Betting Basics

Some essentials to get you started with making a wager.

1 How to wager



Place your bet by visiting a teller, or using a self-serve terminal.

To place a bet here are just 5 things you need to know:

- 1 Name of racetrack (choose from any track in the simulcast feeds)
- 2 Number of the race
- 3 Amount of your bet (e.g. \$2)
- 4 Type of bet (see step 2)
- 5 Horse's number (see step 4)

Once you have decided what you want to bet, head to the nearest seller's window and use the sample statement as your guide:

Hello, (Racetrack), race 6, \$2 to WIN on Horse #4

How to use a self-serve terminal:

- 1 Swipe your Cash Card/Insert Cash
- 2 Enter the initial PIN #1234 (then choose a new PIN)
- 3 Press/Tap the track you would like to bet: (defaults to current race)
- 4 Tap the Horse Number: **#4**
- 5 Press/Tap the Bet Type: **WIN**
- 6 Press/Tap the Bet Amount: **\$2**
- 7 Press/Tap the Race Number: **Race #6**
- 8 Press Green **"Make BET"** button
- 9 Press/Tap the **"Finish with Receipt"** button
- 10 Be sure to check your ticket to confirm it's the bet you wanted

To get a Cash Card or for assistance ask a teller, or a staff member.

2 Types of bets



Single horse bets (minimum \$2.00 bet is required)

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Win	U U U	Your horse must finish 1st; payoff determined by the win odds.
Place	U U	Your horse must finish 1st or 2nd; payoffs better than to show.
Show	U	Your horse must finish 1st, 2nd, or 3rd; modest payoffs.

Exotic multiple-horse bets

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Exacta*	U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st and 2nd in exact order; riskier bet that can pay a little or a lot, depending on the horses' odds.
Daily double	U U U U U	Pick the winners of two designated consecutive races.
Pick 3, Win 4, Pick 5, Pick 6	U U U U U U	Select the winners of a designated set of consecutive races. The wager must be made prior to the start of the first race in the multi-race wager.
Triactor*	U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in exact order; can be expensive to play if you use a lot of horses.
Superfecta*	U U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th; big payoff possible.

* Exotic bets require the horses to finish in the EXACT order you select, unless you "BOX" the bet, in which case your selections can finish in any order.

Race 1 Selections

The Horseplayer's Journal by Garnet Barnsdale

#6 JJ XAVIER raced okay three starts back, then he got a notable driver switch to Tyler Borth on May 17th. That night, Borth worked out a perfect second-over trip tracking fast fractions, and JJ Xavier took care of the rest, pacing away from his rivals in the stretch to lower his lifetime mark to 1:51-flat in his 153rd start. He then tried the front last week, and he couldn't see it through to the wire, same as happened four starts back on May 3rd. Starting from the best post tonight in against at least one speedball, he will almost certainly revert to stalking tactics, and he might be able to work out the same kind of trip that he did when he won at this level on May 17th. He gets top billing to kick off tonight's \$75,000 guaranteed Pick 5.

#9 UNCLE SHANK A gets needed class relief tonight, and it seems likely that he will be blasting off the gate this time. He projects to land in the pocket following Bettor B Going, who comes in off two blowout wins but steps up several levels racing off the claim. This veteran is capable of sticking close to that leader and he could make the first move on the final turn and sprint away from the closers. He is worth a look for the early Pick 5.

#1 PHONE NINE ONE ONE stepped up in class 13 days ago, but it was a logical move coming off two straight wins racing one level lower, and he followed through with another dominating win finished off with a 27 2/5 kicker. He steps up again, but he couldn't be any sharper. If he can work out a covered up trip to the last turn racing close to the front, he could be the one. He is another interesting contender in a good betting race to kick off the card.

#10 WANNABEABIGSTAR on May 17th dropped in for his lowest claiming tag since he shipped here from British Columbia 48 starts ago in January of 2025. He had beaten better fields than he faced that night on several occasions, and with a claim entered, it was thought that he might show more gate speed than he had in previous starts. He dropped back early, though, and he motored late to get up for second behind a sharp rival that was winning for the third straight time. He was out of the Cullen barn for only one start and that came last week when he won racing for trainer Demers. He is sharp but he will likely need to pass them all starting from the widest post. It seems more likely that he will pass a few of them and land on the edges tonight.

