Betting Basics

Some essentials to get you started with making a wager.

1 How to wager



Place your bet by visiting a teller, or using a self-serve terminal.

To place a bet here are just 5 things you need to know:

- 1 Name of racetrack (choose from any track in the simulcast feeds)
- 2 Number of the race
- 3 Amount of your bet (e.g. \$2)
- 4 Type of bet (see step 2)
- 5 Horse's number (see step 4)

Once you have decided what you want to bet, head to the nearest seller's window and use the sample statement as your guide:

Hello, (Racetrack), race 6, \$2 to WIN on Horse #4

How to use a self-serve terminal:

- 1 Swipe your Cash Card/Insert Cash
- 2 Enter the initial PIN #1234 (then choose a new PIN)
- 3 Press/Tap the track you would like to bet: (defaults to current race)
- 4 Tap the Horse Number: **#4**
- 5 Press/Tap the Bet Type: **WIN**
- 6 Press/Tap the Bet Amount: **\$2**
- 7 Press/Tap the Race Number: **Race #6**
- 8 Press Green **"Make BET"** button
- 9 Press/Tap the **"Finish with Receipt"** button
- 10 Be sure to check your ticket to confirm it's the bet you wanted

To get a Cash Card or for assistance ask a teller, or a staff member.

2 Types of bets



Single horse bets (minimum \$2.00 bet is required)

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Win	U U U	Your horse must finish 1st; payoff determined by the win odds.
Place	U U	Your horse must finish 1st or 2nd; payoffs better than to show.
Show	U	Your horse must finish 1st, 2nd, or 3rd; modest payoffs.

Exotic multiple-horse bets

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Exacta*	U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st and 2nd in exact order; riskier bet that can pay a little or a lot, depending on the horses' odds.
Daily double	U U U U U	Pick the winners of two designated consecutive races.
Pick 3, Win 4, Pick 5, Pick 6	U U U U U U	Select the winners of a designated set of consecutive races. The wager must be made prior to the start of the first race in the multi-race wager.
Triactor*	U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in exact order; can be expensive to play if you use a lot of horses.
Superfecta*	U U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th; big payoff possible.

* Exotic bets require the horses to finish in the EXACT order you select, unless you "BOX" the bet, in which case your selections can finish in any order.

All of the numbers and letters in the program might seem confusing or overwhelming at first, but focusing on these sections makes choosing a horse simple.

- Horse's number in the race
- Horse's post position colour
- Horse's colour, sex, age, sire (father), dam (mother), sire of the dam
- Morning line odds
- Horse's name
- Driver and Driver Record (Name, # of wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, winning %)
- Trainer information
- Horse's Lifetime record (with best win time, track size, track, age, lifetime wins and lifetime earnings)
- Horse's current record (# of races, # wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, and money earned)

4 The odds



Odds are also important to consider when choosing your horse. Horses that are thought to have a better chance of winning will typically have lower odds.

Morning line odds

Odds listed in the race program are the "morning line" odds. These are predictions of how the public will bet on the race. They are set by the track's handicapper when the race program is published, before the wagering starts.

The actual odds will be posted on the **Television** or in-field on the **Tote Board** before the race; they change up until post time, depending on how customers are betting on each horse in the race.

Calculating a \$2 win prize

To calculate a win prize, find the Odds of a horse on the **Television** or **Tote Board** (in-field board).

Multiply the first number by 2, then divide that number by the second digit (if there is one), and then add \$2. Simple as that!

Odds	1/2	2/1	7/2	5/1	10/1
Pays	\$3.00	\$6.00	\$9.00	\$12.00	\$22.00

Helpful facts for betting

- Some racetracks have a television simulcast commentator who tries to identify winning horses (handicaps) between the races. Listen and see if you can pick up any good tips to bet on.
- A good betting method is to choose horses with current odds two to three times higher than their morning line odds.

