Betting Basics

Some essentials to get you started with making a wager.

1 How to wager



Place your bet by visiting a teller, or using a self-serve terminal.

To place a bet here are just 5 things you need to know:

- 1 Name of racetrack (choose from any track in the simulcast feeds)
- 2 Number of the race
- 3 Amount of your bet (e.g. \$2)
- 4 Type of bet (see step 2)
- 5 Horse's number (see step 4)

Once you have decided what you want to bet, head to the nearest seller's window and use the sample statement as your guide:

Hello, (Racetrack), race 6, \$2 to WIN on Horse #4

How to use a self-serve terminal:

- 1 Swipe your Cash Card/Insert Cash
- 2 Enter the initial PIN #1234 (then choose a new PIN)
- 3 Press/Tap the track you would like to bet: (defaults to current race)
- 4 Tap the Horse Number: **#4**
- 5 Press/Tap the Bet Type: **WIN**
- 6 Press/Tap the Bet Amount: **\$2**
- 7 Press/Tap the Race Number: **Race #6**
- 8 Press Green **"Make BET"** button
- 9 Press/Tap the **"Finish with Receipt"** button
- 10 Be sure to check your ticket to confirm it's the bet you wanted

To get a Cash Card or for assistance ask a teller, or a staff member.

2 Types of bets



Single horse bets (minimum \$2.00 bet is required)

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Win	U U U	Your horse must finish 1st; payoff determined by the win odds.
Place	U U	Your horse must finish 1st or 2nd; payoffs better than to show.
Show	U	Your horse must finish 1st, 2nd, or 3rd; modest payoffs.

Exotic multiple-horse bets

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Exacta*	U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st and 2nd in exact order; riskier bet that can pay a little or a lot, depending on the horses' odds.
Daily double	U U U U U	Pick the winners of two designated consecutive races.
Pick 3, Win 4, Pick 5, Pick 6	U U U U U U	Select the winners of a designated set of consecutive races. The wager must be made prior to the start of the first race in the multi-race wager.
Triactor*	U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in exact order; can be expensive to play if you use a lot of horses.
Superfecta*	U U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th; big payoff possible.

* Exotic bets require the horses to finish in the EXACT order you select, unless you "BOX" the bet, in which case your selections can finish in any order.

All of the numbers and letters in the program might seem confusing or overwhelming at first, but focusing on these sections makes choosing a horse simple.

- 1 Horse's number in the race
- 2 Horse's post position colour
- 3 Horse's colour, sex, age, sire (father), dam (mother), sire of the dam
- 4 Morning line odds
- 5 Horse's name
- 6 Driver and Driver Record (Name, # of wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, winning %)
- 7 Trainer information
- 8 Horse's Lifetime record (with best win time, track size, track, age, lifetime wins and lifetime earnings)
- 9 Horse's current record (# of races, # wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, and money earned)

4 The odds



Odds are also important to consider when choosing your horse. Horses that are thought to have a better chance of winning will typically have lower odds.

Morning line odds

Odds listed in the race program are the "morning line" odds. These are predictions of how the public will bet on the race. They are set by the track's handicapper when the race program is published, before the wagering starts.

The actual odds will be posted on the **Television** or in-field on the **Tote Board** before the race; they change up until post time, depending on how customers are betting on each horse in the race.

Calculating a \$2 win prize

To calculate a win prize, find the Odds of a horse on the **Television** or **Tote Board** (in-field board).

Multiply the first number by 2, then divide that number by the second digit (if there is one), and then add \$2. Simple as that!

Odds	1/2	2/1	7/2	5/1	10/1
Pays	\$3.00	\$6.00	\$9.00	\$12.00	\$22.00

Helpful facts for betting

- Some racetracks have a television simulcast commentator who tries to identify winning horses (handicaps) between the races. Listen and see if you can pick up any good tips to bet on.
- A good betting method is to choose horses with current odds two to three times higher than their morning line odds.

