Betting Basics

Some essentials to get you started with making a wager.

1 How to wager



Place your bet by visiting a teller, or using a self-serve terminal.

To place a bet here are just 5 things you need to know:

- 1 Name of racetrack (choose from any track in the simulcast feeds)
- 2 Number of the race
- 3 Amount of your bet (e.g. \$2)
- 4 Type of bet (see step 2)
- 5 Horse's number (see step 4)

Once you have decided what you want to bet, head to the nearest seller's window and use the sample statement as your guide:

Hello, (Racetrack), race 6, \$2 to WIN on Horse #4

How to use a self-serve terminal:

- 1 Swipe your Cash Card/Insert Cash
- 2 Enter the initial PIN #1234 (then choose a new PIN)
- 3 Press/Tap the track you would like to bet: (defaults to current race)
- 4 Tap the Horse Number: **#4**
- 5 Press/Tap the Bet Type: **WIN**
- 6 Press/Tap the Bet Amount: **\$2**
- 7 Press/Tap the Race Number: **Race #6**
- 8 Press Green **"Make BET"** button
- 9 Press/Tap the **"Finish with Receipt"** button
- 10 Be sure to check your ticket to confirm it's the bet you wanted

To get a Cash Card or for assistance ask a teller, or a staff member.

2 Types of bets



Single horse bets (minimum \$2.00 bet is required)

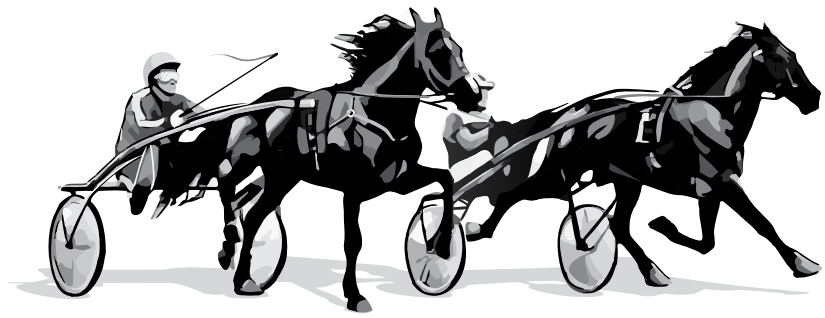
Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Win	U U U	Your horse must finish 1st; payoff determined by the win odds.
Place	U U	Your horse must finish 1st or 2nd; payoffs better than to show.
Show	U	Your horse must finish 1st, 2nd, or 3rd; modest payoffs.

Exotic multiple-horse bets

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Exacta*	U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st and 2nd in exact order; riskier bet that can pay a little or a lot, depending on the horses' odds.
Daily double	U U U U U	Pick the winners of two designated consecutive races.
Pick 3, Win 4, Pick 5, Pick 6	U U U U U U	Select the winners of a designated set of consecutive races. The wager must be made prior to the start of the first race in the multi-race wager.
Triactor*	U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in exact order; can be expensive to play if you use a lot of horses.
Superfecta*	U U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th; big payoff possible.

* Exotic bets require the horses to finish in the EXACT order you select, unless you "BOX" the bet, in which case your selections can finish in any order.

All of the numbers and letters in the program might seem confusing or overwhelming at first, but focusing on these sections makes choosing a horse simple.

- 1 Horse's number in the race
- 2 Horse's post position colour
- 3 Horse's colour, sex, age, sire (father), dam (mother), sire of the dam
- 4 Morning line odds
- 5 Horse's name
- 6 Driver and Driver Record (Name, # of wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, winning %)

- 7 Trainer information
- 8 Horse's Lifetime record (with best win time, track size, track, age, lifetime wins and lifetime earnings)
- 9 Horse's current record (# of races, # wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, and money earned)

4 The odds



Odds are also important to consider when choosing your horse. Horses that are thought to have a better chance of winning will typically have lower odds.

Morning line odds

Odds listed in the race program are the "morning line" odds. These are predictions of how the public will bet on the race. They are set by the track's handicapper when the race program is published, before the wagering starts.

