Betting Basics

Some essentials to get you started with making a wager.

1 How to wager



Place your bet by visiting a teller, or using a self-serve terminal.

To place a bet here are just 5 things you need to know:

- 1 Name of racetrack (choose from any track in the simulcast feeds)
- 2 Number of the race
- 3 Amount of your bet (e.g. \$2)
- 4 Type of bet (see step 2)
- 5 Horse's number (see step 4)

Once you have decided what you want to bet, head to the nearest seller's window and use the sample statement as your guide:

Hello, (Racetrack), race 6, \$2 to WIN on Horse #4

How to use a self-serve terminal:

- 1 Swipe your Cash Card/Insert Cash
- 2 Enter the initial PIN #1234 (then choose a new PIN)
- 3 Press/Tap the track you would like to bet: (defaults to current race)
- 4 Tap the Horse Number: **#4**
- 5 Press/Tap the Bet Type: **WIN**
- 6 Press/Tap the Bet Amount: **\$2**
- 7 Press/Tap the Race Number: **Race #6**
- 8 Press Green **"Make BET"** button
- 9 Press/Tap the **"Finish with Receipt"** button
- 10 Be sure to check your ticket to confirm it's the bet you wanted

To get a Cash Card or for assistance ask a teller, or a staff member.

2 Types of bets



Single horse bets (minimum \$2.00 bet is required)

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Win	U U U	Your horse must finish 1st; payoff determined by the win odds.
Place	U U	Your horse must finish 1st or 2nd; payoffs better than to show.
Show	U	Your horse must finish 1st, 2nd, or 3rd; modest payoffs.

Exotic multiple-horse bets

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Exacta*	U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st and 2nd in exact order; riskier bet that can pay a little or a lot, depending on the horses' odds.
Daily double	U U U U U	Pick the winners of two designated consecutive races.
Pick 3, Win 4, Pick 5, Pick 6	U U U U U U	Select the winners of a designated set of consecutive races. The wager must be made prior to the start of the first race in the multi-race wager.
Triactor*	U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in exact order; can be expensive to play if you use a lot of horses.
Superfecta*	U U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th; big payoff possible.

* Exotic bets require the horses to finish in the EXACT order you select, unless you "BOX" the bet, in which case your selections can finish in any order.



CUSTOMER CODE OF CONDUCT

Race 1 Selections

The Horseplayer's Journal by Garnet Barnsdale

#8 TAVERN ON THE GREEN is 0 for 8 so far in this initial season of racing, but he has raced against tougher than these in every one of those eight starts, and this is the first time that he is getting the chance to race in the non-winners of one class. Most recently, he produced a decent late rally over an off track to get up for a cheque in the \$300,000 Ontario Sires Stakes Super Final. This \$225,000 Harrisburg buy, who is a half brother to 1:54 3/5 (F.) trotter Mr Grant, gets top billing here to kick off tonight's \$75,000 guaranteed Pick 5, but don't expect to get the 8 to 1 morning line quote.

#6 BASELITZ got the leading driver in the bike two starts back, and she improved immediately, racing in the pocket to get second. Last week, she was even better, parlaying a perfect trip into a maiden win by trotting a 28-flat kicker, the fastest of her career, and she dug in gamely late to hold off the filly that followed her in third before rallying. This improving filly now draws best here, and she projects to get another great trip from the outset. It would be no surprise if she repeated here.

#1 MASSBAR followed Baselitz last week and she just failed to get up, perhaps getting victimized by the slow opening half. She sprinted well to the wire and fell just short in a good effort, her second in a row. She has produced fast final quarters in both of her last two starts, and she will get the job done soon, maybe tonight. She is another that merits a close look for use in this early Pick 5.

#5 KING TRIXTON was having trouble staying flat until he added trotting hobbles for his qualifier on October 3rd where he got around without making a break in stride. He comes in off two straight races where he finished third, and in his last start, he saw the lead for the first time. This Trixton homebred is getting better with each start, but I prefer to use him underneath in this spot.

#4 ANIBAL DUHARAS picked a good time to break his maiden, closing to win the OSS Grassroots Consolation, rallying off cover to chase down a loose leading 3 to 5 shot and win going away. He was given some time off following that initial win and he resurfaces here in the opening leg of the Harvest Series. Assuming the stale date hasn't dulled his form much, I'll side with him.

