Betting Basics

Some essentials to get you started with making a wager.

1 How to wager



Place your bet by visiting a teller, or using a self-serve terminal.

To place a bet here are just 5 things you need to know:

- 1 Name of racetrack (choose from any track in the simulcast feeds)
- 2 Number of the race
- 3 Amount of your bet (e.g. \$2)
- 4 Type of bet (see step 2)
- 5 Horse's number (see step 4)

Once you have decided what you want to bet, head to the nearest seller's window and use the sample statement as your guide:

Hello, (Racetrack), race 6, \$2 to WIN on Horse #4

How to use a self-serve terminal:

- 1 Swipe your Cash Card/Insert Cash
- 2 Enter the initial PIN #1234 (then choose a new PIN)
- 3 Press/Tap the track you would like to bet: (defaults to current race)
- 4 Tap the Horse Number: **#4**
- 5 Press/Tap the Bet Type: **WIN**
- 6 Press/Tap the Bet Amount: **\$2**
- 7 Press/Tap the Race Number: **Race #6**
- 8 Press Green **"Make BET"** button
- 9 Press/Tap the **"Finish with Receipt"** button
- 10 Be sure to check your ticket to confirm it's the bet you wanted

To get a Cash Card or for assistance ask a teller, or a staff member.

2 Types of bets



Single horse bets (minimum \$2.00 bet is required)

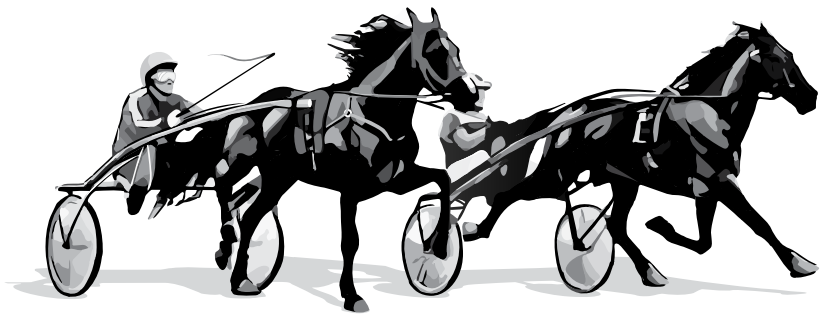
Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Win	U U U	Your horse must finish 1st; payoff determined by the win odds.
Place	U U	Your horse must finish 1st or 2nd; payoffs better than to show.
Show	U	Your horse must finish 1st, 2nd, or 3rd; modest payoffs.

Exotic multiple-horse bets

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Exacta*	U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st and 2nd in exact order; riskier bet that can pay a little or a lot, depending on the horses' odds.
Daily double	U U U U U	Pick the winners of two designated consecutive races.
Pick 3, Win 4, Pick 5, Pick 6	U U U U U U	Select the winners of a designated set of consecutive races. The wager must be made prior to the start of the first race in the multi-race wager.
Triactor*	U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in exact order; can be expensive to play if you use a lot of horses.
Superfecta*	U U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th; big payoff possible.

* Exotic bets require the horses to finish in the EXACT order you select, unless you "BOX" the bet, in which case your selections can finish in any order.

All of the numbers and letters in the program might seem confusing or overwhelming at first, but focusing on these sections makes choosing a horse simple.

- 1 Horse's number in the race
- 2 Horse's post position colour
- 3 Horse's colour, sex, age, sire (father), dam (mother), sire of the dam
- 4 Morning line odds
- 5 Horse's name
- 6 Driver and Driver Record (Name, # of wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, winning %)
- 7 Trainer information
- 8 Horse's Lifetime record (with best win time, track size, track, age, lifetime wins and lifetime earnings)
- 9 Horse's current record (# of races, # wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, and money earned)

4 The odds



Odds are also important to consider when choosing your horse. Horses that are thought to have a better chance of winning will typically have lower odds.

Morning line odds

Odds listed in the race program are the "morning line" odds. These are predictions of how the public will bet on the race. They are set by the track's handicapper when the race program is published, before the wagering starts.

The actual odds will be posted on the **Television** or in-field on the **Tote Board** before the race; they change up until post time, depending on how customers are betting on each horse in the race.

