# Betting Basics

Some essentials to get you started with making a wager.

## 1 How to wager



Place your bet by visiting a teller, or using a self-serve terminal.

### To place a bet here are just 5 things you need to know:

- 1 Name of racetrack (choose from any track in the simulcast feeds)
- 2 Number of the race
- 3 Amount of your bet (e.g. \$2)
- 4 Type of bet (see step 2)
- 5 Horse's number (see step 4)

Once you have decided what you want to bet, head to the nearest seller's window and use the sample statement as your guide:

**Hello, (Racetrack), race 6, \$2 to WIN on Horse #4**

### How to use a self-serve terminal:

- 1 Swipe your Cash Card/Insert Cash
- 2 Enter the initial PIN #1234 (then choose a new PIN)
- 3 Press/Tap the track you would like to bet: (defaults to current race)
- 4 Tap the Horse Number: **#4**
- 5 Press/Tap the Bet Type: **WIN**
- 6 Press/Tap the Bet Amount: **\$2**
- 7 Press/Tap the Race Number: **Race #6**
- 8 Press Green **"Make BET"** button
- 9 Press/Tap the **"Finish with Receipt"** button
- 10 Be sure to check your ticket to confirm it's the bet you wanted

To get a Cash Card or for assistance ask a teller, or a staff member.

## 2 Types of bets



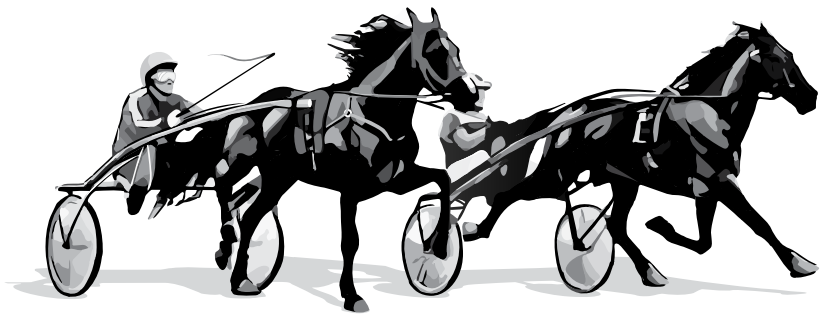
### Single horse bets (minimum \$2.00 bet is required)

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Win	U U U	Your horse must finish 1st; payoff determined by the win odds.
Place	U U	Your horse must finish 1st or 2nd; payoffs better than to show.
Show	U	Your horse must finish 1st, 2nd, or 3rd; modest payoffs.

### Exotic multiple-horse bets

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Exacta*	U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st and 2nd in exact order; riskier bet that can pay a little or a lot, depending on the horses' odds.
Daily double	U U U U U	Pick the winners of two designated consecutive races.
Pick 3, Win 4, Pick 5, Pick 6	U U U U U U	Select the winners of a designated set of consecutive races. The wager must be made prior to the start of the first race in the multi-race wager.
Triactor*	U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in exact order; can be expensive to play if you use a lot of horses.
Superfecta*	U U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th; big payoff possible.

\* Exotic bets require the horses to finish in the EXACT order you select, unless you "BOX" the bet, in which case your selections can finish in any order.

All of the numbers and letters in the program might seem confusing or overwhelming at first, but focusing on these sections makes choosing a horse simple.

- 1 Horse's number in the race
- 2 Horse's post position colour
- 3 Horse's colour, sex, age, sire (father), dam (mother), sire of the dam
- 4 Morning line odds
- 5 Horse's name
- 6 Driver and Driver Record (Name, # of wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, winning %)
- 7 Trainer information
- 8 Horse's Lifetime record (with best win time, track size, track, age, lifetime wins and lifetime earnings)
- 9 Horse's current record (# of races, # wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, and money earned)

# 4 The odds



Odds are also important to consider when choosing your horse. Horses that are thought to have a better chance of winning will typically have lower odds.

### Morning line odds

Odds listed in the race program are the "morning line" odds. These are predictions of how the public will bet on the race. They are set by the track's handicapper when the race program is published, before the wagering starts.