#9 PLANKTON HANOVER had a decent two-year-old season, and he qualified well twice for his sophomore debut here on May 2nd. He drew the rail and started third, and he was sent first up after the half to challenge the leader that stole a 29 1/5 second quarter. He was never getting past that rival in a back half that was paced in 55 1/5, and I thought he hung in there well while pacing a 27 2/5 kicker uncovered. Getting off the rail for his second start back, he was an even money winner, making an early move to the front, letting one go, then popping back out of the pocket on the last turn to retake command. Last week, he made an aggressive move out of the pocket to attack the even money favorite on the last turn, and he had gained a slight advantage coming off that turn when he jumped off stride. That was the first time in 16 career miles that he broke stride, so it was probably an anomaly, a speed break as he was accelerating. He can bounce back here.

#5 DR DAVE looked good here winning a leg of the Spring Series with a big late brush, and he raced well in the third leg and the final, but the pace was against him in both of those miles. Last week, racing against Grassroots colts, he sat inside most of the way, and the best he could do was finish a distant fourth to a winner that was scorching the final quarter in 25 4/5. He is in with a better chance tonight and he should get positioned close to the front early in the mile again leaving from one of the best posts.

#4 D A LETS BOOGIE produced his best effort of this four-year-old season in his third start back which was his most recent start. He tried hard racing first up, but he couldn't get past Scorpion Seelster who came right back and beat Plankton Hanover six days later. The colt that finished second that night came out of that mile and finished second behind Beau Jangles in an Ontario Sires Stakes Gold Leg in his next start. This improving gelding is another one that is worth a look for the early Pick 5.

#2 SOLAR VOLTAGE finished off his rookie season in style last year, taking his maiden victory before he hung his harness up for the winter. The son of Always B Miki has some upside, and he qualified well for this sophomore debut, but this step up into non-winners of two isn't easy. I prefer to use him on the bottom tonight.

#8 MAKEMBLUSH HANOVER finished second in a fast mile three starts back where she got off the pylons on the final turn and followed the eventual winner, who she couldn't get to in the stretch because that filly was pacing home in 26 4/5. She missed three weeks drew wide and got an impossible trip in her next start. She was then bet down to 8 to 5 favorite last week, and she came up against a well meant razor sharp filly that neither she nor anyone else could get past. She looks good in here, and she gets top billing to start up tonight's early Pick 4.

#2 CACKLE BERRY qualified well on May 15th then she was sent off as a 25 to 1 longshot for her sophomore debut here a week later. She gapped Makemblush Hanover's cover on the last turn but when that filly tired after getting in a third quarter speed duel, this one came flying late to get second. She is a contender in here, but I wonder if she will get over bet off that mile.

#9 BARB LAHEY gets a look here because she closed in 25 3/5 in her last start in a much improved effort despite not getting a cheque. She draws wide here, but she has shown gate speed in the past. Aggressive teamster Thiessen might decide to send her tonight, and that makes her worth a look tonight.

#6 PEARL WASH was decent in her first two starts, closing for third in both, then she was even better three weeks ago when she made a wide move around the final turn and drove away for her maiden win. She then stepped up to face tougher, and she drew wide and she showed little. Moving to the best post gives her a better chance to get positioned in the top five early, and she can work her way into the exotics.

#6 FRANCO SANTANA N takes a notable class drop tonight after missing getting a cheque in both of his last two starts. He showed little from post 10 two starts back, then he drew best and he blasted off for the lead as expected, but he was soon overtaken and he accepted a pocket ride. He wasn't able to stay with the leaders in a 1:50 1/5 mile, but he did pace in 1:51 2/5 himself. That kind of a mile would probably make him tough to beat, and he surely will get an aggressive Mark Macdonald steer tonight. He gets top billing as we start up tonight's 20-cent Pick 6 wager.

