#4 MOVENTOTHECOUNTRY made a wide bid on the far turn before flattening out to be distant fifth on June 25. She has done her best running in races where she has sat close to the early pace, and the lack of speed in this race could put her in that position. #2 MAKAYLA kicked off her season in a seven furlong race at this level on June 18, stalking the pace and chasing through the stretch to be fifth by just three lengths. She is better suited to two turns and looks competitive here. #6 SIGHT TO SEE tried front end tactics on June 18 but wilted turning for home. Both of her wins have come around two turns; this will be her first two turn trip since her last win in April 2025. #3 AMAZIN QUEEN took on the boys in her return from an extended layoff on June 12 and was never involved. At her best she was more talented than most of today's foes; we'll see if she is more competitive with that start under her belt.

#4 EXECUTIVE SUCCESS stalked the pace before flattening out when kicking off her season in an N1X/\$32,000 on June 27. She was not originally entered in this race when it had been scheduled for Thursday and likely jumped in seeing what a manageable group it was for the level. #5 EMPTY GESTURE has been unable to run down the speedy Soupergirl in two tries over the Fort Erie dirt but has tried hard and raced well both times. A winner at this level here last year with a good run over this course last August, she is not catching the toughest group for the level. #3 SOUPER SUNDAY faced \$15,000 boys in her first start off of the bench on June 19 and ran second behind the very in-form Lazio. She has had turf success in the past; not out of the question. #1 PRIMA has been showing speed and yielding late in \$15,000 Tapeta races. Her last win came against non-threes over this course and distance in September.

#1 WHERE'S SAMNBAILEY missed second by two heads when taking on the boys for this price on June 5. A lack of early speed in this race could be a problem for her but I do think at her best she's the most talented mare in this field. #4 MIDNITE SADIE dropped in for \$10,000 and was a comfortable winner on June 25 over Silverdart,

who came back to win a maiden special weight at Fort Erie. She drops again for her first try against winners and should be well positioned early. #6 JINX ME added blinkers while facing \$15,000 company for her first start of the year on June 18 and ran on to be a non-threatening third. Claimed for \$4,500 last year, they get her back in her \$7,500 today; looks competitive. #7 SERIOUS GREEN broke her maiden for \$10,000 in her 2026 debut but has found the \$15,000 non-twos too tough; she halves in value looking to get back to form.

#2 ZIO CAVALLO was an easy front end winner on debut against OS/\$40,000 maidens, but came up empty when facing a much tougher group of N1X/\$32,000 types with some very salty older horses on June 21. If he handles the turf he should fit very well with this group of N2Ls. #6 SHAK TOWN has had two runner up finishes in as many starts at this level this year, setting the pace before getting run down both times. He raced over this course and distance on June 7 when beaten by repeat-winner Backroadsbilly. #1 IMPULSIVE BID was 3 ¾ lengths behind Shak Town when last racing on June 28. He pressed the pace before fading when trying this course and distance on June 7; could probably be more effective on turf if he gets to settle a bit more with a target to run at. #3 UNBRIDLED WEATHER makes his four-year-old debut here after making just two starts last year. Stakes-winning juvenile has had good results on turf in the past and has a good starting point here.

#1 INDIAN PEAK had a troubled trip but ran a good third, 1 ¼ lengths behind Arabian Prince when kicking off his season on June 21. He was consistently competitive at this level last year and looks live in his second try off of the bench. #4 ARABIAN PRICE battled on the lead and was able to put away Pine Knoll but could not fend off Last American Exit when finishing second on June 21. His last two efforts have been very strong; an obvious contender. #5 POSEIDON STEEL had a wide trip and never got involved when facing N1X/\$32,000 foes on June 21. Plodding type takes the drop in for \$25,000 and should have more finishing kick if he can save some ground this time. #6 PINE KNOLL dueled with Arabian Prince up front before giving way to be fourth on June 21. He does not need the lead and could benefit by sitting just off of the pace this time.

