Betting Basics

Some essentials to get you started with making a wager.

1 How to wager



Place your bet by visiting a teller, or using a self-serve terminal.

To place a bet here are just 5 things you need to know:

- 1 Name of racetrack (choose from any track in the simulcast feeds)
- 2 Number of the race
- 3 Amount of your bet (e.g. \$2)
- 4 Type of bet (see step 2)
- 5 Horse's number (see step 4)

Once you have decided what you want to bet, head to the nearest seller's window and use the sample statement as your guide:

Hello, (Racetrack), race 6, \$2 to WIN on Horse #4

How to use a self-serve terminal:

- 1 Swipe your Cash Card/Insert Cash
- 2 Enter the initial PIN #1234 (then choose a new PIN)
- 3 Press/Tap the track you would like to bet: (defaults to current race)
- 4 Tap the Horse Number: **#4**
- 5 Press/Tap the Bet Type: **WIN**
- 6 Press/Tap the Bet Amount: **\$2**
- 7 Press/Tap the Race Number: **Race #6**
- 8 Press Green **"Make BET"** button
- 9 Press/Tap the **"Finish with Receipt"** button
- 10 Be sure to check your ticket to confirm it's the bet you wanted

To get a Cash Card or for assistance ask a teller, or a staff member.

2 Types of bets



Single horse bets (minimum \$2.00 bet is required)

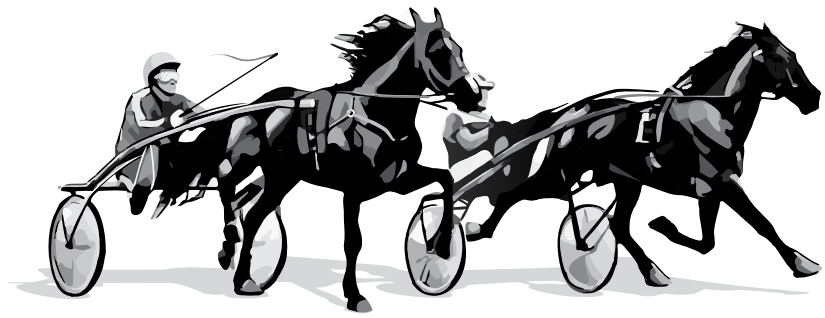
Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Win	U U U	Your horse must finish 1st; payoff determined by the win odds.
Place	U U	Your horse must finish 1st or 2nd; payoffs better than to show.
Show	U	Your horse must finish 1st, 2nd, or 3rd; modest payoffs.

Exotic multiple-horse bets

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Exacta*	U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st and 2nd in exact order; riskier bet that can pay a little or a lot, depending on the horses' odds.
Daily double	U U U U U	Pick the winners of two designated consecutive races.
Pick 3, Win 4, Pick 5, Pick 6	U U U U U U	Select the winners of a designated set of consecutive races. The wager must be made prior to the start of the first race in the multi-race wager.
Triactor*	U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in exact order; can be expensive to play if you use a lot of horses.
Superfecta*	U U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th; big payoff possible.

* Exotic bets require the horses to finish in the EXACT order you select, unless you "BOX" the bet, in which case your selections can finish in any order.

All of the numbers and letters in the program might seem confusing or overwhelming at first, but focusing on these sections makes choosing a horse simple.

- Horse's number in the race
- Horse's post position colour
- Horse's colour, sex, age, sire (father), dam (mother), sire of the dam
- Morning line odds
- Horse's name
- Driver and Driver Record (Name, # of wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, winning %)

- Trainer information
- Horse's Lifetime record (with best win time, track size, track, age, lifetime wins and lifetime earnings)
- Horse's current record (# of races, # wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, and money earned)

4 The odds



Odds are also important to consider when choosing your horse. Horses that are thought to have a better chance of winning will typically have lower odds.

Morning line odds

Odds listed in the race program are the "morning line" odds. These are predictions of how the public will bet on the race. They are set by the track's handicapper when the race program is published, before the wagering starts.

The actual odds will be posted on the **Television** or in-field on the **Tote Board** before the race; they change up until post time, depending on how customers are betting on each horse in the race.

Calculating a \$2 win prize

To calculate a win prize, find the Odds of a horse on the **Television** or **Tote Board** (in-field board).

Multiply the first number by 2, then divide that number by the second digit (if there is one), and then add \$2. Simple as that!

