Betting Basics

Some essentials to get you started with making a wager.

1 How to wager



Place your bet by visiting a teller, or using a self-serve terminal.

To place a bet here are just 5 things you need to know:

- 1 Name of racetrack (choose from any track in the simulcast feeds)
- 2 Number of the race
- 3 Amount of your bet (e.g. \$2)
- 4 Type of bet (see step 2)
- 5 Horse's number (see step 4)

Once you have decided what you want to bet, head to the nearest seller's window and use the sample statement as your guide:

Hello, (Racetrack), race 6, \$2 to WIN on Horse #4

How to use a self-serve terminal:

- 1 Swipe your Cash Card/Insert Cash
- 2 Enter the initial PIN #1234 (then choose a new PIN)
- 3 Press/Tap the track you would like to bet: (defaults to current race)
- 4 Tap the Horse Number: **#4**
- 5 Press/Tap the Bet Type: **WIN**
- 6 Press/Tap the Bet Amount: **\$2**
- 7 Press/Tap the Race Number: **Race #6**
- 8 Press Green **"Make BET"** button
- 9 Press/Tap the **"Finish with Receipt"** button
- 10 Be sure to check your ticket to confirm it's the bet you wanted

To get a Cash Card or for assistance ask a teller, or a staff member.

2 Types of bets



Single horse bets (minimum \$2.00 bet is required)

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Win	U U U	Your horse must finish 1st; payoff determined by the win odds.
Place	U U	Your horse must finish 1st or 2nd; payoffs better than to show.
Show	U	Your horse must finish 1st, 2nd, or 3rd; modest payoffs.

Exotic multiple-horse bets

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Exacta*	U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st and 2nd in exact order; riskier bet that can pay a little or a lot, depending on the horses' odds.
Daily double	U U U U U	Pick the winners of two designated consecutive races.
Pick 3, Win 4, Pick 5, Pick 6	U U U U U U	Select the winners of a designated set of consecutive races. The wager must be made prior to the start of the first race in the multi-race wager.
Triactor*	U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in exact order; can be expensive to play if you use a lot of horses.
Superfecta*	U U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th; big payoff possible.

* Exotic bets require the horses to finish in the EXACT order you select, unless you "BOX" the bet, in which case your selections can finish in any order.

All of the numbers and letters in the program might seem confusing or overwhelming at first, but focusing on these sections makes choosing a horse simple.

- 1 Horse's number in the race
- 2 Horse's post position colour
- 3 Horse's colour, sex, age, sire (father), dam (mother), sire of the dam
- 4 Morning line odds
- 5 Horse's name
- 6 Driver and Driver Record (Name, # of wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, winning %)
- 7 Trainer information
- 8 Horse's Lifetime record (with best win time, track size, track, age, lifetime wins and lifetime earnings)
- 9 Horse's current record (# of races, # wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, and money earned)

4 The odds



Odds are also important to consider when choosing your horse. Horses that are thought to have a better chance of winning will typically have lower odds.

Morning line odds

Odds listed in the race program are the "morning line" odds. These are predictions of how the public will bet on the race. They are set by the track's handicapper when the race program is published, before the wagering starts.

The actual odds will be posted on the **Television** or in-field on the **Tote Board** before the race; they change up until post time, depending on how customers are betting on each horse in the race.

Calculating a \$2 win prize

To calculate a win prize, find the Odds of a horse on the **Television** or **Tote Board** (in-field board).

Multiply the first number by 2, then divide that number by the second digit (if there is one), and then add \$2. Simple as that!

Odds	1/2	2/1	7/2	5/1	10/1
Pays	\$3.00	\$6.00	\$9.00	\$12.00	\$22.00

Helpful facts for betting

- Some racetracks have a television simulcast commentator who tries to identify winning horses (handicaps) between the races. Listen and see if you can pick up any good tips to bet on.
- A good betting method is to choose horses with current odds two to three times higher than their morning line odds.

