Betting Basics

Some essentials to get you started with making a wager.

1 How to wager



Place your bet by visiting a teller, or using a self-serve terminal.

To place a bet here are just 5 things you need to know:

- 1 Name of racetrack (choose from any track in the simulcast feeds)
- 2 Number of the race
- 3 Amount of your bet (e.g. \$2)
- 4 Type of bet (see step 2)
- 5 Horse's number (see step 4)

Once you have decided what you want to bet, head to the nearest seller's window and use the sample statement as your guide:

Hello, (Racetrack), race 6, \$2 to WIN on Horse #4

How to use a self-serve terminal:

- 1 Swipe your Cash Card/Insert Cash
- 2 Enter the initial PIN #1234 (then choose a new PIN)
- 3 Press/Tap the track you would like to bet: (defaults to current race)
- 4 Tap the Horse Number: **#4**
- 5 Press/Tap the Bet Type: **WIN**
- 6 Press/Tap the Bet Amount: **\$2**
- 7 Press/Tap the Race Number: **Race #6**
- 8 Press Green **"Make BET"** button
- 9 Press/Tap the **"Finish with Receipt"** button
- 10 Be sure to check your ticket to confirm it's the bet you wanted

To get a Cash Card or for assistance ask a teller, or a staff member.

2 Types of bets



Single horse bets (minimum \$2.00 bet is required)

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Win	U U U	Your horse must finish 1st; payoff determined by the win odds.
Place	U U	Your horse must finish 1st or 2nd; payoffs better than to show.
Show	U	Your horse must finish 1st, 2nd, or 3rd; modest payoffs.

Exotic multiple-horse bets

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Exacta*	U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st and 2nd in exact order; riskier bet that can pay a little or a lot, depending on the horses' odds.
Daily double	U U U U U	Pick the winners of two designated consecutive races.
Pick 3, Win 4, Pick 5, Pick 6	U U U U U U	Select the winners of a designated set of consecutive races. The wager must be made prior to the start of the first race in the multi-race wager.
Triactor*	U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in exact order; can be expensive to play if you use a lot of horses.
Superfecta*	U U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th; big payoff possible.

* Exotic bets require the horses to finish in the EXACT order you select, unless you "BOX" the bet, in which case your selections can finish in any order.

Race 1 Selections

The Horseplayer's Journal by Garnet Barnsdale

#6 DUBLIN DASHER got a good following trip last week and he got room to attack the leaders at the head of the lane, but trying to chase down classy Poseidon Seelster and Brue Hanover racing in the rain over a wet track in a 26-flat final quarter turned out to be an impossible task. He did kick home in 25 4/5, now he gets to drop in class and he draws best. He is sharp, and he should get an aggressive steer tonight. The last time he raced this low, he throttled a good field by three lengths nine starts back. He will take beating in this opening leg of tonight's \$75,000 guaranteed Pick 5.

#5 WALLACE HARTLEY could be an interesting contender for Exacta players here coming off a mile that was probably better than it looks on the program. He followed along to the backstretch last week where he moved out third-over. He got backed up when the first-over challenger started to stall midway around the final turn. He swung wide and lost a lot of ground, and when he was fanned out widest in the stretch, he found his best stride. He flew down the middle of the track, but he simply had too much ground to make up and the best he could do was get up for fourth. Drawing a better post gives him a chance to get a better trip racing close to the front tonight, and he could be right there at the wire.

#3 WHATCHULOOKIN AT came on late to score a major upset four starts back racing at a level similar to tonight's after the race was thrown wide-open at the three quarter pole when the favorite broke stride. He moved up to face much tougher in his next start, and he fired a 25 3/5 final quarter to get up for third. Two weeks ago, he class dropped but didn't get involved after starting from a wide post. Last week, he was simply in too tough. Dropping down and getting an inside post gives him a chance to take a share tonight.

#4 SOARING NOW can be very fast when he is on his game, and he was just that last week when he showed speed both early and late to take a 1:51 1/5 season's best win. He steps up tonight and he faces some class droppers so there is no question that he is in tougher. I prefer to use him underneath tonight, but there is no question that he is sharp, and he can be dangerous.

