# Betting Basics

Some essentials to get you started with making a wager.

## 1 How to wager



Place your bet by visiting a teller, or using a self-serve terminal.

### To place a bet here are just 5 things you need to know:

- 1 Name of racetrack (choose from any track in the simulcast feeds)
- 2 Number of the race
- 3 Amount of your bet (e.g. \$2)
- 4 Type of bet (see step 2)
- 5 Horse's number (see step 4)

Once you have decided what you want to bet, head to the nearest seller's window and use the sample statement as your guide:

**Hello, (Racetrack), race 6, \$2 to WIN on Horse #4**

### How to use a self-serve terminal:

- 1 Swipe your Cash Card/Insert Cash
- 2 Enter the initial PIN #1234 (then choose a new PIN)
- 3 Press/Tap the track you would like to bet: (defaults to current race)
- 4 Tap the Horse Number: **#4**
- 5 Press/Tap the Bet Type: **WIN**
- 6 Press/Tap the Bet Amount: **\$2**
- 7 Press/Tap the Race Number: **Race #6**
- 8 Press Green **"Make BET"** button
- 9 Press/Tap the **"Finish with Receipt"** button
- 10 Be sure to check your ticket to confirm it's the bet you wanted

To get a Cash Card or for assistance ask a teller, or a staff member.

## 2 Types of bets



### Single horse bets (minimum \$2.00 bet is required)

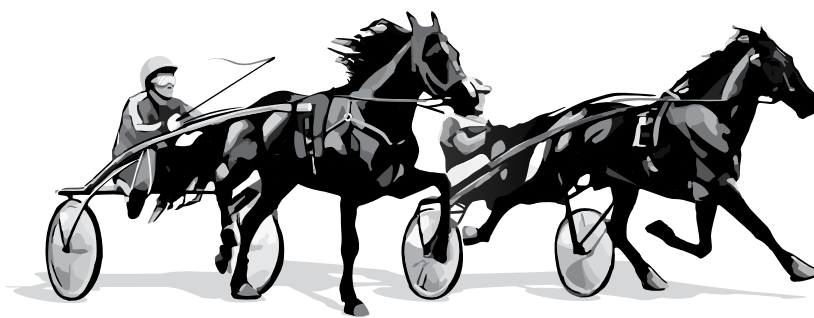
Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Win	U U U	Your horse must finish 1st; payoff determined by the win odds.
Place	U U	Your horse must finish 1st or 2nd; payoffs better than to show.
Show	U	Your horse must finish 1st, 2nd, or 3rd; modest payoffs.

### Exotic multiple-horse bets

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Exacta*	U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st and 2nd in exact order; riskier bet that can pay a little or a lot, depending on the horses' odds.
Daily double	U U U U U	Pick the winners of two designated consecutive races.
Pick 3, Win 4, Pick 5, Pick 6	U U U U U U	Select the winners of a designated set of consecutive races. The wager must be made prior to the start of the first race in the multi-race wager.
Triactor*	U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in exact order; can be expensive to play if you use a lot of horses.
Superfecta*	U U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th; big payoff possible.

\* Exotic bets require the horses to finish in the EXACT order you select, unless you "BOX" the bet, in which case your selections can finish in any order.

All of the numbers and letters in the program might seem confusing or overwhelming at first, but focusing on these sections makes choosing a horse simple.

- 1 Horse's number in the race
- 2 Horse's post position colour
- 3 Horse's colour, sex, age, sire (father), dam (mother), sire of the dam
- 4 Morning line odds
- 5 Horse's name
- 6 Driver and Driver Record (Name, # of wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, winning %)

- 7 Trainer information
- 8 Horse's Lifetime record (with best win time, track size, track, age, lifetime wins and lifetime earnings)
- 9 Horse's current record (# of races, # wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, and money earned)

# 4 The odds



Odds are also important to consider when choosing your horse. Horses that are thought to have a better chance of winning will typically have lower odds.

### Morning line odds

Odds listed in the race program are the "morning line" odds. These are predictions of how the public will bet on the race. They are set by the track's handicapper when the race program is published, before the wagering starts.

The actual odds will be posted on the Television or in-field on the Tote Board before the race; they change up until post time, depending on how customers are betting on each horse in the race.

### Calculating a \$2 win prize

To calculate a win prize, find the Odds of a horse on the Television or Tote Board (in-field board).

Multiply the first number by 2, then divide that number by the second digit (if there is one), and then add \$2. Simple as that!

Odds	1/2	2/1	7/2	5/1	10/1

### Helpful facts for betting

- Some racetracks have a television simulcast commentator who tries to identify winning horses (handicaps) between the races. Listen and see if you can pick up any good tips to bet on.
- A good betting method is to choose horses with current odds two to three times higher than their morning line odds.

