Betting Basics

Some essentials to get you started with making a wager.

1 How to wager



Place your bet by visiting a teller, or using a self-serve terminal.

To place a bet here are just 5 things you need to know:

- 1 Name of racetrack (choose from any track in the simulcast feeds)
- 2 Number of the race
- 3 Amount of your bet (e.g. \$2)
- 4 Type of bet (see step 2)
- 5 Horse's number (see step 4)

Once you have decided what you want to bet, head to the nearest seller's window and use the sample statement as your guide:

Hello, (Racetrack), race 6, \$2 to WIN on Horse #4

How to use a self-serve terminal:

- 1 Swipe your Cash Card/Insert Cash
- 2 Enter the initial PIN #1234 (then choose a new PIN)
- 3 Press/Tap the track you would like to bet: (defaults to current race)
- 4 Tap the Horse Number: **#4**
- 5 Press/Tap the Bet Type: **WIN**
- 6 Press/Tap the Bet Amount: **\$2**
- 7 Press/Tap the Race Number: **Race #6**
- 8 Press Green **"Make BET"** button
- 9 Press/Tap the **"Finish with Receipt"** button
- 10 Be sure to check your ticket to confirm it's the bet you wanted

To get a Cash Card or for assistance ask a teller, or a staff member.

2 Types of bets



Single horse bets (minimum \$2.00 bet is required)

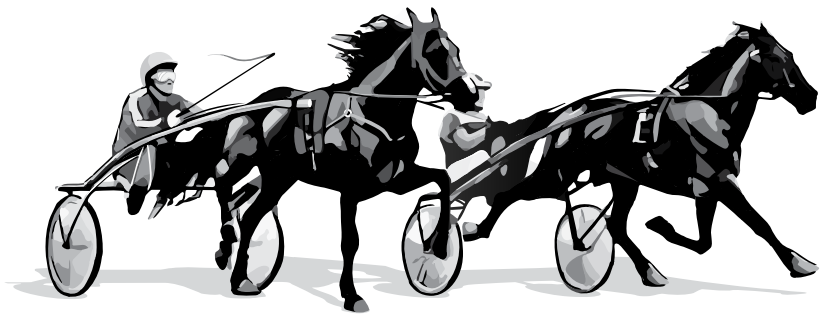
Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Win	U U U	Your horse must finish 1st; payoff determined by the win odds.
Place	U U	Your horse must finish 1st or 2nd; payoffs better than to show.
Show	U	Your horse must finish 1st, 2nd, or 3rd; modest payoffs.

Exotic multiple-horse bets

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Exacta*	U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st and 2nd in exact order; riskier bet that can pay a little or a lot, depending on the horses' odds.
Daily double	U U U U U	Pick the winners of two designated consecutive races.
Pick 3, Win 4, Pick 5, Pick 6	U U U U U U	Select the winners of a designated set of consecutive races. The wager must be made prior to the start of the first race in the multi-race wager.
Triactor*	U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in exact order; can be expensive to play if you use a lot of horses.
Superfecta*	U U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th; big payoff possible.

* Exotic bets require the horses to finish in the EXACT order you select, unless you "BOX" the bet, in which case your selections can finish in any order.

All of the numbers and letters in the program might seem confusing or overwhelming at first, but focusing on these sections makes choosing a horse simple.

- 1 Horse's number in the race
- 2 Horse's post position colour
- 3 Horse's colour, sex, age, sire (father), dam (mother), sire of the dam
- 4 Morning line odds
- 5 Horse's name
- 6 Driver and Driver Record (Name, # of wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, winning %)
- 7 Trainer information
- 8 Horse's Lifetime record (with best win time, track size, track, age, lifetime wins and lifetime earnings)
- 9 Horse's current record (# of races, # wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, and money earned)

4 The odds



Odds are also important to consider when choosing your horse. Horses that are thought to have a better chance of winning will typically have lower odds.

Morning line odds

Odds listed in the race program are the "morning line" odds. These are predictions of how the public will bet on the race. They are set by the track's handicapper when the race program is published, before the wagering starts.

