Betting Basics

Some essentials to get you started with making a wager.

1 How to wager



Place your bet by visiting a teller, or using a self-serve terminal.

To place a bet here are just 5 things you need to know:

- 1 Name of racetrack (choose from any track in the simulcast feeds)
- 2 Number of the race
- 3 Amount of your bet (e.g. \$2)
- 4 Type of bet (see step 2)
- 5 Horse's number (see step 4)

Once you have decided what you want to bet, head to the nearest seller's window and use the sample statement as your guide:

Hello, (Racetrack), race 6, \$2 to WIN on Horse #4

How to use a self-serve terminal:

- 1 Swipe your Cash Card/Insert Cash
- 2 Enter the initial PIN #1234 (then choose a new PIN)
- 3 Press/Tap the track you would like to bet: (defaults to current race)
- 4 Tap the Horse Number: **#4**
- 5 Press/Tap the Bet Type: **WIN**
- 6 Press/Tap the Bet Amount: **\$2**
- 7 Press/Tap the Race Number: **Race #6**
- 8 Press Green **"Make BET"** button
- 9 Press/Tap the **"Finish with Receipt"** button
- 10 Be sure to check your ticket to confirm it's the bet you wanted

To get a Cash Card or for assistance ask a teller, or a staff member.

2 Types of bets



Single horse bets (minimum \$2.00 bet is required)

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Win	U U U	Your horse must finish 1st; payoff determined by the win odds.
Place	U U	Your horse must finish 1st or 2nd; payoffs better than to show.
Show	U	Your horse must finish 1st, 2nd, or 3rd; modest payoffs.

Exotic multiple-horse bets

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Exacta*	U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st and 2nd in exact order; riskier bet that can pay a little or a lot, depending on the horses' odds.
Daily double	U U U U U	Pick the winners of two designated consecutive races.
Pick 3, Win 4, Pick 5, Pick 6	U U U U U U	Select the winners of a designated set of consecutive races. The wager must be made prior to the start of the first race in the multi-race wager.
Triactor*	U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in exact order; can be expensive to play if you use a lot of horses.
Superfecta*	U U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th; big payoff possible.

* Exotic bets require the horses to finish in the EXACT order you select, unless you "BOX" the bet, in which case your selections can finish in any order.

All of the numbers and letters in the program might seem confusing or overwhelming at first, but focusing on these sections makes choosing a horse simple.

- Horse's number in the race
- Horse's post position colour
- Horse's colour, sex, age, sire (father), dam (mother), sire of the dam
- Morning line odds
- Horse's name
- Driver and Driver Record (Name, # of wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, winning %)

- Trainer information
- Horse's Lifetime record (with best win time, track size, track, age, lifetime wins and lifetime earnings)
- Horse's current record (# of races, # wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, and money earned)

4 The odds



Odds are also important to consider when choosing your horse. Horses that are thought to have a better chance of winning will typically have lower odds.

Morning line odds

Odds listed in the race program are the "morning line" odds. These are predictions of how the public will bet on the race. They are set by the track's handicapper when the race program is published, before the wagering starts.

The actual odds will be posted on the **Television** or in-field on the **Tote Board** before the race; they change up until post time, depending on how customers are betting on each horse in the race.

Calculating a \$2 win prize

To calculate a win prize, find the Odds of a horse on the **Television** or **Tote Board** (in-field board).

Multiply the first number by 2, then divide that number by the second digit (if there is one), and then add \$2. Simple as that!

Odds	1/2	2/1	7/2	5/1	10/1

Helpful facts for betting

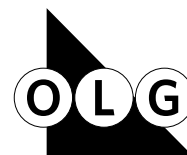
- Some racetracks have a television simulcast commentator who tries to identify winning horses (handicaps) between the races. Listen and see if you can pick up any good tips to bet on.
- A good betting method is to choose horses with current odds two to three times higher than their morning line odds.

