Betting Basics

Some essentials to get you started with making a wager.

1 How to wager



Place your bet by visiting a teller, or using a self-serve terminal.

To place a bet here are just 5 things you need to know:

- 1 Name of racetrack (choose from any track in the simulcast feeds)
- 2 Number of the race
- 3 Amount of your bet (e.g. \$2)
- 4 Type of bet (see step 2)
- 5 Horse's number (see step 4)

Once you have decided what you want to bet, head to the nearest seller's window and use the sample statement as your guide:

Hello, (Racetrack), race 6, \$2 to WIN on Horse #4

How to use a self-serve terminal:

- 1 Swipe your Cash Card/Insert Cash
- 2 Enter the initial PIN #1234 (then choose a new PIN)
- 3 Press/Tap the track you would like to bet: (defaults to current race)
- 4 Tap the Horse Number: **#4**
- 5 Press/Tap the Bet Type: **WIN**
- 6 Press/Tap the Bet Amount: **\$2**
- 7 Press/Tap the Race Number: **Race #6**
- 8 Press Green **"Make BET"** button
- 9 Press/Tap the **"Finish with Receipt"** button
- 10 Be sure to check your ticket to confirm it's the bet you wanted

To get a Cash Card or for assistance ask a teller, or a staff member.

2 Types of bets



Single horse bets (minimum \$2.00 bet is required)

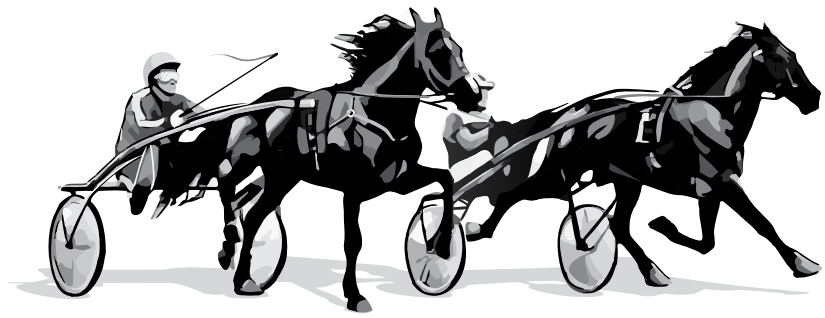
Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Win	U U U	Your horse must finish 1st; payoff determined by the win odds.
Place	U U	Your horse must finish 1st or 2nd; payoffs better than to show.
Show	U	Your horse must finish 1st, 2nd, or 3rd; modest payoffs.

Exotic multiple-horse bets

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Exacta*	U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st and 2nd in exact order; riskier bet that can pay a little or a lot, depending on the horses' odds.
Daily double	U U U U U	Pick the winners of two designated consecutive races.
Pick 3, Win 4, Pick 5, Pick 6	U U U U U U	Select the winners of a designated set of consecutive races. The wager must be made prior to the start of the first race in the multi-race wager.
Triactor*	U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in exact order; can be expensive to play if you use a lot of horses.
Superfecta*	U U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th; big payoff possible.

* Exotic bets require the horses to finish in the EXACT order you select, unless you "BOX" the bet, in which case your selections can finish in any order.

All of the numbers and letters in the program might seem confusing or overwhelming at first, but focusing on these sections makes choosing a horse simple.

- Horse's number in the race
- Horse's post position colour
- Horse's colour, sex, age, sire (father), dam (mother), sire of the dam
- Morning line odds
- Horse's name
- Driver and Driver Record (Name, # of wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, winning %)
- Trainer information
- Horse's Lifetime record (with best win time, track size, track, age, lifetime wins and lifetime earnings)
- Horse's current record (# of races, # wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, and money earned)

4 The odds



Odds are also important to consider when choosing your horse. Horses that are thought to have a better chance of winning will typically have lower odds.

Morning line odds

Odds listed in the race program are the "morning line" odds. These are predictions of how the public will bet on the race. They are set by the track's handicapper when the race program is published, before the wagering starts.