The actual odds will be posted on the **Television** or in-field on the **Tote Board** before the race; they change up until post time, depending on how customers are betting on each horse in the race.

Calculating a \$2 win prize

To calculate a win prize, find the Odds of a horse on the **Television** or **Tote Board** (in-field board).

Multiply the first number by 2, then divide that number by the second digit (if there is one), and then add \$2. Simple as that!

Helpful facts for betting

- Some racetracks have a television simulcast commentator who tries to identify winning horses (handicaps) between the races. Listen and see if you can pick up any good tips to bet on.
- A good betting method is to choose horses with current odds two to three times higher than their morning line odds.

3 Tips to remember

WIN BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 32% of the time
PLACE BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 53% of the time
SHOW BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 67% of the time

Race 1 Selections

The Horseplayer's Journal by Garnet Barnsdale

#2 TEMPTING gets the top call to win in this journal for the third start in a row in the hopes that she will stay flay this time. She came into last week's race off a break in stride on May 1st, but not through any fault of her own. She left the gate hard with intent to make front, and a rival that she was following in the two-path heading to the quarter broke and interfered with her. That caused her to break, and she was taken out of the race. She was forgiven by the betting public last week and send off at even money, but she broke at the start. She showed on April 24th that she has the speed to contend here if she behaves. Louis-Phillipe Roy sticks with her tonight when he had other options and so will I. She gets the nod to kick off the \$50,000 guaranteed Pick 5.

#8 ITLL BE ALRIGHT improved sharply ast week and produced the best performance of her career to date in almost picking off a Millar Farms 1 to 5 shot to score a big upset. The Mike Bishop owned and trained sophomore daughter of Bettors Delight came with a strong first-over challenge in that mile and fell just a nose short of beating a filly that had already taken a win at the non-winners of one level in her debut the week before. This filly loses driver Roy to the top choice, but she is capable and she's worth a look for the opening leg of the Pick 5.

#7 WHO ARE YOU is another one that comes off an improved effort, chasing a dominant winner around the track in a fast mile for this class. She finished a clear second, but she never threatened the strong winner. She started much faster in that mile after closing from the back in her first two starts of the year to get shares in both races. She gets off the rail post after drawing it twice in a row and she is another that could do in here with the right trip.

#1 SARA B DELIGHT had only one start for a purse last year, and it was a decent effort where she finished third in a Prospect series race at Kawartha Downs. That debut mile was sandwiched in between two vet scratches due to sickness, and she never made another start after that July 19th debut. She tried to qualify in April over an off track in Quebec and she broke. Since then, she has qualified well, winning twice, but she will need to drop a few seconds tonight. I can see her racing well and taking a small share to kick off her sophomore season tonight.

#8 HEAD OF THE CLASS is interesting here to me based on his winning May 16th qualifier where he simply bottomed out the field in the third quarter. That mile is encouraging for his connections considering that he won nine races in 22 starts last year, but none of them came for them after they purchased him on September 12th. Him trotting a 55 4/5 middle half in that qualifier in May, and still having enough left to Grand Circuit winner Emoji Hanover should be a cause for optimism. The final quarter was only trotted in 32-flat, but that is understandable considering the blistering middle half, and he was under no urging in the stretch. The leading driver keeps the lines after steering him to that qualifying win, and he adds Lasix tonight. He might be able to bottom out this field.

#3 THE CANAM BANKER is the other one in here that will likely have designs on making the lead early in this race and it will be interesting to see if a cat-and-mouse game plays out with one of the two trotters willingly accepting the pocket with the intent to pounce on his rival on the last turn. I could see this one sitting the pocket then moving on Head Of The Class if he starts to tire on the last turn. He comes off a strong effort where he took a perfect pocket trip to beat him, and he is hard to leave off early Pick 5 tickets in this field.

#5 MISTER MAGIC comes off a good effort racing a class higher than this, and he is right there every time that he stays flat, it seems. Assuming he behaves, he will likely leave for position and sit a good trip racing close to the front throughout. He was a winner at this level four starts back and a close second two starts back, and he was raced aggressively in both starts. It's possible he could sit third and benefit from the top two engaging in battle at some point of this race, then rally late for the win. He is yet another Pick 5 possibility.

