Betting Basics

Some essentials to get you started with making a wager.

1 How to wager



Place your bet by visiting a teller, or using a self-serve terminal.

To place a bet here are just 5 things you need to know:

- 1 Name of racetrack (choose from any track in the simulcast feeds)
- 2 Number of the race
- 3 Amount of your bet (e.g. \$2)
- 4 Type of bet (see step 2)
- 5 Horse's number (see step 4)

Once you have decided what you want to bet, head to the nearest seller's window and use the sample statement as your guide:

Hello, (Racetrack), race 6, \$2 to WIN on Horse #4

How to use a self-serve terminal:

- 1 Swipe your Cash Card/Insert Cash
- 2 Enter the initial PIN #1234 (then choose a new PIN)
- 3 Press/Tap the track you would like to bet: (defaults to current race)
- 4 Tap the Horse Number: **#4**
- 5 Press/Tap the Bet Type: **WIN**
- 6 Press/Tap the Bet Amount: **\$2**
- 7 Press/Tap the Race Number: **Race #6**
- 8 Press Green **"Make BET"** button
- 9 Press/Tap the **"Finish with Receipt"** button
- 10 Be sure to check your ticket to confirm it's the bet you wanted

To get a Cash Card or for assistance ask a teller, or a staff member.

2 Types of bets



Single horse bets (minimum \$2.00 bet is required)

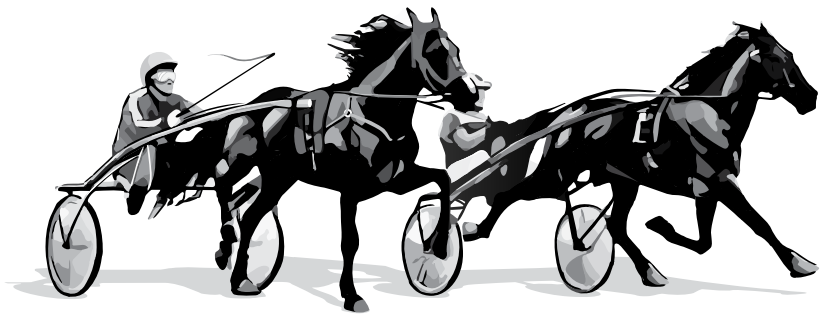
Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Win	U U U	Your horse must finish 1st; payoff determined by the win odds.
Place	U U	Your horse must finish 1st or 2nd; payoffs better than to show.
Show	U	Your horse must finish 1st, 2nd, or 3rd; modest payoffs.

Exotic multiple-horse bets

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Exacta*	U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st and 2nd in exact order; riskier bet that can pay a little or a lot, depending on the horses' odds.
Daily double	U U U U U	Pick the winners of two designated consecutive races.
Pick 3, Win 4, Pick 5, Pick 6	U U U U U U	Select the winners of a designated set of consecutive races. The wager must be made prior to the start of the first race in the multi-race wager.
Triactor*	U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in exact order; can be expensive to play if you use a lot of horses.
Superfecta*	U U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th; big payoff possible.

* Exotic bets require the horses to finish in the EXACT order you select, unless you "BOX" the bet, in which case your selections can finish in any order.

All of the numbers and letters in the program might seem confusing or overwhelming at first, but focusing on these sections makes choosing a horse simple.

- 1 Horse's number in the race
- 2 Horse's post position colour
- 3 Horse's colour, sex, age, sire (father), dam (mother), sire of the dam
- 4 Morning line odds
- 5 Horse's name
- 6 Driver and Driver Record (Name, # of wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, winning %)
- 7 Trainer information
- 8 Horse's Lifetime record (with best win time, track size, track, age, lifetime wins and lifetime earnings)
- 9 Horse's current record (# of races, # wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, and money earned)

4 The odds



Odds are also important to consider when choosing your horse. Horses that are thought to have a better chance of winning will typically have lower odds.