The actual odds will be posted on the **Television** or in-field on the **Tote Board** before the race; they change up until post time, depending on how customers are betting on each horse in the race.

Calculating a \$2 win prize

To calculate a win prize, find the Odds of a horse on the **Television** or **Tote Board** (in-field board).

Multiply the first number by 2, then divide that number by the second digit (if there is one), and then add \$2. Simple as that!

Odds	1/2	2/1	7/2	5/1	10/1
Pays	\$3.00	\$6.00	\$9.00	\$12.00	\$22.00

Helpful facts for betting

- Some racetracks have a television simulcast commentator who tries to identify winning horses (handicaps) between the races. Listen and see if you can pick up any good tips to bet on.
- A good betting method is to choose horses with current odds two to three times higher than their morning line odds.

3 Tips to remember

WIN BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 32% of the time
PLACE BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 53% of the time
SHOW BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 67% of the time

Race 1 Selections

The Horseplayer's Journal by Garnet Barnsdale

#1 LANDING ON TIME won early at two in 2024, taking a 1:56 4/5 victory in his debut which was a strong first-over effort finished off with a 27 4/5 kicker. From there, he spent most of the season racing in Kentucky Sires Stakes, taking a few shares along the way. He once again showed that he fires fresh when he took victories in both of his first two starts last season. He went on to take a mark of 1:51 1/5 later in the year which is the fastest mark in this field. Trainer Zeron has been sending them ready this spring and this son of Tactical Landing gets top billing in this opening leg of tonight's \$75,000 guaranteed Pick 5.

#8 DEBRA took a win against non-winners of three four starts back then she stepped up to face tough classy rivals such as Willys Home Run, Ghostly Casper and Osceola, and she landed in the top three in every one of those miles. She has the gate speed to get away in the top three or four here, and she has some upset potential in this spot.

#4 SEEKING SALVATION has been racing on the lead in recent miles and in some of them accepting a pocket ride and sticking around for shares. He gets aggressive Mark Macdonald tonight, so the strategy at the start of the race likely won't change. He can take another share tonight.

#2 JAYPORT CASH was bet down to 9 to 5 favorite last week, and he worked out a great trip to eventually win going away. After leaving well enough to drop in third early, he sat in past the half then he managed to get off the pylons and latch onto some live cover that carried him to where he needed to be to pounce in the stretch and take his second win of the season in his thirteenth start. He steps up now and I'm not sure he can get the same kind of racing luck in this spot. I'll use him on the bottom tonight.

#9 GLORYVIEW IMAGE made a start against a decent \$10,000 claiming field on April 2nd, when coming off a two-and-a-half month break, and starting from a wide post racing in the fog, he didn't show much. He showed up here four days later in an easier spot, and he was bet like he couldn't lose, closing at even money. The ample action that he got coming off that seventh place finish at Flamboro Downs where he closed at 49 to 1 was accurate. Trevor Henry blasted him off the gate and went right down the road for a season's best 1:53 1/5 score. He doubled up in the opening leg of a Pop Up series capitalizing on a pocket trip where he didn't need to leave the pylons, once again winning as the even money favorite. Last week he was in tougher and he perhaps went too fast, too soon in that mile. He fits well in this spot, and he gets the nod to rebound here.

#7 BAYFIELD BEACH is only 1 for 14 so far this season, and he has only one second place finish to go along with that win, but that runner up spot was earned last week when he finished ahead of the top pick here. In that mile, he started out second, then he made an early move to the front before being overtaken by Gloryview Image. He followed that rival to the lane, and he angled out of the pocket in mid stretch and passed late to get second. This race could line up the same, and this gelding can be a threat from the pocket.

#1 TITANIC HANOVER had a tough trip last week. After getting a slow start, he followed a horse that struggled to keep up in the opening quarter and then broke in front of him, and that put him a few more lengths behind. He eventually caught up to the leaders, and he rallied decently to get up for fourth. He can get a better trip tonight and land in the bottom of the exotics.