3 Tips to remember

WIN BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 32% of the time
PLACE BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 53% of the time
SHOW BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 67% of the time

#6 KENOGAMI MAT has had two starts and he broke stride in both races in the stretch. In his debut, it appeared he broke when trying hard to keep up to the leading big favorite. In his second start, racing over a wet track, he jumped it off after tipping off cover in the stretch when it seemed sure he would be no worse than second had he stayed flat. He requalified four days after that second start, adding trotting hobbles, and he looked good. He was full of himself at the start and tore off to a big lead but then rated kindly in the middle half. He accelerated late but was overtaken by the pocket sitter who kicked in 27 4/5 to get the win. He looked sure gaited throughout the mile and now he draws the best post for his first start for a purse while deploying the trotting hobbles. Assuming he stays flat, he has a decent shot to break his maiden in this opening leg of the guaranteed \$75,000 Pick 5.

#2 GREEN MANS JOY brings a 0 for 13 record to the track tonight, but she has raced well in all three of her starts this year, and she is clearly getting faster and closer to breaking her maiden. She comes off a good front end effort where she made all the pace before getting passed in the lane by the 4 to 5 favorite, who simply got too good of a trip to be denied. She will likely be positioned on or near the front again tonight. She won't be denied her maiden win for much longer, and she would be no surprise in this spot.

#4 ANGELIC is another improving filly that has been getting closer every week. The three-race pattern shows her improving from fourth to third to second leading up to this fourth start of the year. Last week, she trotted what would typically be a winning mile at this level, but there was one rival that produced a wicked 27 1/5 kicker to get past her. That was the only one in the race that was close to Angelic at the wire. This Archangel sophomore is dangerous coming off that sharp effort, and she is another one to consider in the opening leg of the Pick 5.

#3 BANKS A MILLION is 0 for 14, but she has taken six slices from those 14 starts. The only race from her four starts where she hasn't finished in the top four this year came when she drew post nine. She will likely take another good following trip tonight and land in the bottom of the Tri or Super.

Race 2 Selections

The Horseplayer's Journal by Garnet Barnsdale

#1 DEDICATION took a dead-heated win at first asking last week as the 2 to 5 choice in a race where things got interesting in the stretch when the filly that was challenging first-over veered out at the head of the lane and made a bad break, causing some of the field to scatter. Dedication avoided the confusion and came on late to hit the line in unison with a rival that was able to escape the pylons because of the break. She behaved professionally considering she was following fairly closely behind the breaker. She draws the rail again, but she now has some experience starting from that post. She gets the call to repeat.

#5 MY GELATO made a wide move starting at the entry to the far turn last week that was eye catching until she made it up to second from tenth, then simply ran out of gas in mid stretch. That followed a start two weeks ago where she tried racing first-over against a very strong leader that was never getting caught. She gets post relief here, and when she started from post five three starts back, she roared home for third, unleashing a 26-flat kicker. She shows a couple of races last year where she left the gate quickly, and I could see her leaving for position in this field tonight. She seems like the one most likely to upset the top pick.

#3 AMERICAN STARLIGHT was affected worse than Dedication by the breaker in that race last week. She was directly following that rival around the last turn and into the stretch, looking like she was poised to strike from her second-over position when the rival veered out and made that break. This mare was forced to swing wide to ensure her safety. That allowed Dedication to push through and commence her late charge. This one stayed game while racing wide down the stretch and stayed for third. It's a bit of a hard sell to think she will break her maiden here as a five-year-old after she has had 43 unsuccessful tries, but she would have been right there last week if the mile was raced clean without that incident at the top of the stretch.

#6 FLUID gets off the rail here and she should be able to leave for position in the top three easier starting from the best post. She seems to be improving, and she should sit a decent following trip in this spot and stick around for a share. She is a good one to use on the bottom of Tri and Super bets.

