Betting Basics

Some essentials to get you started with making a wager.

1 How to wager



Place your bet by visiting a teller, or using a self-serve terminal.

To place a bet here are just 5 things you need to know:

- 1 Name of racetrack (choose from any track in the simulcast feeds)
- 2 Number of the race
- 3 Amount of your bet (e.g. \$2)
- 4 Type of bet (see step 2)
- 5 Horse's number (see step 4)

Once you have decided what you want to bet, head to the nearest seller's window and use the sample statement as your guide:

Hello, (Racetrack), race 6, \$2 to WIN on Horse #4

How to use a self-serve terminal:

- 1 Swipe your Cash Card/Insert Cash
- 2 Enter the initial PIN #1234 (then choose a new PIN)
- 3 Press/Tap the track you would like to bet: (defaults to current race)
- 4 Tap the Horse Number: **#4**
- 5 Press/Tap the Bet Type: **WIN**
- 6 Press/Tap the Bet Amount: **\$2**
- 7 Press/Tap the Race Number: **Race #6**
- 8 Press Green **"Make BET"** button
- 9 Press/Tap the **"Finish with Receipt"** button
- 10 Be sure to check your ticket to confirm it's the bet you wanted

To get a Cash Card or for assistance ask a teller, or a staff member.

2 Types of bets



Single horse bets (minimum \$2.00 bet is required)

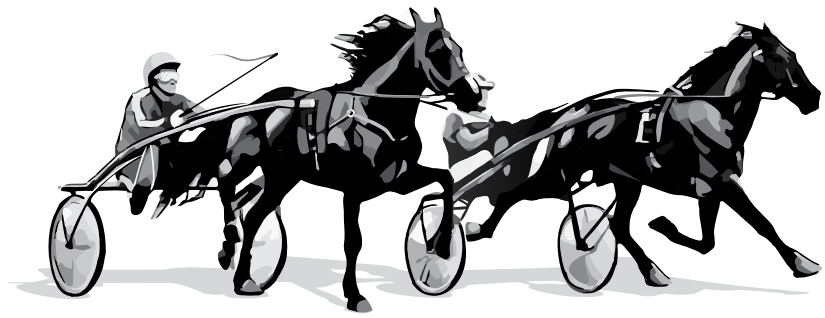
Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Win	U U U	Your horse must finish 1st; payoff determined by the win odds.
Place	U U	Your horse must finish 1st or 2nd; payoffs better than to show.
Show	U	Your horse must finish 1st, 2nd, or 3rd; modest payoffs.

Exotic multiple-horse bets

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Exacta*	U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st and 2nd in exact order; riskier bet that can pay a little or a lot, depending on the horses' odds.
Daily double	U U U U U	Pick the winners of two designated consecutive races.
Pick 3, Win 4, Pick 5, Pick 6	U U U U U U	Select the winners of a designated set of consecutive races. The wager must be made prior to the start of the first race in the multi-race wager.
Triactor*	U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in exact order; can be expensive to play if you use a lot of horses.
Superfecta*	U U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th; big payoff possible.

* Exotic bets require the horses to finish in the EXACT order you select, unless you "BOX" the bet, in which case your selections can finish in any order.

All of the numbers and letters in the program might seem confusing or overwhelming at first, but focusing on these sections makes choosing a horse simple.

- 1 Horse's number in the race
- 2 Horse's post position colour
- 3 Horse's colour, sex, age, sire (father), dam (mother), sire of the dam
- 4 Morning line odds
- 5 Horse's name
- 6 Driver and Driver Record (Name, # of wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, winning %)

- 7 Trainer information
- 8 Horse's Lifetime record (with best win time, track size, track, age, lifetime wins and lifetime earnings)
- 9 Horse's current record (# of races, # wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, and money earned)

4 The odds



Odds are also important to consider when choosing your horse. Horses that are thought to have a better chance of winning will typically have lower odds.

Morning line odds

Odds listed in the race program are the "morning line" odds. These are predictions of how the public will bet on the race. They are set by the track's handicapper when the race program is published, before the wagering starts.

The actual odds will be posted on the **Television** or in-field on the **Tote Board** before the race; they change up until post time, depending on how customers are betting on each horse in the race.

Calculating a \$2 win prize

To calculate a win prize, find the Odds of a horse on the **Television** or **Tote Board** (in-field board).

Multiply the first number by 2, then divide that number by the second digit (if there is one), and then add \$2. Simple as that!

Odds	1/2	2/1	7/2	5/1	10/1

Helpful facts for betting

- Some racetracks have a television simulcast commentator who tries to identify winning horses (handicaps) between the races. Listen and see if you can pick up any good tips to bet on.
- A good betting method is to choose horses with current odds two to three times higher than their morning line odds.

