Betting Basics

Some essentials to get you started with making a wager.

1 How to wager



Place your bet by visiting a teller, or using a self-serve terminal.

To place a bet here are just 5 things you need to know:

- 1 Name of racetrack (choose from any track in the simulcast feeds)
- 2 Number of the race
- 3 Amount of your bet (e.g. \$2)
- 4 Type of bet (see step 2)
- 5 Horse's number (see step 4)

Once you have decided what you want to bet, head to the nearest seller's window and use the sample statement as your guide:

Hello, (Racetrack), race 6, \$2 to WIN on Horse #4

How to use a self-serve terminal:

- 1 Swipe your Cash Card/Insert Cash
- 2 Enter the initial PIN #1234 (then choose a new PIN)
- 3 Press/Tap the track you would like to bet: (defaults to current race)
- 4 Tap the Horse Number: **#4**
- 5 Press/Tap the Bet Type: **WIN**
- 6 Press/Tap the Bet Amount: **\$2**
- 7 Press/Tap the Race Number: **Race #6**
- 8 Press Green **"Make BET"** button
- 9 Press/Tap the **"Finish with Receipt"** button
- 10 Be sure to check your ticket to confirm it's the bet you wanted

To get a Cash Card or for assistance ask a teller, or a staff member.

2 Types of bets



Single horse bets (minimum \$2.00 bet is required)

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Win	U U U	Your horse must finish 1st; payoff determined by the win odds.
Place	U U	Your horse must finish 1st or 2nd; payoffs better than to show.
Show	U	Your horse must finish 1st, 2nd, or 3rd; modest payoffs.

Exotic multiple-horse bets

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Exacta*	U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st and 2nd in exact order; riskier bet that can pay a little or a lot, depending on the horses' odds.
Daily double	U U U U U	Pick the winners of two designated consecutive races.
Pick 3, Win 4, Pick 5, Pick 6	U U U U U U	Select the winners of a designated set of consecutive races. The wager must be made prior to the start of the first race in the multi-race wager.
Triactor*	U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in exact order; can be expensive to play if you use a lot of horses.
Superfecta*	U U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th; big payoff possible.

* Exotic bets require the horses to finish in the EXACT order you select, unless you "BOX" the bet, in which case your selections can finish in any order.

All of the numbers and letters in the program might seem confusing or overwhelming at first, but focusing on these sections makes choosing a horse simple.

- Horse's number in the race
- Horse's post position colour
- Horse's colour, sex, age, sire (father), dam (mother), sire of the dam
- Morning line odds
- Horse's name
- Driver and Driver Record (Name, # of wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, winning %)

- Trainer information
- Horse's Lifetime record (with best win time, track size, track, age, lifetime wins and lifetime earnings)
- Horse's current record (# of races, # wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, and money earned)

4 The odds



Odds are also important to consider when choosing your horse. Horses that are thought to have a better chance of winning will typically have lower odds.

Morning line odds

Odds listed in the race program are the "morning line" odds. These are predictions of how the public will bet on the race. They are set by the track's handicapper when the race program is published, before the wagering starts.

The actual odds will be posted on the **Television** or in-field on the **Tote Board** before the race; they change up until post time, depending on how customers are betting on each horse in the race.

Calculating a \$2 win prize

To calculate a win prize, find the Odds of a horse on the **Television** or **Tote Board** (in-field board).

Multiply the first number by 2, then divide that number by the second digit (if there is one), and then add \$2. Simple as that!

Odds	1/2	2/1	7/2	5/1	10/1
Pays	\$3.00	\$6.00	\$9.00	\$12.00	\$22.00

Helpful facts for betting

- Some racetracks have a television simulcast commentator who tries to identify winning horses (handicaps) between the races. Listen and see if you can pick up any good tips to bet on.
- A good betting method is to choose horses with current odds two to three times higher than their morning line odds.