3 Tips to remember

WIN BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 32% of the time
PLACE BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 53% of the time
SHOW BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 67% of the time

#1 FIREFLIESNTHUNDER is an improving sophomore that might have what it takes to score the minor upset here in the opening leg of the \$75,000 guaranteed Pick 5. Two starts back, he sat the pocket behind a favored Determination owned gelding that led all the way, and he was nailed for second by the colt that came back to beat both him and Call Me Parker last week. In that mile last week, he left well enough to land in the pocket then he took a shuffle and re-rallied, finishing willingly to get third. He has improved in every start and if he improves a bit again tonight, he can take his maiden win. He Doug McNair back in the bike tonight, and he gets the nod to kick off the \$75,000 guaranteed Pick 5.

#3 CALL ME PARKER squandered what appeared to be a sure win two starts back when he jumped it off while leading in the stretch. Last week, he did nothing wrong other than come up against a stubborn 2 to 5 favorite that attacked him first-over and would not be denied. This sophomore Musical Rhythm gelding was game in defeat, and he didn't give it up until very late in the mile. Based on that game mile last week, he is an obvious top contender in this field, but he is 0 for 18 now, so I'm not sure how short of a price I would be willing to accept here.

#9 HAPPY ANGEL raced well last week after dropping out of an OSS Gold race. He made front early but then could only watch a rival take off and separate himself from the field. He did win the battle for place in a solid effort. Three starts back, he was a closing second at this same non-winners of one level. He has shown some versatility recently, and he is another possibility for the early Pick 5.

#2 LEXUS LEGACY is 0 for 6, but he comes off his best effort yet when beaten only two- and three-quarter lengths by Call Me Parker last week. Despite being sent off as a 61 to 1 longshot, he went straight to the front leaving the gate. He took a following trip from there, and he finished okay, trotting a 28 1/5 final quarter to just get beat for fourth. He also trotted the faster mile of his six-race career. He should be able to sit a trip racing close to the front and stay for a share.

#5 DIAMOND RYDER was outspinted early in the mile last week, and he was forced to take back and drop in third, then race first-over. That might have been okay if the mile wasn't paced in 1:52-flat which was the fastest race that this gelding raced in during his 31-race career. He paced the same 27 4/5 kick that he did two starts back when he jogged in leg one of this Pop Up series. He doesn't have to face the same dominant rival that beat him last week and he should be able to make front leaving from the widest post in a field of five. He gets the nod to make amends after getting beat at 1 to 2 last week.

#4 ALWAYS B SWEETEST brings a 1 for 46 record to the racetrack tonight, but he has been much better in his past two starts, showing improvement for trainer Ronald Macdonald, who took over his training six starts back. In his second start back, he closed well from far back to get second behind the top choice in this race. Last week, he got position on him early, then rode the better trip sitting in the pocket to beat him for second. He projects to get another pocket trip following Diamond Ryder tonight, and that gives him a chance to take his second win in this 47th try.

#3 MCWINNER made a mild middle move last week to finish behind the top two picks here to get fourth. He did show speed in his previous two starts racing at The Raceway at Western Fair, so there is a chance he can be closer early in this mile. The leading driver sticks here, and he wins plenty of races where he isn't sitting behind the horse that looks best on paper. I prefer to use him underneath, but I suppose it wouldn't be the biggest upset if he can find the trip to pull off the win tonight.

#2 SOME MIGHT SAY tried an outside move last week, but he couldn't catch up to Diamond Ryder to latch onto his cover. He can get a following trip in this five-horse field and stick around for a small share. He has finished seventh in seven of 15 starts so far this year, and he is probably a good one to use on the bottom of the Tri of Super in this spot.

#8 EXQUISITE TASTE was on a roll racing in conditioned classes before she tested stakes company in three straight starts with varying results. In her most recent start in OSS Gold company, she tried to rally from last following poor cover. In the lane, she moved inside looking for room and she finished willingly stuck behind a wall of horses. She gets Louis-Phillipe Roy back in the bike tonight, and he drove her to two wins in April. Assuming she will get put into this race earlier, she gets top billing.

