Betting Basics

Some essentials to get you started with making a wager.

1 How to wager



Place your bet by visiting a teller, or using a self-serve terminal.

To place a bet here are just 5 things you need to know:

- 1 Name of racetrack (choose from any track in the simulcast feeds)
- 2 Number of the race
- 3 Amount of your bet (e.g. \$2)
- 4 Type of bet (see step 2)
- 5 Horse's number (see step 4)

Once you have decided what you want to bet, head to the nearest seller's window and use the sample statement as your guide:

Hello, (Racetrack), race 6, \$2 to WIN on Horse #4

How to use a self-serve terminal:

- 1 Swipe your Cash Card/Insert Cash
- 2 Enter the initial PIN #1234 (then choose a new PIN)
- 3 Press/Tap the track you would like to bet: (defaults to current race)
- 4 Tap the Horse Number: **#4**
- 5 Press/Tap the Bet Type: **WIN**
- 6 Press/Tap the Bet Amount: **\$2**
- 7 Press/Tap the Race Number: **Race #6**
- 8 Press Green “**Make BET**” button
- 9 Press/Tap the “**Finish with Receipt**” button
- 10 Be sure to check your ticket to confirm it's the bet you wanted

To get a Cash Card or for assistance ask a teller, or a staff member.

2 Types of bets



Single horse bets (minimum \$2.00 bet is required)

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Win	U U U	Your horse must finish 1st; payoff determined by the win odds.
Place	U U	Your horse must finish 1st or 2nd; payoffs better than to show.
Show	U	Your horse must finish 1st, 2nd, or 3rd; modest payoffs.

Exotic multiple-horse bets

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Exacta*	U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st and 2nd in exact order; riskier bet that can pay a little or a lot, depending on the horses' odds.
Daily double	U U U U U	Pick the winners of two designated consecutive races.
Pick 3, Win 4, Pick 5, Pick 6	U U U U U U	Select the winners of a designated set of consecutive races. The wager must be made prior to the start of the first race in the multi-race wager.
Triactor*	U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in exact order; can be expensive to play if you use a lot of horses.
Superfecta*	U U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th; big payoff possible.

* Exotic bets require the horses to finish in the EXACT order you select, unless you “BOX” the bet, in which case your selections can finish in any order.

- 2 Horse's post position colour
- 3 Horse's colour, sex, age,sire (father), dam (mother), sire of the dam
- 4 Morning line odds
- 5 Horse's name
- 6 Driver and Driver Record (Name, # of wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, winning %)

- 7 Trainer information
- 8 Horse's Lifetime record (with best win time, track size, track, age, lifetime wins and lifetime earnings)

4 The odds



Odds are also important to consider when choosing your horse. Horses that are thought to have a better chance of winning will typically have lower odds.

Morning line odds

Odds listed in the race program are the “morning line” odds. These are predictions of how the public will bet on the race. They are set by the track’s handicapper when the race program is published, before the wagering starts.

The actual odds will be posted on the **Television** or in-field on the **Tote Board** before the race; they change up until post time, depending on how customers are betting on each horse in the race.

Calculating a \$2 win prize

To calculate a win prize, find the Odds of a horse on the **Television** or **Tote Board** (in-field board).

Multiply the first number by 2, then divide that number by the second digit (if there is one), and then add \$2. Simple as that!

Odds	1/2	2/1	7/2	5/1	10/1
Pays	\$3.00	\$6.00	\$9.00	\$12.00	\$22.00

Helpful facts for betting

- Some racetracks have a television simulcast commentator who tries to identify winning horses (handicaps) between the races. Listen and see if you can pick up any good tips to bet on.
- A good betting method is to choose horses with current odds two to three times higher than their morning line odds.