Odds	1/2	2/1	7/2	5/1	10/1
Pays	\$3.00	\$6.00	\$9.00	\$12.00	\$22.00

Helpful facts for betting

- Some racetracks have a television simulcast commentator who tries to identify winning horses (handicaps) between the races. Listen and see if you can pick up any good tips to bet on.
- A good betting method is to choose horses with current odds two to three times higher than their morning line odds.

3 Tips to remember

WIN BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 32% of the time
PLACE BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 53% of the time
SHOW BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 67% of the time

#8 CANT TURN YOU DOWN is a homebred Cattlewash daughter that is the third foal from her dam. Her two siblings are both winners, including 1:50 (S.) pacer Reign Supreme (13 wins, \$221K). She took a lot of action in her second start, and she was an impressive front end winner that night. She then raced here on July 2nd, and she raced well in defeat. After parking past the quarter, she dropped into the available pocket. From there, she stayed in until the stretch where she tried the inside route but got shut off. After twisting and turning, she found a seam, but the 4 to 5 favorite had already sailed past and was long gone. This filly finished with plenty of pace and was a clear second at the wire. She came back eight days later, and she left nothing to chance that night, taking the lead at the half then powering away from the field. Her 1:51 4/5 mile with a 26 3/5 kicker makes her a standout here despite the class rise. She will likely be singled on many tickets in tonight's \$75,000 guaranteed Pick 5.

#7 TEESHA SEELSTER is only 1 for 12 so far, but she has been second five times, including in two of her last three starts where she wasn't far back at the wire. She will likely get sent forward leaving the gate again tonight, and I could see her working out a pocket trip tonight and finishing second again.

#2 FAVORITISM makes her sophomore debut here coming out of two qualifiers where she kicked home in 26 and change both times. She paced the fastest mile of her life in that July 6th qualifier, and she should be passing rivals late, but I prefer to use her underneath in this first start at three.

#10 JAYPORT DIAMOND was 0 for 5 last year, but she has already taken three wins from nine starts, including two of her last three racing on the B tracks. Her best game is her early speed, but she will likely be forced to take a seat early here starting from the widest post. If she can find a spot in the top five early, I could see her landing in the bottom of the Tri or Super at a price.

#7 SPEEDY MICHAEL is a King Of The North colt being that is out of Safekeeping which makes him a half brother to Safe Conduct who was an Ontario Sires Stakes Superfinal winner here at three and later in his career won several Open Trots here. This colt showed something in his second qualifier, taking over the lead passing the quarter then dominating from there to the wire. He was good in his pari-mutuel debut, too, racing first-over chasing the even money favorite home. That rival was just too good for him that night. He draws decently here, and I'll give him top billing expecting him to get a more aggressive steer tonight.

#5 DA TRIXTER brought only \$16,000 at the London Classic Sale, and the son of Trixton earned all but \$1,000 of it back in his winning Grassroots debut here two weeks ago. In that mile, he rode Great White North's cover to the stretch, and he angled inside when that rival drifted out a few lanes in mid stretch. This gelding kicked in late and won the sprint to the wire. He looks the main threat to the top pick here.

#1 KING OF THE SOUTH comes into this third start off two decent efforts to start his career. In his pari-mutuel debut on June 26th, he was sitting fifth at the half when he was guided to the outside by pilot Trevor Henry. He latched onto cover then he lost it when the rival that he was following dropped into the open pocket at the three quarters. He still kept closing down the middle of the track. He couldn't catch the two in front of him, but he kept coming and he was still gaining at the wire. Then, two weeks ago, he latched onto the cover of Speedy Michael, but he couldn't stay with that rival in the drive to the wire. I don't love the rail post for him here tonight, but he has a strong late kick, and he can be dangerous if he is close to the leaders at the head of the lane.

#3 MAKING GREEN was bought for \$18,000 at the Lexington Sale by The Stable, and the half brother to millionaire What The Hill – who might be most famous for being disqualified from a Hambletonian victory – raced okay on debut, passing a couple of rivals in the stretch. He has plenty of room for improvement, and I can see him landing in the bottom of the exotics here.

#6 JEN TILLY is interesting here adding Lasix after showing big early speed then backing up in an Ontario Sires Stakes Gold race last time out. She has faced a steady diet of stakes company in her last five starts and last time she was in a conditioned race, she jogged versus non-winners of two six starts back in Pennsylvania. She draws best here and she should get put into action leaving the gate again. I'll go price shopping with her in this opening leg of tonight's early Pick 4.