#7 TH SUMMER LOVIN drew well for her first start of the season on March 27th, and she got Doug McNair in the bike for the first time. She might have been a bit over bet closing as the 4 to 5 favorite, but she was probably good enough to win but the shape of that mile led to a closer catching her in the lane. The fractions were wild as the leader was a runaway that eventually pulled off the track. That mile was a good tightener for her, and she was raced much more aggressively in her second start back last week. Her only issue was the presence of class dropping Tells On A Roll who took command from this mare just past the half and was never going to be caught once she touched down on the lead. This 28-time winner fits well here, and I'll stick with her.

#4 PERFECTLY CHIC returns to the races for her four-year-old season coming off an excellent sophomore season where she was a Grand Circuit winner and earned more than \$332,000 for her connections. Considering that she was bought for only \$12,000 at the Harrisburg Sale, she has shown herself to be quite a bargain as she nears a half million dollars in earnings. She qualified okay on the morning of April 3rd, sitting in to the lane, then fanning out and finishing in a three across battle for second. She was asked for nothing by driver Bob McClure, and she paced to the wire on her own energy. She has shown she is capable of beating these types and she would be no surprise in this spot.

#6 LA MIKI N has a pretty amazing streak of sorts going having finished third in five of her last six starts. She gets the best post to work from tonight, and there are a couple in here that seem more likely to win than her, so it is very possible that she will once again complete the Tri. I would expect pilot Jody Jamieson to put her into play at the outset starting from the best post.

#1 SUNSHINE MAGIC has excelled for Team Cullen to the point where she was taking shares racing in the top class in March. She didn't get any money in her last two starts, so she gets some class relief tonight. #6 LET R SINK SON displayed a big late kick here last October when he motored past six rivals in the stretch to win a leg of the Harvest Series and pay a whopping \$102. He has shown in his lone qualifier and first pari-mutuel race at three that he has ramped up that late speed as a sophomore. After kicking in 26 4/5 in the qualifier, he flashed home in 26 2/5 last week and he lacked room along the inside at a critical point in the stretch. He finished full of pace, and he was in front a few strides past the wire when the room he needed appeared. He draws best here and he should get an aggressive Travis Henry steer. He gets the nod to take his first win as a sophomore as we kick off tonight's early Pick 4.

#9 COUNT ON GORD is hard to fault because he has been right there in every one of his first five starts. Two starts back, he was bet down to 6 to 5 favorite, but the repeat winner stole a 58 3/5 middle half making him impossible to catch. Last week, he took the bull by the horns, taking command early, and he cut slow fractions himself that time. He was outsprinted in the lane, but he has missed three weeks, so he has licence to improve tonight coming back in seven days. He can be an Exacta factor.

#3 FRENCH BULLDOG had a prep for the opening leg of this Spring Series last week as he made his first start at three. He was ready to produce a good effort, but he had the misfortune of facing a Millar Farms debutant who blew the field away at 1 to 5 odds. The Bulldog Hanover gelding tasted his first defeat that night, but he still has some upside, and he should be in the mix tonight.

#5 RIP THE PAGE brought \$32,000 at the London Classic Sale by trainer Gregg McNair for himself and some partners, and he qualified well twice for his career debut, dropping close to three seconds in the second qualifying mile. Doug McNair drove him in both of those efforts, but he sided with a rival for his debut, so this colt picked up leading driver James MacDonald. He rallied well in the stretch and overcame an outside rival contacting one of his wheels early in the lane to get up for the win. He closed well for third last week when he stepped up one class level, and he should be able to get a piece in here.