Calculating a \$2 win prize

To calculate a win prize, find the Odds of a horse on the **Television** or **Tote Board** (in-field board).

Multiply the first number by 2, then divide that number by the second digit (if there is one), and then add \$2. Simple as that!

Odds	1/2	2/1	7/2	5/1	10/1
Pays	\$3.00	\$6.00	\$9.00	\$12.00	\$22.00

Helpful facts for betting

- Some racetracks have a television simulcast commentator who tries to identify winning horses (handicaps) between the races. Listen and see if you can pick up any good tips to bet on.
- A good betting method is to choose horses with current odds two to three times higher than their morning line odds.

3 Tips to remember

WIN BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 32% of the time
PLACE BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 53% of the time
SHOW BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 67% of the time

Race 1 Selections

The Horseplayer's Journal by Garnet Barnsdale

#5 EXACTLY was a \$180,000 Lexington yearling being a son of top sire Bar Hopping and he was a winner at first asking at two, taking a Kentucky Sires Stake in his first try. He finished a close second to Grand Circuit winner Strobe Lite in his qualifier prepping for his sophomore debut, then he was placed on the Judges list for performance; the horse tried to pull up in the first turn. He was much better in his qualifier on May 4th when he closed along the inside landing third in a three-pronged stretch battle where he was being asked for nothing. He parlayed that good qualifying effort into a sharp win where he trotted a big back half racing first-over, flying home in 27 1/5 to secure his second win in his ninth start. He stepped up one level in his third start of the year, and he motored home in 27-flat to take a repeat score. His start last week in a Grand Circuit elimination is a toss because he broke at the start and lost all chance. He fits better in this field, and he gets the nod to kick off tonight's \$75,000 guaranteed Pick 5.

#2 FIRST CLASS MASS dropped from the SBOA Final to a much easier Grassroots race last time and he moved to the best post. He was sent straight to the front and he converted, as expected by bettors that made him a 1 to 5 favorite. He established a new lifetime mark that night, but his best winning time is more than two seconds slower than Exactly's so he will likely need to improve to take down that rival tonight, assuming that they both stay flat.

#1 MIKE ME UP was good in both the SBOA elimination and final to start his season, then he raced in an Ontario Sires Stakes Gold event where he got an impossible trip. Last week, he tried the Grand Circuit route, racing in the Goodtimes elimination, and he was simply out of his element, especially trying to close from the back. He did trot a 55 back half, and he is worth a look here tonight in what should be an easier spot.

#3 L P BAY showed some ability last year at two, winning the \$75,000 Grassroots Final as a big bomb then qualifying for the Grade 1 Breeders Crown Final. Coming into last week's mile, it was noted that he had some excuses in previous miles, but last week he got a clean trip and clear sailing, and he raced well in defeat to a repeat winner that peeled off his cover in the lane and sailed past him. He is in tougher here, but he can get another piece of this.

WARM-UP PAD

#1 JOHNNY ANGEL looked like a good colt on debut here on April 3rd. After dropping back early, he pulled from sixth and the horse racing in front of him pulled a fraction of a second before this gelding made that move. Instead of following that rival, he was sent three-wide around him. He took over the lead on the final turn and sprinted home in 27-flat much to convert at 1 to 5. He looked just as impressive in his next start, firing a 26 2/5 final quarter to win going away. He was sent off at 1 to 5 in his third start despite starting from post 10, and he looked a winner at the head of the lane, but he got picked off late. His final quarter of 28 2/5 was the slowest of his young career, and after adding Lasix on May 16th, he kicked home in 25 4/5 to obliterate his previous lifetime best mark by more than two seconds. He comes in off a Grassroots win showing a stale date, but that was no issue on May 16th, so I don't expect it to be a problem tonight.

#6 WHOLETHE DOGS OUT showed some promise at two when he rallied from last in a field of eight to win his debut while showing a big late kick. He displayed an even bigger closing burst in his second start this year when he powered home in 25 4/5 to fall just short of taking a second win. Since then, he has been in too tough, and he did okay last Saturday to be beaten only four lengths in his North America Cup elimination, just missing qualifying for the \$1 million final. He will be heard from late tonight, and he is in with a chance as long as Johnny Angel doesn't get away on the lead.