### 3 Tips to remember

WIN BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 32% of the time  
 PLACE BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 53% of the time  
 SHOW BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 67% of the time

**Race 1 Selections**

**The Horseplayer's Journal by Garnet Barnsdale**

**#5 BETTOR BELLE** is one that was expected to do better last week based on her good effort on February 6th. In that mile two starts back, after starting from the worst post she trailed to the last turn where she was roused by driver Trevor Henry and asked to pass some rivals. She got into some traffic in early stretch, though, and finally found open road at the eighth pole. Once sent to the far outside, she flew home, passing four rivals in the last sixteenth of a mile to finish fourth. Based on the way she finished that mile and getting a much better post last week, her odds dropped from 51 to 1 two starts back to 8 to 1 last week. She didn't show much, however, looking like a short racehorse after missing 15 days between starts. She comes back in a week now, and I'll side with her expecting an improved effort and a square price.

**#8 LITTLE MOMENTS** is one of only three winners in this race and she comes off a solid effort last week. She left for position then sat in to the three quarters where she was able to slide out on cover then she closed for second behind a well meant 6 to 5 leader that was never going to be caught. That followed a good closing effort two starts back where she kicked home in 27 2/5 to get a cheque. She seems to fit well in this spot, and she has enough speed to get position leaving the gate. She has a decent chance to take her second win tonight.

**#7 FULLOF PERSONALITY** exits the same race as Little Moments, and she is the one that provided final turn cover for that rival. She was moved out to go first over when Calcite started to stop and drifted out a couple of paths which allowed this filly to get off the pylons and start her move. She ended up getting beat a length for second by Little Moments. That was her second decent effort in a row, and she should be in the exotics mix again tonight.

**#4 AMERICAN STARLIGHT** brings a 0 for 37 record into this maiden race and she doesn't give any indication that tonight will be the night that she finally graduates. She is however, a good one to use on the bottom of Tri and Super bets when you consider that she has finished in the top four in 10 of her last 15 starts. Most recently she finished fourth, not too far behind Little Moments and Fullof Personality after starting from post 10. Getting post relief tonight, she should be able to close for a share.

### Race 2 Selections

### The Horseplayer's Journal by Garnet Barnsdale

**#4 NO MONEY HONEY** raced well last week and probably could have been much closer with better racing luck. She fired off the gate for the lead, but there was a scramble into the first turn with two other mares looking for the lead. The opening quarter was fast and after that early exertion, this mare took her chances staying in instead of going first-over. Unfortunately for her, she got stuck behind a stopper on the final turn, and by the time she got a clear lane in the stretch, the top two were long gone. She was moving well at the wire, and she looks good in this spot. She gets top billing once again starting from a good post.

**#3 TAMARA HANOVER** was racing well here in late January and early February chasing hot mare Wifey Said So around the track and finishing second to her in two straight miles. She then got parked the mile and had an unsuccessful jaunt to Flamboro that I'm willing to forgive. She gets the leading driver back tonight and her best puts her right there with these. She merits a close look for the early Pick 5.

**#5 MYSTIC WILD ROSE** wasn't far behind the choice last week and that was after starting from the worst post that continues to show only one win in 96 starts so far this year in pacing races. She typically is better used underneath, having taken 17 slices versus only four wins in 51 starts, but she has been getting closer recently and this doesn't look like a field that is beyond her scope. Last year, she won she took her lifetime mark of 1:52 1/5 when beating a better field than this one. That win came last summer, but she still looks like one that is in with a chance here.

**#8 TRIBAL DANCER** is one of the three mares that were set on making front last week in the race that the top pick exits. She made two early moves to the lead in fact, taking the top on the opening turn, giving up command, then removing to the front before the half. She tired early from all that exertion, and she is the one that backed up No Money Honey. She is capable of much better when she gets an easier trip, and she can stick around for a share here.

**#6 BOOTS** comes into this Popup Series Final looking for a sweep after dominating as the favorite in the opening two legs. If he was going to get beat that probably should have happened two starts back on February 14th when he faced several challenges, made three moves, and still drove away from several of tonight's rivals to win going away. Last week, he was an easy winner on the engine, and he is strictly the one to beat starting from the best post from where Louis-Phillipe Roy has options.

**#5 WHY WOULDNT YA** got good trips two weeks in a row, but he could get no closer than one- and three-quarter lengths behind the choice. In both of those miles, he turned for home in the pocket but could not make a dent in Boots lead. Those looking for a reason to back him to beat the choice can look three starts back when he did just that in the last Pop Up series final and he was driven more aggressively in that spot while edging Boots for third by a neck. In a short field like this, I think it will be tough for him to turn the tables, but it's also not impossible.

**#4 SMILES FOR MILES** is probably the best closer in this race, but the dynamics and pace in a short field will probably make it difficult for him to get more than a slice, like he did in the first two legs. He did almost pull off the upset of the year three starts back when he capitalized on a slowing late pace to edge both Boots and Why Wouldnt Ya in the Pop Up Series Final, falling a head short of scoring a 94 to 1 upset. I think he sits and rallies tonight and once again lands third behind the top two picks.

