Betting Basics

Some essentials to get you started with making a wager.

1 How to wager



Place your bet by visiting a teller, or using a self-serve terminal.

To place a bet here are just 5 things you need to know:

- 1 Name of racetrack (choose from any track in the simulcast feeds)
- 2 Number of the race
- 3 Amount of your bet (e.g. \$2)
- 4 Type of bet (see step 2)
- 5 Horse's number (see step 4)

Once you have decided what you want to bet, head to the nearest seller's window and use the sample statement as your guide:

Hello, (Racetrack), race 6, \$2 to WIN on Horse #4

How to use a self-serve terminal:

- 1 Swipe your Cash Card/Insert Cash
- 2 Enter the initial PIN #1234 (then choose a new PIN)
- 3 Press/Tap the track you would like to bet: (defaults to current race)
- 4 Tap the Horse Number: **#4**
- 5 Press/Tap the Bet Type: **WIN**
- 6 Press/Tap the Bet Amount: **\$2**
- 7 Press/Tap the Race Number: **Race #6**
- 8 Press Green **"Make BET"** button
- 9 Press/Tap the **"Finish with Receipt"** button
- 10 Be sure to check your ticket to confirm it's the bet you wanted

To get a Cash Card or for assistance ask a teller, or a staff member.

2 Types of bets



Single horse bets (minimum \$2.00 bet is required)

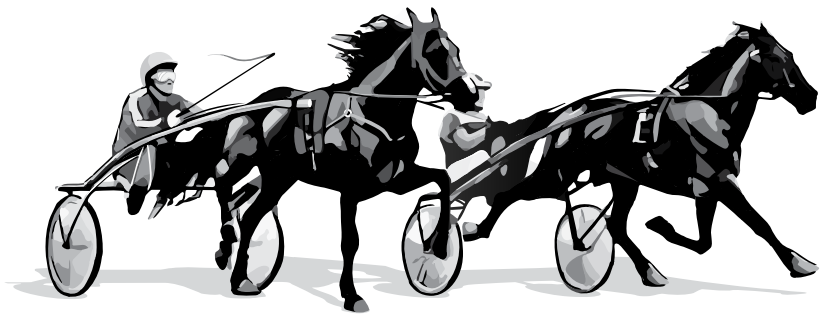
Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Win	U U U	Your horse must finish 1st; payoff determined by the win odds.
Place	U U	Your horse must finish 1st or 2nd; payoffs better than to show.
Show	U	Your horse must finish 1st, 2nd, or 3rd; modest payoffs.

Exotic multiple-horse bets

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Exacta*	U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st and 2nd in exact order; riskier bet that can pay a little or a lot, depending on the horses' odds.
Daily double	U U U U U	Pick the winners of two designated consecutive races.
Pick 3, Win 4, Pick 5, Pick 6	U U U U U U	Select the winners of a designated set of consecutive races. The wager must be made prior to the start of the first race in the multi-race wager.
Triactor*	U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in exact order; can be expensive to play if you use a lot of horses.
Superfecta*	U U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th; big payoff possible.

* Exotic bets require the horses to finish in the EXACT order you select, unless you "BOX" the bet, in which case your selections can finish in any order.

All of the numbers and letters in the program might seem confusing or overwhelming at first, but focusing on these sections makes choosing a horse simple.

- 1 Horse's number in the race
- 2 Horse's post position colour
- 3 Horse's colour, sex, age, sire (father), dam (mother), sire of the dam
- 4 Morning line odds
- 5 Horse's name
- 6 Driver and Driver Record (Name, # of wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, winning %)
- 7 Trainer information
- 8 Horse's Lifetime record (with best win time, track size, track, age, lifetime wins and lifetime earnings)
- 9 Horse's current record (# of races, # wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, and money earned)

4 The odds

Odds are also important to consider when choosing your horse. Horses that are thought to have a better chance of winning will typically have lower odds.

Morning line odds

Odds listed in the race program are the "morning line" odds. These are predictions of how the public will bet on the race. They are set by the track's handicapper when the race program is published, before the wagering starts.

The actual odds will be posted on the **Television** or in-field on the **Tote Board** before the race; they change up until post time, depending on how customers are betting on each horse in the race.

Calculating a \$2 win prize

To calculate a win prize, find the Odds of a horse on the **Television** or **Tote Board** (in-field board).

Multiply the first number by 2, then divide that number by the second digit (if there is one), and then add \$2. Simple as that!