3 Tips to remember

WIN BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 32% of the time
PLACE BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 53% of the time
SHOW BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 67% of the time

Race 1 Selections

The Horseplayer's Journal by Garnet Barnsdale

#6 VALIDUS caught an easy non-winners of two field here in his penultimate start on February 2nd, and he was predictably bet down to 3 to 5. He got an aggressive steer from the leading driver, and he crushed his overmatched opponents that night. He fired back last week facing a promising sophomore gelding that had just broke his maiden impressively. That rival was bet down to 3 to 5, and when Validus vaulted off cover to take the lead in early stretch, it looked like he might have gotten the jump on that favorite. He fought bravely to the wire and just failed to last. He goes from the worst post to the best one now, and he stands out in this non-winners of two field. He will probably be a popular single in this opening leg of tonight's \$75,000 guaranteed Pick 5.

#8 NUMERO DIX got Doug McNair in the bike for his first two starts as a four-year-old, and in the first one he dropped to the back and closed mildly in the race that Validus won by several lengths. He was much better in his second start back, showing early speed, sitting a trip, then digging in late to stay for third in a dead heat. He draws outside again and he loses McNair, but both of those factors will only boost his price and that can make him a good one to use underneath in this spot.

#4 FATEFUL clearly has some ability having already won three times, but her gait issues and typical lack of gate speed make her a risky proposition. Her race two starts back where she finished third behind better horses than she meets tonight identify her as one of the main contenders in here, but you have to ask what price you'd be willing to accept tonight when you consider that she broke in two of her last four starts.

#2 SOUTHVIEW AVIATOR drops from non-winners of three and he raced better and finished closer last week. It wouldn't be a big stretch for him to sneak into the bottom of the Tri or Super facing non-winners of two tonight. He's worth a look at a price.

#6 DIVINE LOVE took plenty of [lay last week after producing a nice closing kick two starts back to get up for second behind a winner that blew the doors off the field in the third quarter. Unfortunately for those who bet her down to 3 to 2 last week, she broke soon after the start, spotting the field at least 20 lengths. She worked hard to catch up to the field, and she found her best stride in deep stretch to get within two lengths of the winner. It's concerning that she broke stride in two of her last three starts while wearing trotting hobbles. Hopefully, she will offer a better price in here. I think she's the best one in here if she stays flat, and leaving from the best post, she should be able to get decent position leaving the gate. I'll give her a slight nod.

#3 ACROBATIC's qualifier here on January 12th provided reason for optimism. In that winning mile, she sat third from the start to the far turn where she edged off the pylons to chase the loose leader. She methodically chased down that rival under a confident drive from her trainer. She got catch driver Todd Ratchford in the bike for her sophomore debut on January 19th, and after breaking at the start, she won the race for place behind a winner that blew the field away. She got bet down to 4 to 1 in her next start, and she made a couple of moves then finished evenly. Last week, she made a middle move to the front, got a good pace trip stealing a 1:02 middle half, then drifted off the pylons in the stretch and failed to hold off a rival that ducked to her inside. She had no visible excuse in that mile, but she stacks up well in this field and she might be able to get the job done tonight.

#4 DULCES SUENOS DEO, as has become customary with him, passed some rivals in the back half last week to get up for a slice, and that marked the 14th time in 29 starts where he finished second or third, and the 12th time that he has finished exactly third. He looks like a professional maiden at this point, but he is a great one to use on the bottom of Tri bets.

#1 KINNDER ICECUBE led early last time then after taking a shuffle re-rallied into second around the last turn in pursuit of a leader that opened up an insurmountable advantage. He got picked off on the line by Divine Love for second. That was a decent effort, and he has been taking shares consistently of late. He should be in the mix again.

