Race 1

#4 Legal Attack (GB)

#7 Hemlo Gold

#2 Small Talk

#8 Mid Day Image

#4 LEGAL ATTACK (GB) rallied to earn his second win of the season in a five furlong dash at this level 15 days ago. He has been in remarkably consistent form this season and has fared well at distances up to a mile in his younger years. #7 HEMLO GOLD had a troubled trip over this course when attracting a \$15,000 claim two-back, then had a very wide trip when being claimed again for \$25,000 on July 12. The new connections do not hesitate to get him back down in for \$15,000 off of that poor effort; he likes this course and is due for a good trip. #2 SMALL TALK outfinished Legal Attack to win an optional \$10,000 going six furlongs on the EP Taylor on July 25. He was primarily a two-turn horse in his younger years and definitely has a shot to double up. #8 MID DAY IMAGE raced very well to be second behind Legal Attack when making his local debut on June 27, then tried the Tapeta on August 1 where he raced an even fifth. He is definitely a turf specialist, and he has enough back class that I would give him serious consideration.

#1 ROYAL QUALITY had an absurdly wide trip from the 10 hole when finishing last here for \$15,000 on July 25, but rebounded with a close runner-up finish for \$6,250 over the Fort Erie turf behind a respectable foe 11 days ago. He is drawn well here and had good results in synthetic sprints early in the meet. #6 BOLD RELOAD gets significant class relief after tiring in a starter/optional \$15,000 five furlong dash on the inner turf 15 days ago. Although rapid, his best results are typically going six or 6 ½ furlongs as he gets an easier time on the lead. #4 MIDNIGHT ARKLE was entered in a wide-open \$7,500 yesterday but scratched and re-entered in favour of this easier spot. He ran on well to be third at this level on August 1 and should have a more honest pace to rally into this time. #2 THE NEW QUALITY ran a similar race to Royal Quality off of a wide trip on July 25. He did have a good effort three starts ago; could rebound on the drop in for bottoms.

#7 CRUCIAL TAUNT drops back in for the tag he was taken for after running a credible third for \$25,000 on August 8. He should have a solid pace to run into here. #6 BIG BABY HENRY ran a big second sprinting on the turf on August 1, then wheeled back two weeks later with a midpack effort routing on the inner turf. He seems to be showing that he simply wants to sprint; we'll see how he

handles the Tapeta. #3 ISAAC LEO took advantage of a speed-favouring track and held by a neck to break his maiden for \$25,000 on July 25. He takes a drop for his first start against winners; may have company on the lead here. #2 IMPERIAL GOLD plunged in for \$15,000 and was never headed on the lead when winning easily on August 2. He catches a much tougher group for his first start against winners and will likely be outsprinted for the early lead.

#7 LIL BIT GANGSTA raced evenly when fourth in a very solid OS/\$40,000 group 16 days ago. His first two starts of the season at this level were both very solid; contender in a wide-open group. #6 AGILE DANCER won his non-two for \$15,000 on June 22, then outfinished Lil Bit Gangsta to be second at this level on July 17. He had some good efforts over this course last year. #4 STONKS rallied well to be second by a length behind Mister Holden while attracting a \$15,000 claim on August 1. He seems to do his best running over this course. #5 SOONER LUNAR came up completely empty when sprinting on the EP Taylor on July 31. Always a hit or miss type, he will go without blinkers today and seems to prefer this course.

#4 A LA CARTE did not have a great trip but showed nothing when making his local debut for \$25,000 on turf. He plunges in for bottoms and will likely prefer the Tapeta; rebound candidate. #5 DOADSTER is another taking the plunge from the \$25,000 level, finishing fourth in the same July 18 race that A La Carte exits. He broke his maiden on synthetic though I do think turf is his preferred surface; an obvious threat. #7 CUT'EM LOOSE ships up from Gulfstream where he has had mixed results. He could be a pace threat stretching out from the shorter sprints offered on the Tapeta down there. #3 MONDAY MORNING's best race this season was his first start of the year sprinting on the Tapeta. He drops in for bottoms and gets back on his preferred surface.