3 Tips to remember

WIN BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 32% of the time
PLACE BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 53% of the time
SHOW BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 67% of the time

#2 NOT PASSABLE is a sophomore Muscle Mass filly that I thought looked really good winning her qualifier on April 18th. The \$38,000 London Classic sale graduate, left well from the tricky rail post and settled into fourth early. From there, she followed well to the three quarters where she was pointed to the outside. She got forced three wide at the head of the lane but charged onward, unaffected. She dug in late to get up to catch a colt that won four races last year at two, including two Grassroots events. This full sister to Darbyshire (17 wins, \$270K, 1:53 S.) gets top billing to kick off the \$75,000 guaranteed Pick 5.

#1 SHESAMANALISHI has had two starts at three, and the second one was better than the first. In her most recent start, she gapped out a bit on the final turn, but then closed again in the lane. She was kept snug on a helmet to the eighth pole, then shown clear racetrack and she was closing well at the end of the mile, but the top two were too strong, especially the winner that was bet down to 8 to 5 off an even qualifier. She is clearly improving, and she should be in the mix again tonight. Her driver, Bob McClure, has been on fire lately. He scored five wins here on Monday night.

#5 FISHERMANS BLUES race last week probably was better than it looks on paper because he was bottled up early in the stretch, then closed well once he found a clear lane. The colt that won that race was a repeat winner and one that would n doubt be favored in this field. This Cantab Hall gelding has taken shares in four of his six starts, and he hasn't missed a cheque so far. He is a good one to use underneath in this spot.

#7 KENOGAMI MAT's debut wasn't bad when you consider that he was chasing the 1 to 5 favorite around the track, and he held second until late. He was sitting a clear third when he got steppy and broke stride nearing the wire, so there was no reason to set him back because he didn't get lapped on. With that experience under his belt, he can once again compete for a share in this spot, and he should be part of the Tri or Super if he stays flat.

#10 TEMPTING is a filly that took a big step forward last week in her second start. After starting sixth and following to the half, she was sent to the outside and she gapped cover that advanced quickly around the final turn. In the lane, she finished gamely and although she lost a position late, she still closed ground on the leaders while kicking in 26 3/5 and pacing her back half in 55 2/5. She draws worst tonight, and not many have won from post 10 this year, but I think she can get the job done versus these if she can land in mid pack again at the start. Drawing widest will also help keep her price viable.

#3 SADIES DELIGHT raced well to take shares in the preliminary legs of the Ontario Spring series, then she had no shot in the final when she dropped back to last when leaving from post eight. She brings a 0 for 15 record to the track tonight, but I like the late speed that she showed in her last two starts. She also faces easier tonight, and she is worth a look for the early Pick 5.

#4 GUCCI SEELSTER is one that I thought raced okay in the Spring Series on April 17th. She followed cover that night and she finished evenly in a 1:54 1/5 mile. That was her best mile of the year, and the filly that finished directly in front of her in third came back a week later to score an upset in the final of that series. I don't love that she missed a week, but her improving form makes her worth a look in here at what should be a decent price.

#2 LITTLE MOMENTS comes out of an eventful race where she inherited a gapped out second on the first turn when the leader jumped it off and went into the safety lane, then the filly that was racing third also broke a couple of strides later. She chased the leader to the head of the lane and took her shot, but she finished a one-paced third. That was by far the fastest mile of her 18-race career. She is improving and she fits okay in this field. She should be in the hunt again, and she is a good one to use in the bottom of the Tri and Super.

#6 ANGELIC produced a decent effort in her sophomore debut now she lands in a good spot that gives her a decent chance to break her maiden. In that 2025 debut, the \$55,000 Lexington yearling flashed nice early speed, making front immediately from the 8-hole. After being overtaken by the second choice, she followed in the pocket, and she took her shot in the lane. She raced evenly through the stretch, finishing well clear in fourth while trotting her own final quarter in 28 1/5. She draws best now, and she looks like the one to catch and beat in this spot.

#10 NORTHERN DRIFTER is another one that showed good early speed last time, and he too was overtaken in the second quarter. He then followed the big 1 to 2 favorite around the track and held for second. That was a good effort, and most importantly for him, he stayed flat after making a break in his sophomore debut two weeks earlier. He has had frequent gait issues that make him risky, but he also comes off his fastest mile and he looks like one of the best ones in here. I'd want a price that he likely won't offer in this spot, but it makes sense to toss him on Pick 5 tickets.