#1 SENDI KI is interesting to me here because he was Doug McNair's choice over two others. He comes out of a race where he finished third behind two rivals that then went on to Breeders Crowns eliminations and either of whom would be prohibitive favorites in this field. He will likely push out from the rail at the start and find a good trip racing on or near the lead, and he is another one that I would give strong consideration to for use on early Pick 5 tickets.

#3 GO ROSSCO got a key driver change to leading teamster Macdonald for his most recent start and he made a couple of moves to win going away. He keeps the leading driver tonight, and we probably haven't seen this colt's best race yet. He is another contender to consider in a competitive field in a race made more interesting because of the top pick's stale date.

#8 MAIZE AND BLUE got things all his own way in the Grassroots Consolation, stealing a 1:00-flat middle half and he looked home free in early stretch before Anibal Duharas rallied to get past him. He will likely flash speed again starting from the widest post, but I don't see him holding on for more than a small share tonight.

#8 LISAS ALL IN never saw a pylon last week and she still almost got the job done. After staying out in the flow, she followed a rival that backed her up on the last turn before drifting out of the way. She then picked up the cover of the pocket sitter who popped out nearing the three quarters. She tipped widest and took over the lead in mid stretch before getting nailed on the wire by the 3 to 5 favorite. That was a terrific effort, and she should be the one in here if she can get a reasonable trip starting from the widest draw. She gets top call in this opening leg of tonight's early Pick 4.

#1 MY ONLY SUNSHINE is a four-time winner this year that comes off a solid effort where she finished third behind the top choice last week, closing from far back while pacing a swift 27 2/5 kicker. She was a winner here four starts back where she came and got loose leader Lisas All In down the lane. She is the logical alternative to the choice in this field and the other one that I would consider using in this early Pick 4.

#2 JUST ONE BITE was raced aggressively last week by the leading teamster, popping the pocket on the last turn, taking a clear lead, then eventually ending up finishing third at the wire. She simply was third best in that mile, and she faces Lisas All In again, a rival that got a tougher trip and finished ahead of her that night. She will likely take another slice tonight.

#6 SHARE THE MOMENT has been racing well for several weeks, winning two of her last four starts and she typically does well when she shows early speed. Starting from the best post tonight with aggressive driver Louis-Phillippe Roy in the bike, she will likely blast off the gate and get positioned near the front. She should be able to stick around for a share in this spot.

#3 SCORPION SEELSTER is a \$95,000 Lexington buy that certainly has licence to be a good racehorse being a Bulldog Hanover half brother to \$1.6 million earner Stockade Seelster (16 wins, 1:48 4/5 S.). He hinted improvement was coming two starts back when he kicked in 27 1/5 coming off a three-month rest. Perhaps no one saw his monster 1:51 4/5 maiden breaking score coming though on October 11th. If he comes anywhere close to repeating that stellar mile here, his rivals will be racing for second. He will be a popular single in this opening leg of tonight's 20-cent Pick 6.

#8 TWIN B JOHN B was a winner in his debut in July in the first leg of the Grassroots series, and it was no fluke that night. He powered home in 26 2/5 to get up and catch the 7 to 5 favorite in a sharp effort at first asking. Since then, he raced exclusively against Grassroots races with mixed results, but he did pass some horses in the Grassroots Final after trailing for most of the way. He since qualified okay, and he appears to be the alternative to the top pick here for those that might expect that rival to regress.

#6 LOUS GAME dropped out of the Grassroots Consolation, got Doug McNair in the bike, got bet down to 2 to 1 and converted to take his maiden win. The colt that he beat that night has already come back to jog in 1:53 1/5 as a 4 to 5 favorite. He draws best tonight, so he should get positioned closer to the front. This Dancin Lou gelding is improving, and he should be part of the Tri tonight.

#4 LUNAR SPORT got good in his last two starts when he was sent right to the front leaving the gate, taking his maiden win then finishing third against some decent Grassroots horses. He has missed four weeks now which makes his task a tall one facing a colt that just paced a sub-1:52 winning mile. A smaller share is likely his ceiling in this spot tonight.

