Betting Basics

Some essentials to get you started with making a wager.

1 How to wager



Place your bet by visiting a teller, or using a self-serve terminal.

To place a bet here are just 5 things you need to know:

- 1 Name of racetrack (choose from any track in the simulcast feeds)
- 2 Number of the race
- 3 Amount of your bet (e.g. \$2)
- 4 Type of bet (see step 2)
- 5 Horse's number (see step 4)

Once you have decided what you want to bet, head to the nearest seller's window and use the sample statement as your guide:

Hello, (Racetrack), race 6, \$2 to WIN on Horse #4

How to use a self-serve terminal:

- 1 Swipe your Cash Card/Insert Cash
- 2 Enter the initial PIN #1234 (then choose a new PIN)
- 3 Press/Tap the track you would like to bet: (defaults to current race)
- 4 Tap the Horse Number: **#4**
- 5 Press/Tap the Bet Type: **WIN**
- 6 Press/Tap the Bet Amount: **\$2**
- 7 Press/Tap the Race Number: **Race #6**
- 8 Press Green **"Make BET"** button
- 9 Press/Tap the **"Finish with Receipt"** button
- 10 Be sure to check your ticket to confirm it's the bet you wanted

To get a Cash Card or for assistance ask a teller, or a staff member.

2 Types of bets



Single horse bets (minimum \$2.00 bet is required)

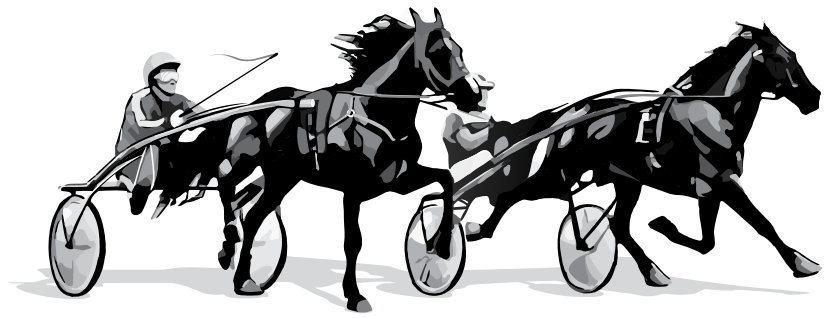
Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Win	U U U	Your horse must finish 1st; payoff determined by the win odds.
Place	U U	Your horse must finish 1st or 2nd; payoffs better than to show.
Show	U	Your horse must finish 1st, 2nd, or 3rd; modest payoffs.

Exotic multiple-horse bets

Bet type	Level of difficulty	Explanation and expectation
Exacta*	U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st and 2nd in exact order; riskier bet that can pay a little or a lot, depending on the horses' odds.
Daily double	U U U U U	Pick the winners of two designated consecutive races.
Pick 3, Win 4, Pick 5, Pick 6	U U U U U U	Select the winners of a designated set of consecutive races. The wager must be made prior to the start of the first race in the multi-race wager.
Triactor*	U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, and 3rd in exact order; can be expensive to play if you use a lot of horses.
Superfecta*	U U U U U U U U	Your horses must finish 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th; big payoff possible.

* Exotic bets require the horses to finish in the EXACT order you select, unless you "BOX" the bet, in which case your selections can finish in any order.

All of the numbers and letters in the program might seem confusing or overwhelming at first, but focusing on these sections makes choosing a horse simple.

- Horse's number in the race
- Horse's post position colour
- Horse's colour, sex, age, sire (father), dam (mother), sire of the dam
- Morning line odds
- Horse's name
- Driver and Driver Record (Name, # of wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, winning %)
- Trainer information
- Horse's Lifetime record (with best win time, track size, track, age, lifetime wins and lifetime earnings)
- Horse's current record (# of races, # wins, # of 2nds, # of 3rds, and money earned)

4 The odds



Odds are also important to consider when choosing your horse. Horses that are thought to have a better chance of winning will typically have lower odds.