#3 JAYPORT CASH came into last week's race off a bad luck second two starts back. After starting from a wide post and getting nicely positioned in the pocket early in the mile, he took a major mid race shuffle as the lead changed hands several times. He moved out on the final turn, but at that point, the leader was accelerating on the engine. Driver Thiessen moved this gelding widest at the head of the lane, and he finished full of trot, but he ran out of racetrack. He got bet down to 3 to 2 last week, and he tried to make his own luck by being aggressive. He raced first up around the turn to engage the leader, and he eventually got past that rival, but he drifted out in the land and Bonito Boy (who he faces again tonight) slid past him between horses. He can turn the tables if he works out a slightly better trip.

#7 CAPTAIN WANIA recently raced okay in some tough conditioned races facing some salty veterans, now he moves into non-winners of three to face what appears to be easier company. Most recently, he wasn't beaten that far against non-winners of \$6.000 last four, but he could only muster a 30 2/5 final quarter. That might help explain the addition of Lasix tonight. He will likely get put into play from the widest post, and he is a candidate to lead these all the way tonight.

#6 BONITO BOY showed little racing at this level two starts back, then he got a bit of a lucky trip last week, but he was able to convert, passing the tired leaders late between horses to get the job done for his second win of the season. He is in play again tonight, and he gets the bonus of drawing the best post, but I have a hard time backing his as a 2 to 1 morning line favorite tonight. I'll take a stand against him and try to beat him out of this opening leg of tonight's early Pick 4.

#5 DAFFY HANOVER was used up early after starting from a wide post last time and she finished well behind Jayport Cash. She draws a much better post tonight, and she has shown that she is capable of producing a much better effort than she did in her last start. She can race better and get a slice tonight.

#7 VOLCANIC's fans abandoned him two starts back after he was expected to get the job done in his previous start on January 26th and he couldn't seal the deal as the 4 to 5 favorite. Losing Doug McNair for a start also contributed to his overlaid final odds of 10 to 1. Capable replacement Travis Henry provided the winning steer as this gelding wore down the McNair driven 4 to 5 favorite. That was a game win, and he came right back last week to double up as the 2 to 5 favorite. He caught a bit of a break that night when his expected main rival scratched. Still, he is sharp and consistent, and he looks best in here. He gets the call to notch the repeat as we kick off tonight's 20-cent Pick 6 sequence.

#2 CHEF took the early lead from his wide post last week, then he gave up command to Volcanic in the second quarter. He followed that rival to the lane and had to wait for the first-over challenger to stop advancing so he could exit the pocket. He got the room he needed at the eighth pole, and he had a clear shot at the leader, but he could only get to his wheel. He should be prominent leaving the gate again tonight and work out another good trip, but I don't love his chances if he enters the stretch

#5 BELMONT BLAZER was a decent closing third here two starts back then he tried racing first-over against Volcanic, and that was a trip that was a trip that wasn't going to work. He did hang in there for third, and I could see him being closer tonight if he can find a live helmet to follow. The Cullen barn scored two upset wins here on Friday night and they appear to be heating up again. This gelding is worth a look at a price here.

#6 WICKED EXPRESS got pressured by Volcanic for the entire back half last time with that rival eventually getting the best of him. He missed a week now tries his luck again. With other speed horses in here, I prefer to use him underneath, but if you still like him on top, you will almost certainly get a better price than the 4 to 5 he offered last time.

#6 ROYAL FLUSH DEO is an \$80,000 Lexington Sale buy that started only once at two and broke in that lone rookie try. The sophomore son of Walner entered his second start on January 26th off a sneaky good qualifier 10 days earlier. In that mile, he was content to sit sixth most of the way then he angled off the pylons in early stretch. He closed some ground between horses, in traffic the whole way home, and he finished on a helmet with plenty of trot in reserve. He parlayed that mile into his first win where he was held in reserve following cover in the lane until very late in the stretch. When he was shown racetrack, he ate up ground rapidly, getting up on the line for an impressive maiden win. He came back to score again last week, fanning widest turning for home then measuring the game Validus late to get up for another narrow win. This gelding clearly has some talent and he will likely triple up tonight at another short price.