#2 REGAL MOMENT had a hot pace to run at and was able to slip up the rail while holding off the talented Secret Load to win her seasonal bow on June 18. A winner over this course late last year, she should have another honest pace to run at here with a few stretching out in distance to her outside. #4 RETAIL THERAPIST looked like a winner in midstretch after rallying to the lead but could not hold off Ella It Is when racing at this level on June 6, missing by just a half-length. She had a solid winter at Tampa and looks very live here. #7 WHISKEY N ICE battled on the lead and gave way to be fourth in a five-eighths race won by the very solid Breezero on June 27. Rapid mare will stretch out around two turns for the first time in her career here; we'll see if she can outspurt the other potential speed types. #1 TANDHONEYWITHANE was a rallying second in a split of the June 6 race in what was her first turf try and is definitely a contender with a repeat of that effort.

#8 LAWRENCE THE GREAT is by 18% juvenile debut sire Nyquist, and is the first foal to race out of an unraced War Front mare. \$550,000 purchase had a rapid gate work on June 10. #4 DE LA RENTA is by 13% juvenile debut sire Oscar Performance, and is the first foal to start out of a maiden Uncle Mo mare. It looks like she's had a couple of solid gate drills; figures to draw attention with John Velazquez riding. #6 KING'S COUNSEL has two starts under her belt already, rallying well to be beaten a length by the favoured Quipster on June 28. We'll see if the experience edge can put her in the winner's circle. #2 LORD YORKTON made a wide bid before giving way to be fourth when debuting on a major rail speed biased track on June 14. Third-place finisher Uncle Dodo came back to win the Victoria Stakes last week; blinkers are added this time.

#5 FIERY LUCY (GB) had multiple Stakes-placings in her three-year-old campaign in Ireland, finishing off the season coming up empty with a wide trip over the Dundalk polytrack. Fourth in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies Turf in 2024, we know she can race well on firm turf and is an interesting entrant in her first start since being purchased for 165,000 guineas in December. #4 VINA ARANA (IRE) has been racing well this season, most recently finishing a good third in the Mint Julep at Churchill. Although typically a closer she did sit closer to

the pace last time, and that could be an advantage in a race where most of the main threats tend to sit at the back. #1 SULTANA looks for her fourth consecutive win here, cutting back to a mile after winning the 12 furlong Orchid at Gulfstream in March. Two-for-two on turf, we'll see what kind of position she finds with this cutback in distance. #7 QUADRUPLE (GB) finished up well to be third when making her local debut in the Whimsical but threw in a clunker when drawing in off of the AEs in the Royal North. A solid handicap mare in Ireland, she is definitely capable of better than she showed last time.

#4 MILITARY TIME finished gamely but could not get by the pacesetting Highwaytothemoon when last racing in the Queenston on June 7. Second in the Coronation Futurity last year, we know the nine furlong distance won't be an issue and he should have plenty of pace to run at here. #2 VERY SPECIAL is a maiden taking on a tough assignment here, but has definitely shown promise. He ran against a major speed bias when second to Powell River on June 14, then had a rough break but recovered and ran a good third on July 4. Blinkers are added to this son of Ghostzapper who could grind his way onto the ticket. #6 HIGHWAYTOTHAMOON battled on the lead when second-best to Casson in the King Corrie, then was able to dictate his own terms and went all the way in the Queenston. We'll see if he can ration his speed in his first try around two turns. #10 CASSON was pressed on the lead and gave way to be third in the Marine. He is probably better suited to sprinting and will likely need to be able to settle and find some cover from this tough draw.

#7 LUSTER either needed a start over the Tapeta or didn't care for the quicker sprint pace of the Ruling Angel, but got back to form when getting back out to two turns in the Selene. The outside draw may take some maneuvering from Velazquez but I believe in a vacuum she is the most talented filly in this field. #2 DIXIE LAW settled near the back and rallied to nose out Meilani when winning the Ruling Angel, but then looked a little too keen in the early stages when finishing third, outfinished for place by Katie's Grace in the Selene. If she is more settled early I expect her to offer a big finish. #3 KATIE'S GRACE had to be taken back to last early to avoid being hung three-wide on the first turn, settled and was able to rally up the inside to be second in the Selene. The same way you can argue Dixie Law could have been better if she settled early, you can also argue this filly could have raced better if she had been able to sit a bit closer; definitely one to consider off of a strong effort. #1

PIPER'S GIFT tracked the pacesetting Bossy Candy and was able to get up to win the Fury over seven furlongs on June 6. An easy winner of last year's Princess Elizabeth, she shouldn't have an issue with nine furlongs; Hernandez lands on her after riding both Desruisseaux entrants.

