Betting Basics

Some essentials to get you started with making a wager.

1 How to wager



Place your bet by visiting a teller, or using a self-serve terminal.

To place a bet here are just 5 things you need to know:

- 1 Name of racetrack (choose from any track in the simulcast feeds)
- 2 Number of the race
- 3 Amount of your bet (e.g. \$2)
- 4 Type of bet (see step 2)
- 5 Horse's number (see step 4)

Once you have decided what you want to bet, head to the nearest seller's window and use the sample statement as your guide:

Hello, (Racetrack), race 6, \$2 to WIN on Horse #4

How to use a self-serve terminal:

- 1 Swipe your Cash Card/Insert Cash
- 2 Enter the initial PIN #1234 (then choose a new PIN)
- 3 Press/Tap the track you would like to bet: (defaults to current race)
- 4 Tap the Horse Number: **#4**
- 5 Press/Tap the Bet Type: **WIN**
- 6 Press/Tap the Bet Amount: **\$2**
- 7 Press/Tap the Race Number: **Race #6**
- 8 Press Green “**Make BET**” button
- 9 Press/Tap the “**Finish with Receipt**” button
- 10 Be sure to check your ticket to confirm it's the bet you wanted

To get a Cash Card or for assistance ask a teller, or a staff member.

2 Types of bets



Single horse bets (minimum \$2.00 bet is required)

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Win	U U U	Your horse must finish 1st; payoff determined by the win odds.
Place	U U	Your horse must finish 1st or 2nd; payoffs better than to show.
Show	U	Your horse must finish 1st, 2nd, or 3rd; modest payoffs.

Exotic multiple-horse bets

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Exacta*	U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st and 2nd in exact order; riskier bet that can pay a little or a lot, depending on the horses' odds.
Daily double	U U U U U	Pick the winners of two designated consecutive races.
Pick 3, Win 4, Pick 5, Pick 6	U U U U U U	Select the winners of a designated set of consecutive races. The wager must be made prior to the start of the first race in the multi-race wager.
Triactor*	U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in exact order; can be expensive to play if you use a lot of horses.
Superfecta*	U U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th; big payoff possible.

* Exotic bets require the horses to finish in the EXACT order you select, unless you “BOX” the bet, in which case your selections can finish in any order.

- 1 Horse's number in the race
- 2 Horse's post position colour
- 3 Horse's colour, sex, age,sire (father), dam (mother), sire of the dam
- 4 Morning line odds
- 5 Horse's name
- 6 Driver and Driver Record (Name, # of wins, # of 2nd, # of 3rd, winning %)

- 7 Trainer information
- 8 Horse's Lifetime record (with best win time, track size, track, age, lifetime wins and lifetime earnings)
- 9 Horse's current record (# of races, # wins, # of 2nd, # of 3rd, and money earned)

4 The odds



Odds are also important to consider when choosing your horse. Horses that are thought to have a better chance of winning will typically have lower odds.

Morning line odds

Odds listed in the race program are the “morning line” odds. These are predictions of how the public will bet on the race. They are set by the track’s handicapper when the race program is published, before the wagering starts.

The actual odds will be posted on the **Television** or in-field on the **Tote Board** before the race; they change up until post time, depending on how customers are betting on each horse in the race.

Calculating a \$2 win prize

To calculate a win prize, find the Odds of a horse on the **Television** or **Tote Board** (in-field board).

Multiply the first number by 2, then divide that number by the second digit (if there is one), and then add \$2. Simple as that!

Odds	1/2	2/1	7/2	5/1	10/1
Pays	\$3.00	\$6.00	\$9.00	\$12.00	\$22.00

Helpful facts for betting

- Some racetracks have a television simulcast commentator who tries to identify winning horses (handicaps) between the races. Listen and see if you can pick up any good tips to bet on.
- A good betting method is to choose horses with current odds two to three times higher than their morning line odds.

3 Tips to remember

WIN BETS on the **FAVOURITE** pay 32% of the time
PLACE BETS on the **FAVOURITE** pay 53% of the time
SHOW BETS on the **FAVOURITE** pay 67% of the time

#3 NEVER ASSUME turned his form around two starts back when he got Daryl Thiessen in the bike, and that teamster continues to impress, winning with longshots on a regular basis. After closing tree wide to get second in that start on January 20th, he fired back a week later, made another wide move at the three quarters and drove away from the field as the 4 to 5 favorite. He faces tougher now, but he is sharp, and he should get a solid early pace to chase here. I'll take a price swing with him in the opening leg of tonight's \$75,000 guaranteed Pick 5.