#5 UP TO NO GOUDA produced a strong effort two starts back when he rallied for second after breaking, kicking home in a snappy 27 2/5. Then, he trotted a mile on Monday night that should have trip handicappers salivating. After leaving hard from post 10 and dropping in third early, he stayed in and he took a big shuffle around the last turn when the pocket sitter started to tire and backed up the horses that were following him. He was wheeled out wide turning for home and he ate up a lot of ground in the stretch to get close to the 3 to 5 favorite and the 2 to 1 second choice. He has really come on in his last two starts, and I especially like that he showed gate speed from the widest post tonight. He draws better tonight, and he gets top billing in this opening leg of tonight's 20-cent Pick 6.

#6 P L TALLADEGA didn't hit the board in any of his seven starts at two, but he did show some promise taking several cheques in the Grassroots division of the Ontario Sires Stakes. He looked sharp here on the morning of March 13th winning his qualifier, but the final margin was a bit misleading because as he was passing the leader, that one stopped abruptly causing confusion behind him and affecting the entire field except for this gelding. He got a driver switch from his trainer in the qualifier to catch driver Ratchford for his sophomore debut here on March 23rd, and after making front past the quarter then getting passes, he didn't stay put long. He re-moved to the front in the third quarter then saw it through on the lead to win as the 3 to 2 favorite. He missed a bit of time, but he should be a big threat here if he is sharp enough.

#9 THOR B GOOD was better than good in winning his pari-mutuel debut here on March 16th, trotting away from his rivals for a big win after he stole an opening half that was only one tick slower than 1:02. He hasn't raced since, but he did qualify here last Friday and he looked sharp. He is another contender in what should be a good betting race.

#4 THRUFIREANDFLAMES landed in the bottom of the Super in all of his first three starts this season then he drew widest in his fourth start, and he got too far back early. He draws much better tonight, and he is worth a look for the bottom of the exotics at a price tonight.

#5 AYEAYE CAPTAIN DEO makes his four-year-old debut here coming off a strong sophomore season where he earned more than \$231,000 on the strength of a 5-4-4 record from 19 starts. He was a Grand Circuit winner here in September and he took a lifetime mark of 1:49 2/5 in his third start of the season. He was ready to fire fresh winning all of his first three starts, and he comes into this race off a strong qualifier where he paced the final three quarters in 1:23 1/5. He draws perfectly here in his first start for a new barn and expecting that the leading driver will give him an aggressive steer, he gets top billing.

#1 SOS SPORTS BET is winless in four starts this season, but he has been good in both of his last two miles, only to face Get Wings, who is one of the sharpest horses on the grounds currently. He moves from the best post to the rail tonight which can mean that he may fall into a second-over trip after getting out sprinted leaving the gate. He has shown 26 and change closing speed in three of his four starts, and he can be a late threat in this spot tonight. He is the other one that I would consider for early multi-race tickets.

#3 FRANCO SANTANA N was flashing big speed then stopping last fall, and after being distanced on September 20th, he was put away for the year. He qualified twice for his seasonal debut, the latter mile being the much better of the two, and he added Lasix for that mile on March 21st. On that night, he set strong fractions on the lead, and he held off a rival that came back to win in a 4YO Open. He stepped up last week and he couldn't see it through on the engine. He could last longer tonight coming back in seven days, but I prefer to use him underneath in this spot tonight.

#9 RIPASSO dropped and popped here last week, notching his first win on Canadian soil in his 20th try since shipping north from the United States last September. He looked good motoring past the leaders in deep stretch, but he faces considerably tougher now. Still, he will likely be passing some horses late and I could see him sneaking into the Tri or Super at a price.

#9 LOUS WORLD got Mark Macdonald in the bike last week, and he produced a nice closing rush to get withing two and a quarter lengths of the best older pacers on the grounds. He kicked in 25 2/5, now he gets to take a class drop to a spot where he should be the boss. This looks like a race where Macdonald will blast off, make front early from his wide post, and go right down the road and this gelding gets top call in this opening leg of tonight's middle Pick 5 wager.