#1 WHATCHULOOKIN AT was expected to improve on the class drop last week, and he did go better, but Jabberwocky bet down to 4 to 5 had designs on bottoming out the field and he did just that. This gelding raced evenly down the lane, and he just got picked off for third in a decent effort. He gets another class drop now, and while he figures to contend, I don't love the rail post for him, and I wouldn't take a short price when he will likely get outsprinted leaving the gate.

#3 LIVINTHEBEACHLIFE has taken three wins so far this season from nine starts, one coming at the bottom of the condition ladder and the other two coming in Pop Up Series legs. He gets to drop in class here, but he must tackle the other two class plungers that are picked ahead of him in this spot. I could see him improving enough to land in the exotics. He is worth a look for use underneath.

#9 RBSTENACIOUS T is another one that is dropping on paper, but how much of a drop is it really when most of the field raced in a higher class in their previous starts. He will likely drop to the back at the start and try to pass them all. I don't see that happening, but he can pass enough of them to get up for a spot in the Tri or Super.

#6 BRANDON BLVD had a nice rookie season last year where he went 7-2-0 from 10 starts and earned more than \$538,000. His fastest win of 1:48 4/5 – which at the time was a Canadian Record – was taken here in his Breeders Crown elimination where he capitalized on a perfect trip and got past some winded leaders in the lane. He sat the pocket in the Final, but he couldn't go with Beau Jangles in the stretch in a mile that broke that Canadian record by a tick. This Andrew Harris trainee doesn't have to contend with Beau Jangles tonight, and he looks best in here.

#7 SWEET LOVIN LOU is another colt that had a good rookie season, taking three wins and five slices from nine starts while earning close to \$250,000. He showed his quality with a good closing effort to get third in the Grade 1 \$1,000,000 Metro Stakes. He got a good tightener in two weeks ago racing against some sharp older pacers where he paced a 53 2/5 back half. He should be the main threat to Brandon Blvd here.

#3 NO WAITLIST is only a one-time winner, but he looks improved at three and he comes off one of his best performances last week. In that Ontario Sires Stakes Gold event, he showed blazing speed from the rail to secure the lead while pacing a 25 4/5 opening quarter, and that deft move facilitated a pocket trip following unbeaten Beau Jangles. He rode that trip to a 25% purse share for finishing second. He gets Doug McNair in the bike tonight and he will likely get put into play leaving the gate. He can ride another good following trip to a piece of this purse.

#8 BORDERLINE MOBBY has been first-over against Beau Jangles in both of his last two starts, and that's a trip that hasn't worked out for any horse to date in Beau's 15 pari-mutuel starts. Starting from a wide post tonight, he will likely be farther back early in the mile, but that will likely mean that he can find a live helmet to follow. I can see him closing for a small share.

#3 JACK PANIC is an infrequent winner partially because he tries so hard and gets lots of cheques and the money he earns keeps him in elevated classed that are tough for him. When he finds the right class though, he can be very tough to beat. A case in point is four starts back when he dropped to this non-winners of \$6,000 last 4 class. He got bet down to 4 to 5 that night and after he made a middle move to the front, he left no doubt. After missing cheques in three straight races, he gets to drop back down to that level again, and he will no doubt get an aggressive Travis Henry steer tonight. He is the one to beat in this opening leg of tonight's middle Pick 5.

#5 CODENAME CIGAR BOX has a similar profile as Jack Panic in that in his last six starts he shows five races where he didn't get a cheque and one emphatic fast win that came in his lone start racing at tonight's class level. Dropping in class and starting from one of the best posts means he will likely blast right to the front. When Jack Panic makes an expected middle move to the front, those two will likely turn for home racing 1-2 then settle it in the battle to the wire.

#7 AQUINAS HANOVER dropped and popped for a narrow win three starts back then he moved back up to this class level for his last two starts where he raced decently to get third in both. Last week, he was in a mile where Jabberwocky simply bottomed out the field. This gelding made a nice late move to get up for third while kicking in 26 4/5 over the wet track. He will likely have too much to do to catch both of the top two picks in here, but I could see him closing for third again.

