Betting Basics

Some essentials to get you started with making a wager.

1 How to wager



Place your bet by visiting a teller, or using a self-serve terminal.

To place a bet here are just 5 things you need to know:

- 1 Name of racetrack (choose from any track in the simulcast feeds)
- 2 Number of the race
- 3 Amount of your bet (e.g. \$2)
- 4 Type of bet (see step 2)
- 5 Horse's number (see step 4)

Once you have decided what you want to bet, head to the nearest seller's window and use the sample statement as your guide:

Hello, (Racetrack), race 6, \$2 to WIN on Horse #4

How to use a self-serve terminal:

- 1 Swipe your Cash Card/Insert Cash
- 2 Enter the initial PIN #1234 (then choose a new PIN)
- 3 Press/Tap the track you would like to bet: (defaults to current race)
- 4 Tap the Horse Number: **#4**
- 5 Press/Tap the Bet Type: **WIN**
- 6 Press/Tap the Bet Amount: **\$2**
- 7 Press/Tap the Race Number: **Race #6**
- 8 Press Green “**Make BET**” button
- 9 Press/Tap the “**Finish with Receipt**” button
- 10 Be sure to check your ticket to confirm it's the bet you wanted

To get a Cash Card or for assistance ask a teller, or a staff member.

2 Types of bets



Single horse bets (minimum \$2.00 bet is required)

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Win	U U U	Your horse must finish 1st; payoff determined by the win odds.
Place	U U	Your horse must finish 1st or 2nd; payoffs better than to show.
Show	U	Your horse must finish 1st, 2nd, or 3rd; modest payoffs.

Exotic multiple-horse bets

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Exacta*	U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st and 2nd in exact order; riskier bet that can pay a little or a lot, depending on the horses' odds.
Daily double	U U U U U	Pick the winners of two designated consecutive races.
Pick 3, Win 4, Pick 5, Pick 6	U U U U U U	Select the winners of a designated set of consecutive races. The wager must be made prior to the start of the first race in the multi-race wager.
Triactor*	U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in exact order; can be expensive to play if you use a lot of horses.
Superfecta*	U U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th; big payoff possible.

* Exotic bets require the horses to finish in the EXACT order you select, unless you “BOX” the bet, in which case your selections can finish in any order.

- 1 Horse's number in the race
- 2 Horse's post position colour
- 3 Horse's colour, sex, age,sire (father), dam (mother), sire of the dam
- 4 Morning line odds
- 5 Horse's name
- 6 Driver and Driver Record (Name, # of wins, # of 2nd, # of 3rd, winning %)

- 7 Trainer information
- 8 Horse's Lifetime record (with best win time, track size, track, age, lifetime wins and lifetime earnings)
- 9 Horse's current record (# of races, # wins, # of 2nd, # of 3rd, and money earned)

4 The odds



Odds are also important to consider when choosing your horse. Horses that are thought to have a better chance of winning will typically have lower odds.

Morning line odds

Odds listed in the race program are the “morning line” odds. These are predictions of how the public will bet on the race. They are set by the track’s handicapper when the race program is published, before the wagering starts.

The actual odds will be posted on the **Television** or in-field on the **Tote Board** before the race; they change up until post time, depending on how customers are betting on each horse in the race.

Calculating a \$2 win prize

To calculate a win prize, find the Odds of a horse on the **Television** or **Tote Board** (in-field board).

Multiply the first number by 2, then divide that number by the second digit (if there is one), and then add \$2. Simple as that!

Odds	1/2	2/1	7/2	5/1	10/1
Pays	\$3.00	\$6.00	\$9.00	\$12.00	\$22.00

Helpful facts for betting

- Some racetracks have a television simulcast commentator who tries to identify winning horses (handicaps) between the races. Listen and see if you can pick up any good tips to bet on.
- A good betting method is to choose horses with current odds two to three times higher than their morning line odds.

3 Tips to remember

WIN BETS on the **FAVOURITE** pay 32% of the time
PLACE BETS on the **FAVOURITE** pay 53% of the time
SHOW BETS on the **FAVOURITE** pay 67% of the time

#3 BEACH TOUR was facing much tougher than the ones he meets in this Pop Up Series field when he was last seen here in November, facing the likes of Uncle Shank A and Jabberwocky. His last two starts, where he started from a bad post in two straight in London, don't give a very good indication of what he can do. Perhaps a better indicator came six starts back where he was driven to a 1:50 1/5 lifetime best score while crushing a decent conditioned field. He gets a key driver change to Doug McNair tonight and the expectation is that teamster will send him on a speed mission leaving the gate. He gets top billing to kick off tonight's \$75,000 guaranteed Pick 5.