**#1 ROBBY LOVE DAT** finished fourth to the top three choices on February 14th, but he passed a few rivals in the lane in a decent effort that night, which was a hint of better things to come last week. He got a driver change to Phil Hudon and produced a big late rally to notch his first win of the year. I think he is in tougher here and pace and trip will work against him. A small share is likely for him tonight.

**#1 SPIN FOR LIFE** just got soundly beaten in a non-winners of three condition, but it was a different and stronger field than this one because the earnings condition was \$30,000 higher. Two starts back, he was given a great steer on the lead by Colin Kelly to get the job done versus non-winners of two competition and he fits better versus these than he did racing against the likes of Fabulous Freddie and Hungry Hill. He gets the deadly "first time Doug McNair" angle tonight and that sways me to make him the top pick.

**#3 EYE OF AN EAGLE** comes off a good effort where he closed from far back to just miss and he fired a 28 3/5 kicker which is by far the fastest final quarter of any of these in their last starts. In that mile, he started a move from the back after the half and found himself racing fifth-over approaching the three quarter pole. He was fanned wide by Eddie Hensley while the leader was cutting the corner. He simply ran out of racetrack because he passed the leader a couple of strides past the wire. That race came on the heels of an effort two starts back where he made a big third quarter move and turned for home with a clear lead. He fits well against these, and he will likely be the one to fend off late.

**#7 OH HILL NO** went off at a good price last week considering that two starts back she got in some traffic on the final turn, had to wait for room, then closed with good energy to get a share. Last week, she was driven much more aggressively and she got rewarded with her first win of the year in only her second start. In that mile she made two early moves, first powering out for the lead, then re-moving to the front after getting overtaken by a big longshot. From there, she led the rest of the way, fought off a bold final turn challenge, then had enough left to hold off Eye Of An Eagle. That was a good effort, and she is a threat to repeat here.

**#4 MR JAZZ MAN** is in great form, coming off a convincing maiden win and having finished second in three of his other four starts this year. In his maiden breaking score 15 days ago, he made it very clear from the start that he was intent on making front, and he easily controlled the race from there. He jumps up from non-winners of one to non-winners of three here, though. I think he sits and closes for a share this time.

**#4 ROYAL BELUGA** showed no speed whatsoever leaving the gate last week and that left him with too much to do racing from the back. Remarkably, he was at least three wide at the three quarters for the sixth consecutive race and he closed well enough for taking a share. Two starts back, he was the first to move widest and he just failed to catch the winner who was taking his second victory in as many starts. Getting off the rail tonight could help him beat a couple of these off the gate, and if he can find the second-over spot this time, he can be the one tonight. I'll give him a slight nod to take down an undefeated rival who missed a week.

**#8 LUVUTOTHEMOONANBAK** comes into this race undefeated, and both of his wins were impressive. In his last start, he took a couple of stutter steps at the start and momentarily broke stride, then he was patiently and confidently driven by Doug McNair. He battled with Royal Beluga in the lane and eventually won the sprint home. In his debut on February 6th, he was sent postward as the big favorite coming in off a strong qualifying win and he delivered a strong winning effort making a middle move to the front, fighting off a final turn challenge then easily holding sway. He is the obvious horse to beat but I wonder if the recency edge held by the top choice could be the difference maker.

**#1 MASTERWORK** comes off two strong closing efforts in non-winners of two company and there are reasons to believe that he is in with a decent chance tonight. Most recently, he encountered traffic trouble in early stretch, and he searched for a seam before finally angling out following Eye Of An Eagle home down the middle of the track. He is in the mix for a share in this spot.

**#6 ROSETTA** arrived from Ohio on a two-race win streak last week and she tried a different racing style that didn't work. She dropped back and attempted a late wide move but sputtered in the stretch. She now gets the best post (from which seven of ten winners started from here on Monday night), and she will likely get raced more aggressively. She should be better tonight and its likely that she will be part of the Tri or Super.

**#5 SETTN A PRECEDENT** gets a key class drop here to the level where she fits best, and she typically makes no mistake in these situations. Case in point is her February 7th start where she came in off a distant eighth place finish at the non-winners of \$14,500 last five level. Starting from the same post she has tonight, she completely reversed tactics that night and took an aggressive approach taking the lead in the second quarter and holding it all the way from there. The previous time she raced in a class similar to tonight's on December 14th, she was also a front end winner. She will likely make an early lead to the front tonight, and she gets top billing here.