#4 ROCHESTER FLASH took a new life's mark here last week, and he beat five of tonight's eight rivals in the process. He got a great trip, but he helped make his own luck by blasting straight to the front leaving the gate which ensured that he was positioned close to the lead throughout the mile. After getting shuffled to the position of the third one racing on the rail following some leadership changes, he slipped off the pylons turning for home, then angled to the far outside. From there, he kicked into high gear and chased down a loose leader to earn the new speed badge. He is sharp and it's possible he could race from the pocket tonight. He is the one to beat and he gets the call to repeat.

#8 BRUDON popped and stopped here on May 1st in his first start ever for a tag. He understandably adds Lasix off that mile, but more interestingly, he also adds leading driver James Macdonald. He drove him to a series sweep in the Ontario Harvest series here last November and a win in a preliminary leg of the Valedictory series. It's possible he could wake this McWicked gelding up tonight. He is worth a look at a price.

#6 JIMMY WHISPERS did all the work last week, cutting the mile after touching down on the front just past the quarter. He set a strong pace, put away the pocket sitter and looked like a winner at the head of the stretch. But then Rochester Flash appeared on the far outside full of pace, and it became apparent at the tote board that he was not going to hold him off. That was a sharp effort, and it wouldn't be surprising if he turned the tables tonight. But it's also a bit concerning that he finished second for the eighth time in 17 starts versus only one win this year after he won five of 27 last year. I wouldn't take a short price here.

#9 ON TIME DELIVERY made a bold last turn move last week on Jimmy Whispers that eventually fizzled out, but he did stick around for third. He tries hard every week, and he makes his second start off the Carmen Auciello claim tonight, but he has his work cut out starting from the widest post and a small share is likely for him tonight.

#2 TEMPTING was one that was called to win from post 10 here on May 1st, and she took plenty of action at the windows, considering that she drew the 10-hole. It turned out she had no chance, but not through any fault of her own. She left the gate hard with intent to make front, and a rival that she was following in the two-path heading to the quarter broke and interfered with her. That caused her to break, and she was taken out of the race. She showed on April 24th that she has the speed to be one of the main contenders in this field. I'll stick with her in this short field where she should get a clean trip. She gets the nod to kick off the 20-Cent Pick 6.

#7 YS FLOWERNUMBERTEN was in front coming off the final turn last week when she veered out a couple of lanes then got funky gaited and made a bad break which scattered the field. She was in the midst of a second move in the race and had forged to the front first-over prior to that miscue. She brings a 0 for 14 record to the track tonight, but she is one of the best ones in here. She just needs to behave to have a big shot at taking her maiden win. She gets the leading drive back in the bike tonight and he drove her to three straight second place finishes in April. She should be right there if she stays flat.

#1 WHO ARE YOU has started her sophomore season off well, taking two shares and passing horses in both starts. She has now landed in the top three in half of her starts, and she fits well versus these. My concern is that she draws the rail again, and she will once again get too far back. I think she closes too late, and takes a small share here, rounding out either the Tri or the Super.

#3 MCJAZZ has form that you can't fault at this point. After getting her feet wet in her debut where she drew into the second tier and closed for fifth, she has taken a win, two seconds and a third in four starts. She made a very impressive third quarter brush and crush move to break her maiden in her most recent start at Flamboro Downs. She will need to drop a few seconds tonight to compete for the win, and I'm not sure that we'll see that kind of improvement tonight. I will use her underneath in this spot.

#8 SOUTHWIND CASPIAN was ready to roll for his sophomore debut last week and he trotted a mile that would be good enough to win most maiden races. Unfortunately for him, he came up against a well-regarded, sharp debutant who trotted a 27-flat final quarter to get past him late. That was a good effort, and this Grand Circuit placed Walner gelding should be able to boss this field and notch his maiden win in his 10th try. He would be a single for me on all multi-race tickets.

#4 P L STEVIE is impeccably bred, being by Canada's perennial leading trotting sire and out of a high-quality dam that earned close to \$700,000 and trotted several big miles over this track, including her 1:51 4/5 lifetime mark. This filly's connections won with two trotters on Monday night here. This filly qualified well, but she would need to drop at least five seconds tonight to challenge the top pick. It seems more likely that she will close to round out the Exacta in this pari-mutuel debut.