#4 NEVERLEAVE HARLAN broke his maiden as the 4 to 5 favorite two starts back on a night where he got a great following trip and converted. He faced tougher last week, and he didn't get an easy trip that night, but he came first over and he pulled away for a new lifetime mark. He faces considerably tougher again tonight, but he is improving rapidly. I could see him taking a slice if he can get a covered trip this time.

#7 JIMS FIRST DATE was claimed by Carmen Auciello two starts back, and after qualifying on June 1st he produced a big final quarter last week when he closed 14 lengths to get up for fourth. #5 SHANES DREAM is the stablemate to the top choice here and he too is an infrequent winner having taken only one win from nine starts so far this season. He moves from a tough claiming handicap to the bottom of the condition ladder, and he figures to benefit greatly from that class drop. He chased home a 1:49 1/5 winner last week and he gained six and a half lengths in the back half in his first start in three months. He should be nicely tightened for this try against easier tonight, and I would think that teamster Drury will put him into plat early starting from one of the best posts. He is one of several to consider using in this opening leg of tonight's early Pick 4.

#8 LARCENY got Daryl Thiessen in the bike two starts back, and he was given a much more aggressive steer than in previous starts. After blasting to the front, he was overtaken by a rival that opened up a lead to the three quarters, and this gelding had trouble keeping up. He reversed tactics last week, dropping back then closing late to get up for fourth while pacing a 27 2/5 kicker that was his fastest in five starts since returning from a one month break in May. He was the beneficiary of a fast early pace that slowed late last Monday at Grand River when he got up to score over a decent field. He will likely sit back and look to close again tonight, and he is the third one in her that I would consider using on early multi race tickets.

#1 DUCK DYNASTY showed big improvement in his last two starts, dropping close to six seconds from his 1:59 mile at Flamboro Downs on May 3rd. He will likely be aggressive early in this mile that doesn't seem to have many quick leavers. I could see him getting spotted near the front and getting a good trip. He can stick around for a slice at a square price.

#6 R PEAKY BLINDERS takes a huge class drop tonight into this non-winners of \$9,000 last four field when you consider that only five starts back, he beat the likes of Usain Hanover and Osceola racing first-over at one level below the top class here. He also gets the best post, and I would expect that regular pilot Tyler Borth will look to go right down the road with him tonight. He will likely be a popular single in this opening leg of tonight's 20-cent Pick 6 wager.

#8 OUTSIDE THE FIRE is the other big class dropper in here, and one could make a case for him by simply looking at last week's result where he finished ahead of R Peaky Blinders racing a couple of levels higher than tonight's class. Like the top pick in here, he too was a winner five starts back and it was on the same night. He beat easier than R Peaky Blinder did, but he trotted a faster mile that night. He gets top billing in this opening leg of tonight's late Pick 5.

#4 P L SPENCER had an excellent sophomore season where he won 10 of 16 starts and earned more than \$528,000. He finished off the season with four straight wins, the final one coming in the \$300,000 Ontario Sires Stakes Superfinal. He was driven conservatively in his first two starts of this year, and he closed for small shares in both. He got aggressive in his third start, making front, sitting pocket, then popping back out to challenge on the last turn before fading. He drew best last week, worked out a perfect trip, and got the job done as the 8 to 5 second choice, and he lowered his lifetime mark to an impressive 1:51 1/5. She got sent forward leaving the gate and found the pocket following the 3 to 2 second choice. She kicked off her sophomore campaign with an even race in this class, and I think tonight's field is tougher. She can get another good prep in for her three-year-old stakes campaign, and she can close for a slice.

#3 LEGION SEELSTER hasn't taken a single cheque in any of his last four starts but the silver lining in that cloud is that gets to take a multi-level class drop tonight, and he should be mighty tough in here when you consider that he was a strong first-over winner racing two classes higher than tonight's six starts back. He gets driver Louis-Phillipe Roy back in the bike tonight and that pilot will likely provide an aggressive steer in this spot. He is the one to beat tonight.