The actual odds will be posted on the **Television** or in-field on the **Tote Board** before the race; they change up until post time, depending on how customers are betting on each horse in the race.

### Calculating a \$2 win prize

To calculate a win prize, find the Odds of a horse on the **Television** or **Tote Board** (in-field board).

Multiply the first number by 2, then divide that number by the second digit (if there is one), and then add \$2. Simple as that!

Odds	1/2	2/1	7/2	5/1	10/1
Pays	\$3.00	\$6.00	\$9.00	\$12.00	\$22.00

### Helpful facts for betting

- Some racetracks have a television simulcast commentator who tries to identify winning horses (handicaps) between the races. Listen and see if you can pick up any good tips to bet on.
- A good betting method is to choose horses with current odds two to three times higher than their morning line odds.

### 3 Tips to remember

**WIN BETS** on the FAVOURITE pay 32% of the time  
**PLACE BETS** on the FAVOURITE pay 53% of the time  
**SHOW BETS** on the FAVOURITE pay 67% of the time

# CUSTOMER CODE OF CONDUCT

Woodbine Entertainment and its' employees are honoured to engage in the sport of horse racing and entertainment activities in the meeting place of Etobicoke. Woodbine Racetrack is located within the traditional and treaty Lands of the Mississaugas of the Credit. Known as Aadoobiigok, the "Place of the Alders" in Michi Saagiig language, the region is uniquely situated along the Humber River Watershed, which historically provided an integral connection for Anishinaabe, Haudenosaunee, and Wendat peoples between the Ontario Lakeshore and Lake Simcoe/Georgian Bay regions. The territory is covered by the Dish With One Spoon Wampum Belt Covenant, an agreement between the Anishinaabe and the Haudenosaunee to peaceably take care of the land and resources around the Great Lakes. Woodbine is honoured to care for this land, our human and equine athletes, and provide a place to race responsibly.

**#10 UNGAWA** caught the eye in deep stretch in his four-year-old debut here on April 20th when he came flying down the outside to get third. Starting from a wide post in his second start back, he got bet down to 7 to 2 second choice, and he was put in play leaving the gate. He made front passing the quarter, but he was soon passed by 1 to 5 shot Eurobank Hanover who would go on to take a second consecutive win. This Paul Macdonell trained and driven gelding finished a clear second that night, and he was all set to produce his best effort of the year in his third start. He made a middle move to the front and coasted to a new lifetime mark of 1:53 3/5 and last week, he was even better, lowering that mark to 1:53 2/5. He faces tougher now including Eurobank Hanover again, but he has a recency edge on that rival. Post 10 ensures that he will offer a square price and he gets the call to score the threepat to kick off tonight's \$75,000 guaranteed early Pick 5.

**#1 EUROBANK HANOVER** won seven of 15 starts last season and he broke stride in every one of the other eight miles. He has shown no gait issues so far this season and he has been near perfect, falling a head short of winning all four of his starts. He faces that rival that beat him that night again in this field. He is an obvious contender with the only concern being him missing three weeks between starts.

**#4 MR WALNER FASHION** is five for six in 2025-26 with the only blemish being a breaking incident in the New Jersey Sires Stakes Final last June. He won three races in 16 days then he took three weeks off leading to this fourth start of the season. He is one of three contenders in here that can win to kick off the Pick 5.

**#8 ROXIE HART** changed tactics last week, and taking the front almost worked for her. She typically does her best racing chasing horses and starting from a wide post against other expected leavers, she will likely be dropping back tonight. She will probably pass a few of these in the final quarter and she is worth a look for the bottom of the Tri and Super in this spot.

**#9 JUST GIVENER** paced the fastest mile of his life here in his sophomore debut on April 17th, but his 1:53 4/5 clocking was only good enough for a ninth place finish that night because the winner was pacing a 1:52 mile which is very fast for maidens this time of year. He then produced a decent closing effort last to get fourth, finishing four and a half lengths behind American Road Trip. He got off the rail last week, and he got more aggressive, and he raced great in defeat. He has a big shot to make front and lead all the way tonight.