Morning line odds

Odds listed in the race program are the "morning line" odds. These are predictions of how the public will bet on the race. They are set by the track's handicapper when the race program is published, before the wagering starts.

The actual odds will be posted on the **Television** or in-field on the **Tote Board** before the race; they change up until post time, depending on how customers are betting on each horse in the race.

Calculating a \$2 win prize

To calculate a win prize, find the Odds of a horse on the **Television** or **Tote Board** (in-field board).

Multiply the first number by 2, then divide that number by the second digit (if there is one), and then add \$2. Simple as that!

Odds	1/2	2/1	7/2	5/1	10/1

Helpful facts for betting

- Some racetracks have a television simulcast commentator who tries to identify winning horses (handicaps) between the races. Listen and see if you can pick up any good tips to bet on.
- A good betting method is to choose horses with current odds two to three times higher than their morning line odds.

3 Tips to remember

WIN BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 32% of the time
PLACE BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 53% of the time
SHOW BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 67% of the time

Race 1 Selections

The Horseplayer's Journal by Garnet Barnsdale

#6 R PEAKY BLINDERS has yet to record a single victory this season in seven starts, but that winless record is mostly due to him having to race over his head in the top class against Open trotters for most of the year so far. There is no questioning his sharpness as he has been trotting home in 27 or 27 and small change in his last several starts. He gets the best post to work from tonight, and he does best when he is allowed to roll on the front. I fully expect him to be leading by the time they reach the backstretch, and he should lead this field on a merry chase on the class drop tonight. He gets top billing and he will likely be a popular single in this opening leg of tonight's \$75,000 guaranteed Pick 5.

#8 WAYS AND MEANS seems like the logical alternative to the choice in this spot making his second start of the season. He had a great four-year-old season, earning more than \$212,000 racing mostly in Kentucky Sires Stakes restricted to four-year-olds. He couldn't have looked much better in his qualifier on February 21st winning well on a morning when there was a two second variant assigned to the good track. He moved into the barn of Hall of Famer Paul Macdonell and he raced evenly chasing 1 to 5 shot New Rules. He gets Doug McNair in the bike tonight and he is familiar with this gelding having driven him 17 times and steering him to five wins.

#5 CHIC CHOC ROSE got the leading driver in the bike last week and he steered her to a good trip that resulted in a second place finish behind the big favorite. She retains the same pilot tonight and she draws one of the best posts so it's likely that she will get another good trip racing close to the front and stick around for a share.

#9 FLASHCHAP seems to race well every week, and she is always around the money, but she has her work cut out for her starting from the widest post facing big class dropper R Peaky Blinders. Still, she is versatile, and she should be able to float out and get positioned in mid pack early. She will offer good value here and she is worth a look for the bottom of Tri and Super bets.

#1 SAFE CONDUCT got a driver switch to Bob McClure on February 1st, a change that was necessitated due to the unfortunate injuries incurred by regular driver Chris Christoforou in an accident that occurred on January 11th. In that first start with McClure in the bike, he sat inside to the lane, and he angled off the pylons to the far outside at the eighth pole. After drifting out a couple of extra lanes, he straightened out and he found his best stride late to come on for second behind a dominant winner. He fired back with an even better mile the next week, rallying inside the drifting out leader in mid stretch to get up for the win while under minimal earning. As expected, he moved to the front early two starts back and he doubled up. Last week, he dropped back and got out of position early, and he had no chance once the opening half was cut in 58 1/5. He won from the rail two starts back and he should be much better tonight. He gets the nod to bounce back here.

#2 NEW RULES got Doug McNair in the bike last week and it was no surprise when that pilot gave him an aggressive steer that led to a win. He steps up to the top class tonight, but he has won at this level previously, and he trotted a full second faster than the winner of the Open Trot last week. He was a big 1 to 5 favorite last week. He will offer a better price tonight.

