

### Race 1

#### #2 Hurricane Amelia

#2 HURRICANE AMELIA was one-paced when debuting in a five furlong dash on September 20. Daughter of Shaman Ghost should benefit from experience and the added distance. #4 SOBIECH has raced well in both of her starts at this level. She has more experience than most of her foes here and looks like the one to beat on a slight cutback in distance. #6 BLACK HAWK EAGLE is by 11% juvenile debut sire Silent Name, out of an unraced mare who has produced four-time winner Goodnightgodbless; the worktab does not look bad. #1 WHISKEY OVER WINE drops in for \$40,000 after a green debut against maiden allowance company on August 29.

#8 RUN MATTEO RUN drops in for \$10,000 after trying more forward tactics for \$25,000 and finishing fourth on September 13; the one to beat. #1 ARMINO has had back-to-back runner-up efforts since moving to this barn. He should be saving ground this time after wide draws in his last two. #9 GINGER'S HOLIDAY plodded along to be fifth in a sprint on September 7 after finishing second around two turns on the inner turf on August 22; should like this distance. #6 ARRAKASTA IZAN has been grinding checks this season and figures to be in the money again.

#1 BOLD TOWN broke a bit slowly and did not fire when debuting against the boys in a race won by the impressive Military Time on August 31. She should like the route distance and does not look to be in super tough. #5 CLASSIC DISCOVERY did not fire when going a mile over the inner turf on September 13 but had been in good form prior to that; I don't mind giving her another shot around two turns on the move back to the Tapeta. #6 GOLDEN GOOSE dropped in for \$40,000 for her local debut and rallied to be second. That is at least more positive form than most of her rivals have here. #2 GOLDEN HARVEST is by 9-for-40 juvenile debut sire Maxfield, out of a mare who has had three winners in as many foals to race including the Stakes-placed Naptown. She has plenty of foundation to go the route at first asking.

#1 TRIP ACES attended the pace, opened up the advantage in the stretch but was caught late when dropping in for this tag on September 18. I have liked this horse all season and when he gets the right setup he will win. #2 PARADISE PERFECT rallied into the quick fractions and dead-heated for place with Trip Aces on September 18. This race will come down to the tactics up front; if you think he gets the pace he needs he is clearly good enough. #4 POCKET SPEED tried going to the lead when stretching out on September 18 but gave way to be a distant fourth. He ran well from off of the pace in his debut; we'll see what they try with him here. #5 SLUGGERNAUT failed to fire when making his return to the races on September 7. He tries the Tapeta for the first time and could be better in his second try off of the bench.

#6 NO NAY HUDSON made a bid but was outkicked when finishing a good fourth in the Green Flash at Del Mar on August 30. He could have a perfect setup if the favourites go too fast too early. #7 NOBALS had a wide, chasing trip and flattened out in the Turf Sprint at Kentucky Downs on August 30. Last year's Kennedy Road-winner has some blazing speed at his disposal and should be happy to return to a more normal course. #5 BRING THEBAND HOME figures to be well-supported off of a pair of gate-to-wire scores with big Beyers at Saratoga, most recently in the Grade 2 Troy. If he is able to outsprint everyone for the lead he will be tough once again. #1 LIGHT THE LAMP jumps up in class off of an N2X/\$50,000 win, but could have a perfect trip behind the speed and maybe capitalizes at a price if everything falls apart up front.

#7 SAILOR'S PASSION did not have much pace to rally into when finishing fifth behind stablemate Peja Du on the inner turf on September 12. He won at this level on the Tapeta last fall and should have a much better setup this time. #8 HEMLO GOLD dropped in for \$15,000 to win his first start off of a claim for this price, then came back to be fourth, a neck better than Sailor's Passion on September 12. If he works out a trip from the outside he should be a contender. #1 VOLCANIC makes his delayed seasonal debut here racing for the waived tag. A disappointing \$50,000 claim last year, he has a lot of back class and could be a better horse after the time off; worth a look at an okay price. #6 PEJA DU was left alone on the lead and cruised in to win at this level on the inner

turf on September 12. The pace could be more contested this time.

