Betting Basics

Some essentials to get you started with making a wager.

1 How to wager



Place your bet by visiting a teller, or using a self-serve terminal.

To place a bet here are just 5 things you need to know:

- 1 Name of racetrack (choose from any track in the simulcast feeds)
- 2 Number of the race
- 3 Amount of your bet (e.g. \$2)
- 4 Type of bet (see step 2)
- 5 Horse's number (see step 4)

Once you have decided what you want to bet, head to the nearest seller's window and use the sample statement as your guide:

Hello, (Racetrack), race 6, \$2 to WIN on Horse #4

How to use a self-serve terminal:

- 1 Swipe your Cash Card/Insert Cash
- 2 Enter the initial PIN #1234 (then choose a new PIN)
- 3 Press/Tap the track you would like to bet: (defaults to current race)
- 4 Tap the Horse Number: **#4**
- 5 Press/Tap the Bet Type: **WIN**
- 6 Press/Tap the Bet Amount: **\$2**
- 7 Press/Tap the Race Number: **Race #6**
- 8 Press Green **"Make BET"** button
- 9 Press/Tap the **"Finish with Receipt"** button
- 10 Be sure to check your ticket to confirm it's the bet you wanted

To get a Cash Card or for assistance ask a teller, or a staff member.

2 Types of bets



Single horse bets (minimum \$2.00 bet is required)

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Win	U U U	Your horse must finish 1st; payoff determined by the win odds.
Place	U U	Your horse must finish 1st or 2nd; payoffs better than to show.
Show	U	Your horse must finish 1st, 2nd, or 3rd; modest payoffs.

Exotic multiple-horse bets

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Exacta*	U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st and 2nd in exact order; riskier bet that can pay a little or a lot, depending on the horses' odds.
Daily double	U U U U U	Pick the winners of two designated consecutive races.
Pick 3, Win 4, Pick 5, Pick 6	U U U U U U	Select the winners of a designated set of consecutive races. The wager must be made prior to the start of the first race in the multi-race wager.
Triactor*	U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in exact order; can be expensive to play if you use a lot of horses.
Superfecta*	U U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th; big payoff possible.

* Exotic bets require the horses to finish in the EXACT order you select, unless you "BOX" the bet, in which case your selections can finish in any order.

Race 1 Selections

The Horseplayer's Journal by Garnet Barnsdale

#1 SORCHA SEELSTER announced she was ready to win two starts back when she produced a nice closing effort to get second at this level behind Western Wish, who she also faces again tonight. She was accordingly bet down to 5 to 2 last week, and she was very good, but racing luck was against her in that mile. She rode non-advancing cover third-over to the head of the lane and she tipped wide, and she was airborne late. Unfortunately for her, the 9 to 5 favorite, who rode the pylons for the opening three quarters, slipped out, found a seam, and got the jump on her. She flew home, but the damage was already done, and she couldn't reach the leader. She is razor-sharp, and she gets top billing in the opening leg of tonight's \$75,000 guaranteed Pick 5 under the assumption that she will get a more aggressive steer here.

#2 AVYANNA is the other mare in here that will likely take the bulk of mutuel support along with Sorcha Seelster. She gets several key changes that should lead to sharp improvement. In addition to getting back to a seven-day rotation after missing more than a month before her last start, she gets class relief, and trainer/Hall of Famer Paul McDonell hands the lines to leading driver James Macdonald. She is an obvious contender that is hard to leave out of the early Pick 5.

#8 WESTERN WISH beat the choice two starts back, and she was full value for that win here on February 13th. Sitting fourth to the far turn, she was the first one to move and chase a loose leader. She eventually collared that rival, then dug deep to fend off the closers, including Sorcha Seelster, who made the last move, She was forced up in class last week, and although she was over matched, she was still beaten less than four lengths at the wire. She fits better in this class, and I don't mind the wide draw as she has the gate speed to overcome it. She could offer some value for the early Pick 5 as it's likely Sorcha Seelster will get hammered at the windows tonight.