#4 LITTLE ARROW made his first pari-mutuel start for trainer Barrington last week, and he dropped close to six seconds from his previous start on the Maritimes. He sat back for most of the mile, then slid off the pylons at the head of the lane after briefly getting in a blind switch. Once he found clear racetrack, he powered home in 27 3/5 and he was visually motoring when he hit the wire. Getting off the rail post and making his second start back, he will likely get more aggressive at the start. He gets top call in a spot where he can get a good trip racing close to the front.

#2 FLORIDA GUY has raced decently in all of his five starts, most recently closing for second in two straight. He obviously has some talent, although I would caution that he failed to get the job done as the favorite in both those miles, now he comes into this race having missed four weeks. He has the speed to get the job done versus these, but he could be ripe for the picking considering the stale date. I wouldn't take a short price here.

#5 JS SHESREALSPECIAL raced okay to get a share two starts back when she drew a decent post, then she got the 10-hole and trailed throughout. Drawing one of the best two posts here, she will likely get put into this race leaving the gate, and I can see her sticking around for a spot in the Tri at a price in this field. She could be a good one to use on the bottom tonight.

#10 GUCCI GUCCI GOO was impressive in his winning qualifier on October 10th, and six days later, he was hammered down to 8 to 5 second choice. He dropped back and did trot a decent back half that included a 27 1/5 kicker. He draws worst now, and he is hard for me to back on top starting from the 10-hole. I see him closing late for a slice.

#9 PA SALT is a \$17,000 London Classic buy that is related to 10 winners, including six \$100,000 earners, and he was well prepped for this debut. He qualified nicely at Grand River with a trainer in the bike, rallying for the win while unleashing a 27 3/5 kicker. He then qualified here nine days later where tonight's pilot Doug McNair got a test drive. He kicked in 27 1/5 and that mile and that had him perfectly primed for his debut here on October 2nd. He was patiently driven as the 3 to 5 favorite, and he showed his mettle late in the mile, sprinting hard to get the job done. He then finished second to a colt that came back to win here Monday night in 1:51 2/5, and he looks good versus his Harvest Series rivals here. He gets top billing in this opening leg of tonight's late Pick 5.

#5 Joses Triplets raced well in two starts here after shipping north from Vernon Downs, then he was thrown to the wolves, or more specifically one wolf named Beau Jangles who has yet to lose and will surely go behind the gate as a Breeders Crown favorite tomorrow night. This Carmen Auciello pupil will likely get put into play leaving the gate tonight starting from one of the best posts, and he should be a threat.

#7 BARRACUDA HANOVER took a month break, and he qualified between those two starts, a move that served him well as he came out of that qualifying mile to jog in a maiden class to take his second win. He looked good there, but he got the benefit of a slow opening half, now he faces tougher tonight. He is one that I will try to beat here as a likely underlay.

#4 ALLTHERIGHTPLACES is another that comes in having beaten maidens, and he looked good doing it, racing first up and powering past a leader that got a nice third quarter breather. He is a sharp contender that should be good for a share, and I could see him doubling up with the right trip.

#9 PARTY IT UP comes into tonight's race off a good closing effort where he finished fourth to a blowout winning 4 to 5 favorite that no one could get close to in the stretch. He lost ground peeling widest coming off the final turn, and he then passed several rivals. He is an eight-time winner this year and he has shown that he can leave better than he did in his last start. I'll give him a slight nod here expecting him to get positioned closer to the front early in the mile.

#6 D A SUPER GLO raced well here two starts back pacing a 54-flat back half and a 26 4/5 kicker racing in a good non-winners of two field. It wasn't a big surprise to see him get bet down to even money when he dropped in for a \$20,000 claiming tag last week. He looked good racing on the lead until he broke momentarily on the backstretch. He found his way off the pylons on the last turn, and he rallied strongly to get third. He was set back for interference but that was a good effort considering the break in stride and re-rally. He will be one of the top contenders here if he stays flat.

#1 RUSTYS BETT is only 2 for 21 so far this year, but he raced well at this class level in his last two starts here, and he finished ahead of both of the top two picks in here last week. He is likely to show more speed tonight starting from the inside, and I wouldn't be surprised if he made an early move to the front tonight. He is another one that I would consider using on late multi-race tickets.