**#3 AMERICAN ROAD TRIP** raced well in two straight starts here in January to start his season off, getting second in both before getting some time off. He returned on April 24th, and he was a victim of both trip and pace, and he did well to finish a clear third behind overwhelming favorite No Waitlist. Racing in a driving rainstorm, he made an early move on the backstretch, and he ended up on the cover of a non advancing 62 to 1 shot. He pulled wide early on the final turn, but at that point the leader was kicking into high gear and about to pace a 27-flat final quarter. Last week, from post 10, he left hard but so did three others. It took him past the quarter to make front then he was overtaken by Just Givener. He followed that rival home to get third now he has to face him again. He can be an Exacta factor tonight.

**#5 WICKED WANKS** was much better in his second start back, pacing a 54 3/5 back half and a 27 1/5 final quarter. He draws one of the best posts tonight, and he gets Mark Macdonald in the bike, so he will likely get a much more aggressive steer tonight. He should improve enough to hit the board in this spot.

**#2 SUNSET LOO** was decent last year, taking a couple of shares in six starts and his lone qualifier prepping for his 2026 debut was okay. Trevor Henry sided with him over Wicked Wanks in this spot. He is another one that can land in the exotics.

**#3 KENOGAMI FANCY** was thought to be a live longshot on debut based on what we saw in her May 4th qualifier. That morning, she was patiently driven to the stretch where she moved outside then back inside and finished her mile with plenty of trot, closing in 27 4/5. She had a solid debut where she found her best stride in deep stretch, and she finished a clear third behind the 4 to 5 favorite and 9 to 5 second choice. Her full sister Kenogami Queen was an early winner, taking a victory in her second start, and this filly gets the nod to do the same as we kick off tonight's early Pick 4.

**#7 UPGRADE** is 0 for 13, but she raced well in the recently concluded Ontario Spring Series. She was faster in each leg of the series, and her third mile in the final was close to three seconds faster than the mile that she trotted in the opening leg. This should be an easier spot here facing straight maidens, and I imagine that she will be aggressive from the outset here. She is probably the one that the top pick will need to pass in the stretch.

**#8 MY CLASSY QUEEN** came withing a couple of inches of pulling off a massive upset two starts back where she raced great and was unlucky to fall a nose short at 61 to 1. She then moved from post nine to the 10-hole which may not seem much worse, but in fact is so. In 2026 so far, post nine has produced winners at a rate of 8.6% (11 for 128) versus only 3.7% for post 10 (3 for 82). She trotted a faster final quarter last time than she did two starts back, but she finished farther back. She gets post eight tonight, and she can come on late to take a share.

**#10 WHT BLONDE HANOVER** raced well in her sophomore debut where she finished a close third, so punters made her 7 to 5 favorite in her second start back. She broke at the start, and she was out of contention right there. She needs a clean line here so she will likely get a conservative steer, but I can see her getting a share if she stays trotting this time.

**#10 ILL HAVE THE RED** was sharp to kick off her rookie campaign, winning a Grand Circuit race on debut then coming back to double up in a New York Sires Stake in her next start. She qualified okay for her sophomore debut, and after making front at the quarter, she was passed and she was sitting a nice pocket trip when she blew up. Trainer Zeron handed the lines to Mark Macdonald last week, and he provided the daughter of Chapter Seven with an aggressive steer, and she had no problem getting the job done, and she took a new lifetime mark in the process. She draws widest here, and steps up in class but she has the gate speed to overcome post 10, and she should offer a good price tonight. She gets top billing to kick off tonight's 20-cent Pick 6.

**#7 CAPTAIN CODE** looks like the obvious one to beat here making his sophomore debut following a strong rookie campaign where he was Grand Circuit placed. His sharp qualifying win here last Saturday suggests that he is ready to fire a big effort tonight. He was sent straight to the front by regular driver Scott Young, and he controlled the race and trotted away from his rivals in the stretch with Young never lifting a line. This gelding is one that I wouldn't leave off early multi-race tickets.