#4 SHOOT THE WHISKEY was used hard early last time, and she paid the price late. She is capable at this level, and she gets a key driver change tonight back to Travis Cullen, who steered her to a win two starts back in the top class at Flamboro Downs and another win three starts back here racing one level lower than tonight's class. She's worth a look for the Tri and Super at 15 to 1 in the morning line.

#1 EMERALDA DU LAC shipped in from Quebec following a short rookie season where she finished second in two of three starts including her last race of the year where she dropped more than three seconds to grab the runner up spot behind blowout 1 to 9 winner Cattlekiss in a stakes final. This daughter of Cattlewash, bred, owned and driven by Louis-Phillipe Roy has some upside and she showed some of it in her qualifier preparing for this sophomore debut. Last Saturday morning, she followed along and was patiently driven to the final turn, and she lost valuable ground following a gapper. She was moved between horses at the head of the lane, and, responding to Roy urging, she produced the co-fastest final quarter of the morning along with the gelding that nipped her for second on the wire. She showed enough in that qualifier to make me think that she is ready to go, and she gets the call to break her maiden in this first start at three.

#6 PELICAN BAY is the third foal from her dam, and when she won on debut, she kept that broodmare's record producing winners perfect. The half sister to 1:49 3/5 (F.) pacer Dream Bird (67-6-17-9, \$199K) couldn't have been any more impressive in that debut score, making a big third quarter move then driving away from her rivals after pacing that frame in 28 2/5. She gets the leading driver for trainer/owner Hollingsworth who had a blowout winner here in the Monday nightcap, and this filly should be right there with these.

#7 LDS KIMBERLY had a decent season at two, taking five shares from nine starts while earning close to \$16,000. She qualified well twice leading up to her sophomore debut last week and she got bet down the 3 to 1 but starting from the nine hole, she showed little. She draws widest again here, but it's different to start widest in a seven-horse field. She gets a key driver change to Travis Henry now, and she figures to be sharper. She can be an exotics factor at a good price tonight.

#2 RED BEACH ONE was bet down to a lukewarm 5 to 2 favorite for her sophomore debut and she got an aggressive steer, making front early then again at the head of the lane. She can be sharper tonight, but I prefer to use her underneath tonight.

#3 TAMARA HANOVER is a mare that I thought did remarkably well last week to get third considering the trip that she got that night. Starting from the widest post, she began at the back, and she was asked to go forward early, probably seeking to get positioned along the pylons closer to the front. That move backfired as she got hung out three wide briefly entering the first turn, then she got parked the mile. After gapping out on the backstretch, she stayed game in the lane and re-rallied for third in a super effort. She steps up tonight which ensures she will offer a square price making her third start off the Auceillo claim. I'll take a shot at the upset with her in this opening leg of tonight's 20-cent Pick 4.

#2 MADAM X finished off her 2025 campaign with some breaking issues then she shipped north to join trainer Menary's barn. She came into her seasonal debut off a nice qualifying effort with the leading driver in the bike sitting chilly as the mare drove away to win, as she beat two rivals that morning. She was bet down to 4 to 5 on January 23rd, and she didn't disappoint her supporters, making two moves and winning easily. She made the unusual move of taking on the boys in a Pop Up series in her next three starts, and she did well to almost complete the sweep. She gets a much better post tonight, and she gets to face the girls tonight in a spot where she seems to fit well. She is hard to leave off multi-race tickets in this spot.

#5 FATED FIRE got a great J R Plante steer and a perfect trip last week, and she got a perfect trip, but she got passed late by the mare that rode her cover. Still, that was a strong effort, and she was a clear second at the wire. She has yet to find the winner's circle in six starts this season, but she is sharp, and she'll get that first 2026 win soon, maybe tonight.