#2 JJ XAVIER raced in the \$30,000 to \$40,000 Claiming Handicap level in nine straight starts before stepping up to this level two starts back. In those nine miles, he took five wins, one second, one third, one fourth and one fifth. Two starts back, when he stepped up to this level, he faced classy dropper Pacino Hanover. Racing luck didn't go his way as he ended up providing perfect cover for that rival, and that was not a trip that was going to work for him. He raced well again at this level last week, motoring up from the back late, kicking in 26-flat to get third after trailing to the top of the stretch. He gets a much better post draw now, and he can be a threat tonight.

#8 GINGER TREE FINNY was a winner at tonight's class level two starts back where he got a heady drive from Louis-Phillipe Roy and came on late to take the victory. He stepped up last week, lost Roy and showed little, now he drops back down, and he gets leading driver James Macdonald with Roy opting for JJ Xavier. He is up against it starting from a wide draw, but I could see him getting a share in this spot.

#6 STONEBRIDGE HELIOS was live last week, a good indicator being him going off at 5 to 1 after closing no lower than 9 to 1 in any of his previous four starts. He dropped in for a tag, and he got an aggressive steer from Mark Macdonald that left no doubt. He steps up tonight and he loses Macdonald to Lous World, but he is sharp and he should contend for a share here.

#3 THIRTY SIX RED had a decent rookie season last year after getting a bit of a late start, taking two wins and three slices from eight starts, good for more than \$28,000 in earnings. Last Saturday, he got what should serve as a perfect tightener in for this first leg of the Ontario Spring Series. He trailed throughout racing on the wet track, but he found his best stride in the stretch, and he really flew late in the mile. Finishing off that mile in 26-flat should have him primed for a big effort tonight, and he should get a more aggressive steer this time. He gets top billing in this second start back.

#2 LUNAR SPORT took a mark of 1:54 late in his rookie season, and that is the fastest mark taken by any in this field. He qualified well for this sophomore debut, and he will likely look for the front early in this mile. If he gets left alone on the engine and can steal a breather, he might be very hard to pass in the lane. His speed makes him a dangerous gelding in this spot.

#5 TWIN B CABO has been consistent in his three starts this season, pacing in exactly 1:56 in each of that trio of miles. There is reason to believe that he will step forward tonight as he comes off two strong efforts leading up to this Spring Series. After closing for second behind a big winner two starts back, he raced in the same mile as the choice, and he beat that rival to the wire that night while gaining on the leaders in the closing strides of that mile. Starting from a good post tonight, I think he will get put into play at the start by driver Jody Jamieson, and he is the other one that I would consider using in the middle Pick 5.

#1 CALYPSO CREEK went a solid trip in defeat here on March 21st and despite getting roughed up after leaving from the 10-hole, he managed to stick around for a share. He was forced to make a three wide move passing the quarter to make front, then the one that he passed to take command retook the lead on the last turn. He was willing but softened up in the lane. Coming off that tough mile, he was given an easier trip last week, and he was a bit one paced in the lane. He lands in a spot here that should be easier, and he can land in the bottom of the Tri or Super.

#6 VERITY BLUE CHIP was driver Doug McNair's choice over Avyanna in this spot as he sticks with this mare that was a winner racing one class lower than tonight's in her first race of the season last week. She was impressive in victory that night, as she was bottled up on the inside until very late in that mile. When she finally found the room she needed, she absolutely flew through the final strides to catch a leader that looked like a wrapped up winner at the sixteenth pole. She can be sharper now with that start under her belt, and she gets the call to repeat as we kick off tonight's late Pick 5.

#8 AVYANNA comes off two 10th-place finishes in a row, but she has excuses for both of those miles where she finished last and it's just this simple: she drew the 10-hole facing the top older pacing mares on the grounds which is probably a higher class than where she will perform best – especially when she gets mired in the worst post. She gets both post and class relief tonight, and a quick glance at her past performances shows us that she was a winner five starts back which was the last time she raced this low. She gets Jody Jamieson in the bike tonight, and she should be the main threat to Verity Blue Chip.