3 Tips to remember

WIN BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 32% of the time
PLACE BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 53% of the time
SHOW BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 67% of the time

Race 1 Selections

The Horseplayer's Journal by Garnet Barnsdale

#6 ESMERELDA DU LAC raced well in defeat here last week, perhaps falling victim to how the track was playing late in that card where the wide paths seemed faster than the inside part of the wet track. She got a great trip that night and when she edged out of the pocket in the lane, she looked like a winner. She was passed on the line by a rival she will again face tonight, one that rallied down that best path on the far outside. She gets the post position edge on that rival tonight, and she gets the nod to turn the tables in this opening leg of tonight's \$75,000 guaranteed early Pick 5.

#9 ANGELS AMONG US took a new lifetime mark At Flamboro Down four starts back making a devastating wide late move that night, then she lowered that mark in her next start when she was a game first-over winner here three weeks ago in her first start at Mohawk Park. She was then bet down to 2 to 1 on March 6th, but she didn't get a winning trip. Last week, she was dropped to last at the start, and that turned out to be a winning move as because it was clear that the widest path in the stretch was the best path racing in the snow over a wet track. She rallied past them all, possibly aided by that bias, but she is clearly sharp and she should contend again here. My only worry is that she might get too far back starting from a wide post and get left with too much to do late, and she may end up closing as an underlay this time.

#3 PLAYSOMETHINGSWEET was only a one-time winner last season in 11 starts, but she did some good racing near the end of the season in the Harvest Series, and she qualified okay for this sophomore debut when she finished third behind two male pacers. She's in with her own gender here, and she is the other one in here that I would consider using in the early Pick 5.

#7 BEACH WIGGLE got a dream trip on the engine here two starts back, getting a 31-flat second quarter on route to a 58 4/5 opening half, but she couldn't fend off first-over challenger Angels Among Us who got the tougher trip. She resurfaced last Wednesday in London, and she couldn't get the job done as the 1 to 5 favorite after getting another easy opening half. She will likely show speed again tonight, but I don't see her lasting to the wire on the engine. I prefer to use her underneath in this spot.

#5 SPARKS FLY was taken to the back two starts back and given an easier trip than he is used to, then in his last start, he got both class and post relief. A much different approach was expected last week with those variables swinging his way; he has always done his best work racing on or near the lead. He indeed was raced much more aggressively, and he looked good plowing through the fog on the engine until very deep in the lane where he tired. After missing last week due to transportation issues, he fires back in the same class after disappointing as the even money favorite, and I'll stick with him in what looks like a good spot for his front end style.

#3 BUCK DANCER, with two wins and three thirds at this level in his last five starts, is the most consistent trotter in this field. He does his best work when he gets a covered trip, and he should be able to find the pocket or three hole early here and sit a good following trip from where he can get covered up to the three quarters then rally late. He would be no surprise in this spot.

#6 MISTER MAGIC gives it his best effort every week, and he has been part of the Superfecta in all his last seven starts while already earning close to \$25,000 this season racing exclusively in this \$20,000 optional claiming class. He has taken only one win in his last 27 starts, but he always seems to be around the money, and he should be part of the Tri or Super in this spot.

#4 EUROBANK HANOVER had a productive 2025 campaign, taking seven wins from 15 starts while earning more than \$36,000. He is unique in that in his other eight starts, he didn't hit the board because he broke stride in every one of those miles, including his last four pari-mutuel starts. His most recent qualifier racing in the snow where he finished with trot on a helmet is encouraging, but I don't trust him enough to take a likely underlaid win price tonight and I'll play to beat him out of the early Pick 5.

#8 WINDSUN CHELSEA showed predicted improvement on February 20th when making her second start of the year, closing from far back to get second, and she found her best stride in the final eighth where she closed a lot of ground quickly. It was a completely different story in her next start on March 6th as she kind of got lost in the fog as a slow pace was being cut and she couldn't close much into a 27 2/5 final quarter although she did kick home in 26 4/5. Last week, she got the leading driver in the bike and she was raced aggressively. She engaged the leader first up in the third quarter and she eventually finished on even terms with that rival, but they both lost the war when a fresh closer blew past them both in deep stretch. She fits well here, and she gets the nod to break her maiden in this opening leg of tonight's early Pick 4.