#4 FOREFATHER can appear to be tricky to drive at times, but he can produce a strong closing move on his best night. He gets back on a seven-day cycle tonight and he draws better, so there is a good chance that he will improve in this spot. He is worth a look when constructing Tri and Super bets.

#3 CHIC CHOC ROSE has only one win so far this season, but that lone victory did come when she was racing at a higher class level. She found her best stride in deep stretch two starts back, and she closed late to get the smallest cheque. Last week, she was expected to be even better dropping one class level, but she was just okay, although she did finish the mile racing with a broken headpole. Dropping again tonight gives her a chance to turn things around and she gets top billing in this opening leg of tonight's early Pick 4.

#9 DJIMON was good early in the season last year, he came within a head of beating a much better field than he faces here in his second start of 2025. He gets into a spot here where he should be able to do some damage in this initial start of 2026 as this is the lowest class he will race in for a couple of years. His qualifier preparing for this seasonal debut was decent, and I think he gets sent forward leaving the gate by Billy Davis Jr. If he clears to the front, he could lead all the way here.

#8 P L SAPPHIRE is another that gets in easier here, exiting non-winners of four miles where she has been facing the likes of Eurobank Hanover and Mr Walner Fashion, both of whom who have been hot recently. She tried racing first up against 1 to 5 Eurobank last week, and that didn't work out so well. She should improve enough on the class drop that she can be and exotics factor tonight.

#7 MISTER MAGIC has now been part of the Superfecta in all his last 12 starts while already earning more than \$34,000 this season racing exclusively in this \$20,000 optional claiming class. He has taken only one win in his last 32 starts, however, and that streak isn't likely to get broken tonight facing the class droppers. He will likely produce his typical solid effort, though, and he can extend the Superfecta streak.

#10 BETTER BE GOING was bet like he couldn't lose last time, getting sent off as the 3 to 5 favorite, and he didn't disappoint favorite bettors. He got an uber aggressive drive from James Macdonald, tearing through a 54-flat opening half and a 1:22 2/5 three quarters, basically exhausting his rivals who tried to keep up to him. He draws widest now, but he gets Mark Macdonald in the bike, and he will surely look to clear to the front with him. I'm nit sure how many of those kinds of miles he has in him, but he can be good for one more and he gets top call in this first leg of tonight's 20-cent Pick 6.

#4 CANT STOP LOU made a power move to the top on the backstretch four starts back and he paced a 27 2/5 third frame to keep first-over 6 to 5 favorite Seriously Hanover at bay. He then dug in down the lane to keep his lead and pace to his first victory of the season in his ninth try. Coming off that impressive mile he stepped up in class, and he raced well again, but he was chased down by the favorite after setting some strong fractions. Then, he met up with Better Be Going and he simply got paced off his feet that night. He came right back to notch an impressive win last week when Better Be Going sat idle, and he has a recency edge on that rival tonight. He is the logical alternative to the top pick here.

#3 VERTICAL SQUIRT went to Flamboro Downs, and he turned his form around winning two straight, but he was set back last week for causing interference when he was attempting to clear to the front passing the half. He gets Louis-Phillipe Roy back in the bike tonight, and he draws inside. I can see him getting a following trip and landing in the Tri tonight.

#5 BELMONT BLAZER moved from a conditioned claimer to a claiming handicap last week, and he raced okay, closing for fourth. He draws better now, and he can be closer to the front early in this mile. He should be able to work his way into the Super for a third start in a row.

He made a move on the backstretch to issue a challenge for the lead, and Osceola pulled at about the same time, and this gelding was moving so fast that he had no choice but to pull three-wide. He then broke stride and there was a very lengthy inquiry on Osceola, but no change was made. He gets back in the same class here, and although he faces some class droppers, this is a field that he can beat if he gets a clean trip. I'll give him the nod here.

#3 PERFETTO is a war horse millionaire who last week came out of a race where he had little chance drawing worst and facing much better horses that night two weeks ago when he started from the 10-hole. He was much better last week, setting the pace to deep stretch where he was eventually picked off by a tripped out rival. He can be a speed threat again tonight, and he is worth a look for early multi-race tickets.