The actual odds will be posted on the **Television** or in-field on the **Tote Board** before the race; they change up until post time, depending on how customers are betting on each horse in the race.

Calculating a \$2 win prize

To calculate a win prize, find the Odds of a horse on the **Television** or **Tote Board** (in-field board).

Multiply the first number by 2, then divide that number by the second digit (if there is one), and then add \$2. Simple as that!

Odds	1/2	2/1	7/2	5/1	10/1
Pays	\$3.00	\$6.00	\$9.00	\$12.00	\$22.00

Helpful facts for betting

- Some racetracks have a television simulcast commentator who tries to identify winning horses (handicaps) between the races. Listen and see if you can pick up any good tips to bet on.
- A good betting method is to choose horses with current odds two to three times higher than their morning line odds.

3 Tips to remember

WIN BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 32% of the time
PLACE BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 53% of the time
SHOW BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 67% of the time

Race 1 Selections

The Horseplayer's Journal by Garnet Barnsdale

#1 THE FEAST is a \$20,000 Harrisburg Sale graduate that shipped north off two quite different looking race lines at The Meadows this past summer. He raced well to get third on debut, then three weeks later he raced first-over, and he tired badly to be beaten by 20 lengths. He was sold in October, and he was entered in a qualifier here five days ago. Racing out of the Garry Merner barn for the first time, he got leading driver James Macdonald in the bike. He was given an aggressive steer, making a middle move to the front from the pocket and quickly opening up on the field. He was driven out to an impressive qualifying win, and the leading driver – who had two other choices in here – sticks with this rookie son of Stay Hungry. He gets the nod in this opening leg of tonight's guaranteed \$75,000 Pick 5.

#7 LISTEN LINDO is a \$15,000 London Classic Sale graduate who was decent in his debut mile here on October 23rd where he showed a bit of zip late in the mile, closing in 27 4/5. He predictably got driven more aggressively in his next start, getting positioned closer to the front early before re-rallying late to get second behind a favorite that was breaking his maiden in his 26th try. Following a lacklustre try in his third start, he got a three-week break then a trip to Flamboro Downs for start number four. He was clearly best in that field and he dropped the hammer as the heavy 1 to 9 favorite, crushing his overmatched rivals. Last week he got raced aggressively as expected but he got no breathers. He can fare better here if he finds some cover or gets a breather.

#5 WINDSUN DUKE is a two-time winner that comes off a decent effort racing at this class last week when he was aggressively driven. He was sent hard leaving the gate and he was part of a three-pronged battle for the lead heading into the opening turn. He made front but he was soon overtaken. He rode the inside path to the lane where he skimmed the pylons, and he got up to finish third. He draws one of the best posts here, and he can get another good trip. He should be good for another share.

#4 LOU KNOWS hasn't missed the top two in any of his four starts at Flamboro Downs but none of those miles were fast and this should prove to be a tougher spot for him. I respect his consistency, but I prefer to use him underneath tonight.

#7 MOVIN ON OVER was full value for his upset win five starts back as he passed most of them in the final quarter while pacing a wicked 26 2/5 kicker. In his next start, with a claim entered on him, he got an aggressive steer, and he set a big opening half, and he couldn't see it through on the engine, the front end perhaps not being his best trip. He drew well in his next start, and he got a covered trip with a claim entered, and he got the job done as the 2 to 5 favorite. The leading driver stuck with him two starts back racing off the Auciello claim and he had this gelding moving well on the final turn when he made a break, taking himself out of contention. He bounced back last week with a game winning effort as the 3 to 5 favorite, and he is the one to beat here.

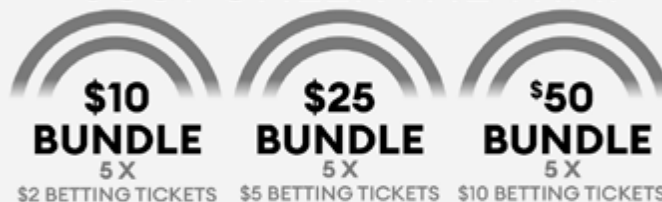
#4 ERINWOOD BIG MACK showed up here last week with mediocre Flamboro Downs form and showing a stale date, and he raced very well as a 30 to 1 bomb. He was sent first up before the half, and he provided the winning cover for Movin On Over while staying game to the wire. If you reverse the trips tonight, you will likely see a different result. This is another contender to consider for the early Pick 5.

