# Betting Basics

Some essentials to get you started with making a wager.

## 1 How to wager



Place your bet by visiting a teller, or using a self-serve terminal.

### To place a bet here are just 5 things you need to know:

- 1 Name of racetrack (choose from any track in the simulcast feeds)
- 2 Number of the race
- 3 Amount of your bet (e.g. \$2)
- 4 Type of bet (see step 2)
- 5 Horse's number (see step 4)

Once you have decided what you want to bet, head to the nearest seller's window and use the sample statement as your guide:

**Hello, (Racetrack), race 6, \$2 to WIN on Horse #4**

### How to use a self-serve terminal:

- 1 Swipe your Cash Card/Insert Cash
- 2 Enter the initial PIN #1234 (then choose a new PIN)
- 3 Press/Tap the track you would like to bet: (defaults to current race)
- 4 Tap the Horse Number: **#4**
- 5 Press/Tap the Bet Type: **WIN**
- 6 Press/Tap the Bet Amount: **\$2**
- 7 Press/Tap the Race Number: **Race #6**
- 8 Press Green **"Make BET"** button
- 9 Press/Tap the **"Finish with Receipt"** button
- 10 Be sure to check your ticket to confirm it's the bet you wanted

To get a Cash Card or for assistance ask a teller, or a staff member.

## 2 Types of bets



### Single horse bets (minimum \$2.00 bet is required)

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Win	U U U	Your horse must finish 1st; payoff determined by the win odds.
Place	U U	Your horse must finish 1st or 2nd; payoffs better than to show.
Show	U	Your horse must finish 1st, 2nd, or 3rd; modest payoffs.

### Exotic multiple-horse bets

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Exacta*	U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st and 2nd in exact order; riskier bet that can pay a little or a lot, depending on the horses' odds.
Daily double	U U U U U	Pick the winners of two designated consecutive races.
Pick 3, Win 4, Pick 5, Pick 6	U U U U U U	Select the winners of a designated set of consecutive races. The wager must be made prior to the start of the first race in the multi-race wager.
Triactor*	U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in exact order; can be expensive to play if you use a lot of horses.
Superfecta*	U U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th; big payoff possible.

\* Exotic bets require the horses to finish in the EXACT order you select, unless you "BOX" the bet, in which case your selections can finish in any order.

All of the numbers and letters in the program might seem confusing or overwhelming at first, but focusing on these sections makes choosing a horse simple.

- 1 Horse's number in the race
- 2 Horse's post position colour
- 3 Horse's colour, sex, age, sire (father), dam (mother), sire of the dam
- 4 Morning line odds
- 5 Horse's name
- 6 Driver and Driver Record (Name, # of wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, winning %)
- 7 Trainer information
- 8 Horse's Lifetime record (with best win time, track size, track, age, lifetime wins and lifetime earnings)
- 9 Horse's current record (# of races, # wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, and money earned)

# 4 The odds

Odds are also important to consider when choosing your horse. Horses that are thought to have a better chance of winning will typically have lower odds.

### Morning line odds

Odds listed in the race program are the "morning line" odds. These are predictions of how the public will bet on the race. They are set by the track's handicapper when the race program is published, before the wagering starts.

The actual odds will be posted on the **Television** or in-field on the **Tote Board** before the race; they change up until post time, depending on how customers are betting on each horse in the race.

### Calculating a \$2 win prize

To calculate a win prize, find the Odds of a horse on the **Television** or **Tote Board** (in-field board).

Multiply the first number by 2, then divide that number by the second digit (if there is one), and then add \$2. Simple as that!

Odds	1/2	2/1	7/2	5/1	10/1
Pays	\$3.00	\$6.00	\$9.00	\$12.00	\$22.00

### Helpful facts for betting

- Some racetracks have a television simulcast commentator who tries to identify winning horses (handicaps) between the races. Listen and see if you can pick up any good tips to bet on.
- A good betting method is to choose horses with current odds two to three times higher than their morning line odds.