#7 IRISH ACES made his return from a 437 day layoff at Churchill on June 19, fighting the rider down the backstretch and running on while under no urging in the stretch. He can race well from almost any position and should be set up well for a big effort. #1 KING SIZE found more on the lead when winning an N2X/\$40,000 over the Laurel turf on May 15. He had a rough trip in his only previous Stakes try; unlikely to make the lead here but should be able to sit a very good inside trip. #3 MAYCOCKS BAY ran them off their feet in the Eclipse, with the two-length winning margin likely aided by Stanley House's drifting in the stretch. Godolphin entrant will likely have to go a bit quicker this time if he wants to try the same style. #4 WYOMING BILL looked good when winning an N2X/\$50,000 on the main track two-back, then ran on fairly well to be fourth in the Dominion Day on June 27. A close second in last year's King Edward, he is very capable on turf and is one to consider if you think the pace will meltdown.

#3 WILLFUL WARRIOR was disqualified from an easy debut win in a sprint and now cuts back in distance after a couple of two turn tries. Last time out he faded after chasing the inside bias-aided Powell River in a forgivable effort; blinkers are added today. #8 STARSHIP SALUTE was entered to debut in an easier spot on the cancelled Thursday card but now has a tougher assignment. Miltole is 12% debut sire and the dam has thrown the Stakes-winning Gun Society. #4 WAR LEGEND was unable to hold off Baaeed Alynna when last racing on June 28. His recent form has been quite good; figures to be in the money again. #7 SUPER TOM reared at the start but came running to be fourth when debuting in the same race that War Legend exits. Hopefully he can get out of the gate cleanly this time.

#5 SHAPOVAL has raced okay in Tapeta sprints but gets an opportunity to get back to two turns on turf, which is what he showed he seems to do best when racing in California. He is not hooking the toughest of groups here. #6 WU TANG KING debuted in a similar spot two weeks ago, having to steady sharply shortly after the start and falling way back early, but coming into the pack nicely going into the far turn before finding some traffic in the stretch. He could be a sleeper pick here with a clean run. #3 BIG SCREEN BOSS set the pace on July 6, giving way to be fourth after having to check in midstretch. With nine runner up finishes in 13 lifetime starts he clearly has enough ability to win but seemingly not enough desire; the blinkers are re-added and he figures to be a short price. #7 BALTIC SEA rallied well from last to finish third for \$25,000 on July 6. He makes just his third lifetime start here; we'll see what kind of pace he gets to run at here.

#6 SCREEN SCENE had a very tough setup in his June 21 debut, racing on the inside of a three-horse duel with two more experienced foes, giving way midturn then getting crowded a bit in the stretch. He adds blinkers here and could get loose on the lead this time. #7 LITTLE THONIO makes his seasonal debut here after being vet scratched on June 15. Very lightly-raced, he has performed well at higher levels and is now dropped in for \$25,000 for his return; an obvious contender but tough to love with the glaring red flags. #5 MR. PERFECT was forwardly-placed and opened up in the stretch but could not hold off a class-dropping Mac Gowan when racing for \$15,000 on June 26. I don't think this is a bad spot to be rising in class in. #8 BONGINO WARRIOR had some traffic in early stretch and may have been able to get third if he had been able to maintain his momentum when finishing fifth for this price on July 6. #4 JOLTED had a perfect set up behind the pace duel but could not finish when ending up fifth in the same race that Screen Scene exits, disappointing as the 2-1 favourite. He now continues to descend the class ladder.