3 Tips to remember

WIN BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 32% of the time
PLACE BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 53% of the time
SHOW BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 67% of the time

#7 CAPTAIN FEAR NOT was perfectly prepped here in his first two starts of the year with an eye to the Juravinski Memorial, and he propelled those two tighteners into good efforts in the elimination and final of that stake. He made a bold third quarter move in the elimination to win going away, then he tried a wide move in the final and he ended up taking fourth money. Those two identical 1:51 1/5 miles should have him sharp as a tack as he lands in what should be a good spot for him. Expecting that he will get an aggressive steer from "Mr. Saturday Night" Jody Jamieson, he gets the nod to kick off the \$75,000 guaranteed Pick 5.

#10 CAPTAINS QUARTERS is no doubt the class of this field, coming off a sophomore season where he danced all the big dances and earned more than \$445,000. He did most of the work on the engine in the North America Cup, only to get passed late by Nijinsky, so you know if he is on his game, this is an easy spot for him. My concern is that he kicks off his four-year-old season starting from the worst post, and I wonder how hard he will be used coming in off one 1:54-flat qualifier. I wouldn't be taking a short price here.

#2 WARRAWEEFORLAURA was sent postward as a 90 to 1 longshot racing at this class level last week, and he landed in the money while pacing in 1:50 1/5, which is the fastest mile of his 23-race career. That was his fifth start of the year, and he is likely at his sharpest now. He can get a good following trip tonight starting from an inside post, and he is a good one to use underneath in this spot.

#4 BLUE BAR raced well two starts back when finishing second. His problem in that race was he was up against an outstanding colt that was going right down the road as the 1 to 5 favorite. He then tried OSS Gold company last week and he sat a trip then raced evenly along the pylons in the stretch to take the smallest cheque behind a blowout winner. He will likely look to sit in again then rally late. He could sneak into the bottom of the Tri or Super tonight.

#4 AMERICAN SON paced some big miles at two, including two in a row in 1:49-flat at Lexington in September. He took four wins and two seconds from seven starts, but perhaps one of his best miles came in the Kentucky Sires Stakes Final where he led Louprint and Sippinonsearoc into the stretch but eventually succumbed to sustained first-over pressure to finish third. He had one start in early May against some salty older pacers that should serve as a nice tightener for these upcoming stakes, and it won't hurt that he has the best driver in the world sitting behind him tonight. I'll give him a slight nod in a competitive yet compact field.

#5 AYEAYE CAPTAIN DEO has already had three starts leading up to this division of the Somebeachsomewhere stakes, and he brings a flawless 2025 record to the track tonight. He is obviously faster at three; he just took a new lifetime mark of 1:49 2/5 in a race where he made a couple of moves and looked beat at the tote board. He persisted, showing some grit to get up right on the line to catch the 4 to 5 favorite right on the line. This improving colt is in with a decent chance tonight.

#7 PRINCE HAL HANOVER is no stranger to Mohawk Park, having raced here in the Grand Circuit last year. He finished second in all of: the Nassagaweya, and the Metro Pace elimination and final. He tuned up for this event with a convincing 1:49 3/5 front end score in the Pennsylvania Sires Stakes, and that mile should have him on his toes. Dave Miller, who has done all the driving so far in this colt's sophomore season will likely send him to the front again tonight, and he will be a threat racing on the lead or from the pocket if he lost one go. He is another contender in a race where it makes sense to price shop.

#2 D A LOVE BOAT holds the fastest mark in this field thanks to a 1:48 4/5 upset score in the International Stallion stakes in Lexington last fall where he triumphed over Louprint, who would go on to win the Breeders Crown. He had an opening mile here on May 17th where he failed to get the job done at 1 to 5. He can improve off that race, but I prefer to use him underneath in this field.

#1 SOARING NOW couldn't have been any better in his first start for new connections here last week, winning in 1:47 4/5 which is the current fastest mile in Canada this year. Sure, he sat a perfect trip chasing some wicked fractions, but he still had to dig deep to fend off the horse that followed him throughout the mile, and he delivered. He had already paced a sub-1:49 mile two races previous at The Meadowlands, so he is about as sharp as a racehorse can get at the moment. He has excellent gate speed, so he should be able to get away in the top three tonight, make an early move to the front, and continue on from there to take a fourth straight win here. This isn't the toughest Preferred class with some of the better four-year-olds racing in a class restricted to their age later in the card and the usual older suspects racing in the Camluck Classic last night in London. This six-year-old JK Endofanera stallion will be a popular single on early Pick 5 and Pick 4 tickets.