**#1 WOLFPACK CROWN** had missed three weeks when he lined up behind the gate last week, but a bigger problem for him was that he was about to face Ungawa, who was ready to lower his lifetime mark to 1:53 2/5. This colt raced well considering, and he was picked off very late for second. He can be better here coming back much quicker, and he is another possibility for early multi-race tickets.

**#4 FLORIDA GUY** is another one that had to face a sharp Ungawa in his most recent mile, and while he was no threat, he improved his final time and his last quarter, trotting home in 27 1/5 to get up for fourth. I could see him closing late to land in the bottom of the exotics here.

**#8 WICKED EXPRESS** has been racing just okay in his seven starts where he has finished on the edges frequently. All of those races came in claiming handicaps, though. What you can't see in your program, though, is that eight starts back, he raced in tonight's \$20,000 conditioned claimer for non-winners of \$60,000 lifetime. On that night, he was bet down to even money, and he led all the way to score a season's best win. He gets into this race only because he meets the non-winners of \$4,000 last four condition. Expecting that he will get an aggressive steer from Tyler Borth, I'll call him to score the upset.

**#4 JIMS FIRST DATE** dropped from non-winners of two to the \$20,000 conditioned claiming two starts back, and his odds dropped from 42 to 1 the previous week to 8 to 1. He showed improvement as expected, following to the stretch then angling outside the eventual winner to get up for second. Off that improved performance, he was bet down to even money, and he was given an aggressive Billy Davis Jr. steer to get the job done and lower his lifetime best mark to 1:52 1/5. The earnings threshold for tonight's condition is much higher, but this field doesn't look much tougher. He should be right there again.

**#7 ONEFORMYBABY** didn't show much in the two qualifiers leading up to her four-year-old debut last week, and she looked up against it racing against the boys, too. She was ready to roll, though, and she sat a good trip following Jims First Date, and she got up for second. She draws okay here and she should be able to get another decent following trip and take another share.

**#2 BRUDON** showed big improvement last week as many horses do when leading pilot James Macdonald takes over the driving duties. He got a good covered trip and motored late to get third. I can see him getting a similar trip tonight and landing in the bottom of the Tri or Super.

**#6 DELIGHTFUL YANKEE** was bought for \$325,000 at the Lexington Sale, being sired by top trotting stallion Chapter Seven and the first foal from multiple stakes winning dam Darlene Hanover. She never made it to the races at two having participated in three qualifiers and breaking in two of them. She put it all together in her qualifier on March 13th, kicking home in 28-flat to take the win, and she followed that up with a winning debut performance. She was even better on April 6th, making a third quarter power move to the front and sprinting away from the field to knock three seconds off the mark that she established in her debut. In her third start back, she fought bravely on the lead, but she got picked off late by a filly that has already come back to win two more races. Last week, she wasn't as good, but she had two strikes against her: drawing the rail and coming in with a stale date. Returning in a week and drawing the best post gives her a big chance tonight and she gets top billing to kick off tonight's late Pick 5.

**#3 TH TRIX R FORKIDS** got good towards the end of her brief rookie campaign last year when she took her maiden win in the second leg of the Harvest Series then followed that up with a repeat win in the Final as the 2 to 5 favorite. She showed some grit in both of those miles, winning racing first-over in both. She dropped more than two seconds in her second qualifier preparing for this sophomore debut, and she should be ready to roll.

**#4 ANTEBELLUM** was given an aggressive steer in her second start back, but it took her past the first quarter to make front. That early exertion took its toll late, but she did stick around for third. She draws better now and she could get an easier trip here and finish closer.

**#5 P L STEVIE** had a pretty good rookie campaign last year, taking three wins and five other shares from 15 starts while earning more than \$54,000. She got a start in here a couple of weeks ago where she raced just evenly. She should improve with that first mile as a four-year-old under her belt and she is worth a look for use underneath tonight.