#9 CHEF won for the third time in eight starts here on January 3rd after starting his career as a three-year-old in 2024, but instead of stepping up to non-winners of three, he immediately got reclassified and dropped into a conditioned claimer where he could be taken for \$20,000. That looked like the right move when he led all the way and held on for a three-quarter length win. He came back at the same class level and made a middle move to the front two starts back, but he couldn't fend off a strong class dropper. Last week, I thought he raced great in defeat, making a second move and racing first up to get past the leader, only to get nailed late by a rival that enjoyed a much better trip. Drawing widest should mean he will offer a square price here, and he is in with a decent chance.

#2 CRAZIN PARTY BOY is another one in here that came to life two starts back when he finished a closing second, then he got a slick steer and a perfect trip to get the best of Chef last week. After staying inside on the backstretch, everything went right for him. He gained several positions skimming the pylons, then he found a seam in the lane, and he got up right on the line. He is clearly improved, but I'm inclined to play to beat him off that perfect trip unless he closes as an overlay, which he likely won't.

#5 BETTOR BEAST raced okay off the Chris Matthews claim last week, closing late to finish only two lengths behind Crazin Party Boy. Now, he draws best and he gets Doug McNair in the bike, so it's likely that he will get a more aggressive steer. He is a potential price player to consider for the early Pick 5.

#5 CATCHMEGRACEFULLY shipped in from Flamboro Downs on December 15th after smoking fields of \$20,000 conditioned claimers in two straight. She added Lasix that night, and she was the only one pursuing Side Effects in the stretch and the only one that finished close to that rival at the wire. Then three starts back, she was left first-over in the third quarter, and she would have needed to sprout wings to catch Side Effects after that rival moved to the front in a 58 1/5 middle half. On January 12th, she got a contested pace to chase, and she scored at an overlaid price of 14 to 1. She drew best for her last start, and she failed to get the job done as the 1 to 2 favorite, but she looks good in here and she has a big shot to lead these all the way.

#2 SIDE EFFECTS was winless in 2025 when she got leading driver James Macdonald in the bike four starts back here on December 15th. She came into that race off a good effort the previous week and that good performance, combined with the driver change, got her bet down to even money. Unsurprisingly, she was given an aggressive steer and she turned for home on the lead and drifted out a few lanes then kicked into high gear to fend off one closer. She came right back a week later, and she was even better, pacing away from some overmatched rivals to take a new lifetime mark while kicking home in a snappy 27 2/5. On January 12th, she made a middle move to the front, but she got strung out while making that move and she couldn't convert. Last week, racing off the Kyle Fellows claim, she was too far back after leaving from a wide post. She gets post relief now, and she should get a more aggressive steer. She figures to be the main threat to the choice.

#1 ARIELS BET has been racing well recently passing rivals in the back half to hot the board in both of her last two starts. She will sit back and rally again tonight, and she can get another slice tonight.

#3 YS FLOWERNUMBERTEN tried racing first-over on a snow-covered track last time and she didn't get very far before she started to back up. That's not her best trip and she is capable of better. It seems likely that she will stay covered up and she can get a slice if she gets a good trip.

#1 SPEAKDOLLARSNCENTS moved into leading trainer Jodie Cullen's barn to begin 2026, and after producing two decent efforts at Flamboro Downs, he tries his luck at the big track here. He raced okay on Thursday night at the Dundas, Ontario oval, racing first up after starting from the widest post. He tried to make a middle move to the front and got rebuffed, now he draws much better here, and his trainer continues to fire on all cylinders, winning at a 25% clip so far this year. He gets top call to kick off tonight's early Pick 4.

#5 LUCKY DANCER got a driver change to Brady Galliers two starts back, and he was immediately sent right down the road to score his first win in 22 starts. He fired right back and took another front end win, and he gets leading driver James Macdonald now. He projects to be the one to catch in this spot, and it would be no surprise to see him score the threepeat.