#5 SHOCK FACTOR raced well in defeat here two weeks ago, coming on late to get second behind a blowout winner. He then led to the top of the stretch last week against Royal Flush Deo when he jumped it off right after he cornered. He likely won't take much action tonight and he will probably revert to the closing style coming off that break in stride. He might offer some Exacta value in this spot.

#3 FRENCHMONI HANOVER came first-over on the final turn last time to chase loose leader Validus home, and in mid stretch he looked like he had second wrapped up. He got a but tired nearing the wire and he got picked off by Shock Factor but he was well clear in third. That third-place finish represented his ninth share in his 29th start, and he should be in the exotics mix again tonight.

#2 HAPPY ANGEL raced well in defeat here three starts back when he just failed to hang on at 12 to 1. In his next start, he got bet down to 2 to 1 favorite, and he never really fired his best shot that night. Undaunted, bettors made him an even bigger favorite last week when starting from a wide post, and he didn't disappoint, going right down the road to score his maiden win. He meets tougher now, and he will likely a fringe player tonight.

#2 HAZELS MUSCLE, a \$50,000 Lexington purchase, started only twice last year at two, and he didn't show much in his debut, then he broke stride in his next start and didn't get a chance to show what he could do. He qualified sharply here on January 31st on an extremely cold morning where times were allowed a one second variant. He was kept inside to the lane where he then edged off the pylons, and he stayed on a helmet until very late in the stretch where he was shown clear racetrack, and although he ran out of real estate, he was clearly moving best at the wire. Off that impressive qualifying effort, he got bet down to 3 to 1 last week but not much went right for him in that mile. He was stacked up fourth-over turning for home when the horse he was following broke, and it took him a few strides to get off that cover, which cost him several lengths. He trotted home well after that incident, but the damage was done. I'll stick with him in the opening leg of tonight's late Pick 5.

#3 LOVE SENSATION is a \$40,000 Lexington buy purchased by The Stable that made only one start at two last year, and that mile didn't go so well. She wasn't seen for seven months when she showed up to qualify here on January 31st, and what we saw that morning gave hope that she has matured and she would be ready to produce a good effort in her sophomore debut. On that morning, she rallied between horses, but she finished the mile surrounded and buried in behind rivals, clearly with plenty of trot to offer. She then broke on the backstretch last week in that sophomore debut, and she now loses J Mac for A Mac, but that change will inflate her price. She's worth a look here.

#6 STORMONT FULLALIFE was racing well when he tried the front end racing on a snow covered track last time and tired late. He draws best here, and he can probably work out a trip this time. I don't love his stale date, but he still may be good for a share.

#1 ACEFORTYFOUR MAGIC raced okay at 127 to 1 in defeat to Happy Angel last time, but he isn't one that I could back on top in here as the morning line favorite. He will likely be a fringe player starting from the rail.

#1 TOUR CHAMPION raced well in defeat last week in Leg 1 of this series. Coming off a break in stride in his previous start, he was bet down to 8 to 5, and he was on go at the start. He was involved in a three pronged battle for the top heading into the first turn, and he made front briefly before giving up command. From there, he rode the pocket to the head of the stretch where he got a clear lane to rally along the pylons. He sprinted home with the race favorite, but he couldn't quite hold that rival at bay. He loses the leading driver, but it seems likely that he will get another aggressive steer from replacement driver Ratchford. He gets top billing in this opening leg of tonight's late Pick 4.

#3 BENJAMIN BEE is another that raced well in the same mile that Tour Champion exits, and he is worth a look for late multi-race tickets tonight. Despite coming into that race with solid Flamboro Downs form, he was sent postward as a 32 to 1 bomb. He got badly gapped out on the backstretch when the horse he was following couldn't keep up. He commenced an outside move at the half, and he did well to close more than eight lengths in the back half, rallying widest in the lane to get up for fourth. Moving inside tonight, he should be able to lay closer to the front early in this mile.