Morning line odds

Odds listed in the race program are the "morning line" odds. These are predictions of how the public will bet on the race. They are set by the track's handicapper when the race program is published, before the wagering starts.

The actual odds will be posted on the **Television** or in-field on the **Tote Board** before the race; they change up until post time, depending on how customers are betting on each horse in the race.

Calculating a \$2 win prize

To calculate a win prize, find the Odds of a horse on the **Television** or **Tote Board** (in-field board).

Multiply the first number by 2, then divide that number by the second digit (if there is one), and then add \$2. Simple as that!

Odds	1/2	2/1	7/2	5/1	10/1

Helpful facts for betting

- Some racetracks have a television simulcast commentator who tries to identify winning horses (handicaps) between the races. Listen and see if you can pick up any good tips to bet on.
- A good betting method is to choose horses with current odds two to three times higher than their morning line odds.

3 Tips to remember

WIN BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 32% of the time
PLACE BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 53% of the time
SHOW BETS on the FAVOURITE pay 67% of the time

Race 1 Selections

The Horseplayer's Journal by Garnet Barnsdale

#5 BROADWAY STAR, like his nine rivals in here, seems to be unreliable, but there are reasons to believe that the twelfth time will be the charm for this sophomore son of Walner. He comes out of a mile where he left hard enough from the middle of the gate to land in the pocket, then he got shuffled back to third on the backstretch. He was out and moving again in the third quarter. He challenged first up but the favored winner was too good that night. He needs to avoid that trip here, and there is a good chance he will starting from the middle of the gate in this field. He gets a lukewarm nod to start up tonight's \$75,000 guaranteed Pick 5 that features a carryover of more than \$48,000.

#7 NIXEN BIXEN kicked off his career with two clear wins here last summer, but even as he was taking those victories, he looked a little bumpy gaited. That roughness came to a head in his third start where he broke stride at the start of a Grand Circuit race. He proceeded to break stride in three of his next five pari-mutuel starts then a barn change was made. Pat Hudon, who might be one of the best locally dealing with problem trotters, took over, and this gelding was much better in his last start where he took a sizable early lead then eventually got passed late by the 8 to 5 favorite. If he behaves again, and he brings his best race, he can be right there with these.

#6 LOVEMESOMETACOS lacked room early in the stretch two starts back, then he dove inside and began to close along with three rivals to his outside. Those rivals had momentum and all three of them got the better of this gelding, who finished a close fifth. Last week, he followed the cover of Broadway Star, and he won the race for third, getting up to beat that rival right on the wire. He draws best now, and he should be good for another share in this spot tonight.

#2 DULCES SUENOS DEO ran her record to 0 for 50 two weeks ago here, but she continues to pass rivals in the back half of her miles, and she has taken 20 slices and finished fourth on thirteen other occasions. As always, she is a good one to use on the bottom of the Tri and Super.

#7 ELBOWS UP was a strong winner in Grassroots Leg 1 at Flamboro Downs then she experienced gait issues in her next two starts so she was given a couple of weeks off before requalifying on July 6th. She finished second to Blue Jean Gal who came out of that race to win a Gold event in 1:51 3/5 which represented an all time Ontario Sires Stakes record for three-year-old trotting fillies. This filly then won well at Hanover Raceway racing first-over. She produced a repeat performance here on July 20th when she won racing first-over again. She got a maintenance qualifier in on July 31st, and she then on August 9th, she picked up right where she left off by dominating a Grassroots field as the even money favorite. She tuned up for Grassroots Leg 4B with another front end on August 17th, then she tired in deep stretch on August 27th when she looked like she had the race wrapped up. She was much better last week when she closed in 27 2/5, now she can be even sharper coming back in a week. I like that she gets off the rail tonight; she should be able to work out a better trip racing closer to the front throughout. She gets top billing here.

#6 UPGRADE looked good here winning Grassroots Leg 4A and since then, she was beaten by Elbows Up in her next start then she scored an upset win two starts back in Grassroots Leg 4B. She raced first-over last week, and that isn't her best trip, so I won't hold that sixth-place finish against her too much. Starting from the best post, she could get a pocket trip here. That makes her a threat.