#5 UNGAWA comes into this race off two solid efforts in defeat and more importantly, he has stayed flat in three straight races after having some gait issues earlier this spring, trotting hobbles seemingly solving that problem. Two starts back, he was a head loser to a gelding that then finished fifth in an elimination for the Goodtimes. Last week, he raced first up in a race where the back half was much faster than the first one. He trotted a 27 3/5 third quarter then closed in 28 1/5 and that was a first-over trip that was too tough. He should be a threat in this spot and one that merits a close look for early multi-race tickets.

#4 EUROBANK HANOVER was flawless racing with trotting hobbles on until last week when he blew up before the start. Two starts back, he broke his maiden beating Outbound Train who came back to break his maiden racing first-over. This Greenshoe gelding still has some upside and he can contend tonight if he stays flat. He is another one that I would consider for Pick 5 and Pick 4 bets.

#7 SUNDAY SHOES is clearly much faster at three when you consider he just broke his maiden in 1:55 3/5 and his fastest mile as a two-year-old was trotted in 1:59 3/5. In that winning mile last week, he was bet down to 5 to 2 despite having missed two and a half weeks between starts, and he delivered a blowout win. He did enjoy some slow fractions for the first three quarters before sprinting away from his rivals. This is a tougher non-winners of two field and he would need to improve again to beat these. I am inclined to play to beat him tonight.

#8 SHAMPOO GIRL hinted that she was coming around to her best form two starts back when she produced a strong closing effort to finish third behind Incantation in an OSS Grassroots race. Last week, she raced great from the 10-hole, making the lead in the second quarter, and she looked like a winner in the lane, but she got picked off by a rival that flew home from the back, trotting a 27 1/5 final quarter to get the job done. Now, she draws better, and she has a good shot to take her second win in this spot.

#10 ZETTE ATHENA didn't hit the board at two, but she raced in stakes in all four of her starts. She has been a different racehorse at three racing in conditioned classes, taking four wins in five starts. In all five of those starts, she held a clear lead by the time she reached the half, and the only time she got caught was on a night where the track was sloppy and she was racing on the inside in the stretch, the lane that was clearly the worst all night long. She has the necessary speed to get away well from post 10, and if she can make the lead by the half again, she could prove tough to catch.

#7 P L SAPPHIRE is another filly that has been better at three, taking two wins from three starts after going winless in nine starts at two. She is another that does her best work racing near the front, and she comes in off a nice win racing in the slop. She projects to get a good trip racing close to the front, and she should get a good piece of the purse tonight.

#5 GREEN MANS JOY was going well until she tried the Grassroots on May 26th where she sat a good trip but backed up late. She gets a few factors swinging her way tonight: she gets a better post on the middle of the gate; she gets leading driver James Macdonald back in the bike, and she adds Lasix. She should improve enough to land on the Tri or Super tonight.

#7 SOLO CP got bet down to 2 to 1 for his sophomore debut on May 29th based on a solid qualifying mile where he finished second to Eurobank Hanover. He stayed inside that night, and he finished the race with trot but no racing room. He came back on June 5th and raced evenly from the 10-hole now he gets post improvement. The leading driver gave him a vote of confidence sticking with him over three others in this field. I'll give him a slight nod here based mainly on driver's choice.

#10 TAHONTA brought only \$7,000 at the Harrisburg sale and that is looking like a bargain buy for Jeff Sucee at this point. The Muscle Mass sophomore filly has taken three blowout wins at the 5/8ths of a mile Kawartha Downs oval, one racing from the pocket, another racing first-over and her most recent win taken racing on the lead. She will need to be faster tonight facing tougher and starting from post 10, but she could be up to it. She merits a close look for usage in this anchor leg of the early Pick 5.

#5 INDUSTRIALISTS was bet down to 7 to 5 last week moving from post 10 to the best post, and he didn't have much of a shot with the trip he got. After sitting in fifth, he moved first-over in the third quarter, and that was mission impossible because the leader stole a 59 2/5 middle half as was about to liftoff for the wire. That leader trotted home in 27 4/5 in a blowout win. This colt draws well again tonight, and his price is sure to be much better for those that still like him. With the leading driver abandoning him for the choice, I prefer to use him underneath.