#5 R SPORTS DELIGHT was ready to produce a good effort at first asking here last week and she was put into the race immediately by pilot Doug McNair. She gamely battled Windsun Chelsea to the wire as they ended up in a dead heat for second. She has licence to improve off that long awaited debut, and she would be no surprise in this spot tonight.

#2 LIZA MAE had a similar profile to top pick Windsun Chelsea when entered last week before she was a weather scratch. Two starts back, she got a good following trip and she rallied for third, then in her last start, she was in the same race as Windsun Chelsea. She too was camped at the back early and unable to rally for anything better than sixth place while pacing her own final quarter in a sizzling 26-flat. She should contend here if she is sharp enough after missing that start last week.

#7 LDS KIMBERLY had a decent season at two, taking five shares from nine starts while earning close to \$16,000. #9 MYSTIC hasn't shown much in his past three starts, but previous to that he won three of four starts racing here at Mohawk Park, and he was well clear while taking those three victories. He comes off two straight miles where he raced first-over and that isn't his best trip. I don't mind the wide post for him tonight, as he should be able to float out and get positioned then find a helmet to follow. I'll take a price swing with him in the opening leg of tonight's 20-cent Pick 6 that features a carryover in excess of \$34,000.

#8 NO ANGEL LIKE ME produced an improved effort two starts back here two weeks ago when she flashed down the far outside late in the stretch when the field raced out of the fog, beaten by less than two lengths while gaining on a tightly packed group of five on the wire. Last week, she was sent off as a 20 to 1 in the opening leg of this Pop Up Series, and after starting from the rail, she was given an aggressive steer. She moved out first-over before the half and he chased the leader as the two of them trotted away from the rest of the field. She was no match for that winner, but she was game to the wire, and she finished well clear in second. She fits well in this series, and she is sharp and dangerous in this field.

#3 THE FIXER returns to Mohawk Park fresh off two second place finishes in some solid conditioned fields at Flamboro Downs, and he picks up the leading driver who can do no wrong at the moment. This gelding started 11 times at Mohawk Park last year and he took only one win, but many of the fields he faced were tougher than the one he meets here, and the one field that he beat was comparable to this Pop Up field. He will no doubt get put into this race leaving the gate and he is hard to leave off Pick 6 tickets.

#6 STONEBRIDGE ZEUS was bet down to 7 to 2 in the opening leg of this series last week, and he raced okay to get third, but he was well behind No Angel Like Me at the wire. He draws best and he can get a good following trip tonight, but I prefer to use him underneath tonight.

#1 LETS N JOY N has been nothing short of sensational since shipping into town from Down Under while winning all six of her Canadian starts. She started out crushing a non-winners of three field at Flamboro Downs, then she impressively swept the Blizzard Series. She was even better in her next two starts with Mohawk Park's leading driver in the bike. In both miles, she wasn't particularly close to the front turning for home, and in both cases, she roared home to catch the leader and win pacing away at the wire. Then two weeks ago, she won again and she motored home in 25 4/5 which I believe is the fastest final quarter paced in a race for a purse at Mohawk Park this year so far. She seems to just be able to do whatever it takes to win each race, and she should be able to handle this step up in class to the Fillies and Mares Open 2 level. She gets the nod to take her seventh straight win, and she will likely be a popular single on Pick 6 tickets.

#4 ABSOLUTION has been sharp for several weeks, but she has had the misfortune of having to face white hot Angostura Hanover, who has reeled off four straight wins. This consistent mare was too far back chasing a slow pace last week, and she did the best that she could to finish a distant third. She will get there soon to take her first win of 2026, but if Lets N Joy N gets a reasonable trip tonight, this mare might have to wait at least another week to get off the schneid.

#7 BADGIRL BRIDGETTE has looked good since she landed in Ontario, starting with her qualifier on February 27th when she motored home in 26-flat when she just missed. She has finished fast winning both her pari-mutuel starts, now she gets class tested. I don't see her passing them all, but she could sneak into the bottom of the Tri or Super at a square piece.

#9 SO MUCH MORE took no action last week, and she raced tough after starting from the rail, taking command early then cutting some solid fractions before getting overtaken and beaten by streaking Angostura Hanover. Her class can never be questioned, and although I don't love the nine hole for her tonight, she has proven me and many others wrong on several occasions in the past.