#5 LEFT HAND LOU tried the front end last week and he got pushed three wide around the first turn and past the quarter before finally touching down on the point. He led to the stretch, but that early battling took its toll. He can get a better trip tonight, and he is another in with a chance in a race that lacks a standout.

#7 COLD CREEK PANTERA dropped into this Pop Up Series out of the Snowshoe Pacing Series Final, so it wasn't surprising to see him attract a claim that night, and it was then predictable that he would get driven aggressively in his last start for the barn he was claimed from. He tried it first up, but he couldn't sustain his bid and he was passed by both Tour Champion and Benjamin Bee in the lane. He can be an exotics factor in this first start for trainer Puddy.

#6 SIDE EFFECTS was winless in 2025 when she got leading driver James Macdonald in the bike five starts back here on December 15th. She raced tough on the engine to score the win that night, then she came right back a week later, and she was even better, pacing away from some overmatched rivals to take a new lifetime mark while kicking home in a snappy 27 2/5. On January 12th, she made a middle move to the front, but she got strung out while making that move and she couldn't convert. Then on January 19th, racing off the Kyle Fellows claim, she was too far back after leaving from a wide post. She got a better post on January 2nd and rallied for a win, then last week, she was an impressive first-over winner. She stands out in this field, and she should take another win at a short price.

#3 COEURATOUT DU LAC's four-year-old debut when facing Side Effects was decent and that's a mile she can build from. She was prominent early, took a shuffle then shook loose late to get up for third in a decent effort. She showed she has some ability when she took her 1:53 1/5 lifetime mark in a leg of the Spring Series here last year. If there is going to be one to upset Side Effects tonight, it will likely be this mare right here.

#2 ARIELS BET finished closest to Side Effects last week, but she rode that rival's perfect cover to the head of the lane, tipped out and she couldn't reach the leader's wheel. The leading trainer was heating up earlier in this week, but I'm not sure what trip this mare could get to bridge the gap on the top pick when she couldn't do it last week. She can be an Exacta factor here, however.

#1 HOT COE COE moved up to this \$20,000 claiming level coming off two wins versus easier and she took no action whatsoever last week. After dropping back from a wide post at the start, she did manage to rally for fourth behind the top three picks in here, and she will likely look to do something similar here. She can be a fringe player again tonight.

#1 BETTOR BEAST shipped in from London three starts back on January 26th and he rallied well to finish a close fourth that night. He fired back in the same class a week later, and he got the "first time McNair" angle with a claim entered. He got an aggressive steer as expected, and he was an easy winner. He then raced off the Kyle Fellows claim in the opening leg of this series, and he rallied wide to score a second consecutive win. Drawing the inside is okay for him because he should be able to work out another good stalking trip and rally late again. He gets the nod to score the threepeat here.

#7 ALL BETS ON GARY raced well off the Maguire claim three starts back, rallying to get second behind the winning 2 to 5 favorite. Coming off that good mile, he got bet down to 2 to 1 favorite, but he never fired, although he did gain ground late while pacing a 28-flat kicker. He got Louis-Phillipe Roy back in the bike following a one race absence, in the opening Leg of this series last week, and he appeared to be in an easier spot. Roy provided an aggressive steer and this son of All Bets Off did the rest to take his first win of the season in his fifth try. He looks like the main threat to the choice and those two will take most of the action on late multi-race tickets.

#2 RYLENTLESS got claimed by conditioner Kyle Bossence two starts back in London when he was taking a second consecutive win, and he raced okay here last week when finishing third behind Bettor Beast. In that mile, he sat an inside trip to the head of the lane where he angled off the pylons. He found a seam and closed well to get up for third and he was still gaining at the wire. He can get another trip here and he is worth a look for the bottom of Tri and Super tickets.

#4 POPPA JOE looked trapped inside at the back last week, but he managed to find a seam to get off the pylons just before the three quarter pole, and once he found clear sailing, he rallied well on the outside to get into a clear second behind All Bets On Gary. He is another closer that can come on late and work his way into the bottom of the Tri or Super.