**#7 WESTERN WISH** is the other dropper in here that will almost surely improve facing easier. Two starts back, she produced a super effort in defeat at this level as a 26 to 1 bomb, just missing by a scant nose. The money she earned from that start required her to jump up to the non-winners of \$18,850 last five and the race there is probably better than it looks on the program page. She was buried on the inside turning for home and driver J.R. Plante kept looking for room that was not available. She finished with good pace but missed a cheque, now she gets to drop back down. She has shown in the past that she can race effectively positioned near the front throughout miles and it shouldn't be assumed that she is going to drop to the back tonight.

**#3 FOX VALLEY TESSA** got the key driver change to leading teamster James Macdonald last week, and as it often happens in that case, she got bet down to favoritism and took care of business. She stays at the same level by taking on a \$75,000 claiming tag. She is in tougher here facing the two droppers, but she is a threat, nonetheless.

**#4 CHARMBO STORMY** has compiled a solid record in 2025 and this year she has missed the board only once, that instance coming at this class level two starts back. Last week, she got Louis-Phillipe Roy in the bike racing at this class level, and she showed immediate improvement at big odds to finish in the money. She followed Fox Valley Tessa to the stretch, tipped wide and closed willingly. She is a good one to use on the bottom tonight.

**#5 SAULSBROOK OLYMPIA** gets Billy Davis Jr. in the bike tonight after failing to get a cheque as the 5 to 2 favorite last week. Two starts back, this mare was game in defeat to a class dropper that would not be denied. She also left faster than normal in that mile with the leading driver directing her. She compiled a good record last year with five wins and 11 Exacta finishes from 32 starts. She has yet to hit the top two this year but in this seventh start, she has a good chance to take her first win of the year.

**#7 COZ IM SPECIAL** was expected to do well on the class drop last week, and she managed to finish second to a dominant winner that fought off a stiff third quarter challenge to get the job done. She looked like she was on live cover until the one that she was following got put away by the leader and started to back up on the final turn. So as the leader was sprinting away, this mare was getting backed up, then forced to make a wide move. She fits well versus these and she should get an aggressive steer. She is another possibility for Pick 6, Pick 4 and Pick 5 tickets.

**#8 SAULSBROOK ABBEY** made her local debut coming in off two qualifiers, the second one being much better than the first, and she produced a good effort in defeat in that first start raced outside of the Maritimes. Sitting fourth early, she made a power move to the front on the backstretch, and she looked long gone until the eighth pole where it became apparent that a closing rival was likely going to chase her down. She is in tougher tonight, but she has licence to improve in this second start over the track. I can see her landing in the bottom of the Tri or Super.

**#3 TREASURES WATCHING** closed well in all of her last three starts, and she was fancied more last week than in previous starts. She closed at 7 to 1 after going off at odds of 28 to 1 or higher in seven straight starts. She rewarded her backers by making a wide late bid and chasing down Saulsbrook Abbey for the win. She is sharp and she will likely be passing rivals again in the final quarter. She is worth a look for exotic wagers.

**#5 FOXY SEASIDE** has raced well in all of her starts at three and all came at this track. Last week, coming off an impressive win the week before, she was sent off as the 4 to 5 favorite. She made an early move to the front that covered up the third choice in the race, who then got a perfect trip. She couldn't hold that rival off in the stretch, but she was a clear second. She raced better off a helmet on February 14th when she towered up in the stretch full of pace and sailed past the leaders four wide. She is the one to beat here and I think she reverts to those closing tactics tonight.

**#1 KANDY KISS** has done nothing wrong in her two-race career, taking a win last week that followed a narrow loss on Valentine's Day. Both miles were strong efforts, and she was a no doubt winner last week after taking an early lead. This is a tougher spot tonight as she steps up to face non-winners of two, but she has given no indication that she can't handle it. I expect that she will get another aggressive steer from Tyler Borth, and she will likely be the one to catch when they turn for home.

**#2 PRESCELTO** came into her race on February 14th having requalified off three ugly lines in a row where she finished a well beaten eighth in all three, the last two in which she broke stride. She caught the eye that night in the lane, passing some rivals to land fourth at 86 to 1 while pacing a 28 2/5 kicker. She followed that up with a strong second-place finish to a filly that powered down the lane and was never getting beat in that race. She is clearly improved, and she should be in the mix to take another share tonight.

**#4 JOB HUNTER** sat in most of the way last week, then pulled on the last turn and closed mildly to finish only three quarters of a length behind Foxy Seaside at the wire. That was the eighth start in a row where she has finished in the top four for owner/trainer/driver Jeff Hunt. Her two wins came at Flamboro Downs, however and she finished third or fourth in all of her starts at Mohawk Park. She is probably a good one to use on the bottom of Tri and Super bets in this spot.

**#7 SWIFT TALKER** came into last week's race off a decent closing effort on February 14th and she was sent off as the 2 to 1 favorite. She rallied off cover at the head of the lane took a narrow win, but she became subject of an inquiry. It was ruled by the judges that she did bear out and hooked the fork on the wheel of the runner up, which in the judges' opinion impeded the progress of that rival. She was subsequently placed second. She has a chance to make amends here facing some of the same rivals and she gets top billing.