#1 HOBKNOB HANOVER typically finishes her miles off quickly, but she often finds herself too far back to make any kind of an impact. She kicked home in 27 4/5 last week, but she was out of contention at that point after starting from a wide post. She gets the rail tonight, and when she drew that post three starts back, she landed in mid pack at the start. If she could do that here, I could see her passing some of these late and getting a share. She is worth using on the bottom of Tris and Supers at what should be a good price tonight.

#2 BUDDIES DREAM is interesting here because of the sharp improvement that she made in her most recent qualifier on May 5th. After breaking in her first qualifier and showing little in the second one, the third time was the charm for this daughter of Il Sogno Dream. She marched right to the front from the tricky rail post then gave up command to a more seasoned rival that was intent on showing the way. She followed well in the lane, not losing any ground in a 28-flat final quarter. She can take a share in this debut mile.

#6 D A DREAM GIRL came out firing in her sophomore debut on May 1st, gamely digging in racing first-over to catch the loose leader right on the wire. She followed that up with a decent effort in a mile where she had little chance of passing them all from third-over when the final quarter was trotted in 27 4/5. She draws best now and she is obviously sharp. I think Jody Jamieson will take advantage of drawing the best post and put her into the race leaving the gate. If she gets positioned where I think she will early in this mile, she should be the one to beat. She gets the call to kick off the late Pick 5 that starts here.

#9 OCEANVIEW RUMOURS comes off a terrific rookie campaign where she took seven wins and two seconds in nine starts. After dominating on the Maritimes in the summer, winning seven straight – many in provincial stake races – after losing in her debut, she shipped west and didn't skip a beat. In her first local start, she took her 1:55 1/5 lifetime mark winning a leg of the Harvest series racing first up. Her May 9th qualifier where she finished second to double millionaire Emoticon Hanover's four-year-old half sister should have her primed for this three-year-old debut and she would be no surprise in this spot.

#2 P L SAPPHIRE came well prepared for her sophomore debut, and she took all the action at the windows, being sent off at 4 to 5 in a field of maidens. She got plugged into the pocket early and rode a perfect trip to the stretch, always looking like she was going to go by for the win. That 1:55 3/5 mark puts her in the conversation here despite the class rise, but I doubt that she will get that same golden trip leaving from the inside tonight. Her driver Bob McClure has been on fire recently. I prefer to use her underneath in this spot, however.

#1 IVY LYNNE compiled a decent record last year taking two wins and four other shares in 10 starts, including her mark of 1:57-flat taken over this track, but she has been slow to get going so far this year. She tried the SBOA elimination last week, which was likely a bit ambitious, but she only missed making the final by a length. I could see her doing better in this spot and landing in the bottom of the Tri or Super.

#6 SUPERIOR DELIGHT got back on the winning track last week just when the betting public abandoned her after losing two straight races as the favorite. She was bet down in those races because she had won five straight in this class previous to those starts. Last week, she went off as the second choice, and she won convincingly. After making front early, she gave up command to the 3 to 2 favorite. She followed to the final turn where she made her move on the leader, passed that rival, opened up, and sailed to the wire for her sixth win in her 12th start this season. She draws best and looks best tonight, and she is the clear mare to beat, but she will surely go off favored, likely as low as odds-on in this spot.

#1 GRAND CIRCUIT is worth a look here for the bottom of the Exacta based on last week's effort where she just missed second in a photo. After dropping to the back, she moved off the pylons on the final turn and she ended up fourth-over in the seven-horse field. Turning for home, she was steered to the far outside and she kicked into high gear, pacing the fastest final quarter in the race. She also finished third to Superior Delight here on April 17th. She likely won't get bet much because she had most of her success on the B tracks this year. She will be passing some rivals late again.

#7 ALLSMOKEANDMIRRORS has been a consistent performer at this \$20,000 conditioned claimer level IN 2025, taking two wins in six starts and never missing the top four racing at this class. Last week, she finished second to the choice, closing down the middle of the track in the stretch and nosing out Grand Circuit to preserve the runner up spot. She no doubt will be closing again tonight, and she should maintain her consistency with another top three finish.