#1 SILVERWALLS had a terrific season at three last year, taking nine wins from 21 starts, six slices, and earnings of close to \$96,000. His best mark of 1:49 4/5 was taken right here at Mohawk Park. He finished second in this class in his four-year-old debut, and he has the tactical speed to work out a good trip despite starting from the rail. He is worth a look for the bottom of the exotics.

#2 MR WALNER FASHION has been terrific racing here this spring in winning four of five starts and he couldn't be any sharper coming into Leg 1 of this Graduate Series for four-year-olds. His recent miles may not be as fast as some of the invaders in here, but he did take a 1:51 2/5 lifetime best mark in a New Jersey Sires Stake at the Meadowlands last year. I think he will offer a bigger price than his 9 to 2 morning line quote here, and I'll side with him to score the upset.

#8 MR MOUTON was fast at three where he took a mark of 1:50 1/5 and he did it twice at The Red Mile. He raced here in the Grade 1 Breeders Crown in October, and after flashing big gate speed to land in Go Dog Go's pocket, he followed along and raced evenly through the stretch to get the fifth-place cheque. He got a good tightener in for this race on May 15th, now it should be all systems go. He will likely be a big speed threat in here and one that I wouldn't leave off middle Pick 5 tickets.

#9 HEY PORTER strung some wins together including his four-year-old debut in the slop at Pocono, then he stepped into the deep end of the waters facing the best older trotter on the continent in Lexus Kody, Antognoni S, and Periculum in two consecutive starts where he didn't fare as well. He moves into the potent Dave Menary barn tonight and he faces considerably easier here racing in an event restricted to four-year-olds. He should be heard from tonight.

#1 EUROBANK HANOVER had a breaking issue last year where he broke in eight of his 15 miles but won the other seven where he stayed flat. He has seemed to have solved that problem this season as he is 3-1-1 from five starts. He got a qualifier in to tighten up for this Graduate Series leg. I can see him getting a nice following trip and landing in the Tri or Super tonight.

#10 CHRISTOPHER DANCE N was bought in April by heavy hitters Pollack Racing Stable and he moves north and into Dave Menary's barn. He adds Lasix tonight coming in off two qualifiers where he did well chasing top older pacer Ervin Hanover who last October paced the fastest mile in Canadian history here while dominating in the Breeders Crown Final. This son of Sweet Lou was an eight time winner in 13 starts last season and three of those victorious miles were paced under 1:50. He is certainly fast enough for these. The only question is what kind of trip he will get starting from the widest post. He gets top billing to kick off the late Pick 5.

#9 SAULSBROOK VICTOR was a winner here four starts back when he wired a field and he has also been racing on the front recently in the top class at Tioga Downs. He has shown many times in the past that he is capable racing at tonight's class level, and he almost surely will be blasting off the gate tonight. He could be the one to catch turning for home in this spot.

#4 CAPTAIN FEAR NOT comes out of a race where he was impressive in defeat. After following along on the inside to the last turn, he slid off the pylons on fourth-over cover and he looked loaded. He swung wide turning for home, but he was forced a couple of lanes wider than he wanted to be when a rival beside him broke stride. Once he got his momentum back after losing considerable ground, he flew down the middle of the track to get up for second behind a winner that was long gone. This is a sharp gelding that could get ignored in the wagering, and he is worth a look for late multi-race tickets.

#2 ROCHESTER FLASH didn't show much after starting from a wide draw last time now he moves inside from where he should get a better start. I can see him sitting a trip and closing for a slice like he did two starts back in the Open class.

#3 PRINCE HAL HANOVER had a big three-year-old season, earning more than \$1 million, but it could have been even bigger had he not lost the Grade 1 Meadowlands Pace through disqualification. He did win the Adios and he has come back good at four, taking wins in all three of his starts, including the Juravinski Memorial elimination and final. He got a heady steer in the final when pilot Todd McCarthy moved early to the front which forced 2 to 5 favorite Bruno No No No to do the heavy lifting racing first-over. This race on paper looks like it will be another battle between those two and I'll side with this gelding to kick off the late Pick 4.