3 Tips to remember

WIN BETS on the **FAVOURITE** pay 32% of the time
PLACE BETS on the **FAVOURITE** pay 53% of the time
SHOW BETS on the **FAVOURITE** pay 67% of the time

#3 HIRO HANOVER is a \$13,000 Lexington Sale buy that was sent off at 83 to 1 here on debut two weeks ago, and he certainly outraced those odds at first asking. He was ready for action coming in off two even qualifiers. He blasted straight to the front leaving the gate then accepted the pocket when the overwhelming 1 to 5 favorite ranged up to take command passing the quarter. He followed well in the pocket from there, and he finished a clear third, pacing a snappy 28 1/5 kicker. This Dr. Peter Johnston trainee lands in a good spot tonight, and he gets top billing to kick off the \$75,000 guaranteed Pick 5.

#6 CARDINAL CREED, an \$18,000 London Classic Sale purchase is an unaltered son of Big Jim that makes his debut here as a sophomore tonight and judging by the way he raced in his lone qualifier eight days ago, he has some talent to offer. Racing in the snow on a less-than-ideal morning, the half brother to 11-time winner Conquest Seelster looked like a seasoned pro. After tucking into the pocket early, he followed the leader to the stretch where he was guided to the outside with three sixteenths to go. He eased past the leader late under his own energy with driver Dale Spence sitting like a statue in the bike. His mile of 1:59 over a track that was assigned a three second variant stacks up well in this field and he should be a threat in this maiden voyage.

#4 LOU KNOWS was raced aggressively here two starts back and he stuck around for a small share. He then drew post 10 and dropped back and showed little while finishing far behind Hiro Hanover. Getting needed post relief tonight means he will almost certainly be closer early. He's worth a look for the bottom of Tri and Super bets.

#2 CAPTAINS LEGACY came close to winning here two starts back, then he was victimized by a slow pace in his last start. He did get some decent cover in the back half though, and he could do no better than close for fourth, 1 1/4 lengths behind Hiro Hanover at the wire. He is another one that I would consider using on the bottom.

#2 MIRACULOUS DESBI N raced at a level similar to this one two starts back, and while he disappointed the bettors that made him a 6 to 5 favorite that night, he did race well in defeat. Racing in the rain, he pulled first-over on the last turn, and he had a long way to come. He kept grinding and finished a clear third in a good effort. He stepped up to the top class last week, where he wasn't disgraced, and him pacing a 26 4/5 kicker should keep him sharp. Dropping back down in class tonight, he will likely get a more aggressive steer, and he gets the call to take his first North American win here.

#1 GET WINGS was a trip handicapper's dream last week after getting shut off in the lane the week before in a mile where he would have finished second to Pacino Hanover had he found a clear lane to race in the stretch. He was no secret last week, however, as he got bet down to 3 to 5 on the class drop. Starting from the best post, he was hustled to the lead early, and once he made front, he left no doubt, pacing his way to an easy win over a decent field. He has been sharp for several weeks, and he figures to be right there again tonight despite stepping up one class level.

#3 JABBERWOCKY dropped in class last week and he returned to a seven-day cycle after missing a month prior to his mile two starts back. His odds dropped from 68 to 1 to 9 to 1, and he improved as expected, coming on late to get third. I don't see him as a threat to win here, but he can pass some rivals late again and land in the bottom of the Tri or Super.

#4 JACK PANIC was picked to win last week because he got an impossible trip the week before, then he dropped in class and picked up driver Doug McNair last week. He was game in victory now he steps up to face much tougher. I could see him sitting a good trip and sticking around for a small slice tonight.

#2 JJ XAVIER shipped here from Ottawa and raced at this level on December 20th on five days rest and he got a tough trip that night and he backed up late after cutting a fast opening three quarters, he backed up late. He bounced back well a week later when he got a class drop and the leading driver in the bike, and he got the job done as the 4 to 5 favorite. He doubled up against a decent field at Flamboro Downs, then he jumped back up into the \$30,000 to \$40,000 Claiming Handicap level two weeks ago. He was the first leader that night, then he took a mid race shuffle and re-rallied. Last week, he got the toughest trip and didn't miss by much. There isn't much between many of these, and I'll give him the nod expecting he will find a helmet to follow this time.