#3 SEEKINGTITLEREADY dropped back early and ran on very well to be third when debuting on July 26. She gets a little more distance to work with and will perhaps be a little sharper early this time. #4 MIKELLE was a game closing second behind Workout Affair over a mile on the inner turf on July 12. She was beaten a head in her debut on Tapeta and will get back to the main track for the first time this year. #5 LUDICROUS chased the pace and evened out a bit late when finishing fourth, a half-length behind Seekingtitleready when debuting on

July 26; should be a pace factor here. #6 XARABELLA has raced very well in all three of her starts this year, two runner-up finishes on this surface before finishing third, a neck behind Mikelle on the inner turf last time. It's tough to ignore her consistency; big shot.

#3 SULTANA was ultra-impressive in her winning debut, exploding after a rough break, then was chasing the pacesetting Blitz and was unable to go by when coming back on July 12. She should be able to handle this group. #7 REVELER'S ROW won on debut before being beaten a half-length by the solid Aspen Dawn when setting the pace in an N1X/\$32,000 on June 22. In the Woodbine Oaks she was nowhere near the lead and ran on to a decent midpack finish; she should fare well here. #5 LUPA (IRE) stalked and popped to win her debut over the inner turf before coming up empty after a speed duel in the Ontario Colleen. She tries the synthetic for the first time here; we'll see if she can rebound. #6 FAMILY was completely empty at 1-2 when making her local debut in a seven furlong sprint on June 14. She has had time to freshen up and will try a route for the first time; figures to be the main speed.

#2 HARLAN ESTATE made his seasonal debut at this level on the Tapeta on August 2, finishing a very solid third. He is best on turf and should be live in his second start off of the bench. #3 MCAVOY came up empty in the Niagara. He had a nice effort at the N3X/\$80,000 level three starts ago; blinkers are being added for this drop in for \$50,000. #1 HUNT MASTER won at this level over this course in his first start for these connections, then cut back to a sprint and switched surfaces for the Pink Lloyd, where he rallied to be fifth by just 1 ¾ lengths. He could be the clear pacesetter here from the rail draw. #10 WESTSIDE TIDE swung wide and rallied well to win his N2L allowance on August 3. He takes on tougher here and draws a bad post but has the speed figures to be competitive.

#2 TICKER TAPE HOME has been in very good form this season, most recently finishing a game third behind Oujda in the Sweet Briar Too. She has hit the exactor in half of her eight starts on the Tapeta and should have a hot pace to run at here. #8 WEIGH THE RISKS returned from a five-month break at Saratoga on July 23 with a dominant front-end win against high-level allowance company on the dirt. She will likely have company on the front end here; we'll see how she takes to the synthetic.

#3 METAPHYSICAL finished gamely to be fourth, a neck behind Ticker Tape Home in the Sweet Briar Too. All three of her wins have come on the synthetic and she will get to race over it for the first time this season today. #1 STORMCAST held on to win the Bessarabian in her final start of 2024 and will now return to the races. Typically a pacesetter, she seems likely to stalk from the inside as Olivia Rose will probably try to pressure Weigh the Risks early.

#7 MEDIA SENSATION had a very wide journey over 10 furlongs in the second leg of the Turf Distance series 13 days ago. He has had more success on the synthetic and should be live with a better trip. #1 BACHELOR PAD rallied to be beaten a head by Sailor's Passion on the turf on August 1. A 15-time winner with 13 synthetic wins, he is extremely versatile when it comes to distance and running style and is very hard to ignore. #5 SOULMATE was pressed through quick fractions in the Turf Distance series, giving way to be fifth, a neck better than Media Sensation. Once again there is other speed to potentially wear him down here. #8 SAILOR'S PASSION hit the lead in deep stretch and was able to hold off Bachelor Pad for the win last time. Closing type should have another honest pace to run at here.

#1 MICHAEL'S GIFT raced wide, moved prematurely and flattened out when facing \$25,000 foes on this course on August 1. He gets more class relief and should have a better trip here. #3 UPHILL ROAD clipped heels early but was able to recover and run on to be a non-threatening fifth when debuting on July 25. He could improve with experience and a cleaner trip. #8 ITS IN THE CARDS dropped in for this tag on July 25 and finished very well to be a length behind repeat-winner True Shot. He figures to be well-supported here. #4 NIGHT STRIKER was a half-length behind Its in the Cards last time when finishing third. He makes his 22nd start here and is tough to endorse on top, but if he is going to win it seems the inner turf is where its most likely to happen. #2 AIM DONT MISS ran a decent third when trying this course two-back and could be there for a minor share today.