#2 BRUNO NO NO NO has been terrific since being purchased by Pollack Racing Llc and moving into Dave Menary's barn for this four-year-old season. He has compiled a record of 5-2-1 from eight starts this season, and he as earned more than \$147,000. He lowered his lifetime mark to 1:48 1/5. He was favored to win the Juravinski Final, but he probably lost that race at the start when Prince Hal Hanover got position on him. He is the obvious threat to the top pick in here in a race that seems like a toss up between those two.

#5 SUGAR MAN shipped north for the Juravinski and moved into the Menary barn and the immediate results were good. After racing well to get second in his elimination, he was disregarded by bettors despite starting from the rail. He was sent off at 16 to 1. He got a heads up steer from Louis-Phillipe Roy to take early command of the race so he could then ride a nice pocket trip. Those tactics and trip got him the second place cheque. He draws well here and he will likely be heard from early again. He is sharp, but I don't see him beating both of the top picks racing on the bigger track tonight.

#4 AYEAYE CAPTAIN DEO has been racing decently all season long and he comes into tonight's mile off a sneaky good effort in the Juravinski Final where he paced his final three quarters in 1:21 2/5. I don't see him winning in here, but he should be able to close and find his way into a spot in the bottom of the Tri or Super.

#10 MAJOR MIKI hasn't missed the board in his career which so far is three races contested here last season and his sophomore debut here two weeks ago. He dropped five seconds in his second qualifier preparing for that sophomore debut, then he dropped two more when he finished a good second to up and coming Johnny Angel, who since then came right back to dominate in Leg 1 of the Ontario Sires Stakes Grassroots series, winning easily as the 1 to 9 favorite. There are some decent colts in here, but none of them are Johnny Angel. This son of Always B Miki has a big shot to lead all the way here despite starting from the widest draw, and he gets top billing.

#9 EXACTLY CORRECT didn't show much until his final start last year where he got a driver change to James Macdonald, and the leading driver worked out a winning trip for him for a 10 to 1 upset score. He qualified nicely for this sophomore debut and if he drops a second or two tonight, he can be right there. It's interesting to me that the leading driver chose him over the Millar Farms/Gallucci gelding that is lined up to his left, especially considering that he drove that one to a win last time. Beware.

#1 ONE LUCKY BEACH had a pretty good start to his career last season, taking three wins at three different B tracks following an even debut mile in the Prospect Series. He moved into the Kyle Fellows barn, and he qualified okay here on May 2nd, following along in third for the entire mile, in a race that was dominated by a blowout winner. He was much better in his sophomore debut, racing tough first up to win while lowering his lifetime mark by three seconds. I'm not sure what went wrong in his last start where he finished 24 lengths behind Major Miki. Perhaps an equipment change tonight might help explain that poor performance. He has shown that he is capable of much better.

#5 DYLAN VETT was fancied by no one when he roared down the middle of the track to win at 36 to 1 here after missing close to a year and qualifying just okay. He reproduced his 27 2/t closing quarter in defeat in his second start back and his good late speed could get him a piece of this at a price.

#3 AXIAL was doing great racing against non-winners of three here taking a win and two seconds then two starts back he moved into the tougher Winners of Three But Not More Than Six conditioned class. In his most recent try in that class last week, he was second to 2 to 5 shot Figment, who no one was beating that night. There are no Figments in here, and Doug McNair will likely put him on the lead at some point of this mile then look to see it through from there.

#9 MAJOR THREAT came close to pulling off a big upset over Figment two starts back then he was in a mile where they crawled then sprinted home, and that perhaps isn't his best style. I don't mind the wide draw for him here because I see him clearing then perhaps sitting the pocket following Axial. He could live up to his name coming down the stretch, and he is worth a look in here.