#3 GALLEY HEAD was up against it when taking on a tough group of boys in a route on September 6. A winner of three of her previous four starts, she should be tough returning to this kind of company. #6 CANDID CANDACE put in three very nice efforts off of the claim before finally breaking through with a smart-looking win against non-threes on September 11. She takes on tougher here but looked good enough last time to think she can handle it. #10 HARD TO CAPTURE was second-best behind the pacesetting Lois Len at this level on September 13. She has been in terrific form all season and should have a more advantageous pace setup this time. #5 ONDINE LADY outkicked the very nice Gizmo's B F F while attracting a \$10,000 claim in her third win of the season on September 18. She is tough to ignore off of very consistent recent form.

#4 READY FOR SHIRL rallied to pull off a minor upset in the Canadian but was unable to keep up with the top two when finishing a non-threatening third in the EP Taylor. She is drawn well here and looks as good as anyone in this field. #1 BREATHE AWAY (GB) swung wide turning for home and got up to win the Violet at Monmouth on August 30. She rarely misses a check and should have a nice covered up trip from the rail. #8 QUEEN'S COMMAND (IRE) was an expensive purchase from the Fasig Tipton March digital auction and looked nice when beating N2X/\$50,000 mares in her debut for these connections on August 29. Supplemental entrant is Grade 3-placed in California; we'll see how she handles this jump. #2 FIVE TOWNS (GB) was a one-paced fourth in the Ontario Matron over the Tapeta on September 13. Just four starts ago she was beaten only a length in the Distaff Turf Mile at Churchill; may offer some value off of less-flashy recent form.

#10 NATIONS PRIDE (IRE) returns to Woodbine after winning this race in 2023. Globetrotting multiple Grade 1-winner comes into this off of a good third in the Swords Dancer in which he may have assumed the lead a bit too early; if he can work out a trip from the outside draw he will be very tough. #2 MY BOY PRINCE was second-best to the very talented Notable Speech after setting the pace in the Woodbine Mile. The 2024 King's Plate-runner up has shown he can carry his speed further than the conventional distances; an interesting threat if he gets left

alone and Nations Pride gets stuck too wide. #1 HAUNTED DREAM (IRE) rallied smartly to win the Singspiel over this course on September 6. In the money in 25 of 39 lifetime starts, he is tough to knock but has to take on tougher company this time. #4 TAWNY PORT had two very nice runner-efforts a week apart over the Kentucky Downs course in their marathon Gold Cup Invitational over 2 1/16 miles, then the Kentucky Turf Cup over today's distance. He is a long time between wins but is consistently capable of showing up in these distance races.

#2 JAYHAWK had some early trouble en-route to a third-place effort behind runaway, repeat-winner Awesome Bourbon when trying turf on September 13. He draws well for his return to the Tapeta which is probably his preferred surface. #5 POSSIBLEMENTE dropped in for \$32,000 on September 13, setting quick fractions over nine furlongs and giving way to be third behind Map's a Breeze and Grandson. He gets a slight cutback and probably is better racing with a target to run at. #4 LAST DAWN had a wide trip and just missed show when last racing at this level on August 23. Hard-knocker switches back to the Tapeta over which he has a very solid record and has the speed figures to be a threat here. #6 MAP'S A BREEZE rebounded when returning to his original barn with a rail-skimming ride on September 13. He should be a factor once again.

He is still lightly raced and does not need to be on the lead to win; good enough to turn the tables. #5 OCEAN ATLANTIQUE dropped in for this tag on September 6 and was able to power by Itsastormymonday for the win. Son of American Pharoah has some back class and is definitely a big threat to double up. #2 EL KABONG rallied nicely to be second behind lone speed-winner Peja Du while attracting a \$25,000 claim on September 12. The pace figures to be a little more contested here. #12 ONE MORE BREW battled into the stretch but gave way to be third behind distance-specialist Twowaycrossing over 11 furlongs on September 1. He has a tough post to overcome here but loves this course and should appreciate the cutback. #7 PRETTY CAPABLE was scheduled to try turf at Saratoga back on July 11 but the race came off. Three-year-old has been breezing strongly since arriving at Woodbine; wild-card.