#4 HF PANS SHADOW on January 10th missed the board for the first time in 14 starts since returning from a vet scratch on September 30th. He raced out of the Garry Merner barn, and he had missed a week, then last two weeks ago, he got back to a seven-day rotation after getting reclaimed by trainer Carm Auciello who sent him out to two straight wins in late December. He rallied well to get second that night, then he came back last week, and, after following the good cover that JJ Xavier provided, he got up late for the win. He is sharp and dangerous, and he is another to consider in this opening leg of tonight's early Pick 4.

#8 EARLY ACTION got post and class relief last week coming off a decent effort where he closed wide late and passed a few rivals to get up for fourth. Starting from the best post last week, he tried to go down the road, and he fell only a head short of beating JJ Xavier and HF Pans Shadow despite finishing with a broken headpole. He draws widest here racing off the Vic Puddy claim, and he is in with a chance.

#5 SOMETIMES SOMEWHERE is one of those that always seems to be closing on the end of his miles, and last week was no exception. He rode cover to the lane, and he appeared on the scene late, but as often happens with him, it was too late. He will be passing rivals in the final quarter again tonight, and he can land in the bottom of the Tri or Super.

#1 MYULTIMATE SNOWY A hasn't raced this low in a while, since he raced in a Pop Up series against similar competition in September, and he took his lifetime mark of 1:51 1/5 that night. He should be well prepared for this 2026 debut based on the way he won his qualifier eight days ago. He was sent right to the front, and after leading through a moderate opening quarter, he kept rolling on the engine, and he ended up pacing the fastest mile of the morning, a 1:56 1/5 mile over a track that was assigned a three second variant. The only downside I see with him is his record of 1-5-4 from 23 starts last year. He gets the nod to kick off tonight's 20-cent Pick 6, but I wouldn't take too short of a price here.

#7 LOGAN BEHOLD has only taken two shares in six starts since shipping here from Ottawa in December, and he comes out of a mile where he rode good cover to the stretch then hung and lost some positions. That's the bad news. The good news is, like the top pick here, he gets needed class relief. I expect that he will get an aggressive Daryl Thiessen in this spot, and he is another that I would consider for use on early multi-race tickets.

#3 SOARING NOW returns to action off an okay qualifier after having choked down and pulled up in his most recent start here on December 20th. Many will remember a couple of big winning miles that he produced here last spring, a 1:47 4/5 lifetime best score followed by another win, both of them at the top level. This non-winners of \$2,500 last four class would be a piece of cake for him if he was close to his best, but it's hard to know what to expect here. I like that he was tried on the front end in the qualifier. Let price be your guide here.

#8 LARCENY is another class dropper that is worth a look here especially when you can see that he won at a higher level five starts back. He will be dropping back early and looking to pass most of them in the back half. If there is any mid race battling, he may roll past them all. He is another option in a good betting race.

#3 D A MISS UNIVERSE was an impressive debut winner here on December 19th. After sitting fifth to the last turn, she moved out, pulled widest in the stretch and easily sailed past the leaders. She stepped up in her second start, and she went off as an overlay because the leading driver chose another over her. She ended up getting a perfect steer from Mike Whelan who retained the drive for her third start, and he provided her with another good steer, keeping her covered up to the lane before tipping widest. She stayed game to the wire and edged clear late. She made her move too late in the first leg of this series then she was a weather scratch in Leg 2. She gets a driver change to Dave Kelly here and she could get the best trip in this spot stalking the leaders. Her price should make her worth a play.

#9 LETS N JOY N was purchased privately after winning four of her first seven starts racing Down Under last season. She paced a nice qualifier here on January 3rd and she followed that up with a very impressive winning effort at Flamboro Downs two weeks later where she made an impressive wide brush in the final quarter. She was equally impressive winning her Mohawk Park debut as the 2 to 5 favorite here last week, re-rallying after giving up the lead in the third quarter. She showed she has the speed to get away well from the gate that night, and she is the one to beat here.

#8 KOBRA KATE got a great trip to win here two starts back in the opening leg of this series, and I thought she was over bet last week, closing at 4 to 5. She showed convincingly that the bettors that hammered her down to that price knew what they were doing as she went right down the road to score the repeat. She is an obvious threat trying for the series sweep tonight.