#1 EASY STATION is a nice sophomore filly that was on a big roll leading into a Grand Circuit engagement where she faced the best three-year-old fillies on the continent in the Fan Hanover Stakes. She finished second to an undefeated filly in her elimination, then she could do no better than finish sixth in the final while pacing her own mile in 1:49 1/5. She came back six nights later and dominated an overmatched field of non-winners of three as the 1 to 5 favorite. Then in her last start she was in a bit tough facing older mare Carerra Sunset N who paced out of her skin that night to take a new lifetime mark of 1:48 1/5. This filly did all she could, pacing a 26 1/5 kicker and a 1:48 4/5 mile – the fastest of her life – in defeat. She was in to go last week but the races were cancelled, now she has missed four weeks. I think she is the best filly in here, but I'm inclined to play against her with that stale date being the main reason.

#5 TH CHECK ME OUT was a winner at this class level four starts back before finishing fourth behind Easy Station in her next start. She was terrific in her most recent mile in a Grassroots race in Dresden, taking over the lead in the second quarter then pacing her way to a track record breaking winning performance. She does her best work when she is racing on or near the front and she should get good position here starting from one of the best posts. She is another that is in with a chance.

#4 NAUGHTY DELIGHT is in her best form right now having landed in the money in three straight starts, but she faces a tougher non-winners of three field here than she raced against in those past three starts. She looks like one that is best used underneath in this spot.

#8 GREAT WHITE NORTH brought \$45,000 at the Harrisburg Sale, and he is from the first crop of King Of The North. He is the second foal to race from his dam; the first one having taken a win and two seconds in three starts to date. This grey colt raced decently in defeat in his lone qualifier; he came up against a \$140,000 Pollack Racing Stable purchase that came out of that qualifier to win the first leg of the OSS Gold in 1:54 2/5. This colt had a nice debut mile where he closed a lot of ground on the loose leader quickly in the stretch to fall just short. He again raced well in his second start, racing first-over, getting a clear lead in the stretch, then getting nailed late by a rival that shot up the inside late. Leaking off the rail probably cost him a Grassroots win that night. He looks best here and the wide draw doesn't worry me. He gets top billing in this opening leg of tonight's 20-cent Pick 6.

#6 GRACEFUL KING brought \$100,000 at the Lexington Select Sale, and he qualified in basically the same time twice, but the two miles were quite different. He was an even fourth in his first qualifier, then in the second one he was parked for about five-eighths of the mile. He made a move on the last turn to move three quarters of a length in front then he was rebuffed. He had little chance in his debut the way his trip worked out, but he tried hard and he fired home in 27 1/5. Drawing the best post tonight gives him a chance to lay closer to the front in this second start, and he should be a threat.

#5 STORMONT GOLDEN is a Muscle Mass homebred that is related to several winners including four full siblings that visited the winner's circle. This colt is sent out by conditioner Kevin Benn who tends to send his two-year-olds ready to fire at first asking and some that have already won at this meet showed qualifiers where they finished farther back than this colt did in the two that he competed in. He gets one of the best posts to work from in his debut here, and he is worth a look.

#4 SEND ME NO FLOWERS broke on debut, then he was much better in his second start with trotting hoppers added, trotting a 56 3/5 back half to get up for third. Now that his breaking issue seems to be solved, he should be able to take another share here tonight.

#3 ON FLEEK entered her last mile with a 1 for 15 record, but she came off a solid second place finish behind a strong winner two starts back, and her current good form suggested that she had a very good chance to get that second win that night. Three starts back, she was a flying fourth in another good effort, and she went off at 45 to 1 that night. Drawing best in her last start, this sharp filly was pointed to the front, and she led all the way, and she dug in late to fend off a tripped out challenger. Her 1:50 3/5 winning mile lowered her lifetime mark by three seconds. She looks best in here, and she gets the call to repeat.

#7 MADAME PANIC on July 4th finished second to the same filly that beat On Fleek the week before and it took a 1:50-flat mile that night to beat this filly. She paced the fastest mile of her life that night by almost two seconds, now she isn't required to face Cackleberry. This mare made front from post seven on that night before accepting the pocket, so she will likely be blasting off the gate again. With five wins, this daughter of Sunshine Beach is the winningest filly in this field, and she should be one of the main contenders in here.

#5 KISSEDBYASTRANGER is a one time winner, but she has taken nine slices in 19 starts, including eight third place finishes. She tends to be one paced in the lane – at least in recent miles, but she has been involved in some fast races in her last couple of starts. She can get positioned close to the front tonight and she could stick around for another share at a price.