#6 JACK PANIC is the other class dropper in here that rates highly and he comes out of a wild race where there was a ton of action that contributed to some wild fractions being set. He tried racing first-over into the teeth of a 1:21 three quarters, and he tired like many others as a 55 to 1 shot out staggered the field home to score the big upset. This veteran gelding was a blowout front end winner five starts back racing one class higher than tonight's and he was the 4 to 5 favorite tonight. His strategy will be no secret tonight. Starting from the best post he will almost certainly look to bottom out the field, and he will probably be the one that Legion Seelster will need to chase down in the stretch.

#2 CAPTAIN HURLEY is the third class dropper in here that merits a close look being that only two starts back, he raced in the fastest mile in Canada this year in the Graduate Series. Last week, he was in tough again racing in a sub-1:50 mile. He typically isn't the fastest leaver and that could put him behind the eight ball in this field. I prefer to use him underneath the top two, but he isn't without a chance.

#8 PREMIER FIRST STAR dropped to the bottom of the condition ladder two starts back and he crushed then he moved up two levels last week and after taking a shuffle, he closed in traffic to get up for fourth. It is a tall order to expect him to beat all of the top three picks in here, but I could see him landing in the bottom of the Tri or Super.

#5 GALEN ERSO had a nice sophomore campaign last year where he was an Ontario Sires Stakes Gold winner who took two other wins and three slices from 16 starts while earning more than \$268,000. He has found some of the upper conditioned classes tough sledding to start off his four-year-old campaign, now he gets to drop two class levels. He also draws one of the best posts tonight. If there is a spot where he is going to wake up, this is probably right here. He gets top billing in the finale.

#1 MYFRIENDJOSE was bet down to 1 to 5 racing at this level two starts back following a mile where raced better three starts back when he dropped in class, closing along the pylons in deep stretch to get fourth while kicking home in 28-flat. He predictably set the pace in that mile two starts back, but he couldn't see it through as the big favorite. He seems to race better when he is chasing and passing horses, and he stepped up in class on May 31st and produced a nice late rally to get fourth. Starting from the rail, he will likely drop back and look to set up a late rally, and he is capable of beating these.

#8 MISTER MAGIC at 11 years old just keeps rolling along, and it was impressive to see him take two wins in four days, racing first-over in both, and drawing away from his rivals in the stretch. You'd be hard pressed to find a more consistent racehorse on this circuit, and he couldn't be any sharper. His challenge tonight is the step out of his comfort zone as he rises in class. The only other time he raced in a \$30,000 optional claimer this year, he finished seventh, but I can see him landing in the Tri tonight.

#7 ROXIE HART dropped to this class level last week and she produced a decent rally to get fourth. She has a decent chance to work her way into the Super again tonight.

#2 ZIP ME UP steps up in class tonight, but he is in solid form, and he can likely work out a nice following trip and work his way into the High-5.

CONDITIONS AND ALLOWANCES IN HARNESS RACING - IMPORTANT TO KNOW

The conditions of a race determine whether a horse is eligible to enter. For example many races are restricted to horses that have won a certain number of races or a certain amount of money in a specified number of starts. Many races are restricted to horses entered to be "claimed" (offered for sale) at a specific price.

Allowances in the claiming price itself are given to colts and geldings, four-year-olds and younger and to mares, five-year-olds and younger.

The purpose of the allowance is to keep younger horses more competitive when racing against older and more experienced rivals. Mares are given extra consideration in claiming events because of their potential as broodmares.

The accompanying chart shows what the allowances are, but an example may make them easier to understand. The chart indicates that three-year-olds receive a 50% allowance in claiming races. This means that a three-year-old entered in a \$20,000 claiming race carries an actual claiming price of \$30,000 (50% higher).

Fillies and mares receive an additional 25% allowance in claiming races. Details of the race conditions and claiming price (if any) are given at the top of each race in the program.

ALLOWANCES FOR PURSE EARNINGS

When Fillies/Mares compete against Colts/Geldings (normally on the trot) Fillies/Mares will receive an additional 25% on the condition of the race. ie: nw \$5,000 (FM \$6,250) last 5 or \$12,000 (FM \$15,000) last 10 starts.

C.P.M.A. Regulation Changes

Effective January 1st 2012
CPMA will be instituting several new rule changes with regards to the following pari-mutuel pools:

Pick Pools

- If there are no winners in any leg of a Pick N pool, the entire pool is refunded.
- If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners.
- A pool is no longer refunded if the 1st leg in the pool is cancelled or declared no contest.
- Pick-3: If at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: If at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.