#4 MISS MASS APPEAL took her first win of the year two starts back when she was given a great drive that led to a perfect trip, and she was able to get up to beat Elbows Up and score the 6 to 1 upset. She was given a conservative steer in her last start against non-winners of two, and she stayed sharp trotting a 28-flat kicker. She is another one in here that I would consider using on the early Pick 5 ticket.

#8 LOOK A DIAMOND is hard to dismiss considering she has won 10 times this year, including last week's victory over the top two picks. However, her only Grassroots points win came in a week field at Hanover Raceway, and she likely won't be allowed to steal a 58 4/5 middle half tonight like she did last week. She will almost surely be blasting off looking for the front tonight. I think her rivals will be sharper, and one or more of them will get the measure of her tonight.

#1 UBIQUITOUS brought \$35,000 at the Lexington Sale and the son of Walner is related to a double millionaire Ariana G (26 wins, \$2.6 million, 1:50 2/5 M.), and a millionaire All The Time (12 wins, \$1.02 million, 1:52 1/5 M.). His dam dropped seven more foals since those two raced and the highest earner of those amassed only \$38,000 from racing. This gelding dropped more than five seconds in his second qualifier, and he raced well on debut last week, firing home in 27 1/5 to get up for fourth. The rail is tricky for a young trotter especially, but if this gelding can get away in the top five leaving the gate tonight, he should have a decent chance in here. I'll give him top billing to start up tonight's early Pick 4.

#3 DATA BREACH will likely get hammered at the windows tonight coming off a mile where he finished third in his Wellwood Memorial elimination while trotting a 1:55-flat mile. This Determination homebred that is a full brother to \$771K earner Drawn Impression, who won her first three starts, the third win being a dominating Grand Circuit win in the \$425,000 Peaceful Way Final. This colt is also a half brother to millionaire Emoticon Legacy, who won last year's Kentucky Futurity and just set a 1:50 2/5 World Record in the Charlie Hill Memorial at Scioto Downs last week. This is obviously a big class drop, but I'm a bit hesitant to take odds on in this case when he has missed a month's action and is coming off a sick scratch.

#2 IF POSSIBLE raced well in two straight and he did finish ahead of the top pick last time. He has excellent gate speed, and he should be able to get positioned on or near the front again tonight and ride another good trip to another spot in the Tri.

#4 D A VOLUSIA is a \$40,000 London Classic Sale buy that debuts here for Team Jamieson that have had some success with young trotters at Mohawk Park this season. He is a full sister to 17-time winner Masterwork (\$121K, 1:55 3/5) and he qualified okay for this maiden voyage. I could see him closing to take a small slice.

#7 MIKE ME UP was 0 for 10 this season when he lined up behind the gate on August 8th in Grassroots Leg 4A, and he got an aggressive drive and that led to him taking his first win of the season. He followed that strong winning effort with an even better one in his next start when he wired a field of Grassroots/Prospect Series trotters after starting from post 10 while lowering his lifetime best mark to 1:53 3/5. For context, only 10 trotters from 225 starters have won from the 10-hole at Mohawk Park so far this year, and this Muscle Mass gelding did it easily that night. He then tripled up in Grassroots Leg 4B as the 1 to 5 chalk. He continued his roll with a fourth straight win against some decent older rivals on August 30th, then he had his streak broken last week when he got picked off late. I won't hold that loss against him as it should serve as a good tightener for this Grassroots leg. He can bounce back in this spot.

#8 GREEN NINETEEN is 0 for 16 this year and he is 0 for 25 lifetime, but he has finished second seven times along the way, and he could be a good one to use underneath in the Exacta tonight. He comes off a nice closing effort where he finished less than two lengths behind Mike Me Up. He should offer a good price here, too.

#6 THOR B GOOD wasn't beaten far by Mike Me Up last time he raced in a Grassroots leg here on August 23rd, and last week when he raced against that rival, he drew wide and he got raced from the back. He gets the best post tonight, and he should be looking to get spotted near the front in this spot. He should be part of the exotics in this spot.