#2 STAY HUMBLE raced well in defeat three starts back then he drew post 10 in his next start on December 6th, so it was no surprise to see him sent off as an 11 to 1 shot. He got a slick steer from Tyler Jones who snuck up the inside around the final turn then found a seam at the eighth pole when a rival drifted out. He drove through to take the win, but he didn't get a similarly good trip last week when he got shuffled to the back in the third quarter. He should get a better trip here, and he can take a share.

#6 GANSBAAI is a great one to use on the bottom of the exotics when you consider that he has taken 14 slices from 24 starts this year and he brings a 1 for 46 record to the track tonight. He typically passes horses in the back half, and we should see more of the same of that tonight.

#1 BOOKER SEELSTER shipped to London on December 12th, and he took a maiden win being aggressively driven by owner/trainer/driver Terry Fritz. He shipped back to Mohawk Park a week ago, and he took some action, getting bet down to 4 to 1. He got the "first time McNair" angle, and that teamster had this gelding looming large racing first-over around the last turn. He took the lead turning for home, but he got picked off by the rival that he provided cover to. He stands out in this field of maidens, and it seems likely that McNair will make an early move to the front and look to control the race. This altered sophomore son of Sunshine Beach will probably be a popular single in this opening leg of tonight's early Pick 4.

#9 DEAL SPEED ships into Mohawk Park with a record of 1 for 23, but other than the top pick, he is the only other one in this field that shows a good recent mile, his last start at Rideau Carleton on December 14th. He raced first up a long way in that mile, and he came withing a neck of chasing down a favorite that closed at the minimum odds of five cents on the dollar. The horse that beat him that night is a five-time winner and he faces eight rivals here that have won seven races combined. He is the only one that I could make a legitimate case for to take down the top pick.

#2 SNOWPORT is 0 for 36 to date, but he has taken 16 slices, and his best strength is his good tactical speed. He will likely get positioned near the front tonight, and he should be able to fend off the backfield to hang around for a spot in the Tri or Super. He is probably a good one to use underneath.

#5 CLAYMORE shipped here from Flamboro Downs on December 6th coming off a win and he raced decently that night to get fourth. He raced again in this class last week and after getting a good start, he got shuffled out of the race. He is capable of better than he showed that night and I could see him taking a share tonight starting from his good draw.

#3 MONTANA SLIM is one that I liked in both local starts, mainly because of his very good qualifying mile on December 5th. In that mile, he sat fifth to the final turn where he moved outside and latched onto second-over cover. He tipped off that cover and closed relentlessly in the lane to just miss while under minimal Kelly urging. Racing on a cold morning, he produced the fastest final quarter of the 45 qualifiers that morning. His Mohawk debut was a good closing effort, but he then drew post nine and dropped to the back and closed mildly last week. With two local starts under his belt, he should get more aggressive now, especially considering he gets needed post relief tonight. I'll give him a slight nod in a tough race to start the 20-cent Pick 6.

#1 J XAVIER shipped here from Rideau Carleton last week and he dropped in for a tag and got a key driver change to Louis-Phillipe Roy. He was heavily bet, and he was driven aggressively accordingly. His trip was probably a bit too tough, and he tired late. He gets another class drop here and he will almost surely get put into this race early. He would be no surprise in this spot.

#4 ELLIOT MOOSE comes out of a race where he got a great trip when you consider that he drafted to the head of the lane, found a way off the pylons, and he got a clear run at the leaders. He flattened out, and that stretch drive showed that he needed some class relief, and he gets that here tonight. He does his best work with Travis Cullen in the bike, and he gets that pilot back tonight. He is another in with a chance here.