#5 MADAM X made an uncharacteristic break in stride pointing to the front racing in the fog five starts back, but she has been very good in her subsequent four miles. Leading driver James Macdonald changed this mare's racing style after that break in stride, and it paid off with two second place finishes and an impressive closing win two starts back. Then, starting from the middle of the gate last week, she was once again pointed to the front, and this mare looked every bit a winner until the last few strides when Verity Blue Chip got airborne. I wonder if she will now try a closing style again after getting nailed on the wire. Either way, she should be good for a share in here.

#1 SORCHA SEELSTER has been closing from the back in all of her starts, and she came into last week's mile off a decent try racing in tonight's class where she closed to get fourth. She was better last week on the class drop, now she steps back up into a tougher spot. She will pass them all one of these nights, but I don't see it being tonight. She can close for a small share, however.

#5 BRUE HANOVER gets to race on a seven-day cycle for the first time in a few starts after getting picked off in the stretch last week. He did finish that race with a broken Buxton, although I'm not sure if that was the difference or not. Perhaps the pace was slowed down a bit too much as the pocket sitter turned into a 25 4/5 final quarter rocket. Drawing well and returning in a week, he gets top billing in this spot as we kick off tonight's late Pick 4 wager.

#6 BRUNO NO NO NO has been spectacular racing out of the Dave Menary barn since being bought by Pollack Racing Stable in January. He has taken wins in three of four starts and wasn't far behind stablemate Its Saturday Night in that one loss in the second leg of the New Holland Series. He couldn't be much sharper right now and he will likely be the main threat to stablemate Brue Hanover tonight.

#1 POSEIDON SEELSTER is sharp coming off a win over the top pick in here, but he got a perfect trip that likely won't get repeated tonight as he draws the rail and he almost surely will get out sprinted by the two Menary trainees leaving the gate. It seems likely that he will take a following trip in third or fourth and then stick around for a spot in the Tri or Super.

#9 CALICOJACK HANOVER came off a terrific four-year-old season where he took six wins and six seconds and earned close to \$325,000, his biggest win coming in the \$247,000 Final of the Charles Juravinski Memorial. He qualified well twice for his five-year-old debut, and he took some action at the windows, closing at 7 to 2. He was taken back off the gate, and the way the race played out, he really had no chance when you consider that he closed in 25 2/5 and couldn't pass any rivals. He should be better for that start, and he will now be forgotten by the wagering public moving to a wide post coming off that seventh-place finish. He is worth a look for the bottom of the exotics at what should be a square price.

#8 SUPERIOR DELIGHT was on a tremendous roll for a long time before she finally threw in a clunker on January 30th which then precipitated her getting some time off. She comes into this return race off a mediocre looking qualifier, but that should only help her price in this spot. I'll take a stab with her here expecting to get some value that will likely be gone next week if she is good tonight.

#6 UTOPIA BLUE CHIP hasn't hit the board since February 20th, but after winning her two previous starts in early February, her earnings from those wins forced her up into a class that isn't the best fit for her. She got to take a class drop last week, but she drew wide and she never entered contention. Now, she gets to take a double class drop and last time she raced in this non-winners of \$2,500 last four class on February 13th, she was an easy two-length winner. Starting from the best post tonight, she figures to be the one to beat.

#1 MADRID A was going well here in late February and early March then she was a lame scratch on March 13th. She wasn't close in her return race, then she raced a bit better last week when she dropped to this class. Making her third start back since that lame scratch, she can be better here, and she is one that I could see getting a good trip racing close to the front and sticking around for a share.

#4 TAMARA HANOVER got an aggressive steer here two starts back and she ended up sticking around for fourth. Last time, she deployed a closing style, and she could only get up to take the smallest cheque. She adds Lasix tonight, and she draws well, and she can be part of the exotics tonight.

#1 CARRERA SUNSET N has been consistent racing at the non-winners of \$9,000 last four level in that she has been doing her best and taking shares. She gets needed class relief tonight and she rarely gets bet, so she will likely offer a square price in here. Anticipating that she will get a good following trip starting from the rail, I'll give her a slight nod in what appears to be a wide-open race.