#4 HASTY BID got a flawless drive that led to a perfect trip and a narrow win as he gamely chased down 7 to 5 favorite Mr Bluebird. I'm not sure he can get that same perfect trip which is what he likely needs to double up here. I'll use him underneath.

#7 MR BLUEBIRD found his best form here on January 11th, taking his first local win. He moved up and came within a head of scoring the upset at the top level, then he got two aggressive steers in a row at this level, racing first-over in both miles. Three starts back, he assumed command in the lane, then he drifted out and watched Safe Conduct pass him on the inside. Then two starts back, he built what looked like an insurmountable lead then he drifted out and got nailed by the pocket sitter that it appeared he had already put away. Last week, he got a soft opening half and he couldn't convert. He is one that I will play against until he shows he can win at the top level.

#4 TANGO SEELSTER is an infrequent winner that tends to be trip dependent, but he improved in his most recent start, closing ground late while kicking home in 28 1/5. He draws a good post, and he seems to fit well in this \$8,000 conditioned claiming field. The tipping point for me is that he gets Natasha Day in the bike for this International Women's Day race, and she always seems to come up big in these races. I'll give this gelding top billing to kick off tonight's early Pick 4.

#6 REDLAND WRANGLER comes off a good effort at Flamboro Downs where he flashed speed then rode a pocket trip to a narrow defeat at 48 to 1. He draws best here tonight, and he picks up driver Anita Ouelette, who won this International Women's Day race here in 2013 with an 11 to 1 longshot. I think this gelding can get a good trip racing on or near the lead tonight, and he is definitely worth a look for early multi-race tickets at what should be a square price.

#3 YYC ON THE HORIZON gets to take a substantial class drop here after facing Always B Sweetest, one of the hottest horses at this track last week. The difference in calibre between \$16,000 claiming handicap horses and \$8,000 conditioned claimers is wide, and this gelding also gets post relief to boot. Tonight's driver Britt Kennedy will likely have this gelding on the move early, and it's hard to leave this one out when constructing early Pick 5 and Pick 4 tickets.

#1 CAPTAIN HIGHLINER flew home in 27 4/5 to win in his Mohawk Park debut three starts back, and he followed that win up with another couple of good efforts where he closed for third in each mile. He draws inside here and he will likely land in mid pack early, from where he can rally from, and Pam Forgie should be able to steer him into the Tri or Super tonight.

#3 WILLYS HOME RUN was excellent at two and three making a ton of money racing mainly in the provincial stakes program earning close to \$1 million in those two seasons, but she also raced well more than once against Grand Circuit company. She found the sledding tougher as a four-year-old as often happens, but she did end her season on a positive note, taking her second win of the year. She comes into her five-year-old year having qualified twice and she was asked for nothing until the stretch in both of those miles. That she fired identical 27 2/5 kickers in those qualifiers shows that she is sharp, and she gets top billing in this opening leg of tonight's 20-cent Pick 6 wager.

#2 COVER BAND was a good winner here three starts back, the second time in three starts that Hehe won with the leading driver calling the shots. After breaking in his next race on February 8th, he was driven conservatively last time. He got around without breaking stride, closed a little ground and trotted a 28 2/5 kicker, all positives. He gets James MacDonald back tonight and he draws okay, and he figures to be a threat in this spot. He is the other one that I would consider using on early multi-race tickets.

#10 WILDTURKEY HANOVER raced decently two starts back to get fourth, but that didn't matter to bettors last week, as he was sent off as a 36 to 1 longshot. After getting a good start from a wide post, he sat in racing fourth to the last turn where he took out and followed cover. He shifted to the middle of the track at the head of the lane than he closed relentlessly to get up for the upset score. He is back in the same class, but it's likely that he will get ignored at the windows again starting from the widest post. He is worth a look for the bottom of Tri and Super bets in this spot.

#6 KEVIN ANTHONY was probably just in too tough last time when he backed up in the lane. A better indication of what he can do came in his previous two miles where he held clear leads in the stretch both times. He seems to do his best work with Todd Ratchford driving and he returns to the bike tonight. He is another one that is worth a look for use on the bottom at a price.