#7 SPORTSLINE is a 40-time winner that lands in this Pop Up series tonight as he seeks a 41st win in his 137th start. Most recently, he raced tough first-over in London, but he couldn't get past the leader. He draws decently here to leave hard and get a good spot early, and he looks like the main threat to the choice in this spot. He is no stranger to Mohawk Park having taken 11 of his wins at this track, and he is the other one that I would consider using in the early Pick 5.

#6 BETTOR BE GOING will get some action here racing off the Paul Court claim and picking up the leading driver. Getting the best post is another positive. The one negative I see is his typical lack of gate speed as he rarely gets away from the gate in the top three. Because he might get outsprinted early, I'll use him underneath.

#8 PUNCHESINBUNCHES is a 25-time winner that has shown in the past that he can string several wins in a row together, and he will probably get put into this race by catch driver J R Plante, but in this particular spot, I prefer to use him underneath.

#3 PEMBERTON took a class drop last week, and he got bet down to 3 to 1, but he drew the widest post in a field of nine, and the best he could do was get away sixth. He moved third-over on the final turn, and he trotted home well down the middle of the track in the stretch to get up for fourth. He was simply too far behind on that night. He draws better and gets in a field with two fewer horses now, and he can beat this group if he is a bit closer at the three-quarter pole tonight.

#2 DEVILS ARCH got the pocket trip last week that he has deployed on several other occasions to convert into wins. He followed the leader to the lane, and he gamely closed along the inside, but that leader was too good on that night and a 27 3/5 final quarter wasn't enough to propel him to victory. That was a solid try, and he did finish ahead of Pemberton. He can get another good trip racing on the lead or from the pocket, and he is another possibility for the early Pick 5.

#7 DEVASTATE was impressive in victory last week, showing intent to control the race by making a retake early after blasting to the front leaving the gate then getting overtaken before the quarter. He never looked a loser at any point of that race, and he is clearly very sharp right now. The widest post is no issue for him in this seven-horse field, and he is another live contender.

#1 TACTICAL STRIKE took a trip to New Jersey for a three-race stint, and it was fruitless as she didn't take a cheque in any of those three miles, breaking in her last two starts there. She was a good second here five starts back and she raced well in defeat here two starts back, closing widest to get up for second in a strong effort. She laid much closer to the front early in the mile last week, and she produced a strong first-over effort to take her first win of 2026. She steps up into a much tougher spot now, but she should be good for a share here.

#7 MADAM X finished off her 2025 campaign with some breaking issues then she shipped north to join trainer Menary's barn. She came into last week's race off a nice qualifying effort with the leading driver in the bike sitting chilly as the mare drove away to win, as she beat two rivals that morning. She was bet down to 4 to 5 and she didn't disappoint her supporters, making two moves and winning easily. She makes the unusual move of taking on the boys tonight in the opening leg of this Pop Up series, but she doesn't look out of place, and trainer Menary didn't win the dash title here last year by misplacing his stock. She draws well here, and the leading driver sticks with her when had two other options in this field. She gets top billing in this opening leg of tonight's early Pick 4.

#9 TELLIT RUSS TELLIT finished second here four starts back where he was in tight quarters in the stretch, then he drew the same wide post he has here, and he got too far back and closed mildly. He then went to London to take two predictable wins as the big favorite in both miles. He seems to fit well here, and he can be a threat at a price if he can get away in the top five early leaving from the 9-hole.

#1 BUDDYVILLE has been racing well in recent starts, closing for shares in his last three miles. He fits okay in this Pop Up series, but he has taken only one win in his past 35 starts. He will probably get outsprinted early starting from the rail, but he will be passing rivals late, and he can get another slice.

#4 REIGN SUPREME looks good coming in off two straight wins, but he will probably need tonight's mile coming into the race having missed six weeks of action. He can get spotted near the front leaving the gate and probably stick around for a share, but I don't see him as a win threat considering the time missed.