#7 TRICKY TRISH's sophomore season wasn't anything great, she took only two fifth-place checks in seven starts, but her performance in her lone qualifier leading up to this race gives reason to believe that she is improved and ready to compete for the win here in this sophomore debut. In that mile, new trainer Rick Zeron put her right on the point leaving the gate, and immediately opened up a big lead in the opening quarter. She came back to Zeron and stole a second quarter breather, then marched on and sealed the deal with a 28 3/5 kicker. Watching her stride out past the wire, she refused to let the five-time winner that finished second pass her, racing her all the way around the first turn. She could be the one in here if she gets sent to the front again by Zeron, who takes his first drive of 2025 in this spot.

#9 HOBNOB HANOVER trotted a 27 4/5 kicker last week and that makes her worth a look for the bottom of the Tri and Super in this spot. She has had 29 tries to break her maiden and hasn't been able to get the job done, so it is unlikely that she will break through here starting from the nine-hole. She has taken seven slices though, and if she can repeat that late speed here, she could sneak into the exotics at a price.

#10 MY GELATO produced one of her best efforts in her ninth start last week, flying home to get third behind two rivals that were motoring at the end of the mile after stealing a 1:28 opening three quarters. Her 26-flat kicker sets her up for a big try here, assuming she gets sent forward from post 10 by Bob McClure, who has been absolutely on fire the past two weeks. She was good early in the season last year, finishing second in Grassroots races in both of her first two starts, and she showed good gate speed in both of those races. She gets the nod here despite drawing the widest post.

#7 YS FLOWERNUMBERTEN was predictably bet down to 2 to 5 last week after finishing a close second to streaking Mai Tide the week before. She avoided a breaker on the first turn then was gifted a big early lead when another rival that was racing close to the front also broke. She drifted out in the lane and tired a bit opening the door for the second choice to sprint up the inside lane and get past her. She was still a clear second in a fast race for the class and she will get bet again. She is a contender, but she may be ripe for the picking by the choice in the stretch if that rival is within striking range.

#4 DEAR ABBEY raced okay in the Spring Series versus better fillies than she meets tonight, and she should be a contender back in with maidens tonight. She has shown that she is faster at three, and she will likely get more aggressive tonight in a spot where she looks like one of the best ones. If she can replicate her mile from two starts back where she finished second to 3 to 5 shot Whiskey Blue Chip, she should be right there. This race could come down to which one of the top three choices gets the best trip, and she is another that merits a close look for early multi-race tickets.

#8 GOOSEBERRY took some action last week, likely because of the 27 1/5 kicker that she paced the week before. In last week's mile, she left well enough from post nine to get positioned in the top four, then she stayed in and took a shuffle back to seventh. She then closed okay, and she finished the race with pace. I think she has a decent chance to land in the bottom of the Tri or Super tonight.

#7 STORMONT BEAUTIFUL comes into this sophomore debut looking ready for battle based on her lone qualifier where she started fast and accepted the pocket, followed well to the three quarters, popped pocket and absolutely flew down the lane to prevail while trotting a 27-flat kicker while under no urging from Bob McClure. She was a good rookie, taking three wins and three seconds in her final six starts after missing the board in her debut, and she finished second to a good filly in the Harvest Series final. She should be tough in here if she gets sent forward leaving the gate in the same manner as she was in that winning qualifier.

#9 GREEN GLIDER got better towards the end of her rookie season, culminating with a victory in the Grassroots consolation, her second win in her last four starts of that two-year-old campaign. Her best weapon is her high speed, and that was on display in both of her qualifiers leading to this first start of 2025. Both of those miles were trotted over the Spring Garden Ranch mile surface in Florida, and in her last qualifier on April 10th, she trotted her final three quarters in 126-flat with tonight's driver Trevor Henry in the bike. She will likely look to gain command by the time the quarter is reached tonight then try to bottom out this field, and she is a threat to do just that. She should get a close look for multi-race tickets.