#8 CHARMBO STORMY arrived here on February 6th coming off two impressive front end scores in the top class in London, and she has raced three times here, and was dropped to the back at the start in all of those miles. She draws wide tonight, but she drops in class, and I think her tactics change here. She will likely blast off the gate looking for the front or a position close to the lead, and she can stick around for a share.

#6 KELLINA DIAMOND is another mare that missed Leg 1 of this Pop Up series that will no doubt get raced aggressively looking for a high placing in this second leg of the series. She was racing well in January, taking a win, a second and a third from three starts following a 11-0-1-2 season, then she got sick and was sidelined. She looked terrific winning her qualifier here on the morning of February 21st, taking over the lead in the second quarter then winning far easier than it looked on paper, pacing the final quarter in 28-flat while under no urging, JR Plante sitting with the whip leaning on his right shoulder for the entire stretch drive. Based on how sharp she looked that morning, she gets top billing to kick off tonight's 20-cent Pick 6.

#5 MY ONLY SUNSHINE entered her last start coming off three straight fifth-place finishes, but she was in too tough in all of those starts, and she wasn't disgraced in any of those trio of miles. Two starts back, she tried racing first-over, and she tired from her efforts. She got a key class drop on February 8th, and as expected, she controlled the race after making an early move to the front and she went on to score an easy win. She missed Leg 1 of this series, so she needs a good result here to make it into the final. She fits well here; the only concern is the 19 days between starts. Starting from one of the best posts, she should get a good trip racing close to the front throughout, and she should be a threat.

#1 LA PETITE GRISE comes in from Flamboro Downs in sharp form, and she has found the winner's circle in nine of her past 39 starts over the past two seasons. She gets Louis-Phillipe Roy in the bike for the first time in her career in this 136th start, and starting from the rail, Roy can probably work out a good following trip racing close to the front. It seems likely that she will land in the Tri or Super.

#2 HERES THE THING hit the board in five straight starts before getting a tough first-over trip last time while finishing sixth. It's interesting that she picks up the leading driver tonight, and he will likely find a helmet for this mare to follow tonight. She is another one that is worth using underneath.

#5 LIKE CHAOS has been facing much tougher foes recently than he meets tonight, such as Buck Dancer, who was the winner in both of this gelding's last two starts. He gets needed class relief here tonight, and he draws one of the best posts. One only need look back to last time he raced at tonight's class as a clue into what his strategy will be in this spot tonight. In that mile on January 2nd, he blasted straight to the front, raced with the throttle fully open for the entire mile, and bottomed out the field to win by a football field. He should prove to beat dropping back to the lowest class level here.

#3 STONEBRIDGE GLEE is interesting here because of the mile he trotted here last week. He trailed to the last turn, and he was sent widest on that turn, and he started to pass horses. After losing a lot of ground on that turn, he continued to pass rivals, and he had his best stride late in the stretch, getting up for fourth. He would have finished third if the race was a mile and a few strides long. Daryl Thiessen got a lot of trot out of the gelding that night, and this one can be an Exacta factor tonight if he can lay a bit closer early.

#4 DONATOVER dropped, popped, and got bet down to 2 to 1 two starts back, and he tried the front, but he couldn't see it through. He then he drew the widest post last week, went off at 16 to 1 and showed little. He gets a much better starting spot tonight, and it's likely that he will show more speed leaving the gate. It's possible that he will ride in Like Chaos' pocket tonight, and I could see him sticking around for a share.

#9 DELCREST BRENT, second choice in tonight's morning line, came within a neck of winning racing one class higher here five starts back. He has a good closing kick on his best night, and while the class drop should help him tonight, the post draw likely won't. He will likely be looking to rally from far back, and a smaller share is likely his ceiling in this spot.

#5 ANGELS AMOUNG US couldn't be going any better right now coming into this Mohawk Park debut tonight. Three starts back, she got an easy trip on the lead to take a first of three straight victories in the non-winners of two class. She followed that win up with another on February 7th, racing first-over and drawing away late. Her most impressive mile came in her last start on Valentine's Day. She made a lethal three wide move at the three quarters, then, pacing the fastest final quarter of her career, she sprinted away from her rivals to take a big win. She took a new lifetime mark that night, and she is obviously on top of her game for the leading trainer. She is the clear top pick to kick off tonight's late Pick 6.