#1 SONOFAMILLIONAIRE had a decent 2024 season taking two wins and seven other slices from 13 starts, 12 of them raced at Kawartha Downs. He opened his 2025 campaign with a dominant win over that surface, now he tries the big track. He is also trying much tougher company in this race, and a small share is likely his ceiling here. He could sit a trip and sneak into the bottom of the Tri or Super.

#1 CAVIAR N CRACKERS shoots for a fifth straight win tonight, and a fourpeat at this Fillies and Mares Preferred level, and if she isn't currently the sharpest racehorse at Mohawk Park, she is very close to the top. The Team Hensley five-year-old won three in a row from April 25th to May 10th racing from the back and kicking home with tremendous late speed. Last week, she showed a new dimension, making a bold first-over move on the last turn then driving away from her rivals. She faces tougher in this spot with some higher profile returnees signed on, and that's fine. That means she should go off at a viable price again. She hasn't been sent postward as favorite in a race since last November. That trend could continue here, and she gets the nod to notch the six pack of wins.

#2 SYLVIA HANOVER had a decent but unspectacular (for her) four-year-old season where she earned close to a half million dollars on the strength of three wins, seven seconds, and two thirds in 17 starts, facing the best older pacing mares in North America for most of the season. One of those three wins came at this class level at this track in her final start of the season. She is a high-quality mare that is sure to take money based on her reputation. It's interesting to note that she started slow last year, finishing fourth then second in this class in her first two starts. She is likely gearing up for a second crack at the Roses Are Red stakes here on North America Cup night after finishing second to Twin B Joe Fresh last year. I'd proceed with caution here because she will likely be an underlay.

#3 CENTURY JAMILA has made seven starts in this top class since March 7th, and she hasn't missed the board once. There is no reason to expect that streak to get broken tonight in this six-horse field. Last week, she sat the pocket to the lane where she had to move out to get around the tiring leader. She came out and around then slid to Caviar N Crackers inside where she had a clear shot. She didn't threaten the winner, and she lost second in a photo. She should get another good trip here and take another share.

#4 SO MUCH MORE was the queen of this division locally for several years, and although she may have lost a step, she can still be formidable on her best day. She returns here gearing up to defend her title in the Forest City Pace at The Raceway in London next week. I assume then, she will drop back and look to finish this mile strong. I'll use her on the bottom.

#3 AARDIES MONEY N has improved in every start since she shipped overseas and landed at Mohawk Park, and she still incredibly has room for improvement because she tends to run in a bit in the stretch. Last week, she came into the race off a great effort where she made a quick brush to the lead two starts back then sealed the deal. Somehow, she went off at a generous 5 to 1 and she showed how silly that was by again making a lightning quick move to the front then leading all the way while not slowing down much. Her 1:50 3/5 lifetime mark that she took that night is the fastest in this field, and if she comes close to repeating it, she will be tough to beat in this good field of 10.

#1 CHARLOTTE STATION steps up to face non-winners of three tonight, but she couldn't have looked any better breaking her maiden, then crushing non-winners of two in her last start on May 16th. The \$300,000 Lexington buy was a bit of a disappointment at two for owner Determination, going winless in six starts and taking four slices. She is clearly a different racehorse as a sophomore, and if she can improve a bit again tonight, she can threaten the choice. She merits a look for early multi-race tickets.

#4 LANESIDE INCONTROL didn't start her career until she was three, but she made her connections patience pay off when she won four of her first five starts and finished in the top two in all of her first seven starts. Things went awry for her in the Harvest Series final where she was apparently sick, and she got distanced. Veteran trainer Brethour gave her one good qualifier over Kawartha Downs for her 2025 debut last week, and she was ready to fire. She ate up a lot of ground in the stretch to almost get up for the win while flying home in 26 1/5. That was the fastest mile she has paced in her career by more than a full second, and she should be a late threat tonight.

#7 SUNSHINE MAGIC did well last week to follow fast fractions then get past the tiring leader in the stretch and fend off the closers to take a 1:51 3/5 new life's mark. She is a hard trier that often gets overlooked by bettors because her capable trainer/driver isn't a regular on this circuit. I don't see her repeating in this field, but she can land in the Tri or Super at what should be a good price.