**#5 LOVE ON ME** missed a week after notching a big upset in the final of the Blizzard series and she drew poorly last week. Despite those two negatives, she gained close to eight lengths in the back half to finish less than two lengths behind the top pick. Now she returns faster, and she draws a much better post. I think she will get better positioning at the start of this mile that should enable her to get into the flow, and she has a better chance tonight than she did last week. She is worth a look for late multi-race tickets.

**#3 MISS DUTTON** came into last week's race looking for a second straight win in this class and she didn't miss by much. After finishing a close third, she, like the top choice in this race, also was the subject of a judges' inquiry. It was determined that she moved out of the two-hole without clearance and put a wheel under a rival, touching her hind leg. She was placed eighth as a result of the inquiry. She is obviously sharp, and she fits well in this class. She is a candidate to go down the road tonight and is yet another contender in a good betting race.

**#1 SUNSHINE MAGIC** is one that always seems to try hard for owner/trainer/driver Jeff Hunt. Most recently, she paced a 27 2/5 kicker to finish two lengths behind Miss Dutton. That was the tenth start in a row where she took a cheque. That followed a popular dominant win in non-winners of two company the week before. She seems to fit better at that level, but she is also capable of taking a small share in this non-winners of two class.

**#2 BUCK DANCER** was claimed by Kyle Fellows out of his race on February 14th where he was a narrowly beaten third and he came out swinging in his first start for the new barn, taking over command in the second quarter and trotting away to an easy win where he was never headed after making the lead. Driver Louis-Phillipe Roy was a statue in the bike at the wire and this veteran nine-year-old gelding looks good to repeat coming right back at the same class level and facing many of the rivals he handled in that winning mile.

**#3 DERF HANOVER** makes his first start of the year coming in off a sharp qualifying win at Flamboro Downs and he lands in a spot where he should contend immediately. The 11-year-old gelded son of Cantab Hall had a decent season in 2024, earning more than \$60,000 on the strength of a 3-4-4 record from 33 starts. The highlight came in May when he took a lifetime mark of 1:52 3/5 while beating a non-winners of \$14,500 last five field. He raced in a class similar to tonight's two starts back in November and he was a following second that night as the 8 to 5 favorite. He is fresh and I could see him tripping out and getting the job done tonight.

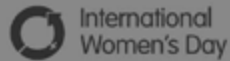
**#5 EYES OF JUSTICE** has produced some good recent rallies at this class level to land on the board, although last week wasn't one of them, mostly due to post position and trip. After starting from post nine and dropping to the back, he was simply too far behind to make any big impact late. He still managed to close to get a cheque. Getting a much better post this time gives him a chance at a better start which then should make his typical late rally more effective. Billy Davis Jr. takes the lines for a second straight start, and I see this gelding rallying for a share.

**#1 CHAMPAGNE BETTINA** raced well in two starts after getting claimed out of a winning effort at The Raceway in London on February 11th. She is a hard-trying mare that almost always is positioned near the front: She has been first or second at the half in 19 of her past 20 starts. Her typical racing style conflicts with a couple of others in here, but she still may be able to sit a trip racing close to the front and take a share.

## The Horseplayer's Journal by Garnet Barnsdale

**#9 CAVIAR N CRACKERS** is one of several in here that exit the same race, and she was the one that was moving best at the wire, although none of them were a threat to chase down the strong first-over winner. That was her second strong closing effort in a row, and she is getting closer to taking her first win of the year after notching seven victories from 33 starts last year. She will likely need a bit of racing luck from out there, but drawing widest should ensure that she goes off at a bettable price.

**#7 GLENBORO** set the pace to the lane in the race that the choice exits, but first up challenger Century Jamila was too sharp for all of them in that race and she wouldn't be denied. This consistent mare took a share as she always seems to do and she looks like a good fit in here, especially if she can find the pocket tonight. She is in with a chance, and she merits a look for late Pick 4 tickets.

**#5 ANGOSTURA HANOVER** exits the same race as the two mares above and she closed ground late but appeared to be one paced at the end of the mile. That simply could have been that she was pacing a 27 3/5 final quarter and going all she could at that point. She seems to do better when she can lay closer to the front, and she has a better chance of doing so tonight leaving from the middle of the gate. She is another in with a shot in a race that has a few viable options.

**#2 OH A LEGEND** did well to be beaten less than a length in the Blizzard series final considering nothing went right for her from the start. Despite appearing to be several lengths the best on paper, she was relegated to last early, and it seemed to just get worse from there as she ran into traffic issues before rallying late. She missed time and she faces a much tougher field here, but she is a solid mare that could close for a share in this spot anyway.

**#3 GRIT N GRACE** steps up off a race where she was elevated to the win after getting impeded and prevented from passing the rival that interfered with her. This is obviously a tougher assignment, but I can see her taking another following trip and landing in the High-5.