**#5 TAVERN ON THE GREEN** took the fastest mark of any of these in his final start of 2025 and he did it wearing trotting hobbles. He tried qualifying with no hobbles here on April 27th, and he took a big lead early then jumped it off. Requalifying with the trotting hobbled redeployed last week, he won easier than it looks on paper. He pulled on the final turn, and he was sent widest when he turned for home. With pilot Louis-Phillipe Roy sitting like a statue in the bike, the Luc Blais trainee edged clear late and kept the advantage to the wire while under no urging. He seems primed to take his second lifetime win and he gets top billing to kick off tonight's late Pick 4.

**#1 MASS DEPLOYMENT** was edged by Tavern on the Green in that qualifier last week after riding the pocket to the stretch and taking over the lead, and he can be a threat here in this sophomore debut. He finished off his short two-year-old campaign with a third-place finish in a \$140,000 OSS Gold event, so he obviously has some talent. The main concern here is the rail draw as he could get outsprinted by a few of these leaving the gate.

**#4 EXACTLY** was a \$180,000 Lexington yearling being a son of top sire Bar Hopping and he was a winner at first asking at two, taking a Kentucky Sires Stake in his first try. He finished a close second to Grand Circuit winner Strobe Lite in his qualifier prepping for his sophomore debut, then he was placed on the Judges list for performance; the horse tried to pull up in the first turn (taken straight from the Judges Report). He was much better in his qualifier last week and he closed along the inside landing third in a three-pronged stretch battle where he was being asked for nothing. He should contend tonight.

**#3 SOUTHWIND CHESTER** got a great trip to take his maiden win last week, now he faces tougher and he loses the leading driver to rival Exactly tonight. I can see him getting a good trip here and working his way into the bottom of the Tri or Super.

**#8 CAPTAIN WILLIE** produced his best effort of his career in his seventh start on April 27th, and he looks primed to take his maiden victory tonight. Starting from the same post that he drew tonight, the sophomore son of Captain Corey was given an aggressive steer from Todd Ratchford, and after fighting off a third quarter challenger, he led to the stretch, but he was about to face a fresh challenge from the 4 to 5 favorite. He was unable to fend off that challenger, but he stayed game to the wire, and he held on for second. He should get another aggressive steer tonight and he gets top billing.

**#10 NOTATTHETABLCARLOS** came into last week's three-year-old debut off a good qualifier where he finished second to veteran Mercutio while kicking home in 27 4/5. He was bet down to even money, and he was never close enough to threaten the top two finishers. He is capable of better and he should be sharper tonight. The obvious concern is what kind of trip he might get starting from the widest post. He is one of the better ones in here, but I'd demand a much higher price than he offered last week.

**#7 GREEN GRASS GROWS** looked good winning his qualifier here on March 27th, leading all the way and sprinting away from the field late while under tight lines to teamster Travis Henry. He came up against a couple of sharp racehorses in Felix Hanover and Steinbeck in his first pari-mutuel start of the season, but he never got a chance to compete against them after breaking at the start of the mile. He bounced back with a solid effort in his second start back. After suffering an interference break at the quarter, he lost touch with the field until they reached the far turn where he reappeared and commenced a rally. He rolled up widest in the lane to close in on the leader and get up for third. He was too far back in both of his last two starts. He can get a share here if he lays a bit closer early.

**#6 DULCES SUENOS DEO** is 0 for 36 but she has taken 17 slices and finished fourth on several occasions. She is always passing rivals late it seems, and she will likely close to land in the bottom of the Tri or Super tonight.

This looks like a spot where she will either lead or sit the pocket, and she has a good chance to resume her winning ways tonight.

**#7 RONDA MAY K** took two wins in three tries last season and she showed she had some talent when she crushed a field of maidens in her second start in an eye popping 1:54 2/5. She tried an OSS Gold event in her third and final start and she broke at the start and was distanced. She comes in off a strong winning qualifier, and on paper, she is the obvious threat to Elbows Up.