#4 PAPIAMENTO was a winner at this \$8,000 conditioned claiming level four starts back when he got an aggressive steer and led most of the way. He then stepped up to face tougher in a claiming handicap, and racing first-over didn't work. His last two starts from wide posts at Flamboro Downs can be forgiven. He is in a better spot here, and he gets a positive driver change to Tyler Borth. He is the third one in here that I would consider using on early multi-race tickets.

#6 THE COLT comes in off two decent tries at this level, last time racing first-over to get third and two starts back closing for third. Those were the tenth and eleventh time in the last 46 starts that he finished third, and he seems best used underneath in this spot.

He stepped up to non-winners of two Thursday night and just failed to get the job done. This is a horse that is on the rise, and he figures to get a good trip racing on or near the lead, and he gets the nod in this first leg of tonight's 20-cent Pick 6.

#2 TIE GAME was coming off a lame scratch last time and he had missed more than month, and he didn't get bet much, but he did race much better than he did in his previous start where he was beaten 25 lengths. He was raced aggressively and he had a clear shot coming out of the pocket in the lane and he was one-paced. He can be better now coming back much quicker, and he figures to be a threat.

#3 DULCES SUEÑOS DEO, as has become customary with him, passed some rivals in the back half last week to get up for a slice, and that marked the 12th time in 27 starts where he finished second or third. He was in a good spot in the lane, but he got caught flat footed and got in a blind switch briefly which may have cost him a placing. I'll continue to use him underneath until he gives me a reason to change my mind.

#9 SATU WANIA raced okay to finish fourth last week, and she has shown enough gate speed to be able to get away in the top five here then take another following trip. She is improving and she makes only her fifth start here, so she still has some upside. She is worth a look for the bottom of the exotics at what should be a square price in this spot tonight.

#7 WICKED EXPRESS controlled the pace in two consecutive starts racing in two straight starts at this level, and he got claimed by Malik Smith in the second of those victories. He stepped up into a class that was just too tough for him racing off the claim last week, and after showing his traditional early speed, he was overtaken in the second quarter, and he eventually backed up to last. Dropping back to the level where he was claimed gives him a great opportunity to bounce back, and he should be tough racing on the lead tonight.

#3 SMILES FOR MILES was no match for Wicked Express in those two wins, but he got away from him last week, took all the money at the windows, then drove off to a convincing win as the even money favorite. It's unlikely that he will see the lead early in this mile, but I could see him landing in the pocket, and that gives him a chance here. He is the other one that I would consider using on muti-race tickets.

#4 PARTY IT UP compiled a great record last year taking eight wins and nine other shares from 31 starts while earning more than \$31,000. He hasn't missed the board in three starts so far this season, and he was best of the rest against Smiles For Miles last week without threatening for the win. He will likely pass some rivals again tonight and get up for a small share.

#8 VOLCANIC won as expected here in his first start of the season coming in off a sneaky good qualifier on January 19th. He tried the front end again last week, and he couldn't see it through on the engine. It's hard to see him getting the lead from Wicked Express in this spot, and it seems more likely that he will try to rally from mid pack. He is one that I prefer to use underneath tonight.

He raced tough first-over, clearing to the front turning into the stretch and sprinting to the wire hard, only to get nailed by a rival that enjoyed a much better trip. He lands in a spot here where there doesn't seem to be many that will be leaving hard. He can make an early move to the front tonight and that should be the winning move. He gets top billing in this opening leg of tonight's late Pick 5.

#4 ALWAYS B SWEETEST is on a good roll, having taken wins in two of his last three starts. His most recent win featured an impressive late move to get the job done. He made an early wide move on the final turn, which isn't the easiest trip, and after losing valuable ground, he still chased down a loose leader to win going away, and it was a long way back to the third-place finisher. Coming back at the same level, he is the other one that I would consider using in the late Pick 5.

#3 RAYS KREDIT has been in solid form for a few starts, and he got the best trip last time and he ad no problem capitalizing, drawing off to win easily. He tends to be trip dependent, and I'm not sure that he can find that same perfect trip tonight. I'll play to beat him in this spot, but he is probably a good one to use on the bottom of Tri and Super bets.

#8 LETS GET PICKLED was raced aggressively off the Corey Giles claim, and he backed up late to get beaten by double digits. Drawing widest now, it seems likely that the leading driver will take back and look for a helmet to follow. I could see him sneaking into the bottom of the exotics.