#2 D A DREAM GIRL got bet more than I thought she would last week coming off one even qualifier, but the money that came in for her was proven to be a tell that she was ready to trot a big mile in that sophomore debut. She had a tough chore, moving first up at the half to try to chase down a rival that looked strong on the lead. She toughed out that difficult chore and responded to Trevor Henry urging to chase won that leader and get up in deep stretch for the win. She loses Henry to Green Glider tonight, and she faces tougher non-winner of two foes, but that was a strong effort, and she can be part of the Tri or Super in spite of the class rise tonight.

#10 LISBON had her three-race win streak broken last week, a victim of pace and trip. After leaving sixth, she watched the first two quarters cut in a slow 29 1/5 and 29 3/5, and her fate was sealed right there. She tried to close into a 56 2/5 back half, but there wasn't much chance of her getting anything at that point. She unfortunately draws widest here, and there are at least a couple lined up to her inside that will beat her off the gate. A small share is likely her ceiling tonight.

#5 ABOVE MYPAYGRADE was bet down to the 6 to 5 favorite last week on the strength of four straight wins at Flamboro Downs, and he got a less than ideal trip while coming on for third in the final quarter. After getting outsprinted leaving the gate, he dropped in fifth and he was content to sit there until the final turn where he was sent to the outside by Travis Cullen. He started to advance on cover when the pocket sitter popped out, and he ended up then getting forced four wide coming off the last turn. He closed willingly for third, now he draws a much better post. He will likely get sent forward leaving the gate tonight and work out a better trip racing on or near the lead and he gets top billing in this opening leg of the late Pick 5.

#10 B SONNY dropped to this level last week following a race against some decent conditioned horses where he went a long trip and missed getting a cheque. Last week, he was out a long way before touching down on the engine before the half, and he kept on truckin' despite being required to pace two sub-28 quarters to make front. He recorded a new life's mark, and I don't think post 10 is terrible for him here, because he can float out and drive on again, same as he did last week. If he can make his way to the front and touch down on the lead, he could prove tough to catch again tonight.

#6 ACEFORTYFOURAPOLLO shoots for the threepeat here, having won two straight after starting his career 1 for 32. He showed versatility in those two races, winning one racing close to the front throughout, and last week closing nicely to take a new life's mark. He draws best here and that gives him some options and he keeps white hot driver Bob McClure who has won 18 races since April 14th. Here we have another sharp horse that merits a look for the late Pick 5.

#4 STEELWHEEL HANOVER followed the top pick home last week and closed for a share in an improved effort from his previous start where he led to the half then stopped in the stretch. He might be better when he finds a helmet to follow and that is the trip that he will likely seek out tonight. I can see him closing late, passing some of these rivals and landing in the bottom of the Tri or Super.

#10 GREEN MANS JOY trotted the fastest mile of her 11-race career last week in a good effort that looked like at the top of the stretch was going to get her a maiden win. Unfortunately for her, a well-meant rival was not going to be denied, trotting a 27 3/5 final quarter to get up and nail this filly on the wire. She draws widest here, but keeps the leading driver, and she should be the one to catch again. I'll give her the nod despite the wide draw in a spot where she should be tough to catch if she clears to the front.

#8 P C SUNSHINE GIRL trotted an okay mile in her qualifier on April 7th that set her up for a good try in her career debut last week. In that initial start, she left well for position and accepted the pocket following the even money favorite. She followed to the stretch where she got a clear shot at the leader, but she could only follow that more experienced rival to the wire while finishing a clear second. She can improve off that first start and she is in the mix tonight, likely racing from close range again.

#9 FIREFLIESNTHUNDER showed what he is capable of in his first qualifier when he went right down the road for a 2:00 1/5 score, fighting off a last turn challenger to pull away in the stretch. He raced evenly in his next qualifier but produced a faster final quarter. This is the second foal out of an Amigo Hall mare and the first one to make the races. He goes for Team McNair who excel with young horses year in and year out. He is another that could do in a race with no standout.