#1 ELLICE ISLAND, a \$70,000 Lexington buy, is a full sister to a mare that is still racing at four that has taken seven wins from 25 starts and earned more than \$188,000. This filly raced okay in her second qualifier after breaking in her first try. In that second qualifier, she won the race within a race in finishing second because none of them were beating Grand Circuit winner Emoticon Legacy. She gets the tricky rail post for this debut, and I see her taking back and closing for a slice.

#3 P L STEVIE is one of several in this field that were beaten favorites in their most recent races. In her most recent start, she got mid pack position then followed to the lane, tipping off cover at the eighth pole. She finished willingly chasing tough winner Tellers Choice. She gets a better post here and she can get the job done versus these if she gets raced more aggressively. She gets top billing in the opening leg of the late Pick 5.

#6 ANGELIC is 0 for 15 but she has been close in several starts, and she will likely get her maiden win soon, possibly tonight. In her most recent start, she left well enough to get spotted in third, and she was in good striking position turning for home. She looked to go up the inside with the leader starting to tire, but there was no room. She finally came out between horses after the eventual winner took over the lead racing first-over. She was closing well on that rival at the wire, but she ran out of racetrack. She gets off the rail now and gets the best post position and she is in with a decent chance.

#10 SUPERGIRL MOLLY was bet down to 3 to 5 favorite last week based on a strong closing effort in her previous race in an OSS Grassroots race two starts back. She never got involved in the race really, trying a wide move late that didn't pan out. Her odds should climb off that line moving to post 10 tonight, but she attracts the leading driver, and she is worth a look at what should be a square price.

#2 TRUDYBIRD, a \$60,000 Harrisburg purchase, broke in her first start then requalified at Kawartha Downs. Her second start here was a much better mile, a nice closing effort where she landed third at 63 to 1. In that mile, it took her a while to get into high gear in the lane, but once she did, she was moving very well at the wire. She should be good for another share in this spot if she behaves.

#5 GETTHEGREEN has been good in two of four starts so far in 2025, with possible excuses in the other two races. Of course, she had no chance in the race where she broke at the start in her second start after jogging in her sophomore debut as the 1 to 5 favorite. After racing well to finish second in the SBOA elimination, she didn't fare well in the final, trotting home in a pedestrian 31 4/5. Her adding Lasix tonight probably explains that slow final quarter. She fits well in this field, the only concern being the time missed. I'll give her a slight nod to kick off the late Pick 4.

#2 HP LUCAS was a strong winner here two starts back, coming off a good Grassroots try at Flamboro Downs, and he was sent off as an overlay that night. He came right back in the same class and again took no money at the windows, and he broke at the start. He is an improved gelding at three and he will probably get sent postward as an overlay tonight because he broke last week. He is another to consider for the late Pick 4 in a race that has no standout.

#3 DEBRA looked good sweeping the Ontario Sired Spring Series that was restricted to fillies, then she found the sledding tougher in non-winners of three facing some males in her next two starts. She tried Grassroots company, and she was grinded down by the 4 to 5 favorite who was taking a new lifetime mark on that night. She fits better here facing non-winners of two, and she is yet another possibility for the late multi-race tickets in what appears to be a tricky race on paper.

#7 HOUSTON SEELSTER is an improved gelding in his past few starts, and he never gets bet. He was a dominant maiden breaker two starts back, then he raced well first-over last week at 20 to 1 to just miss. He has been racing no worse than fourth at the quarter in his last seven starts, so you know if you bet him, you will likely get a run for your money. Owner/driver Travis Cullen will likely put him into play leaving the gate and he is worth a look at a price tonight.