#5 SUPERSONIC HANOVER came close at this level two starts back when he went to the gate at huge odds and got an aggressive J R Plante steer. He moved to the front in a slow second quarter, then he led to the stretch where he opened up a sizeable lead. He couldn't fend off the 1 to 2 favorite in the end, but he finished a clear second in a sharp effort. He then faced tougher and he finished only evenly last week. This is a better spot for him tonight, and if he gets another aggressive steer, he could get the job done against these. He gets top billing in this cash leg of the late multi-race tickets.

#9 CHIC CHOC ROSE is a consistent competitor that is always a good one to use on the ticket, it seems. She comes off a mile where she followed Supersonic Hanover to the lane, then she rallied past him to beat him for fourth. She draws wide here, but she looks like one of the best ones in this field, and it seems likely that she will get put into play leaving the gate tonight. She is the other one that I would consider using on late multi-race tickets in this spot.

#4 WILDTURKEY HANOVER recovered from an early break last time to get fifth while finishing less than two lengths behind Supersonic Hanover. He was then a weather scratch, so I won't hold missing that week against him. His best race puts him right there with these, and he could do in here if he stays flat.

#6 FLASHCHAP is another that wasn't too far behind Supersonic Hanover at the wire last time, now he draws best and he picks up Louis-Phillipe Roy in the bike. It's not a stretch to think that he is going to get put into play leaving from the best post tonight. He is another one to consider for late multi-race tickets in what appears to be a spread race.

#3 LUVUTOTHEMOONANBAK was a good winner as the favorite two starts back when facing non-winners of three then he tried the front end last week, but he couldn't seal the deal. He will likely be heard from early in the mile again, but this is a tougher spot, and I don't see him beating all of these tonight, but he should be able to stick around and take a small slice.

CONDITIONS AND ALLOWANCES IN HARNESS RACING - IMPORTANT TO KNOW

The conditions of a race determine whether a horse is eligible to enter. For example many races are restricted to horses that have won a certain number of races or a certain amount of money in a specified number of starts. Many races are restricted to horses entered to be "claimed" (offered for sale) at a specific price.

Allowances in the claiming price itself are given to colts and geldings, four-year-olds and younger and to mares, five-year-olds and younger.

The purpose of the allowance is to keep younger horses more competitive when racing against older and more experienced rivals. Mares are given extra consideration in claiming events because of their potential as broodmares.

The accompanying chart shows what the allowances are, but an example may make them easier to understand. The chart indicates that three-year-olds receive a 50% allowance in claiming races. This means that a three-year-old entered in a \$20,000 claiming race carries an actual claiming price of \$30,000 (50% higher).

Fillies and mares receive an additional 25% allowance in claiming races. Details of the race conditions and claiming price (if any) are given at the top of each race in the program.

ALLOWANCES FOR PURSE EARNINGS

When Fillies/Mares compete against Colts/Geldings (normally on the trot) Fillies/Mares will receive an additional 25% on the condition of the race. ie: nw \$5,000 (FM \$6,250) last 5 or \$12,000 (FM \$15,000) last 10 starts.

Effective January 1st 2012
CPMA will be instituting several new rule changes with regards to the following pari-mutuel pools:

Pick Pools

- If there are no winners in any leg of a Pick N pool, the entire pool is refunded.
- If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners.
- A pool is no longer refunded if the 1st leg in the pool is cancelled or declared no contest.
- Pick-3: If at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: If at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.

EXPLANATION OF THE LASIX PROGRAM

After careful study and consultation with Ontario Horsemen's groups, racetrack operators and veterinarians, Agriculture Canada and the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario passed legislation allowing the controlled (or supervised) administration of furosemide, more commonly called "Lasix". "Lasix" is used to alleviate the symptoms of exercise induced pulmonary hemorrhaging in racing horses. Horses will undergo an endoscopic examination of the trachea by a veterinarian licensed by the Ontario Racing Commission and endorsed by an official veterinarian before being allowed on the medication list. Once qualified, horses will be treated with "Lasix" within four hours plus or minus 15 minutes of a scheduled race in a secure retention area under the super vision of racing officials.