#8 MONALISHI was outstanding at two and three, earning close to \$1 million while winning Breeders Crown races and finishing third in last year's Breeder's Crown. She is obviously a high quality mare, and she looks ready for this four-year-old debut, but this is no easy spot facing some older male trotters. I'm inclined to give her one, but I can see her closing for a slice.

#7 SOUTHWIND DOMINO was racing well in Pop Up series before stepping up to face millionaire Ghostly Casper last week where he was sent off at 126 to 1 and raced just evenly. Getting a class drop tonight, he should be better, and he will likely get a more alert start and race closer to the front throughout. He is one to consider for the bottom of the exotics.

He was chasing his class dropping stablemate around the track that night and that one was being driven by this gelding's regular pilot, Travis Cullen. He gets Cullen back tonight and he gets a key class drop tonight. Last time he raced this low, he took his only win of the season so far, and he was sent off as the 4 to 5 favorite that night. He gets the nod here in a spot where he should improve sharply as we kick off tonight's late Pick 5.

#5 TYGA HANOVER is another one in here that gets some class relief tonight, and he gets a great post to work from and aggressive teamster Mark Macdonald in the bike tonight. He was good here last May, taking a 1:51 3/5 three-length win over \$40,000 optional claimers. Making his fifth start of the season here, it's possible that he will get sent on a speed mission by Macdonald and he could lead these all the way.

#6 BEACHIN LINDY raced much better two starts back after breaking stride in his previous start. He motored up from the back of the pack to get up for third in a good effort, then last week, he was in a mile that was simply too fast for him to close into. I don't see anyone in here pacing a sub-1:51 mile tonight, and this veteran gelding has a better chance to get a share this week.

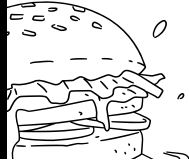

#10 CODE CRACKER has been in tough recently, chasing Stonebridge Helios around the racetrack in both his last two starts and prior to that facing class dropper Pacino Hanover. He is up against it starting from the 10-hole tonight, but he has the gate speed to blast off from out there and he is worth a look on the class drop at what should be a good price.

#6 STORM SHADOW was pacing in 1:50 flat when last seen here racing at Mohawk Park, so we know he is fast enough to go with these. He qualified okay here on April 17th, but he hasn't won a race since August 2024, although he did face much tougher than tonight's opponents in many of his miles last year. He is in with a shot in this 2026 debut.

#7 EARLY ACTION was a winner here three starts back but he got set back to second for a pylon violation. He stepped up on April 12th, and he got out sprinted early in a wicked 25 4/5 opening quarter. #5 LOGAN PARK had another outstanding season as a seven-year-old last year, taking eight wins from 19 starts while earning close to \$288,000. He looks well prepared for this first start at eight and there is no concern with him racing off the shelf when you consider that he won his first start of the season in the past three years, last year handling a Preferred Trot field easily. Locally, he is The Man until he isn't, and this is a field he should beat but you likely won't get much of a price.

#8 OSCEOLA is another classy veteran that last week came off a productive five-year-old season where he took six wins and four other top two finishes from 20 starts while earning more than \$162,000. He was all business in his lone qualifier preparing for this seasonal debut here on the morning of April 11th leading every step and powering away from the field with a snappy 27 2/5 kicker to finish off the mile. Regular pilot Doug McNair drove him patiently last week, waiting to the last turn to move first-over and he eventually got the job done. He had to survive a lengthy inquiry before getting his picture taken. He is capable of improving off that season opener, and he can be an Exacta factor tonight.

#1 GHOSTLY CASPER is a newly minted millionaire that couldn't be going much better right now. He comes in on a three-race win streak having stepped up to this top level where he got the job done racing tough first-over last week. He steps into the lion's den now facing Logan Park, and if that rival brings close to his A game, they will likely all be racing for second tonight.