**#1 TAHONTA** was taking his fourth win in her 12th start of the season when last seen here last summer, then she got sick, missed a start, and was shelved until she qualified twice here this month. **#2 SMILES FOR MILES** moved from a claiming handicap to a conditioned claimer last week, and he showed how significant the class discrepancy is between the two when he showed speed both early and late and produced a winning effort that was only two-fifths of a second off his lifetime best mark. He is right back in a conditioned claimer tonight and he should be able to get positioned close to the front early in this mile. It looks like this gelding has found his best class level, and he gets the call to repeat.

**#8 VOLCANIC** was the King of this class for several weeks in the winter as he amassed seven wins in his first 11 starts this season. He tried a claiming handicap two starts back and he found out how much tougher that level is. He comes off an okay effort in London where he raced first-over. That isn't his best trip. He should go better tonight racing on or near the lead.

**#9 ACEFORTYFOURAPOLLO** caught the eye last week, making a big late move in the stretch to finish less than a length behind Lochinvar Aussie and Catitude. He drew widest last week, and he trailed to the last turn then passed a few rivals. He gets slight post relief tonight, and he can lay a bit closer to the front which could lead to him hitting the ticket at a price.

**#1 CHEF** seems to get the same trip every week. He usually shows enough gate speed to get spotted in the top two early in his miles then he is one paced in the stretch and hangs around to take a slice. He will likely get that same trip tonight and land in the Tri or Super.

**#5 PARTY IT UP** is 0 for 15 this season, and he is another one that frequently finishes on the edges. He comes in off a couple of decent tries at Flamboro Downs, and he can pass enough of these in the back half to work his way into the bottom of the Tri or Super.

### C O N D I T I O N S A N D A L L O W A N C E S I N H A R N E S S R A C I N G - I M P O R T A N T T O K N O W

The conditions of a race determine whether a horse is eligible to enter. For example many races are restricted to horses that have won a certain number of races or a certain amount of money in a specified number of starts. Many races are restricted to horses entered to be "claimed" (offered for sale) at a specific price.

Allowances in the claiming price itself are given to colts and geldings, four-year-olds and younger and to mares, five-year-olds and younger.

The purpose of the allowance is to keep younger horses more competitive when racing against older and more experienced rivals. Mares are given extra consideration in claiming events because of their potential as broodmares.

The accompanying chart shows what the allowances are, but an example may make them easier to understand. The chart indicates that three-year-olds receive a 50% allowance in claiming races. This means that a three-year-old entered in a \$20,000 claiming race carries an actual claiming price of \$30,000 (50% higher).

Fillies and mares receive an additional 25% allowance in claiming races. Details of the race conditions and claiming price (if any) are given at the top of each race in the program.

### A L L O W A N C E S F O R P U R S E E A R N I N G S

When Fillies/Mares compete against Colts/Geldings (normally on the trot) Fillies/Mares will receive an additional 25% on the condition of the race. ie: nw \$5,000 (FM \$6,250) last 5 or \$12,000 (FM \$15,000) last 10 starts.

## C.P.M.A. Regulation Changes

Effective January 1<sup>st</sup> 2012  
CPMA will be instituting several new rule changes with regards to the following pari-mutuel pools:

### Pick Pools

- If there are no winners in any leg of a Pick N pool, the entire pool is refunded.
- If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners.
- A pool is no longer refunded if the 1<sup>st</sup> leg in the pool is cancelled or declared no contest.
- Pick-3: If at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: If at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.

## EXPLANATION OF THE LASIX PROGRAM

After careful study and consultation with Ontario Horsemen's groups, racetrack operators and veterinarians, Agriculture Canada and the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario passed legislation allowing the controlled (or supervised) administration of furosemide, more commonly called "Lasix". "Lasix" is used to alleviate the symptoms of exercise induced pulmonary hemorrhaging in racing horses. Horses will undergo an endoscopic examination of the trachea by a veterinarian licensed by the Ontario Racing Commission and endorsed by an official veterinarian before being allowed on the medication list. Once qualified, horses will be treated with "Lasix" within four hours plus or minus 15 minutes of a scheduled race in a secure retention area under the super vision of racing officials.

