Race 1

#3 Valley of Kings - Best Bet

#2 Grand Warrior (JPN)

#4 Proud Painter

#1 Silent Tactic

#3 VALLEY OF KINGS was second-best behind the impressive Military Time after setting the pace on August 31. He should have no problem with the stretch out to two turns; stablemate Bold Time exited this race to win last week. #2 GRAND WARRIOR (JPN) was purchased out of Japan. He is by five-time Group 1-winning stallion Contrail, out of a mare who has produced Group 2-winner Sound Chiara. He has plenty of foundation and should be ready to go the route at first asking. #4 PROUD PAINTER showed finishing interest when fourth over six furlongs in his debut on September 21. He should have no issue with the added distance. #1 SILENT TACTIC is by 2-for-26 juvenile debut sire Tacitus, and the first foal to race out of a mare who made just one start in her career. Expensive purchase had a month between breezes from August 15 to September 11 and the works look ok; tough to feel strongly about.

#2 MO ARGENTO ran a couple of runner-up finishes for \$40,000 before a one-paced fourth on September 4 and now takes the drop in for \$15,000. She figures to be in stalking position and could have enough in the finish at this level. #3 ROCK HARD ROSE chased the pacesetter Ball In Ur Court throughout and was a clear second-best when dropping in for this tag on September 18. Her only poor race since coming to Woodbine was a two turn inner turf race where she was bothered on the first turn. #7 RYO AMAZING rallied up a dead rail to hit the front before giving way to be fourth in a good effort on September 4, but came back last week without the blinkers and failed to close. She re-adds the blinkers and could offer some value. #1 STRAWBERRY WORLD had a tough post and ran an okay fourth for \$25,000 on September 25; could definitely be a factor from a better draw with another class drop.

#2 ZABARTA ran on to be fourth for \$40,000 on September 11 in a race that has produced next-out winner Sobiech. She could be a big factor with the drop in for \$25,000. #6 DAOU set the pace but was outkicked and held second when dropping in for this tag on September 20. She will likely have to set quicker fractions this time. #1 SPADINA, a \$175,000 yearling purchase, showed nothing when debuting in a maiden special weight turf sprint on September 11 and is promptly dropped right in for what is currently the bottom tag for juveniles. We'll see if she shows some life at this level. #10 HENNA GAL ran gamely to be third, a head behind Daou at this level on September 20 and is worth some consideration in this spot.

#5 HURRICANE GIZMO has raced a little better with each start this year, most recently coming up a half-length short at this level on September 20. She catches a similar group this time and could come out on top. #6 SERENADING AMAYA grinded from the back to be fourth, 2 ¼ lengths behind Hurricane Gizmo on September 20. I think she is capable of a bit better than the fringe efforts she's been giving this season. #8 POWAQA rose back up to the \$15,000 level on September 27 and was able to rally from the back to be fourth. She is not a consistent type but is capable of the effort it would take to win this. #4 RIGHT BRIGHTLY was a head behind Serenading Amaya when finishing fifth last time in an improvement from her first route try. If she can reproduce the late turn of foot she had in her maiden win back in July she could be a big factor here.

#6 COMPTON closed well on the wrong lead but came up a half-length short when dropping in for \$15,000 and attracting a claim on September 12. He could have an honest pace to rally into in this spot and should have no problem with the slight stretch out to nine furlongs. #5 RIDE FOR THE PURSE dropped in for this price on September 1 and rallied nicely to be third going 6 ½ furlongs. He tries a route for the first time here. #7 COUNTRYBOYSURVIVE looked good when kicking clear on the front end to break his maiden for this price on September 5, then came back 23 days later with a game third place effort in which he was beaten just ¾ lengths. He will likely be a pace factor stretching out from seven furlongs. #3 GOTME GOOD was carried wide on the first turn and faltered after making the lead when facing a solid group of OS/\$40,000 foes on September 14. He drops in class and removes the blinkers; it will be interesting to see what the tactics are this time.

#3 AFLEET FLATTER has been okay in two starts on turf this year and now gets back to the synthetic for the first time since her career debut which came sprinting. She takes the blinkers off and is worth a look in a group with no true standouts. #6 TAP MY DESIRE was empty on the turf on September 20 which was not a shock given her turf effort on August 2. She was a game second on the Tapeta on August 23 and had a decent route effort four-back. #1 PRINCESS JADE was two lengths behind Tap My Desire when finishing fourth on August 23. She has run more good races than bad this year and has speed figures good enough to win this but is arguably a better sprinter than router. #5 SILLY RISK is by 14% debut sire Quality Road, and the first foal to race out of maiden allowance winner Coconut Grove, who finished second in her career debut at a route distance. She has done her gate work on the training track.

#5 WILD RED finally gets back to the races for the new connections after being claimed for this price on August 7. He really has not run a bad race yet and figures to be live after the freshening. #1 CUPIDS BEST ARROW was bearing out on the turn en route to a last place effort beaten seven lengths when debuting for \$40,000 on September 20. Blinkers are being added for this drop in class. #3 FLORIDA VACATION was pressed on the lead and gave way to be fourth at the OS/\$40,000 level on September 20. She drops in for \$25,000 off of the best last-race Beyer in the field. #7 OOKPIK is by 12% debut sire Frac Daddy, and is the second foal to race out of debut-winning mare Fuhr Love. She outworked company from the gate on September 21.

#1 CYMBAL COURT raced wide and was a non-threatening fourth for \$15,000 on September 11. She draws better and halves in value; has the best speed figures in this field. #7 KAVALA was a distant third behind the runaway Voice From Above on September 11. She adds blinkers for this cutback to five furlongs. #6 IMA BEAST forced the pace while racing wide but emptied out when adding blinkers on September 19. She removes the blinkers today; had two good efforts at this level without them. #2 REALLY THIRSTY chased the pace before giving way to be fourth at this level on September 19. She has numbers good enough to win this and is definitely capable of better than she showed last time. #4 VANDOO drops back in for \$7,500 after two empty efforts for \$15,000 since being claimed and will remove the blinkers; fringe player.