#5 BACKUP PLAN only had 10 starts at three last season, but he did take four wins and three seconds while earning more than \$70,000 and he finished off his abbreviated season with a strong mile in an OSS Gold leg. His first two starts of the year were decent closing efforts, and he was even better in his third start back, closing in 26 1/5 to take his first win of the year. Last week he had no chance in a race where the final quarter was paced in 26 2/5. He is one of the best closers in this race and if there is a big first half cut, he will likely be the one that passes them all in the lane.

#4 BLAZING CRUISER has a similar profile as Axial in that he raced well here two starts back in a non-winners of three mile two starts back, then he raced in the tougher class last week and he finished third behind Axial in that mile. He is only a one-time winner this season from 15 starts though, and he has taken eight slices. He seems more likely to take a share than a win.

#3 CHAIN GANG raced very well in his second start of the year on May 9th considering he was unable to get a good start beginning his mile from the 11-hole. He made a wide move on the last turn to chase after a strong leader that was never going to get caught. He got to drop to this class level a week later, but he drew widest and he dropped to the back and didn't show much, but he did pace a 53 1/5 back half. He finally draws a good post, and we should find out how much he has left in his tank in this spot. I'm thinking there is plenty there, and he gets top billing in this finale.

#5 LEGION SEELSTER scored a huge 29 to 1 upset racing at this class level four starts back when he was given an aggressive steer by Daryl Thiessen and he was dead game to prevail. Since then, he has been in too tough, now he drops and he draws well. He should be heard from tonight, and he will likely offer a square price. He is worth a look for the late multi-race tickets.

#1 BLUE HUNT got needed class relief when he dropped to this level two starts back, and he produced a much better effort immediately, leading to the stretch and landing second in a 1:49-flat mile. He was good again last week closing in 26 2/5 to get third after getting outsprinted early from the rail. He gets a driver upgrade to Travis Cullen here, but I don't love the rail post for him. I see him closing for another share.

#6 JABBERWOCKY dropped and crushed last week; after he stole a 31 1/5 second quarter, that mile was in effect over. He draws well tonight but he faces tougher, and he won't get gifted that same trip tonight. He will likely flash speed and stick around for a small share.

#8 JMR SPEAK AWAY rarely misses getting a cheque, and he will offer a big price tonight starting from a wide post. He could sneak into the bottom of the Tri, Super or High-5 in this spot and this consistent gelding is worth a look for use underneath.

C O N D I T I O N S A N D A L L O W A N C E S I N H A R N E S S R A C I N G - I M P O R T A N T T O K N O W

The conditions of a race determine whether a horse is eligible to enter. For example many races are restricted to horses that have won a certain number of races or a certain amount of money in a specified number of starts. Many races are restricted to horses entered to be "claimed" (offered for sale) at a specific price.

Allowances in the claiming price itself are given to colts and geldings, four-year-olds and younger and to mares, five-year-olds and younger.

The purpose of the allowance is to keep younger horses more competitive when racing against older and more experienced rivals. Mares are given extra consideration in claiming events because of their potential as broodmares.

The accompanying chart shows what the allowances are, but an example may make them easier to understand. The chart indicates that three-year-olds receive a 50% allowance in claiming races. This means that a three-year-old entered in a \$20,000 claiming race carries an actual claiming price of \$30,000 (50% higher).

Fillies and mares receive an additional 25% allowance in claiming races. Details of the race conditions and claiming price (if any) are given at the top of each race in the program.

C.P.M.A. Regulation Changes

Effective January 1st 2012
CPMA will be instituting several new rule changes with regards to the following pari-mutuel pools:

Pick Pools

- If there are no winners in any leg of a Pick N pool, the entire pool is refunded.
- If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners.
- A pool is no longer refunded if the 1st leg in the pool is cancelled or declared no contest.
- Pick-3: If at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: If at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.

EXPLANATION OF THE LASIX PROGRAM

After careful study and consultation with Ontario Horsemen's groups, racetrack operators and veterinarians, Agriculture Canada and the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario passed legislation allowing the controlled (or supervised) administration of furosemide, more commonly called "Lasix". "Lasix" is used to alleviate the symptoms of exercise induced pulmonary hemorrhaging in racing horses. Horses will undergo an endoscopic examination of the trachea by a veterinarian licensed by the Ontario Racing Commission and endorsed by an official veterinarian before being allowed on the medication list. Once qualified, horses will be treated with "Lasix" within four hours plus or minus 15 minutes of a scheduled race in a secure retention area under the super vision of racing officials.