#1 AMAZING ADDY is an improving filly that is worth a look in this spot, coming off second place finishes in the Kin Pace Final and an OSS Grassroots race in Dresden where the winner broke the track record for three-year-old pacing fillies. She has enough speed to get away in the top four or five leaving from the rail post, and she should be able to work her way into the Tri or Super.

#7 THE ITALIAN JOB is a \$40,000 Harrisburg purchase that was impressive in both qualifying miles leading up to his pari-mutuel debut here on July 10th. In his first qualifier, he raced first-over and powered away from his rivals in the stretch. He dropped two seconds in his next qualifier on June 27th in a mile where he was required to trot in 26 2/5 to outprint his rivals. This Captain Corey gelding drew the best post for his debut two weeks ago, and he took advantage, working out a pocket trip then converting. He was in to go in the Grand Circuit Tompkins-Geers race last Friday on a night where the races were cancelled due to air quality. He gets to face an easier field here, and he will likely go off as a big favorite. He gets the call to repeat as we start up tonight's late Pick 5.

#1 ACCESS NOW brought \$200,000 at Harrisburg being related to three siblings that have earned more than \$287,000, the most famous being \$778,000 earner Private Access who won three legs of the Graduate Series last year. This Walner gelding was much better in his second qualifier here on June 27th when he took control of the race in the third quarter and finished off his rivals with a 27 1/5 closing quarter. He was patiently driven in his debut where he closed well to get third behind The Italian Job. He scratched out of the same race as The Italian Job last week and he is at a tactical disadvantage now drawing the rail. He has plenty of upside though, and he can be an Exacta factor here.

#4 HONCHO broke in his pari-mutuel debut here on June 26th, then he got Doug McNair in the bike for his next start and he was bet down to 3 to 5. The punters that hammered him down to odds on knew what they were doing because he was sent to the front and he opened up a big lead then held sway. He is in tougher here, and I prefer to use him underneath tonight.

#2 POINT BLANK brought only \$6,000 at the Harrisburg Sale, and based on his two qualifying miles, that purchase price could turn out to be a bit of a bargain. In that second qualifier on July 10th, he sat sixth to the three quarters where he was sent widest and he produced an eye catching late move to catch a loose leader. He is in a bit tough here, but he should be able to take a share.

#6 ERINWOOD COSMO is a \$25,000 London Classic Sale purchase that had a promising debut here on June 26th after winning two qualifiers leading up to that initial start. In that pari-mutuel debut, he raced in sixth early after starting from a wide post. He pulled third-over on the backstretch, followed cover to the lane, then swung widest turning for home. He got into his highest gear in the final eighth of a mile, and he closed well to win the race for fourth. He then had a maintenance qualifier where he raced well, and he was bet down to 3 to 5 in Leg 1 of this OSS Grassroots series. He raced well there, but he fell a couple of strides short of catching leader Kings Crown N Coke. He draws best here, and I'll give him the nod to turn the tables.

#8 KINGS CROWN N COKE was bought for \$43,000 at the London Classic Sale and he is a half brother to \$244K earner Wania who is a 13-time winner. This King Of The North colt qualified okay here on June 12th then he broke in both of his first two starts. He qualified well here on July 4th, fending off Erinwood Cosmo in the drive to the wire, then he did it again in Leg 1 of the Grassroots. He showed speed and grit in those two miles, and he is the one to beat despite starting from a wide post again.

#4 STORMONT MAROON is by one of the better Ontario trotting sires and he is the first foal from a daughter of Angus Hall. Any debut starter sent out by Kevin Benn gets a look, especially one that won a qualifier as easily as he did on Monday morning. He is one that I would consider for the late Pick 5.

#9 ARM N HAMMER raced well in two straight starts here against maidens, so his connections took a shot in a \$150,000 OSS Gold race on July 6th. He tried the front, but he wasn't there long as there were some leadership changes on the backstretch and he got shuffled. In the end, he was overmatched in that race and he faded to sixth. This is obviously an easier spot, and he could take a share at what should be a good price.