### C O N D I T I O N S A N D A L L O W A N C E S I N H A R N E S S R A C I N G - I M P O R T A N T T O K N O W

The conditions of a race determine whether a horse is eligible to enter. For example many races are restricted to horses that have won a certain number of races or a certain amount of money in a specified number of starts. Many races are restricted to horses entered to be "claimed" (offered for sale) at a specific price.

Allowances in the claiming price itself are given to colts and geldings, four-year-olds and younger and to mares, five-year-olds and younger.

The purpose of the allowance is to keep younger horses more competitive when racing against older and more experienced rivals. Mares are given extra consideration in claiming events because of their potential as broodmares.

The accompanying chart shows what the allowances are, but an example may make them easier to understand. The chart indicates that three-year-olds receive a 50% allowance in claiming races. This means that a three-year-old entered in a \$20,000 claiming race carries an actual claiming price of \$30,000 (50% higher).

Fillies and mares receive an additional 25% allowance in claiming races. Details of the race conditions and claiming price (if any) are given at the top of each race in the program.

### A L L O W A N C E S F O R P U R S E E A R N I N G S

When Fillies/Mares compete against Colts/Geldings (normally on the trot) Fillies/Mares will receive an additional 25% on the condition of the race. ie: nw \$5,000 (FM \$6,250) last 5 or \$12,000 (FM \$15,000) last 10 starts.

## C.P.M.A. Regulation Changes

Effective January 1<sup>st</sup> 2012  
CPMA will be instituting several new rule changes with regards to the following pari-mutuel pools:

### Pick Pools

- If there are no winners in any leg of a Pick N pool, the entire pool is refunded.
- If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners.
- A pool is no longer refunded if the 1<sup>st</sup> leg in the pool is cancelled or declared no contest.
- Pick-3: If at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: If at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.

## EXPLANATION OF THE LASIX PROGRAM

After careful study and consultation with Ontario Horsemen's groups, racetrack operators and veterinarians, Agriculture Canada and the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario passed legislation allowing the controlled (or supervised) administration of furosemide, more commonly called "Lasix". "Lasix" is used to alleviate the symptoms of exercise induced pulmonary hemorrhaging in racing horses. Horses will undergo an endoscopic examination of the trachea by a veterinarian licensed by the Ontario Racing Commission and endorsed by an official veterinarian before being allowed on the medication list. Once qualified, horses will be treated with "Lasix" within four hours plus or minus 15 minutes of a scheduled race in a secure retention area under the super vision of racing officials.

All horses on "Lasix" must remain on the program for a minimum of 100 days while racing in this jurisdiction.

- L** Denotes horses treated with Lasix.
- (L)** Denotes horses treated with Lasix today who were not so treated for their last start.
- (L)** Denotes horses treated with Lasix for their last start but not so treated today.

## RULES AND INFORMATION REGARDING CANADIAN HARNESS AND FOREIGN SEPARATE POOL EVENTS

### GENERAL

All pari-mutuel pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with the regulations and directives as issued by Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada ("the Regulations"), under the approval and supervision of the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency. The Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency can be contacted at 1-800-268-8835 or 613-759-6100 or Email: [cpmawebacpm@agr.gc.ca](mailto:cpmawebacpm@agr.gc.ca). A complete version of the CPMA regulations can be found at <http://laws-lois.justice.gc.ca/eng/regulations/SOR-91-365/>.

All tickets should be held until the result of the race is declared official and prices are posted.

No person under the age of 18 shall purchase or cash a ticket or voucher.

A claim of receiving an incorrect payment or incorrect change must be made to the Mutuel office of the association within twenty four hours of buying or cashing a valid ticket or voucher.

No ruling made by the Stewards/Judges or the Ontario Racing Commission with regard to distribution of purse money or the placing of horses in the order of finish, after the race has been declared official, shall have any bearing on the pay-out prices or distribution of pari-mutuel pools.

Change boards and Photo Finish display monitors are located in the Grandstand. In addition, Photo Finish pictures are shown on the closed-circuit television system. Customers are reminded that mutuel clerks are responsible for all shortages. When making a wager, customers must present sufficient funds at the time of purchase to cover the wagers requested.

### ENTRIES AND MUTUEL FIELDS

"Entry" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled or considered as the same betting interest. The most common reason for the coupling of horses in an Entry is the fact that they are owned by the same person.

"Mutuel Field" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled because the number of horses in the race exceeds the number which can be handled separately by the pari-mutuel system. Subject to the Regulations, a bet on one horse of an Entry or Mutuel Field shall be considered a bet on all horses in that Entry or Mutuel Field.