#1 THE WRITER jumped into this series in Leg 2 last week, and he couldn't have been more impressive in victory that night. After dropping back to last early, he trailed to the last turn, he moved to the outside and sat fourth-over to the top of the stretch. He swung widest coming off the last turn and he lost a lot of ground, but that didn't matter as he sailed past the leaders by mid stretch and coasted to an easy win. It's notable that Bob McClure chose this gelding over Cheddar Bay, who also won a division of Leg 2 and drew best here. This gelding gets top billing here in the cash leg of the early Pick 5.

#10 BEACH TOUR was bet down to even money last week in Leg 2 of this Pop Up series coming off an impressive first-over score in Leg 1 the week before. Not much went right for this gelding last week in what turned out to be the race that featured the most action of any miles raced this year at Mohawk Park. After getting a bit of a slow start, he drove on between horses to take command, but he was passed on the first turn. After getting shuffled to third, he made another move to the front to avoid getting massively shuffled with a rival coming in the two path. Once he made front for a second time, he immediately came under assault heading into the final turn. It wasn't surprising to see him shrivel up in the lane after getting no breathers. He has his work cut out here starting from the widest posts, but he is clearly one of the best horses in here, and the odds should justify the risk in this case. He's worth a look for early multi-race tickets.

#6 CHEDDAR BAY, like The Writer, made a wide move on the final turn last week, and he prevailed, but he was the beneficiary of several rivals battling each other into submission. He draws best and he will likely work out a good trip tonight, and he is another one that is in with a chance in a competitive dash.

#4 STONE CARVER is the third winner from last week, and he rallied late to get the job done, but I think that was the weakest of the three divisions. He will get plenty of attention at the windows getting the leading driver here coming off a win, but I'm willing to take a stand against him when constructing multi-race tickets.

#1 WHITE TIGER raced better last week on the class drop, now he gets to take another dip in class. He was thriving racing at this level in January and February, taking two straight closing wins with tonight's driver J R Plante in the bike. This class drop should be just what he needs to get back on track and her get the nod in this opening leg of tonight's late Pick 5.

#4 MY BUDDY SAM hadn't really had a chance to show what he could do prior to last week's mile simply because he had been in too tough. Three starts back, he did okay to finish fifth behind Devils Arch who came out of that race and stepped up and won at the top level. Then, this gelding drew post 10 and closed mildly after dropping right to the back at the start. He got both class and post relief last week, so it was no surprise to see him used hard early to try going right down the road. He couldn't see it through, and he did lose a shoe during that race. That was a decent effort, and he could do in here with a more conservative trip.

#7 ALL GAS NO BRAKES got a covered trip two starts back, and that's when he typically thrives. He looked like a winner until just before the wire when Jokic got clearance along the pylons and surged to take the victory away from him. He stepped up in class last week and he drew best. Using that post position advantage, he left hard and worked out a good trip and the race became a three across battle in the lane after the top three broke away from the field. He passed My Buddy Sam, but he couldn't fend off the favorite who drafted behind him all the way then pounced late. He should be able to work out another good trip here, and he should be a legitimate threat.

#3 BELLA CAVALLA dropped to this level last week and she closed mildly to finish fourth while finishing behind both My Buddy Sam All Gas No Brakes. She should get good position here starting from one of the best posts, and she can close to take another share.

#1 TELLIT RUSS TELLIT raced well when facing better in two straight starts leading up to last week's mile, so it was no surprise to see him get bet down to 2 to 5 when facing \$8,000 claimers in that mile a week ago. He sat a nice trip to the last turn then he pounced. He passed the leader at the eighth pole, then he drove away to a dominant score. Tonight's field looks no tougher than the one he crushed last week, and he gets the call to repeat. He will probably be a popular single in tonight's late Pick 4.