#6 LADY CAFE AU LAIT, as expected, got bet down to favorite last week, partially on the driver change to James Macdonald. But she was also coming out of a mile where she kicked in 25 4/5, she got to take a class drop, and she drew the best post, so it was no surprise to see her make an early move to the front and drive away from the field. She only gets into this race on the also eligible condition for four-year-old Ontario bred mares, and she once again draws best. Trainer Bo Ford has sent out 86 starters in 2025-26, but he has clicked 31 times for a potent strike rate of 36%. Looking into my crystal ball, I see this mare leaving hard again and landing in the pocket of class dropping probable favorite Tells On A Roll who leaves from the widest post. I'll side with this sharp improving mare to notch the repeat win in this opening leg of tonight's late Pick 5.

#8 TELLS ON A ROLL gets needed class relief tonight, and drawing the widest post in a field of eight isn't terrible for her because she should be able to clear to the front from out there then try to control the fractions. Last time this 27-time winner raced at tonight's level, she wired a field and won easily. She will most likely be the one to catch at the three quarters, and she is hard to leave off Pick 6 tickets.

#4 CARRERA SUNSET N comes out of the same race as top choice Lady Cafe Au Lait, and she closed well to get third after sitting last on the inside to the last turn. She cut the corner, saved ground, then worked her way through traffic before finding clear sailing. She was never going to be a threat to the winner, however. She has been part of the Super in all of her last three starts raced at this level, and she can take another share here tonight.

#3 SORCHA SEELSTER put together a decent rally to get fourth two starts back racing at this level then she could do no better than race evenly last time in a race where the final quarter was paced in 26-flat. She drops back down here but despite adding Lasix, she will probably find a couple of mares in here too tough. She should be able to get a share in this spot, though.

#7 GOOBER SMACK lost a shoe and broke stride in his first start of the season at Flamboro Downs on February 19th, then he bounced back nicely a week later racing at the same track. He made a decisive first-over move and crushed his rivals that night. Then, after missing a week, he produced a similar kind of mile here, winning the hard way racing first-over. He showed how sharp he is when the fastest quarter he trotted one was the final quarter of the race. He jumps into this Pop Up series in the second leg, and he looks like a good fit in here. I'll give him the nod to notch the threeppeat in this opening leg of tonight's late Pick 4.

#4 JOKIC was racing well up to his last start where he made an unfortunate break in stride not long after the start. In that mile, it appeared as though he clipped the wheel of a rival with one of his front hooves which threw him off stride, so that miscue is easily forgiven. Three starts back, he beat a horse that has since raced three times and won twice and finished second in the other mile. This 15-time winner is a good fit in this Pop Up Series and he in one of several to consider for multi-race tickets.

#9 MUSCLE FASHION took a trip down the road to Flamboro Downs, and he dominated an overmatched field of trotters as expected. He gets a look here being that he was the choice of leading driver James Macdonald over two others, including one that was a winner in the opening leg of this series last week. He should get put into this race leaving the gate and it won't be a shock if Macdonald works out the winning trip.

#1 HEY RALPHIE dominated in one of the divisions of the opening leg of this series last week, but he got a soft trip on the lead that is unlikely to get repeated here tonight with him facing some tougher horses and leaving from the rail. He also loses pilot Jamieson who opted to stick with top choice Goober Smack. I prefer to use this veteran gelding underneath in this spot.

#6 SUGAR PIE HONEY started out the 2026 season hot, winning two in a row with a \$60,000 claiming tag on her. She was claimed out of that second mile by Team Cullen, and she raced well again in her third start of the year, leading to the final strides before getting caught. Since then, she has simply been in too tough, facing the likes of So Much More and Lets N Joy N. She missed a cheque in two straight starts which allows her to drop one level, and that needed class drop combined with her drawing the best post should lead to a much better result. Assuming that she gets put into this race early, she gets top billing here.

#1 BLINDED BY DELIGHT has recorded only one win in 10 starts so far this season, but that lone victory came the last time she raced at tonight's class level on February 6th. On that night, she dropped back early then she made a middle move to the front and drove away from the field to win comfortably. She figures to improve sharply here facing easier and she is another one that I would give a close look at for use on late multi-race tickets.