#7 UNSTABLE GENIUS went through the London Classic Sale ring and brought a final bid of \$140,000. This son of top Ontario stallion Muscle Mass is a related to five siblings that have earned \$222,000 or more including full brothers Masstercraft (10 wins, \$336K, 1:52 2/5 S.), Publicity Seeker (11 wins, \$336K, 1:54 4/5 F.) and Stable Genius (16 wins, \$256K, 1:51 1/5 M.). He was certainly ready to roll at first asking for Team Menary. He was patiently driven early in the mile, and he gapped cover a bit racing around the last turn. Once he was cut loose in the middle of the track in the stretch, he found a gear that his rivals couldn't match and he powered past for the Ontario Sires Stakes Gold win as the 6 to 5 favorite at first asking. He could be any kind, and he will probably be a big favorite here to score the repeat win as we kick off tonight's late Pick 4.

#1 DETONATER HANOVER is a \$80,000 Harrisburg Sale purchase by top Ontario trotting sire Muscle Mass. This colt looked good winning his lone qualifier on June 12th, making a second quarter move to the front and winning easily although he did run before the wire. He was bet a bit on debut, going off at 9 to 2, and he raced well in that OSS Gold event. He looked like he was going to be the winner until Unstable Genius hit his best stride. That was a nice debut, and he can be an Exacta factor right back.

#4 THREE SIX ZERO is a \$50,000 Lexington Sale purchase by top Ontario trotting sire Muscle Mass. This colt looked good winning his lone qualifier on June 12th, making a second quarter move to the front and winning easily while under tight lines to Doug McNair. He looked like a pro navigating the tricky rail post, then he got the best post to work from on debut, and he led all the way. He drifted into the three path in the lane, then he accelerated as many horses seem to do when they move to the middle of the track for driver McNair. His second start was even better as he raced first-over and chased down a game leader. He landed in a good spot early racing against the top two picks then he jumped it off and ruined his chances. He can rebound and get a share here if he stays flat.

#3 GRAND MANALISHI was an easy winner in a four-horse qualifier here on June 20th and although only two of his rivals stayed flat that morning, he still got bet down to 6 to 5 for his debut. He took over command at the half, and he was never getting caught from there as he accelerated through the back half. He raced okay to get third behind the top two picks last time and he should be in the exotics mix again.

#2 COULD BE QUEEN last raced in a non-winners of two class six starts back, and she was in a mile where the final quarter was paced in 26 3/5. She raced first-over in that final quarter, and that wasn't going to work. Since then, she won a leg of the OSS Grassroots, and she took an elimination of the Kin Pace before laboring first-over in the final then fading. She gets the leading driver in the bike tonight, and she adds Lasix. I'll give her the nod in what appears to be a good spot for her.

#4 ARTISTIC DELIGHT came into her mile three starts back with a 0 for 10 record and only one third place finish on her record. She produced a great effort in defeat that night. She sat at the back for most of the mile, and she ended up racing on bad cover around the final turn. She peeled widest and after losing considerable ground on that final turn, she motored down the middle of the track to finish a clear second while pacing the fastest final quarter of her career. She found better cover in her next start, and she peeled wide off third-over cover at the head of the stretch and mowed down her rivals. She stepped up to non-winners of two in her last start, and she produced a furious late rush that was too late in a sub-1:51 mile. She draws well here tonight, and if she can get positioned a bit better and/or start her rally earlier, she could get the job done.

#7 MONTE AMORE got Jody Jamieson in the bike for the first time last time and she produced the fastest mile of her life when she was a good second in a 1:50 3/5 mile. She will likely get positioned near the front again tonight in a race where there doesn't appear to be many leavers. She could get the best trip and convert in this spot, and she is worth a look for late multi-race tickets.

#3 EMCEE hit her best stride three starts back when she rallied well to take her first win of the season. She broke in her next start then she produced another strong rally to beat Artistic Delight on June 26th. The issue that I have with her is that stale date, but, if she is sharp enough, she can obviously contend here.

#2 BALIUS brought \$40,000 at the Harrisburg sale and the son of top Ontario sire Muscle Mass had an adventurous, yet promising debut. After drawing the worst post, he broke at the start, but he showed some resilience by working his way to getting the smallest cheque while kicking home in 27 2/5. He gets a major barn change here going for Dave Menary, and he gets an equally big driver change getting the leading driver in the bike. If he stays flat, he figures to be a big threat here in his second crack at the OSS Grassroots.