All horses on "Lasix" must remain on the program for a minimum of 100 days while racing in this jurisdiction.

- (L)** Denotes horses treated with Lasix for their last start but not so treated today.

GENERAL

All pari-mutuel pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with the regulations and directives as issued by Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada ("the Regulations"), under the approval and supervision of the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency. The Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency can be contacted at 1-800-268-8835 or 613-759-6100 or Email: cpmawebacpm@agr.gc.ca. A complete version of the CPMA regulations can be found at <http://laws-lois.justice.gc.ca/eng/regulations/SOR-91-365/>.

All tickets should be held until the result of the race is declared official and prices are posted.

No person under the age of 18 shall purchase or cash a ticket or voucher.

A claim of receiving an incorrect payment or incorrect change must be made to the Mutuel office of the association within twenty four hours of buying or cashing a valid ticket or voucher.

No ruling made by the Stewards/Judges or the Ontario Racing Commission with regard to distribution of purse money or the placing of horses in the order of finish, after the race has been declared official, shall have any bearing on the pay-out prices or distribution of pari-mutuel pools.

Change boards and Photo Finish display monitors are located in the Grandstand. In addition, Photo Finish pictures are shown on the closed-circuit television system. Customers are reminded that mutuel clerks are responsible for all shortages. When making a wager, customers must present sufficient funds at the time of purchase to cover the wagers requested.

"Entry" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled or considered as the same betting interest. The most common reason for the coupling of horses in an Entry is the fact that they are owned by the same person.

"Mutuel Field" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled because the number of horses in the race exceeds the number which can be handled separately by the pari-mutuel system. Subject to the Regulations, a bet on one horse of an Entry or Mutuel Field shall be considered a bet on all horses in that Entry or Mutuel Field.

DAILY DOUBLE BETTING (INCLUDING LATE DOUBLE)

A Daily Double bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of the two races specified for the Daily Double. Tickets not selecting the winner of the first half of the Daily Double and all tickets in the second half of the Daily Double not coupled with the declared official winner of the first half of the Daily Double are not winners and are not refunded no matter what circumstances affect the running of the second half of the Daily Double.

Should a horse or horses (not coupled with another starter) be excused from starting in the second race of the Daily Double after the first race of the Daily Double has closed for betting, holders of all Daily Double tickets on such horses, coupled with the winner of the first Daily Double race, shall participate in a Consolation Double pool. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

EXACTA (Also known as Exactor)/TRIFECTA (Also known as Trifactor)/SUPERFECTA

An Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first two, three and four horses respectively, representing different betting interests to finish in the exact official order of finish, in the race on which the pool is operated.

SWINGER (Also known as OMN)

A Swinger is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select horses to finish in any order from the official first 3 positions.

JACKPOT HI-5

A Jackpot Hi-5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners in the specified Jackpot Hi-5 race. If there are races that have an entry, (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B), Jackpot Hi-5 will not offer a wager consisting of both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in a Jackpot Hi-5, the payout would be 1st, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th.

That jackpot portion of the pool will only be paid out if there is a single winning ticket. If there are multiple winning tickets that have correctly chosen the first 5 runners of the race, they will receive 50% of the pool for that day. The other 50% will go over into the Jackpot carryover. If there are no winning tickets with the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners, 100% of the current day's pool will be carried over into the Jackpot.

PICK 3 & PICK-4 BETTING

The Pick 3 & Pick 4 bets are betting transactions in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of three or four successive races specified for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 respectively.

Winning tickets for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 are determined in the following sequence: A) winners of all legs, B) most winners, then refund. If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners. If there are no winners in any leg of a pool, the entire pool is refunded.