#2 MADAM X was an easy winner at this level in fast time three starts back. She was hammered down to 3 to 5 in her next mile starting from the widest post racing in the fog, and she had her sights set on the lead on the first turn when she broke stride. She rebounded nicely last week chasing a dominant class dropping winner home, now she faces some more class droppers again tonight. She is another possibility in here, I just wonder how much value she might offer as she will likely get bet in this spot.

#7 HIGHLAND DELIGHT is a grinding type that tries hard every week, and she brings a streak of four straight third place finishes. She has enough gate speed to get positioned in mid pack or better at the start of this mile, and she is worth a look for the bottom of Tri and Super bets, especially since she seems to never get bet and she likely won't take much action tonight.

#6 PIZAZZ HANOVER last raced in tonight's non-winners of three class three starts back and on that night, she was a closing fifth to promising import mare Lets N Joy N who will likely be favored in the Fillies and Mares Open 2 tonight. Since then, she raced well in defeat in two straight starts in some tough non-winners of \$6,000 last four class now she gets into what looks like an easier spot here tonight. Starting from the best post, she will likely get sent forward leaving the gate by Louis-Phillipe Roy, and she has a good chance to take her first win of the season here in her sixth start.

#3 BRITTAS BEST BET had a nice sophomore season last year, taking six wins and seven other shares from 19 starts while earning more than \$57,000. She starts her four-year-old season in what appears to be a good spot for her, and she looks ready to roll based on her lone qualifier on March 13th. On that morning, racing over a track that was assigned a one second variant, she produced a 26 2/5 final quarter to get up for third and she looked good pacing strongly to the wire. She could get overlooked here making her first start of the year, and she is worth a look for use on late multi-race tickets.

#5 KOBRA KATE won a leg of the Blizzard Series six starts back, and since then she raced five times and those five miles were won by the same two mares, Lets N Joy N and Side Effects. This mare raced well in both of her last two starts, but Side Effects was just too good for her, although she was only a half length short in each of those starts. I think if Pizzazz Hanover brings her A game, this mare and the others will likely be racing for second. That being said, this daughter of Big Bad John can get another share in this spot.

#7 STELLRMANIPULATION was a sharp winner here two starts back, then she faced tougher and she got too far back in that mile. She gets into a smaller field tonight, and she should be able to pass a few of these mares in the back half. She is a good one for use on the bottom of the exotics.

#4 TAMARA HANOVER was claimed six starts back and since then she only hit the board once, but that third-place finish did come racing at tonight's class level four starts back. She figures to improve on the class drop tonight, and I could see pilot Jody Jamieson trying to get her positioned closer to the front leaving the gate this time. CONDITIONS AND ALLOWANCES IN HARNESS RACING - IMPORTANT TO KNOW

The conditions of a race determine whether a horse is eligible to enter. For example many races are restricted to horses that have won a certain number of races or a certain amount of money in a specified number of starts. Many races are restricted to horses entered to be "claimed" (offered for sale) at a specific price.

Allowances in the claiming price itself are given to colts and geldings, four-year-olds and younger and to mares, five-year-olds and younger.

The purpose of the allowance is to keep younger horses more competitive when racing against older and more experienced rivals. Mares are given extra consideration in claiming events because of their potential as broodmares.

The accompanying chart shows what the allowances are, but an example may make them easier to understand. The chart indicates that three-year-olds receive a 50% allowance in claiming races. This means that a three-year-old entered in a \$20,000 claiming race carries an actual claiming price of \$30,000 (50% higher).

Fillies and mares receive an additional 25% allowance in claiming races. Details of the race conditions and claiming price (if any) are given at the top of each race in the program.

C.P.M.A. Regulation Changes

Effective January 1st 2012
CPMA will be instituting several new rule changes with regards to the following pari-mutuel pools:

Pick Pools

- If there are no winners in any leg of a Pick N pool, the entire pool is refunded.
- If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners.
- A pool is no longer refunded if the 1st leg in the pool is cancelled or declared no contest.
- Pick-3: If at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: If at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.