#7 TIMEWAITSONNOONE was terrific last week, racing first-over and chasing down his stablemate in a wicked 1:51-flat mile where the two McQueen trainees finished well clear of the rest of the field. That was her third good start in a row, and her 27 2/5 kicker in that very fast race stands out. She will likely get sent off as a big favorite tonight, and she will be hard to beat if she comes close to replicating last week's winning mile. She will likely be singled on many late multi-race tickets.

#2 JAZZVILLE was bet down to 5 to 2 third choice behind the two McQueen pupils last week, and despite sitting a good trip racing in the pocket she couldn't go with that dynamic duo. Her best asset is her ability to find a good trip, and she often gets the best trip. It's hard to imagine her making up more than seven lengths on the choice, but I can see her getting another good trip and completing the Exacta.

#4 CORA CORA CORA exits the same race as the top two choices, and she closed late for third despite not getting the best trip. She moved out at the half, and she ended up racing third-over. Her cover stalled on the last turn, and she was sent wide. She closed nicely to win the race within a race to get up for third, finishing ahead of Jazzville. It won't be surprising to see her beat that rival tonight and get up for second, but I wonder what kind of trip she will get tonight.

#1 WIFEY SAID SO has been a win machine so far this year, taking nine victories from 21 starts, many of them coming at this track. She comes off a dominant win over some over matched rivals at Grand River. Previous to that victory, she was winless in five starts at Mohawk Park. Her chances of reversing that trend probably aren't strong considering how sharp the top pick is. She is one of several that will likely be fighting for the place spot as they pace down the lane.

#2 DAY stands out here having won an elimination of the SBOA stakes in his sophomore debut. He was impressive closing to win from fifth on that night on May 10th. In the process, he took the fastest mark of any horse in this field. He broke in the final, then raced evenly in an OSS Gold race. He gets class relief here, and with him dropping back down to non-winners of two, he will be a multi-race single for me.

#7 FAST SNAP finished fifth in that same SBOA elimination that was won by day, and he provided the final turn cover to that rival. He got a driver change to Chris Christoforou for the SBOA stakes final, and he was a charging second in that mile as a big longshot. He came back to race decently again in an OSS Gold race won by the sharp P L Spencer. He is the main danger on paper, but he loses Christoforou to the #8 horse. He is the most likely winner if the choice falters, however.

#6 GO BLUE is only 1 for 15 to this point, but he hasn't missed the board in six starts this year, including a good effort in an OSS Grassroots race two starts back where he closed for second. His best asset is his strong early speed that gets him in contention every week. He has had several chances in this non-winners of two level, however, and it's likely that he will once again land in the bottom of the Tri tonight.

#4 OUTBOUND TRAIN looked good beating maidens last week as the 2 to 5 favorite. He was coming in off a strong closing effort where he got second behind Eurobank Hanover. He parlayed that good mile into his maiden win, racing first up and out gaming the leader in deep stretch to get up nearing the finish. The gelding that he beat that night is now 0 for 18, and he faces tougher tonight. I prefer to use him underneath in this spot.

#2 SOLIDAZABRICKHOUSE change hands on May 26th, and he was an instant winner for his new connections at Dresden Raceway, beating \$8,000 claiming mares racing first-over despite having missed four weeks. She came back four days later in a \$9,000 claiming handicap at this track, and she took a lot of action at the windows. She set some big fractions and was picked off right on the wire by her stablemate in a very fast mile for the class. She now gets into a conditioned claimer which might be an easier spot. If she replicates last week's mile, her rivals will be racing for second.

#4 SUPERIOR DELIGHT has been ultra consistent racing at this level, taking three wins in her last four starts in this class. She races on the lead or from the pocket in every race, and she will most likely be the one chasing the choice. She is hard to discount in any race that she contests in this \$20,000 conditioned claiming level, and she will be the one if the choice can't seal the deal again.

#6 KIERA SEELSTER is one that interests me for use underneath tonight mainly due to post position improvement. She had no shot in her first two starts dropping to the back from the worst posts. Getting the best post tonight and she will likely get a better start. She is one that I could see completing the Tri or Super tonight.