EXPLANATION OF THE LASIX PROGRAM

After careful study and consultation with Ontario Horsemen's groups, racetrack operators and veterinarians, Agriculture Canada and the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario passed legislation allowing the controlled (or supervised) administration of furosemide, more commonly called "Lasix". "Lasix" is used to alleviate the symptoms of exercise induced pulmonary hemorrhaging in racing horses. Horses will undergo an endoscopic examination of the trachea by a veterinarian licensed by the Ontario Racing Commission and endorsed by an official veterinarian before being allowed on the medication list. Once qualified, horses will be treated with "Lasix" within four hours plus or minus 15 minutes of a scheduled race in a secure retention area under the super vision of racing officials.

All horses on "Lasix" must remain on the program for a minimum of 100 days while racing in this jurisdiction.

RULES AND INFORMATION REGARDING CANADIAN HARNESS AND FOREIGN SEPARATE POOL EVENTS

GENERAL

All pari-mutuel pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with the regulations and directives as issued by Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada ("the Regulations"), under the approval and supervision of the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency. The Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency can be contacted at 1-800-268-8835 or 613-759-6100 or Email: cpmawebacpm@agr.gc.ca. A complete version of the CPMA regulations can be found at <http://laws-lois.justice.gc.ca/eng/regulations/SOR-91-385/>.

All tickets should be held until the result of the race is declared official and prices are posted.

No person under the age of 18 shall purchase or cash a ticket or voucher.

A claim of receiving an incorrect payment or incorrect change must be made to the Mutuel office of the association within twenty four hours of buying or cashing a valid ticket or voucher.

No ruling made by the Stewards/Judges or the Ontario Racing Commission with regard to distribution of purse money or the placing of horses in the order of finish, after the race has been declared official, shall have any bearing on the pay-out prices or distribution of pari-mutuel pools.

Change boards and Photo Finish display monitors are located in the Grandstand. In addition, Photo Finish pictures are shown on the closed-circuit television system. Customers are reminded that mutuel clerks are responsible for all shortages. When making a wager, customers must present sufficient funds at the time of purchase to cover the wagers requested.

ENTRIES AND MUTUEL FIELDS

"Entry" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled or considered as the same betting interest. The most common reason for the coupling of horses in an Entry is the fact that they are owned by the same person.

"Mutuel Field" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled because the number of horses in the race exceeds the number which can be handled separately by the pari-mutuel system. Subject to the Regulations, a bet on one horse of an Entry or Mutuel Field shall be considered a bet on all horses in that Entry or Mutuel Field.

DAILY DOUBLE BETTING (INCLUDING LATE DOUBLE)

A Daily Double bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of the two races specified for the Daily Double. Tickets not selecting the winner of the first half of the Daily Double and all tickets in the second half of the Daily Double not coupled with the declared official winner of the first half of the Daily Double are not winners and are not refunded no matter what circumstances affect the running of the second half of the Daily Double.

Should a horse or horses (not coupled with another starter) be excused from starting in the second race of the Daily Double after the first race of the Daily Double has closed for betting, holders of all Daily Double tickets on such horses, coupled with the winner of the first Daily Double race, shall participate in a Consolation Double pool. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

EXACTA (Also known as Exactor)/TRIFECTA (Also known as Trifactor)/SUPERFECTA

An Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first two, three and four horses respectively, representing different betting interests to finish in the exact official order of finish, in the race on which the pool is operated.

SWINGER (Also known as OMN)

A Swinger is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select horses to finish in any order from the official first 3 positions.

JACKPOT HI-5

A Jackpot Hi-5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners in the specified Jackpot Hi-5 race. If there are races that have an entry, (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B), Jackpot Hi-5 will not offer a wager consisting of both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in a Jackpot Hi-5, the payout would be 1st, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th.

That jackpot portion of the pool will only be paid out if there is a single winning ticket. If there are multiple winning tickets that have correctly chosen the first 5 runners of the race, they will receive 50% of the pool for that day. The other 50% will go over into the Jackpot carryover. If there are no winning tickets with the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners, 100% of the current day's pool will be carried over into the Jackpot.