### 3 Tips to remember

**WIN BETS** on the FAVOURITE pay 32% of the time  
**PLACE BETS** on the FAVOURITE pay 53% of the time  
**SHOW BETS** on the FAVOURITE pay 67% of the time

**Race 1 Selections**

**The Horseplayer's Journal by Garnet Barnsdale**

**#1 CHEDDAR BAY** exits one concluded Pop Up Series and enters the first leg of another tonight, and he raced well in all three legs of the one that just finished. He was a closing winner two starts back in a race where he was the beneficiary of some mid race battling, but he came right back and raced well again in the final, showing that win on March 1st was no fluke. In the Final last week, he was rallying best in the lane from far back, but the eventual winner had already vaulted off second-over cover and got a big jump on the closers, and he wasn't going to be caught. I don't mind the rail draw here for this veteran 10-year-old gelding. He should be able to get away closer to the front than he did last week. He couldn't be any sharper, and he gets top billing as we kick off tonight's \$75,000 guaranteed Pick 5.

**#6 JACK BOSWALL** is intriguing here because leading driver James Macdonald chose him over three others despite this gelding having not raced in three weeks. In that last mile, he sat an inside trip to the lane and paced willingly to the wire in tight down along the inside and he finished less than a length behind Cheddar Bay at the wire. It seems likely that Macdonald will put this gelding into play leaving the gate from the best post and this one could add some value to the early Pick 5.

**#8 LAMANDIER A** produced on of his best race since arriving from Australia when he finished second in a Pop Up Series Final last week. After leaving hard enough to land in the favorite's pocket early, he made a move to the front in the second quarter, but that move provided a perfect trip for his rival. He was unable to stay with that one in the lane, but he was a clear second at the wire. He should be in the exotics mix again tonight despite drawing a wide post here.

### The Horseplayer's Journal by Garnet Barnsdale

**#8 CAPTAIN HIGHLINER** flew home in 27 4/5 to win in his Mohawk Park debut four starts back, and he followed that win up with another couple of good efforts where he closed for third in each mile. He draws inside for the women drivers race celebrating International Women's Day last time, and he may have been good enough to win there, but he took a shuffle at a critical part of that mile on the last turn, then he closed ground in the lane but he lacked room in deep stretch racing along the inside. He lands in a spot here where the late pace could be faltering, and he gets the nod to pick up the pieces.

**#6 TITANIC HANOVER** was a good winner here three starts back when he was claimed by Team Waxman, then he was just in too tough in his next two starts. His last line is a bit ugly with him getting beat by more than 22 lengths, but he was in a mile where they paced down to the three quarters in sub-1:24 time, and the pace in this race should be slower and more to his liking. He gets the best post now in a spot where he figures to improve sharply, but he needs to find more late in the mile too.

**#7 PARTYINTHESHADOWS** hasn't taken a single win in 2025-26 going 0 for 18, but he has been competitive in any of them having taken six shares. Key for him tonight could be him facing easier and taking on a claiming tag for the first time since January 2024. He is the third one that I would consider using in the late Pick 5.

**#2 EARLY PLAY** raced okay here two starts back when he was beaten only two lengths in a decent conditioned claiming field. Then last time, he drew post 10 in the women drivers race while being steered by a driver making her first pari-mutuel start. Neither horse or driver was disgraced, and he did show a little bit of pop on the end of his mile. He can get a good trip tonight racing closer to the lead and take a slice.

**#1 JOHNNY BUCKSHOT** was beaten only two lengths last time he raced here four starts back and he was facing better that night than he meets tonight in this opening leg of a Pop Up Series. He made three starts in London which qualify him for this race based on purse, and he was terrific winning his last two starts, most recently flying home racing wide to win in the top class trotting away from the field at the wire. Last time he shipped in from the B tracks, he was a four length winner here in November in the opening leg of a Pop Up series. There is a good chance that history will repeat here, and he gets top billing in this opening leg of tonight's early Pick 4.

**#4 BLESS ME FATHER** dropped in class for his second local start on February 20th, and he raced better, and he got a better result. Racing amid a snow flurry, he rallied from third-over and found his best stride in mid stretch, then he passed several rivals to win the race for fourth as the top three finishers weren't getting caught. He got to take another class drop last week, and he was patiently driven and he powered home in 27 3/5 to reward his backers that made him the 3 to 5 favorite. He has reached peak form now, and he will likely be the one to fend off in the lane tonight.

**#5 WILLOWTIME** is another one shipping in from the B tracks in top form having won two in a row, most recently doing it the hard way racing first-over on a good track that was assigned a two second variant. He is no stranger to Mohawk Park, and he figures to be a threat tonight starting from one of the best posts. He is another possibility for early multi-race tickets.