All horses on "Lasix" must remain on the program for a minimum of 100 days while racing in this jurisdiction.

- (L)** Denotes horses treated with Lasix for their last start but not so treated today.

RULES AND INFORMATION REGARDING CANADIAN HARNESS AND FOREIGN SEPARATE POOL EVENTS

GENERAL

All pari-mutuel pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with the regulations and directives as issued by Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada ("the Regulations"), under the approval and supervision of the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency. The Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency can be contacted at 1-800-268-8835 or 613-759-6100 or Email: cpmawebacpm@agr.gc.ca. A complete version of the CPMA regulations can be found at <http://laws-lois.justice.gc.ca/eng/regulations/SOR-91-365/>.

All tickets should be held until the result of the race is declared official and prices are posted.

No person under the age of 18 shall purchase or cash a ticket or voucher.

A claim of receiving an incorrect payment or incorrect change must be made to the Mutuel office of the association within twenty four hours of buying or cashing a valid ticket or voucher.

No ruling made by the Stewards/Judges or the Ontario Racing Commission with regard to distribution of purse money or the placing of horses in the order of finish, after the race has been declared official, shall have any bearing on the pay-out prices or distribution of pari-mutuel pools.

Change boards and Photo Finish display monitors are located in the Grandstand. In addition, Photo Finish pictures are shown on the closed-circuit television system. Customers are reminded that mutuel clerks are responsible for all shortages. When making a wager, customers must present sufficient funds at the time of purchase to cover the wagers requested.

ENTRIES AND MUTUEL FIELDS

"Entry" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled or considered as the same betting interest. The most common reason for the coupling of horses in an Entry is the fact that they are owned by the same person.

"Mutuel Field" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled because the number of horses in the race exceeds the number which can be handled separately by the pari-mutuel system. Subject to the Regulations, a bet on one horse of an Entry or Mutuel Field shall be considered a bet on all horses in that Entry or Mutuel Field.

DAILY DOUBLE BETTING (INCLUDING LATE DOUBLE)

A Daily Double bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of the two races specified for the Daily Double. Tickets not selecting the winner of the first half of the Daily Double and all tickets in the second half of the Daily Double not coupled with the declared official winner of the first half of the Daily Double are not winners and are not refunded no matter what circumstances affect the running of the second half of the Daily Double.

Should a horse or horses (not coupled with another starter) be excused from starting in the second race of the Daily Double after the first race of the Daily Double has closed for betting, holders of all Daily Double tickets on such horses, coupled with the winner of the first Daily Double race, shall participate in a Consolation Double pool. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

EXACTA (Also known as Exactor)/TRIFECTA (Also known as Trifactor)/SUPERFECTA

An Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first two, three and four horses respectively, representing different betting interests to finish in the exact official order of finish, in the race on which the pool is operated.

SWINGER (Also known as OMN)

A Swinger is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select horses to finish in any order from the official first 3 positions.

JACKPOT HI-5

A Jackpot Hi-5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners in the specified Jackpot Hi-5 race. If there are races that have an entry, (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B), Jackpot Hi-5 will not offer a wager consisting of both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in a Jackpot Hi-5, the payout would be 1st, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th.

That jackpot portion of the pool will only be paid out if there is a single winning ticket. If there are multiple winning tickets that have correctly chosen the first 5 runners of the race, they will receive 50% of the pool for that day. The other 50% will go over into the Jackpot carryover. If there are no winning tickets with the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners, 100% of the current day's pool will be carried over into the Jackpot.

PICK 3 & PICK-4 BETTING

The Pick 3 & Pick 4 bets are betting transactions in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of three or four successive races specified for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 respectively.

Winning tickets for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 are determined in the following sequence: A) winners of all legs, B) most winners, then refund. If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners. If there are no winners in any leg of a pool, the entire pool is refunded.