#5 SHURI caught the eye in deep stretch on January 9th as she was really flying late in that mile. That was her second strong start in a row, then she tried different tactics in the first two legs of this series, racing closer to the front. She will likely drop back and look to rally this time, and she can get a piece of this.

#1 RIPASSO was only a one-time winner last season, but he did take nine slices, and he earned more than \$50,000. His seasonal debut raced at this level last week gives reason for optimism as he tries the same class level here a week later. After sitting last of seven for the opening three quarters, he moved out and commenced a closing rally that saw him pace a strong 27 1/5 kicker to get up for fourth. If he can lay a bit closer and find a live helmet to follow, he might be the one in here, and he should offer a good price in this spot. He gets the nod to kick off tonight's late Pick 5.

#2 STONEBRIDGE HELIOS will likely take plenty of action tonight coming into this seasonal debut off an impressive blowout win over a decent field that included the good mare Absolution. He is another infrequent winner, but he stacks up well in this field, and he will likely get an aggressive Billy Davis Jr. steer in this spot. If he can make the lead at some point of the mile, he may prove to be tough to overhaul.

#4 JORDY N is a Down Under shipper that got bet down to 6 to 5 in his North American debut on January 10th, and he added Lasix for that first pari-mutuel start over this track. While he didn't reward the punters faith in him, he certainly had a valid excuse. As he was making a move to the outside on the backstretch, a rival pulled late in front of him, sending him three wide where he raced for the entire back half. Remarkably, he kept coming and stayed game right to the wire to get third. He raced okay first up in his next start, then last week, he was first-over again and he couldn't get past a class dropper. He is sharp and he will get that first local win soon, maybe tonight.

#8 GINGER TREE FINNY raced first-over against a strong 3 to 5 winner last week, and that was a trip that simply wasn't going to work. Perhaps starting widest, he can drop in mid pack this time and find a helmet to follow, and that trip can lead him to a spot in the Tri or Super.

#9 ERINWOOD BIG MACK showed up here on December 20th with mediocre Flamboro Downs form and showing a stale date, and he announced he was coming around to his best form that night. He was sent first up before the half, and he provided the winning cover while staying game to the wire. In his next start on December 27th, he vaulted off cover at the head of the lane and drove away to an easy win. He stepped up to non-winners of three on January 3rd, and he drew best, and it was a bit surprising to see him drop right to the back and race from last. He followed to the stretch and passed a couple of rivals then he tipped wide and really kicked in late to get up for third. Then on January 10th, he drew wide and he dropped back then made a powerful wide move coming off the last turn to gain the lead in the stretch. He got picked off very late by a rival that hid on his cover then pounced and nipped him. Last week, he was forced to move wide around stalled cover on the last turn, and he managed to get the job done. He will offer a good price here stepping up and drawing wide, but he is in great form, and I'll take a value swing with him.

#5 MAGICAL BET raced well in defeat here racing in this non-winners of three class on January 17th, but his odds still climbed last week. Undaunted by the lack of support, he produced an eye-catching stretch move to roll past the leaders from last and get up for his first win of the season. He gets a better draw here which could mean that he will get positioned closer to the front. He is a threat to repeat.

#6 BLUE BAR got the trip and the win two starts back on January 17th, then he was bet down to 3 to 2 favorite last week and he tried the front end and things didn't go as well. He draws best here and that gives him a chance to find the pocket again as he did early last week, and he will likely look to sit a trip like he did two starts back. He is another in with a chance here.

#7 TRINIDAD was in a tough spot racing around the final turn last week, buried at the back on the inside. He had pace in the lane, but he had to idle briefly then angle out and follow Magical Bet after that rival made his move. He would not have caught that winner regardless, and he is probably best used underneath in this spot.