#4 CENTURY KOMODO finished closest to Soaring Now of any in this field that are taking a return spin against that rival tonight. Pacing a mile in 1:48 4/5 that night was only good enough for a fourth-place cheque, but he can and should be closer here. I think he will be looking to start more alertly, looking to land in the coveted pocket following the top pick. If he can secure that position early, he should complete the Exacta.

#7 TAURASI is another one that will likely look to leave much harder this week to get positioned closer to the front understanding that it will probably be hard to close on Soaring Now late in this mile. He will likely land in the top three in the opening quarter, and that gives him a good chance to be part of the Tri. There's a chance that he will offer the lowest Exacta payoff behind Soaring Now, and I would play to beat him out of second if that was the case.

#2 ODDS ON CAPITALISM started off with a bang in the winter when he shipped here, winning three straight, including two victories racing at tonight's level, but he hasn't had much luck since. Any horse that upgrades to Dexter Dunn in the bike is worth a look, and I see him getting a share tonight.

#1 CAPTAIN LUKE started off his four-year-old season with two decent efforts in the Juravinski Memorial elimination and final that are probably better than they look on the program. In the elimination, he was used hard early to make front after starting from the widest post then he gave up the lead and followed the leader home in a fast mile. He had no chance in the final drawing an even wider post. He was parked the whole way, and he picked up a couple of positions after making a wide move on the final turn. Now he draws better, and he should be as tight as a drum with those two starts under his belt. I'll give him the nod here.

#2 HOWLENTHEHILLS finished ahead of Captain Luke in both the elimination and the final of the Juravinski but neither he nor any other horse had an answer for Calicojack Hanover. This four-year-old American Ideal gelding won 13 of 17 races last year, all of those 13 wins coming on half mile or five-eighths mile tracks. But he did race well in defeat in the Jennas Beach Boy stakes over the seven-eighths Hoosier park oval when second to Sabonis. Matt Kakaley will likely put this gelding on the point which is where he does his best work. He will have to be caught.

#8 GEM QUALITY kicked off his four-year-old campaign with two straight wins then he was well beaten twice, breaking stride in one of those starts. He had a race over this track chasing monster Brue Hanover, and that didn't go well. All of that said, he moves into Doc Moore's barn tonight, and he is better than he showed in those last two starts. He also gets a driver change to Dave Miller, and I think he will go better tonight, but he is one that I would use underneath.

#6 HUNTINGFORCHROME makes his four-year-old debut here coming off a decent sophomore season where he took a mark of 1:48 1/5 and earned more than \$360,000 on the strength of several New York Sires Stakes win and cheques taken in some races like the Adios and the Little Brown Jug final. He can get a piece of this starting from the best post tonight.

#5 FOREVERAFTERALL was racing well in conditioned races leading up to her first Grassroots race as a sophomore, and on that night, she produced a lifetime-best performance to get the job done. She moved first-over just past the half, wore the leader down to gain a stretch lead, then dug in to hold off a deep closer that flew down the middle of the track while pacing a 27 1/5 kicker trying to catch her for the win. Now that she is in top form, this filly should prove hard to beat here starting from the middle of the gate and retaining the leading driver.

#2 ALWAYS DAWN took a mark of 1:53 1/5 at two and she came out for her sophomore debut and produced a faster mile in defeat chasing a strong 4 to 5 favorite home. What catches the eye with her is the way she finished that race, pacing a 27 2/5 kicker and the way she closed in her two qualifiers (26 2/5 twice). She could get more aggressive tonight, and she is the one that the top pick will likely need to worry about the most.

#4 ALL MY WISHES was the other Grassroots winner on May 19th, and she too took a new life's mark while winning for the second time in two starts this year. In that winning mile, she was patiently driven sitting fifth to the final turn where she pulled and latched onto cover. She was sent wide turning for home and she steamrolled down the middle of the track to sail by the pocket sitter who had popped out and passed the leader. That was a strong effort, but it was also more than a second slower than the choice's winning mile, and she loses the leading driver to that rival tonight. I think she could win with the right trip, but I wouldn't take a short price.

#7 DARLENES ANGEL made a middle move that she couldn't sustain racing against the choice, but she got a better result two starts back when she got a more conservative drive. I think she finds a spot in midpack tonight and looks to rally. She can find her way into the Tri or Super.

#6 AMAZING CATCH only scored two victories in his sophomore season last year, but he was consistent all year and he brought home close to \$1,000,000 in earnings in 12 starts. His biggest win came right here in the \$713,000 Canadian Trotting Classic final where he upset at 19 to 1 from post 10, given one of the best drives of the year at Mohawk by Dexter Dunn. He also finished third in the Hambletonian, second in the Kentucky Futurity and third in the Breeders Crown. His class is unquestioned. He draws best here, and trainer Ake Svanstedt will have him ready to rock. He gets the call to kick off the middle Pick 5 that starts right here.