#8 FOX VALLEY TATUM is another mare that has been consistent racing at this level taking a win, two seconds and three thirds in nine starts at this level while never missing a cheque. Last week, she got a good following trip and finished evenly between horses to take fourth. I don't expect her to be a threat to win starting from the widest post tonight, but she can land in the bottom of the Tri or Super at a price.

#7 WIFEY SAID SO was given a conservative drive and easy trip last week after being sent hard off the gate in 13 consecutive starts. She followed in last in a field of eight then stayed inside, cutting the corner, picking up a couple of spots. She then moved off the rail and rallied in close quarters while lacking a clear lane until deep stretch. That easy mile should have her set up for a big speed try from the wide post which tonight is the seven hole. Last time she was raced from the back on January 16th, she came back the following week, raced in her aggressively, and jogged by three and a half lengths. She will almost surely blast to the front tonight, and she will be the one to catch and beat.

#3 TAMARA HANOVER was bet down to 9 to 5 favorite last week, and she did produce a good closing effort, but she was too far back and passing them all from last wasn't going to work. She paced a similar mile two starts back and she kicked home in 27 1/5, which was likely the reason that she was chalk last week. She is certainly capable if she can lay closer early, but she has failed as the favorite in five of her last six starts, so I would suggest that she would be one to try to beat if she goes favored again in this spot, understanding that she could win if she gets a better trip that has her in striking range at the three quarter pole.

#4 DOLLYDAYDREAM could be the "now" mare in this \$20,000 conditioned claimer level. She came into last week's race off an impressive win at Flamboro Downs on May 4th where she passed them all from last. Granted, the late pace slowed considerably, but that isn't the typical type of trip that produces winners at the Dundas half miler. Last week, she sat in to the final turn where she found a seam and latched onto cover racing second-over. She pounced in the lane and drove away to a 13 to 1 upset win. Her price will likely drop tonight, but she is in with a decent chance to repeat.

#1 CORA CORA CORA got on a good roll racing in the \$8,000 claimers at Flamboro Downs and on April 20th, she was claimed by trainer Malik Smith for himself and a partner. She faces tougher tonight, but she is capable of improving off the claim. My issue is her stale date with her having missed three and a half weeks. I'll use her underneath tonight.

#5 STEELWHEEL HANOVER started to turn his form around three starts back when he made a decent late closing effort which was a big improvement over previous starts. He then blew up the tote board the following week, getting a nice second-over trip to blow up the tote board as a 35 to 1 bomb. Last week, he was sent postward at a generous 9 to 2 and he validated that his longshot win on May 1st was no fluke. Sitting fourth heading to the half, he was the first to move, and he produced a huge 27 1/5 third quarter to brush and crush his rivals. If he can come close to replicating that mile tonight, the rest will be racing for second.

#1 DIAMOND RYDER was part of a three-pronged battle for the lead on the first turn last week, and he made front then gave it up to the horse that was driving on from post 10. He then took a shuffle while Steelwheel Hanover was pacing off into the galaxy. He found room early in the stretch and closed gamely to just miss second. That was a good effort, and it's unlikely that he will get hooked up in a similar duel early in this mile. I can see him tripping out and completing the Exacta this time.

#2 ABOVE MYPAYGRADE was raced conservatively last week after being used hard and facing as the even money favorite the week before. He followed to the head of the lane where he had to briefly idle behind horses before swinging to the far outside. He closed best to get up for second, three quarters of a length ahead of Diamond Ryder. He will likely take a closing approach again tonight, probably laying closer to the front this time. He should be part of the Tri again.

#7 JOHNSTOWN JET changed barns two starts back and faced much easier competition at The Raceway in London, and got immediate positive results, crushing the field and paying the minimum \$2.10. He fired right back with a good effort to finish second in a decent conditioned race at Flamboro Downs. He will likely get sent to the front here, but he will likely have trouble keeping up to the top pick when that rival makes his move to the front. I think he finishes on the edges here.