#6 ALL GAS NO BRAKES comes off a decent third-place finish racing against a much tougher field than he meets tonight, and he gets needed class relief now. Moving from the rail to the 6-hole gives him every chance to get a great trip racing near the front, and he should be in front at the eight pole. He hasn't raced this low since last September and after leaving second and getting shuffled back to third, he moved first over and grinded his way to victory as the 4 to 5 favorite. He should be hard to beat in this spot, and he gets top call to kick off the 20-cent Pick 6.

#1 JGS PAL dropped to this level for his last start, and he got post relief, too, and his odds dropped from 74 to 1 in his penultimate start to 5 to 2. Doug McNair moved him to the front on the backstretch, and plowing through the snow on the lead, he stayed game to the wire while getting overtaken by two rivals on the wire. He is the obvious threat to the choice here, and the other possibility for early multi-race tickets.

#4 LIKE CHAOS dropped to this level and he got Trevor Henry in the bike last week, and he was bet down to 2 to 1 favorite. His best game is to motor to the front and try to bottom out the field, and he got taken out of that comfort zone in the second half quarter when he was overtaken for the lead when he slowed the pace down. Owner/trainer Bruce Richardson is back in the bike tonight, and he will likely keep the throttle open the whole way. I don't see this gelding lasting on the engine, but he could provide a perfect target for All Gas No Brakes.

#8 VICTOR INVICTUS got over bet down to 8 to 5 last week, and he could only close mildly to take fourth. He draws wide now facing a tougher field, and his price will be much higher tonight if you still like him. He will likely pass a few of these late and he could sneak into the bottom of the Tri or Super.

#5 SUNDAY SHOES was bet down to 6 to 5 favorite last week, and he was in go, as he was pointed to the front early in the mile. He was soon overtaken by a rival that was intent on controlling the race and neither this gelding, nor any other horse in that race could provide a challenge to that leader in the back half. This gelding draws perfectly for another aggressive try, and he might be able to lead this field on a merry chase. He gets top billing in this cash leg of the early Pick 5.

#6 COVER BAND squeaked out a narrow win two starts back when he got up for a narrow win, then he moved up too high. A good indicator of how tough that race was shows in this gelding's back half that he trotted in 55 3/5 and still never passed a single horse. This is an easier spot, and he gets the leading driver back and he draws well again. He should get positioned much closer to the front tonight, and he would be no surprise in this spot.

#1 CHIC CHOC ROSE raced well in defeat last week, moving briefly on cover on the final turn before circling wide to then pass some rivals to get up for second, beating Sunday Shoes in the process. She loses the leading driver tonight as he chose her stablemate Cover Band, but she is in solid form, and she can win here with the right trip. She is another possibility for early multi-race tickets.

#2 SUPERSONIC HANOVER tried to make a final turn move on Devastate last week, and that rival was simply too strong, so it wasn't long before this gelding started to spin his wheels. He should be able to get a good following trip tonight starting from an inside post, and he should be a good one to use on the bottom of Tri and Super bets in this spot tonight.

#5 HOT COE COE indicated in her mile two starts back that she was reaching her best form when she produced a nice closing effort to get up for third. On that night, after drawing a wide post, she dropped right to the back early. Sitting last of eight at the half, she commenced a rally on the rim. She was still well back at the head of the lane, then she made up a lot of ground in the last eighth of a mile to win the race for show. Off that improved effort, her odds dropped from 47 to 1 to 2 to 1 two weeks ago. Starting from the best post on that night, she changed tactics and took control of the race at the start and went right down the road to record her first victory of 2026. Drawing well again and facing a similar field, she gets the call to repeat in the opening leg of tonight's late Pick 5.

#4 STAY PUMPED strangely was bet down to even money last time when facing Hot Coe Coe. It turned out she was a live rival who had plenty of pace in the lane, but she was too far back to challenge the choice, as that rival was long gone. This mare closed down the middle of the track with good energy, finishing well clear in second, and she looks like the main threat to Hot Coe Coe tonight.

#8 HEAVENS LIL DRAGON shipped from Alberta to London, and she moved into Mohawk Park's leading trainer's barn following a private sale, and she produced a nice rally in her first local start in London on January 10th. She tries her luck on the big track now, and assuming she can improve in her second start in the new barn, she is another one that is worth a look for use in the late Pick 5.