PICK 3 & PICK-4 BETTING

The Pick 3 & Pick 4 bets are betting transactions in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of three or four successive races specified for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 respectively.

Winning tickets for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 are determined in the following sequence: A) winners of all legs, B) most winners, then refund. If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners. If there are no winners in any leg of a pool, the entire pool is refunded.

PICK 5 BETTING

The Pick 5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of five successive races specified for the Pick 5 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 5 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 5.

PICK 6 BETTING

The Pick 6 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of six successive races specified for the Pick 6 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 6 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 6.

PICK 5 & 6 BETTING

If at least 1 race as part of the Pick 5 or 6 has been cancelled or declared "No contest", but not more than the specified below under Refunds, the net pool shall be distributed to those selecting the most # of winners and NOT include any carryover from a previous pool.

PICK 3, PICK 4, PICK 5 & PICK 6 SCRATCHES

In the event a Pick 3, Pick 4, Pick 5 or Pick 6 ticket designates as a selection a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the Stewards/Judges to be a non-starter in any of the races comprising the Pick 3, Pick 4, Pick 5 or Pick 6 the favourite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection. In the event that the money bet in the win pool for two or more favourites is identical, the selection with the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non-starting selection.

However, if a scratch occurs in any leg of the Pick 3, Pick 4, Pick 5 or Pick 6 pools before the pool is closed, a ticket including the scratched horse may be cancelled.

REFUNDS

Subject to the Regulations, all monies in all pools on a race are refunded in the event that the race is cancelled, declared off or declared no contest, and all monies bet on a horse are refunded if the horse is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start. These refunds will be communicated to the public through various means such as betting terminals, video display, changes boards and our website.

The Pick(n) pool shall be cancelled and all Pick(n) wagers for the individual performance shall be refunded if:

- Pick-3: at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

Where a horse that is part of an Entry is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start and at least one horse of that Entry receives a fair start in the race, all tickets purchased on the Entry remain valid and the purchase price of any such ticket shall not be refunded.

COMMON POOL WAGERING (INTERTRACK BETTING)

In the unlikely event of a communications or computer system failure that prevents pools from merging with the host track's pools before the end of a race, CPMA regulations require that the site must refund all tickets for that race. This refund will be communicated to the public through various means such as video displays, change boards and messages on our website.

FAIR START

If a horse has reached the Fair Start Pole (located 200 feet before the Starting Pole) by the time the mobile gate has reached the Starting Pole, that horse is deemed to have had a fair start. It makes no difference whether or not the horse is on or off stride at that precise moment. Under current policy and regulations, which are designed to be as fair as possible to all bettors on all starters, there is no Recall - a repeat of the entire starting procedure - when a horse does not reach the Fair Start Pole before the gate reaches the Starting Pole. Monies bet on such a horse are refunded in accordance with the regulation concerning refunds.

LOST & OLD TICKETS

WEG issued tickets or vouchers are valid indefinitely, however, they cannot be cashed at a mutuel teller after 2 years from date of issue. Please mail tickets, along with your name and address, to Mutuel Manager, P.O. Box 156, Rexdale, Ontario, M9W 5L2, keeping a photocopy for future reference.

For "Lost Tickets" originally sold at a Woodbine Entertainment Group racetrack or Teletheatre, please enquire at the Mutuel office at Woodbine, Greenwood Teletheatre, or Mohawk. Policy may be subject to change retroactively in the event regulatory bodies amend existing regulations.

ASSOCIATION PERCENTAGE, AND TAXATION/LEVY

The Woodbine Entertainment Group deducts and retains the following percentages from wagers placed at our own licensed sites which are then shared with the horsepeople, host and simulcast associations and the Ontario Racing Commission.

WOODBINE/MOHAWK LIVE: Win, Place & Show: 13.65%. Swinger 14.7%. Trifecta & Pick 4: 21.7%. Double & Exacta 17.2%. Jackpot Hi-5, Pick 5 & Pick 6: 11.7%. All other 23.0%

Horsepeople receive a further 2% on all wagers, except Trifecta wagering where it is 4%. The Ontario Provincial Government retains 0.5% on all bets placed in Ontario. The Canadian Government (through a revolving fund cost recovery basis) retains 0.8% on all wagers placed in Canada for provision of drug control, and audit services.
