#### #3 Balboni's Crew

#### #1 Bank On Big Winner

#### #2 Deputy Ghost

#### #5 Silent Code

#3 BALBONI'S CREW stormed home to be third in his debut on July 13. If he can be a little closer early he could be a serious threat. #1 BANK ON BIG WINNER was a very game second chasing stablemate Big Bold and First on June 29. He could be the main speed and the fact that he has started from the rail post already is a positive. #2 DEPUTY GHOST ran a credible third when debuting in the same race as Bank On Big Winner. Son of Shaman Ghost should appreciate more distance as he gains experience. #5 SILENT CODE is by 12% juvenile debut sire Silent Name, and the first foal to race out of debut-winning mare Peace Sign. Both of his gate works have been slow; we'll see what we get.

#5 DEPUTY DADDY was able to prevail over the talented Philip My Wine over this course on June 15. If Go Kart Mozart and Dark Screen wear each other out, he could get the perfect trip behind them. #6 GO KART MOZART had to work but found enough to prevail over Dark Screen in the Lake Huron, extending his win-streak to three. Speedy gelding is a deserving favourite. #2 DARK SCREEN was valiant in defeat when beaten a half-length by Go Kart Mozart in the Lake Huron. He can be up and down but his best effort could turn the tables on Go Kart Mozart. #1 KEKOA was a bit even in the stretch when finishing midpack in an inner turf mile race on June 20. He raced well in the Bull Page over this course last year; I would not count him out entirely.

#1 WICKED MERCURY ran on to be a credible third behind stablemate Gloriannia on July 5. She drops down from the N1X/\$32,000 level; very consistent and hard to ignore. #3 HOME FOR A REST chased the speed and just missed by a half-length behind the very solid Galley Head when racing for \$15,000 on June 19. She could be a speed factor in a race without many true front-end sprinters. #2 VERI GIZMO rallied from last to be a decent fourth at the N1X/\$32,000 level in her first start for these connections in December. She raced well to be second in her first start off of the layoff last year. #6 TABLOID MATERIAL chased a moderate pace and proved best in the stretch to win her non-three for this price on July 5.

Her speed figures will need to improve to double up moving into open company.

#8 WILL WIN raced very well in his July 6 debut to be beaten a neck by the promising Corsia Veloce. He has to overcome the outside draw with this move to the turf but could use his experience edge to his advantage. #7 DYNA is by 14% juvenile debut sire Quality Road, out of a multiple Stakes-winning mare who has produced Grade 1-winning millionaire turfer Force the Pass. She was outworked by a couple of stablemates from the gate on July 9; takes on the boys for her debut. #5 GONE WITH DUWYN is by 12% juvenile debut sire Silent Name, out of a mare who has produced juvenile winner Pontiac. He worked evenly with a stablemate from the gate on June 29 and had another sharp gate move on Wednesday. #4 THUNDERMAKER is by freshman fire Modernist, who has two debut winners in eight starters so far. The dam has produced multiple Graded Stakes-winner Lucky Score as well as Stakes-winner Miss Matzoball.

#5 CONACHER was disqualified for interference at the start when winning on the inner turf at this level on July 6. He is not hooking the toughest field ever and could secure the win this time. #1 SHAMATEUR set the pace but gave way late to be third when kicking off his season in the same race that Conacher exits. He figures to be the pacesetter again but has a difficult time sustaining his speed. #7 YOU'RE SO LUCKY was never involved when facing OS/\$40,000 foes over 5 ½ furlongs back in May. He now returns to the race; broke his maiden for \$25,000 in a route and should be at home here. #2 SPEEDY BULLEIT looked good when breaking his maiden at Fort Erie in July, then ran a non-threatening third behind two Woodbine-claims in an allowance down there. He raced well in Tapeta routes a couple of years ago; could be worth a look here.