#5 RBSTENACIOUS T showed improvement in the opening leg of the Valedictory series six starts back when he was raced more aggressively. He pulled from fifth at the half, and he took a clear lead on the last turn before being engaged in battle by one of the even money co-favorites. In the end, he couldn't fend off either of the two favorites, but he did stick around for a small slice. In Leg 2, he was again driven aggressively, and his chances improved greatly when Blazing Cruiser broke at the start. Still, he was impressive in victory, carving out a big opening half then bottoming the field out. He couldn't get the job done in the final of that series and he backed up when the 1 to 5 favorite popped out of the pocket and drove past him on the final turn. Then, on January 10th, he produced an impressive back half rally to get the job done versus non-winners of two leading into the opening leg of the Snowshoe Pacing series last week where he dominated. He was again a strong winner in Leg 2, and he is the bone to beat in this Final as we kick off tonight's late Pick 4.

#4 THE TULSA KING's form leading up to his win in the opening leg of this series was a bit darkened because he had been in too tough. He finished off the month of November with two miles that were paced in 1:52-flat and 1:51 2/5 respectively, then he tried the Valedictory series with mixed results. In the opening leg of this series, he blasted off the gate right to the front then he accepted the pocket and followed leader Booker Seelster to the lane then he popped out to begin his charge. He outsprinted the leader to get up on the line, then he missed Leg 2 of this series. He will likely get overlooked here, but he is capable with the right trip, and he is worth using in the late Pick 4.

#1 BOOKER SEELSTER came into the opening leg of this series off a strong effort three starts back when he was a close second to Chef, who then came right back to win again. In that opening leg two weeks ago, he made a predictable move to the front in the second quarter as the even money favorite. He set reasonable fractions then tried to sprint away from The Tulsa King at the head of the lane, but that rival stuck with him and eventually nipped him at the wire. He came back to beat a weak field as the 1 to 9 favorite last week, and I'll play to beat him starting from the rail tonight.

#8 COLD CREEK PANTERA finished third in five of his last six starts including the opening two legs of this series and he will offer a big price here. He is worth a look for the bottom of the Tri and Super.

#3 BLUE HUNT continued a hot run for the Jodie Cullen barn by almost scoring the upset in this top class last week. After sitting last of six to the final turn, he moved outside on cover, and responding to Billy Davis Jr's urging in the lane, he motored down the middle of the track and just failed to get up for the upset. He has been racing from the back recently, but this field looks ripe for the picking for a sharp contender that takes control of the mile on the engine, and I expect that he will get a more aggressive drive in this spot. He gets top billing.

#5 DUBLIN DASHER, stablemate to the choice, is another sharp racehorse that closed like a rocket in the lane last week to take his first win of the season. He takes a big jump in class tonight, but he has raced well at the top class level several times in the past. He will likely look to sit and rally, and I could see him scoring the repeat with the right trip at a nice price.

#1 SAULSBROOK VICTOR dropped and he was expected to pop as the 2 to 5 favorite last week, but he had no answer for Dublin Dasher's stretch onslaught. There doesn't seem to be many leavers in this field, and he could get a great trip racing close to the front, and that makes him a viable contender in this spot. He is the third one in here that I would consider using on late multi-race tickets.

#6 TAURASI made an uncharacteristic break while leading two starts back, then last week, he sat a perfect trip following Brue Hanover, but he was one-paced in the lane, and he ended up finishing last of six. He was going well prior to those two starts, and while he is never a surprise when he wins at this level, he doesn't appear to be in the best form currently, and I'll play to beat him as a probable underlay.

#4 TWIN B ALLIANCE was a dominant maiden breaker three starts back here, winning off impressively after racing first-over, and he fired back with another nice effort when finishing third. In that mile two starts back, he dropped to absolute last early and he worked his way through the field late to get up for the show dough. Last week, he again rallied from the back, making a wide move on the final turn and just missing getting up for his second win of the season. That was a strong effort, and he stacks up well in this field. I wonder if he will get a more aggressive drive this time to avoid traffic issues. The smaller field should help his cause anyway.

#2 ALL BETS ON GARY got plucked out of a \$20,000 claimer in London on January 13th by trainer Jean-Francois Maguire, and he immediately produced a good effort here for the new barn racing at this non-winners of two level last week. He latched onto the cover of the 2 to 5 race favorite in the third quarter, and he rode that third-over cover to mid stretch. He was produced in the middle of the track to go after that leader, but that rival was too strong, and he won while under no urging late. This son of All Bets Off finished a clear second, and he looks like one of the main contenders in here, one that is hard to leave off late multi-race tickets.

