pick(n) wagers for the individual performance shall be refunded if:

- Pick-3: at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

Where a horse that is part of an Entry is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start and at least one horse of that Entry receives a fair start in the race, all tickets purchased on the Entry remain valid and the purchase price of any such ticket shall not be refunded.

COMMON POOL WAGERING (INTERTRACK BETTING)

In the unlikely event of a communications or computer system failure that prevents pools from merging with the host track's pools before the end of a race, CPMA regulations require that the site must refund all tickets for that race. This refund will be communicated to the public through various means such as video displays, change boards and messages on our website.

FAIR START

If a horse has reached the Fair Start Pole (located 200 feet before the Starting Pole) by the time the mobile gate has reached the Starting Pole, that horse is deemed to have had a fair start. It makes no difference whether or not the horse is on or off stride at that precise moment. Under current policy and regulations, which are designed to be as fair as possible to all bettors on all starters, there is no Recall - a repeat of the entire starting procedure - when a horse does not reach the Fair Start Pole before the gate reaches the Starting Pole. Monies bet on such a horse are refunded in accordance with the regulation concerning refunds.

LOST & OLD TICKETS

WEG issued tickets or vouchers are valid indefinitely, however, they cannot be cashed at a mutuel teller after 2 years from date of issue. Please mail tickets, along with your name and address, to Mutuel Manager, P.O. Box 156, Rexdale, Ontario, M9W 5L2, keeping a photocopy for future reference.

For "Lost Tickets" originally sold at a Woodbine Entertainment Group racetrack or Teletheatre, please enquire at the Mutuel office at Woodbine, Greenwood Teletheatre, or Mohawk. Policy may be subject to change retroactively in the event regulatory bodies amend existing regulations.

ASSOCIATION PERCENTAGE, AND TAXATION/LEVY

The Woodbine Entertainment Group deducts and retains the following percentages from wagers placed at our own licensed sites which are then shared with the horsepeople, host and simulcast associations and the Ontario Racing Commission.

WOODBINE/MOHAWK LIVE: Win, Place & Show: 13.65%. Swinger 14.7%. Trifecta & Pick 4: 21.7%. Double & Exacta 17.2%. Jackpot Hi-5, Pick 5 & Pick 6: 11.7%. All other 23.0%

Horsepeople receive a further 2% on all wagers, except Trifecta wagering where it is 4%. The Ontario Provincial Government retains 0.5% on all bets placed in Ontario. The Canadian Government (through a revolving fund cost recovery basis) retains 0.8% on all wagers placed in Canada for provision of drug control, and audit services.

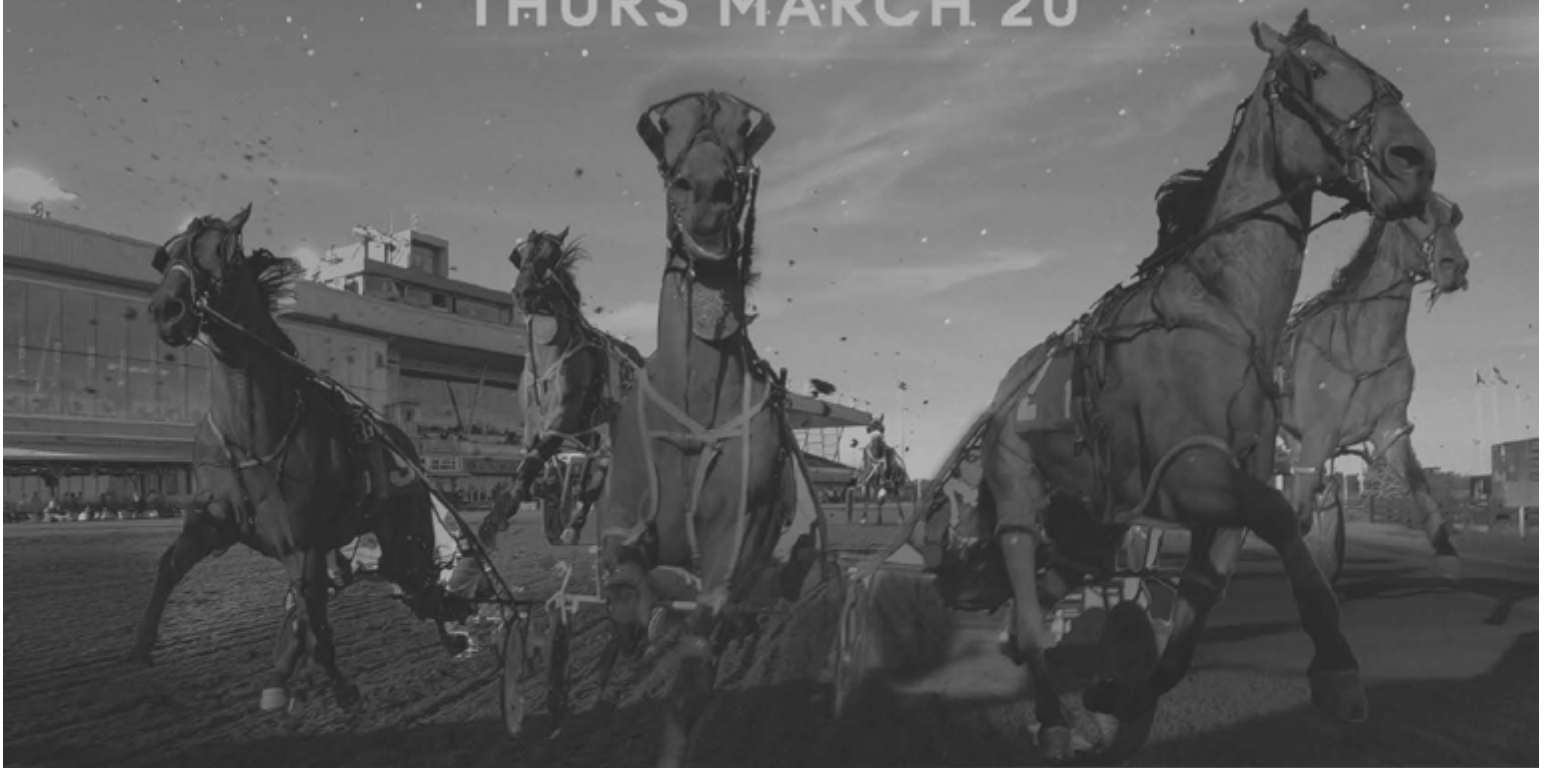