#3 SUNDAE ROYALE is a \$62,000 London Classic Sale purchase and he is from the first crop of King Of The North. He was just okay in his first qualifier here on June 12th when he closed mildly to get fourth. He was better 15 days later as he showed some gate speed and sat the pocket to the stretch. He popped out and he closed some ground on the leader, but a rival shot along the pylons and scooted past both of them. He improved his final quarter speed by more than a second that morning. He showed speed in his debut for a purse, but he jumped it off just past the quarter. He was better in his second start, showing enough gate speed from a wide post to drop in third early, and he sat inside to the stretch where he moved widest and passed two rivals to get up for third. The top two were long gone at that point so he wasn't going to threaten for the win. Once you get past Balius, he appears to be next best, and he is the most likely benefactor if the top pick miscues again.

#4 BLACK SHANK is a homebred Archangel gelding that is a half brother to 42-time winner Royalty Beer who is still going and approaching \$500,000 in career earnings. This gelding showed a nice late kick in his second qualifier where he trotted home in 27 4/5. He gets sent out by a trainer that is clicking at a 27 per cent rate so far in 2026 and he is another possibility for late multi-race tickets.

#6 COMMANDER KELLY is a Trixton homebred that is related to two winners including 1:55 2/5 (S.) trotter Vanjie Blue Chip who took that mark when she broke her maiden in a non-winners of two race here in the summer of 2024. This colt took three tries to qualify for this debut, but he did show speed in that most recent mile and he could get position early here and ride a trip to a share.

#2 MADAM X is one that I will side with on the class drop tonight making her second start off the Isaac Waxman claim. Last time, she was simply in too tough in a race that went too fast, and she chased the leader through some wicked fractions, but in the end, she simply couldn't stay with a mare that was scorching her way to a new lifetime mark of 1:48 3/5. I don't mind the inside draw for her in this spot as she can probably start in mid pack and pick up some live cover to follow. She gets top call in the finale.

#7 TWIN B EMPRESS was on a big roll here in the spring, winning seven times in eight starts. She reached her class ceiling when she was stepped up to the \$50,000 optional claiming level and she found herself in three consecutive miles that were all paced in 1:48 4/5 or faster. Dropping back down to the level where she does her best work gives her a good chance to rebound tonight, and she is one that I wouldn't leave off late multi-race tickets.

#4 LANESIDE INCONTROL was dominant in the opening two legs of the recently concluded Pop Up series, but she came up against a white hot Aussie mare in the final, and no one was beating that mare on that night. That victorious rival came out of that race to finish a close second in the Fillies and Mares Open as 39 to 1 in her next start. This mare should be prominent early here and she fits well. She would be no surprise in this spot.

#8 TAMARA HANOVER races tough every week, but she does best when she has James Macdonald in the bike, and the leading driver returns tonight. She draws a wide post here, so she will likely look to drop in around the middle of the field early then find a live helmet to follow. I think she lands in the Tri or Super tonight.

#6 SETTN A PRECEDENT reached peak form last time when she showed speed at the start and on the end of her mile when she finished second, only three quarters of a length behind the 1 to 5 favorite in a mile where she closed as a 99 to 1 longshot. She fires right back at the same level here, and she can get another good trip racing on or near the lead. It won't be a surprise if he beats this prediction.

CONDITIONS AND ALLOWANCES IN HARNESS RACING - IMPORTANT TO KNOW

The conditions of a race determine whether a horse is eligible to enter. For example many races are restricted to horses that have won a certain number of races or a certain amount of money in a specified number of starts. Many races are restricted to horses entered to be "claimed" (offered for sale) at a specific price.

Allowances in the claiming price itself are given to colts and geldings, four-year-olds and younger and to mares, five-year-olds and younger.

The purpose of the allowance is to keep younger horses more competitive when racing against older and more experienced rivals. Mares are given extra consideration in claiming events because of their potential as broodmares.

The accompanying chart shows what the allowances are, but an example may make them easier to understand. The chart indicates that three-year-olds receive a 50% allowance in claiming races. This means that a three-year-old entered in a \$20,000 claiming race carries an actual claiming price of \$30,000 (50% higher).

Fillies and mares receive an additional 25% allowance in claiming races. Details of the race conditions and claiming price (if any) are given at the top of each race in the program.

ALLOWANCES FOR PURSE EARNINGS

When Fillies/Mares compete against Colts/Geldings (normally on the trot) Fillies/Mares will receive an additional 25% on the condition of the race. ie: nw \$5,000 (FM \$6,250) last 5 or \$12,000 (FM \$15,000) last 10 starts.