#4 IMA RUM RUNNER was good in his qualifier on February 21st. With J R Plante at the controls, this four-year-old Alberta bred gelding was allowed to camp out near the back of the field until the final turn where he was edged off the pylons to commence an overland rally from far back. Once he straightened out for home, he closed with good energy pacing a 28-flat kicker over a track that was assigned a two second variant. He was moving well when the wire hit and it was thought he would be a threat last week, but he never really got untracked. He can be better in this second start back, and he may offer some Exacta value in this spot.

#5 MIDNIGHT MOOD got the leading driver in the bike last week, and he got a great drive and a perfect trip, but he could do no better than finish three-and-a-half lengths behind Tellit Russ Tellit. Starting from one of the best posts, he will likely get another good trip racing near the front, but I don't see him turning the tables on the top pick tonight. He will likely be part of the Tri again.

#3 SEAFARER looked great winning in fast time here two starts back racing in an \$8,000 conditioned claimer, then not so great when he stepped up and faced much tougher, showing how big that class gap is. Dropping down gives him a better chance tonight, but I prefer to use him underneath.

#5 CALL ME IT is intriguing as the longest shot in the morning line here, because he gets needed class relief in this spot and draws one of the best posts and he is expected to improve sharply tonight. Four and five starts back, when racing at tonight's bottom conditioned level, he raced well in two straight starts that were won by Toronto, who was taking a class edge. He has shown good late speed in both of his last two starts, and I'll take a price swing on him here in a field that lacks a standout.

#6 SOUTHWIND SAMBUCCA hasn't hit the board in any of his eight starts so far this season, but that record of futility should be improved upon tonight, providing he stays flat after breaking stride in his last start. He raced decently at this level three starts back when finishing fourth, then he moved up one level and fired a 26 2/5 kicker while finishing a non-threatening eighth. He gets class and post relief tonight, and he picks up Louis-Phillipe Roy to drive, all positives. Roy has driven the gelding several times and he drove him to a win here in the spring of 2024 in a much tougher class than tonight's.

#3 CRAZY WORLD raced okay here two starts back when facing a much tougher field, closing to take the smallest cheque. After an unsuccessful trip to Flamboro Downs, he gets to drop to the bottom conditioned level tonight where he figures to improve. Getting the leading driver in the bike won't hurt, and he is another possibility in what looks like a wide-open race.

#2 TITANIC HANOVER crushed a field of \$8,000 claimers two starts back then he faced much tougher in a Pop Up Series race racing off the Waxman claim and he couldn't see it through on the lead that time. He is in what appears to be an easier spot tonight, and he should last longer if he attempts another wire job, but I still prefer to use him underneath in this spot.

She draws inside last week, and she was somehow let go at 16 to 1 coming in off that strong effort the previous week. Driver J R Plante showed more confidence in her than the punters did, as he made two moves with her and drove away from the field for the upset. It makes no sense to me that she is not the morning line favorite in here and this sharp mare gets the call to repeat.

#5 FIRST FILLY CHIP disappointed as the 4 to 5 favorite two starts back coming off a narrow loss the previous week, and her price predictably climbed last week. Last week, she tried to follow Pretty Missy May on the final turn, but she gapped out which allowed a rival to squeeze out in front of her, making her rally wide probably earlier than she wanted to. She eventually found her best stride in deep stretch and got up for second. She can be an Exacta factor again tonight.

#8 JOB HUNTER was predictably bet down to 4 to 5 last week here getting a needed class drop, and she made a move to the front in the second quarter looking like she had control of the race. She was confronted by Pretty Missy May on the final turn, and she had no answer for that rival's attack. She raced at Flamboro Downs on Thursday night and she failed to get a cheque as the even money favorite. She is hard to endorse on top here as the morning line favorite, but she could get a slice.