Odds	1/2	2/1	7/2	5/1	10/1
Pays	\$3.00	\$6.00	\$9.00	\$12.00	\$22.00

Helpful facts for betting

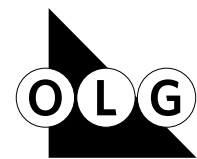
- Some racetracks have a television simulcast commentator who tries to identify winning horses (handicaps) between the races. Listen and see if you can pick up any good tips to bet on.
- A good betting method is to choose horses with current odds two to three times higher than their morning line odds.

3 Tips to remember

WIN BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 32% of the time
 PLACE BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 53% of the time
 SHOW BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 67% of the time

Race 1 Selections

The Horseplayer's Journal by Garnet Barnsdale

#3 DJIMON was good early in the season last year, he came within a head of beating a much better field than he faces here in his second start back following a three and a half month break. In his first start back, he got into a spot here where he was in the lowest class he raced at in the last couple of years. Despite getting sent off at 16 to 1, he was sent forward leaving the gate, and after getting hung three wide briefly heading into the opening turn, he set his sights on the leader. He was never able to clear to the front, and he paid the price for that long parked out journey. Last week, starting from a better post, he was expected to get a better trip, and he was bet down to 3 to 1. He blew up at the start though and lost all chance. He paced a decent back half, passing a couple of rivals. He drops again tonight, and this is absolutely a field he should beat – if he stays flat. He gets the nod to kick off tonight's \$75,000 guaranteed Pick 5.

#6 DAFFY HANOVER hasn't finished higher than sixth in any of his last four starts, but he has been facing much better than these racing in the non-winners of three class. Most recently, he finished behind Ungawa and Mr Walner Fashion either of whom would be 1 to 5 favorites in this class. In addition to getting class relief, he also draws the best post, and this is the spot where he should wake up. Expecting that he will get an aggressive Travis Cullen drive, he is the other one that I would use in the early Pick 5.

#9 MY WAY is another one that has been facing better in all of his recent starts where he hasn't been getting much money. His best finish, however, came two starts back, when he was racing one class level higher than tonight's and he closed for fourth. He will most likely be dropping to the back at the start again, but he is capable of passing some of these and landing in the bottom of the exotics at a price.

#8 BUCK DANCER has had some gait issues since being claimed, but he is another one that can contend here if he stays flat. He will likely show speed if he behaves, and he is another one that is worth a look for use on the bottom of the Tri or Super.

#8 SOMETIME SOMEWHERE was having great success racing at tonight's class level before he moved up one class for two starts and failed to get a cheque in either of them. Four starts back, he was a good second behind dominant winner Stonebridge Helios, and in his start previous to that one, he was a closing winner. Both of those miles were contested at tonight's class level which he dropped back into last week. It was no surprise that he got sent hard and found the pocket following 2 to 5 favorite JJ Xavier, and he parlayed that trip into a win at an overlaid price of 9 to 2. He projects to get the same kind of trip tonight, and he gets the call to repeat, although his price will likely be lower.

#9 JJ XAVIER was doing very well here in March racing at the \$30,000 to \$40,000 Claiming Handicap level, winning four in a row and five of six. He stepped up one class level on March 28th, and he raced well in defeat, and he was good in his next start, too. Then on April 11th, he found himself chasing Stonebridge Helios around the track in a 1:49 1/5 mile. In his next start, faced a similar scenario when tough front ender Uncle Shank N as he wired the field in a 1:50-flat mile. He dropped into this class last week, and he was expected to boss the field as the 2 to 5 favorite starting from the best post. He got a reasonable trip racing on the engine, but he couldn't seal the deal. Maybe leading the way isn't his best trip and driver Tyler Jones will look to find a helmet to follow here. He is still a contender, and he will surely offer a better price here.

#1 PONDER NO LONGER stepped up in class last week making his second start following a Gerard Demers claim, but he came off a nice effort where he came from fourth-over and really motored in the final sixteenth of a mile to get up for fourth after being forced to make a wide move around the final turn. Last week, I thought he raced well first-over. He is an upset possibility here if he can work out a better trip.

#5 CODE CRACKER sat an inside following trip last week and closed along the pylons to get withing two lengths of winner Sometime Somewhere. That was an improved effort, and I could see him landing in the Tri or Super here.