EXPLANATION OF THE LASIX PROGRAM

After careful study and consultation with Ontario Horsemen's groups, racetrack operators and veterinarians, Agriculture Canada and the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario passed legislation allowing the controlled (or supervised) administration of furosemide, more commonly called "Lasix". "Lasix" is used to alleviate the symptoms of exercise induced pulmonary hemorrhaging in racing horses. Horses will undergo an endoscopic examination of the trachea by a veterinarian licensed by the Ontario Racing Commission and endorsed by an official veterinarian before being allowed on the medication list. Once qualified, horses will be treated with "Lasix" within four hours plus or minus 15 minutes of a scheduled race in a secure retention area under the super vision of racing officials.

All horses on "Lasix" must remain on the program for a minimum of 100 days while racing in this jurisdiction.

RULES AND INFORMATION REGARDING CANADIAN HARNESS AND FOREIGN SEPARATE POOL EVENTS

GENERAL

All pari-mutuel pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with the regulations and directives as issued by Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada ("the Regulations"), under the approval and supervision of the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency. The Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency can be contacted at 1-800-268-8835 or 613-759-6100 or Email: cpmawebacpm@agr.gc.ca. A complete version of the CPMA regulations can be found at <http://laws-lois.justice.gc.ca/eng/regulations/SOR-91-385/>.

All tickets should be held until the result of the race is declared official and prices are posted.

No person under the age of 18 shall purchase or cash a ticket or voucher.

A claim of receiving an incorrect payment or incorrect change must be made to the Mutuel office of the association within twenty four hours of buying or cashing a valid ticket or voucher.

No ruling made by the Stewards/Judges or the Ontario Racing Commission with regard to distribution of purse money or the placing of horses in the order of finish, after the race has been declared official, shall have any bearing on the pay-out prices or distribution of pari-mutuel pools.

Change boards and Photo Finish display monitors are located in the Grandstand. In addition, Photo Finish pictures are shown on the closed-circuit television system. Customers are reminded that mutuel clerks are responsible for all shortages. When making a wager, customers must present sufficient funds at the time of purchase to cover the wagers requested.

ENTRIES AND MUTUEL FIELDS

"Entry" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled or considered as the same betting interest. The most common reason for the coupling of horses in an Entry is the fact that they are owned by the same person.

"Mutuel Field" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled because the number of horses in the race exceeds the number which can be handled separately by the pari-mutuel system. Subject to the Regulations, a bet on one horse of an Entry or Mutuel Field shall be considered a bet on all horses in that Entry or Mutuel Field.

DAILY DOUBLE BETTING (INCLUDING LATE DOUBLE)

A Daily Double bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of the two races specified for the Daily Double. Tickets not selecting the winner of the first half of the Daily Double and all tickets in the second half of the Daily Double not coupled with the declared official winner of the first half of the Daily Double are not winners and are not refunded no matter what circumstances affect the running of the second half of the Daily Double.

Should a horse or horses (not coupled with another starter) be excused from starting in the second race of the Daily Double after the first race of the Daily Double has closed for betting, holders of all Daily Double tickets on such horses, coupled with the winner of the first Daily Double race, shall participate in a Consolation Double pool. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

EXACTA (Also known as Exactor)/TRIFECTA (Also known as Tractor)/SUPERFECTA

An Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first two, three and four horses respectively, representing different betting interests to finish in the exact official order of finish, in the race on which the pool is operated.

SWINGER (Also known as OMN)

A Swinger is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select horses to finish in any order from the official first 3 positions.

JACKPOT HI-5

A Jackpot Hi-5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners in the specified Jackpot Hi-5 race. If there are races that have an entry, (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B), Jackpot Hi-5 will not offer a wager consisting of both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in a Jackpot Hi-5, the payout would be 1st, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th.

That jackpot portion of the pool will only be paid out if there is a single winning ticket. If there are multiple winning tickets that have correctly chosen the first 5 runners of the race, they will receive 50% of the pool for that day. The other 50% will go over into the Jackpot carryover. If there are no winning tickets with the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners, 100% of the current day's pool will be carried over into the Jackpot.

PICK 3 & PICK-4 BETTING

The Pick 3 & Pick 4 bets are betting transactions in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of three or four successive races specified for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 respectively.