#1 BEACH WIGGLE is in solid form, but she comes off a race where she got a perfect trip and couldn't convert, although it was probably just that the two that finished in front of her were simply too fast considering that race went in 1:55 1/5 with a 28 3/5 kicker. It's definitely interesting that Travis Cullen, who owns both her and the top pick in here, sided with this sophomore filly. There is a decent chance that we will be looking at a Team Cullen Exacta here.

#6 DAY OF DELIGHT entered her first pari-mutuel start off a sneaky good qualifier and she got bet down to 6 to 5 on debut and raced terrific in victory. She raced first-over a long way into a driving snow, and she dug deep late in the stretch to get the decision over Beach Wiggle, who she once again faces tonight. Her second start was too dull to believe, and she got a week off. I'll trust that trainer Menary fixed whatever issue prevented her from pacing her best mile. The leading driver sticks here, and she should offer a much better price than her 6 to 5 closing price two weeks ago.

#7 MONTAGUE VELMA was raced first-over in all of her three starts leading up to last week's mile, and she was unable to convert in any of them. She showed the value of following a live helmet last week. She made a move out of third on the final turn which forced the pocket sitter to make a move in front of her, and she rode that cover for a piece before pouncing to take her maiden win. She is sharp, but she faces much tougher tonight, and she is likely best used underneath.

Race 7 Selections

The Horseplayer's Journal by Garnet Barnsdale

#2 ALLSMOKEANDMIRRORS raced better last week, now she gets needed class relief dropping down to the non-winners of \$2,500 last four class. She produced a nice closing effort seven nights ago to land third behind a mare that would be a big favorite in this field. Prior to that mile, she missed getting a cheque in three straight starts, but she drew wide in all of those miles. When she last raced in this class, she was a closing second, beaten only a nose by a mare that she faces tonight. Expecting that she will get a decent trip starting from an inside post tonight, she gets top billing.

#7 SANTAFES APPETITE last won here on January 23rd when racing at this class level. She made front early that night and she was a clear leader until late in the mile when Allsmokeandmirrors charged at her and fell just short. Last week, she was provided with a good drive and a nice trip, but she miscued. She was following the eventual winner racing second-over in the third quarter, and she was still advancing when that rival cleared and she lost her cover. She then jumped it off and galloped out of contention. I'm willing to overlook that miscue considering she hadn't broken stride since the fall of 2023. She figures to be a top contender in here.

#6 KIERA SEELSTER compiled a nice record in 2025, taking six wins and four slices from 21 starts while taking her lifetime mark of 1:51 3/5 right here at Mohawk Park. She qualified well here on February 21st, sitting third to the head of the lane, then tipping three wide and sprinting well to get the measure of the two mares in front of her while under minimal Travis Henry urging. She is another possibility for the late Pick 5.

#8 ONE LAST BET gives off a bit of a glass half full/glass half empty feel in this spot. While she appears to fit well at this class level, and she comes in off a good qualifying mile, she draws widest, and she was an infrequent winner last season, taking only two victories from 38 starts. She did, however, take 15 slices, and she seems like a good one to use underneath in this initial start of 2026.

#2 LETS N JOY has been nothing short of terrific since shipping into town from Down Under. She was purchased privately after winning four of her first seven starts racing in Australia last season. She paced a nice qualifier here on January 3rd and she followed that up with a very impressive winning effort at Flamboro Downs two weeks later. She was equally impressive winning her Mohawk Park debut as the 2 to 5 favorite on January 23rd, re-rallying after giving up the lead in the third quarter. Her subsequent win in the Blizzard Series Final was probably her most impressive effort since landing in Canada. She was stacked up third-over around the turn tracking a slowish pace but looking live on a helmet. She was pointed to the middle of the track at the head of the lane, and she thundered past five rivals to win drawing away. She followed that win up with another impressive score two weeks ago while pacing a 27-flat kicker and she gets top call in this first leg of tonight's late Pick 4 as a fivepeat looms.