#7 MR BLUEBIRD amazingly has been part of the Super in 28 straight starts and although he faces some tougher rivals tonight, there is a very good chance that he will be able to extend that impressive streak. His versatility is one of his biggest assets and he can land another share tonight.

#7 LIVINTHEBEACHLIFE came off the shelf four starts back and raced at the bottom of the conditions, and he was ready to pace a 1:52 mile right away. That was bad news for his non-winners of \$1,000 last four rivals as he was a game winner over class dropper Legion Seelster. He then stepped up where he drew a wide post and he raced just evenly. He showed in Leg 1 that he is a good fit in this Popup series when he went right down the road as the 2 to 5 favorite. I thought he faced some tougher rivals last week, but he was faster and better, and he stands out in this Final where he will likely close as a big favorite again tonight.

#3 THAI TOUR turned his form around three starts back when his odds dropped from 37 to 1 the week before to 6 to 5. He left no doubt that night, making front in the second quarter then pacing away to an open-length win. Then in Leg 1 of this series, he was given a perfect steer by leading driver Macdonald, and he had dead aim on the leader in the stretch, but that rival had enough left to fight him off. Last week in Leg 2, he was driven more aggressively, and he converted as the odds-on choice. He is the logical alternative to Livinthebeachlife.

#9 SOUTHSIDE EDDY got good three starts back where he dropped to the bottom level to take his first win of the season. He was a game winner in Leg 1 of this season, then he was no match for Livinthebeachlife last week. He will likely get positioned close to the front early tonight and stick around for a share.

#2 SAULSBROOK IAN should get a spot in mid pack early, probably take an inside following trip then reemerge in the lane and work his way into the top four. He is worth a look for use on the bottom of the Tri and Super.

#10 SKYLAR has been racing well and passing horses late for several weeks, and he will likely be coming from far back tonight, but I could see him passing a few of them and sneaking into the bottom of the exotics.

CONDITIONS AND ALLOWANCES IN HARNESS RACING - IMPORTANT TO KNOW

The conditions of a race determine whether a horse is eligible to enter. For example many races are restricted to horses that have won a certain number of races or a certain amount of money in a specified number of starts. Many races are restricted to horses entered to be "claimed" (offered for sale) at a specific price.

Allowances in the claiming price itself are given to colts and geldings, four-year-olds and younger and to mares, five-year-olds and younger.

The purpose of the allowance is to keep younger horses more competitive when racing against older and more experienced rivals. Mares are given extra consideration in claiming events because of their potential as broodmares.

The accompanying chart shows what the allowances are, but an example may make them easier to understand. The chart indicates that three-year-olds receive a 50% allowance in claiming races. This means that a three-year-old entered in a \$20,000 claiming race carries an actual claiming price of \$30,000 (50% higher).

Fillies and mares receive an additional 25% allowance in claiming races. Details of the race conditions and claiming price (if any) are given at the top of each race in the program.

ALLOWANCES FOR PURSE EARNINGS

When Fillies/Mares compete against Colts/Geldings (normally on the trot) Fillies/Mares will receive an additional 25% on the condition of the race. ie: nw \$5,000 (FM \$6,250) last 5 or \$12,000 (FM \$15,000) last 10 starts.

C.P.M.A. Regulation Changes

Effective January 1st 2012
CPMA will be instituting several new rule changes with regards to the following pari-mutuel pools:

Pick Pools

- If there are no winners in any leg of a Pick N pool, the entire pool is refunded.
- If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners.
- A pool is no longer refunded if the 1st leg in the pool is cancelled or declared no contest.
- Pick-3: If at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: If at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.

EXPLANATION OF THE LASIX PROGRAM

After careful study and consultation with Ontario Horsemen's groups, racetrack operators and veterinarians, Agriculture Canada and the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario passed legislation allowing the controlled (or supervised) administration of furosemide, more commonly called "Lasix". "Lasix" is used to alleviate the symptoms of exercise induced pulmonary hemorrhaging in racing horses. Horses will undergo an endoscopic examination of the trachea by a veterinarian licensed by the Ontario Racing Commission and endorsed by an official veterinarian before being allowed on the medication list. Once qualified, horses will be treated with "Lasix" within four hours plus or minus 15 minutes of a scheduled race in a secure retention area under the super vision of racing officials.