#8 COZ IM SPECIAL was a winner here two starts back when aggressively driven, then she got sick and missed three weeks. It wasn't hard to predict that she would get a conservative drive last week starting from post nine considering that time missed. She tried to rally in the back half last week, but she found herself racing fifth-over around the last turn. She closed willingly on the far outside passing a couple of rivals late in a mile that should serve as a good tightener for tonight's start. I think she will be leaving harder tonight to get positioned closer to the front and she gets the nod in this anchor leg of the early Pick 5.

#3 MISS DUTTON comes off a solid effort where she was simply beaten by a mare who produced a freakishly good effort. Starting from post nine in that race, this Jeff Gillis trainee was sent forward leaving the gate and she touched down on the lead past the quarter, but that only lasted a split second because Aardies Money N was coming three-wide to assume command. That rival went on to lead all the way from there while pacing a wicked 1:50 3/5 mile. Miss Dutton was edged late for second by the 4 to 5 favorite, but she was well clear in third. A similar aggressive approach could work here in a mile that is likely to go in closer to 1:52 than 1:50 and she is worth a look for early multi-race tickets.

#5 ALABAMA HANNAH comes off a solid effort at this class level at a big price after stepping up off a winning effort vs. lesser two starts back. Last week, she took a following trip, found a lane to close from in the stretch, then gained ground quickly in the final sixteenth to finish a narrowly beaten third. She has hit her best stride in those two races and Billy Davis Jr. has been a good partner for her. She can close for another share in this spot.

#7 CHIEFS DREAM GIRL dropped to this class level – where she typically performs well – last week, but unfortunately drew the worst post. She dropped to the back and tried to rally, and she was only a half length behind the top pick in this race at the wire. She should get positioned better at the start by default getting off post 10, and she should pass a few of these late to finish on the edges. She can land in the bottom of the Tri or the Super.

#5 SIDE EFFECTS opened her 2025 season with a race over Kawartha Downs that should serve as a perfect tightener for this second start. Facing a field of males with her trainer in the bike, she dropped to the back leaving the gate then she made a wide move around the final turn, passing five of those male rivals to finish fourth in a good effort. She took her 1:55 4/5 mark here last summer when she was raced aggressively. She gets catch driver Trevor Henry in the bike tonight, and I expect her to be sent forward leaving the gate. She gets top call in this opening leg of the late Pick 5.

#6 DUCHESS DEO took a fast mark here last September before heading to Kentucky for some stakes action and she did take a cheque in one of those starts against some classier and faster fillies. She too had a sophomore debut that should serve as a nice tightener where she passed a couple of rivals in a fast mile for non-winners of two pacing fillies. She draws the magic six hole now and that should mean that she will get a much more aggressive steer from Billy Davis Jr tonight. She could be the one to catch here in a field where she fits well, and she is the other one that I would consider using in the late Pick 5.

#1 TOPVILLE CHECKMEIN already has three wins this year, the first of which came here on January 3rd when she broke her maiden. Last week she moved from the worst post in her previous start to the best one, and she raced aggressively trying to lead all the way. She tired late but it wasn't a bad effort. The second-place finisher from that race has already come back to win a Grassroots event. This filly can sit a trip and take a share tonight.

#2 CALL YOU UP, a \$245,000 Harrisburg purchase, showed a little promise at two, winning her second start at his track in 1:55 3/5. Her qualifier and first start of the season don't inspire a ton of confidence, but she can be better tonight if she stays flat, and she is capable of hitting the board versus these starting from an inside post. She could be a good one to use on the bottom of the Tri and Super here.

#10 TELLS ON A ROLL has had three starts against the best older pacing mares on the grounds, picking up two small checks, and missing getting a cheque last week facilitates this multi-level class drop. She is fast and classy, and if she faced this field last summer when she was at her sharpest, she would probably win by a pole. She will have to overcome post 10 tonight, but she has shown that she has the gate speed required to do just that. She should be able to clear these by the time she reaches the quarter pole and continue on and take her first win of 2025 in this fourth start.