#7 CENTURY INSPECTOR is another that could improve sharply here getting needed class relief. He will likely flash speed in this spot and it's possible that he could get the job done if he finds the pocket early and gets clear sailing at the head of the lane. This is a race where it makes sense to price shop.

#3 H F PANS SHADOW is done well in all three since being claimed. He stepped up to this level three starts back after getting claimed out of a dominant winning performance against \$20,000 claimers, and he was sent off at a juicy 7 to 1. He sat back and watched some rivals take turns on the lead cutting some fast fractions, and he had the liveliest legs at the wire. He was only a neck back in his next start then last week he gutted it out racing first-over to take his eleventh win of the season in his 36th start.

#8 BOLD SPIRIT raced well in defeat to H F Pans Shadow last week. After taking over the lead in the second quarter, he was passed by a rival that was intent on controlling the race. When that leader started to tire at the head of the lane, this gelding angled out and took his shot at H F Pans Shadow who was taking the lead on the outside. His rally fell just short, and he should be the main threat again tonight.

#9 HOWMAC VICTOR raced well off the Justin Turcotte claim here three starts back and that effort was a precursor to his win last week. In that mile on December 6th, he was eighth and last on the inside entering the final turn, and he really kicked in coming down the lane, closing between horses and getting jammed up in traffic nearing the wire, probably costing him a placing. He fired in the same class a week later, and he worked out a perfect trip and after looking like he was stalling at the eighth pole, he kicked back in between horses to get up on the wire and nail the 3 to 5 favorite. He raced well from the 10-hole last week to get third, but he draws wide again, and post position disadvantage will likely limit him to a small share here.

#7 WRY has been closing well at the end of his miles without threatening the winner, and I expect to see more of the same here. He will likely pass enough of them to work his way into the Tri or Super, and he is worth a look for use underneath.

#4 P L OZZY was given a great aggressive steer by driver Travis Henry to win last week at a price and that pilot has really had a terrific year racing full time at Mohawk Park after toiling at the B tracks for several years. This is a tougher spot for this son of Sunshine Beach, and while I don't see him repeating, he has found the winner's circle in just 24 starts this season, so he certainly knows where the wire is.

#2 A CLASS YANKEE has produced two good closing efforts to get up for slices at tonight's level in his last two starts, and he can get a better start here leaving from an inside post. He can pass enough of these to work his way into the bottom of the Tri or Super, and he is probably a good one to use on the bottom tonight.

#2 DUSTY LANE LEVI fires back in five days coming off a very impressive winning effort on Monday racing in the snow here at Mohawk Park. After leaving hard from the six hole, he got stuck three wide racing around the first turn. He eventually was able to settle in fifth past the quarter, but he was soon forced out again when the backfield started up. He was uncovered until the pocket sitter popped out on the final turn, and he edged past that rival in mid stretch. After seizing command, he faced a strong late challenge from a backfield closer, and he dug deep to get the job done. He shoots for five straight here and he picks up the leading driver. I'll give him a slight nod facing tougher here.

#4 ETHERIUM PARTY got a great trip three starts back to take a new lifetime mark of 1:50 4/5. He followed that mile up with a more aggressive approach, and he led all the way to beat a decent non-winners of three field. From there he stepped up to face classy Write Me A Rose who never let him get closer than a half length behind turning for home. He gets back into non-winners of three where he already won twice, and he is the one to beat as the probable favorite here.

#7 BLUE BAR races better with Travis Cullen in the bike, and he was good two starts back with that pilot in control, but he was still two lengths back at the wire. He gets off the rail tonight, and he will likely get a more aggressive steer starting from the widest post in this short field. He can be a speed threat in this spot, but he will need to make up those two lengths on Etherium Party to get the job done.

#1 COALFORD TOPGUY GB raced well several times in a row at Flamboro Downs before returning here last week where he raced well in defeat, kicking into high gear late to pass several rivals and finish a clear fourth. He gets Jody Jamieson in the bike tonight, and he still has some upside. I can see him closing for a share in this spot.