#5 HASSELHOFF raced okay in defeat here two starts back when he dropped into a claimer after contesting the Valedictory Series. That got the attention of trainer Carmen Auciello, who took him for \$20,000 last week. He steps back up into a conditioned field here, and he will likely find the top two picks in here too tough, but he can take another share.

#3 CONVOY TWENTY TWO produced a nice late rally to get third last week, and he was visually moving well at the wire, but he got set back for a pylon violation that occurred earlier in the mile. He is one that can pass some of these late and he is worth a look for the bottom of the Tri and Super.

#4 TITANIC HANOVER shipped in from Alberta on January 18th, and he dropped into an \$8,000 conditioned claimer. He advanced gradually on slow moving cover on the final turn then he rallied well late to get up for third, and he would have finished second if the race were a few strides longer. He was claimed by Jason McGinnis for himself, and a partner and he gets into a slightly easier condition tonight. He gets top billing under the assumption that he will get a more aggressive steer tonight, he gets top billing.

#2 THUMANN raced okay in London three starts back, then the next week, starting from a better post, his odds dropped from 45 to 1 to 5 to 2. He rewarded the public's faith by scoring a thrilling come from behind win, then he was even more impressive scoring the repeat win on January 12th where he went first up and raced the even money favorite into submission. He is clearly much-improved, and the only concern tonight is the two-and-a-half weeks between starts.

#9 ARAGONITE is a bit hard to figure because he can be really good...or the opposite. He crushed the field in two straight starts at this level five and six starts back then he moved up and he found the company too tough. Dropping back into a conditioned claimer tonight gives him a chance to turn his form around, and he will probably offer a good price based on his most recent chart line. I'd consider him for Pick 4 tickets.

#6 SUPA FAST dropped to this level last week and he produced the first top three finish since being claimed on November 27th. He fits okay in this field, and he can close late to take another share.

#10 PASSIONATE PRINCE comes off a decent closing effort, and he is one that takes small shares frequently. He will likely be passing some horses late, and he could add some value to the bottom of the Super or High-5 because he won't get bet at all in this spot.



CONDITIONS AND ALLOWANCES IN HARNESS RACING - IMPORTANT TO KNOW

The conditions of a race determine whether a horse is eligible to enter. For example many races are restricted to horses that have won a certain number of races or a certain amount of money in a specified number of starts. Many races are restricted to horses entered to be "claimed" (offered for sale) at a specific price.

Allowances in the claiming price itself are given to colts and geldings, four-year-olds and younger and to mares, five-year-olds and younger.

The purpose of the allowance is to keep younger horses more competitive when racing against older and more experienced rivals. Mares are given extra consideration in claiming events because of their potential as broodmares.

The accompanying chart shows what the allowances are, but an example may make them easier to understand. The chart indicates that three-year-olds receive a 50% allowance in claiming races. This means that a three-year-old entered in a \$20,000 claiming race carries an actual claiming price of \$30,000 (50% higher).

Fillies and mares receive an additional 25% allowance in claiming races. Details of the race conditions and claiming price (if any) are given at the top of each race in the program.

ALLOWANCES FOR PURSE EARNINGS

When Fillies/Mares compete against Colts/Geldings (normally on the trot) Fillies/Mares will receive an additional 25% on the condition of the race. ie: nv \$5,000 (FM \$6,250) last 5 or \$12,000 (FM \$15,000) last 10 starts.

C.P.M.A. Regulation Changes

Effective January 1st 2012

CPMA will be instituting several new rule changes with regards to the following pari-mutuel pools:

Pick Pools

- If there are no winners in any leg of a Pick N pool, the entire pool is refunded.
- If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners.
- A pool is no longer refunded if the 1st leg in the pool is cancelled or declared no contest.
- Pick-3: If at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: If at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.

EXPLANATION OF THE LASIX PROGRAM

After careful study and consultation with Ontario Horsemen's groups, racetrack operators and veterinarians, Agriculture Canada and the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario passed legislation allowing the controlled (or supervised) administration of furosemide, more commonly called "Lasix". "Lasix" is used to alleviate the symptoms of exercise induced pulmonary hemorrhaging in racing horses.