#9 LYONS BETTORDAY contested the same three races in the top class that the choice comes out of, finishing behind that rival twice, and beating her last week. Making the same class drop as the choice, she too will likely get sent forward leaving the gate, and she could spend much of this mile racing in the choice's pocket. The last time she raced this low, this mare made a third quarter brush to the front and held that lead to the wire. She figures to be the main threat to Tells On A Roll tonight, and she is the other one that I would consider using on late multi-race tickets including the Pick 4 that starts here.

#1 RAPTORS WON is yet another that drops from the top class and we already know that this is a good class level for her because she was a big winner at this level two starts back. The rail post probably isn't a big issue for her because she has good gate speed. The bigger problem will likely be the two mares lined up on the outside of the gate. I prefer to use this mare underneath, but I also think that there is a trip that could unfold that could result in her scoring the upset. She is a feasible inclusion on deep multi-race tickets.

#6 STYLE FOR A MILE stepped up to this class level on May 10th coming off a win versus lesser two starts back. Starting from the rail in that May 10th race, she probably got further back early than she wanted to be, and she rallied for third, following winner Raptors Won. She now moves from the rail to the best post, and she can get better position early in this mile. It is probably a big ask to expect her to beat all of the three mares picked ahead of her tonight. Another small share is likely for her.

#5 SEA LIFE HANOVER did most of the work last week, and he was probably unlucky in defeat as the favorite. After making a middle move to the front, he maintained a strong pace to ensure that he kept a clear lead to the stretch. He opened up his lead in early stretch and looked good to go. In mid stretch, the second choice – who had sat in for the entire mile to that point – got clearance and closed rapidly in the final sixteenth to catch him. He looks best in here, and a similarly aggressive drive can get him his second win tonight.

#3 SHADOW OF AN ANGEL will get a lot of attention at the windows tonight because of the sharp improvement he showed in his second start last week. After starting fourth, he was kept inside, and he got shuffled back to sixth midway on the last turn seemingly out of contention. He found room along the pylons and started to close as the field turned for home. He angled four wide in mid stretch to hunt the three leaders, and he got up for second, closing on the winning favorite late. That was a fast mile, and his 26-flat kicker stands out on the page. He will likely be the one to fend off late.

#7 SILKY CHOICE exits the same race as Shadow Of An Angel, and like that rival, he will get some attention here because he paced a sub-1:52 mile in defeat. After making a middle move to the lead, he was confronted by the favorite on the final turn, and he dug in and raced that rival right to the wire, only getting picked off for second by Shadow Of An Angel for second in deep stretch. He is the third contender in here with a chance in a race that could be decided by trip and pace.

#9 NOVA BLU is in the mix every week, but he can't seem to get over the hump. He comes out of a race where he finished a close fourth, but he had two of tonight's rivals in front of him at the wire after getting a good trip. He draws widest now, and he will probably look to find a spot in mid pack early and look to pass some rivals late. I will use him underneath in this spot.

#5 EYES OF JUSTICE races better when he is aggressive at the start and kind find a position near the lead to rally from later in the mile. He stepped up to this optional \$30,000 claiming level last week after winning with a \$20,00 tag, and he raced decently in defeat. After floating out from the best post then finding a spot to drop into on the opening turn, he stayed in and took a shuffle around the far turn. He did find a lane in the stretch, and he closed willingly between horses to get fourth at 13 to 1. He draws another good post tonight, and he should get sent forward leaving the gate. I'll give him a slight nod in a race with no standout.

#2 FLIRTY DANCER makes her fifth start of the year still looking for her first top three finish, and she should get her best result of 2025 in this easier spot. She comes out of a race where she faced tougher than she meets tonight, and she tried hard, trotting a 28-flat kicker in defeat while finishing fourth. The late speed that she showed in her previous two starts makes her a top contender in this field. If she gets a clean trip and clear sailing tonight, she should be right there.

#1 CADILLAC MOON flashes speed every week, and he could get a great following trip here without having to exert a lot of energy in the opening half. Last week, he tired from his efforts to keep up to leader Truffles Too, who tried to bottom out the field. In his previous start, he finished second to Devils Wish, who then came back to win in the tougher non-winners of \$9,000 last five class. This gelding can be a good one to use underneath here because he won't get bet much and he could sit a nice trip and stick around for a share.