#3 YS FLOWERNUMBERTEN raced much better when she dropped in for a tag last week, closing for third behind two mares that were logical to finish in the top two spots. She has hit the board in six of 10 starts this year so far and she is another one that can take a share in this spot.

#1 LILLY CLARE hasn't recorded a win this year after taking six victories from 33 starts last year. But she has been a good earner, landing in the top three seven times while taking 10 cheques finishing fourth or fifth. She always seems to be around the money, and she is a good one to use on the bottom of the exotic wagers tonight.

CONDITIONS AND ALLOWANCES IN HARNESS RACING - IMPORTANT TO KNOW

The conditions of a race determine whether a horse is eligible to enter. For example many races are restricted to horses that have won a certain number of races or a certain amount of money in a specified number of starts. Many races are restricted to horses entered to be "claimed" (offered for sale) at a specific price.

Allowances in the claiming price itself are given to colts and geldings, four-year-olds and younger and to mares, five-year-olds and younger.

The purpose of the allowance is to keep younger horses more competitive when racing against older and more experienced rivals. Mares are given extra consideration in claiming events because of their potential as broodmares.

The accompanying chart shows what the allowances are, but an example may make them easier to understand. The chart indicates that three-year-olds receive a 50% allowance in claiming races. This means that a three-year-old entered in a \$20,000 claiming race carries an actual claiming price of \$30,000 (50% higher).

Fillies and mares receive an additional 25% allowance in claiming races. Details of the race conditions and claiming price (if any) are given at the top of each race in the program.

ALLOWANCES FOR PURSE EARNINGS

When Fillies/Mares compete against Colts/Geldings (normally on the trot) Fillies/Mares will receive an additional 25% on the condition of the race. ie: nw \$5,000 (FM \$6,250) last 5 or \$12,000 (FM \$15,000) last 10 starts.

Effective January 1st 2012
CPMA will be instituting several new rule changes with regards to the following pari-mutuel pools:

- Pick Pools**
- If there are no winners in any leg of a Pick N pool, the entire pool is refunded.
 - If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners.
 - A pool is no longer refunded if the 1st leg in the pool is cancelled or declared no contest.
 - Pick-3: If at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.
 - Pick-4, 5 or 6: If at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.

EXPLANATION OF THE LASIX PROGRAM

After careful study and consultation with Ontario Horsemen's groups, racetrack operators and veterinarians, Agriculture Canada and the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario passed legislation allowing the controlled (or supervised) administration of furosemide, more commonly called "Lasix". "Lasix" is used to alleviate the symptoms of exercise induced pulmonary hemorrhaging in racing horses. Horses will undergo an endoscopic examination of the trachea by a veterinarian licensed by the Ontario Racing Commission and endorsed by an official veterinarian before being allowed on the medication list. Once qualified, horses will be treated with "Lasix" within four hours plus or minus 15 minutes of a scheduled race in a secure retention area under the super vision of racing officials. All horses on "Lasix" must remain on the program for a minimum of 100 days while racing in this jurisdiction.

- (L)** Denotes horses treated with Lasix for their last start but not so treated today.

RULES AND INFORMATION REGARDING CANADIAN HARNESS AND FOREIGN SEPARATE POOL EVENTS

GENERAL

All pari-mutuel pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with the regulations and directives as issued by Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada ("the Regulations"), under the approval and supervision of the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency. The Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency can be contacted at 1-800-268-8835 or 613-759-6100 or Email: cpmawebacpm@agr.gc.ca. A complete version of the CPMA regulations can be found at <http://laws-lois.justice.gc.ca/eng/regulations/SOR-91-365/>.

All tickets should be held until the result of the race is declared official and prices are posted.

No person under the age of 18 shall purchase or cash a ticket or voucher.

A claim of receiving an incorrect payment or incorrect change must be made to the Mutuel office of the association within twenty four hours of buying or cashing a valid ticket or voucher.

