#2 LEGALLY CHARITABLE was forwardly placed and a clear second best in a good effort against \$12,500 company at Oaklawn on March 21. The cutback to five furlongs should be no issue, especially with her winter fitness edge. #4 SILVER BULLET LADY was able to win her first start of the 2024 season in gate to wire fashion in a race where she took no early pressure. She missed the top three only once in eight tries last year and looks like the biggest threat to Legally Charitable. #6 SOUPER COP had a hit or miss 2024 season with several wide trips working against her. She did run some of her better races early in the season and could be dangerous fresh; lasix is added. #3 ALA TURKA spent the majority of the 2024 season facing tougher starter optional claiming company; she has posted some sharp works this spring and has potential to turn her form around.

#7 HOULIHAN ran her best race to date when closing out the 2024 season, setting the pace and missing by a nose over a closer-friendly track on December 5. She does not have much to beat if she can run back to that effort off of the shelf. #3 HYPER HOLIDAY ran on to be a non-threatening second when kicking off the season on opening day and figures to be competitive with these. #8 SLOANS SKY was two lengths behind Hyper Holiday when finishing fourth on April 26 but was able to finish in front of that foe last year; blinkers are being added for the first time today. #1 EASTER SUNDAY GIRL has the best speed figures in this race when looking at her turf races in Maryland last year. She probably wants nothing to do with five furlongs but if the synthetic is not an issue, she is probably talented enough to pick up a check against this group.

#2 THE FIERY ONE (GB) had a rough run into the first turn and ran on one-paced when debuting around two turns on the speed-favouring Gulfstream turf on February 14. She was purchased in an online auction and will go off of lasix for the new connections; an interesting player cutting back. #4 HOODLESS was forwardly-placed and came up second best on December 5 behind stablemate Zippy Gamble, who won an OS/\$40,000 non-two last

week. She will add blinkers and looks like the one to beat as a speed threat for the live combo of Kevin Attard and Pietro Moran. #1 SERIOUS GREEN ran a few good races last year, picking up checks at this level. Her form might not be flashy but her speed figures are as good as anyone's and she may be a better price than the top two choices. #6 CODICIA POR VIDA is by 11% debut sire Blame; out of a mare who has one winner at longer distances in Europe. She trained in Ocala over the winter so fitness should not be an issue.

#4 GLASWEIGIAN had some very solid efforts in his 2024 campaign. Tactically speedy gelding has strong speed figures and goes for a barn that did very well in the early season last year. #5 SOL DE VERANO was never able to run back to his debut win which is not uncommon for precocious two year olds. He has been gelded in the off season and goes for a new low tag; could be worth a look at a price. #2 TUTTI CONTENTI stalked the pace and got up to break his maiden when dropping in for this tag on November 9, but was a bit flat when pressing the pace 15 days later. He ran a respectable third behind a runaway winner in his debut last year. #1 FROST BITTEN is a bizarre horse with seemingly no true preferred running style or distance. He could offer value with a fitness edge off of some poor form in Gulfstream turf routes.

#2 MOVENTOTHECOUNTRY was fanned widest and took a moment to switch leads in a green but respectable fourth-place effort on December 7. She adds blinkers for her first start for new connections. #4 FANNY M has speed and clearly has some ability but has found ways to lose in spots where she looked best a few times. Her best hope is to get loose on the lead and stay brave, which definitely looks possible but I wouldn't want a short price on her. #5 SCARY BOO had a rough start but rallied well to be second, beating both Moventothecountry and Fanny M on December 7. We'll see if she can show any more speed this year. #6 HER OBSESSION improved with each start last year, closing the season with a third place effort on December 7, two lengths behind Scary Boo; worth a look.

#6 ITSASTORMYMONDAY had a wake-up effort in his second start at two when dropping in for \$40,000, stalking the pace and pouncing to a comfortable score. He gets to run for the waived tag here and looks live. #2 OUT N OUT DISGRACE was a non-factor in a very tough group of N1X/\$25,000 types at Turfway on March 22, but rallied over a speed-favouring track to be fourth in the start prior. Winter-fit runner ran well in sprints in his first few starts and may not mind cutting back to seven furlongs. #3 NEXT PITCH was a game winner on debut in June but was sidelined after a workout two weeks later. The first foal out of speedy Stakes-winning mare Green Doctor showed serious potential and is definitely one to consider in his return. #4 PRIVATE LABEL is a half to Grade 1-winner Fair Maiden but a full to a dud in Passionplate. He likely had been breezing south of the border before the April 6 work that shows up on his form and comes into this race off of a quick gate drill on May 3.

#8 BRIGHT SUNSHINE drops in for \$40,000 after essentially being eased in her final start at two. She is the only runner here who has shown any semblance of speed. #1 LEMONCELLA SPRITZ was beaten a length in a blank finish when debuting at this distance on October 5, and also ran a good third at the distance on November 30. She may be the only one in this field who truly wants to sprint. #7 BOLD RIPASSO took on the boys when debuting in a route on December 8 and rallied from last to be a solid third. She figures to be well backed in her return. #2 PAT'S HOLIDAY was outfinished by Bold Ripasso when finishing fourth on December 8. All three of her starts last year were routes.

#6 ROLLING ALONG had a dominant maiden win on July 6 but was sidelined after finishing second at a short price at this level on August 25. He has some speed in a race without much pace and could be tough to run down. #5 PIERRE started off his three year old campaign with some big efforts before finishing a very respectable fourth in the King's Plate, but disappointed with a sixth-place finish over the Fort Erie dirt in the Prince of Wales. He now returns as a gelding and has been posting sharp works. #1 MAP'S A BREEZE ran an eye-catching second on debut behind the very solid Victory Achieved and continued to race well before breaking his maiden in a route on December 8. The lack of pace in this race may

leave him at a disadvantage. #3 FORTY N FIVE did not fire in a turf route at Keeneland last time but did finish second in a dirt sprint at Gulfstream behind Rolando, who came back to win the Hutcheson. The cutback and recency could both work in his favour.

#2 EVER DANGEROUS was three-wide throughout and was picked up by a 6-5 shot with a better trip when beaten a nose at Gulfstream on March 12. He rises in class but has the speed figures to handle this company. #4 JOURNEYMAN was stymied in early stretch when finishing fourth for \$50,000 on the Tampa turf on April 6. He raced well there all winter and was able to have success on the Tapeta at this level last year. #1 ROSCAR ran a big third at this level on November 17 before failing to threaten in the Valedictory to close out the season. The Breeders' Stakes winner has run more good races than bad and should be able to work out a good trip for his four-year-old debut. #5 ESSEX SERPENT showed speed but dropped the anchor in both the King's Plate and the Prince of Wales before being put on the shelf. He was impressive in his front-end score in the Marine; figures to be chasing Maakwa.

#2 ZEENA SWIFT forced the pace before wilting against \$25,000 company last week. Her Gulfstream form was good and the quick return seems like a positive in a field with some questionable company. #4 ENGLISH JUBILEE was put on the shelf after being claimed out of her maiden win for this tag on October 31. Her speed figures are solid but she's only had one try on Tapeta and it was nothing to write home about. #8 SECRET BUTTERFLY showed nothing in her first few starts but figured something out when breaking her maiden for bottoms on October 31 and raced well in her final two starts of the season. She could be a speed player from the outside. #5 PRINCESSONAMMISSION took advantage of a speed bias when going gate to wire for an overdue maiden win on October 10 before being sidelined; another speed threat. #1 OLIVIA'S MELODY raced well in each of her final three starts of 2024, culminating in a narrow maiden win at this distance on December 5. The barn has started the meet off well with some good prices.