#8 RADIO LAB was expected to get the job done on the class drop on May 12th after closing in 27 2/5 at this class level two starts back. He got a clear lead early, cut a reasonable pace, and looked good at the three quarter pole. But he couldn't see it through, and he could only muster a 30 4/5 kicker after doing all the work. His price will skyrocket tonight, and he will likely drop back from his outside post and look to pass some rivals late. He could sneak into the bottom of the Tri or Super at a big price if he can close like he did two starts back.

I'll take a price stab with this mare in a wide-open anchor leg of the late Pick 5 and Pick 4.

#2 MIST AMBER will likely get some attention at the windows tonight simply because she showed something for the first time this year last week after getting trounced in her previous three starts. She also gets to drop to the bottom conditioned level, so it's logical to assume that she will contend for a win for the first time this year. She shows no early speed in her recent lines, but that doesn't mean that she can't leave quickly. In her final start of 2024, she was sent straight to the front in an optional \$50,000 claiming race and she made a second move in the race ultimately finishing second. She would be no surprise tonight, but she can get over bet here.

#3 LOVE ON ME scored a big upset in the Blizzard series final on February 7th, and she hasn't won since. There is reason to believe that she could end that streak tonight, however. Two starts back when racing at this level, she finished third to two class droppers that stood out and both closed under 2 to 1. She followed that up with another decent effort in a fast race when facing tougher last week. She will probably be the one to fend off late tonight.

#7 CHELSIS CHOICE has improved in her last two starts and she has a strong late kick on her best day. This is an easier non-winners of \$3,000 last five class than she faced in her most recent start that was dominated by two class droppers. She can come on late and take a share in this spot and she is a good one to use on the bottom of the Tri and Super.

#4 TWIN B TIPSTER is a veteran of the racing wars that has fallen on hard times recently, being forced to requalify after breaking stride in two straight starts. She had a productive 2024 campaign but has only hit the board once this year. Her qualifier on May 16th was okay, and she could sneak into the bottom of the High-5 or Super here at a price.

CONDITIONS AND ALLOWANCES IN HARNESS RACING - IMPORTANT TO KNOW

The conditions of a race determine whether a horse is eligible to enter. For example many races are restricted to horses that have won a certain number of races or a certain amount of money in a specified number of starts. Many races are restricted to horses entered to be "claimed" (offered for sale) at a specific price.

Allowances in the claiming price itself are given to colts and geldings, four-year-olds and younger and to mares, five-year-olds and younger.

The purpose of the allowance is to keep younger horses more competitive when racing against older and more experienced rivals. Mares are given extra consideration in claiming events because of their potential as broodmares.

The accompanying chart shows what the allowances are, but an example may make them easier to understand. The chart indicates that three-year-olds receive a 50% allowance in claiming races. This means that a three-year-old entered in a \$20,000 claiming race carries an actual claiming price of \$30,000 (50% higher).

Fillies and mares receive an additional 25% allowance in claiming races. Details of the race conditions and claiming price (if any) are given at the top of each race in the program.

ALLOWANCES FOR PURSE EARNINGS

When Fillies/Mares compete against Colts/Geldings (normally on the trot) Fillies/Mares will receive an additional 25% on the condition of the race. ie: nw \$5,000 (FM \$6,250) last 5 or \$12,000 (FM \$15,000) last 10 starts.

C.P.M.A. Regulation Changes

Effective January 1st 2012

CPMA will be instituting several new rule changes with regards to the following pari-mutuel pools:

Pick Pools

- If there are no winners in any leg of a Pick N pool, the entire pool is refunded.
- If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners.
- A pool is no longer refunded if the 1st leg in the pool is cancelled or declared no contest.
- Pick-3: If at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: If at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.