#2 LAMANDIER A was bought by local connections in October, and he shipped overseas from Australia where he had a decent season taking three wins and nine other shares from 23 starts to the end of August. He produced a qualifying mile here on December 5th that was faster than many of his rivals here do racing for purses. In that mile, he sat fifth to the far turn and he started to edge out heading to the stretch. He tipped widest when they straightened out, and he motored home in 27 1/5 to finish a good looking fourth. He added Lasix for his local debut and after getting bet down to 2 to 1 favorite, he looked like a racehorse that needed a start. Assuming he got the tightener that he needed in that spot, I'll stick with him expecting a much better effort.

#5 SAULSBROOK LITTEN moved from a wide post to the best starting slot two starts back, and his odds went from 23 to 1 the week before to 4 to 1 in that mile. He didn't get the best trip as he was buried in behind a wall of horses turning for home. He tried moving up the inside but there was no room there, and he eventually managed to find racing room nearing the wire, but he couldn't build up any momentum at that point. He got to drop in class last week and he was bet down to 3 to 5. He was raced aggressively and the fast fractions caught up to him in the lane as did a rival that sat a beautiful following trip. He is sharp and he should offer a better price tonight stepping up in class. I'll give him a price look.

#6 R J RINGO moves from a wide post to the best starting slot tonight, and his odds will drop sharply from the 111 to 1 last week. He raced okay closing from last to fifth, and he almost surely will get better position early in tonight's mile. He should be good for a share in this spot.

#1 GINGER TREE FINNY is in great form and the leading driver has been a good partner for him, but I think he will find this conditioned field tougher than the Pop Up series that he exits. He also will be under the gun early starting from the rail. He will likely look to rally from mid pack, and I think he will close for a slice this time.

CONDITIONS AND ALLOWANCES IN HARNESS RACING - IMPORTANT TO KNOW

The conditions of a race determine whether a horse is eligible to enter. For example many races are restricted to horses that have won a certain number of races or a certain amount of money in a specified number of starts. Many races are restricted to horses entered to be "claimed" (offered for sale) at a specific price.

Allowances in the claiming price itself are given to colts and geldings, four-year-olds and younger and to mares, five-year-olds and younger.

The purpose of the allowance is to keep younger horses more competitive when racing against older and more experienced rivals. Mares are given extra consideration in claiming events because of their potential as broodmares.

The accompanying chart shows what the allowances are, but an example may make them easier to understand. The chart indicates that three-year-olds receive a 50% allowance in claiming races. This means that a three-year-old entered in a \$20,000 claiming race carries an actual claiming price of \$30,000 (50% higher).

Fillies and mares receive an additional 25% allowance in claiming races. Details of the race conditions and claiming price (if any) are given at the top of each race in the program.

ALLOWANCES FOR PURSE EARNINGS

When Fillies/Mares compete against Colts/Geldings (normally on the trot) Fillies/Mares will receive an additional 25% on the condition of the race. ie: nw \$5,000 (FM \$6,250) last 5 or \$12,000 (FM \$15,000) last 10 starts.

C.P.M.A. Regulation Changes

Effective January 1st 2012

CPMA will be instituting several new rule changes with regards to the following pari-mutuel pools:

Pick Pools

- If there are no winners in any leg of a Pick N pool, the entire pool is refunded.
- If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners.
- A pool is no longer refunded if the 1st leg in the pool is cancelled or declared no contest.
- Pick-3: If at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: If at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.

EXPLANATION OF THE LASIX PROGRAM

After careful study and consultation with Ontario Horsemen's groups, racetrack operators and veterinarians, Agriculture Canada and the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario passed legislation allowing the controlled (or supervised) administration of furosemide, more commonly called "Lasix". "Lasix" is used to alleviate the symptoms of exercise induced pulmonary hemorrhaging in racing horses. Horses will undergo an endoscopic examination of the trachea by a veterinarian licensed by the Ontario Racing Commission and endorsed by an official veterinarian before being allowed on the medication list. Once qualified, horses will be treated with "Lasix" within four hours plus or minus 15 minutes of a scheduled race in a secure retention area under the super vision of racing officials.