#3 CC ROCKIN ROSIE looked like she had Lets N Joy N beat here on February 13th when she made a power move to the front in the third quarter and opened up what appeared to be an insurmountable lead. She paced strongly to the wire, but Lets N Joy N simply had a gear that she couldn't match in the final eighth of a mile. She was bet down to 3 to 5 last week and everything went against her that night as the classy So Much More was allowed to walk the dog on the engine. She should be right there versus these, and she is the likely threat to the choice tonight if there will be one.

#4 SUGAR PIE HONEY exits the same mile as CC Rockin Rosie where no mare had any chance of closing from the back. That line is best tossed, and she will likely show much more gate speed tonight. Although I don't see her holding off both of the top two choices, she can stick around for a share in this spot.

#1 EA MONEY MAKER looked good in victory last week, racing first-over and sprinting late to chase down the leader. She steps up to non-winners of three to face much tougher though, and although she is in sharp form, and slice is likely her ceiling in this spot tonight. She should be a good one to use on the bottom of Tri and Super bets in this spot.

#5 CENTURY JAMILA should get the attention of trip handicappers who watched her last mile. Specifically, the final eighth. She got a good trip to that point riding in leader Tells On A Roll's pocket, and when that rival started to tire, this mare angled off the pylons looking for somewhere to race. Just when it looked like she found a seam, that lane closed on her and she was forced to check and look to angle outside, At that point, the eventual winner had beaten her to that spot, too, and she was forced to take back and come around. Once she did all of that, she finished full of pace, but the wire hit and she was still fourth at that point. I have little doubt that she was a winner if she found clearance at the head of the lane, and she gets top billing here.

#4 ABSOLUTION has been sharp recently but victimized by first-over trips, now she gets a driver switch to leading teamster James Macdonald in this spot. She had a terrific four-year-old campaign in 2025, taking nine wins and 16 slices in 34 starts while earning close to \$200,000, and it's only a matter of time until she gets that first win of 2026. She is in with a good chance tonight; my fear is that she will get over bet relative to her chances based on the driver change to James Macdonald.

#3 ANGOSTURA HANOVER got the best trip last time, staying covered up to the lane then angling widest at the right time to leave Century Jamila flat footed and pinned in until it was too late. She is a hard trier who saves her one move for the stretch, so she is kept sharp every week by not getting used too hard. She doesn't strike me as one that strings wins together, however, and I'll use her underneath tonight.

#7 TELLS ON A ROLL seems to be on the downward swing of her form cycle now, but her speed always makes her dangerous, and there is the possibility that she could be racing in the pocket turning for home tonight. She is hard to toss completely, but I think some others are sharper, and I'll play to beat her out of late multi-race tickets.

#7 SEACLUSION disappointingly has failed to hit the board in all five local starts since shipping here from overseas, but it says here that string of futility ends tonight. Because she has earned only \$4,860 in those five starts, she squeaks into the "not averaging \$1,000 per start in 2026 (minimum five starts) condition of this Pop Up series and she gets to face much easier tonight. This looks like a spot where the leading driver sends her to the front and goes right down the road, and she should prove tough to beat.

#6 MISS DUTTON was expected to win two starts back when she dropped to the bottom conditioned level and got hammered down to even money favorite. She was put into play immediately at the start of the race, and she parked past the quarter before making front. She was overtaken in the second quarter, then she rode the pocket from there. She was locked up tight to the eighth pole where she found room along the pylons. She tried to rally, but several rivals had momentum on the outside, and she couldn't get a rally going down along the inside. Last week, she was kept in the clear and she got the job done racing first-over. She will likely have her hands full with Seaclusion here, but she can be an Exacta factor.