#7 BANKS A MILLION is a filly that showed a bit of promise last season at two, finishing third in her first three starts, one of them being in a Grassroots race. She makes her third start tonight coming off two decent sophomore efforts where she passed horses in the stretch in both of those miles. It wouldn't be surprising to see her take a step forward tonight coming out of a mile where she flashed home in 27 2/5. She should be a good one to use on the bottom of Tri and Super bets tonight.

#4 SUPERIOR DELIGHT had to work harder than usual to make front last week, getting stung three wide to make front in a very fast 26 3/5 opening quarter and that was likely the difference in that race. That was the fastest opening quarter that she paced in her life, and it turned out to be a bit too fast as she wasn't able to seal the deal for her sixth straight win. The rival that drove on between horses into the opening turn, One Last Kiss, was the eventual winner and she isn't in this field this week. This filly should bounce back here in a spot where she should be able to make front easier.

#2 ALLSMOKEANDMIRRORS has done her best work racing at this \$20,000 conditioned claiming level, winning four of the last six times she raced at this level. But the two losses at this level came in her last two starts, neither of which were poor efforts, but she adds Lasix now, and she should be right in the mix again tonight. She has shown in the past that she can take a lot of air and keep coming at this level. She might be able to race first up in this spot and chase down the choice. She is one that I will use on late multi-race tickets.

#6 JOB HUNTER raced well enough to win last week, the filly that shaded her simply got the better trip. While that rival was angling out of Superior Delight's pocket at the top of the stretch, Job Hunter was losing ground before tipping off stalled cover and she still only fell one stride short of pulling off a monumental upset. She is often a victim of trip because of the closing style that she deploys, but she has taken three wins so far in 2025 and she is one of the sharpest mares in this field. She won't pay \$94 this week, but it wouldn't be a huge shock to see her get her nose up on the wire this time.

#5 FOX VALLEY TATUM got a good inside following trip last week and she had pace in the lane, but she had to wait for room to midstretch. She found clear racetrack eventually and finished well between mares to finish third, edging Superior Delight on the wire. She should get another good trip tonight leaving from the middle of the gate and land in the Tri or Super.

#9 WIFEY SAID SO is one of the gamest racehorses on this circuit considering how hard she gets raced and how she manages to find the wire more often than not. Last week, she was hung out past the half to make front and after she touched down on the engine she came under immediate attack. She fended off that challenge then produced a 28 2/5 kicker to prevail in a typical game effort. She gets a slightly better post tonight with the field having only nine starters and she is the one to catch and beat once again as she shoots for her ninth win of the 2025 season in her sixteenth start.

#7 DEL DIGGITY is another mare that is known for her gameness and nose for the wire, having taken 33 wins in her 136-race career. She is no stranger to Mohawk Park, having taken 13 of those victories here. She comes into this race off a tough first-over trip at Flamboro Downs while getting beat by the same mare for a second straight start. She goes for a barn that is winning at a 24 per cent clip from 103 starts in 2024, and she figures to be a threat racing off the claim tonight.

#2 JAZZVILLE got an inside trip two starts back, but she didn't find room to race in the lane until it appeared was too late. But she paced a storm in the last few strides to the wire to get up and nail Wifey Said So right on the line. Last week, she was used harder early and raced in that rival's pocket for most of the mile. She followed to the wire without really gaining late, but she was a clear third on the wire. She has shown she is capable with the right trip, but I'd demand a price with this one who is more likely to take a share than a win in this spot where she will likely get out sprinted by at least a couple of rivals early in the mile.

#4 TIMEWAITSONNOONE improved in her past two starts, and she produced a big closing effort last week to fall just short of nailing the top pick in this race. She will obviously get bet much lower in this spot than the 47 to 1 that she closed at last week, and her 27 2/5 late speed puts her in the mix. She has taken only one win in 15 starts this year though and she is facing some rivals that know how to stack wins. She isn't impossible in this field, but I prefer to use her underneath tonight.