#9 DAFFY HANOVER was a predictable winner on January 12th on the drop and pop, and she led all the way, crushing her rivals that night. She moved back up to tonight's non-winners of three level ON January 19th, and neither she, nor anyone else could keep up to blowout winner Supersonic Hanover. She got back into a race restricted to females last week, and she improved as expected, but she provided perfect cover for the winner coming around the final turn and into the stretch, and she couldn't fend that rival off in the drive to the wire. I don't mind the widest post for her tonight, and she gets top billing in this opening leg of tonight's Pick 4.

#2 PANTOFOLAO has only one third-place finish to show for his past six starts, but he has been facing much tougher rivals than he meets tonight such as: Manoah, Devastate, and Chic Choc Rose. Dropping into a straight non-winners of three condition tonight gives him a chance to improve sharply, and while I would be hesitant to take the 2 to 1 morning line price, he does seem to be one of the main contenders tonight.

#7 MY WAY dialed up a nice late rally two starts back to get up for his second win in his twenty third start. He fired back with another good effort when he jumped up to non-winners of three, and he closed for a slice behind blowout winner Supersonic Hanover. He will drop back and look to rally again tonight, and I can see him getting up for a share.

#4 LUVUTOTHEMOONANBAK raced decently two starts back when he was sent first-over and he stuck around for third. Last week, he was racing near the back when he was affected by a breaker on the last turn, causing him to idle for a few strides until the breaker was safely out of his way. He finished okay to get the smallest cheque and he can do better here if he lays a bit closer to the front early in the mile. He is one to consider for the bottom of Tri and Super bets.

#4 KINNDAR ICECUBE brings an 0 for 8 record to the track tonight, but he has finished second five times, and he came close to winning in both of his last two starts where he led until late in both of those miles. Two starts back, he was nailed right on the line by the pocket sitter. Last week, he had a clear lead in the lane, but he was passed late by a wide rallier that motored home down the middle of the track. He may have found a field that he can beat here, and he gets top billing.

#2 HAPPY ANGEL looked like a winner for every stride except the final one last week as he turned his form around with a solid front end effort after starting from a wide post. He almost made it to the wire, but the race favorite caught fire in the final strides and ate up ground in a hurry to get up by a slim nose. That was a strong effort in defeat, and this Gaetan Hebert trainee should be a threat right back here.

#6 ZILLENIAL showed some ability last season at two, taking four slices from five starts, and he had an even race in his sophomore debut after starting from the eight-hole and dropping in fifth early. He gets a big post position change here moving from the eight hole to post six, and I wouldn't be shocked if he gets sent forward at the start and works out a good trip. He is worth a look at a price and he is another one that I would consider for use on late multi-race tickets.

#1 OVEREND has been showing speed, racing well, and taking shares recently. That's the glass half full view of this five-year-old gelding. The glass half empty is his 1 for 31 record. He has the speed required to get away well from the rail post, and he should be able to work out a good trip racing near the front. I don't see him as a win threat, however, and I'll use him underneath in this spot.

CONDITIONS AND ALLOWANCES IN HARNESS RACING - IMPORTANT TO KNOW

The conditions of a race determine whether a horse is eligible to enter. For example many races are restricted to horses that have won a certain number of races or a certain amount of money in a specified number of starts. Many races are restricted to horses entered to be "claimed" (offered for sale) at a specific price.

Allowances in the claiming price itself are given to colts and geldings, four-year-olds and younger and to mares, five-year-olds and younger.

The purpose of the allowance is to keep younger horses more competitive when racing against older and more experienced rivals. Mares are given extra consideration in claiming events because of their potential as broodmares.

The accompanying chart shows what the allowances are, but an example may make them easier to understand. The chart indicates that three-year-olds receive a 50% allowance in claiming races. This means that a three-year-old entered in a \$20,000 claiming race carries an actual claiming price of \$30,000 (50% higher).

Fillies and mares receive an additional 25% allowance in claiming races. Details of the race conditions and claiming price (if any) are given at the top of each race in the program.

ALLOWANCES FOR PURSE EARNINGS

When Fillies/Mares compete against Colts/Geldings (normally on the trot) Fillies/Mares will receive an additional 25% on the condition of the race. ie: nv \$5,000 (FM \$6,250) last 5 or \$12,000 (FM \$15,000) last 10 starts.