#4 BOOTS N BLING comes off a good effort in Leg 1 of this series last week where she finished second to Miss Dutton. In that mile, she left for position and rode the pocket to the lane, then she twisted and turned looking for room, finally getting clearance at the eighth pole. She closed inside of Miss Dutton and poked her head in front inside the sixteenth pole before getting out sprinted to the wire. She should be in with a good chance to land another share tonight.

#1 ONE MORE BET comes into tonight's mile off a nice win at Flamboro Downs where she led all the way after starting from the widest post. Drawing the rail is no treat here, because there will be other leavers for sure, but she can get positioned near the front early and ride a trip to a spot in the Tri or Super.

#6 BUCK DANCER clearly has the best form if any in here, having taken wins in two of his last three starts while hitting the board in four of five starts racing exclusively at this \$20,000 optional claiming level this year, and as such, he gets top billing by default. He draws the best post after easily overcoming a wide draw last week to win going away, and he should prove tough to beat in this nightcap.

#7 PESO HANOVER's last line where he was a well-beaten third to Buck Dancer was better than it looks on paper. He turned for home racing in the pocket, and he had to idle looking for room while Buck Dancer was powering down the middle of the track with clear sailing. He eventually angled back to the inside and found racing room late in the stretch, but it was too late. He is the other one in here that I would consider using on late multi-race tickets. I could see him turning the table with the right trip.

#8 VICTOR INVICTUS was a driving away winner racing at this class level three starts back, then he stepped up in class on February 15th and found the competition too tough. He dropped back down to the \$20,000 optional claiming level last week, but he had little chance starting from the 10-hole. He closed well there to be beaten less than four lengths, now he gets a better draw. He should be passing rivals late and he should be part of the Tri in this spot.

#5 NO ANGEL LIKE ME made a big move to the front that she couldn't sustain last time, and her 31 4/5 final quarter stands out. Still, that was an improved effort, and she might be able to find a helmet to follow starting from the middle of the gate tonight. She is another one to consider for Tri and Super bets.

#4 OCEANVIEW NIKKI has landed exactly fifth in two straight starts, so she should get a look from High-5 bettors for use on the bottom. She will likely drop back at the start again and look to pass some rivals late, and she should be able to get up for a small piece.



The conditions of a race determine whether a horse is eligible to enter. For example many races are restricted to horses that have won a certain number of races or a certain amount of money in a specified number of starts. Many races are restricted to horses entered to be "claimed" (offered for sale) at a specific price.

Allowances in the claiming price itself are given to colts and geldings, four-year-olds and younger and to mares, five-year-olds and younger.

The purpose of the allowance is to keep younger horses more competitive when racing against older and more experienced rivals. Mares are given extra consideration in claiming events because of their potential as broodmares.

The accompanying chart shows what the allowances are, but an example may make them easier to understand. The chart indicates that three-year-olds receive a 50% allowance in claiming races. This means that a three-year-old entered in a \$20,000 claiming race carries an actual claiming price of \$30,000 (50% higher).

Fillies and mares receive an additional 25% allowance in claiming races. Details of the race conditions and claiming price (if any) are given at the top of each race in the program.

When Fillies/Mares compete against Colts/Geldings (normally on the trot) Fillies/Mares will receive an additional 25% on the condition of the race. ie: nw \$5,000 (FM \$6,250) last 5 or \$12,000 (FM \$15,000) last 10 starts.

C.P.M.A. Regulation Changes

Effective January 1st 2012
CPMA will be instituting several new rule changes with regards to the following pari-mutuel pools:

Pick Pools

- If there are no winners in any leg of a Pick N pool, the entire pool is refunded.
- If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners.
- A pool is no longer refunded if the 1st leg in the pool is cancelled or declared no contest.
- Pick-3: If at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: If at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.