### DAILY DOUBLE BETTING (INCLUDING LATE DOUBLE)

A Daily Double bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of the two races specified for the Daily Double. Tickets not selecting the winner of the first half of the Daily Double and all tickets in the second half of the Daily Double not coupled with the declared official winner of the first half of the Daily Double are not winners and are not refunded no matter what circumstances affect the running of the second half of the Daily Double.

Should a horse or horses (not coupled with another starter) be excused from starting in the second race of the Daily Double after the first race of the Daily Double has closed for betting, holders of all Daily Double tickets on such horses, coupled with the winner of the first Daily Double race, shall participate in a Consolation Double pool. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

### EXACTA (Also known as Exactor)/TRIFECTA (Also known as Trifactor)/SUPERFECTA

An Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first two, three and four horses respectively, representing different betting interests to finish in the exact official order of finish, in the race on which the pool is operated.

### SWINGER (Also known as OMN)

A Swinger is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select horses to finish in any order from the official first 3 positions.

### JACKPOT HI-5

A Jackpot Hi-5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners in the specified Jackpot Hi-5 race. If there are races that have an entry, (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B), Jackpot Hi-5 will not offer a wager consisting of both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in a Jackpot Hi-5, the payout would be 1<sup>st</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>.

That jackpot portion of the pool will only be paid out if there is a single winning ticket. If there are multiple winning tickets that have correctly chosen the first 5 runners of the race, they will receive 50% of the pool for that day. The other 50% will go over into the Jackpot carryover. If there are no winning tickets with the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners, 100% of the current day's pool will be carried over into the Jackpot.

### PICK 3 & PICK-4 BETTING

The Pick 3 & Pick 4 bets are betting transactions in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of three or four successive races specified for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 respectively.

Winning tickets for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 are determined in the following sequence: A) winners of all legs, B) most winners, then refund. If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners. If there are no winners in any leg of a pool, the entire pool is refunded.

### PICK 5 BETTING

The Pick 5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of five successive races specified for the Pick 5 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 5 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 5.

### PICK 6 BETTING

The Pick 6 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of six successive races specified for the Pick 6 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 6 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 6.

### PICK 5 & 6 BETTING

If at least 1 race as part of the Pick 5 or 6 has been cancelled or declared "No contest", but not more than the specified below under Refunds, the net pool shall be distributed to those selecting the most # of winners and NOT include any carryover from a previous pool.

### PICK 3, PICK 4, PICK 5 & PICK 6 SCRATCHES

In the event a Pick 3, Pick 4, Pick 5 or Pick 6 ticket designates as a selection a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the Stewards/Judges to be a non-starter in any of the races comprising the Pick 3, Pick 4, Pick 5 or Pick 6 the favourite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection. In the event that the money bet in the win pool for two or more favourites is identical, the selection with the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non-starting selection.

However, if a scratch occurs in any leg of the Pick 3, Pick 4, Pick 5 or Pick 6 pools before the pool is closed, a ticket including the scratched horse may be cancelled.

### REFUNDS

Subject to the Regulations, all monies in all pools on a race are refunded in the event that the race is cancelled, declared off or declared no contest, and all monies bet on a horse are refunded if the horse is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start. These refunds will be communicated to the public through various means such as betting terminals, video display, changes boards and our website.

The Pick(n) pool shall be cancelled and all Pick(n) wagers for the individual performance shall be refunded if:

- Pick-3: at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

Where a horse that is part of an Entry is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start and at least one horse of that Entry receives a fair start in the race, all tickets purchased on the Entry remain valid and the purchase price of any such ticket shall not be refunded.

### COMMON POOL WAGERING (INTERTRACK BETTING)

In the unlikely event of a communications or computer system failure that prevents pools from merging with the host track's pools before the end of a race, CPMA regulations require that the site must refund all tickets for that race. This refund will be communicated to the public through various means such as video displays, change boards and messages on our website.

### FAIR START

If a horse has reached the Fair Start Pole (located 200 feet before the Starting Pole) by the time the mobile gate has reached the Starting Pole, that horse is deemed to have had a fair start. It makes no difference whether or not the horse is on or off stride at that precise moment. Under current policy and regulations, which are designed to be as fair as possible to all bettors on all starters, there is no Recall - a repeat of the entire starting procedure - when a horse does not reach the Fair Start Pole before the gate reaches the Starting Pole. Monies bet on such a horse are refunded in accordance with the regulation concerning refunds.

### LOST & OLD TICKETS

WEG issued tickets or vouchers are valid indefinitely, however, they cannot be cashed at a mutuel teller after 2 years from date of issue. Please mail tickets, along with your name and address, to Mutuel Manager, P.O. Box 156, Rexdale, Ontario, M9W 5L2, keeping a photocopy for future reference.

For "Lost Tickets" originally sold at a Woodbine Entertainment Group racetrack or Teletheatre, please enquire at the Mutuel office at Woodbine, Greenwood Teletheatre, or Mohawk. Policy may be subject to change retroactively in the event regulatory bodies amend existing regulations.