#7 NO MONEY HONEY rallies mildly in most of her miles, pacing sub-30 final quarters in all of them. If she produces that kind of late speed again tonight, she might be able to pass enough mares in here to get up for a small slice, and she is worth a look for the bottom of the Tri or Super at what should be a big price.

#5 OUTLAWGRANDETORINO got a nice covered trip to the lane last two starts back, and he had to wait for racing room, then he closed between horses. He did have a clear shot at the winner in deep stretch, and he wasn't gaining at the wire. Last start, he raced much more aggressively, making a middle move to the front and opening up on the field before getting passed late by the best closer. He is sharp and he draws well here, and he should get another aggressive steer tonight. He gets top billing to kick off tonight's late Pick 4.

#2 WILDRIVERBUMBLEBEE was racing okay before he drew the worst post at Flamboro Downs last time in a mile that is best tossed because it isn't a very good indication of what he can do. He gets Bob McClure in the bike tonight, and he fits well in the opening leg of this Pop Up series. He should get positioned much closer to the front early in this mile, and he is in with a chance here.

#3 HAZEE COAST comes into this Pop Up series off a decent even race in London where he was a close fifth. He gets a key driver change to Doug McNair tonight which will likely mean that he will get a more aggressive steer. He was a winner here last February in a Pop Up series race, so he does have some precedence on his side. He is one I would consider using on late multi-race tickets at what should be a square price.

#7 HOUND ON THE BEACH improved when he dropped into \$20,000 conditioned claimers at Flamboro Downs after shipping north from Pennsylvania, taking a third in his first local start, then getting a predictable front end win after leaving from the rail and backing the pace down early. He gets the leading driver here and he could get over bet, and it's unlikely that he will get the same easy trip on the lead that he enjoyed in that recent win at Flamboro downs. He has only one other win in his past 27 starts, and I'm inclined to try to beat him tonight.

#7 WHITE TIGER moved into the Pam Forgie barn three starts back, and he improved immediately, rallying for a going away win as a bomb, going off at 59 to 1. He stepped up in class on January 11th, and he showed that mile was no fluke when he rallied to just miss at 30 to 1. He finally got bet a little bit in his last start, and he once again closed well to take another win at 6 to 1. He has developed an effective relentless closing style, and he draws slightly better here tonight. He once again should be the one to fend off in the lane and he gets the call to score the repeat win.

#6 JOHNNY BUCKSHOT raced well in every leg of a Pop Up series here in November and December, taking a win in the opening leg before finishing second to Kevin Anthony in Leg 2 and the Final. That rival swept the series after winning in a different division in the opening leg. This gelding simply moved up too high last time, and after drawing wide, he showed little. He gets needed class and post relief tonight, and he should go much better in this spot. Expecting that he will get an aggressive steer, he is the other one that I would consider using on late multi-race tickets.

#4 SPARKS FLY raced well in defeat here in a lower class two starts back where he got a pocket trip to the lane then rallied along the pylons only to be nipped at the wire by a rival that closed in the five path. He stepped up to this level last week, and he again raced well, but Tactical Strike was too good that night and he had no answer for her late pressure. He should be in the mix again tonight, but I prefer to use him underneath.

#8 BELLA CAVALLA is a grinder that rarely misses the top four and she will likely sit back and look for a helmet to follow here. She should be able to pass some of these and work her way into the exotics, and she is worth using on the bottom of the Tri and Super.

#1 USAIN HANOVER was a winner here four starts back when he dropped out of tonight's Open Trot class, then he moved back up to the top level on January 4th. He raced first up that night, and he trotted a 26 2/5 third quarter which took its toll late and he couldn't continue advancing. In his next start, he was given an easier trip, staying hidden until mid stretch where he angled widest and took dead aim on loose leader Sid The Kid. He then hooked wheels with a rival and went off stride, losing all chance as the 4 to 5 favorite. In his last start, he broke long before the start and wagers on him were refunded. I'll stick with him hoping he behaves tonight.

#5 MR BLUEBIRD took a while to find his best stride after shipping to Ontario as he finished fourth in his first five starts. He has been closer recently, last time coming within a head of beating Sid The Kid in this class, and that rival isn't entered here. Now that he has found his best form, he could be sitting on an Open win, and he could get it here if he can work out another good trip.