**#2 SHESAMANALISHI** almost got the job done at 20 to 1 two starts back in a strong effort, then she drew post 10 and she was let go as a 20 to 1 shot again in her last start. She was provided with a great steer from Louis-Phillipe Roy, and she got up late for the upset score. She is sharp, but this looks like a tougher spot. She is honest, and she can take a share here probably racing from close range.

**#5 MONEYBAGS** got Doug McNair in the bike last week for his second start of the season, and he showed improvement in that mile. In the end, he was no match for the top three finishers, but he was a clear fourth at the wire in a decent effort. He now gets to drop from a \$20,000 conditioned claimer to a \$7,500 claimer which is more suitable as he last won racing for a \$5,000 tag in Alberta last November. There are several in here with questionable current form while this gelding appears to be improving. I'll give him the nod as we kick off tonight's 20-cent Pick 6 wager.

**#1 BETTOR THAN PRIDE** is another one that seems to be improving, coming off a closing effort when facing much tougher in a claiming handicap than he faces in this Pop Up Series tonight. He showed last season that he knows where the wire is by taking seven wins from 22 starts and he missed some time due to lameness. But last week's improved mile shows that he is moving in the right direction now, and he is in with a decent chance here. He is one of a few that could be used on early multi-race tickets in a race that lacks a standout.

**#7 BETTOR B HOME SOON** hasn't been racing great in \$20,000 conditioned claimers recently, but getting in to face \$7,500 claimers now gives him a chance to improve sharply. He gets Bob McClure in the bike tonight and he has recorded the highest win percentage (23.4%) of any of Mohawk Park's regular drivers so far this season. This gelding is worth a look at what should be a square price tonight.

**#4 BRYANT SEELSTER** raced at Flamboro Downs Thursday night and he did well to get third. He gets a good draw, and he holds a recency advantage in this spot. He also had a good closing effort here a week ago, and he is another one that is in with a shot in what appears to be a wide-open race.

**#9 SOUTHWIND SAMBUCCA** dropped and it was expected that he would pop last week, failing to get the job done as the overwhelming 1 to 2 favorite. That may have been simply a case of him facing a rival that was prepared to fire his best shot making his first pari-mutuel start for a new barn after being sold. That was a fast race, and this gelding looks best in here. He should be able to make amends here despite starting from a wide post, and he is one that I would strongly consider as a single in this spot.

**#2 CRAZY WORLD** comes out of the same race as Southwind Sambucca, and he was the first one to move on the final turn of that race. He found his best stride late as the pace slowed in deep stretch, and he came within a half length of catching Southwind Sambucca for second. He draws well here and he keeps the leading driver in the bike for a second consecutive drive. He seems like the logical alternative to the choice here, but I'm not sure he can keep close enough tabs on that one to chase him down late.

**#4 HOLLYWOOD DEO** is one of two Cassidy Scheider trainees in this field, and this gelding comes off an improved effort in London, passing several rivals in the back half to finish a close fourth. He has taken only two wins in 2025-26, but he has second or third 11 times. I could see him passing some of these late in the mile, and he could be a good one to use underneath here.

**#5 GYPSY JOE** has been a regular competitor in Pop Up series here this winter with mixed results finishing between third and sixth in all of those starts since February 1st. He draws well here and he will likely get sent forward by Tyler Borth leaving the gate. He should get positioned close to the front early, and I could see him sticking around for a slice here.

**#7 BETTORHOLDONTIGHT** came into last week's race coming off a start in London the week before where he broke stride early then made up some ground late. He has periodic gait issues, but he has always seemed better suited to the bigger track, and he showed that last week when he took some support then went straight to the front and led the field on a merry chase. He fits well in this Pop Up series field, and he should be able to find the pocket leaving the gate following expected pacesetter Aragonite and work out a great trip. He gets the call to repeat here in this opening leg of tonight's late Pick 5.

**#9 ARAGONITE** last won here facing conditioned claimers on February 9th, and on that occasion, he finished well ahead of Betterholdontight. His strategy is no secret; he will look to blast straight to the front and lead these every step, and if he can open up on the final turn, he might be able to ride that advantage to the wire. Speed is always dangerous on this track, and this gelding is definitely worth a look for this late Pick 5.