#7 PRIVATE ACCESS is a high quality horse that probably deserved a better fate than getting to the winner's circle only once as a three-year-old. He was Grand Circuit placed in both the Goodtimes and when finishing second to Amazing Catch in the Canadian Trotting Classic, and he was beaten only three lengths in the Hambletonian racing in a near monsoon. Trainer Luc Blais qualified him three times in 15 days getting ready for this four-year-old debut, and his best qualifier was the last one. Regular driver Louis-Philippe Roy will put him into the race, and he would be no surprise in this spot.

#3 WARRAWEE MICHELLE, last year's Hambletonian Oaks winner, shows up here for her four-year-old debut to take on male trotters for the first time in this the 20th start of her career. She is one of four being sent out by trainer Svanstedt, and she qualified well in 1:53 flat for this first start of the year. She races best when she is close to the front, and I think she can get a trip racing near the lead and finish in the money tonight.

#1 MARS HILL is one of only two horses in this race that has started for a purse this year, and his most recent mile was his best one. He doesn't have the flashy resume as many of his rivals in here, but he will be sharp, and Doug McNair will likely find him a following trip racing close to the front throughout. He could hit the ticket here at what should be a big price.

#10 JABBERWOCKY didn't finish any higher than fourth in his last five starts racing in the top class, and that allows him to drop a couple of levels here into a spot where he should prove best. He has only been close to the lead once in his past six starts, but make no mistake, he can fly off the wings of the gate when asked to do so, and the 10-hole shouldn't pose a problem for him tonight. Last time he raced at a similar level was in February, and he led every step to win as the even money favorite. He has a class edge in this sot, and this is a field that his is supposed to beat.

#9 P L OZZY got his first win of the year on May 19th when he dropped to the bottom conditioned level. That victory was certainly no surprise as he was sent postward as the 1 to 9 favorite on that occasion. He came back five days later facing a much tougher field and produced an impressive winning effort. Sitting fourth in a quick opening half, he moved first-over and hooked the leader on the last turn. Those two were under full acceleration and they opened a gap on the field. P L Ozzy put that rival away, opened up, then held off the closers late. He is razor-sharp now and he has won at this level before. He can be dangerous here if he lands in the choice's pocket early in the mile.

#4 NAZARE has done well racing at this level when he was in with a realistic chance. That wasn't the case last week when he drew the widest post then got an impossible wide trip. Two starts back when starting from tonight's post position, he raced tough first-over, digging to the wire and falling just short. He projects to get a better trip tonight starting from the better post position and he is capable of getting a much better result in this spot.

#6 DRAGONONTHEBEACH raced much better in his past two starts after not showing much in his first start of the season on May 10th. He gets the best post tonight and he should get positioned closer to the front then look to rally. He is sharp now and he should be passing some rivals late in this mile. He is a good one to use on the bottom of the Tri or Super.

#6 LITE UP THE WORLD is a colt that looked like he could be any kind in his brief two-year-old campaign, and he came back strong at three so far, winning two straight conditioned races. Him showing versatility in those two wins should have his connections optimistic as he begins his sophomore stakes season tonight. In his first win, he took over command in the second quarter then held off a good colt that leaves from post eight in this race. In his next win, he was patiently driven and moved first-over in the third quarter, and he impressively drove away from his rivals. He has options starting from the best post tonight, and I don't think we have seen his best race yet. He gets the nod.

#7 PAPIS PISTOL is a fast colt that took a mark of 1:49 3/5 at two and raced here in the Metro Pace elimination, where he finished third, and the final, where he broke stride. He also showed that he wasn't that far behind the best colts by qualifying for the final of the Breeders Crown where he was beaten only six lengths. He is well prepped for this sophomore debut having qualified three times at the Meadowlands, the latest mile being paced in 1:51 3/5. He figures to be a big threat in this spot tonight.

#8 TH KAY C CRUNCH has kicked off his three-year-old season well and he is another that should be in the mix here. After opening his year with a good second-place finish behind Lite Up The World, he headed south for his first Pennsylvania Sires Stake engagement. He tried racing first up against last year's Breeders Crown Winner Louprint and last year's Metro Pace winner Fallout. It was somewhat inevitable that he would end up third when he was first-over and those two rivals were racing 1-2. He should be razor-sharp now, and he is another that is worth a look for multi-race tickets.

#4 AQUINAS HANOVER is a gelding that got bet down to 2 to 1 favorite in an OSS Gold race last week, but he ended up in a bad spot on excess cover. When the leader stole a 56 3/5 opening half, he was going to be tough to beat, but this gelding caught the eye flashing down the middle of the track, pacing a 26-flat kicker to just miss second. He will be passing horses late, and there are worse longshots you can land on tonight.