EXPLANATION OF THE LASIX PROGRAM

After careful study and consultation with Ontario Horsemen's groups, racetrack operators and veterinarians, Agriculture Canada and the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario passed legislation allowing the controlled (or supervised) administration of furosemide, more commonly called "Lasix". "Lasix" is used to alleviate the symptoms of exercise induced pulmonary hemorrhaging in racing horses. Horses will undergo an endoscopic examination of the trachea by a veterinarian licensed by the Ontario Racing Commission and endorsed by an official veterinarian before being allowed on the medication list. Once qualified, horses will be treated with "Lasix" within four hours plus or minus 15 minutes of a scheduled race in a secure retention area under the super vision of racing officials.

All horses on "Lasix" must remain on the program for a minimum of 100 days while racing in this jurisdiction.

- (L)** Denotes horses treated with Lasix for their last start but not so treated today.

RULES AND INFORMATION REGARDING CANADIAN HARNESS AND FOREIGN SEPARATE POOL EVENTS

GENERAL

All pari-mutuel pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with the regulations and directives as issued by Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada ("The Regulations"), under the approval and supervision of the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency. The Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency can be contacted at 1-800-268-8835 or 613-759-6100 or Email: cpmawebacpm@agr.gc.ca. A complete version of the CPMA regulations can be found at <http://laws-lois.justice.gc.ca/eng/regulations/SOR-91-365/>.

All tickets should be held until the result of the race is declared official and prices are posted.

No person under the age of 18 shall purchase or cash a ticket or voucher.

A claim of receiving an incorrect payment or incorrect change must be made to the Mutuel office of the association within twenty four hours of buying or cashing a valid ticket or voucher.

No ruling made by the Stewards/Judges or the Ontario Racing Commission with regard to distribution of purse money or the placing of horses in the order of finish, after the race has been declared official, shall have any bearing on the pay-out prices or distribution of pari-mutuel pools.

Change boards and Photo Finish display monitors are located in the Grandstand. In addition, Photo Finish pictures are shown on the closed-circuit television system. Customers are reminded that mutuel clerks are responsible for all shortages. When making a wager, customers must present sufficient funds at the time of purchase to cover the wagers requested.

ENTRIES AND MUTUEL FIELDS

"Entry" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled or considered as the same betting interest. The most common reason for the coupling of horses in an Entry is the fact that they are owned by the same person.

"Mutuel Field" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled because the number of horses in the race exceeds the number which can be handled separately by the pari-mutuel system. Subject to the Regulations, a bet on one horse of an Entry or Mutuel Field shall be considered a bet on all horses in that Entry or Mutuel Field.

DAILY DOUBLE BETTING (INCLUDING LATE DOUBLE)

A Daily Double bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of the two races specified for the Daily Double. Tickets not selecting the winner of the first half of the Daily Double and all tickets in the second half of the Daily Double not coupled with the declared official winner of the first half of the Daily Double are not winners and are not refunded no matter what circumstances affect the running of the second half of the Daily Double.

Should a horse or horses (not coupled with another starter) be excused from starting in the second race of the Daily Double after the first race of the Daily Double has closed for betting, holders of all Daily Double tickets on such horses, coupled with the winner of the first Daily Double race, shall participate in a Consolation Double pool. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

EXACTA (Also known as Exactor)/TRIFECTA (Also known as Tractor)/SUPERFECTA

An Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first two, three and four horses respectively, representing different betting interests to finish in the exact official order of finish, in the race on which the pool is operated.

SWINGER (Also known as OMNI)

A Swinger is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select horses to finish in any order from the official first 3 positions.

JACKPOT HI-5

A Jackpot Hi-5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners in the specified Jackpot Hi-5 race. If there are races that have an entry, (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B), Jackpot Hi-5 will not offer a wager consisting of both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in a Jackpot Hi-5, the payout would be 1st, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th.

That jackpot portion of the pool will only be paid out if there is a single winning ticket. If there are multiple winning tickets that have correctly chosen the first 5 runners of the race, they will receive 50% of the pool for that day. The other 50% will go over into the Jackpot carryover. If there are no winning tickets with the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners, 100% of the current day's pool will be carried over into the Jackpot.

PICK 3 & PICK 4 BETTING

The Pick 3 & Pick 4 bets are betting transactions in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of three or four successive races specified for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 respectively.