#2 TROUBLE WITH NAMES won well racing on the lead here in Grassroots Leg 4B, then he last Bob McClure for his most recent start, and things didn't go very well for him. I think he will improve enough in this spot to work his way into the Tri or Super.

#6 MEETMEONTHEBEACH is a Cattlewash homebred that is the second foal from her dam. The first one, Cavendish, started his career at three this year, and he has a second and a third from three starts at the Meadowlands so far. This colt has raced exclusively in stakes prior to tonight, and he has taken a cheque in every one. He gets the best post to work from and the leading driver sticks. He will likely be an anchor leg single for many in the Pick 5 carryover.

#8 STAMPEDE gets a look here because he exits an OSS race where he raced decently and got a small slice. Two starts back, he probably deserved a better fate, too. In that mile, he suffered interference at the quarter, and he was pushed four wide, and his night was in effect over at that point. Dropping in to face maidens again gives him a better chance to get a share.

#5 SIR GALLOWAY raced decently last time considering he closed as a 62 to 1 longshot. He paced a sub-55 back half to be beaten by less than three lengths. Starting from one of the best posts, he should be able to get positioned closer to the front leaving the gate, and I could see him working his way into the bottom of the Tri or Super.

#4 SLICK DRAW showed little on debut here on July 27th, mostly because he broke at the start. He was entered into the Battle of Waterloo, and there were no eliminations required, so he went right into the final despite having one race which was a ninth-place finish. He managed to finish third and he got elevated to second when the winner was tossed due to a pylon violation. After a couple of mediocre miles following that race, he was much better two starts back, then he was raced aggressively last week, and it didn't work out. I think he will revert to a closing style, and he can get a slice.

#9 ANOTHER GREAT MASS turned a corner of sorts three starts back when he closed to finish third in Grassroots Leg 4B, and he raced okay again eight nights later. He was even better here last week where he was first-over for most of the second half and he kept coming to prevail as a 12 to 1 longshot. He dug in late to knock off Mike Me Up who was looking for a fifth straight win. He should offer a good price again because he drew widest here, and I'll give him the nod to repeat in this opening leg of tonight's late Pick 5.

#6 MAIZE AND BLUE raced first-over in Grassroots Leg 4B, and neither he, nor anyone else, could get close to leader and eventual winner Trouble With Names. I don't think first up is this gelding's best trip, it was expected last week that he would blast off from post six, and he did so. He then was overtaken by longshot Stonebridge Wings, but he didn't sit for long. He made a second move to the front as even money favorite Mike Me Up was also moving, and he was right back in the pocket. He closed along the inside in the stretch and lost a three across battle to the wire. He draws best here, and he once again should be prominent throughout this mile.

#4 FIRST CLASS MASS dropped from the Grassroots to non-winners of two on September 3rd, and he got the leading driver in the bike, and he got pounded down to 9 to 5 favorite. He made a third quarter power move to the front and he fended off a challenger that poked her head in front briefly in the stretch drive. He lowered his lifetime mark to 1:54-flat, then he was raced more conservatively driven last week and he closed well to get the smallest cheque. It seems very likely that he will get a more aggressive steer tonight, and he is the third one that I would consider using on late Pick 5 tickets.

#3 WOLVERINE LEGEND came into last week's mile off two solid efforts where he finished second, once from the pocket, and once closing from mid pack. Starting from the rail last week, he stayed in and got shuffled out of the race. He should be able to get a small slice here if he gets a better trip.

#6 NORTHERNLIGHTS GLO has raced six times and in only one of those miles she faced maidens. That was her debut mile on June 25th where she broke at the start. Since then, she raced in either Gold or Grand Circuit races, and she took cheques in three of those five starts. She gets a great chance to break her maiden here starting from the best post facing what should be a much easier field, and she gets top billing to start up tonight's late Pick 4.

#7 NEWEVE is a \$30,000 Harrisburg buy that is form the first crop of sire King Of The North and she is related to five winners, the best of which was 1:53 (S.) trotter Winndevie who won 12 of 22 starts and earned more than \$863,000. She raced decently in her debut here last week where she made a second-over move on the last turn and finished willingly to get up for fourth. She can improve in this second start, and she could be an Exacta factor here.