#9 GENTRIFY has looked really good in her first two starts of her four-year-old season, and there is no reason to think her success won't continue here. In her initial start on May 16th, she ate up ground fast in the lane, falling only a head short of taking the win while pacing home in a snappy 26 2/5. She got more aggressive on May 23rd making her move earlier and driving away from her rivals while taking a new lifetime mark. She has enough gate speed to float out for midpack position from this wide post, and she gets the call to repeat.

#6 LADY CAFE AU LAIT will likely get some attention at the windows tonight from bettors that see she has been chasing undefeated three-year-old filly Chantilly in her past two starts. Prior to that, she raced against an import that showed freaky fast speed in stretches of her two wins. This Vic Puddy pupil was a good second to that rival on May 2nd. This is obviously an easier spot for this filly when you consider how much better Chantilly is than any filly or mare in this field. Starting from the best post she is worth a look, and she is one that I would consider using in the late Pick 5 that starts right here.

#5 AU JUS HANOVER just finished second to Gentrify in a decent effort where she sat sixth to the far turn, then moved late on that turn and never could catch up to Gentrify who was in full flight in the lane. She followed that rival home and got up for second just before the wire hit. She is capable of getting positioned closer to the front starting from the middle of the gate – see her sophomore debut on April 25th – and that gives her a good chance to finish closer tonight.

#2 LANESIDE INCONTROL had a nice rookie season, taking four wins three seconds and a third from nine starts, and she has come back good at three for trainer Murray Brethour. She went off at even money in her first start and she produced a wicked late brush to finish third. She got more aggressive last week but she had no answer for Gentrify in the lane, and she got picked up for second by Au Jus Hanover. She should be in the mix for a spot in the Tri or Super tonight.

#6 NIJINSKY needs little introduction coming off a terrific sophomore campaign where he won \$1.6 million, \$500,000 of it winning this track's signature race, the North America Cup. He kicked off his four-year-old season facing some very sharp rivals, most notably Brue Hanover, who came into the race looking for a seventh consecutive win since shipping north. That rival was allowed to steal a 55 4/5 opening half, and he was never getting caught. Nijinsky was patiently driven making his move on the final turn, and he paced a 53 2/5 back half to get up for second. That mile should set him up perfectly for this opening leg of the Graduate series, and he gets top billing here starting from the best post.

#1 FUNTIME BAYAMA was already a winner at Mohawk Park this spring, winning the final of the Canadian Graduate Series after getting a great trip racing in the pocket. He since went back to New Jersey where he raced in a qualifier to stay sharp for tonight's mile facing better. His best mile puts him right there with these, especially if he can work out another good trip tonight.

#2 CALICOJACK HANOVER didn't show much in his first two starts of the year at this track, finishing tenth then eighth in conditioned company. He moved to Flamboro and caught fire in the Juravinski Memorial elimination and final, taking both while racing close to the front in each of them. His 1:50 2/5 winning time registered in the final was a new life's mark. This is a tougher assignment, but this four-year-old Luc Blais trainee is clearly improving. I prefer to use him underneath in this race, but I won't be shocked if he pulls off the upset.

#5 STORM SHADOW wasn't close in the Juravinski final, but he raced much better last week when driven aggressively in a fast mile. He fell just short in an all-out sprint down the lane, and the colt that beat him is undefeated in three starts so far this year. This Ian Moore pupil gets his best results when he blasts off the gate and races on or close to the front. He can get a piece of this deploying that racing strategy again tonight.

#4 MAJOR FERNCO N has won three of his past four starts, his only loss coming in what was then the fastest mile paced in Canada this year. In that race, I thought he was really good, battling for second right to the wire while getting claimed. He came out of that race and paid a juicy \$8.40 making his first start racing out of the Garry Merner barn a winning one last week. He is razor-sharp, and he will likely offer another good price in this field, and I’ll stick with him.

#2 LARRY KARR is a one trick pony who knows only one way to race, on the engine often times with the throttle wide-open for the entire race. He is interesting here moving back into the Dean Nixon barn. Racing out of that stable last June, he took his lifetime mark of 1:47 4/5 over this racetrack, demolishing a field of non-winners of \$4,000 last five rivals. He races with a claiming tag for the first time in his career while making his 196th start tonight, coming in off a winning 1:51 3/5 qualifier. His strategy will be no secret tonight. You will have to catch him to greet the cashier.