**#1 RAYS KREDIT** raced much better last time when he appeared on the scene in deep stretch to get second in the women's race last Sunday. That good performance came on the heels of a start where he broke stride, so it was encouraging to see him staying flat last week. I have a feeling though, that he may end up too far back and have too much to do late after starting from the rail, and he is one that I will look to beat out of the late Pick 5 as a 7 to 2 choice on the morning line.

**#2 DAN SPEED** shipped in from Flamboro Downs for the women's driver race, and he produced a good closing effort to finish on the edges. Prior to that mile, he was regularly finishing in the money. He has taken only two wins from 36 starts in 2025-26 but in those miles, he was second or third 13 times. He will probably be a good one to use on the bottom of Tri and Super bets.

**#2 CRYSTAL BALLER** raced well at this level twice straight in February showing early speed in both miles, then he stepped up in class on March 1st, and he lost all chance when he broke before the start. Looking to get a clean line down last week, he was raced conservatively, and he had little chance when he was racing seventh at the half that was trotted in a pedestrian 59 2/5. He closed mildly, but he more importantly stayed flat throughout the mile. He draws decently here and I would expect him to get sent forward leaving the gate this time. He gets top billing to kick off tonight's late Pick 4.

**#6 PESO HANOVER** steps up tonight, but I'm not sure this field is all that much tougher than last week's. He was right there on the wire last week, now he adds Lasix and he draws the best post. If he can repeat his winning effort from two starts back, although it should be noted that he was "sent for post race observation" as noted in the Judges Report. It would likely be prudent to observe him in the post parade before making a run to the window to put your money down.

**#5 KEVIN ANTHONY** get needed class relief, and he draws well again tonight. Last time he raced in this non-winners of \$6,000 last four class, he raced great, making an aggressive first-over move and opening up a lead before getting nailed right on the wire. He figures to be aggressive tonight, too, and he is another one that deserves a close look for late multi-race tickets.

**#7 BELLA CAVALLA** raced better in this class last week when she was sent off as a 33 to 1 longshot. She is winless so far this season, but I could see her taking another share here. I don't mind the widest draw in here for her as she should be able to float out and get positioned near the front at the start.

**#4 HES SWIFT** raced first-over here two starts back, and although that isn't his best trip, he hung in there for fourth, beaten by fewer than two lengths. That was a better mile than his previous one where he got hung out forever as the 6 to 5 favorite. He got a driver switch to Phil Hudon last week, and starting from the best post, he was sent straight to the front and he took no prisoners, setting strong fractions and rebuffing 2 to 5 favorite Tellit Russ Tellit in the lane. He was straight as an arrow down the stretch which is probably a good sign considering he had some drifting issues in some of his previous starts. Coming off that strong winning effort, I'll give him the nod to repeat in this opening leg of a Pop Up series.

**#5 TELLIT RUSS TELLIT** raced well when facing better in two straight starts leading up to his race on March 1st, so it was no surprise to see him get bet down to 2 to 5 when facing \$8,000 claimers in his next start. He sat a nice trip to the last turn then he pounced. He passed the leader at the eighth pole, then he drove away to a dominant score. Last week, he was again bet down to 2 to 5, and he was patiently driven to the half where he embarked on a first-over journey. He had dead aim on Hes Swift but he couldn't get past him now he faces him again. He still a viable contender in a dash that shapes up to be a two-horse race.

**#2 FISCAL POLICY** has a win and a second in his recent miles and both of those results came with tonight's pilot James Macdonald at the controls. Most recently two weeks ago, he sat a perfect trip, and he got up in the very last stride to dead heat for the win. He can sit another good trip here, but I prefer to use him underneath in this spot.

**#6 SIR LUCKNOW** races off the claim and draws best coming off an okay mile in London where he got third. While I don't see him threatening either of the top two in this spot, but he could float out and get positioned in the top four early and ride an inside following trip to a small share.

**#3 MYFRIENDJOSE** showed in his qualifier on February 13th that he was ready for action when he stormed home late, flying in the last sixteenth of a mile to get up for the win. He fired in his seasonal debut, and won pretty much the same way, staying covered up to mid stretch then pouncing. In his next start, he hooked wheels when on the move and that took him out of the race. Last week, he got a driver change to Doug McNair, and that new pilot blasted off with him from a wide post and said: see ya later. He steps up one level, but he is sharp, and he gets the call to repeat here.