#9 JULIA LABELLE raced great in defeat last week while finishing ahead of Neweve, and she was perhaps a bit unlucky in defeat. She was camped out near the back early and she got sent to the outside, but she was unable to find any cover. She raced first-over for the rest of that mile, and she got past the leader late only to get nailed by the pocket sitter who slid up the pylons late in the stretch. That was a strong effort, and she can be right there again if she gets another aggressive steer.

#8 PANACHE PRINCESS got several things that seemed to be in her favor last week, starting with a switch to the leading driver from her trainer. She also dropped in class, so she got bet down to 2 to 1. She got an aggressive steer as expected, and she held the lead to the stretch, then she tired badly from there. I expect that she will get a more conservative steer in this spot, and I can see her closing to take a share.

#6 A SPLASH OF GREEN is a filly that didn't hit the board in her first five starts this season, then she took a couple of months off, and she really turned her year around when she returned on August 3rd. Since then, she has raced five times and finished first or second in the first four of those miles before trying a Grand Circuit race on September 4th. She broke stride at the start and lost all chance. Two starts back she took a new lifetime mark in Grassroots Leg 4B where she was raced aggressively, and she won driving away from her rivals. She should prove tough to beat here starting from the best post if she stays flat.

#8 BARBARA MAY came out of a fast OSS Gold race six starts back where she finished third behind the two big favorites, and she was bet heavily getting in against non-winners of two. Starting from the middle of the gate, she was moved to the front in the second quarter, and she left no doubt from there, powering her way to her first win of the season while lowering her lifetime mark. She wasn't as good on July 27th when bet down to the 4 to 5 favorite, but that front end effort kept her sharp for the Grassroots Leg on August 9th. She was bet down to 4 to 5 that night and she turned for home with a few lengths to make up on the leader. She unleashed a wicked 27 2/5 brush to win going away. Two starts back, she looked a bit short coming in off an 18 day break and she couldn't hold the lead after getting a reasonable first half. She raced okay in a Grand Circuit race last time, and she should be a threat in here.

#1 RONDA MAY K was a big winner here two starts back then she wasn't as good last week as the favorite. She has the speed to overcome her rail draw, and she should be able to get positioned close to the front at the start and ride a good trip to a share in this spot.

#2 INTEL QUEEN comes off a mile where she fired home in 28-flat, and while I don't see her as a win threat in here, I think she might be able to work her way into the bottom of the exotics at a price.

Her full brother, Impressive Landing, is a three time winner so far from 25 starts, took a mark of 1:56 4/5 and has earned more than \$37,000. This Rick Zeron trainee up to her last start, was ambitously spotted after finishing a close fourth on debut on July 9th. For her next three starts, she raced only in Grand Circuit races, and she did okay landing in third in the final of the Grade 3 Pure Ivory three starts back. She got in against maidens two weeks ago, and her odds plummeted from 132 to 1 in her previous start to 1 to 5. She was sent to the front in the second quarter, and from there she left no doubt, trotting her way to an impressive maiden score. She steps up one class level now, but she should have a good chance to take a repeat win.

#6 GRAND MANALISHI jogged in her debut mile here racing against maidens on June 26th, then she faced a steady diet of OSS Gold or Grand Circuit company. She gets needed class relief here and starting from the best post tonight, it seems certain that she will be sent hard at the start looking for the lead. She should be the one to beat in here.

#5 KIRWIN cost \$80,000 at the London Classic Sale and he is from the first crop of King Of The North out of a half sister to 1:53 4/5 (S.) trotter Lil Sweet who was a Gold Superfinal winner at two right here in October of 2024. This Meg Crone pupil qualified five times leading up to his debut on August 27th. He broke in two of them and won the other three, but he only beat two minutes once. That mile did come in his last qualifier on August 21st where he led all the way in a dominating performance to win in 1:58 3/5. He debuted here six nights later, and he raced well in that initial start, but he was no match for a more experienced rival that was dropping out of an OSS Gold race and led all the way as the even money favorite. He was well clear in third at the wire. He fired back to take his maiden win two weeks ago, now he is in substantially tougher. I will use him underneath tonight.