#8 HOWMAC VICTOR raced well making his first start off the Kyle Fellows claim last week, racing first up against Major Fernco N and falling only a half length short while losing the stretch battle. He has been consistent this year, finishing in the top four in all of his last 13 starts. He is up against it here starting from the widest post, but he is sharp, and he can close for another share in this field. He is one that I would consider using on the bottom of the Tri and Super.

#3 WINMEBAK is a horse that was ascending at the end of his 2023 season, finishing the year off with four straight wins in the Grassroots ranks, culminating with a 1:50 4/5 score in the final. He raced only once in 2024 now he resurfaces here as a five-year-old coming in off three decent qualifiers, including his most recent one where he was well-beaten by Larry Karr. This is no easy spot and I’m inclined to take a wait and see approach here.

#9 FUBAR BUNDY shipped east from British Columbia and jumped right into the deep end, taking on OSS Gold competition in his first local start. He moved on second-over cover that stalled eventually as the leader, the eventual winner, sprinted away from his rivals, laying down a 26 3/5 final quarter. That was a decent first local start considering this gelding had missed three weeks leading up to that race. He should improve tonight, and he attracts the leading driver in this spot. I'll give him a slight nod over the sharp gelding that leaves from the rail.

#1 REIGNING CAPTAIN was only a one-time winner at two, but he has come back better and faster at three and he rates highly here despite facing tougher company tonight. His most recent win last week was particularly impressive with him parking past a fast opening half to make the lead then driving away for a new lifetime mark of 1:52-flat. Louis-Phillipe Roy should provide another aggressive steer tonight, and he figures to be right there on the wire.

#5 BRUNO NO NO NO came off a decent rookie season on May 24th and he was thrown into the deep end racing in an OSS Gold race as his sophomore debut. He wasn't disgraced in a mile that was paced in 1:50 1/5, pacing his own back half in 54-flat. This will be an easier spot and he draws the middle of the gate. I think he will get a more aggressive drive from Bob McClure tonight with that one tightener under his belt, and he is another possibility for late multi-race tickets at what should be a square price.

#4 ARSON SEELSTER shipped in from Ottawa on a three-race win streak last week, and he left well for position, took a mid race shuffle, then rallied again to get a small share. He lacked room in mid stretch and had to angle widest to find clear racetrack, then he finished with interest. He will get some attention from trip handicappers tonight, but I prefer to use him underneath in this spot.

#9 COLD CREEK QUESO gets to take a class drop tonight after missing cheques in two straight starts. The last time he raced this low on May 1st, he was an upset winner, getting up by a neck in his first start of 2025. He gets the leading driver tonight and I don’t mind the wide post for him because he has the necessary gate speed to head for the front or at least float out and get positioned in the top five as he has done in three of his last four starts. He gets the nod in this anchor leg of the late Pick 5 and Pick 4.

#5 LIVINTHEBEACHLIFE dropped and popped, blasting off and taking command in a fast opening quarter, then backing it down to the half with a 29 3/5 second quarter. That was all he needed to seal the deal, and he will no doubt be looking to control this race too starting from a better post tonight. If he can get a breather like he stole last week, he will be tough to catch.

#2 LEGION SEELSTER dropped to this level last week, took no action at the windows whatsoever, and raced well to grab a small slice, closing in the four-wide path in deep stretch while pacing home in 27 2/5. He was an upset winner at this level four starts back and he will be passing horses late. He could score the upset if this race falls apart late.

#7 UNCLE SHANK A was a fast winner here two starts back, then he came up against a razor-sharp P L Ozzy and he had no response for that rival’s third quarter assault. He could get an easier trip here and that makes him one to consider for deeper Pick 5 and Pick 4 tickets as he is capable with the right trip.

#1 KAPTAIN KARLOS is no stranger to Mohawk Park, having spent most of his 2024 season racing over this track. He also raced here four times earlier in the year, taking some small shares. He returns in decent form, but he has taken only one win versus 19 shares in his 47 starts in 2024-25. He is probably best used underneath tonight in a spot that won’t be easy for him.

CONDITIONS AND ALLOWANCES IN HARNESS RACING - IMPORTANT TO KNOW

The conditions of a race determine whether a horse is eligible to enter. For example many races are restricted to horses that have won a certain number of races or a certain amount of money in a specified number of starts. Many races are restricted to horses entered to be "claimed" (offered for sale) at a specific price.

Allowances in the claiming price itself are given to colts and geldings, four-year-olds and younger and to mares, five-year-olds and younger.

The purpose of the allowance is to keep younger horses more competitive when racing against older and more experienced rivals. Mares are given extra consideration in claiming events because of their potential as broodmares.

The accompanying chart shows what the allowances are, but an example may make them easier to understand. The chart indicates that three-year-olds receive a 50% allowance in claiming races. This means that a three-year-old entered in a \$20,000 claiming race carries an actual claiming price of \$30,000 (50% higher).