All horses on "Lasix" must remain on the program for a minimum of 100 days while racing in this jurisdiction.

- L** Denotes horses treated with Lasix.
- (L)** Denotes horses treated with Lasix today who were not so treated for their last start.
- (L)** Denotes horses treated with Lasix for their last start but not so treated today.

RULES AND INFORMATION REGARDING CANADIAN HARNESS AND FOREIGN SEPARATE POOL EVENTS

GENERAL

All pari-mutuel pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with the regulations and directives as issued by Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada ("the Regulations"), under the approval and supervision of the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency. The Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency can be contacted at 1-800-268-8835 or 613-759-6100 or Email: cpmawebacpm@agr.gc.ca. A complete version of the CPMA regulations can be found at <http://laws-lois.justice.gc.ca/eng/regulations/SOR-91-365/>.

All tickets should be held until the result of the race is declared official and prices are posted.

No person under the age of 18 shall purchase or cash a ticket or voucher.

A claim of receiving an incorrect payment or incorrect change must be made to the Mutuel office of the association within twenty four hours of buying or cashing a valid ticket or voucher.

No ruling made by the Stewards/Judges or the Ontario Racing Commission with regard to distribution of purse money or the placing of horses in the order of finish, after the race has been declared official, shall have any bearing on the pay-out prices or distribution of pari-mutuel pools.

Change boards and Photo Finish display monitors are located in the Grandstand. In addition, Photo Finish pictures are shown on the closed-circuit television system. Customers are reminded that mutuel clerks are responsible for all shortages. When making a wager, customers must present sufficient funds at the time of purchase to cover the wagers requested.

ENTRIES AND MUTUEL FIELDS

"Entry" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled or considered as the same betting interest. The most common reason for the coupling of horses in an Entry is the fact that they are owned by the same person.

"Mutuel Field" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled because the number of horses in the race exceeds the number which can be handled separately by the pari-mutuel system. Subject to the Regulations, a bet on one horse of an Entry or Mutuel Field shall be considered a bet on all horses in that Entry or Mutuel Field.

DAILY DOUBLE BETTING (INCLUDING LATE DOUBLE)

A Daily Double bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of the two races specified for the Daily Double. Tickets not selecting the winner of the first half of the Daily Double and all tickets in the second half of the Daily Double not coupled with the declared official winner of the first half of the Daily Double are not winners and are not refunded no matter what circumstances affect the running of the second half of the Daily Double.

Should a horse or horses (not coupled with another starter) be excused from starting in the second race of the Daily Double after the first race of the Daily Double has closed for betting, holders of all Daily Double tickets on such horses, coupled with the winner of the first Daily Double race, shall participate in a Consolation Double pool. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

EXACTA (Also known as Exactor)/TRIFECTA (Also known as Triactor)/SUPERFECTA

An Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first two, three and four horses respectively, representing different betting interests to finish in the exact official order of finish, in the race on which the pool is operated.

SWINGER (Also known as OMNI)

A Swinger is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select horses to finish in any order from the official first 3 positions.

JACKPOT HI-5

A Jackpot Hi-5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners in the specified Jackpot Hi-5 race. If there are races that have an entry, (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B), Jackpot Hi-5 will not offer a wager consisting of both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in a Jackpot Hi-5, the payout would be 1st, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th.

That jackpot portion of the pool will only be paid out if there is a single winning ticket. If there are multiple winning tickets that have correctly chosen the first 5 runners of the race, they will receive 50% of the pool for that day. The other 50% will go over into the Jackpot carryover. If there are no winning tickets with the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners, 100% of the current day's pool will be carried over into the Jackpot.

PICK 3 & PICK 4 BETTING

The Pick 3 & Pick 4 bets are betting transactions in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of three or four successive races specified for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 respectively.

Winning tickets for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 are determined in the following sequence: A) winners of all legs, B) most winners, then refund. If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners. If there are no winners in any leg of a pool, the entire pool is refunded.