Race 10 Selections

The Horseplayer's Journal by Garnet Barnsdale

#6 GRANITE BEACH ships in from Flamboro Downs coming off a good race where he got beat for the second time in a row by the same sharp rival. He has taken an impressive 15 wins from 36 starts in 2024-25, including a lifetime-best score at this track from post 10 in November at a similar class level to tonight's. I'll take a shot with him starting from the best post in a wide-open race in a spot where I think he can get a good trip racing near the front.

#4 ON TIME DELIVERY comes to play every week at this level. Since dropping into these \$20,000 conditioned claimers in late February, he has finished first or second in all seven starts. He held a clear lead at the three quarters in six of those seven starts. He sometimes looks like he is ripe for the picking then digs in halfway down the stretch. He is the one to catch and beat here.

#2 CRUISE HANOVER is one that I thought raced well last week that is worth a look for late Pick 5 and Pick 4 tickets. After dropping right to the back early, he latched onto fourth-over cover, then spun widest coming off the final turn. He out paced four other rivals to finish a close fourth, and he was still closing when the wire hit. He might get overlooked again tonight, and he is capable of upsetting if he can get a better trip racing closer to the front.

#5 RUSTYS BETT hasn't missed the top four racing exclusively at this level in his four 2024 starts and that streak will likely continue tonight. He made two moves last week and came up short, but he is capable of getting the job done if he gets a perfect pocket trip. I'm not sure the likelihood of that happening will make him worth the risk tonight based on the odds he will likely close at, and I'll use him underneath.

#1 STARS TREASURE is one that typically sits in, saves everything for the stretch, then looks for room and passes horses. Last week, he found room early in the stretch and had clear sailing, but he could do no better than take the smallest cheque. A similar fate likely awaits him tonight as there are many rivals in this field that look tough for him to beat. He could sneak into the bottom of the exotics at a price, however.

CONDITIONS AND ALLOWANCES IN HARNESS RACING - IMPORTANT TO KNOW

The conditions of a race determine whether a horse is eligible to enter. For example many races are restricted to horses that have won a certain number of races or a certain amount of money in a specified number of starts. Many races are restricted to horses entered to be "claimed" (offered for sale) at a specific price.

Allowances in the claiming price itself are given to colts and geldings, four-year-olds and younger and to mares, five-year-olds and younger.

The purpose of the allowance is to keep younger horses more competitive when racing against older and more experienced rivals. Mares are given extra consideration in claiming events because of their potential as broodmares.

The accompanying chart shows what the allowances are, but an example may make them easier to understand. The chart indicates that three-year-olds receive a 50% allowance in claiming races. This means that a three-year-old entered in a \$20,000 claiming race carries an actual claiming price of \$30,000 (50% higher).

Fillies and mares receive an additional 25% allowance in claiming races. Details of the race conditions and claiming price (if any) are given at the top of each race in the program.

ALLOWANCES FOR PURSE EARNINGS

When Fillies/Mares compete against Colts/Geldings (normally on the trot) Fillies/Mares will receive an additional 25% on the condition of the race.
ie: nw \$5,000 (FM \$6,250) last 5 or \$12,000 (FM \$15,000) last 10 starts.

C.P.M.A. Regulation Changes

Effective January 1st 2012
CPMA will be instituting several new rule changes with regards to the following pari-mutuel pools:

- Pick Pools**
- If there are no winners in any leg of a Pick N pool, the entire pool is refunded.
 - If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners.
 - A pool is no longer refunded if the 1st leg in the pool is cancelled or declared no contest.
 - Pick-3: If at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.
 - Pick-4, 5 or 6: If at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.

EXPLANATION OF THE LASIX PROGRAM

After careful study and consultation with Ontario Horsemen's groups, racetrack operators and veterinarians, Agriculture Canada and the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario passed legislation allowing the controlled (or supervised) administration of furosemide, more commonly called "Lasix". "Lasix" is used to alleviate the symptoms of exercise induced pulmonary hemorrhaging in racing horses. Horses will undergo an endoscopic examination of the trachea by a veterinarian licensed by the Ontario Racing Commission and endorsed by an official veterinarian before being allowed on the medication list. Once qualified, horses will be treated with "Lasix" within four hours plus or minus 15 minutes of a scheduled race in a secure retention area under the super vision of racing officials. All horses on "Lasix" must remain on the program for a minimum of 100 days while racing in this jurisdiction.