#6 NEW RULES got to take a class drop on December 22nd, and he crushed his rivals, leading all the way as the even money favorite. Then on January 4th, he made a multi-level class jump last from non-winners of \$9,000 last four to this top class, but bettors were all over him anyway, sending him off as the even money favorite. He set a strong pace to the three quarters and rebuffed the first-over bid of Usain Hanover, and he looked home free, but he tired late and got picked off by a fresh rival that got a much easier trip. Then he had no answers for Sid The Kid in two straight starts and he doesn't have to face that rival here. He should be one of the main contenders in this spot.

#2 SAFE CONDUCT was trying to rally in the stretch here on January 11th when a rival hooked wheels with him and his driver got dumped out of the bike. He missed some time since and it seems logical that he will get a conservative trip coming off that event. I could see him closing for a small share.

Race 10 Selections

The Horseplayer's Journal by Garnet Barnsdale

#10 KYLES ART just finished sixth of seven in his last start, but a key indicator that race was simply too tough was the final quarter that was paced in 28-flat. This gelding tried to close between horses in the stretch, but he simply couldn't pace any faster than the 28-flat and he finished evenly. He gets needed class relief tonight, and although he draws widest, he has shown many times in the past that he has the required gate speed to overcome it, and it is probably an improvement over the rail that he drew last week. He races best off pocket trips, and if he can find that garden spot in here, he should prove tough to beat.

#7 EXOTIC SAND was given a great drive that led to a perfect trip two starts back, and he capitalized, pulling away late to take his ninth win in his previous 18 starts. With a claim entered in his most recent start on January 18th, he was driven pedal to the metal from the start, and cutting a wild 54 3/5 opening half wasn't going to be the path to success. He goes for the Corey Giles barn now and he gets the leading driver who will likely look to trip him out. He can bounce back in this spot.

#3 LETS GET ROCKED got bet down to 2 to 1 racing off the Blake Macintosh claim, and he seemed to have trouble keeping up around the last turn as the leader blazed the way cutting big fractions. He found his best stride in the lane, and he did close some ground late. He could go better here in this second start for the new barn, and he should be part of the Tri or Super.

#8 REMEMBER THE BEACH has been getting some good trips recently but not advancing in the stretch. That being said, he has landed in the top four in eight of his last nine starts, so he is certainly paying his way. He will likely blast off for position tonight, and I can see him sticking around to take a slice at a price.

#2 BETTOR ON ICE tried a middle move to the front two starts back, and he did okay to hang in there for third. He came back on January 18th, and he lost chance when he broke twice in the mile. That was only the third time he broke stride in his 73-race career, so it's likely that he will behave in this spot. He will likely lay close to the front, and he is worth using underneath.

CONDITIONS AND ALLOWANCES IN HARNESS RACING - IMPORTANT TO KNOW

The conditions of a race determine whether a horse is eligible to enter. For example many races are restricted to horses that have won a certain number of races or a certain amount of money in a specified number of starts. Many races are restricted to horses entered to be "claimed" (offered for sale) at a specific price.

Allowances in the claiming price itself are given to colts and geldings, four-year-olds and younger and to mares, five-year-olds and younger.

The purpose of the allowance is to keep younger horses more competitive when racing against older and more experienced rivals. Mares are given extra consideration in claiming events because of their potential as broodmares.

The accompanying chart shows what the allowances are, but an example may make them easier to understand. The chart indicates that three-year-olds receive a 50% allowance in claiming races. This means that a three-year-old entered in a \$20,000 claiming race carries an actual claiming price of \$30,000 (50% higher).

Fillies and mares receive an additional 25% allowance in claiming races. Details of the race conditions and claiming price (if any) are given at the top of each race in the program.

ALLOWANCES FOR PURSE EARNINGS

When Fillies/Mares compete against Colts/Geldings (normally on the trot) Fillies/Mares will receive an additional 25% on the condition of the race. ie: nv \$5,000 (FM \$6,250) last 5 or \$12,000 (FM \$15,000) last 10 starts.

C.P.M.A. Regulation Changes

Effective January 1st 2012

CPMA will be instituting several new rule changes with regards to the following pari-mutuel pools:

Pick Pools

- If there are no winners in any leg of a Pick N pool, the entire pool is refunded.
- If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners.
- A pool is no longer refunded if the 1st leg in the pool is cancelled or declared no contest.
- Pick-3: If at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: If at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.