C.P.M.A. Regulation Changes

Effective January 1st 2012

CPMA will be instituting several new rule changes with regards to the following pari-mutuel pools:

Pick Pools

- If there are no winners in any leg of a Pick N pool, the entire pool is refunded.
- If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners.
- A pool is no longer refunded if the 1st leg in the pool is cancelled or declared no contest.
- Pick-3: If at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: If at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.

EXPLANATION OF THE LASIX PROGRAM

After careful study and consultation with Ontario Horsemen's groups, racetrack operators and veterinarians, Agriculture Canada and the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario passed legislation allowing the controlled (or supervised) administration of furosemide, more commonly called "Lasix". "Lasix" is used to alleviate the symptoms of exercise induced pulmonary hemorrhaging in racing horses.

Horses will undergo an endoscopic examination of the trachea by a veterinarian licensed by the Ontario Racing Commission and endorsed by an official veterinarian before being allowed on the medication list. Once qualified, horses will be treated with "Lasix" within four hours plus or minus 15 minutes of a scheduled race in a secure retention area under the super vision of racing officials.

All horses on "Lasix" must remain on the program for a minimum of 100 days while racing in this jurisdiction.

RULES AND INFORMATION REGARDING CANADIAN HARNESS AND FOREIGN SEPARATE POOL EVENTS

GENERAL

All pari-mutuel pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with the regulations and directives as issued by Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada ("the Regulations"), under the approval and supervision of the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency. The Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency can be contacted at 1-800-268-8835 or 613-759-6100 or Email: cpmawebacpm@agr.gc.ca. A complete version of the CPMA regulations can be found at <http://laws-lois.justice.gc.ca/eng/regulations/SOR-91-365/>. All tickets should be held until the result of the race is declared official and prices are posted. No person under the age of 18 shall purchase or cash a ticket or voucher.

A claim of receiving an incorrect payment or incorrect change must be made to the Mutuel office of the association within twenty four hours of buying or cashing a valid ticket or voucher.

No ruling made by the Stewards/Judges or the Ontario Racing Commission with regard to distribution of purse money or the placing of horses in the order of finish, after the race has been declared official, shall have any bearing on the pay-out prices or distribution of pari-mutuel pools.

Change boards and Photo Finish display monitors are located in the Grandstand. In addition, Photo Finish pictures are shown on the closed-circuit television system. Customers are reminded that mutuel clerks are responsible for all shortages. When making a wager, customers must present sufficient funds at the time of purchase to cover the wagers requested.

ENTRIES AND MUTUEL FIELDS

"Entry" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled or considered as the same betting interest. The most common reason for the coupling of horses in an Entry is the fact that they are owned by the same person.

"Mutuel Field" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled because the number of horses in the race exceeds the number which can be handled separately by the pari-mutuel system. Subject to the Regulations, a bet on one horse of an Entry or Mutuel Field shall be considered a bet on all horses in that Entry or Mutuel Field.

DAILY DOUBLE BETTING (INCLUDING LATE DOUBLE)

A Daily Double bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of the two races specified for the Daily Double. Tickets not selecting the winner of the first half of the Daily Double and all tickets in the second half of the Daily Double not coupled with the declared official winner of the first half of the Daily Double are not winners and are not refunded no matter what circumstances affect the running of the second half of the Daily Double.

Should a horse or horses (not coupled with another starter) be excused from starting in the second race of the Daily Double after the first race of the Daily Double has closed for betting, holders of all Daily Double tickets on such horses, coupled with the winner of the first Daily Double race, shall participate in a Consolation Double pool. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

EXACTA (Also known as Exactor/TRIFECTA (Also known as Tractor)/SUPERFECTA

An Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first two, three and four horses respectively, representing different betting interests to finish in the exact official order of finish, in the race on which the pool is operated.

SWINGER (Also known as OMNI)

A Swinger is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select horses to finish in any order from the official first 3 positions.

JACKPOT HI-5

A Jackpot Hi-5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners in the specified Jackpot Hi-5 race. If there are races that have an entry, (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B), Jackpot Hi-5 will not offer a wager consisting of both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in a Jackpot Hi-5, the payout would be 1st, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th. That jackpot portion of the pool will only be paid out if there is a single winning ticket. If there are multiple winning tickets that have correctly chosen the first 5 runners of the race, they will receive 50% of the pool for that day. The other 50% will go over into the Jackpot carryover. If there are no winning tickets with the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners, 100% of the current day's pool will be carried over into the Jackpot.