PICK 5 BETTING

The Pick 5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of five successive races specified for the Pick 5 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 5 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 5.

PICK 6 BETTING

The Pick 6 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of six successive races specified for the Pick 6 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 6 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 6.

PICK 5 & 6 BETTING

If at least 1 race as part of the Pick 5 or 6 has been cancelled or declared "No contest", but not more than the specified below under Refunds, the net pool shall be distributed to those selecting the most # of winners and NOT include any carryover from a previous pool.

PICK 3, PICK 4, PICK 5 & PICK 6 SCRATCHES

In the event a Pick 3, Pick 4, Pick 5 or Pick 6 ticket designates as a selection a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the Stewards/Judges to be a non-starter in any of the races comprising the Pick 3, Pick 4, Pick 5 or Pick 6 the favourite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection. In the event that the money bet in the win pool for two or more favourites is identical, the selection with the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non-starting selection.

However, if a scratch occurs in any leg of the Pick 3, Pick 4, Pick 5 or Pick 6 pools before the pool is closed, a ticket including the scratched horse may be cancelled.

REFUNDS

Subject to the Regulations, all monies in all pools on a race are refunded in the event that the race is cancelled, declared off or declared no contest, and all monies bet on a horse are refunded if the horse is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start. These refunds will be communicated to the public through various means such as betting terminals, video display, changes boards and our website.

The Pick(n) pool shall be cancelled and all Pick(n) wagers for the individual performance shall be refunded if:

- Pick-3: at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

Where a horse that is part of an Entry is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start and at least one horse of that Entry receives a fair start in the race, all tickets purchased on the Entry remain valid and the purchase price of any such ticket shall not be refunded.

COMMON POOL WAGERING (INTERTRACK BETTING)

In the unlikely event of a communications or computer system failure that prevents pools from merging with the host track's pools before the end of a race, CPMA regulations require that the site must refund all tickets for that race. This refund will be communicated to the public through various means such as video displays, change boards and messages on our website.

FAIR START

If a horse has reached the Fair Start Pole (located 200 feet before the Starting Pole) by the time the mobile gate has reached the Starting Pole, that horse is deemed to have had a fair start. It makes no difference whether or not the horse is on or off stride at that precise moment. Under current policy and regulations, which are designed to be as fair as possible to all bettors on all starters, there is no Recall - a repeat of the entire starting procedure - when a horse does not reach the Fair Start Pole before the gate reaches the Starting Pole. Monies bet on such a horse are refunded in accordance with the regulation concerning refunds.

LOST & OLD TICKETS

WEG issued tickets or vouchers are valid indefinitely, however, they cannot be cashed at a mutuel teller after 2 years from date of issue. Please mail tickets, along with your name and address, to Mutuel Manager, P.O. Box 156, Rexdale, Ontario, M9W 5L2, keeping a photocopy for future reference.

For "Lost Tickets" originally sold at a Woodbine Entertainment Group racetrack or Teletheatre, please enquire at the Mutuel office at Woodbine, Greenwood Teletheatre, or Mohawk. Policy may be subject to change retroactively in the event regulatory bodies amend existing regulations.

ASSOCIATION PERCENTAGE, AND TAXATION/LEVY

The Woodbine Entertainment Group deducts and retains the following percentages from wagers placed at our own licensed sites which are then shared with the horsepeople, host and simulcast associations and the Ontario Racing Commission.

WOODBINE/MOHAWK LIVE: Win, Place & Show: 13.65%. Swinger 14.7%. Trifecta & Pick 4: 21.7%. Double & Exacta 17.2%. Jackpot Hi-5, Pick 5 & Pick 6: 11.7%. All other 23.0%

Horsepeople receive a further 2% on all wagers, except Trifecta wagering where it is 4%. The Ontario Provincial Government retains 0.5% on all bets placed in Ontario. The Canadian Government (through a revolving fund cost recovery basis) retains 0.8% on all wagers placed in Canada for provision of drug control, and audit services.