#1 STAY PUMPED got a great drive and trip to get the job done two starts back to score a massive 57 to 1 upset. She followed along to the last turn where she edged off the cones, and Tyler Borth angled her to the widest path in mid stretch then urged her to the line to get up. She wasn't as lucky last week, but I could see her getting a good following trip tonight and landing in the bottom of the Tri or Super.

#8 THAI TOUR hadn't shown much in his previous four starts over London with his trainer driving, before he showed up here to contest Leg 2 of this Pop Up series last week. He got the attention of bettors because he attracted Doug McNair who drove him to a second-place finish in the Grassroots Consolation here in September of 2024 after the gelding broke at the start and dropped back to last. As expected last week, he was given an aggressive steer, and he was both game and unlucky in defeat as he did much more actual work than the rival that followed him around the turn then edged past him late. McNair sticks here tonight, and this gelding gets top billing in the cash leg of the late multi-race tickets.

#3 SAULSBROOK IAN came into last week's mile showing identical 27-flat kickers in his previous two starts raced in good conditioned fields. He drew best and faced easier, so it was no surprise to see pilot Daryl Thiessen race this gelding aggressively, making two moves to the front. He squandered a clear lead in the lane and perhaps that trip was a bit too tough. I could see him getting a more conservative drive and an easier trip tonight, and that makes him a threat in this Pop Up Consolation.

#5 LAMANDIER N was well meant last week, and he was used hard early in a race that featured action from start to finish and was dominated by closers. He draws well here and it's hard to imagine that kind of action will be repeated in this mile. He could get a good trip racing close to the front, and that makes him another possibility for late multi-race tickets.

#7 DELIGHTFUL LEADER raced decently in both preliminary legs of this series, and he was aggressively driven in both miles. He draws okay here and he seems to fit well, and he is yet another one in here that looks like he has a shot in a race with a few possibilities.

#4 DALHOUSIE has been closing well recently to take some smaller shares and that trend will likely continue tonight. He should be a good one to use underneath in this spot.

CONDITIONS AND ALLOWANCES IN HARNESS RACING - IMPORTANT TO KNOW

The conditions of a race determine whether a horse is eligible to enter. For example many races are restricted to horses that have won a certain number of races or a certain amount of money in a specified number of starts. Many races are restricted to horses entered to be "claimed" (offered for sale) at a specific price.

Allowances in the claiming price itself are given to colts and geldings, four-year-olds and younger and to mares, five-year-olds and younger.

The purpose of the allowance is to keep younger horses more competitive when racing against older and more experienced rivals. Mares are given extra consideration in claiming events because of their potential as broodmares.

The accompanying chart shows what the allowances are, but an example may make them easier to understand. The chart indicates that three-year-olds receive a 50% allowance in claiming races. This means that a three-year-old entered in a \$20,000 claiming race carries an actual claiming price of \$30,000 (50% higher).

Fillies and mares receive an additional 25% allowance in claiming races. Details of the race conditions and claiming price (if any) are given at the top of each race in the program.

ALLOWANCES FOR PURSE EARNINGS

C.P.M.A. Regulation Changes

Effective January 1st 2012
CPMA will be instituting several new rule changes with regards to the following pari-mutuel pools:

Pick Pools

- If there are no winners in any leg of a Pick N pool, the entire pool is refunded.
- If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners.
- A pool is no longer refunded if the 1st leg in the pool is cancelled or declared no contest.
- Pick-3: If at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: If at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.

EXPLANATION OF THE LASIX PROGRAM

After careful study and consultation with Ontario Horsemen's groups, racetrack operators and veterinarians, Agriculture Canada and the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario passed legislation allowing the controlled (or supervised) administration of furosemide, more commonly called "Lasix". "Lasix" is used to alleviate the symptoms of exercise induced pulmonary hemorrhaging in racing horses. Horses will undergo an endoscopic examination of the trachea by a veterinarian licensed by the Ontario Racing Commission and endorsed by an official veterinarian before being allowed on the medication list. Once qualified, horses will be treated with "Lasix" within four hours plus or minus 15 minutes of a scheduled race in a secure retention area under the super vision of racing officials.