#5 SMILES FOR MILES comes in from Flamboro Downs in good form having taken two slices in a row, his eight and ninth share of the season from 19 starts. He should be able to work out a good trip here starting from one of the best posts, and he should be a good one to use on the bottom of the Tri and Super in this spot.

#4 I LOVE THIS BAR makes his fourth start tonight, and he has got progressively better in each of his first three starts. He came off a nice closing effort in his debut, then he drew better, and he got more aggressive. He stole a nice breather – a 59-flat middle half – but he couldn't match the big late kick of the 6 to 5 favorite who powered home to beat him. He then came up against a razor-sharp Scorpion Seelster, who was ready to pace a 1:51 4/5 winning mile, and he couldn't stay with that rival, but he was best of the rest. He looks good in this field, and he has a decent chance to break his maiden in this spot. Starting from a good post, he gets top billing in this opening leg of tonight's late Pick 5.

#3 LATE FOR COFFEE raced okay in three straight starts, last time finishing a non-threatening third to sharp two-year-old Barracuda Hanover, but this Bettors Delight gelding did pace a nice 27 2/5 final quarter in defeat. He was the first leader in that race, and he will likely land in a good spot again at the start of this mile. He can be a threat tonight racing from close range.

#6 NOVA BLU was racing well when he broke stride here on September 16th. He then drew the 10-hole and he was predictably raced from the back needing to get a clean line down. He comes into this race with a 0 for 24 record, but he has taken nine slices from half of his 18 starts this year, and it's reasonable to expect that he will take a slice here starting from the best post tonight.

#2 ALLSTAR COMMANDER just took his maiden win in his 38th lifetime start, a wire job from the seven-hole at Flamboro over an easier field that he meets tonight. That was his sixth top four finish in a row, and he faces tougher now, but he is improving, and I could see him sitting an inside following trip and sticking for a small share here. He is probably a good one to use at the bottom at a price tonight.

#4 ESME was a bit of a wise guy filly last week making her second start back after returning from Kentucky and racing a week after her previous start where she closed a bit after starting from the worst post. She drew much better and she seemed to have quite a few things in her favor last week. One of them wasn't facing 2 to 5 favorite I believe in angels who was just too good for this filly on that night. This looks like a good spot for this Mark Etsell pupil to take her second win, and she will likely get driven aggressively again. She will be popular on late multi-race tickets.

#6 MUSCLE SPASM, stablemate to the choice, shipped in from Grand River last week and shocked the world with her trainer Mark Etsell in the bike. The Muscle Mass gelding was put on the lead for the second time in his career, the first time coming in his debut at Grand River in late August. He was allowed to set moderate fractions, and he just kept on trucking on the engine as a 47 to 1 bomb, and he was a no doubt maiden breaker. He gets the barn's go to catch driver Travis Henry in the bike now, and he is an obvious threat to repeat stepping up to face non-winners of two tonight.

#1 TRIX ON YOU was racing well in conditioned races when he tried a Grassroots leg on September 11th, and he drew the worst post and was dull. He was then given some time off and he could only race evenly in the same race that Esme exits with the back half being trotted two seconds faster than the opening half. He is capable of better, and he can sit and rally tonight. Coming back in a week this time, he is another one that I would consider using on late multi-race tickets.

#2 MASSEDONIA ships in from London having taken his sixth lifetime win, and he picks up the leading driver in this spot. I'm not convinced that he is fast enough to beat all of these, but we see night in and night out that James Macdonald often wins races when he isn't sitting behind the fastest horse. I expect this one to sit a trip and take a smaller share, but others will be tempted to use him on top because of the driver change and sharp current form.

#2 BOXER SEELSTER is a gelding that has been seen as improving as he nears the end of his sophomore season, starting with a wide late move that he made in a Gold race five starts back. He raced well in four subsequent miles, including the Gold Super Final where he finished third to the dominant colt in that division, Crack Shot. It was thought that he had a big shot last week, but after sitting a decent trip, he simply couldn't catch Bruno No No No, who paced the mile of his life that night. This gelding faces that same rival again tonight, and I think driver Trevor Henry will be looking to find the pocket tonight. If he is on Bruno No No No's helmet turning for home, he could turn the tables.