PICK 5 BETTING

The Pick 5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of five successive races specified for the Pick 5 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 5 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 5.

PICK 6 BETTING

The Pick 6 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of six successive races specified for the Pick 6 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 6 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 6.

PICK 5 & 6 BETTING

If at least 1 race as part of the Pick 5 or 6 has been cancelled or declared "No contest", but not more than the specified below under Refunds, the net pool shall be distributed to those selecting the most # of winners and NOT include any carryover from a previous pool.

PICK 3, PICK 4, PICK 5 & PICK 6 SCRATCHES

In the event a Pick 3, Pick 4, Pick 5 or Pick 6 ticket designates as a selection a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the Stewards/Judges to be a non-starter in any of the races comprising the Pick 3, Pick 4, Pick 5 or Pick 6 the favourite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection. In the event that the money bet in the win pool for two or more favourites is identical, the selection with the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non-starting selection.

However, if a scratch occurs in any leg of the Pick 3, Pick 4, Pick 5 or Pick 6 pools before the pool is closed, a ticket including the scratched horse may be cancelled.

REFUNDS

Subject to the Regulations, all monies in all pools on a race are refunded in the event that the race is cancelled, declared off or declared no contest, and all monies bet on a horse are refunded if the horse is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start. These refunds will be communicated to the public through various means such as betting terminals, video display, changes boards and our website.

The Pick(n) pool shall be cancelled and all Pick(n) wagers for the individual performance shall be refunded if:

- Pick-3: at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

Where a horse that is part of an Entry is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start and at least one horse of that Entry receives a fair start in the race, all tickets purchased on the Entry remain valid and the purchase price of any such ticket shall not be refunded.

COMMON POOL WAGERING (INTERTRACK BETTING)

In the unlikely event of a communications or computer system failure that prevents pools from merging with the host track's pools before the end of a race, CPMA regulations require that the site must refund all tickets for that race. This refund will be communicated to the public through various means such as video displays, change boards and messages on our website.

FAIR START

If a horse has reached the Fair Start Pole (located 200 feet before the Starting Pole) by the time the mobile gate has reached the Starting Pole, that horse is deemed to have had a fair start. It makes no difference whether or not the horse is on or off stride at that precise moment. Under current policy and regulations, which are designed to be as fair as possible to all bettors on all starters, there is no Recall - a repeat of the entire starting procedure - when a horse does not reach the Fair Start Pole before the gate reaches the Starting Pole. Monies bet on such a horse are refunded in accordance with the regulation concerning refunds.

LOST & OLD TICKETS

WEG issued tickets or vouchers are valid indefinitely, however, they cannot be cashed at a mutuel teller after 2 years from date of issue. Please mail tickets, along with your name and address, to Mutuel Manager, P.O. Box 156, Rexdale, Ontario, M9W 5L2, keeping a photocopy for future reference.

For "Lost Tickets" originally sold at a Woodbine Entertainment Group racetrack or Teletheatre, please enquire at the Mutuel office at Woodbine, Greenwood Teletheatre, or Mohawk. Policy may be subject to change retroactively in the event regulatory bodies amend existing regulations.

ASSOCIATION PERCENTAGE, AND TAXATION/LEVY

The Woodbine Entertainment Group deducts and retains the following percentages from wagers placed at our own licensed sites which are then shared with the horsepeople, host and simulcast associations and the Ontario Racing Commission.

WOODBINE/MOHAWK LIVE: Win, Place & Show: 13.65%. Swinger 14.7%. Trifecta & Pick 4: 21.7%. Double & Exacta 17.2%. Jackpot Hi-5, Pick 5 & Pick 6: 11.7%. All other 23.0%

Horsepeople receive a further 2% on all wagers, except Trifecta wagering where it is 4%. The Ontario Provincial Government retains 0.5% on all bets placed in Ontario. The Canadian Government (through a revolving fund cost recovery basis) retains 0.8% on all wagers placed in Canada for provision of drug control, and audit services.