**#4 KADIDDLE** hadn't raced in a month when she showed up on February 16th, but she was strangely hammered down to second choice at 7 to 5. She stayed inside to the lane, riding a helmet, and she looked like she was about to set up a late rally when she ducked inside, but she seemed to swerve and she jumped it off. In her subsequent start, her odds climbed to an overlay level, she got a perfect drive and trip and scored the upset. Then in her last start here on March 1st, she was given an aggressive steer, and she retook the lead at the head of lane and sprinted to a clear lead before getting nailed on the wire. She's sharp and dangerous.

**#5 PERFETTO** was a winner at this level two starts back with Scott Young in the bike, now he sticks with Kadiddle. Still, this gelding earned much of his \$1.02 million with tonight's driver Dagfin Henriksen at the controls, and he should be heard from tonight. He is another in with a chance here.

**#6 PEMBERTON** will get plenty of attention at the windows tonight because he gets the leading driver in the bike and last time he drove four starts back, the gelding was a winner. He will likely be last of six early, and I'm not sure that he will get the trip he needs here. I'll go out on a limb and play to beat him.

**#8 QUEBEC HANOVER** has beaten better than he faces here tonight on several occasions. His lingering issue has always been problems staying on stride. He makes his 90th start tonight wearing trotting hobbles for the first time after using that equipment in his qualifier on March 6th and leading all the way in that mile. Assuming the hobbles solved his gait issues, he should have a big shot of leading this group on a merry chase and he gets top billing in this final leg of the late multi-race tickets.

**#4 ALL GAS NO BRAKES** got a covered trip three starts back, and that's when he typically thrives. He looked like a winner until just before the wire when Jokic got clearance along the pylons and surged to take the victory away from him. He stepped up in class for his next start and he drew best. Using that post position advantage, he left hard and worked out a good trip and the race became a three across battle in the lane after the top three broke away from the field. He passed the leader, but he couldn't fend off the favorite who drafted behind him all the way then pounced late. Last week, he took no prisoners on the lead, and he is clearly in his best form now. He could get a great trip following the top pick here, and he is a threat to repeat.

**#1 JGS PAL** won two straight recently, including one at this class level before he found the non-winners of \$12,000 last four class in his two most recent starts. He should find that his closing kick plays better in this lower class, but he may get too far back starting from the rail. I'll use him underneath here.

**#10 RITCHIE RICH** got bet in both starts as a four-year-old, and after hooking wheels in his first mile, he had better luck last week when he raced first-over and stayed for second. He has his work cut out starting from the widest post, but he is rounding into form, and I could see him taking another share tonight.

**#6 MOVE YOUR MASS** sat a perfect trip and finished a close second last time after drawing a good post racing one class lower than tonight's. He gets the best post tonight, but he faces tougher, and a small slice is likely his ceiling in this spot.

### CONDITIONS AND ALLOWANCES IN HARNESS RACING - IMPORTANT TO KNOW

The conditions of a race determine whether a horse is eligible to enter. For example many races are restricted to horses that have won a certain number of races or a certain amount of money in a specified number of starts. Many races are restricted to horses entered to be "claimed" (offered for sale) at a specific price.

Allowances in the claiming price itself are given to colts and geldings, four-year-olds and younger and to mares, five-year-olds and younger.

The purpose of the allowance is to keep younger horses more competitive when racing against older and more experienced rivals. Mares are given extra consideration in claiming events because of their potential as broodmares.

The accompanying chart shows what the allowances are, but an example may make them easier to understand. The chart indicates that three-year-olds receive a 50% allowance in claiming races. This means that a three-year-old entered in a \$20,000 claiming race carries an actual claiming price of \$30,000 (50% higher).

Fillies and mares receive an additional 25% allowance in claiming races. Details of the race conditions and claiming price (if any) are given at the top of each race in the program.

### ALLOWANCES FOR PURSE EARNINGS

When Fillies/Mares compete against Colts/Geldings (normally on the trot) Fillies/Mares will receive an additional 25% on the condition of the race. ie: nw \$5,000 (FM \$6,250) last 5 or \$12,000 (FM \$15,000) last 10 starts.

## C.P.M.A. Regulation Changes

Effective January 1<sup>st</sup> 2012  
CPMA will be instituting several new rule changes with regards to the following pari-mutuel pools:

### Pick Pools

- If there are no winners in any leg of a Pick N pool, the entire pool is refunded.
- If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners.
- A pool is no longer refunded if the 1<sup>st</sup> leg in the pool is cancelled or declared no contest.
- Pick-3: If at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: If at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.