PICK 3 & PICK-4 BETTING

The Pick 3 & Pick 4 bets are betting transactions in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of three or four successive races specified for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 respectively.

Winning tickets for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 are determined in the following sequence: A) winners of all legs, B) most winners, then refund. If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners. If there are no winners in any leg of a pool, the entire pool is refunded.

PICK 5 BETTING

The Pick 5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of five successive races specified for the Pick 5 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 5 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 5.

PICK 6 BETTING

The Pick 6 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of six successive races specified for the Pick 6 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 6 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 6.

PICK 3 & 6 BETTING

If at least 1 race as part of the Pick 5 or 6 has been cancelled or declared "No contest", but not more than the specified below under Refunds, the net pool shall be distributed to those selecting the most # of winners and NOT include any carryover from a previous pool.

PICK 3, PICK 4, PICK 5 & PICK 6 SCRATCHES

In the event a Pick 3, Pick 4, Pick 5 or Pick 6 ticket designates as a selection a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the Stewards/Judges to be a non-starter in any of the races comprising the Pick 3, Pick 4, Pick 5 or Pick 6 the favourite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection. In the event that the money bet in the win pool for two or more favourites is identical, the selection with the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non-starting selection.

However, if a scratch occurs in any leg of the Pick 3, Pick 4, Pick 5 or Pick 6 pools before the pool is closed, a ticket including the scratched horse may be cancelled.

REFUNDS

Subject to the Regulations, all monies in all pools on a race are refunded in the event that the race is cancelled, declared off or declared no contest, and all monies bet on a horse are refunded if the horse is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start. These refunds will be communicated to the public through various means such as betting terminals, video display, change boards and our website. The Pick(n) pool shall be cancelled and all Pick(n) wagers for the individual performance shall be refunded if:

- Pick-3: at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

Where a horse that is part of an Entry is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start and at least one horse of that Entry receives a fair start in the race, all tickets purchased on the Entry remain valid and the purchase price of any such ticket shall not be refunded.

COMMON POOL WAGERING (INTERTRACK BETTING)

In the unlikely event of a communications or computer system failure that prevents pools from merging with the host track's pools before the end of a race, CPMA regulations require that the site must refund all tickets for that race. This refund will be communicated to the public through various means such as video displays, change boards and messages on our website.

FAIR START

If a horse has reached the Fair Start Pole (located 200 feet before the Starting Pole) by the time the mobile gate has reached the Starting Pole, that horse is deemed to have had a fair start. It makes no difference whether or not the horse is on or off stride at that precise moment. Under current policy and regulations, which are designed to be as fair as possible to all bettors on all starters, there is no Recall - a repeat of the entire starting procedure - when a horse does not reach the Fair Start Pole before the gate reaches the Starting Pole. Monies bet on such a horse are refunded in accordance with the regulation concerning refunds.

LOST & OLD TICKETS

WEG issued tickets or vouchers are valid indefinitely, however, they cannot be cashed at a mutuel teller after 2 years from date of issue. Please mail tickets, along with your name and address, to Mutuel Manager, P.O. Box 156, Rexdale, Ontario, M9W 5L2, keeping a photocopy for future reference.

For "Lost Tickets" originally sold at a Woodbine Entertainment Group racetrack or Teletheatre, please enquire at the Mutuel office at Woodbine, Greenwood Teletheatre, or Mohawk. Policy may be subject to change retroactively in the event regulatory bodies amend existing regulations.

ASSOCIATION PERCENTAGE, AND TAXATION/LEVY

The Woodbine Entertainment Group deducts and retains the following percentages from wagers placed at our own licensed sites which are then shared with the horsepeople, host and simulcast associations and the Ontario Racing Commission.

WOODBINE/MOHAWK LIVE: Win, Place & Show: 13.65%. Swinger 14.7%. Trifecta & Pick 4: 21.1%. Double & Exacta 17.2%. Jackpot Hi-5, Pick 5 & Pick 6: 11.1%. All other 23.0%

Horsepeople receive a further 2% on all wagers, except Trifecta wagering where it is 4%. The Ontario Provincial Government retains 0.5% on all bets placed in Ontario. The Canadian Government (through a revolving fund cost recovery basis) retains 0.8% on all wagers placed in Canada for provision of drug control, and audit services.