- (L)** Denotes horses treated with Lasix today who were not so treated for their last start.
- (L)** Denotes horses treated with Lasix for their last start but not so treated today.

RULES AND INFORMATION REGARDING CANADIAN HARNESS AND FOREIGN SEPARATE POOL EVENTS

GENERAL

All pari-mutuel pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with the regulations and directives as issued by Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada ("The Regulations"), under the approval and supervision of the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency. The Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency can be contacted at 1-800-268-8835 or 613-759-6100 or Email: cpmawebacpm@agr.gc.ca. A complete version of the CPMA regulations can be found at <http://laws-lois.justice.gc.ca/eng/regulations/SOR-91-365/>.

All tickets should be held until the result of the race is declared official and prices are posted.

No person under the age of 18 shall purchase or cash a ticket or voucher.

A claim of receiving an incorrect payment or incorrect change must be made to the Mutuel office of the association within twenty four hours of buying or cashing a valid ticket or voucher.

No ruling made by the Stewards/Judges or the Ontario Racing Commission with regard to distribution of purse money or the placing of horses in the order of finish, after the race has been declared official, shall have any bearing on the pay-out prices or distribution of pari-mutuel pools.

Change boards and Photo Finish display monitors are located in the Grandstand. In addition, Photo Finish pictures are shown on the closed-circuit television system. Customers are reminded that mutuel clerks are responsible for all shortages. When making a wager, customers must present sufficient funds at the time of purchase to cover the wagers requested.

ENTRIES AND MUTUEL FIELDS

"Entry" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled or considered as the same betting interest. The most common reason for the coupling of horses in an Entry is the fact that they are owned by the same person.

"Mutuel Field" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled because the number of horses in the race exceeds the number which can be handled separately by the pari-mutuel system. Subject to the Regulations, a bet on one horse of an Entry or Mutuel Field shall be considered a bet on all horses in that Entry or Mutuel Field.

DAILY DOUBLE BETTING (INCLUDING LATE DOUBLE)

A Daily Double bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of the two races specified for the Daily Double. Tickets not selecting the winner of the first half of the Daily Double and all tickets in the second half of the Daily Double not coupled with the declared official winner of the first half of the Daily Double are not winners and are not refunded no matter what circumstances affect the running of the second half of the Daily Double.

Should a horse or horses (not coupled with another starter) be excused from starting in the second race of the Daily Double after the first race of the Daily Double has closed for betting, holders of all Daily Double tickets on such horses, coupled with the winner of the first Daily Double race, shall participate in a Consolation Double pool. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

EXACTA (Also known as Exactor)/TRIFECTA (Also known as Tractor)/SUPERFECTA

An Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first two, three and four horses respectively, representing different betting interests to finish in the exact official order of finish, in the race on which the pool is operated.

SWINGER (Also known as OMNI)

A Swinger is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select horses to finish in any order from the official first 3 positions.

JACKPOT HI-5

A Jackpot Hi-5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners in the specified Jackpot Hi-5 race. If there are races that have an entry, (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B), Jackpot Hi-5 will not offer a wager consisting of both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in a Jackpot Hi-5, the payout would be 1st, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th.

That jackpot portion of the pool will only be paid out if there is a single winning ticket. If there are multiple winning tickets that have correctly chosen the first 5 runners of the race, they will receive 50% of the pool for that day. The other 50% will go over into the Jackpot carryover. If there are no winning tickets with the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners, 100% of the current day's pool will be carried over into the Jackpot.

PICK 3 & PICK 4 BETTING

The Pick 3 & Pick 4 bets are betting transactions in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of three or four successive races specified for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 respectively.

Winning tickets for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 are determined in the following sequence: A) winners of all legs, B) most winners, then refund. If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners. If there are no winners in any leg of a pool, the entire pool is refunded.