No ruling made by the Stewards/Judges or the Ontario Racing Commission with regard to distribution of purse money or the placing of horses in the order of finish, after the race has been declared official, shall have any bearing on the pay-out prices or distribution of pari-mutuel pools.

Change boards and Photo Finish display monitors are located in the Grandstand. In addition, Photo Finish pictures are shown on the closed-circuit television system. Customers are reminded that mutuel clerks are responsible for all shortages. When making a wager, customers must present sufficient funds at the time of purchase to cover the wagers requested.

ENTRIES AND MUTUEL FIELDS

"Entry" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled or considered as the same betting interest. The most common reason for the coupling of horses in an Entry is the fact that they are owned by the same person.

"Mutuel Field" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled because the number of horses in the race exceeds the number which can be handled separately by the pari-mutuel system. Subject to the Regulations, a bet on one horse of an Entry or Mutuel Field shall be considered a bet on all horses in that Entry or Mutuel Field.

DAILY DOUBLE BETTING (INCLUDING LATE DOUBLE)

A Daily Double bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of the two races specified for the Daily Double. Tickets not selecting the winner of the first half of the Daily Double and all tickets in the second half of the Daily Double not coupled with the declared official winner of the first half of the Daily Double are not winners and are not refunded no matter what circumstances affect the running of the second half of the Daily Double.

Should a horse or horses (not coupled with another starter) be excused from starting in the second race of the Daily Double after the first race of the Daily Double has closed for betting, holders of all Daily Double tickets on such horses, coupled with the winner of the first Daily Double race, shall participate in a Consolation Double pool. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

EXACTA (Also known as Exactor)/TRIFECTA (Also known as Triactor)/SUPERFECTA

An Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first two, three and four horses respectively, representing different betting interests to finish in the exact official order of finish, in the race on which the pool is operated.

SWINGER (Also known as OMNI)

A Swinger is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select horses to finish in any order from the official first 3 positions.

JACKPOT HI-5

A Jackpot Hi-5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners in the specified Jackpot Hi-5 race. If there are races that have an entry, (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B), Jackpot Hi-5 will not offer a wager consisting of both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in a Jackpot Hi-5, the payout would be 1st, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th.

That jackpot portion of the pool will only be paid out if there is a single winning ticket. If there are multiple winning tickets that have correctly chosen the first 5 runners of the race, they will receive 50% of the pool for that day. The other 50% will go over into the Jackpot carryover. If there are no winning tickets with the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners, 100% of the current day's pool will be carried over into the Jackpot.

PICK 3 & PICK 4 BETTING

The Pick 3 & Pick 4 bets are betting transactions in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of three or four successive races specified for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 respectively.

Winning tickets for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 are determined in the following sequence: A) winners of all legs, B) most winners, then refund. If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners. If there are no winners in any leg of a pool, the entire pool is refunded.

PICK 5 BETTING

The Pick 5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of five successive races specified for the Pick 5 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 5 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 5.

PICK 6 BETTING

The Pick 6 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of six successive races specified for the Pick 6 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 6 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 6.

PICK 5 & 6 BETTING

If at least 1 race as part of the Pick 5 or 6 has been cancelled or declared "No contest", but not more than the specified below under Refunds, the net pool shall be distributed to those selecting the most # of winners and NOT include any carryover from a previous pool.

PICK 3, PICK 4, PICK 5 & PICK 6 SCRATCHES

In the event a Pick 3, Pick 4, Pick 5 or Pick 6 ticket designates as a selection a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the Stewards/Judges to be a non-starter in any of the races comprising the Pick 3, Pick 4, Pick 5 or Pick 6 the favourite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection. In the event that the money bet in the win pool for two or more favourites is identical, the selection with the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non-starting selection.

However, if a scratch occurs in any leg of the Pick 3, Pick 4, Pick 5 or Pick 6 pools before the pool is closed, a ticket including the scratched horse may be cancelled.

REFUNDS

Subject to the Regulations, all monies in all pools on a race are refunded in the event that the race is cancelled, declared off or declared no contest, and all monies bet on a horse are refunded if the horse is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start. These refunds will be communicated to the public through various means such as betting terminals, video display, changes boards and our website.