#2 HOPES ETERNAL is another recent maiden breaker that steps up to face tougher that could get a good following trip and land a small share.

#5 LUCY LOU WHO won her debut at Kawartha Downs on August 1st, and she then showed little in her first start over this surface other than closing in 27-flat. She then she raced closer to the pace in her mile last week and she came flying late to finish a close second. She gets the benefit of getting one of the best posts tonight, and if she can lay a bit closer to the front this time, she will have a good chance of breaking her maiden.

CONDITIONS AND ALLOWANCES IN HARNESS RACING - IMPORTANT TO KNOW

The conditions of a race determine whether a horse is eligible to enter. For example many races are restricted to horses that have won a certain number of races or a certain amount of money in a specified number of starts. Many races are restricted to horses entered to be "claimed" (offered for sale) at a specific price.

Allowances in the claiming price itself are given to colts and geldings, four-year-olds and younger and to mares, five-year-olds and younger.

The purpose of the allowance is to keep younger horses more competitive when racing against older and more experienced rivals. Mares are given extra consideration in claiming events because of their potential as broodmares.

The accompanying chart shows what the allowances are, but an example may make them easier to understand. The chart indicates that three-year-olds receive a 50% allowance in claiming races. This means that a three-year-old entered in a \$20,000 claiming race carries an actual claiming price of \$30,000 (50% higher).

Fillies and mares receive an additional 25% allowance in claiming races. Details of the race conditions and claiming price (if any) are given at the top of each race in the program.

ALLOWANCES FOR PURSE EARNINGS

When Fillies/Mares compete against Colts/Geldings (normally on the trot) Fillies/Mares will receive an additional 25% on the condition of the race. ie: nw \$5,000 (FM \$6,250) last 5 or \$12,000 (FM \$15,000) last 10 starts.

C.P.M.A. Regulation Changes

Effective January 1st 2012

CPMA will be instituting several new rule changes with regards to the following pari-mutuel pools:

Pick Pools

- If there are no winners in any leg of a Pick N pool, the entire pool is refunded.
- If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners.
- A pool is no longer refunded if the 1st leg in the pool is cancelled or declared no contest.
- Pick-3: If at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: If at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancelled, the pool is refunded.

EXPLANATION OF THE LASIX PROGRAM

After careful study and consultation with Ontario Horsemen's groups, racetrack operators and veterinarians, Agriculture Canada and the Alcohol and Gaming Commission of Ontario passed legislation allowing the controlled (or supervised) administration of furosemide, more commonly called "Lasix". "Lasix" is used to alleviate the symptoms of exercise induced pulmonary hemorrhaging in racing horses. Horses will undergo an endoscopic examination of the trachea by a veterinarian licensed by the Ontario Racing Commission and endorsed by an official veterinarian before being allowed on the medication list. Once qualified, horses will be treated with "Lasix" within four hours plus or minus 15 minutes of a scheduled race in a secure retention area under the super vision of racing officials.

All horses on "Lasix" must remain on the program for a minimum of 100 days while racing in this jurisdiction.

- L** Denotes horses treated with Lasix.
- (L)** Denotes horses treated with Lasix today who were not so treated for their last start.
- (L)** Denotes horses treated with Lasix for their last start but not so treated today.

RULES AND INFORMATION REGARDING CANADIAN HARNESS AND FOREIGN SEPARATE POOL EVENTS

GENERAL

All pari-mutuel pools are calculated and distributed in accordance with the regulations and directives as issued by Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada ("the Regulations"), under the approval and supervision of the Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency. The Canadian Pari-Mutuel Agency can be contacted at 1-800-268-8835 or 613-759-6100 or Email: cpmawebacpm@agr.gc.ca. A complete version of the CPMA regulations can be found at <http://laws-lois.justice.gc.ca/eng/regulations/SOR-91-365/>.