#2 STYLE FOR A MILE dropped from the Open class last time and not much went right for her in a strange mile where a rival set an insane pace to the three quarters then stopped in the lane. This mare gets class relief, and a key driver change to Doug McNair tonight. McNair has clicked at a 29% strike rate in 157 starts driving for trainer Kyle Fellows in the last calendar year, and he has a good chance to add to those stats here.

#3 HORIZON SEELSTER makes her 2026 debut coming off a solid qualifying effort on the morning of April 3rd and she comes off a great 2025 season where she took 10 wins and 15 slices from 42 starts and earned more than \$70,000. #8 FIRE CONTROL was terrific here two starts back coming off a popular win against non-winners of two the week before where he closed as the 3 to 5 favorite. Moving up in class and losing the leading driver, he was completely dismissed by the betting public, sent off at 25 to 1. Undaunted by that lack of respect, he produced by far the best mile of his 23-race career. He was pointed to the front leaving the gate from the best post, and he made front passing the quarter, but was immediately engaged by a rival that was coming into the mile on a four-race win streak. This gelding showed no interest in giving up the lead and laid down some serious fractions on route to a 1:51 1/5 win that represented a new lifetime mark by more than three seconds. He came back March 28th and after making a decision to get into the outer flow early, trip did not go his way as he ended up parked the route. He stayed game to the wire to get up for third, and he gets top billing here moving outside where he should get a better start.

#6 TWIN B COURAGEOUS got a driver change to Bob McClure last week for his third start of the season and he took some heavy action, getting bet down to 8 to 5. He raced well in defeat, but the winner was just too good. Drawing best here, he figures to be the main threat to Fire Control.

#9 TEN CARAT GARRETT won three of his last five starts here racing at Mohawk Park, and last week, owner /trainer Jim Whelan handed the lines to younger Whelan Mike, who engineered a winning trip, easily beating non-winners of two. He steps up here, but he is sharp, and he can be an exotics factor.

#1 ZEBS KRAFTY adds Lasix tonight coming off a mile where he was one paced in the stretch. He hasn't won a race since October of 2024, and he brings a 33-race losing streak to the track tonight. He does fit okay in here and he will likely use his potent gate speed to get position near the front leaving the gate. He can stick around for a share.

#3 MOVING ON OVER has been passing rivals in the back half in all of his recent starts and he finished fifth in all three of his most recent miles. He should be able to work his way into the bottom of the High-5 at a minimum, and he is probably a good one to use underneath.

C O N D I T I O N S A N D A L L O W A N C E S I N H A R N E S S R A C I N G - I M P O R T A N T T O K N O W

The conditions of a race determine whether a horse is eligible to enter. For example many races are restricted to horses that have won a certain number of races or a certain amount of money in a specified number of starts. Many races are restricted to horses entered to be "claimed" (offered for sale) at a specific price.

Allowances in the claiming price itself are given to colts and geldings, four-year-olds and younger and to mares, five-year-olds and younger.

The purpose of the allowance is to keep younger horses more competitive when racing against older and more experienced rivals. Mares are given extra consideration in claiming events because of their potential as broodmares.

The accompanying chart shows what the allowances are, but an example may make them easier to understand. The chart indicates that three-year-olds receive a 50% allowance in claiming races. This means that a three-year-old entered in a \$20,000 claiming race carries an actual claiming price of \$30,000 (50% higher).

C.P.M.A. Regulation Changes

Effective January 1st 2012
CPMA will be instituting several new rule changes with regards to the following pari-mutuel pools:

Pick Pools

- If there are no winners in any leg of a Pick N pool, the entire pool is refunded.
- If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners.
- A pool is no longer refunded if the 1st leg in the pool is cancelled or declared no contest.
- Pick-3: If at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: If at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.

EXPLANATION OF THE LASIX PROGRAM

After careful study and consultation with Ontario Horsemen's groups, racetrack operators and veterinarians, Agriculture Canada and the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario passed legislation allowing the controlled (or supervised) administration of furosemide, more commonly called "Lasix". "Lasix" is used to alleviate the symptoms of exercise induced pulmonary hemorrhaging in racing horses. Horses will undergo an endoscopic examination of the trachea by a veterinarian licensed by the Ontario Racing Commission and endorsed by an official veterinarian before being allowed on the medication list. Once qualified, horses will be treated with "Lasix" within four hours plus or minus 15 minutes of a scheduled race in a secure retention area under the super vision of racing officials.