He showed nothing from post 10 last week, now he moves in two posts, and it's expected that he will get sent forward leaving the gate. He gets the nod to kick off tonight's early Pick 4

#3 JGS PAL has been a bit of a money burner in his last two starts at this level, failing to get the job done at 8 to 5 and 5 to 2 racing at this level. He didn't have a chance last week after he broke at the start. Two weeks ago, he rode the cover of Djimon who was parked out for the entire mile, and that cost him some valuable ground around the final turn. When he straightened out, he found his best stride, and he closed well to get third, trotting home in 27 3/5. He fits well at this level, and he can contend if he will stays trotting for the entire mile.

#9 SEAFARER shipped to Flamboro Downs four starts back and he got pounded down to 3 to 5 favorite with owner/trainer Mark Macdonell in the bike. He got a good trip following live cover and he had no problem converting. He raced here last in his next start with the leading driver in the bike, and he was passed by Early Play in the stretch, but he only finished three quarters of a length behind that rival. Two starts back, he made an early move to the front before being passed by Early Play as they raced past the half. From there, he rode the pocket to the lane where he angled out of the pocket then edged past the leader. Last week, he made an early move to the front as the 7 to 5 favorite, and he looked like the winner until the last stride when the pocket sitting 50 to 1 shot nailed him. Perhaps the 55 4/5 opening half was a bit too fast. He looks best in here, and he gets top billing to kick off tonight's 20-cent Pick 6 bet.

#6 GLORYVIEW IMAGE gets needed class relief tonight and he draws best, and it seems highly likely that he will be looking for the front early in this mile. If he can clear with relative ease, he can prove tough to beat in this spot, although I wonder of Seafarer will land in his pocket early then chase him down late.

#3 EARLY PLAY got off the rail on March 29th, and he delivered his best effort of the year, racing first-over, and he drew away with authority. He lowered his lifetime mark that night, but he just didn't get a winning trip a week later in the final of that Pop Up Series, although he did close well from far back to get fourth. He drew well in his next start on April 13th and when a rival zigged to the outside at the head of the lane, this gelding zagged between horses, and he had clear sailing, but he couldn't go with that rival late. He has already shown that he fits well racing at this level, and he figures to be a speed threat tonight.

#5 WILLOWTIME was raced aggressively four starts back in a Pop Up series final, and he came close to pulling off a 13 to 1 upset. He faced much tougher horses in his next start and it was no surprise to see him finish well back. Two weeks ago, he dropped one class level, and he never really found his best stride until deep stretch. #9 GAINES HANOVER is a high-quality animal that has won racing higher than tonight's class level many times in his career. His six-year-old debut last week where he was coming off a break of more than five months was probably better than it looked on paper. He raced in mid pack to the last turn where he got shuffled to the back. He stayed inside and he found his best stride in the final eighth where he began to close on the leaders. He ran into some traffic nearing the wire and finished the mile blocked. He draws widest here, but he will have a big shot if he gets put into the race. He gets top call to kick off tonight's late Pick 4.

#7 PENNTELLER HANOVER was good here in early April, taking a win and a second before being elevated to the top class. He fared decently racing in those Open fields two weeks in a row, taking cheques in both starts while passing horses. Dropping in class gives him a decent chance to take his second win of the season in this sixth start, and he is another one to consider for tonight's late Pick 4.

#4 DEVILS ARCH has a similar profile as Gaines Hanover in that they drop out of the same race. In fact, it was Devils Arch that finished alongside Gaines Hanover and kept him pinned inside on a helmet in the drive to the wire. This gelding knows where the wire is having taken wins in 13 of 40 starts in 2025-26. He gets Louis Phillippe Roy back in the bike tonight and he will likely get a more aggressive drive. He is another contender in what should be a good betting race.

#3 ROYALTY BEER has been great winning his last two starts and he took a new lifetime mark last week. He does his best work racing on the lead though, and I don't see him on the engine turning for home in this field. He loses driver Roy here, but he picks up the leading driver. He can be part of the Tri or Super.

#4 PLANKTON HANOVER had a decent two-year-old season, and he qualified well twice for his sophomore debut that came last week. He drew the rail and started third, and he was sent first up after the half to challenge the leader that stole a 29 1/5 second quarter. He was never getting past that rival in a back half that was paced in 55 1/5, and I thought he hung in there well while pacing a 27 2/5 kicker uncovered. Getting off the rail gives him a chance to control this race, and he gets top billing here.