All horses on "Lasix" must remain on the program for a minimum of 100 days while racing in this jurisdiction.

- L** Denotes horses treated with Lasix.
- (L)** Denotes horses treated with Lasix today who were not so treated for their last start.
- (L)** Denotes horses treated with Lasix for their last start but not so treated today.

## RULES AND INFORMATION REGARDING CANADIAN HARNESS AND FOREIGN SEPARATE POOL EVENTS

### GENERAL

All pari-mutuel pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with the regulations and directives as issued by Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada ("the Regulations"), under the approval and supervision of the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency. The Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency can be contacted at 1-800-268-8835 or 613-759-6100 or Email: [cpmawebacpm@agr.gc.ca](mailto:cpmawebacpm@agr.gc.ca). A complete version of the CPMA regulations can be found at <http://laws-lois.justice.gc.ca/eng/regulations/SOR-91-365/>.

All tickets should be held until the result of the race is declared official and prices are posted.

No person under the age of 18 shall purchase or cash a ticket or voucher.

A claim of receiving an incorrect payment or incorrect change must be made to the Mutuel office of the association within twenty four hours of buying or cashing a valid ticket or voucher.

No ruling made by the Stewards/Judges or the Ontario Racing Commission with regard to distribution of purse money or the placing of horses in the order of finish, after the race has been declared official, shall have any bearing on the pay-out prices or distribution of pari-mutuel pools.

Change boards and Photo Finish display monitors are located in the Grandstand. In addition, Photo Finish pictures are shown on the closed-circuit television system. Customers are reminded that mutuel clerks are responsible for all shortages. When making a wager, customers must present sufficient funds at the time of purchase to cover the wagers requested.

### ENTRIES AND MUTUEL FIELDS

"Entry" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled or considered as the same betting interest. The most common reason for the coupling of horses in an Entry is the fact that they are owned by the same person.

"Mutuel Field" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled because the number of horses in the race exceeds the number which can be handled separately by the pari-mutuel system. Subject to the Regulations, a bet on one horse of an Entry or Mutuel Field shall be considered a bet on all horses in that Entry or Mutuel Field.

### DAILY DOUBLE BETTING (INCLUDING LATE DOUBLE)

A Daily Double bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of the two races specified for the Daily Double. Tickets not selecting the winner of the first half of the Daily Double and all tickets in the second half of the Daily Double not coupled with the declared official winner of the first half of the Daily Double are not winners and are not refunded no matter what circumstances affect the running of the second half of the Daily Double.

Should a horse or horses (not coupled with another starter) be excused from starting in the second race of the Daily Double after the first race of the Daily Double has closed for betting, holders of all Daily Double tickets on such horses, coupled with the winner of the first Daily Double race, shall participate in a Consolation Double pool. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

### EXACTA (Also known as Exactor)/TRIFECTA (Also known as Tractor)/SUPERFECTA

An Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first two, three and four horses respectively, representing different betting interests to finish in the exact official order of finish, in the race on which the pool is operated.

### SWINGER (Also known as OMN)

A Swinger is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select horses to finish in any order from the official first 3 positions.

### JACKPOT HI-5

A Jackpot Hi-5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners in the specified Jackpot Hi-5 race. If there are races that have an entry, (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B), Jackpot Hi-5 will not offer a wager consisting of both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in a Jackpot Hi-5, the payout would be 1<sup>st</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup>, 6<sup>th</sup>.

That jackpot portion of the pool will only be paid out if there is a single winning ticket. If there are multiple winning tickets that have correctly chosen the first 5 runners of the race, they will receive 50% of the pool for that day. The other 50% will go over into the Jackpot carryover. If there are no winning tickets with the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners, 100% of the current day's pool will be carried over into the Jackpot.

### PICK 3 & PICK-4 BETTING

The Pick 3 & Pick 4 bets are betting transactions in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of three or four successive races specified for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 respectively.

Winning tickets for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 are determined in the following sequence: A) winners of all legs, B) most winners, then refund. If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners. If there are no winners in any leg of a pool, the entire pool is refunded.