#1 BRUNO NO NO NO was stellar last week, cutting a big opening half and driving on to take a new lifetime mark racing on the engine. He never faced a serious threat because he kept the pedal to the medal throughout that mile. He was stellar in taking his fourth win of the year, lowering his lifetime mark by a full three seconds, and he is the obvious one to beat here. I just wonder if he repeats coming off a mile where he seemed to leave it all on track. He will need to be beaten, however.

#4 OUT OF ICE was bet down to 9 to 5 against Bruno No No No last week, and he got out sprinted early as the leader cut a 25 3/5 opening quarter. He stayed in around the final turn and he rallied up the inside, finishing his mile following the leader, but he couldn't pass Boxer Seelster, who made his move earlier and still outlasted this gelding. He will likely be a bit player again in this spot tonight.

#6 AQUINAS HANOVER was one of the only horses that was closing on Bruno No No No last time, pacing a 26 4/5 kicker to get up for third. He draws best now, and he keeps the leading driver in the bike, but I still see him as a fringe player in this spot. He is one that I would restrict to use on the bottom of the Tri and Super.

Race 11 Selections

The Horseplayer's Journal by Garnet Barnsdale

#1 SUPERGIRL MOLLY is the fastest filly in this race, having taken a mark of 1:54 4/5. She has some inherent risk having broke stride in both her last two miles, but she requalified well when finishing second to the colt that is morning line favorite for the Breeders Crown Trot for two-year-old colt and gelding trotters. She will likely take beating if she stays trotting, but I could see how some would play against her starting from the rail coming off those breaks.

#3 NIGHTINGALE got off the 0 for 15 schneid two starts back when she beat a mediocre maiden field, then she jumped into the deep end trying the \$300,000 Gold Super Final where she understandably finished well behind Monalishi. She gets in much easier now and she should be better in this spot.

#9 VALIDUS won like she was supposed to as the 7 to 5 favorite last week, beating professional maiden Hobnob Hanover same as Nightingale did two starts back. She steps up now and she draws a wide post, but she still has some upside, and she has shown that she has enough gate speed to get away well from the outside post. She is another one that merits a look for the late Pick 5.

#8 FRENCHMONI HANOVER raced well at this level from post eight three starts back, then she was out of her league racing in a Grand Circuit race, and she didn't show anything after starting from post 10. She is in a better situation here, and it wouldn't be a shock if she raced much better, but she is 1 for 21 and more likely to take a slice than a win at this point.

#2 ROAD PROMISES raced okay last week here but he got into a little road trouble in the lane with nowhere to go other than follow along at the pylons. He might have got a better finishing position had he found room early in the lane. He can sit another following trip racing close to the front and take a small share.

C O N D I T I O N S A N D A L L O W A N C E S I N H A R N E S S R A C I N G - I M P O R T A N T T O K N O W

The conditions of a race determine whether a horse is eligible to enter. For example many races are restricted to horses that have won a certain number of races or a certain amount of money in a specified number of starts. Many races are restricted to horses entered to be "claimed" (offered for sale) at a specific price.

Allowances in the claiming price itself are given to colts and geldings, four-year-olds and younger and to mares, five-year-olds and younger.

The purpose of the allowance is to keep younger horses more competitive when racing against older and more experienced rivals. Mares are given extra consideration in claiming events because of their potential as broodmares.

The accompanying chart shows what the allowances are, but an example may make them easier to understand. The chart indicates that three-year-olds receive a 50% allowance in claiming races. This means that a three-year-old entered in a \$20,000 claiming race carries an actual claiming price of \$30,000 (50% higher).

Fillies and mares receive an additional 25% allowance in claiming races. Details of the race conditions and claiming price (if any) are given at the top of each race in the program.

C.P.M.A. Regulation Changes

Effective January 1st 2012
CPMA will be instituting several new rule changes with regards to the following pari-mutuel pools:

Pick Pools

- If there are no winners in any leg of a Pick N pool, the entire pool is refunded.
- If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners.
- A pool is no longer refunded if the 1st leg in the pool is cancelled or declared no contest.
- Pick-3: If at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: If at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.