All horses on "Lasix" must remain on the program for a minimum of 100 days while racing in this jurisdiction.

RULES AND INFORMATION REGARDING CANADIAN HARNESS AND FOREIGN SEPARATE POOL EVENTS

GENERAL

All pari-mutuel pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with the regulations and directives as issued by Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada ("the Regulations"), under the approval and supervision of the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency. The Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency can be contacted at 1-800-268-8835 or 613-759-6100 or Email: cpmawebacpm@agr.gc.ca. A complete version of the CPMA regulations can be found at <http://laws-lois.justice.gc.ca/eng/regulations/SOR-91-385/>.

All tickets should be held until the result of the race is declared official and prices are posted.

No person under the age of 18 shall purchase or cash a ticket or voucher.

A claim of receiving an incorrect payment or incorrect change must be made to the Mutuel office of the association within twenty four hours of buying or cashing a valid ticket or voucher.

No ruling made by the Stewards/Judges or the Ontario Racing Commission with regard to distribution of purse money or the placing of horses in the order of finish, after the race has been declared official, shall have any bearing on the pay-out prices or distribution of pari-mutuel pools.

Change boards and Photo Finish display monitors are located in the Grandstand. In addition, Photo Finish pictures are shown on the closed-circuit television system. Customers are reminded that mutuel clerks are responsible for all shortages. When making a wager, customers must present sufficient funds at the time of purchase to cover the wagers requested.

ENTRIES AND MUTUEL FIELDS

"Entry" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled or considered as the same betting interest. The most common reason for the coupling of horses in an Entry is the fact that they are owned by the same person.

"Mutuel Field" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled because the number of horses in the race exceeds the number which can be handled separately by the pari-mutuel system. Subject to the Regulations, a bet on one horse of an Entry or Mutuel Field shall be considered a bet on all horses in that Entry or Mutuel Field.

DAILY DOUBLE BETTING (INCLUDING LATE DOUBLE)

A Daily Double bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of the two races specified for the Daily Double. Tickets not selecting the winner of the first half of the Daily Double and all tickets in the second half of the Daily Double not coupled with the declared official winner of the first half of the Daily Double are not winners and are not refunded no matter what circumstances affect the running of the second half of the Daily Double.

Should a horse or horses (not coupled with another starter) be excused from starting in the second race of the Daily Double after the first race of the Daily Double has closed for betting, holders of all Daily Double tickets on such horses, coupled with the winner of the first Daily Double race, shall participate in a Consolation Double pool. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

EXACTA (Also known as Exactor)/TRIFECTA (Also known as Tractor)/SUPERFECTA

An Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first two, three and four horses respectively, representing different betting interests to finish in the exact official order of finish, in the race on which the pool is operated.

SWINGER (Also known as OMN)

A Swinger is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select horses to finish in any order from the official first 3 positions.

JACKPOT HI-5

A Jackpot Hi-5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners in the specified Jackpot Hi-5 race. If there are races that have an entry, (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B), Jackpot Hi-5 will not offer a wager consisting of both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in a Jackpot Hi-5, the payout would be 1st, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th.

That jackpot portion of the pool will only be paid out if there is a single winning ticket. If there are multiple winning tickets that have correctly chosen the first 5 runners of the race, they will receive 50% of the pool for that day. The other 50% will go over into the Jackpot carryover. If there are no winning tickets with the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners, 100% of the current day's pool will be carried over into the Jackpot.

PICK 3 & PICK-4 BETTING

The Pick 3 & Pick 4 bets are betting transactions in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of three or four successive races specified for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 respectively.

Winning tickets for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 are determined in the following sequence: A) winners of all legs, B) most winners, then refund. If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners. If there are no winners in any leg of a pool, the entire pool is refunded.