All horses on "Lasix" must remain on the program for a minimum of 100 days while racing in this jurisdiction.

- (L)** Denotes horses treated with Lasix for their last start but not so treated today.

RULES AND INFORMATION REGARDING CANADIAN HARNESS AND FOREIGN SEPARATE POOL EVENTS

GENERAL

All pari-mutuel pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with the regulations and directives as issued by Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada ("the Regulations"), under the approval and supervision of the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency. The Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency can be contacted at 1-800-268-8835 or 613-759-6100 or Email: cpmawebacpm@agr.gc.ca. A complete version of the CPMA regulations can be found at <http://laws-lois.justice.gc.ca/eng/regulations/SOR-91-385/>.

All tickets should be held until the result of the race is declared official and prices are posted.

No person under the age of 18 shall purchase or cash a ticket or voucher.

A claim of receiving an incorrect payment or incorrect change must be made to the Mutuel office of the association within twenty four hours of buying or cashing a valid ticket or voucher.

No ruling made by the Stewards/Judges or the Ontario Racing Commission with regard to distribution of purse money or the placing of horses in the order of finish, after the race has been declared official, shall have any bearing on the pay-out prices or distribution of pari-mutuel pools.

Change boards and Photo Finish display monitors are located in the Grandstand. In addition, Photo Finish pictures are shown on the closed-circuit television system. Customers are reminded that mutuel clerks are responsible for all shortages. When making a wager, customers must present sufficient funds at the time of purchase to cover the wagers requested.

ENTRIES AND MUTUEL FIELDS

"Entry" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled or considered as the same betting interest. The most common reason for the coupling of horses in an Entry is the fact that they are owned by the same person.

"Mutuel Field" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled because the number of horses in the race exceeds the number which can be handled separately by the pari-mutuel system. Subject to the Regulations, a bet on one horse of an Entry or Mutuel Field shall be considered a bet on all horses in that Entry or Mutuel Field.

DAILY DOUBLE BETTING (INCLUDING LATE DOUBLE)

A Daily Double bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of the two races specified for the Daily Double. Tickets not selecting the winner of the first half of the Daily Double and all tickets in the second half of the Daily Double not coupled with the declared official winner of the first half of the Daily Double are not winners and are not refunded no matter what circumstances affect the running of the second half of the Daily Double.

Should a horse or horses (not coupled with another starter) be excused from starting in the second race of the Daily Double after the first race of the Daily Double has closed for betting, holders of all Daily Double tickets on such horses, coupled with the winner of the first Daily Double race, shall participate in a Consolation Double pool. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

EXACTA (Also known as Exactor)/TRIFECTA (Also known as Tractor)/SUPERFECTA

An Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first two, three and four horses respectively, representing different betting interests to finish in the exact official order of finish, in the race on which the pool is operated.

SWINGER (Also known as OMN)

A Swinger is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select horses to finish in any order from the official first 3 positions.

JACKPOT HI-5

A Jackpot Hi-5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners in the specified Jackpot Hi-5 race. If there are races that have an entry, (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B), Jackpot Hi-5 will not offer a wager consisting of both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in a Jackpot Hi-5, the payout would be 1st, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th.

That jackpot portion of the pool will only be paid out if there is a single winning ticket. If there are multiple winning tickets that have correctly chosen the first 5 runners of the race, they will receive 50% of the pool for that day. The other 50% will go over into the Jackpot carryover. If there are no winning tickets with the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners, 100% of the current day's pool will be carried over into the Jackpot.

PICK 3 & PICK-4 BETTING

The Pick 3 & Pick 4 bets are betting transactions in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of three or four successive races specified for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 respectively.

Winning tickets for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 are determined in the following sequence: A) winners of all legs, B) most winners, then refund. If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners. If there are no winners in any leg of a pool, the entire pool is refunded.