#2 YS QUEEN BETH didn't finish in the top three in any of her four starts at two, but she did face some good rookies in many of those starts, and she did flash 27 4/5 late speed in two of them. She showed similar trot in the final quarter of her one qualifier in preparation for her sophomore debut last week, and that high late speed was turned up another notch racing for a purse for the first time in 2025. In a race where it looked like the leader was long gone, she was pointed to the middle of the track at the head of the lane and she got airborne late to catch that leader and notch a 12 to 1 upset. That was an impressive effort, and this isn't the toughest step up to non-winners of two. I'll give her the nod to score a repeat win, but she her odds will plummet tonight.

#7 CLARISSA W had a decent rookie season where she took one win and six slices in nine starts facing tougher horses than she meets here in many of her starts. Her two qualifiers signal that she is ready to roll in this sophomore debut. After being given an easy trip in her first qualifier on April 28th, she got serious a week later and she crushed her rivals racing on the engine and looking good trotting home in 28-flat. She is an obvious contender in this spot, and she should be the main threat to the choice.

#6 ROYAL MOON closed well to get third last week, and that was the best she was going to do considering that the top two had broken away from the field by the time they reached the stretch and were accelerating in the final quarter. She draws best now, and she picks up Billy Davis Jr. in the bike. I can see her getting a more aggressive drive tonight and that makes her an upset threat to consider in the final leg of the late Pick 4 and Pick 5.

#9 BEERSNSUNSHINE DEO has taken action at the windows in all three of her starts, and she raced her best last week when she trotted a 27 2/5 final quarter to get up for third. Unfortunately, she draws worst here which likely means she will be taken back again at the start. She can pass many of these late, and she is probably a good one to use on the bottom of Tri and Super bets in this spot.

#8 KADIDDLE typically drops to the back then passes as many rivals as she can in the back half. It's not unreasonable to expect that she will pass at least four of her rivals in this nine-horse field tonight. She is another one to consider using on the bottom in this spot.

CONDITIONS AND ALLOWANCES IN HARNESS RACING - IMPORTANT TO KNOW

The conditions of a race determine whether a horse is eligible to enter. For example many races are restricted to horses that have won a certain number of races or a certain amount of money in a specified number of starts. Many races are restricted to horses entered to be "claimed" (offered for sale) at a specific price.

Allowances in the claiming price itself are given to colts and geldings, four-year-olds and younger and to mares, five-year-olds and younger.

The purpose of the allowance is to keep younger horses more competitive when racing against older and more experienced rivals. Mares are given extra consideration in claiming events because of their potential as broodmares.

The accompanying chart shows what the allowances are, but an example may make them easier to understand. The chart indicates that three-year-olds receive a 50% allowance in claiming races. This means that a three-year-old entered in a \$20,000 claiming race carries an actual claiming price of \$30,000 (50% higher).

Fillies and mares receive an additional 25% allowance in claiming races. Details of the race conditions and claiming price (if any) are given at the top of each race in the program.

ALLOWANCES FOR PURSE EARNINGS

C.P.M.A. Regulation Changes

Effective January 1st 2012
CPMA will be instituting several new rule changes with regards to the following pari-mutuel pools:

- Pick Pools**
- If there are no winners in any leg of a Pick N pool, the entire pool is refunded.
 - If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners.
 - A pool is no longer refunded if the 1st leg in the pool is cancelled or declared no contest.
 - Pick-3: If at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.
 - Pick-4, 5 or 6: If at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.

EXPLANATION OF THE LASIX PROGRAM

After careful study and consultation with Ontario Horsemen's groups, racetrack operators and veterinarians, Agriculture Canada and the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario passed legislation allowing the controlled (or supervised) administration of furosemide, more commonly called "Lasix". "Lasix" is used to alleviate the symptoms of exercise induced pulmonary hemorrhaging in racing horses. Horses will undergo an endoscopic examination of the trachea by a veterinarian licensed by the Ontario Racing Commission and endorsed by an official veterinarian before being allowed on the medication list. Once qualified, horses will be treated with "Lasix" within four hours plus or minus 15 minutes of a scheduled race in a secure retention area under the super vision of racing officials. All horses on "Lasix" must remain on the program for a minimum of 100 days while racing in this jurisdiction.