All tickets should be held until the result of the race is declared official and prices are posted.

No person under the age of 18 shall purchase or cash a ticket or voucher.

A claim of receiving an incorrect payment or incorrect change must be made to the Mutuel office of the association within twenty four hours of buying or cashing a valid ticket or voucher.

No ruling made by the Stewards/Judges or the Ontario Racing Commission with regard to distribution of purse money or the placing of horses in the order of finish, after the race has been declared official, shall have any bearing on the pay-out prices or distribution of pari-mutuel pools.

Change boards and Photo Finish display monitors are located in the Grandstand. In addition, Photo Finish pictures are shown on the closed-circuit television system. Customers are reminded that mutuel clerks are responsible for all shortages. When making a wager, customers must present sufficient funds at the time of purchase to cover the wagers requested.

ENTRIES AND MUTUEL FIELDS

"Entry" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled or considered as the same betting interest. The most common reason for the coupling of horses in an Entry is the fact that they are owned by the same person.

"Mutuel Field" means two or more horses in the same race which, for the purpose of pari-mutuel betting, are coupled because the number of horses in the race exceeds the number which can be handled separately by the pari-mutuel system. Subject to the Regulations, a bet on one horse of an Entry or Mutuel Field shall be considered a bet on all horses in that Entry or Mutuel Field.

DAILY DOUBLE BETTING (INCLUDING LATE DOUBLE)

A Daily Double bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of the two races specified for the Daily Double. Tickets not selecting the winner of the first half of the Daily Double and all tickets in the second half of the Daily Double not coupled with the declared official winner of the first half of the Daily Double are not winners and are not refunded no matter what circumstances affect the running of the second half of the Daily Double.

Should a horse or horses (not coupled with another starter) be excused from starting in the second race of the Daily Double after the first race of the Daily Double has closed for betting, holders of all Daily Double tickets on such horses, coupled with the winner of the first Daily Double race, shall participate in a Consolation Double pool. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

EXACTA (Also known as Exactor)/TRIFECTA (Also known as Triactor)/SUPERFECTA

An Exacta, Trifecta, Superfecta is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the first two, three and four horses respectively, representing different betting interests to finish in the exact official order of finish, in the race on which the pool is operated.

SWINGER (Also known as OMNI)

A Swinger is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select horses to finish in any order from the official first 3 positions.

JACKPOT HI-5

A Jackpot Hi-5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners in the specified Jackpot Hi-5 race. If there are races that have an entry, (i.e. 1 & 1A and/or 2 & 2B), Jackpot Hi-5 will not offer a wager consisting of both halves of the same betting interest. Example: If the same betting interest finishes first and second in a Jackpot Hi-5, the payout would be 1st, 3rd, 4th, 5th, 6th.

That jackpot portion of the pool will only be paid out if there is a single winning ticket. If there are multiple winning tickets that have correctly chosen the first 5 runners of the race, they will receive 50% of the pool for that day. The other 50% will go over into the Jackpot carryover. If there are no winning tickets with the exact order of finish of the first 5 runners, 100% of the current day's pool will be carried over into the Jackpot.

PICK 3 & PICK-4 BETTING

The Pick 3 & Pick 4 bets are betting transactions in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of three or four successive races specified for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 respectively.

Winning tickets for the Pick 3 & Pick 4 are determined in the following sequence: A) winners of all legs, B) most winners, then refund. If there is a change of surface in any leg that is NOT made known to the public prior to wagering for that pool closing, that leg will pay on all runners. If there are no winners in any leg of a pool, the entire pool is refunded.

PICK 5 BETTING

The Pick 5 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of five successive races specified for the Pick 5 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 5 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 5.

PICK 6 BETTING

The Pick 6 bet is a betting transaction in which a purchaser of a ticket undertakes to select the official winners of each of six successive races specified for the Pick 6 respectively.

If no one has correctly selected all 6 winners, the entire net pool is carried over to the next available PICK 6.