PICK 5 BETTING

The Pick 5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of five successive races specified for the Pick 5 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 5 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 5.

PICK 6 BETTING

The Pick 6 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of six successive races specified for the Pick 6 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 6 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 6.

PICK 5 & 6 BETTING

If at least 1 race as part of the Pick 5 or 6 has been cancelled or declared "No contest", but not more than the specified below under Refunds, the net pool shall be distributed to those selecting the most # of winners and NOT include any carryover from a previous pool.

PICK 3, PICK 4, PICK 5 & PICK 6 SCRATCHES

In the event a Pick 3, Pick 4, Pick 5 or Pick 6 ticket designates as a selection a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the Stewards/Judges to be a non-starter in any of the races comprising the Pick 3, Pick 4, Pick 5 or Pick 6 the favourite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection. In the event that the money bet in the win pool for two or more favourites is identical, the selection with the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non-starting selection.

However, if a scratch occurs in any leg of the Pick 3, Pick 4, Pick 5 or Pick 6 pools before the pool is closed, a ticket including the scratched horse may be cancelled.

REFUNDS

Subject to the Regulations, all monies in all pools on a race are refunded in the event that the race is cancelled, declared off or declared no contest, and all monies bet on a horse are refunded if the horse is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start. These refunds will be communicated to the public through various means such as betting terminals, video display, changes boards and our website.

The Pick(n) pool shall be cancelled and all Pick(n) wagers for the individual performance shall be refunded if:

- Pick-3: at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

Where a horse that is part of an Entry is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start and at least one horse of that Entry receives a fair start in the race, all tickets purchased on the Entry remain valid and the purchase price of any such ticket shall not be refunded.

COMMON POOL WAGERING (INTERTRACK BETTING)

In the unlikely event of a communications or computer system failure that prevents pools from merging with the host track's pools before the end of a race, CPMA regulations require that the site must refund all tickets for that race. This refund will be communicated to the public through various means such as video displays, change boards and messages on our website.

FAIR START

If a horse has reached the Fair Start Pole (located 200 feet before the Starting Pole) by the time the mobile gate has reached the Starting Pole, that horse is deemed to have had a fair start. It makes no difference whether or not the horse is on or off stride at that precise moment. Under current policy and regulations, which are designed to be as fair as possible to all bettors on all starters, there is no Recall - a repeat of the entire starting procedure - when a horse does not reach the Fair Start Pole before the gate reaches the Starting Pole. Monies bet on such a horse are refunded in accordance with the regulation concerning refunds.

LOST & OLD TICKETS

WEG issued tickets or vouchers are valid indefinitely, however, they cannot be cashed at a mutuel teller after 2 years from date of issue. Please mail tickets, along with your name and address, to Mutuel Manager, P.O. Box 156, Rexdale, Ontario, M9W 5L2, keeping a photocopy for future reference.

For "Lost Tickets" originally sold at a Woodbine Entertainment Group racetrack or Teletheatre, please enquire at the Mutuel office at Woodbine, Greenwood Teletheatre, or Mohawk. Policy may be subject to change retroactively in the event regulatory bodies amend existing regulations.

ASSOCIATION PERCENTAGE, AND TAXATION/LEVY

The Woodbine Entertainment Group deducts and retains the following percentages from wagers placed at our own licensed sites which are then shared with the horsepeople, host and simulcast associations and the Ontario Racing Commission.

WOODBINE/MOHAWK LIVE: Win, Place & Show: 13.65%. Swinger 14.7%. Trifecta & Pick 4: 21.7%. Double & Exacta 17.2%. Jackpot Hi-5, Pick 5 & Pick 6: 11.7%. All other 23.0%

Horsepeople receive a further 2% on all wagers, except Trifecta wagering where it is 4%. The Ontario Provincial Government retains 0.5% on all bets placed in Ontario. The Canadian Government (through a revolving fund cost recovery basis) retains 0.8% on all wagers placed in Canada for provision of drug control, and audit services.