PICK 5 BETTING

The Pick 5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of five successive races specified for the Pick 5 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 5 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 5.

PICK 6 BETTING

The Pick 6 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of six successive races specified for the Pick 6 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 6 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 6.

PICK 5 & 6 BETTING

If at least 1 race as part of the Pick 5 or 6 has been cancelled or declared "No contest", but not more than the specified below under Refunds, the net pool shall be distributed to those selecting the most # of winners and NOT include any carryover from a previous pool.

PICK 3, PICK 4, PICK 5 & PICK 6 SCRATCHES

In the event a Pick 3, Pick 4, Pick 5 or Pick 6 ticket designates as a selection a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the Stewards/Judges to be a non-starter in any of the races comprising the Pick 3, Pick 4, Pick 5 or Pick 6 the favourite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection. In the event that the money bet in the win pool for two or more favourites is identical, the selection with the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non-starting selection.

However, if a scratch occurs in any leg of the Pick 3, Pick 4, Pick 5 or Pick 6 pools before the pool is closed, a ticket including the scratched horse may be cancelled.

REFUNDS

Subject to the Regulations, all monies in all pools on a race are refunded in the event that the race is cancelled, declared off or declared no contest, and all monies bet on a horse are refunded if the horse is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start. These refunds will be communicated to the public through various means such as betting terminals, video display, changes boards and our website.

The Pick(n) pool shall be cancelled and all Pick(n) wagers for the individual performance shall be refunded if:

- Pick-3: at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

Where a horse that is part of an Entry is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start and at least one horse of that Entry receives a fair start in the race, all tickets purchased on the Entry remain valid and the purchase price of any such ticket shall not be refunded.

COMMON POOL WAGERING (INTERTRACK BETTING)

In the unlikely event of a communications or computer system failure that prevents pools from merging with the host track's pools before the end of a race, CPMA regulations require that the site must refund all tickets for that race. This refund will be communicated to the public through various means such as video displays, change boards and messages on our website.

FAIR START

If a horse has reached the Fair Start Pole (located 200 feet before the Starting Pole) by the time the mobile gate has reached the Starting Pole, that horse is deemed to have had a fair start. It makes no difference whether or not the horse is on or off stride at that precise moment. Under current policy and regulations, which are designed to be as fair as possible to all bettors on all starters, there is no Recall - a repeat of the entire starting procedure - when a horse does not reach the Fair Start Pole before the gate reaches the Starting Pole. Monies bet on such a horse are refunded in accordance with the regulation concerning refunds.

LOST & OLD TICKETS

WEG issued tickets or vouchers are valid indefinitely, however, they cannot be cashed at a mutuel teller after 2 years from date of issue. Please mail tickets, along with your name and address, to Mutuel Manager, P.O. Box 156, Rexdale, Ontario, M9W 5L2, keeping a photocopy for future reference.

For "Lost Tickets" originally sold at a Woodbine Entertainment Group racetrack or Teletheatre, please enquire at the Mutuel office at Woodbine, Greenwood Teletheatre, or Mohawk. Policy may be subject to change retroactively in the event regulatory bodies amend existing regulations.

ASSOCIATION PERCENTAGE, AND TAXATION/LEVY

The Woodbine Entertainment Group deducts and retains the following percentages from wagers placed at our own licensed sites which are then shared with the horsepeople, host and simulcast associations and the Ontario Racing Commission.

WOODBINE/MOHAWK LIVE: Win, Place & Show: 13.65%. Swinger 14.7%. Trifecta & Pick 4: 21.7%. Double & Exacta 17.2%. Jackpot Hi-5, Pick 5 & Pick 6: 11.7%. All other 23.0%

Horsepeople receive a further 2% on all wagers, except Trifecta wagering where it is 4%. The Ontario Provincial Government retains 0.5% on all bets placed in Ontario. The Canadian Government (through a revolving fund cost recovery basis) retains 0.8% on all wagers placed in Canada for provision of drug control, and audit services.