Horses will undergo an endoscopic examination of the trachea by a veterinarian licensed by the Ontario Racing Commission and endorsed by an official veterinarian before being allowed on the medication list. Once qualified, horses will be treated with "Lasix" within four hours plus or minus 15 minutes of a scheduled race in a secure retention area under the super vision of racing officials.

All horses on "Lasix" must remain on the program for a minimum of 100 days while racing in this jurisdiction.

RULES AND INFORMATION REGARDING CANADIAN HARNESS AND FOREIGN SEPARATE POOL EVENTS

GENERAL

All pari-mutuel pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with the regulations and directives as issued by Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada ("the Regulations"), under the approval and supervision of the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency. The Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency can be contacted at 1-800-268-8835 or 613-759-6100 or Email: cpmawebacpm@agr.gc.ca. A complete version of the CPMA regulations can be found at <http://laws-lois.justice.gc.ca/eng/regulations/SOR-91-365/>. All tickets should be held until the result of the race is declared official and prices are posted. No person under the age of 18 shall purchase or cash a ticket or voucher.

A claim of receiving an incorrect payment or incorrect change must be made to the Mutuel office of the association within twenty four hours of buying or cashing a valid ticket or voucher.

No ruling made by the Stewards/Judges or the Ontario Racing Commission with regard to distribution of purse money or the placing of horses in the order of finish, after the race has been declared official, shall have any bearing on the pay-out prices or distribution of pari-mutuel pools.

Change boards and Photo Finish display monitors are located in the Grandstand. In addition, Photo Finish pictures are shown on the closed-circuit television system. Customers are reminded that mutuel clerks are responsible for all shortages. When making a wager, customers must present sufficient funds at the time of purchase to cover the wagers requested.

ENTRIES AND MUTUEL FIELDS

"Entry" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled or considered as the same betting interest. The most common reason for the coupling of horses in an Entry is the fact that they are owned by the same person.

"Mutuel Field" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled because the number of horses in the race exceeds the number which can be handled separately by the pari-mutuel system. Subject to the Regulations, a bet on one horse of an Entry or Mutuel Field shall be considered a bet on all horses in that Entry or Mutuel Field.

DAILY DOUBLE BETTING (INCLUDING LATE DOUBLE)

A Daily Double bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of the two races specified for the Daily Double. Tickets not selecting the winner of the first half of the Daily Double and all tickets in the second half of the Daily Double not coupled with the declared official winner of the first half of the Daily Double are not winners and are not refunded no matter what circumstances affect the running of the second half of the Daily Double.

Should a horse or horses (not coupled with another starter) be excused from starting in the second race of the Daily Double after the first race of the Daily Double has closed for betting, holders of all Daily Double tickets on such horses, coupled with the winner of the first Daily Double race, shall participate in a Consolation Double pool. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

EXACTA (Also known as Exactor/TRIFECTA (Also known as Tractor)/SUPERFECTA

An Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first two, three and four horses respectively, representing different betting interests to finish in the exact official order of finish, in the race on which the pool is operated.

SWINGER (Also known as OMNI)

A Swinger is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select horses to finish in any order from the official first 3 positions.

JACKPOT HI-5

A Jackpot Hi-5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners in the specified Jackpot Hi-5 race. If there are races that have an entry, (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B), Jackpot Hi-5 will not offer a wager consisting of both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in a Jackpot Hi-5, the payout would be 1st, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th. That jackpot portion of the pool will only be paid out if there is a single winning ticket. If there are multiple winning tickets that have correctly chosen the first 5 runners of the race, they will receive 50% of the pool for that day. The other 50% will go over into the Jackpot carryover. If there are no winning tickets with the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners, 100% of the current day's pool will be carried over into the Jackpot.

PICK 3 & PICK-4 BETTING

The Pick 3 & Pick 4 bets are betting transactions in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of three or four successive races specified for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 respectively.