EXPLANATION OF THE LASIX PROGRAM

After careful study and consultation with Ontario Horsemen's groups, racetrack operators and veterinarians, Agriculture Canada and the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario passed legislation allowing the controlled (or supervised) administration of furosemide, more commonly called "Lasix". "Lasix" is used to alleviate the symptoms of exercise induced pulmonary hemorrhaging in racing horses. Horses will undergo an endoscopic examination of the trachea by a veterinarian licensed by the Ontario Racing Commission and endorsed by an official veterinarian before being allowed on the medication list. Once qualified, horses will be treated with "Lasix" within four hours plus or minus 15 minutes of a scheduled race in a secure retention area under the super vision of racing officials.

All horses on "Lasix" must remain on the program for a minimum of 100 days while racing in this jurisdiction.

- (L)** Denotes horses treated with Lasix for their last start but not so treated today.

RULES AND INFORMATION REGARDING CANADIAN HARNESS AND FOREIGN SEPARATE POOL EVENTS

GENERAL

All pari-mutuel pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with the regulations and directives as issued by Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada ("the Regulations"), under the approval and supervision of the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency. The Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency can be contacted at 1-800-268-8835 or 613-759-6100 or Email: cpmawebacpm@agr.gc.ca. A complete version of the CPMA regulations can be found at <http://laws-lois.justice.gc.ca/eng/regulations/SOR-91-385/>.

All tickets should be held until the result of the race is declared official and prices are posted.

No person under the age of 18 shall purchase or cash a ticket or voucher.

A claim of receiving an incorrect payment or incorrect change must be made to the Mutuel office of the association within twenty four hours of buying or cashing a valid ticket or voucher.

No ruling made by the Stewards/Judges or the Ontario Racing Commission with regard to distribution of purse money or the placing of horses in the order of finish, after the race has been declared official, shall have any bearing on the pay-out prices or distribution of pari-mutuel pools.

Change boards and Photo Finish display monitors are located in the Grandstand. In addition, Photo Finish pictures are shown on the closed-circuit television system. Customers are reminded that mutuel clerks are responsible for all shortages. When making a wager, customers must present sufficient funds at the time of purchase to cover the wagers requested.

ENTRIES AND MUTUEL FIELDS

"Entry" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled or considered as the same betting interest. The most common reason for the coupling of horses in an Entry is the fact that they are owned by the same person.

"Mutuel Field" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled because the number of horses in the race exceeds the number which can be handled separately by the pari-mutuel system. Subject to the Regulations, a bet on one horse of an Entry or Mutuel Field shall be considered a bet on all horses in that Entry or Mutuel Field.

DAILY DOUBLE BETTING (INCLUDING LATE DOUBLE)

A Daily Double bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of the two races specified for the Daily Double. Tickets not selecting the winner of the first half of the Daily Double and all tickets in the second half of the Daily Double not coupled with the declared official winner of the first half of the Daily Double are not winners and are not refunded no matter what circumstances affect the running of the second half of the Daily Double.

Should a horse or horses (not coupled with another starter) be excused from starting in the second race of the Daily Double after the first race of the Daily Double has closed for betting, holders of all Daily Double tickets on such horses, coupled with the winner of the first Daily Double race, shall participate in a Consolation Double pool. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

EXACTA (Also known as Exactor)/TRIFECTA (Also known as Trifactor)/SUPERFECTA

An Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first two, three and four horses respectively, representing different betting interests to finish in the exact official order of finish, in the race on which the pool is operated.

SWINGER (Also known as OMN)

A Swinger is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select horses to finish in any order from the official first 3 positions.

JACKPOT HI-5

A Jackpot Hi-5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners in the specified Jackpot Hi-5 race. If there are races that have an entry, (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B), Jackpot Hi-5 will not offer a wager consisting of both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in a Jackpot Hi-5, the payout would be 1st, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th.

That jackpot portion of the pool will only be paid out if there is a single winning ticket. If there are multiple winning tickets that have correctly chosen the first 5 runners of the race, they will receive 50% of the pool for that day. The other 50% will go over into the Jackpot carryover. If there are no winning tickets with the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners, 100% of the current day's pool will be carried over into the Jackpot.

PICK 3 & PICK-4 BETTING

The Pick 3 & Pick 4 bets are betting transactions in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of three or four successive races specified for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 respectively.