### PICK 5 BETTING

The Pick 5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of five successive races specified for the Pick 5 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 5 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 5.

### PICK 6 BETTING

The Pick 6 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of six successive races specified for the Pick 6 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 6 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 6.

### PICK 5 & 6 BETTING

If at least 1 race as part of the Pick 5 or 6 has been cancelled or declared "No contest", but not more than the specified below under Refunds, the net pool shall be distributed to those selecting the most # of winners and NOT include any carryover from a previous pool.

### PICK 3, PICK 4, PICK 5 & PICK 6 SCRATCHES

In the event a Pick 3, Pick 4, Pick 5 or Pick 6 ticket designates as a selection a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the Stewards/Judges to be a non-starter in any of the races comprising the Pick 3, Pick 4, Pick 5 or Pick 6 the favourite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection. In the event that the money bet in the win pool for two or more favourites is identical, the selection with the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non-starting selection.

However, if a scratch occurs in any leg of the Pick 3, Pick 4, Pick 5 or Pick 6 pools before the pool is closed, a ticket including the scratched horse may be cancelled.

### REFUNDS

Subject to the Regulations, all monies in all pools on a race are refunded in the event that the race is cancelled, declared off or declared no contest, and all monies bet on a horse are refunded if the horse is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start. These refunds will be communicated to the public through various means such as betting terminals, video display, changes boards and our website.

The Pick(n) pool shall be cancelled and all Pick(n) wagers for the individual performance shall be refunded if:

- Pick-3: at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

Where a horse that is part of an Entry is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start and at least one horse of that Entry receives a fair start in the race, all tickets purchased on the Entry remain valid and the purchase price of any such ticket shall not be refunded.

### COMMON POOL WAGERING (INTERTRACK BETTING)

In the unlikely event of a communications or computer system failure that prevents pools from merging with the host track's pools before the end of a race, CPMA regulations require that the site must refund all tickets for that race. This refund will be communicated to the public through various means such as video displays, change boards and messages on our website.

### FAIR START

If a horse has reached the Fair Start Pole (located 200 feet before the Starting Pole) by the time the mobile gate has reached the Starting Pole, that horse is deemed to have had a fair start. It makes no difference whether or not the horse is on or off stride at that precise moment. Under current policy and regulations, which are designed to be as fair as possible to all bettors on all starters, there is no Recall - a repeat of the entire starting procedure - when a horse does not reach the Fair Start Pole before the gate reaches the Starting Pole. Monies bet on such a horse are refunded in accordance with the regulation concerning refunds.

### LOST & OLD TICKETS

WEG issued tickets or vouchers are valid indefinitely, however, they cannot be cashed at a mutuel teller after 2 years from date of issue. Please mail tickets, along with your name and address, to Mutuel Manager, P.O. Box 156, Rexdale, Ontario, M9W 5L2, keeping a photocopy for future reference.

For "Lost Tickets" originally sold at a Woodbine Entertainment Group racetrack or Teletheatre, please enquire at the Mutuel office at Woodbine, Greenwood Teletheatre, or Mohawk. Policy may be subject to change retroactively in the event regulatory bodies amend existing regulations.

### ASSOCIATION PERCENTAGE, AND TAXATION/LEVY

The Woodbine Entertainment Group deducts and retains the following percentages from wagers placed at our own licensed sites which are then shared with the horsepeople, host and simulcast associations and the Ontario Racing Commission.

**WOODBINE/MOHAWK LIVE:** Win, Place & Show: 13.65%. Swinger 14.7%. Trifecta & Pick 4: 21.7%. Double & Exacta 17.2%. Jackpot Hi-5, Pick 5 & Pick 6: 11.7%. All other 23.0%

Horsepeople receive a further 2% on all wagers, except Trifecta wagering where it is 4%. The Ontario Provincial Government retains 0.5% on all bets placed in Ontario. The Canadian Government (through a revolving fund cost recovery basis) retains 0.8% on all wagers placed in Canada for provision of drug control, and audit services.