PICK 5 BETTING

The Pick 5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of five successive races specified for the Pick 5 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 5 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 5.

PICK 6 BETTING

The Pick 6 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of six successive races specified for the Pick 6 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 6 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 6.

PICK 5 & 6 BETTING

If at least 1 race as part of the Pick 5 or 6 has been cancelled or declared "No contest", but not more than the specified below under Refunds, the net pool shall be distributed to those selecting the most # of winners and NOT include any carryover from a previous pool.

PICK 3, PICK 4, PICK 5 & PICK 6 SCRATCHES

In the event a Pick 3, Pick 4, Pick 5 or Pick 6 ticket designates as a selection a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the Stewards/Judges to be a non-starter in any of the races comprising the Pick 3, Pick 4, Pick 5 or Pick 6 the favourite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection. In the event that the money bet in the win pool for two or more favourites is identical, the selection with the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non-starting selection.

However, if a scratch occurs in any leg of the Pick 3, Pick 4, Pick 5 or Pick 6 pools before the pool is closed, a ticket including the scratched horse may be cancelled.

REFUNDS

Subject to the Regulations, all monies in all pools on a race are refunded in the event that the race is cancelled, declared off or declared no contest, and all monies bet on a horse are refunded if the horse is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start. These refunds will be communicated to the public through various means such as betting terminals, video display, changes boards and our website.

The Pick(n) pool shall be cancelled and all Pick(n) wagers for the individual performance shall be refunded if:

- Pick-3: at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

Where a horse that is part of an Entry is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start and at least one horse of that Entry receives a fair start in the race, all tickets purchased on the Entry remain valid and the purchase price of any such ticket shall not be refunded.

COMMON POOL WAGERING (INTERTRACK BETTING)

In the unlikely event of a communications or computer system failure that prevents pools from merging with the host track's pools before the end of a race, CPMA regulations require that the site must refund all tickets for that race. This refund will be communicated to the public through various means such as video displays, change boards and messages on our website.

FAIR START

If a horse has reached the Fair Start Pole (located 200 feet before the Starting Pole) by the time the mobile gate has reached the Starting Pole, that horse is deemed to have had a fair start. It makes no difference whether or not the horse is on or off stride at that precise moment. Under current policy and regulations, which are designed to be as fair as possible to all bettors on all starters, there is no Recall - a repeat of the entire starting procedure - when a horse does not reach the Fair Start Pole before the gate reaches the Starting Pole. Monies bet on such a horse are refunded in accordance with the regulation concerning refunds.

LOST & OLD TICKETS

WEG issued tickets or vouchers are valid indefinitely, however, they cannot be cashed at a mutuel teller after 2 years from date of issue. Please mail tickets, along with your name and address, to Mutuel Manager, P.O. Box 156, Rexdale, Ontario, M9W 5L2, keeping a photocopy for future reference.

For "Lost Tickets" originally sold at a Woodbine Entertainment Group racetrack or Teletheatre, please enquire at the Mutuel office at Woodbine, Greenwood Teletheatre, or Mohawk. Policy may be subject to change retroactively in the event regulatory bodies amend existing regulations.

ASSOCIATION PERCENTAGE, AND TAXATION/LEVY

The Woodbine Entertainment Group deducts and retains the following percentages from wagers placed at our own licensed sites which are then shared with the horsepeople, host and simulcast associations and the Ontario Racing Commission.

WOODBINE/MOHAWK LIVE: Win, Place & Show: 13.65%. Swinger 14.7%. Trifecta & Pick 4: 21.7%. Double & Exacta 17.2%. Jackpot Hi-5, Pick 5 & Pick 6: 11.7%. All other 23.0%

Horsepeople receive a further 2% on all wagers, except Trifecta wagering where it is 4%. The Ontario Provincial Government retains 0.5% on all bets placed in Ontario. The Canadian Government (through a revolving fund cost recovery basis) retains 0.8% on all wagers placed in Canada for provision of drug control, and audit services.