EXPLANATION OF THE LASIX PROGRAM

After careful study and consultation with Ontario Horsemen's groups, racetrack operators and veterinarians, Agriculture Canada and the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario passed legislation allowing the controlled (or supervised) administration of furosemide, more commonly called "Lasix". "Lasix" is used to alleviate the symptoms of exercise induced pulmonary hemorrhaging in racing horses.

Horses will undergo an endoscopic examination of the trachea by a veterinarian licensed by the Ontario Racing Commission and endorsed by an official veterinarian before being allowed on the medication list. Once qualified, horses will be treated with "Lasix" within four hours plus or minus 15 minutes of a scheduled race in a secure retention area under the super vision of racing officials.

All horses on "Lasix" must remain on the program for a minimum of 100 days while racing in this jurisdiction.

RULES AND INFORMATION REGARDING CANADIAN HARNESS AND FOREIGN SEPARATE POOL EVENTS

GENERAL

All pari-mutuel pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with the regulations and directives as issued by Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada ("the Regulations"), under the approval and supervision of the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency. The Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency can be contacted at 1-800-268-8835 or 613-759-6100 or Email: cpmawebacpm@agr.gc.ca. A complete version of the CPMA regulations can be found at <http://laws-lois.justice.gc.ca/eng/regulations/SOR-91-365/>. All tickets should be held until the result of the race is declared official and prices are posted. No person under the age of 18 shall purchase or cash a ticket or voucher.

A claim of receiving an incorrect payment or incorrect change must be made to the Mutuel office of the association within twenty four hours of buying or cashing a valid ticket or voucher.

No ruling made by the Stewards/Judges or the Ontario Racing Commission with regard to distribution of purse money or the placing of horses in the order of finish, after the race has been declared official, shall have any bearing on the pay-out prices or distribution of pari-mutuel pools.

Change boards and Photo Finish display monitors are located in the Grandstand. In addition, Photo Finish pictures are shown on the closed-circuit television system. Customers are reminded that mutuel clerks are responsible for all shortages. When making a wager, customers must present sufficient funds at the time of purchase to cover the wagers requested.

ENTRIES AND MUTUEL FIELDS

"Entry" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled or considered as the same betting interest. The most common reason for the coupling of horses in an Entry is the fact that they are owned by the same person.

"Mutuel Field" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled because the number of horses in the race exceeds the number which can be handled separately by the pari-mutuel system. Subject to the Regulations, a bet on one horse of an Entry or Mutuel Field shall be considered a bet on all horses in that Entry or Mutuel Field.

DAILY DOUBLE BETTING (INCLUDING LATE DOUBLE)

A Daily Double bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of the two races specified for the Daily Double. Tickets not selecting the winner of the first half of the Daily Double and all tickets in the second half of the Daily Double not coupled with the declared official winner of the first half of the Daily Double are not winners and are not refunded no matter what circumstances affect the running of the second half of the Daily Double.

Should a horse or horses (not coupled with another starter) be excused from starting in the second race of the Daily Double after the first race of the Daily Double has closed for betting, holders of all Daily Double tickets on such horses, coupled with the winner of the first Daily Double race, shall participate in a Consolation Double pool. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

EXACTA (Also known as Exactor/TRIFECTA (Also known as Tractor)/SUPERFECTA

An Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first two, three and four horses respectively, representing different betting interests to finish in the exact official order of finish, in the race on which the pool is operated.

SWINGER (Also known as OMNI)

A Swinger is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select horses to finish in any order from the official first 3 positions.

JACKPOT HI-5

A Jackpot Hi-5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners in the specified Jackpot Hi-5 race. If there are races that have an entry, (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B), Jackpot Hi-5 will not offer a wager consisting of both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in a Jackpot Hi-5, the payout would be 1st, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th. That jackpot portion of the pool will only be paid out if there is a single winning ticket. If there are multiple winning tickets that have correctly chosen the first 5 runners of the race, they will receive 50% of the pool for that day. The other 50% will go over into the Jackpot carryover. If there are no winning tickets with the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners, 100% of the current day's pool will be carried over into the Jackpot.