RULES AND INFORMATION REGARDING CANADIAN HARNESS AND FOREIGN SEPARATE POOL EVENTS

GENERAL

All pari-mutuel pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with the regulations and directives as issued by Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada ("The Regulations"), under the approval and supervision of the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency. The Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency can be contacted at 1-800-268-8835 or 613-759-6100 or Email: cpmawebacpm@agr.gc.ca. A complete version of the CPMA regulations can be found at <http://laws-lois.justice.gc.ca/eng/regulations/SOR-91-365/>.

All tickets should be held until the result of the race is declared official and prices are posted.

No person under the age of 18 shall purchase or cash a ticket or voucher.

A claim of receiving an incorrect payment or incorrect change must be made to the Mutuel office of the association within twenty four hours of buying or cashing a valid ticket or voucher.

No ruling made by the Stewards/Judges or the Ontario Racing Commission with regard to distribution of purse money or the placing of horses in the order of finish, after the race has been declared official, shall have any bearing on the pay-out prices or distribution of pari-mutuel pools.

Change boards and Photo Finish display monitors are located in the Grandstand. In addition, Photo Finish pictures are shown on the closed-circuit television system. Customers are reminded that mutuel clerks are responsible for all shortages. When making a wager, customers must present sufficient funds at the time of purchase to cover the wagers requested.

ENTRIES AND MUTUEL FIELDS

"Entry" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled or considered as the same betting interest. The most common reason for the coupling of horses in an Entry is the fact that they are owned by the same person.

"Mutuel Field" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled because the number of horses in the race exceeds the number which can be handled separately by the pari-mutuel system. Subject to the Regulations, a bet on one horse of an Entry or Mutuel Field shall be considered a bet on all horses in that Entry or Mutuel Field.

DAILY DOUBLE BETTING (INCLUDING LATE DOUBLE)

A Daily Double bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of the two races specified for the Daily Double. Tickets not selecting the winner of the first half of the Daily Double and all tickets in the second half of the Daily Double not coupled with the declared official winner of the first half of the Daily Double are not winners and are not refunded no matter what circumstances affect the running of the second half of the Daily Double.

Should a horse or horses (not coupled with another starter) be excused from starting in the second race of the Daily Double after the first race of the Daily Double has closed for betting, holders of all Daily Double tickets on such horses, coupled with the winner of the first Daily Double race, shall participate in a Consolation Double pool. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

EXACTA (Also known as Exactor)/TRIFECTA (Also known as Triactor)/SUPERFECTA

An Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first two, three and four horses respectively, representing different betting interests to finish in the exact official order of finish, in the race on which the pool is operated.

SWINGER (Also known as OMNI)

A Swinger is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select horses to finish in any order from the official first 3 positions.

JACKPOT HI-5

A Jackpot Hi-5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners in the specified Jackpot Hi-5 race. If there are races that have an entry, (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B), Jackpot Hi-5 will not offer a wager consisting of both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in a Jackpot Hi-5, the payout would be 1st, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th.

That jackpot portion of the pool will only be paid out if there is a single winning ticket. If there are multiple winning tickets that have correctly chosen the first 5 runners of the race, they will receive 50% of the pool for that day. The other 50% will go over into the Jackpot carryover. If there are no winning tickets with the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners, 100% of the current day's pool will be carried over into the Jackpot.

PICK 3 & PICK 4 BETTING

The Pick 3 & Pick 4 bets are betting transactions in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of three or four successive races specified for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 respectively.

Winning tickets for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 are determined in the following sequence: A) winners of all legs, B) most winners, then refund. If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners. If there are no winners in any leg of a pool, the entire pool is refunded.