#7 DR DAVE got good in the Ontario Spring Series, where he first closed mildly to get the smallest cheque in the opening leg three starts back, while closing in 26 3/5. He parlayed that good effort into a win in Leg 2 where he flew down the middle of the track in deep stretch to score a narrow upset win. Off that impressive score, he was bet down to 9 to 5 favorite in the final and he once again produced a good closing effort that night, but the winner was just a bit better. He fits well in here, and he should be heard from late.

#5 WALK OF LIFE took three straight wins to start his racing career including a lifetime best 1:54-flat score here on April 10th. Since then, he ran into two nice colts in Johnny Angel and We Got History and he raced okay in both of those miles. He gets post relief tonight after drawing wide for his last two starts, he gets the middle of the gate here, and that has him in with a chance.

#8 THIRTY SIX RED is another one that raced well in the Ontario Spring Series, and he rallied for third after taking a mid race shuffle. He has enough gate speed to overcome his wide draw and get positioned close to the front at the start, and he should be able to stick around for a share.

#2 LOGAN PARK had another outstanding season as a seven-year-old last year, taking eight wins from 19 starts while earning close to \$288,000. He looked well prepared for this first start at eight and there was no concern with him racing off the shelf considering that he won his first start of the season in the past three years, last year handling a Preferred Trot field easily. Punters bet him down to 15 cents on the dollar, and he dominated as expected. Facing a similar field tonight means that more of the same is likely coming.

#3 GHOSTLY CASPER is a newly minted millionaire that came into his last start on a three-race win streak having stepped up to this top level where he got the job done racing tough first-over last week two stars back. Last week, he ended up first-over racing around the final turn as Logan Park was in full acceleration mode and that was a win that wasn't going to work. He did hang in there for third, however, and he gets off the rail tonight. I could see him getting positioned closer to the front at the start and completing the Exacta.

#4 MR BLUEBIRD amazingly has been part of the Super in 29 straight starts and he made sure he secured the lead early last week so that he could race in Logan Park's pocket when that rival made the inevitable move to the front. He is in excellent form, and it's expected that he will race well again. The only possible value in this race though, may be trying to beat him out of the Exacta.

#6 HASTY BID is another consistent performer who rarely misses the top four and he missed one cycle of this Open class when he didn't race on April 25th. He will likely get outsprinted early by a couple of these, and he will most likely pass some of them late to land in the bottom of the exotics.

Ozzy delivered as the favorite, but this gelding raced well and he finished well clear in second. He draws widest here, but he might be able to control this race if he can clear from out there. He gets top billing in this cash leg of late multi-race tickets.

#2 AQUINAS HANOVER was a winner here five starts back when he was racing a class higher than tonight's level and he made a wide move and easily rolled past the leaders to win going away. Since then, he has simply been in too tough. He raced okay last week, pacing a sub-55 back half against tougher and the class drop to the bottom makes him a contender here.

#4 HES TOURING makes his first start of the season in the bottom conditioned class and although he finished fifth in his qualifier, he did pace home in 27-flat. He fits well in here, but he is far from a lock, and he is one that I will try to beat as the morning line favorite.

#5 HIGHLAND HOT SAUCE finished well behind Southwind Sambucca last week, but he did work his way through the field and got into a dead heat for third. He is only a four time winner in 70 starts, but he has taken 17 slices. He is in good form, and he can pass some of these late and get another share tonight.

The conditions of a race determine whether a horse is eligible to enter. For example many races are restricted to horses that have won a certain number of races or a certain amount of money in a specified number of starts. Many races are restricted to horses entered to be "claimed" (offered for sale) at a specific price.

Allowances in the claiming price itself are given to colts and geldings, four-year-olds and younger and to mares, five-year-olds and younger.

The purpose of the allowance is to keep younger horses more competitive when racing against older and more experienced rivals. Mares are given extra consideration in claiming events because of their potential as broodmares.

The accompanying chart shows what the allowances are, but an example may make them easier to understand. The chart indicates that three-year-olds receive a 50% allowance in claiming races. This means that a three-year-old entered in a \$20,000 claiming race carries an actual claiming price of \$30,000 (50% higher).

Fillies and mares receive an additional 25% allowance in claiming races. Details of the race conditions and claiming price (if any) are given at the top of each race in the program.