EXPLANATION OF THE LASIX PROGRAM

After careful study and consultation with Ontario Horsemen's groups, racetrack operators and veterinarians, Agriculture Canada and the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario passed legislation allowing the controlled (or supervised) administration of furosemide, more commonly called "Lasix". "Lasix" is used to alleviate the symptoms of exercise induced pulmonary hemorrhaging in racing horses. Horses will undergo an endoscopic examination of the trachea by a veterinarian licensed by the Ontario Racing Commission and endorsed by an official veterinarian before being allowed on the medication list. Once qualified, horses will be treated with "Lasix" within four hours plus or minus 15 minutes of a scheduled race in a secure retention area under the super vision of racing officials.

All horses on "Lasix" must remain on the program for a minimum of 100 days while racing in this jurisdiction.

- (L)** Denotes horses treated with Lasix today who were not so treated for their last start.
- (L)** Denotes horses treated with Lasix for their last start but not so treated today.

RULES AND INFORMATION REGARDING CANADIAN HARNESS AND FOREIGN SEPARATE POOL EVENTS

GENERAL

All pari-mutuel pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with the regulations and directives as issued by Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada ("the Regulations"), under the approval and supervision of the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency. The Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency can be contacted at 1-800-268-8835 or 613-759-6100 or Email: cpmawebacpm@agr.gc.ca. A complete version of the CPMA regulations can be found at <http://laws-lois.justice.gc.ca/eng/regulations/SOR-91-385/>.

All tickets should be held until the result of the race is declared official and prices are posted.

No person under the age of 18 shall purchase or cash a ticket or voucher.

A claim of receiving an incorrect payment or incorrect change must be made to the Mutuel office of the association within twenty four hours of buying or cashing a valid ticket or voucher.

No ruling made by the Stewards/Judges or the Ontario Racing Commission with regard to distribution of purse money or the placing of horses in the order of finish, after the race has been declared official, shall have any bearing on the pay-out prices or distribution of pari-mutuel pools.

Change boards and Photo Finish display monitors are located in the Grandstand. In addition, Photo Finish pictures are shown on the closed-circuit television system. Customers are reminded that mutuel clerks are responsible for all shortages. When making a wager, customers must present sufficient funds at the time of purchase to cover the wagers requested.

ENTRIES AND MUTUEL FIELDS

"Entry" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled or considered as the same betting interest. The most common reason for the coupling of horses in an Entry is the fact that they are owned by the same person.

"Mutuel Field" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled because the number of horses in the race exceeds the number which can be handled separately by the pari-mutuel system. Subject to the Regulations, a bet on one horse of an Entry or Mutuel Field shall be considered a bet on all horses in that Entry or Mutuel Field.

DAILY DOUBLE BETTING (INCLUDING LATE DOUBLE)

A Daily Double bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of the two races specified for the Daily Double. Tickets not selecting the winner of the first half of the Daily Double and all tickets in the second half of the Daily Double not coupled with the declared official winner of the first half of the Daily Double are not winners and are not refunded no matter what circumstances affect the running of the second half of the Daily Double.

Should a horse or horses (not coupled with another starter) be excused from starting in the second race of the Daily Double after the first race of the Daily Double has closed for betting, holders of all Daily Double tickets on such horses, coupled with the winner of the first Daily Double race, shall participate in a Consolation Double pool. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

EXACTA (Also known as Exactor)/TRIFECTA (Also known as Tractor)/SUPERFECTA

An Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first two, three and four horses respectively, representing different betting interests to finish in the exact official order of finish, in the race on which the pool is operated.

SWINGER (Also known as OMN)

A Swinger is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select horses to finish in any order from the official first 3 positions.

JACKPOT HI-5

A Jackpot Hi-5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners in the specified Jackpot Hi-5 race. If there are races that have an entry, (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B), Jackpot Hi-5 will not offer a wager consisting of both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in a Jackpot Hi-5, the payout would be 1st, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th.

That jackpot portion of the pool will only be paid out if there is a single winning ticket. If there are multiple winning tickets that have correctly chosen the first 5 runners of the race, they will receive 50% of the pool for that day. The other 50% will go over into the Jackpot carryover. If there are no winning tickets with the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners, 100% of the current day's pool will be carried over into the Jackpot.