## EXPLANATION OF THE LASIX PROGRAM

After careful study and consultation with Ontario Horsemen's groups, racetrack operators and veterinarians, Agriculture Canada and the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario passed legislation allowing the controlled (or supervised) administration of furosemide, more commonly called "Lasix". "Lasix" is used to alleviate the symptoms of exercise induced pulmonary hemorrhaging in racing horses. Horses will undergo an endoscopic examination of the trachea by a veterinarian licensed by the Ontario Racing Commission and endorsed by an official veterinarian before being allowed on the medication list. Once qualified, horses will be treated with "Lasix" within four hours plus or minus 15 minutes of a scheduled race in a secure retention area under the super vision of racing officials.

All horses on "Lasix" must remain on the program for a minimum of 100 days while racing in this jurisdiction.

- (L)** Denotes horses treated with Lasix today who were not so treated for their last start.
- (L)** Denotes horses treated with Lasix for their last start but not so treated today.

## RULES AND INFORMATION REGARDING CANADIAN HARNESS AND FOREIGN SEPARATE POOL EVENTS

### GENERAL

All pari-mutuel pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with the regulations and directives as issued by Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada ("the Regulations"), under the approval and supervision of the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency. The Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency can be contacted at 1-800-268-8835 or 613-759-6100 or Email: [cpmawebacpm@agr.gc.ca](mailto:cpmawebacpm@agr.gc.ca). A complete version of the CPMA regulations can be found at <http://laws-lois.justice.gc.ca/eng/regulations/SOR-91-385/>.

All tickets should be held until the result of the race is declared official and prices are posted.

No person under the age of 18 shall purchase or cash a ticket or voucher.

A claim of receiving an incorrect payment or incorrect change must be made to the Mutuel office of the association within twenty four hours of buying or cashing a valid ticket or voucher.

No ruling made by the Stewards/Judges or the Ontario Racing Commission with regard to distribution of purse money or the placing of horses in the order of finish, after the race has been declared official, shall have any bearing on the pay-out prices or distribution of pari-mutuel pools.

Change boards and Photo Finish display monitors are located in the Grandstand. In addition, Photo Finish pictures are shown on the closed-circuit television system. Customers are reminded that mutuel clerks are responsible for all shortages. When making a wager, customers must present sufficient funds at the time of purchase to cover the wagers requested.

### ENTRIES AND MUTUEL FIELDS

"Entry" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled or considered as the same betting interest. The most common reason for the coupling of horses in an Entry is the fact that they are owned by the same person.

"Mutuel Field" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled because the number of horses in the race exceeds the number which can be handled separately by the pari-mutuel system. Subject to the Regulations, a bet on one horse of an Entry or Mutuel Field shall be considered a bet on all horses in that Entry or Mutuel Field.

### DAILY DOUBLE BETTING (INCLUDING LATE DOUBLE)

A Daily Double bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of the two races specified for the Daily Double. Tickets not selecting the winner of the first half of the Daily Double and all tickets in the second half of the Daily Double not coupled with the declared official winner of the first half of the Daily Double are not winners and are not refunded no matter what circumstances affect the running of the second half of the Daily Double.

Should a horse or horses (not coupled with another starter) be excused from starting in the second race of the Daily Double after the first race of the Daily Double has closed for betting, holders of all Daily Double tickets on such horses, coupled with the winner of the first Daily Double race, shall participate in a Consolation Double pool. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

### EXACTA (Also known as Exactor)/TRIFECTA (Also known as Trifactor)/SUPERFECTA

An Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first two, three and four horses respectively, representing different betting interests to finish in the exact official order of finish, in the race on which the pool is operated.

### SWINGER (Also known as OMN)

A Swinger is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select horses to finish in any order from the official first 3 positions.

### JACKPOT HI-5

A Jackpot Hi-5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners in the specified Jackpot Hi-5 race. If there are races that have an entry, (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B), Jackpot Hi-5 will not offer a wager consisting of both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in a Jackpot Hi-5, the payout would be 1<sup>st</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>.

That jackpot portion of the pool will only be paid out if there is a single winning ticket. If there are multiple winning tickets that have correctly chosen the first 5 runners of the race, they will receive 50% of the pool for that day. The other 50% will go over into the Jackpot carryover. If there are no winning tickets with the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners, 100% of the current day's pool will be carried over into the Jackpot.