Winning tickets for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 are determined in the following sequence: A) winners of all legs, B) most winners, then refund. If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners. If there are no winners in any leg of a pool, the entire pool is refunded.

PICK 5 BETTING

The Pick 5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of five successive races specified for the Pick 5 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 5 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 5.

PICK 6 BETTING

The Pick 6 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of six successive races specified for the Pick 6 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 6 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 6.

PICK 5 & 6 BETTING

If at least 1 race as part of the Pick 5 or 6 has been cancelled or declared "No contest", but not more than the specified below under Refunds, the net pool shall be distributed to those selecting the most # of winners and NOT include any carryover from a previous pool.

PICK 3, PICK 4, PICK 5 & PICK 6 SCRATCHES

In the event a Pick 3, Pick 4, Pick 5 or Pick 6 ticket designates as a selection a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the Stewards/Judges to be a non-starter in any of the races comprising the Pick 3, Pick 4, Pick 5 or Pick 6 the favourite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection. In the event that the money bet in the win pool for two or more favourites is identical, the selection with the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non-starting selection.

However, if a scratch occurs in any leg of the Pick 3, Pick 4, Pick 5 or Pick 6 pools before the pool is closed, a ticket including the scratched horse may be cancelled.

REFUNDS

Subject to the Regulations, all monies in all pools on a race are refunded in the event that the race is cancelled, declared off or declared no contest, and all monies bet on a horse are refunded if the horse is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start. These refunds will be communicated to the public through various means such as betting terminals, video display, changes boards and our website.

The Pick(n) pool shall be cancelled and all Pick(n) wagers for the individual performance shall be refunded if:

- Pick-3: at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

Where a horse that is part of an Entry is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start and at least one horse of that Entry receives a fair start in the race, all tickets purchased on the Entry remain valid and the purchase price of any such ticket shall not be refunded.

COMMON POOL WAGERING (INTERTRACK BETTING)

In the unlikely event of a communications or computer system failure that prevents pools from merging with the host track's pools before the end of a race, CPMA regulations require that the site must refund all tickets for that race. This refund will be communicated to the public through various means such as video displays, change boards and messages on our website.

FAIR START

If a horse has reached the Fair Start Pole (located 200 feet before the Starting Pole) by the time the mobile gate has reached the Starting Pole, that horse is deemed to have had a fair start. It makes no difference whether or not the horse is on or off stride at that precise moment. Under current policy and regulations, which are designed to be as fair as possible to all bettors on all starters, there is no Recall - a repeat of the entire starting procedure - when a horse does not reach the Fair Start Pole before the gate reaches the Starting Pole. Monies bet on such a horse are refunded in accordance with the regulation concerning refunds.

LOST & OLD TICKETS

WEG issued tickets or vouchers are valid indefinitely, however, they cannot be cashed at a mutuel teller after 2 years from date of issue. Please mail tickets, along with your name and address, to Mutuel Manager, P.O. Box 156, Rexdale, Ontario, M9W 5L2, keeping a photocopy for future reference.

For "Lost Tickets" originally sold at a Woodbine Entertainment Group racetrack or Teletheatre, please enquire at the Mutuel office at Woodbine, Greenwood Teletheatre, or Mohawk. Policy may be subject to change retroactively in the event regulatory bodies amend existing regulations.

ASSOCIATION PERCENTAGE, AND TAXATION/LEVY

The Woodbine Entertainment Group deducts and retains the following percentages from wagers placed at our own licensed sites which are then shared with the horsepeople, host and simulcast associations and the Ontario Racing Commission.

WOODBINE/MOHAWK LIVE: Win, Place & Show: 13.65%. Swinger 14.7%. Trifecta & Pick 4: 21.7%. Double & Exacta 17.2%. Jackpot Hi-5, Pick 5 & Pick 6: 11.7%. All other 23.0%

Horsepeople receive a further 2% on all wagers, except Trifecta wagering where it is 4%. The Ontario Provincial Government retains 0.5% on all bets placed in Ontario. The Canadian Government (through a revolving fund cost recovery basis) retains 0.8% on all wagers placed in Canada for provision of drug control, and audit services.