Winning tickets for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 are determined in the following sequence: A) winners of all legs, B) most winners, then refund. If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners. If there are no winners in any leg of a pool, the entire pool is refunded.

PICK 5 BETTING

The Pick 5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of five successive races specified for the Pick 5 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 5 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 5.

PICK 6 BETTING

The Pick 6 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of six successive races specified for the Pick 6 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 6 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 6.

PICK 5 & 6 BETTING

If at least 1 race as part of the Pick 5 or 6 has been cancelled or declared "No contest", but not more than the specified below under Refunds, the net pool shall be distributed to those selecting the most # of winners and NOT include any carryover from a previous pool.

PICK 3, PICK 4, PICK 5 & PICK 6 SCRATCHES

In the event a Pick 3, Pick 4, Pick 5 or Pick 6 ticket designates as a selection a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the Stewards/Judges to be a non-starter in any of the races comprising the Pick 3, Pick 4, Pick 5 or Pick 6 the favourite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection. In the event that the money bet in the win pool for two or more favourites is identical, the selection with the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non-starting selection.

However, if a scratch occurs in any leg of the Pick 3, Pick 4, Pick 5 or Pick 6 pools before the pool is closed, a ticket including the scratched horse may be cancelled.

REFUNDS

Subject to the Regulations, all monies in all pools on a race are refunded in the event that the race is cancelled, declared off or declared no contest, and all monies bet on a horse are refunded if the horse is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start. These refunds will be communicated to the public through various means such as betting terminals, video display, changes boards and our website.

The Pick(n) pool shall be cancelled and all Pick(n) wagers for the individual performance shall be refunded if:

- Pick-3: at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

Where a horse that is part of an Entry is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start and at least one horse of that Entry receives a fair start in the race, all tickets purchased on the Entry remain valid and the purchase price of any such ticket shall not be refunded.

COMMON POOL WAGERING (INTERTRACK BETTING)

In the unlikely event of a communications or computer system failure that prevents pools from merging with the host track's pools before the end of a race, CPMA regulations require that the site must refund all tickets for that race. This refund will be communicated to the public through various means such as video displays, change boards and messages on our website.

FAIR START

If a horse has reached the Fair Start Pole (located 200 feet before the Starting Pole) by the time the mobile gate has reached the Starting Pole, that horse is deemed to have had a fair start. It makes no difference whether or not the horse is on or off stride at that precise moment. Under current policy and regulations, which are designed to be as fair as possible to all bettors on all starters, there is no Recall - a repeat of the entire starting procedure - when a horse does not reach the Fair Start Pole before the gate reaches the Starting Pole. Monies bet on such a horse are refunded in accordance with the regulation concerning refunds.

LOST & OLD TICKETS

WEG issued tickets or vouchers are valid indefinitely, however, they cannot be cashed at a mutuel teller after 2 years from date of issue. Please mail tickets, along with your name and address, to Mutuel Manager, P.O. Box 156, Rexdale, Ontario, M9W 5L2, keeping a photocopy for future reference.

For "Lost Tickets" originally sold at a Woodbine Entertainment Group racetrack or Teletheatre, please enquire at the Mutuel office at Woodbine, Greenwood Teletheatre, or Mohawk. Policy may be subject to change retroactively in the event regulatory bodies amend existing regulations.

ASSOCIATION PERCENTAGE, AND TAXATION/LEVY

The Woodbine Entertainment Group deducts and retains the following percentages from wagers placed at our own licensed sites which are then shared with the horsepeople, host and simulcast associations and the Ontario Racing Commission.

WOODBINE/MOHAWK LIVE: Win, Place & Show: 13.65%. Swinger 14.7%. Trifecta & Pick 4: 21.7%. Double & Exacta 17.2%. Jackpot Hi-5, Pick 5 & Pick 6: 11.7%. All other 23.0%

Horsepeople receive a further 2% on all wagers, except Trifecta wagering where it is 4%. The Ontario Provincial Government retains 0.5% on all bets placed in Ontario. The Canadian Government (through a revolving fund cost recovery basis) retains 0.8% on all wagers placed in Canada for provision of drug control, and audit services.
