#3 MO TOURING had an impossibly wide trip with the rail in Lane 5, fading in the stretch when last competing on August 12. She drops down from the OS/\$40,000 level and should fare well. #5 MICHELE M. had to angle out in the stretch to avoid traffic when rallying to be second against N1X company at Delaware on August 24. She is offered for a tag for the first time here in her second try with blinkers. #1 O WOW got on turf for the first time on July 20, running a decent fourth around two turns on the inner turf. She should be happy to cut back to a proper sprint and draws a good post for her first start in two months. #2 MUSKOCA SUMMER figures to be a speed factor in her delayed 2023 debut. She may be a little better on the synthetic, but her speed figures fit.

#6 TAVALINE was a debut winner with impressive gate speed last August. Rapid daughter of Runhappy has proven she can run well fresh and should be the controlling speed here. #5 GAMBLE'S ORB has yet to miss a check since returning from Florida, most recently forcing the pace before giving way to be third at this level. She will likely be tracking Tavaline and could inherit the lead if that foe were to falter. #3 SOCIETY'S KAT was a head better than Gamble's Orb when finishing second on August 5. Aside from a turf attempt in June she has not had a bad race this year; a sound option. #1 ROCKET RILEY showed some late interest when finishing fourth in the Algoma. Lightly-race filly's speed figures would need to improve to be a win threat but that is not out of the realm of possibility.

#1 JILL pressed the rapid Halfinthewrapper while helping set things up for Ima Beast when finishing third on the main track nine days ago. If she can secure the lead from

the rail draw she could turn the tables; blinkers are off. #4 IMA BEAST had a beautiful stalking setup before finding a split in the stretch to earn her second consecutive win on September 7. She proved two back that she can win on turf; a deserving favourite. #3 OLD SECRETS has a second and a third (by just a head) in two tries at this distance and surface combo. Closing filly will likely be ignored in the wagering and could make some noise if it is one of her better days. #6 I'M INTO MISCHIEF has had two very good efforts over the outer turf including a good runner-up finish on August 26 and will now try the inner for the first time. Typically a speed type, she may assume a stalking roll with the cutback to five furlongs.

#1 SASSINESS looked absolutely loaded turning for home in her debut at Gulfstream but was shut off and clipped heels. She galloped out very strongly; that race has produced two Stakes-winners including Woodbine Oaks winner Elysian Field. #2 FINANCIAL ADVICE (FR) was claimed from her fifth place effort for \$75,000 at Belmont in July and now makes her return to the races. She finished fifth two starts ago behind Prerequisite, who came back to win the Grade 2 Wonder Again. We'll see how she fares in her local debut. #7 CRY FREEDOM has shown a strong turn of foot in both of her starts to date, most recently rallying to be fourth by just a length on the inner turf. The outer course is probably better for her deep closing style. #5 MONEY BEETS tracked the pace and evened out to be sixth, 2 3/4 lengths behind Cry Freedom on August 20. She was scratched from a sprint over this course last week; I wouldn't be surprised if she is a little better than what she has shown.

#5 GAYELETTE cuts back to a sprint after a series of three route attempts, all of which were good efforts, most recently finishing fourth behind the 12 time-winner Rosebud's Hope. She should have a strong pace to run at here. #6 KAVALA has been a hit or miss type since arriving at Woodbine but her better efforts are definitely worth noting, including a close third in the Star Shoot and a troubled fourth in a solid N1X/\$32,000 on June 24. She is another who could be closing strongly into a hot pace. #2 HAPPY VALENTINE's only poor effort so far in her

career came on turf in last year's Catch a Glimpse. She gets to drop into the easier N2L category after a couple of good efforts at the N1X/\$32,000 level. #3 SCOTTISH SYMPHONY went down to Presque Isle where she finished second behind the monster in the making Pennsylvania-bred filly Captain Courtney in the Malvern Rose. She nearly won at this level two starts ago; speed threat.

#2 CARSON'S RUN was a winner on debut at Saratoga before finishing strongly to be second by a half-length in the With Anticipation. Son of Cupid is shortening up in distance and getting around one turn for the first time; could unleash a strong turn of foot into a fast pace. #7 AIROSA is cross-entered in the Natalma. She found herself in a good spot before kicking clear up the inside to win the Catch a Glimpse; her speed figures fit well enough to give her a shot against the boys. #3 MY BOY PRINCE went to the front and never looked back when winning the Simcoe by 14 lengths. He has to face considerably tougher here, but he has speed out of the gate and should be plenty confident after two romping wins; the dam won her only start on turf. #1 SOUPER ATTENTIVE made a strong rally to be fourth by 1 3/4 lengths on debut on August 20. He draws inside this time and could step forward at a decent price.