Fillies and mares receive an additional 25% allowance in claiming races. Details of the race conditions and claiming price (if any) are given at the top of each race in the program.

ALLOWANCES FOR PURSE EARNINGS

When Fillies/Mares compete against Colts/Geldings (normally on the trot) Fillies/Mares will receive an additional 25% on the condition of the race. ie: nw \$5,000 (FM \$6,250) last 5 or \$12,000 (FM \$15,000) last 10 starts.

C.P.M.A. Regulation Changes

Effective January 1st 2012
CPMA will be instituting several new rule changes with regards to the following pari-mutuel pools:

- Pick Pools**
- If there are no winners in any leg of a Pick N pool, the entire pool is refunded.
 - If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners.
 - A pool is no longer refunded if the 1st leg in the pool is cancelled or declared no contest.
 - Pick-3: If at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.
 - Pick-4, 5 or 6: If at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.

EXPLANATION OF THE LASIX PROGRAM

After careful study and consultation with Ontario Horsemen's groups, racetrack operators and veterinarians, Agriculture Canada and the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario passed legislation allowing the controlled (or supervised) administration of furosemide, more commonly called "Lasix". "Lasix" is used to alleviate the symptoms of exercise induced pulmonary hemorrhaging in racing horses. Horses will undergo an endoscopic examination of the trachea by a veterinarian licensed by the Ontario Racing Commission and endorsed by an official veterinarian before being allowed on the medication list. Once qualified, horses will be treated with "Lasix" within four hours plus or minus 15 minutes of a scheduled race in a secure retention area under the super vision of racing officials.

All horses on "Lasix" must remain on the program for a minimum of 100 days while racing in this jurisdiction.

RULES AND INFORMATION REGARDING CANADIAN HARNESS AND FOREIGN SEPARATE POOL EVENTS

GENERAL

All pari-mutuel pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with the regulations and directives as issued by Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada ("The Regulations"), under the approval and supervision of the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency. The Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency can be contacted at 1-800-268-8835 or 613-759-6100 or Email: cpmawebacpm@agr.gc.ca. A complete version of the CPMA regulations can be found at <http://laws-lois.justice.gc.ca/eng/regulations/SOR-91-365/>.

All tickets should be held until the result of the race is declared official and prices are posted.

No person under the age of 18 shall purchase or cash a ticket or voucher.

A claim of receiving an incorrect payment or incorrect change must be made to the Mutuel office of the association within twenty four hours of buying or cashing a valid ticket or voucher.

No ruling made by the Stewards/Judges or the Ontario Racing Commission with regard to distribution of purse money or the placing of horses in the order of finish, after the race has been declared official, shall have any bearing on the pay-out prices or distribution of pari-mutuel pools.

Change boards and Photo Finish display monitors are located in the Grandstand. In addition, Photo Finish pictures are shown on the closed-circuit television system. Customers are reminded that mutuel clerks are responsible for all shortages. When making a wager, customers must present sufficient funds at the time of purchase to cover the wagers requested.

ENTRIES AND MUTUEL FIELDS

"Entry" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled or considered as the same betting interest. The most common reason for the coupling of horses in an Entry is the fact that they are owned by the same person.

"Mutuel Field" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled because the number of horses in the race exceeds the number which can be handled separately by the pari-mutuel system. Subject to the Regulations, a bet on one horse of an Entry or Mutuel Field shall be considered a bet on all horses in that Entry or Mutuel Field.

DAILY DOUBLE BETTING (INCLUDING LATE DOUBLE)

A Daily Double bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of the two races specified for the Daily Double. Tickets not selecting the winner of the first half of the Daily Double and all tickets in the second half of the Daily Double not coupled with the declared official winner of the first half of the Daily Double are not winners and are not refunded no matter what circumstances affect the running of the second half of the Daily Double.

Should a horse or horses (not coupled with another starter) be excused from starting in the second race of the Daily Double after the first race of the Daily Double has closed for betting, holders of all Daily Double tickets on such horses, coupled with the winner of the first Daily Double race, shall participate in a Consolation Double pool. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

EXACTA (Also known as Exactor)/TRIFECTA (Also known as Triactor)/SUPERFECTA

An Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first two, three and four horses respectively, representing different betting interests to finish in the exact official order of finish, in the race on which the pool is operated.

SWINGER (Also known as OMNI)

A Swinger is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select horses to finish in any order from the official first 3 positions.

JACKPOT HI-5

A Jackpot Hi-5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners in the specified Jackpot Hi-5 race. If there are races that have an entry, (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B), Jackpot Hi-5 will not offer a wager consisting of both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in a Jackpot Hi-5, the payout would be 1st, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th.