C.P.M.A. Regulation Changes

Effective January 1st 2012

CPMA will be instituting several new rule changes with regards to the following pari-mutuel pools:

Pick Pools

- If there are no winners in any leg of a Pick N pool, the entire pool is refunded.
- If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners.
- A pool is no longer refunded if the 1st leg in the pool is cancelled or declared no contest.
- Pick-3: If at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: If at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.

EXPLANATION OF THE LASIX PROGRAM

After careful study and consultation with Ontario Horsemen's groups, racetrack operators and veterinarians, Agriculture Canada and the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario passed legislation allowing the controlled (or supervised) administration of furosemide, more commonly called "Lasix". "Lasix" is used to alleviate the symptoms of exercise induced pulmonary hemorrhaging in racing horses. Horses will undergo an endoscopic examination of the trachea by a veterinarian licensed by the Ontario Racing Commission and endorsed by an official veterinarian before being allowed on the medication list. Once qualified, horses will be treated with "Lasix" within four hours plus or minus 15 minutes of a scheduled race in a secure retention area under the super vision of racing officials.

All horses on "Lasix" must remain on the program for a minimum of 100 days while racing in this jurisdiction.

- L** Denotes horses treated with Lasix.
- (L)** Denotes horses treated with Lasix today who were not so treated for their last start.
- (L)** Denotes horses treated with Lasix for their last start but not so treated today.

RULES AND INFORMATION REGARDING CANADIAN HARNESS AND FOREIGN SEPARATE POOL EVENTS

GENERAL

All pari-mutuel pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with the regulations and directives as issued by Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada ("the Regulations"), under the approval and supervision of the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency. The Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency can be contacted at 1-800-268-8835 or 613-759-6100 or Email: cpmawebacpm@agr.gc.ca. A complete version of the CPMA regulations can be found at <http://laws-lois.justice.gc.ca/eng/regulations/SOR-91-365/>.

All tickets should be held until the result of the race is declared official and prices are posted.

No person under the age of 18 shall purchase or cash a ticket or voucher.

A claim of receiving an incorrect payment or incorrect change must be made to the Mutuel office of the association within twenty four hours of buying or cashing a valid ticket or voucher.

No ruling made by the Stewards/Judges or the Ontario Racing Commission with regard to distribution of purse money or the placing of horses in the order of finish, after the race has been declared official, shall have any bearing on the pay-out prices or distribution of pari-mutuel pools.

Change boards and Photo Finish display monitors are located in the Grandstand. In addition, Photo Finish pictures are shown on the closed-circuit television system. Customers are reminded that mutuel clerks are responsible for all shortages. When making a wager, customers must present sufficient funds at the time of purchase to cover the wagers requested.

ENTRIES AND MUTUEL FIELDS

"Entry" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled or considered as the same betting interest. The most common reason for the coupling of horses in an Entry is the fact that they are owned by the same person.

"Mutuel Field" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled because the number of horses in the race exceeds the number which can be handled separately by the pari-mutuel system. Subject to the Regulations, a bet on one horse of an Entry or Mutuel Field shall be considered a bet on all horses in that Entry or Mutuel Field.

DAILY DOUBLE BETTING (INCLUDING LATE DOUBLE)

A Daily Double bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of the two races specified for the Daily Double. Tickets not selecting the winner of the first half of the Daily Double and all tickets in the second half of the Daily Double not coupled with the declared official winner of the first half of the Daily Double are not winners and are not refunded no matter what circumstances affect the running of the second half of the Daily Double.

Should a horse or horses (not coupled with another starter) be excused from starting in the second race of the Daily Double after the first race of the Daily Double has closed for betting, holders of all Daily Double tickets on such horses, coupled with the winner of the first Daily Double race, shall participate in a Consolation Double pool. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

EXACTA (Also known as Exactor)/TRIFECTA (Also known as Triactor)/SUPERFECTA

An Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first two, three and four horses respectively, representing different betting interests to finish in the exact official order of finish, in the race on which the pool is operated.

SWINGER (Also known as OMNI)

A Swinger is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select horses to finish in any order from the official first 3 positions.

JACKPOT HI-5

A Jackpot Hi-5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners in the specified Jackpot Hi-5 race. If there are races that have an entry, (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B), Jackpot Hi-5 will not offer a wager consisting of both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in a Jackpot Hi-5, the payout would be 1st, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th.

That jackpot portion of the pool will only be paid out if there is a single winning ticket. If there are multiple winning tickets that have correctly chosen the first 5 runners of the race, they will receive 50% of the pool for that day. The other 50% will go over into the Jackpot carryover. If there are no winning tickets with the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners, 100% of the current day's pool will be carried over into the Jackpot.