The Pick(n) pool shall be cancelled and all Pick(n) wagers for the individual performance shall be refunded if:

- Pick-3: at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

Where a horse that is part of an Entry is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start and at least one horse of that Entry receives a fair start in the race, all tickets purchased on the Entry remain valid and the purchase price of any such ticket shall not be refunded.

COMMON POOL WAGERING (INTERTRACK BETTING)

In the unlikely event of a communications or computer system failure that prevents pools from merging with the host track's pools before the end of a race, CPMA regulations require that the site must refund all tickets for that race. This refund will be communicated to the public through various means such as video displays, change boards and messages on our website.

FAIR START

If a horse has reached the Fair Start Pole (located 200 feet before the Starting Pole) by the time the mobile gate has reached the Starting Pole, that horse is deemed to have had a fair start. It makes no difference whether or not the horse is on or off stride at that precise moment. Under current policy and regulations, which are designed to be as fair as possible to all bettors on all starters, there is no Recall - a repeat of the entire starting procedure - when a horse does not reach the Fair Start Pole before the gate reaches the Starting Pole. Monies bet on such a horse are refunded in accordance with the regulation concerning refunds.

LOST & OLD TICKETS

WEG issued tickets or vouchers are valid indefinitely, however, they cannot be cashed at a mutuel teller after 2 years from date of issue. Please mail tickets, along with your name and address, to Mutuel Manager, P.O. Box 156, Rexdale, Ontario, M9W 5L2, keeping a photocopy for future reference.

For "Lost Tickets" originally sold at a Woodbine Entertainment Group racetrack or Teletheatre, please enquire at the Mutuel office at Woodbine, Greenwood Teletheatre, or Mohawk. Policy may be subject to change retroactively in the event regulatory bodies amend existing regulations.

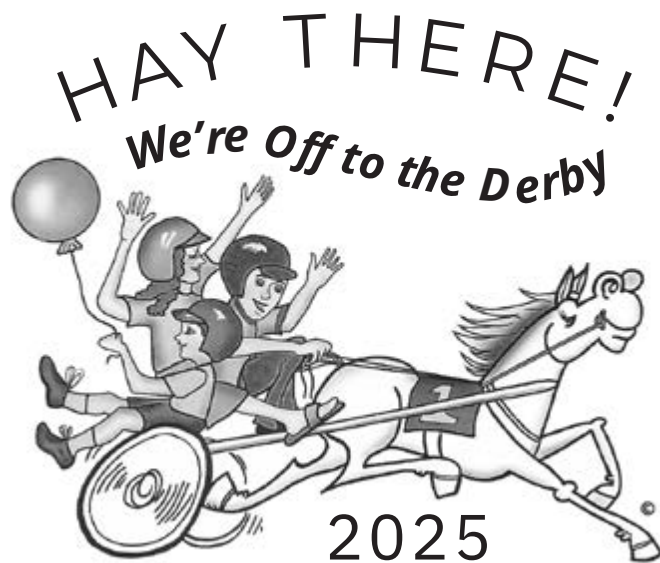
ASSOCIATION PERCENTAGE, AND TAXATION/LEVY

The Woodbine Entertainment Group deducts and retains the following percentages from wagers placed at our own licensed sites which are then shared with the horsepeople, host and simulcast associations and the Ontario Racing Commission.

WOODBINE/MOHAWK LIVE: Win, Place & Show: 13.65%. Swinger 14.7%. Trifecta & Pick 4: 21.7%. Double & Exacta 17.2%. Jackpot Hi-5, Pick 5 & Pick 6: 11.7%. All other 23.0%

Horsepeople receive a further 2% on all wagers, except Trifecta wagering where it is 4%. The Ontario Provincial Government retains 0.5% on all bets placed in Ontario. The Canadian Government (through a revolving fund cost recovery basis) retains 0.8% on all wagers placed in Canada for provision of drug control, and audit services.