PICK 3 & PICK-4 BETTING

The Pick 3 & Pick 4 bets are betting transactions in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of three or four successive races specified for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 respectively.

Winning tickets for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 are determined in the following sequence: A) winners of all legs, B) most winners, then refund. If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners. If there are no winners in any leg of a pool, the entire pool is refunded.

PICK 5 BETTING

The Pick 5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of five successive races specified for the Pick 5 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 5 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 5.

PICK 6 BETTING

The Pick 6 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of six successive races specified for the Pick 6 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 6 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 6.

PICK 3 & 6 BETTING

If at least 1 race as part of the Pick 5 or 6 has been cancelled or declared "No contest", but not more than the specified below under Refunds, the net pool shall be distributed to those selecting the most # of winners and NOT include any carryover from a previous pool.

PICK 3, PICK 4, PICK 5 & PICK 6 SCRATCHES

In the event a Pick 3, Pick 4, Pick 5 or Pick 6 ticket designates as a selection a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the Stewards/Judges to be a non-starter in any of the races comprising the Pick 3, Pick 4, Pick 5 or Pick 6 the favourite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection. In the event that the money bet in the win pool for two or more favourites is identical, the selection with the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non-starting selection.

However, if a scratch occurs in any leg of the Pick 3, Pick 4, Pick 5 or Pick 6 pools before the pool is closed, a ticket including the scratched horse may be cancelled.

REFUNDS

Subject to the Regulations, all monies in all pools on a race are refunded in the event that the race is cancelled, declared off or declared no contest, and all monies bet on a horse are refunded if the horse is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start. These refunds will be communicated to the public through various means such as betting terminals, video display, change boards and our website. The Pick(n) pool shall be cancelled and all Pick(n) wagers for the individual performance shall be refunded if:

- Pick-3: at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

Where a horse that is part of an Entry is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start and at least one horse of that Entry receives a fair start in the race, all tickets purchased on the Entry remain valid and the purchase price of any such ticket shall not be refunded.

COMMON POOL WAGERING (INTERTRACK BETTING)

In the unlikely event of a communications or computer system failure that prevents pools from merging with the host track's pools before the end of a race, CPMA regulations require that the site must refund all tickets for that race. This refund will be communicated to the public through various means such as video displays, change boards and messages on our website.

FAIR START

If a horse has reached the Fair Start Pole (located 200 feet before the Starting Pole) by the time the mobile gate has reached the Starting Pole, that horse is deemed to have had a fair start. It makes no difference whether or not the horse is on or off stride at that precise moment. Under current policy and regulations, which are designed to be as fair as possible to all bettors on all starters, there is no Recall - a repeat of the entire starting procedure - when a horse does not reach the Fair Start Pole before the gate reaches the Starting Pole. Monies bet on such a horse are refunded in accordance with the regulation concerning refunds.

LOST & OLD TICKETS

WEG issued tickets or vouchers are valid indefinitely, however, they cannot be cashed at a mutuel teller after 2 years from date of issue. Please mail tickets, along with your name and address, to Mutuel Manager, P.O. Box 156, Rexdale, Ontario, M9W 5L2, keeping a photocopy for future reference.

For "Lost Tickets" originally sold at a Woodbine Entertainment Group racetrack or Teletheatre, please enquire at the Mutuel office at Woodbine, Greenwood Teletheatre, or Mohawk. Policy may be subject to change retroactively in the event regulatory bodies amend existing regulations.

ASSOCIATION PERCENTAGE, AND TAXATION/LEVY

The Woodbine Entertainment Group deducts and retains the following percentages from wagers placed at our own licensed sites which are then shared with the horsepeople, host and simulcast associations and the Ontario Racing Commission.

WOODBINE/MOHAWK LIVE: Win, Place & Show: 13.65%. Swinger 14.7%. Trifecta & Pick 4: 21%. Double & Exacta 17.2%. Jackpot Hi-5, Pick 5 & Pick 6: 11.1%. All other 23%.

Horsepeople receive a further 2% on all wagers, except Trifecta wagering where it is 4%. The Ontario Provincial Government retains 0.5% on all bets placed in Ontario. The Canadian Government (through a revolving fund cost recovery basis) retains 0.8% on all wagers placed in Canada for provision of drug control, and audit services.