### PICK 3 & PICK-4 BETTING

The Pick 3 & Pick 4 bets are betting transactions in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of three or four successive races specified for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 respectively.

Winning tickets for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 are determined in the following sequence: A) winners of all legs, B) most winners, then refund. If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners. If there are no winners in any leg of a pool, the entire pool is refunded.

### PICK 5 BETTING

The Pick 5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of five successive races specified for the Pick 5 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 5 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 5.

### PICK 6 BETTING

The Pick 6 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of six successive races specified for the Pick 6 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 6 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 6.

### PICK 5 & 6 BETTING

If at least 1 race as part of the Pick 5 or 6 has been cancelled or declared "No contest", but not more than the specified below under Refunds, the net pool shall be distributed to those selecting the most # of winners and NOT include any carryover from a previous pool.

### PICK 3, PICK 4, PICK 5 & PICK 6 SCRATCHES

In the event a Pick 3, Pick 4, Pick 5 or Pick 6 ticket designates as a selection a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the Stewards/Judges to be a non-starter in any of the races comprising the Pick 3, Pick 4, Pick 5 or Pick 6 the favourite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection. In the event that the money bet in the win pool for two or more favourites is identical, the selection with the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non-starting selection.

However, if a scratch occurs in any leg of the Pick 3, Pick 4, Pick 5 or Pick 6 pools before the pool is closed, a ticket including the scratched horse may be cancelled.

### REFUNDS

Subject to the Regulations, all monies in all pools on a race are refunded in the event that the race is cancelled, declared off or declared no contest, and all monies bet on a horse are refunded if the horse is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start. These refunds will be communicated to the public through various means such as betting terminals, video display, changes boards and our website.

The Pick(n) pool shall be cancelled and all Pick(n) wagers for the individual performance shall be refunded if:

- Pick-3: at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

Where a horse that is part of an Entry is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start and at least one horse of that Entry receives a fair start in the race, all tickets purchased on the Entry remain valid and the purchase price of any such ticket shall not be refunded.

### COMMON POOL WAGERING (INTERTRACK BETTING)

In the unlikely event of a communications or computer system failure that prevents pools from merging with the host track's pools before the end of a race, CPMA regulations require that the site must refund all tickets for that race. This refund will be communicated to the public through various means such as video displays, change boards and messages on our website.

### FAIR START

If a horse has reached the Fair Start Pole (located 200 feet before the Starting Pole) by the time the mobile gate has reached the Starting Pole, that horse is deemed to have had a fair start. It makes no difference whether or not the horse is on or off stride at that precise moment. Under current policy and regulations, which are designed to be as fair as possible to all bettors on all starters, there is no Recall - a repeat of the entire starting procedure - when a horse does not reach the Fair Start Pole before the gate reaches the Starting Pole. Monies bet on such a horse are refunded in accordance with the regulation concerning refunds.

### LOST & OLD TICKETS

WEG issued tickets or vouchers are valid indefinitely, however, they cannot be cashed at a mutuel teller after 2 years from date of issue. Please mail tickets, along with your name and address, to Mutuel Manager, P.O. Box 156, Rexdale, Ontario, M9W 5L2, keeping a photocopy for future reference.

For "Lost Tickets" originally sold at a Woodbine Entertainment Group racetrack or Teletheatre, please enquire at the Mutuel office at Woodbine, Greenwood Teletheatre, or Mohawk. Policy may be subject to change retroactively in the event regulatory bodies amend existing regulations.

### ASSOCIATION PERCENTAGE, AND TAXATION/LEVY

The Woodbine Entertainment Group deducts and retains the following percentages from wagers placed at our own licensed sites which are then shared with the horsepeople, host and simulcast associations and the Ontario Racing Commission.

**WOODBINE/MOHAWK LIVE:** Win, Place & Show: 13.65%. Swinger 14.7%. Trifecta & Pick 4: 21.7%. Double & Exacta 17.2%. Jackpot Hi-5, Pick 5 & Pick 6: 11.7%. All other 23.0%

Horsepeople receive a further 2% on all wagers, except Trifecta wagering where it is 4%. The Ontario Provincial Government retains 0.5% on all bets placed in Ontario. The Canadian Government (through a revolving fund cost recovery basis) retains 0.8% on all wagers placed in Canada for provision of drug control, and audit services.