All horses on "Lasix" must remain on the program for a minimum of 100 days while racing in this jurisdiction.

- (L)** Denotes horses treated with Lasix for their last start but not so treated today.

RULES AND INFORMATION REGARDING CANADIAN HARNESS AND FOREIGN SEPARATE POOL EVENTS

GENERAL

All pari-mutuel pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with the regulations and directives as issued by Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada ("the Regulations"), under the approval and supervision of the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency. The Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency can be contacted at 1-800-268-8835 or 613-759-6100 or Email: cpmawebacpm@agr.gc.ca. A complete version of the CPMA regulations can be found at <http://laws-lois.justice.gc.ca/eng/regulations/SOR-91-385/>.

All tickets should be held until the result of the race is declared official and prices are posted.

No person under the age of 18 shall purchase or cash a ticket or voucher.

A claim of receiving an incorrect payment or incorrect change must be made to the Mutuel office of the association within twenty four hours of buying or cashing a valid ticket or voucher.

No ruling made by the Stewards/Judges or the Ontario Racing Commission with regard to distribution of purse money or the placing of horses in the order of finish, after the race has been declared official, shall have any bearing on the pay-out prices or distribution of pari-mutuel pools.

Change boards and Photo Finish display monitors are located in the Grandstand. In addition, Photo Finish pictures are shown on the closed-circuit television system. Customers are reminded that mutuel clerks are responsible for all shortages. When making a wager, customers must present sufficient funds at the time of purchase to cover the wagers requested.

ENTRIES AND MUTUEL FIELDS

"Entry" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled or considered as the same betting interest. The most common reason for the coupling of horses in an Entry is the fact that they are owned by the same person.

"Mutuel Field" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled because the number of horses in the race exceeds the number which can be handled separately by the pari-mutuel system. Subject to the Regulations, a bet on one horse of an Entry or Mutuel Field shall be considered a bet on all horses in that Entry or Mutuel Field.

DAILY DOUBLE BETTING (INCLUDING LATE DOUBLE)

A Daily Double bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of the two races specified for the Daily Double. Tickets not selecting the winner of the first half of the Daily Double and all tickets in the second half of the Daily Double not coupled with the declared official winner of the first half of the Daily Double are not winners and are not refunded no matter what circumstances affect the running of the second half of the Daily Double.

Should a horse or horses (not coupled with another starter) be excused from starting in the second race of the Daily Double after the first race of the Daily Double has closed for betting, holders of all Daily Double tickets on such horses, coupled with the winner of the first Daily Double race, shall participate in a Consolation Double pool. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

EXACTA (Also known as Exactor)/TRIFECTA (Also known as Trifactor)/SUPERFECTA

An Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first two, three and four horses respectively, representing different betting interests to finish in the exact official order of finish, in the race on which the pool is operated.

SWINGER (Also known as OMN)

A Swinger is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select horses to finish in any order from the official first 3 positions.

JACKPOT HI-5

A Jackpot Hi-5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners in the specified Jackpot Hi-5 race. If there are races that have an entry, (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B), Jackpot Hi-5 will not offer a wager consisting of both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in a Jackpot Hi-5, the payout would be 1st, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th.

That jackpot portion of the pool will only be paid out if there is a single winning ticket. If there are multiple winning tickets that have correctly chosen the first 5 runners of the race, they will receive 50% of the pool for that day. The other 50% will go over into the Jackpot carryover. If there are no winning tickets with the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners, 100% of the current day's pool will be carried over into the Jackpot.

PICK 3 & PICK-4 BETTING

The Pick 3 & Pick 4 bets are betting transactions in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of three or four successive races specified for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 respectively.

Winning tickets for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 are determined in the following sequence: A) winners of all legs, B) most winners, then refund. If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners. If there are no winners in any leg of a pool, the entire pool is refunded.