### ASSOCIATION PERCENTAGE, AND TAXATION/LEVY

The Woodbine Entertainment Group deducts and retains the following percentages from wagers placed at our own licensed sites which are then shared with the horsepeople, host and simulcast associations and the Ontario Racing Commission.

**WOODBINE/MOHAWK LIVE:** Win, Place & Show: 13.65%. Swinger 14.7%. Trifecta & Pick 4: 21.7%. Double & Exacta 17.2%. Jackpot Hi-5, Pick 5 & Pick 6: 11.7%. All other 23.0%

Horsepeople receive a further 2% on all wagers, except Trifecta wagering where it is 4%. The Ontario Provincial Government retains 0.5% on all bets placed in Ontario. The Canadian Government (through a revolving fund cost recovery basis) retains 0.8% on all wagers placed in Canada for provision of drug control, and audit services.

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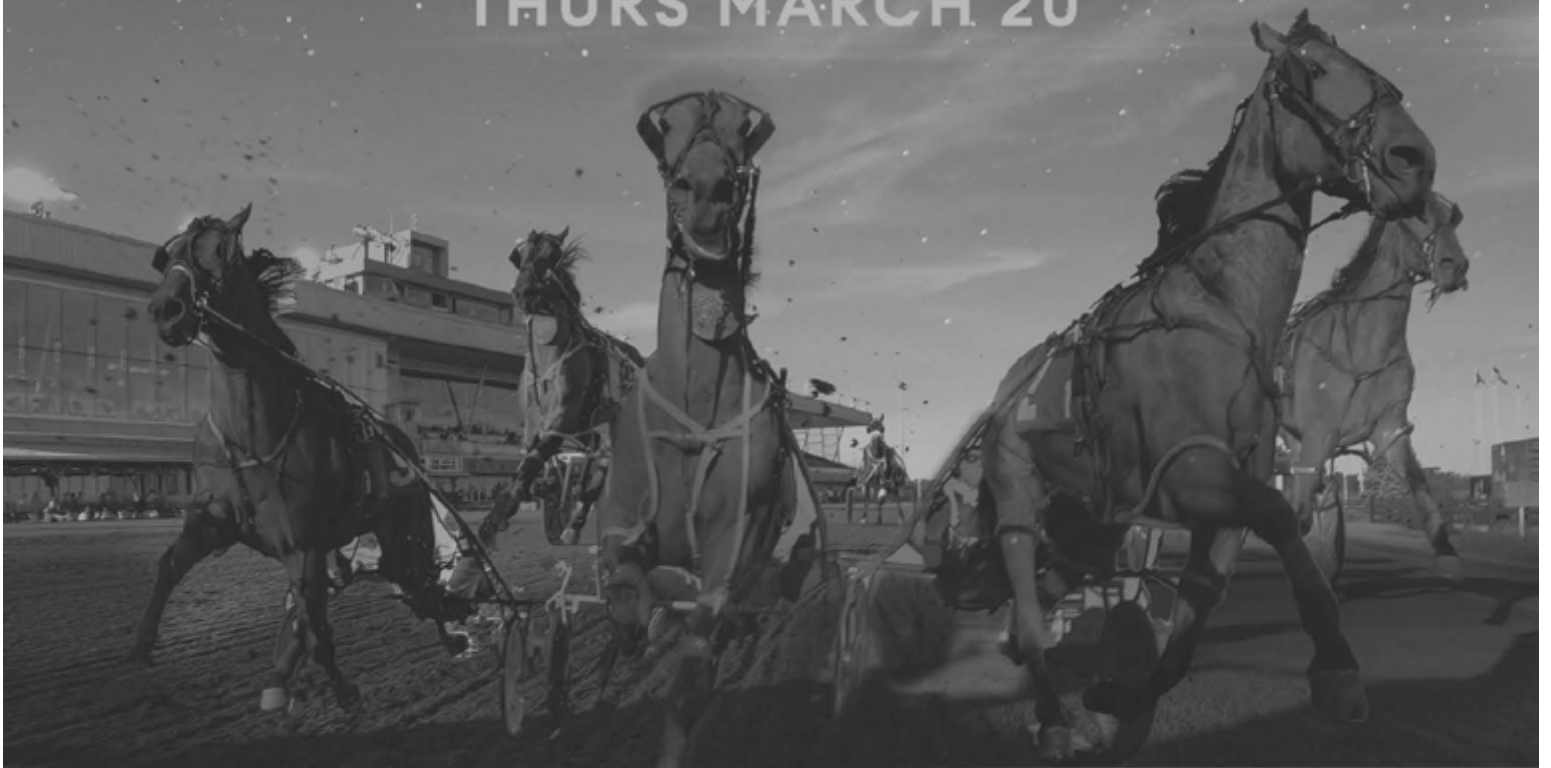