PICK 3 & PICK-4 BETTING

The Pick 3 & Pick 4 bets are betting transactions in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of three or four successive races specified for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 respectively.

Winning tickets for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 are determined in the following sequence: A) winners of all legs, B) most winners, then refund. If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners. If there are no winners in any leg of a pool, the entire pool is refunded.

PICK 5 BETTING

The Pick 5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of five successive races specified for the Pick 5 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 5 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 5.

PICK 6 BETTING

The Pick 6 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of six successive races specified for the Pick 6 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 6 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 6.

PICK 5 & 6 BETTING

If at least 1 race as part of the Pick 5 or 6 has been cancelled or declared "No contest", but not more than the specified below under Refunds, the net pool shall be distributed to those selecting the most # of winners and NOT include any carryover from a previous pool.

PICK 3, PICK 4, PICK 5 & PICK 6 SCRATCHES

In the event a Pick 3, Pick 4, Pick 5 or Pick 6 ticket designates as a selection a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the Stewards/Judges to be a non-starter in any of the races comprising the Pick 3, Pick 4, Pick 5 or Pick 6 the favourite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection. In the event that the money bet in the win pool for two or more favourites is identical, the selection with the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non-starting selection.

However, if a scratch occurs in any leg of the Pick 3, Pick 4, Pick 5 or Pick 6 pools before the pool is closed, a ticket including the scratched horse may be cancelled.

REFUNDS

Subject to the Regulations, all monies in all pools on a race are refunded in the event that the race is cancelled, declared off or declared no contest, and all monies bet on a horse are refunded if the horse is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start. These refunds will be communicated to the public through various means such as betting terminals, video display, changes boards and our website.

The Pick(n) pool shall be cancelled and all Pick(n) wagers for the individual performance shall be refunded if:

- Pick-3: at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

Where a horse that is part of an Entry is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start and at least one horse of that Entry receives a fair start in the race, all tickets purchased on the Entry remain valid and the purchase price of any such ticket shall not be refunded.

COMMON POOL WAGERING (INTERTRACK BETTING)

In the unlikely event of a communications or computer system failure that prevents pools from merging with the host track's pools before the end of a race, CPMA regulations require that the site must refund all tickets for that race. This refund will be communicated to the public through various means such as video displays, change boards and messages on our website.

FAIR START

If a horse has reached the Fair Start Pole (located 200 feet before the Starting Pole) by the time the mobile gate has reached the Starting Pole, that horse is deemed to have had a fair start. It makes no difference whether or not the horse is on or off stride at that precise moment. Under current policy and regulations, which are designed to be as fair as possible to all bettors on all starters, there is no Recall - a repeat of the entire starting procedure - when a horse does not reach the Fair Start Pole before the gate reaches the Starting Pole. Monies bet on such a horse are refunded in accordance with the regulation concerning refunds.

LOST & OLD TICKETS

WEG issued tickets or vouchers are valid indefinitely, however, they cannot be cashed at a mutuel teller after 2 years from date of issue. Please mail tickets, along with your name and address, to Mutuel Manager, P.O. Box 156, Rexdale, Ontario, M9W 5L2, keeping a photocopy for future reference.

For "Lost Tickets" originally sold at a Woodbine Entertainment Group racetrack or Teletheatre, please enquire at the Mutuel office at Woodbine, Greenwood Teletheatre, or Mohawk. Policy may be subject to change retroactively in the event regulatory bodies amend existing regulations.

ASSOCIATION PERCENTAGE, AND TAXATION/LEVY

The Woodbine Entertainment Group deducts and retains the following percentages from wagers placed at our own licensed sites which are then shared with the horsepeople, host and simulcast associations and the Ontario Racing Commission.

WOODBINE/MOHAWK LIVE: Win, Place & Show: 13.65%. Swinger 14.7%. Trifecta & Pick 4: 21.7%. Double & Exakta 17.2%. Jackpot Hi-5, Pick 5 & Pick 6: 11.7%. All other 23.0%

Horsepeople receive a further 2% on all wagers, except Trifecta wagering where it is 4%. The Ontario Provincial Government retains 0.5% on all bets placed in Ontario. The Canadian Government (through a revolving fund cost recovery basis) retains 1% on all wagers placed in Canada for provision of drug control, and audit services.