PICK 5 BETTING

The Pick 5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of five successive races specified for the Pick 5 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 5 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 5.

PICK 6 BETTING

The Pick 6 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of six successive races specified for the Pick 6 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 6 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 6.

PICK 5 & 6 BETTING

If at least 1 race as part of the Pick 5 or 6 has been cancelled or declared "No contest", but not more than the specified below under Refunds, the net pool shall be distributed to those selecting the most # of winners and NOT include any carryover from a previous pool.

PICK 3, PICK 4, PICK 5 & PICK 6 SCRATCHES

In the event a Pick 3, Pick 4, Pick 5 or Pick 6 ticket designates as a selection a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the Stewards/Judges to be a non-starter in any of the races comprising the Pick 3, Pick 4, Pick 5 or Pick 6 the favourite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection. In the event that the money bet in the win pool for two or more favourites is identical, the selection with the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non-starting selection.

However, if a scratch occurs in any leg of the Pick 3, Pick 4, Pick 5 or Pick 6 pools before the pool is closed, a ticket including the scratched horse may be cancelled.

REFUNDS

Subject to the Regulations, all monies in all pools on a race are refunded in the event that the race is cancelled, declared off or declared no contest, and all monies bet on a horse are refunded if the horse is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start. These refunds will be communicated to the public through various means such as betting terminals, video display, changes boards and our website.

The Pick(n) pool shall be cancelled and all Pick(n) wagers for the individual performance shall be refunded if:

- Pick-3: at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

Where a horse that is part of an Entry is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start and at least one horse of that Entry receives a fair start in the race, all tickets purchased on the Entry remain valid and the purchase price of any such ticket shall not be refunded.

COMMON POOL WAGERING (INTERTRACK BETTING)

In the unlikely event of a communications or computer system failure that prevents pools from merging with the host track's pools before the end of a race, CPMA regulations require that the site must refund all tickets for that race. This refund will be communicated to the public through various means such as video displays, change boards and messages on our website.

FAIR START

If a horse has reached the Fair Start Pole (located 200 feet before the Starting Pole) by the time the mobile gate has reached the Starting Pole, that horse is deemed to have had a fair start. It makes no difference whether or not the horse is on or off stride at that precise moment. Under current policy and regulations, which are designed to be as fair as possible to all bettors on all starters, there is no Recall - a repeat of the entire starting procedure - when a horse does not reach the Fair Start Pole before the gate reaches the Starting Pole. Monies bet on such a horse are refunded in accordance with the regulation concerning refunds.

LOST & OLD TICKETS

WEG issued tickets or vouchers are valid indefinitely, however, they cannot be cashed at a mutuel teller after 2 years from date of issue. Please mail tickets, along with your name and address, to Mutuel Manager, P.O. Box 156, Rexdale, Ontario, M9W 5L2, keeping a photocopy for future reference.

For "Lost Tickets" originally sold at a Woodbine Entertainment Group racetrack or Teletheatre, please enquire at the Mutuel office at Woodbine, Greenwood Teletheatre, or Mohawk. Policy may be subject to change retroactively in the event regulatory bodies amend existing regulations.

ASSOCIATION PERCENTAGE, AND TAXATION/LEVY

The Woodbine Entertainment Group deducts and retains the following percentages from wagers placed at our own licensed sites which are then shared with the horsepeople, host and simulcast associations and the Ontario Racing Commission.

WOODBINE/MOHAWK LIVE: Win, Place & Show: 13.65%. Swinger 14.7%. Trifecta & Pick 4: 21.7%. Double & Exacta 17.2%. Jackpot Hi-5, Pick 5 & Pick 6: 11.7%. All other 23.0%

Horsepeople receive a further 2% on all wagers, except Trifecta wagering where it is 4%. The Ontario Provincial Government retains 0.5% on all bets placed in Ontario. The Canadian Government (through a revolving fund cost recovery basis) retains 0.8% on all wagers placed in Canada for provision of drug control, and audit services.