#4 SECRET RESERVE made a wide rally over an inside speed favouring track when finishing fourth behind Patches O'Houlihan in the Bold Venture. Son of Giant Gizmo is frequently in the hunt; if the other speed types are able to wear down Patches O'Houlihan he could be the one to pick up the pieces. #6 PATCHES O'HOULIHAN rocketed out to set the pace, shook off a challenge from Old Chestnut and rebroke to win the Bold Venture impressively. Between Rockcrest and My Buddy B he may have to deal with early pressure, but if he is simply quicker than everyone else out of the gate he may just be too good for them. #7 OUTLAW KID shipped up from Saratoga and ran back on 10 days rest when getting up over the lone speed Silent Reserve to win the Vice Regent on August 5. He tries the Tapeta for the first time; Calling Rhy Rhy was a restricted Stakes-winner on the

synthetic. #8 MY BUDDY B set fast fractions and kicked away to beat some classy horses in an open allowance at Mountaineer August 6. He broke his maiden on debut over the Tapeta at Turfway; we'll see if he can match Patches O'Houlihan's early foot.

#1 DAZZLING STAR exploded late to break her maiden at Newmarket on June 30, but chased the winner and failed to accelerate late when finishing fourth in the Princess Margaret at Ascot. She should have a good covered up trip from the inside. #2 BOLT ENOREE dueled through fast fractions before giving way to be fifth in the Catch a Glimpse. There is not a ton of speed here despite the large field; if she can control things at this longer distance and catch a breather she could get brave. #13 DEA MATRONE (FR) was brought to North American following her easy maiden score at Strasbourg in France. Chad Brown-trainee figures to be well supported but will have to work out a trip from a tough post. #3 DANCING DUCHESS came up a neck short behind stablemate Golden Canary in the Soaring Free. I think she was the best horse in the My Dear two starts ago; talented filly is a half to Queen's Plate-winner Safe Conduct and should handle the stretch out to a mile.

#3 SHIRL'S SPEIGHT raced wide and ran an okay fourth in the King Edward, his first start since his big effort in Dubai in March. He may have needed a start off the bench to get back into the swing of things after his international travels over the winter; he has worked strongly in the interim. #1 MASTER OF THE SEAS (IRE) is a lightly-raced five-year-old with plenty of talent, with five Group Stakes wins to his name in his 13-start career. He was a non-factor in the Dubai Turf but returned at Ascot in the Summer Mile with a dominant score. These connections won last year's edition of this race with Modern Games and have a strong chance to repeat. #4 ICE CHOCOLATE (BRZ) has been knocking on the door of his first North American Graded Stakes win the last couple of seasons, and now returns to Woodbine after a few tries in New York where he chased the likes of Cara Creed and Annapolis, most recently finishing third in the Fourstardave. He is probably better suited to the one-turn

configuration of this race. #2 WAR BOMBER (IRE) chased the pace early and was able to prevail in a gritty stretch duel with Loyalty to win the King Edward. He will likely be chasing My Sea Cottage this time; that's an easier target than Loyalty but the closers figure to be much tougher this time.

#6 CRUDEN BAY was second best behind Lord of War, who took advantage of an inside speed favouring track, when finishing second at this level on August 20.

Consistent runner is good enough to win at this level; should be in the hunt here. #1 J P HELLISH took advantage of an inside speed bias on August 11 but was much the best horse regardless when crushing \$25,000 company by 11 lengths. He looks like the obvious one to beat at this higher level. #5 RAPPER ZAPPER dropped in for \$40,000 and overcame the inside speed track to win with a wide circling move on August 20; we'll see if that was a light switch effort. #8 CALL CURT has closed to be third in both of his most recent efforts, both times finishing behind Cruden Bay. Blinkers are added; hopefully he can find better early position.

#8 DANCIN IN DA'NILE was never a win factor but did not disgrace himself in his sixth place effort in the King Edward where he was sent off at 46-1. Three starts ago he was a nose behind Palazzi, who came back to win the Singspiel; cross out his two-back effort on the inner turf as he had a no-hope wide trip on that day. #3 BRITISH ROYALTY wheels back in a week after finishing a non-threatening fifth in the Singspiel. The 2021 Breeders' Stakes winner is a marathon specialist but must have come out of his last effort well to be running back so quickly and may be live with the easier company. #5 ELUSIVE KNIGHT took back from the far outside post and rallied well to be third while attracting a \$40,000 claim in the first leg of the Turf Endurance Series over 11 furlongs on the inner turf. He is better suited to the outer turf; he won at both this level and the tougher N3X/\$80,000 level on the main track last year. #7 KEROUAC set the pace but was run down by War Court over a closer-friendly surface on August 24. Son of Uncle Mo figures to be a speed threat in his turf debut.

#4 KANTBACKOFF was the best horse in her August 5 effort over the turf course but was held up in traffic a few times. If she can run back to that effort she should be able to handle these. #6 JOKES UP was well clear of the rest of the field when finishing third behind Admissible and Souper Sicily, both solid fillies for the level, on August 18. She has yet to miss the board on Tapeta. #3 TALKING WONDERS dropped in for this tag and ran an okay though somewhat disappointing third as the favourite on August 26, two weeks after a credible fourth against maiden special weight company. She looks logical in just her fourth career start. #5 HITS DIFFERENT showed closing interest in all three of her sprint efforts over the Gulfstream Tapeta. Her speed figures fit and a longer sprint may suit her better than the shorter dashes offered at Gulfstream. #1 ONDINE LADY drops in for \$40,000 and gets back to the Tapeta after a pair of disappointing turf attempts at the maiden special weight level; she finished second in an off-turf route to kick off the season.