That jackpot portion of the pool will only be paid out if there is a single winning ticket. If there are multiple winning tickets that have correctly chosen the first 5 runners of the race, they will receive 50% of the pool for that day. The other 50% will go over into the Jackpot carryover. If there are no winning tickets with the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners, 100% of the current day's pool will be carried over into the Jackpot.

PICK 3 & PICK 4 BETTING

The Pick 3 & Pick 4 bets are betting transactions in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of three or four successive races specified for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 respectively.

Winning tickets for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 are determined in the following sequence: A) winners of all legs, B) most winners, then refund. If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners. If there are no winners in any leg of a pool, the entire pool is refunded.

PICK 5 BETTING

The Pick 5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of five successive races specified for the Pick 5 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 5 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 5.

PICK 6 BETTING

The Pick 6 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of six successive races specified for the Pick 6 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 6 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 6.

PICK 5 & 6 BETTING

If at least 1 race as part of the Pick 5 or 6 has been cancelled or declared "No contest", but not more than the specified below under Refunds, the net pool shall be distributed to those selecting the most # of winners and NOT include any carryover from a previous pool.

PICK 3, PICK 4, PICK 5 & PICK 6 SCRATCHES

In the event a Pick 3, Pick 4, Pick 5 or Pick 6 ticket designates as a selection a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the Stewards/Judges to be a non-starter in any of the races comprising the Pick 3, Pick 4, Pick 5 or Pick 6 the favourite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection. In the event that the money bet in the win pool for two or more favourites is identical, the selection with the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non-starting selection.

However, if a scratch occurs in any leg of the Pick 3, Pick 4, Pick 5 or Pick 6 pools before the pool is closed, a ticket including the scratched horse may be cancelled.

REFUNDS

Subject to the Regulations, all monies in all pools on a race are refunded in the event that the race is cancelled, declared off or declared no contest, and all monies bet on a horse are refunded if the horse is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start. These refunds will be communicated to the public through various means such as betting terminals, video display, changes boards and our website.

The Pick(n) pool shall be cancelled and all Pick(n) wagers for the individual performance shall be refunded if:

- Pick-3: at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

Where a horse that is part of an Entry is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start and at least one horse of that Entry receives a fair start in the race, all tickets purchased on the Entry remain valid and the purchase price of any such ticket shall not be refunded.

COMMON POOL WAGERING (INTERTRACK BETTING)

In the unlikely event of a communications or computer system failure that prevents pools from merging with the host track's pools before the end of a race, CPMA regulations require that the site must refund all tickets for that race. This refund will be communicated to the public through various means such as video displays, change boards and messages on our website.

FAIR START

If a horse has reached the Fair Start Pole (located 200 feet before the Starting Pole) by the time the mobile gate has reached the Starting Pole, that horse is deemed to have had a fair start. It makes no difference whether or not the horse is on or off stride at that precise moment. Under current policy and regulations, which are designed to be as fair as possible to all bettors on all starters, there is no Recall - a repeat of the entire starting procedure - when a horse does not reach the Fair Start Pole before the gate reaches the Starting Pole. Monies bet on such a horse are refunded in accordance with the regulation concerning refunds.

LOST & OLD TICKETS

WEG issued tickets or vouchers are valid indefinitely, however, they cannot be cashed at a mutuel teller after 2 years from date of issue. Please mail tickets, along with your name and address, to Mutuel Manager, P.O. Box 156, Rexdale, Ontario, M9W 5L2, keeping a photocopy for future reference.

For "Lost Tickets" originally sold at a Woodbine Entertainment Group racetrack or Teletheatre, please enquire at the Mutuel office at Woodbine, Greenwood Teletheatre, or Mohawk. Policy may be subject to change retroactively in the event regulatory bodies amend existing regulations.

ASSOCIATION PERCENTAGE, AND TAXATION/LEVY

The Woodbine Entertainment Group deducts and retains the following percentages from wagers placed at our own licensed sites which are then shared with the horsepeople, host and simulcast associations and the Ontario Racing Commission.

WOODBINE MOHAWK LIVE: Win, Place & Show: 13.65%. Swinger 14.7%. Trifecta & Pick 4: 21.7%. Double & Exacta 17.2%. Jackpot Hi-5, Pick 5 & Pick 6: 11.7%. All other 23.0%

Horsepeople receive a further 2% on all wagers, except Trifecta wagering where it is 4%. The Ontario Provincial Government retains 0.5% on all bets placed in Ontario. The Canadian Government (through a revolving fund cost recovery basis) retains 0.8% on all wagers placed in Canada for provision of drug control, and audit services.