C.P.M.A. Regulation Changes

Effective January 1st 2012
CPMA will be instituting several new rule changes with regards to the following pari-mutuel pools:

Pick Pools

- If there are no winners in any leg of a Pick N pool, the entire pool is refunded.
- If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners.
- A pool is no longer refunded if the 1st leg in the pool is cancelled or declared no contest.
- Pick-3: If at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: If at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.

EXPLANATION OF THE LASIX PROGRAM

After careful study and consultation with Ontario Horsemen's groups, racetrack operators and veterinarians, Agriculture Canada and the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario passed legislation allowing the controlled (or supervised) administration of furosemide, more commonly called "Lasix". "Lasix" is used to alleviate the symptoms of exercise induced pulmonary hemorrhaging in racing horses. Horses will undergo an endoscopic examination of the trachea by a veterinarian licensed by the Ontario Racing Commission and endorsed by an official veterinarian before being allowed on the medication list. Once qualified, horses will be treated with "Lasix" within four hours plus or minus 15 minutes of a scheduled race in a secure retention area under the super vision of racing officials.

All horses on "Lasix" must remain on the program for a minimum of 100 days while racing in this jurisdiction.

- (L)** Denotes horses treated with Lasix for their last start but not so treated today.

RULES AND INFORMATION REGARDING CANADIAN HARNESS AND FOREIGN SEPARATE POOL EVENTS

GENERAL

All pari-mutuel pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with the regulations and directives as issued by Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada ("the Regulations"), under the approval and supervision of the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency. The Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency can be contacted at 1-800-268-8835 or 613-759-6100 or Email: cpmawebacpm@agr.gc.ca. A complete version of the CPMA regulations can be found at <http://laws-lois.justice.gc.ca/eng/regulations/SOR-91-365/>.

All tickets should be held until the result of the race is declared official and prices are posted.

No person under the age of 18 shall purchase or cash a ticket or voucher.

A claim of receiving an incorrect payment or incorrect change must be made to the Mutuel office of the association within twenty four hours of buying or cashing a valid ticket or voucher.

No ruling made by the Stewards/Judges or the Ontario Racing Commission with regard to distribution of purse money or the placing of horses in the order of finish, after the race has been declared official, shall have any bearing on the pay-out prices or distribution of pari-mutuel pools.

Change boards and Photo Finish display monitors are located in the Grandstand. In addition, Photo Finish pictures are shown on the closed-circuit television system. Customers are reminded that mutuel clerks are responsible for all shortages. When making a wager, customers must present sufficient funds at the time of purchase to cover the wagers requested.

ENTRIES AND MUTUEL FIELDS

"Entry" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled or considered as the same betting interest. The most common reason for the coupling of horses in an Entry is the fact that they are owned by the same person.

"Mutuel Field" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled because the number of horses in the race exceeds the number which can be handled separately by the pari-mutuel system. Subject to the Regulations, a bet on one horse of an Entry or Mutuel Field shall be considered a bet on all horses in that Entry or Mutuel Field.

DAILY DOUBLE BETTING (INCLUDING LATE DOUBLE)

A Daily Double bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of the two races specified for the Daily Double. Tickets not selecting the winner of the first half of the Daily Double and all tickets in the second half of the Daily Double not coupled with the declared official winner of the first half of the Daily Double are not winners and are not refunded no matter what circumstances affect the running of the second half of the Daily Double.

Should a horse or horses (not coupled with another starter) be excused from starting in the second race of the Daily Double after the first race of the Daily Double has closed for betting, holders of all Daily Double tickets on such horses, coupled with the winner of the first Daily Double race, shall participate in a Consolation Double pool. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

EXACTA (Also known as Exactor)/TRIFECTA (Also known as Trifactor)/SUPERFECTA

An Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first two, three and four horses respectively, representing different betting interests to finish in the exact official order of finish, in the race on which the pool is operated.

SWINGER (Also known as OMNI)

A Swinger is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select horses to finish in any order from the official first 3 positions.

JACKPOT HI-5

A Jackpot Hi-5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners in the specified Jackpot Hi-5 race. If there are races that have an entry, (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B), Jackpot Hi-5 will not offer a wager consisting of both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in a Jackpot Hi-5, the payout would be 1st, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th.

That jackpot portion of the pool will only be paid out if there is a single winning ticket. If there are multiple winning tickets that have correctly chosen the first 5 runners of the race, they will receive 50% of the pool for that day. The other 50% will go over into the Jackpot carryover. If there are no winning tickets with the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners, 100% of the current day's pool will be carried over into the Jackpot.