Winning tickets for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 are determined in the following sequence: A) winners of all legs, B) most winners, then refund. If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners. If there are no winners in any leg of a pool, the entire pool is refunded.

PICK 5 BETTING

The Pick 5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of five successive races specified for the Pick 5 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 5 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 5.

PICK 6 BETTING

The Pick 6 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of six successive races specified for the Pick 6 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 6 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 6.

PICK 3 & 6 BETTING

If at least 1 race as part of the Pick 5 or 6 has been cancelled or declared "No contest", but not more than the specified below under Refunds, the net pool shall be distributed to those selecting the most # of winners and NOT include any carryover from a previous pool.

PICK 3, PICK 4, PICK 5 & PICK 6 SCRATCHES

In the event a Pick 3, Pick 4, Pick 5 or Pick 6 ticket designates as a selection a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the Stewards/Judges to be a non-starter in any of the races comprising the Pick 3, Pick 4, Pick 5 or Pick 6 the favourite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection. In the event that the money bet in the win pool for two or more favourites is identical, the selection with the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non-starting selection.

However, if a scratch occurs in any leg of the Pick 3, Pick 4, Pick 5 or Pick 6 pools before the pool is closed, a ticket including the scratched horse may be cancelled.

REFUNDS

Subject to the Regulations, all monies in all pools on a race are refunded in the event that the race is cancelled, declared off or declared no contest, and all monies bet on a horse are refunded if the horse is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start. These refunds will be communicated to the public through various means such as betting terminals, video display, change boards and our website. The Pick(n) pool shall be cancelled and all Pick(n) wagers for the individual performance shall be refunded if:

- Pick-3: at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

Where a horse that is part of an Entry is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start and at least one horse of that Entry receives a fair start in the race, all tickets purchased on the Entry remain valid and the purchase price of any such ticket shall not be refunded.

COMMON POOL WAGERING (INTERTRACK BETTING)

In the unlikely event of a communications or computer system failure that prevents pools from merging with the host track's pools before the end of a race, CPMA regulations require that the site must refund all tickets for that race. This refund will be communicated to the public through various means such as video displays, change boards and messages on our website.

FAIR START

If a horse has reached the Fair Start Pole (located 200 feet before the Starting Pole) by the time the mobile gate has reached the Starting Pole, that horse is deemed to have had a fair start. It makes no difference whether or not the horse is on or off stride at that precise moment. Under current policy and regulations, which are designed to be as fair as possible to all bettors on all starters, there is no Recall - a repeat of the entire starting procedure - when a horse does not reach the Fair Start Pole before the gate reaches the Starting Pole. Monies bet on such a horse are refunded in accordance with the regulation concerning refunds.

LOST & OLD TICKETS

WEG issued tickets or vouchers are valid indefinitely, however, they cannot be cashed at a mutuel teller after 2 years from date of issue. Please mail tickets, along with your name and address, to Mutuel Manager, P.O. Box 156, Rexdale, Ontario, M9W 5L2, keeping a photocopy for future reference.

For "Lost Tickets" originally sold at a Woodbine Entertainment Group racetrack or Teletheatre, please enquire at the Mutuel office at Woodbine, Greenwood Teletheatre, or Mohawk. Policy may be subject to change retroactively in the event regulatory bodies amend existing regulations.

ASSOCIATION PERCENTAGE, AND TAXATION/LEVY

The Woodbine Entertainment Group deducts and retains the following percentages from wagers placed at our own licensed sites which are then shared with the horsepeople, host and simulcast associations and the Ontario Racing Commission.

WOODBINE/MOHAWK LIVE: Win, Place & Show: 13.65%. Swinger 14.7%. Trifecta & Pick 4: 21.1%. Double & Exacta 17.2%. Jackpot Hi-5, Pick 5 & Pick 6: 11.1%. All other 23.0%

Horsepeople receive a further 2% on all wagers, except Trifecta wagering where it is 4%. The Ontario Provincial Government retains 0.5% on all bets placed in Ontario. The Canadian Government (through a revolving fund cost recovery basis) retains 0.8% on all wagers placed in Canada for provision of drug control, and audit services.