PICK 5 BETTING

The Pick 5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of five successive races specified for the Pick 5 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 5 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 5.

PICK 6 BETTING

The Pick 6 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of six successive races specified for the Pick 6 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 6 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 6.

PICK 5 & 6 BETTING

If at least 1 race as part of the Pick 5 or 6 has been cancelled or declared "No contest", but not more than the specified below under Refunds, the net pool shall be distributed to those selecting the most # of winners and NOT include any carryover from a previous pool.

PICK 3, PICK 4, PICK 5 & PICK 6 SCRATCHES

In the event a Pick 3, Pick 4, Pick 5 or Pick 6 ticket designates as a selection a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the Stewards/Judges to be a non-starter in any of the races comprising the Pick 3, Pick 4, Pick 5 or Pick 6 the favourite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection. In the event that the money bet in the win pool for two or more favourites is identical, the selection with the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non-starting selection.

However, if a scratch occurs in any leg of the Pick 3, Pick 4, Pick 5 or Pick 6 pools before the pool is closed, a ticket including the scratched horse may be cancelled.

REFUNDS

Subject to the Regulations, all monies in all pools on a race are refunded in the event that the race is cancelled, declared off or declared no contest, and all monies bet on a horse are refunded if the horse is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start. These refunds will be communicated to the public through various means such as betting terminals, video display, changes boards and our website.

The Pick(n) pool shall be cancelled and all Pick(n) wagers for the individual performance shall be refunded if:

- Pick-3: at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

Where a horse that is part of an Entry is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start and at least one horse of that Entry receives a fair start in the race, all tickets purchased on the Entry remain valid and the purchase price of any such ticket shall not be refunded.

COMMON POOL WAGERING (INTERTRACK BETTING)

In the unlikely event of a communications or computer system failure that prevents pools from merging with the host track's pools before the end of a race, CPMA regulations require that the site must refund all tickets for that race. This refund will be communicated to the public through various means such as video displays, change boards and messages on our website.

FAIR START

If a horse has reached the Fair Start Pole (located 200 feet before the Starting Pole) by the time the mobile gate has reached the Starting Pole, that horse is deemed to have had a fair start. It makes no difference whether or not the horse is on or off stride at that precise moment. Under current policy and regulations, which are designed to be as fair as possible to all bettors on all starters, there is no Recall - a repeat of the entire starting procedure - when a horse does not reach the Fair Start Pole before the gate reaches the Starting Pole. Monies bet on such a horse are refunded in accordance with the regulation concerning refunds.

LOST & OLD TICKETS

WEG issued tickets or vouchers are valid indefinitely, however, they cannot be cashed at a mutuel teller after 2 years from date of issue. Please mail tickets, along with your name and address, to Mutuel Manager, P.O. Box 156, Rexdale, Ontario, M9W 5L2, keeping a photocopy for future reference.

For "Lost Tickets" originally sold at a Woodbine Entertainment Group racetrack or Teletheatre, please enquire at the Mutuel office at Woodbine, Greenwood Teletheatre, or Mohawk. Policy may be subject to change retroactively in the event regulatory bodies amend existing regulations.

ASSOCIATION PERCENTAGE, AND TAXATION/LEVY

The Woodbine Entertainment Group deducts and retains the following percentages from wagers placed at our own licensed sites which are then shared with the horsepeople, host and simulcast associations and the Ontario Racing Commission.

WOODBINE MOHAWK LIVE: Win, Place & Show: 13.65%. Swinger 14.7%. Trifecta & Pick 4: 21.7%. Double & Exacta 17.2%. Jackpot Hi-5, Pick 5 & Pick 6: 11.7%. All other 23.0%

Horsepeople receive a further 2% on all wagers, except Trifecta wagering where it is 4%. The Ontario Provincial Government retains 0.5% on all bets placed in Ontario. The Canadian Government (through a revolving fund cost recovery basis) retains 0.8% on all wagers placed in Canada for provision of drug control, and audit services.