Winning tickets for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 are determined in the following sequence: A) winners of all legs, B) most winners, then refund. If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners. If there are no winners in any leg of a pool, the entire pool is refunded.

PICK 5 BETTING

The Pick 5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of five successive races specified for the Pick 5 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 5 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 5.

PICK 6 BETTING

The Pick 6 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of six successive races specified for the Pick 6 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 6 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 6.

PICK 5 & 6 BETTING

If at least 1 race as part of the Pick 5 or 6 has been cancelled or declared "No contest", but not more than the specified below under Refunds, the net pool shall be distributed to those selecting the most # of winners and NOT include any carryover from a previous pool.

PICK 3, PICK 4, PICK 5 & PICK 6 SCRATCHES

In the event a Pick 3, Pick 4, Pick 5 or Pick 6 ticket designates as a selection a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the Stewards/Judges to be a non-starter in any of the races comprising the Pick 3, Pick 4, Pick 5 or Pick 6 the favourite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection. In the event that the money bet in the win pool for two or more favourites is identical, the selection with the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non-starting selection.

However, if a scratch occurs in any leg of the Pick 3, Pick 4, Pick 5 or Pick 6 pools before the pool is closed, a ticket including the scratched horse may be cancelled.

REFUNDS

Subject to the Regulations, all monies in all pools on a race are refunded in the event that the race is cancelled, declared off or declared no contest, and all monies bet on a horse are refunded if the horse is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start. These refunds will be communicated to the public through various means such as betting terminals, video display, changes boards and our website.

The Pick(n) pool shall be cancelled and all Pick(n) wagers for the individual performance shall be refunded if:

- Pick-3: at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

Where a horse that is part of an Entry is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start and at least one horse of that Entry receives a fair start in the race, all tickets purchased on the Entry remain valid and the purchase price of any such ticket shall not be refunded.

COMMON POOL WAGERING (INTERTRACK BETTING)

In the unlikely event of a communications or computer system failure that prevents pools from merging with the host track's pools before the end of a race, CPMA regulations require that the site must refund all tickets for that race. This refund will be communicated to the public through various means such as video displays, change boards and messages on our website.

FAIR START

If a horse has reached the Fair Start Pole (located 200 feet before the Starting Pole) by the time the mobile gate has reached the Starting Pole, that horse is deemed to have had a fair start. It makes no difference whether or not the horse is on or off stride at that precise moment. Under current policy and regulations, which are designed to be as fair as possible to all bettors on all starters, there is no Recall - a repeat of the entire starting procedure - when a horse does not reach the Fair Start Pole before the gate reaches the Starting Pole. Monies bet on such a horse are refunded in accordance with the regulation concerning refunds.

LOST & OLD TICKETS

WEG issued tickets or vouchers are valid indefinitely, however, they cannot be cashed at a mutuel teller after 2 years from date of issue. Please mail tickets, along with your name and address, to Mutuel Manager, P.O. Box 156, Rexdale, Ontario, M9W 5L2, keeping a photocopy for future reference.

For "Lost Tickets" originally sold at a Woodbine Entertainment Group racetrack or Teletheatre, please enquire at the Mutuel office at Woodbine, Greenwood Teletheatre, or Mohawk. Policy may be subject to change retroactively in the event regulatory bodies amend existing regulations.

ASSOCIATION PERCENTAGE, AND TAXATION/LEVY

The Woodbine Entertainment Group deducts and retains the following percentages from wagers placed at our own licensed sites which are then shared with the horsepeople, host and simulcast associations and the Ontario Racing Commission.

WOODBINE MOHAWK LIVE: Win, Place & Show: 13.65%. Swinger 14.7%. Trifecta & Pick 4: 21.7%. Double & Exacta 17.2%. Jackpot Hi-5, Pick 5 & Pick 6: 11.7%. All other 23.0%

Horsepeople receive a further 2% on all wagers, except Trifecta wagering where it is 4%. The Ontario Provincial Government retains 0.5% on all bets placed in Ontario. The Canadian Government (through a revolving fund cost recovery basis) retains 0.8% on all wagers placed in Canada for provision of drug control, and audit services.