PICK 3 & PICK-4 BETTING

The Pick 3 & Pick 4 bets are betting transactions in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of three or four successive races specified for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 respectively.

Winning tickets for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 are determined in the following sequence: A) winners of all legs, B) most winners, then refund. If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners. If there are no winners in any leg of a pool, the entire pool is refunded.

PICK 5 BETTING

The Pick 5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of five successive races specified for the Pick 5 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 5 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 5.

PICK 6 BETTING

The Pick 6 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of six successive races specified for the Pick 6 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 6 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 6.

PICK 5 & 6 BETTING

If at least 1 race as part of the Pick 5 or 6 has been cancelled or declared "No contest", but not more than the specified below under Refunds, the net pool shall be distributed to those selecting the most # of winners and NOT include any carryover from a previous pool.

PICK 3, PICK 4, PICK 5 & PICK 6 SCRATCHES

In the event a Pick 3, Pick 4, Pick 5 or Pick 6 ticket designates as a selection a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the Stewards/Judges to be a non-starter in any of the races comprising the Pick 3, Pick 4, Pick 5 or Pick 6 the favourite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection. In the event that the money bet in the win pool for two or more favourites is identical, the selection with the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non-starting selection.

However, if a scratch occurs in any leg of the Pick 3, Pick 4, Pick 5 or Pick 6 pools before the pool is closed, a ticket including the scratched horse may be cancelled.

REFUNDS

Subject to the Regulations, all monies in all pools on a race are refunded in the event that the race is cancelled, declared off or declared no contest, and all monies bet on a horse are refunded if the horse is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start. These refunds will be communicated to the public through various means such as betting terminals, video display, changes boards and our website.

The Pick(n) pool shall be cancelled and all Pick(n) wagers for the individual performance shall be refunded if:

- Pick-3: at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

Where a horse that is part of an Entry is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start and at least one horse of that Entry receives a fair start in the race, all tickets purchased on the Entry remain valid and the purchase price of any such ticket shall not be refunded.

COMMON POOL WAGERING (INTERTRACK BETTING)

In the unlikely event of a communications or computer system failure that prevents pools from merging with the host track's pools before the end of a race, CPMA regulations require that the site must refund all tickets for that race. This refund will be communicated to the public through various means such as video displays, change boards and messages on our website.

FAIR START

If a horse has reached the Fair Start Pole (located 200 feet before the Starting Pole) by the time the mobile gate has reached the Starting Pole, that horse is deemed to have had a fair start. It makes no difference whether or not the horse is on or off stride at that precise moment. Under current policy and regulations, which are designed to be as fair as possible to all bettors on all starters, there is no Recall - a repeat of the entire starting procedure - when a horse does not reach the Fair Start Pole before the gate reaches the Starting Pole. Monies bet on such a horse are refunded in accordance with the regulation concerning refunds.

LOST & OLD TICKETS

WEG issued tickets or vouchers are valid indefinitely, however, they cannot be cashed at a mutuel teller after 2 years from date of issue. Please mail tickets, along with your name and address, to Mutuel Manager, P.O. Box 156, Rexdale, Ontario, M9W 5L2, keeping a photocopy for future reference.

For "Lost Tickets" originally sold at a Woodbine Entertainment Group racetrack or Teletheatre, please enquire at the Mutuel office at Woodbine, Greenwood Teletheatre, or Mohawk. Policy may be subject to change retroactively in the event regulatory bodies amend existing regulations.

ASSOCIATION PERCENTAGE, AND TAXATION/LEVY

Horsepeople receive a further 2% on all wagers, except Trifecta wagering where it is 4%. The Ontario Provincial Government retains 0.5% on all bets placed in Ontario. The Canadian Government (through a revolving fund cost recovery basis) retains 0.8% on all wagers placed in Canada for provision of drug control, and audit services.