PICK 3 & PICK-4 BETTING

The Pick 3 & Pick 4 bets are betting transactions in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of three or four successive races specified for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 respectively.

Winning tickets for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 are determined in the following sequence: A) winners of all legs, B) most winners, then refund. If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners. If there are no winners in any leg of a pool, the entire pool is refunded.

PICK 5 BETTING

The Pick 5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of five successive races specified for the Pick 5 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 5 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 5.

PICK 6 BETTING

The Pick 6 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of six successive races specified for the Pick 6 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 6 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 6.

PICK 5 & 6 BETTING

If at least 1 race as part of the Pick 5 or 6 has been cancelled or declared "No contest", but not more than the specified below under Refunds, the net pool shall be distributed to those selecting the most # of winners and NOT include any carryover from a previous pool.

PICK 3, PICK 4, PICK 5 & PICK 6 SCRATCHES

In the event a Pick 3, Pick 4, Pick 5 or Pick 6 ticket designates as a selection a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the Stewards/Judges to be a non-starter in any of the races comprising the Pick 3, Pick 4, Pick 5 or Pick 6 the favourite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection. In the event that the money bet in the win pool for two or more favourites is identical, the selection with the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non-starting selection.

However, if a scratch occurs in any leg of the Pick 3, Pick 4, Pick 5 or Pick 6 pools before the pool is closed, a ticket including the scratched horse may be cancelled.

REFUNDS

Subject to the Regulations, all monies in all pools on a race are refunded in the event that the race is cancelled, declared off or declared no contest, and all monies bet on a horse are refunded if the horse is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start. These refunds will be communicated to the public through various means such as betting terminals, video display, changes boards and our website.

The Pick(n) pool shall be cancelled and all Pick(n) wagers for the individual performance shall be refunded if:

- Pick-3: at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

Where a horse that is part of an Entry is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start and at least one horse of that Entry receives a fair start in the race, all tickets purchased on the Entry remain valid and the purchase price of any such ticket shall not be refunded.

COMMON POOL WAGERING (INTERTRACK BETTING)

In the unlikely event of a communications or computer system failure that prevents pools from merging with the host track's pools before the end of a race, CPMA regulations require that the site must refund all tickets for that race. This refund will be communicated to the public through various means such as video displays, change boards and messages on our website.

FAIR START

If a horse has reached the Fair Start Pole (located 200 feet before the Starting Pole) by the time the mobile gate has reached the Starting Pole, that horse is deemed to have had a fair start. It makes no difference whether or not the horse is on or off stride at that precise moment. Under current policy and regulations, which are designed to be as fair as possible to all bettors on all starters, there is no Recall - a repeat of the entire starting procedure - when a horse does not reach the Fair Start Pole before the gate reaches the Starting Pole. Monies bet on such a horse are refunded in accordance with the regulation concerning refunds.

LOST & OLD TICKETS

WEG issued tickets or vouchers are valid indefinitely, however, they cannot be cashed at a mutuel teller after 2 years from date of issue. Please mail tickets, along with your name and address, to Mutuel Manager, P.O. Box 156, Rexdale, Ontario, M9W 5L2, keeping a photocopy for future reference.

For "Lost Tickets" originally sold at a Woodbine Entertainment Group racetrack or Teletheatre, please enquire at the Mutuel office at Woodbine, Greenwood Teletheatre, or Mohawk. Policy may be subject to change retroactively in the event regulatory bodies amend existing regulations.

ASSOCIATION PERCENTAGE, AND TAXATION/LEVY

The Woodbine Entertainment Group deducts and retains the following percentages from wagers placed at our own licensed sites which are then shared with the horsepeople, host and simulcast associations and the Ontario Racing Commission.

WOODBINE/MOHAWK LIVE: Win, Place & Show: 13.65%. Swinger 14.7%. Trifecta & Pick 4: 21.7%. Double & Exacta 17.2%. Jackpot Hi-5, Pick 5 & Pick 6: 11.7%. All other 23.0%

Horsepeople receive a further 2% on all wagers, except Trifecta wagering where it is 4%. The Ontario Provincial Government retains 0.5% on all bets placed in Ontario. The Canadian Government (through a revolving fund cost recovery basis) retains 0.8% on all wagers placed in Canada for provision of drug control, and audit services.
