#2 READY TO COLLECT benefitted from Outlaw Kid's poor trip but nevertheless put in a huge effort to be beaten a neck in the Vice Regent 15 days ago. Inner turf specialist should be a major player in this spot. #1 FIFTY B M G was caught in deep stretch to be beaten a neck at this level over the EP Taylor 17 days ago. He shortens up a furlong and has had good results over this course. #3 HE SHOOTS HE WINS dueled on the lead and was prominent throughout when beaten a half-length in a starter/optional \$15,000 over this course on August 8. He may be outmatched by the top two but could hold on for a share. #4 WAGNER rallied and was up late to win his non-two for this tag over the EP Taylor course on August 10. He will need a serious speed duel to get up here.

Race 2

#5 U S Army Corps #3 Sunrise Drive #4 Royal Hudson #6 Chancel

#5 U S ARMY CORPS had a very wide journey when offering little in the stretch 10 days ago. He had been in good form prior to that effort; last year when going this distance he was a good second when outkicked on a closer-friendly surface. #3 SUNRISE DRIVE was very game when winning for \$15,000 in his return from Oaklawn in May but has regressed in two starts since and is now halving in value. Galloping type would be no surprise to see get back to form. #4 ROYAL HUDSON ran an okay fourth in a race where Rapture Bay was allowed to lope along easily on the lead on August 1. He has won half of his synthetic starts; not out of the question here. #6 CHANCEL could be the pacesetter here. He allowed Rapture Bay to have the easy lead in the aforementioned August 1 race and may decide to go a little more out of the gate this time.

Race 3

#2 Hey Cue - Best Bet #1 Highland Society #6 Winston Blue #5 Mister Holden

#2 HEY CUE is two-for-three since being claimed by these connections with both wins coming over this

surface and distance. He has the speed to be in whatever position he wants and should be tough on the slight rise in value. #1 HIGHLAND SOCIETY was a winner for \$7,500 two-back then bumped up to this level on August 10 and ran a big second behind the pacesetting Jimmies Big Day. He is prone to throwing in the odd clunker but his better efforts are good enough to win here. #6 WINSTON BLUE has been very live since getting in for \$7,500 and has also seemed to appreciate the addition of blinkers, winning two of his last three including a game win over the solid Determined Fury. He wheels back in 10 days; repeat chance. #5 MISTER HOLDEN stalked the pace and proved best to win a \$15,000 non-three over the inner turf on August 1. I think he is better around two turns but should still fare well here.

#9 STIRLING CASTLE ran a decent third on debut when chasing the runaway Sundays Will, then added blinkers and lacked any sustain when adding blinkers on August 10. He drops in for \$25,000 and removes the blinkers here. #7 CHAMBERS ran fairly well in a couple of maiden allowance races last fall, then was distanced on the Keeneland dirt in April. He returns here with a plunge in for \$25,000; blinkers are removed. #1 PIN BOY rallied well to be second, 8 ½ lengths clear of his next rival when racing at this level on August 8. He can race well close to the pace or closing. #2 MOPHARRA has shown little at the maiden allowance ranks and now takes the big drop in for \$25,000. He makes his second start with blinkers here; his closest finish to date was his debut in a sprint last year.

#3 LIGHT THE LAMP comes into this race off of a big third-place effort in the Pink Lloyd on July 27. This horse is a much better five furlong turf sprinter than the 6-1-0-1 record suggests as he's been the victim of a couple of disqualifications; most of the competition is coming back on relatively short rest and he may be live as the fresh horse. #6 ARTEMUS CITYLIMITS made a wide bid turning for home and held off Giant Teddy when winning the Vice Regent 15 days ago. He should have a similar setup here, especially with stablemate Silent Reserve here to ensure a quick pace. #2 GIANT TEDDY had to

check going into the turn but recovered and surged to miss by a neck behind Artemus Citylimits in the Vice Regent. Super honest gelding loves to win and would be no surprise here. #1 JET SWEEP JOE was a winner over this course and distance three starts ago over a somewhat troubled Artemus Citylimits. He has since failed to fire in a pair of Stakes against three-year-olds in Saratoga; we'll see if he can rebound.

#4 Roar of the Crowd #7 Red Pharaoh #6 Groot #1 Speedy Bear

#4 ROAR OF THE CROWD ran a flat race on the EP Taylor turf on August 10. He is a better horse on the synthetic and looks very good based on the two races before his most recent start. #7 RED PHARAOH was a game second behind Backonthechaingang while attracting a \$25,000 claim on August 8. Lightly-raced colt should have a good stalking trip behind a hot pace. #6 GROOT was part of an absurd four-horse speed duel before coming up empty in an N2L allowance on May 29. He has been sidelined since and now drops in for \$40,000; we'll see if he can get back to form. #1 SPEEDY BEAR was shuffled back on the turn but came back on again to be a good third, 1 ¾ lengths behind Roar of the Crowd on July 20. He can be very fast but is at risk of a duel here.

Race 7 #6 Pine Knoll #9 Souper Dormy #10 Pat's Gamble #8 Call Me Sue

#6 PINE KNOLL put in a big effort to be third, beaten a head for place by Hanlan while attracting a claim for this price on July 20. He is a very consistent tryer and has had time to freshen up; one of many to consider here. #9 SOUPER DORMY looked very good when winning the Welcome Back Handicap on May 4, then was sidelined after a decent third where Pine Knoll was two lengths better for place on June 8. He is capable of some explosive finishes but will need some luck to work out a trip he likes from the outside. #10 PAT'S GAMBLE has raced well in all three of his starts this season at this level, most recently rallying from 11th to finish third on the EP Taylor turf. His synthetic record is very solid and he should have a good pace to run at here. #8 CALL ME SUE gets to cut back to a sprint after coming up empty in the Plate Trial. He has not gotten to sprint on the synthetic since finishing second behind Mansetti in the Clarendon in November.

#1 JOURNEYMAN has been in excellent form since returning from Tampa, winning an N2X/\$50,000 over this course two-back before finishing a close third on the drop in for \$32,000. He was able to win over this course and distance last year; should be tough. #3 ONE MORE BREW rallied to win the first leg of this series then ran on to be third, 1 ½ lengths behind Fighter in the Win in the 10 furlong leg 22 days ago. He should have no problem with the added furlong and loves this course. #2 FIGHTER IN THE WIN had a perfect stalking trip behind quick fractions and was able to hold off Cornwall to win the 10 furlong leg of this series on August 10. He can race well from seemingly any position. #4 TWOWAYCROSSING was outclassed in the Niagara but had a very nice effort to be beaten a length in an N2X/\$50,000 over nine furlongs two-back and could be a bit overlooked.

#1 TIGER TOWN rushed up after breaking a bit slowly but gave way to be a distant fourth while attracting a \$15,000 claim nine days ago. He wheels back quickly and could be the main speed here with a clean break. #8 PRIME PLUS ONE clipped heels going into the opening turn, raced wide and never factored when going a mile on the inner turf on August 23. He takes the blinkers off and cuts back to a sprint; could be live at a price. #9 MY BOY BRUCE did not seem to improve on turf after three tries on the surface. He drops in for \$25,000 and gets back to his preferred surface. #5 DEMBA looked good when breaking his maiden for \$15,000 over this surface, then came back on July 18 with a good runner-up finish for this price on the turf. He seems like a better horse this year and could be competitive again. #11 DROP YOUR GLOVES has only had one poor race this season when trying a route in May. He has a tough post to overcome but could be in the hunt with a decent trip.