PICK 5 & 6 BETTING

If at least 1 race as part of the Pick 5 or 6 has been cancelled or declared "No contest", but not more than the specified below under Refunds, the net pool shall be distributed to those selecting the most # of winners and NOT include any carryover from a previous pool.

PICK 3, PICK 4, PICK 5 & PICK 6 SCRATCHES

In the event a Pick 3, Pick 4, Pick 5 or Pick 6 ticket designates as a selection a horse which is scratched, excused or determined by the Stewards/Judges to be a non-starter in any of the races comprising the Pick 3, Pick 4, Pick 5 or Pick 6 the favourite, as evidenced by the amount wagered in the win pool at the time of the start of the race in which the scratch occurred, will be substituted for the non-starting selection. In the event that the money bet in the win pool for two or more favourites is identical, the selection with the lowest program number shall be substituted for the non-starting selection.

However, if a scratch occurs in any leg of the Pick 3, Pick 4, Pick 5 or Pick 6 pools before the pool is closed, a ticket including the scratched horse may be cancelled.

REFUNDS

Subject to the Regulations, all monies in all pools on a race are refunded in the event that the race is cancelled, declared off or declared no contest, and all monies bet on a horse are refunded if the horse is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start. These refunds will be communicated to the public through various means such as betting terminals, video display, changes boards and our website.

The Pick(n) pool shall be cancelled and all Pick(n) wagers for the individual performance shall be refunded if:

- Pick-3: at least 2 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)
- Pick-4, 5 or 6: at least 3 legs are declared no contest or cancel. (Effective Jan 1, 2012)

Where a horse that is part of an Entry is a late scratch or does not receive a fair start and at least one horse of that Entry receives a fair start in the race, all tickets purchased on the Entry remain valid and the purchase price of any such ticket shall not be refunded.

COMMON POOL WAGERING (INTERTRACK BETTING)

In the unlikely event of a communications or computer system failure that prevents pools from merging with the host track's pools before the end of a race, CPMA regulations require that the site must refund all tickets for that race. This refund will be communicated to the public through various means such as video displays, change boards and messages on our website.

FAIR START

If a horse has reached the Fair Start Pole (located 200 feet before the Starting Pole) by the time the mobile gate has reached the Starting Pole, that horse is deemed to have had a fair start. It makes no difference whether or not the horse is on or off stride at that precise moment. Under current policy and regulations, which are designed to be as fair as possible to all bettors on all starters, there is no Recall - a repeat of the entire starting procedure - when a horse does not reach the Fair Start Pole before the gate reaches the Starting Pole. Monies bet on such a horse are refunded in accordance with the regulation concerning refunds.

LOST & OLD TICKETS

WEG issued tickets or vouchers are valid indefinitely, however, they cannot be cashed at a mutuel teller after 2 years from date of issue. Please mail tickets, along with your name and address, to Mutuel Manager, P.O. Box 156, Rexdale, Ontario, M9W 5L2, keeping a photocopy for future reference.

For "Lost Tickets" originally sold at a Woodbine Entertainment Group racetrack or Teletheatre, please enquire at the Mutuel office at Woodbine, Greenwood Teletheatre, or Mohawk. Policy may be subject to change retroactively in the event regulatory bodies amend existing regulations.

ASSOCIATION PERCENTAGE, AND TAXATION/LEVY

The Woodbine Entertainment Group deducts and retains the following percentages from wagers placed at our own licensed sites which are then shared with the horsepeople, host and simulcast associations and the Ontario Racing Commission.

WOODBINE/MOHAWK LIVE: Win, Place & Show: 13.65%. Swinger 14.7%. Trifecta & Pick 4: 21.7%. Double & Exakta 17.2%. Jackpot Hi-5, Pick 5 & Pick 6: 11.7%. All other 23.0%

Horsepeople receive a further 2% on all wagers, except Trifecta wagering where it is 4%. The Ontario Provincial Government retains 0.5% on all bets placed in Ontario. The Canadian Government (through a revolving fund cost recovery basis) retains 1% on all wagers placed in Canada for provision of drug control, and audit services.