PICK 5 BETTING

The Pick 5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of five successive races specified for the Pick 5 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 5 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 5.

PICK 6 BETTING

The Pick 6 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of six successive races specified for the Pick 6 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 6 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 6.

PICK 5 & 6 BETTING

If at least 1 race as part of the Pick 5 or 6 has been cancelled or declared "No contest", but not more than the specified below under Refunds, the net pool shall be distributed to those selecting the most # of winners and NOT include any carryover from a previous pool.

PICK 3, PICK 4, PICK 5 & PICK 6 SCRATCHES

In the event a Pick 3, Pick 4, Pick 5 or Pick 6 ticket designates as a selection a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the Stewards/Judges to be a non-starter in any of the races comprising the Pick 3, Pick 4, Pick 5 or Pick 6 the favourite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection. In the event that the money bet in the win pool for two or more favourites is identical, the selection with the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non-starting selection.

However, if a scratch occurs in any leg of the Pick 3, Pick 4, Pick 5 or Pick 6 pools before the pool is closed, a ticket including the scratched horse may be cancelled.

REFUNDS

Subject to the Regulations, all monies in all pools on a race are refunded in the event that the race is cancelled, declared off or declared no contest, and all monies bet on a horse are refunded if the horse is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start. These refunds will be communicated to the public through various means such as betting terminals, video display, changes boards and our website.

The Pick(n) pool shall be cancelled and all Pick(n) wagers for the individual performance shall be refunded if:

- Pick-3: at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

Where a horse that is part of an Entry is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start and at least one horse of that Entry receives a fair start in the race, all tickets purchased on the Entry remain valid and the purchase price of any such ticket shall not be refunded.

COMMON POOL WAGERING (INTERTRACK BETTING)

In the unlikely event of a communications or computer system failure that prevents pools from merging with the host track's pools before the end of a race, CPMA regulations require that the site must refund all tickets for that race. This refund will be communicated to the public through various means such as video displays, change boards and messages on our website.

FAIR START

If a horse has reached the Fair Start Pole (located 200 feet before the Starting Pole) by the time the mobile gate has reached the Starting Pole, that horse is deemed to have had a fair start. It makes no difference whether or not the horse is on or off stride at that precise moment. Under current policy and regulations, which are designed to be as fair as possible to all bettors on all starters, there is no Recall - a repeat of the entire starting procedure - when a horse does not reach the Fair Start Pole before the gate reaches the Starting Pole. Monies bet on such a horse are refunded in accordance with the regulation concerning refunds.

LOST & OLD TICKETS

WEG issued tickets or vouchers are valid indefinitely, however, they cannot be cashed at a mutuel teller after 2 years from date of issue. Please mail tickets, along with your name and address, to Mutuel Manager, P.O. Box 156, Rexdale, Ontario, M9W 5L2, keeping a photocopy for future reference.

For "Lost Tickets" originally sold at a Woodbine Entertainment Group racetrack or Teletheatre, please enquire at the Mutuel office at Woodbine, Greenwood Teletheatre, or Mohawk. Policy may be subject to change retroactively in the event regulatory bodies amend existing regulations.

ASSOCIATION PERCENTAGE, AND TAXATION/LEVY

The Woodbine Entertainment Group deducts and retains the following percentages from wagers placed at our own licensed sites which are then shared with the horsepeople, host and simulcast associations and the Ontario Racing Commission.

WOODBINE MOHAWK LIVE: Win, Place & Show: 13.65%. Swinger 14.7%. Trifecta & Pick 4: 21.7%. Double & Exacta 17.2%. Jackpot Hi-5, Pick 5 & Pick 6: 11.7%. All other 23.0%

Horsepeople receive a further 2% on all wagers, except Trifecta wagering where it is 4%. The Ontario Provincial Government retains 0.5% on all bets placed in Ontario. The Canadian Government (through a revolving fund cost recovery basis) retains 0.8% on all wagers placed in Canada for provision of drug control, and audit services.