#1 BRITISH ARTILLERY was scratched from a very tough race at this level a couple weeks ago and now ends up in an easier spot. On the right day he can have an explosive turn of foot, and he should be able to get a nice covered up trip from the rail. #6 AWESOME BOURBON ran a close third at the N2X/\$50,000 level two-back, then came back to win his OS/\$40,000 non-three. He should be very competitive at this level

considering he almost beat tougher two-back. #8 PALACE VIEW (IRE) found a hole and proved best to win his \$25,000 non-three while attracting a claim 10 days ago. We'll see how he handles the class jump on the quick turnaround. #7 READY TO COLLECT was second-best behind the rapid Silent Reserve in a five furlong inner turf dash on June 29. He may be a five furlong specialist but he is worth a look here.

#3 NEXT PITCH had some trouble in early stretch when running a good fourth on turf on July 6. He had a wide journey when running flat the previous start but had a nice-looking win in May. #8 YACHT BOY makes his first start of the season here. Multiple Stakes-placed gelding hit the board in every start except for a five furlong inner turf try last year; hard to ignore. #1 SUMMER COMMANDER dueled on the lead and was outkicked late by Gilt Edge when second in the same race that Nice Pitch exits. He could have company on the lead from Fifty B M G or Cooler Man. #5 SHADOW REALM made a wide move and was able to get up and win his non-two on June 29. Two-back he was second-best behind Plate Trial-winner Sedbury's Ghost.

#5 WOZNIAKI was an impressive winner on debut then ran a very game third by just a half-length against non-twos. She has one turf-winning sibling in three to try the surface; if she handles the surface she looks good enough to win. #2 RHAENYRA broke a step slowly but recovered and made the lead before kicking clear to win the Georgian Bay over the inner course. If she outsprints Suigu Belle and secures the lead she could be a big threat to double up. #3 SWEET PASSIONS had traffic trouble but was only beaten 2 ½ lengths when facing a solid OS/\$40,000 non-three group on July 5. She hasn't had a bad effort this season; in the hunt. #6 BRENGUNGIRL chased the pace and gave way to be fourth, 2 ¼ lengths behind Sweet Passions on the main track on June 14. She was impressive in her first two wins last year; we'll see how she takes to the turf.

#5 JUNIOR HOT SHOT did not have a clean trip but was able to outkick stablemate Its Time to Shine to win an N2X/\$50,000 on June 29. He has been impressive in both of his wins this season and should be able to add another Stakes-win to his resume here. #3 LIGHT THE LAMP won both legs of the Turf Sprint series before the final leg failed to fill and has rerouted to this spot. He ran third in last year's Vice Regent showing that he can be competitive in these restricted Stakes and is coming into this with confidence. #4 ITS TIME TO SHINE went gate to wire to win his first two starts of the season before back-to-back runner-up finishes in the N2X/\$50,000 ranks. He should be able to take them a fair ways. #2 HUNT MASTER was able to win an N2X/\$50,000 over a mile on the inner turf in his first start off of the claim. Versatile type should not be bothered by the switch to a synthetic sprint.

#8 COUNTRYBOYSURVIVE dueled on the lead and was a presence to the wire when beaten a neck on turf on May 30, then was a wide closing fourth on the main track on July 6. He seems to be in good order; obvious contender. #2 VELOCIRAPTOR dropped in for this price on June 29 and ran a closing third in a five furlong inner turf dash. Blinkers are added; should be happy to get back to the bigger turf. #9 PAYNES SPIRIT was rolling late to be fourth after dropping back to last in his debut over five furlongs, then raced wide and finished evenly in a main track route on July 13. The cutback to 6 ½ could hit him right between the eyes. #13 PARADISE PERFECT flew late to be beaten a neck at this level on May 30 but finished midpack when bumping up to the maiden special weight level on July 6. If he can work out a trip from this post he should be competitive getting back to this level. #7 RED WEAVER dueled and emptied out when kicking off his season on the inner turf. He may simply not be a grass horse but he showed ability last year and is worth a look in his second start off of the bench.
