#5 CIUNAS raced wide and failed to fire in the stretch when competing in an off-turf race on July 4. Stakes-placed gelding has shown plenty of talent and looked fantastic in his win on May 24; if he can settle this time and fire I think he will be very dangerous. #2 DEWOLF challenged a hot pace and flattened out in an off-turf seven furlong race at this level on July 18. He beat a non-descript group of OS/\$40,000 non-threes over this course two-back; he is clearly better on turf and should be better this time than last. #6 CALL ME SUE sat a perfect pocket trip and edged clear in the stretch to win an OS/\$40,000 non-three when stretching out to a route on July 12. He raced well when fifth in a solid allowance group in his sole turf try last year; we'll see if he can continue his upward trajectory. #1 UNBRIDLED WEATHER pressed the pace while racing wide before flattening out to be fifth when kicking off his season in a five furlong dash. A Stakes-winner at two who was second in the Bull Page behind Dewolf, he should appreciate the added distance today.

#8 BIG BABY HENRY narrowly missed place when facing \$10,000 foes in his first start off of a claim for that price last week. He wheels back quickly with a drop in for \$7,500 and should be live. #4 HARPER CITY was an impressive front end winner at this level in his seasonal debut on May 31, then made his return on July 31 for \$15,000, lacking early speed and checking early, never getting involved. He wheels back quicker this time and gets back to a level at which he is frequently competitive. #1 DISSECTOLOGIST tracked the pacesetter, took the lead in the stretch but evened out to be third when last racing on July 24. He has been gradually improving after a poor start to the year; I won't be surprised when he finds himself back in the winner's circle. #5 BOLD RELOAD has been flat in the stretch in both of his starts this season. He re-adds blinkers for his third start off of the bench; we'll see if he can get back to form.

#2 CRYSTAL PEARL lacked early speed but got running in the stretch when finishing second to the bias-aided Lover Boy Mo when debuting on July 4. He should be tough in his second attempt here with the stretch out to nine furlongs. #5 SUPER TOM has had two good efforts in as many starts sprinting, flying home after a slow break to be second behind War Legend on July 19. He will shed the blinkers for his route debut. #1 KEEPMYPOWDERDRY is by 13% debut sire Omaha Beach, out of an unraced mare who has produced a couple of Stakes-placed runners in Flight Deck and Justleaveitalone. His breeding suggests he'll like the distance. #7 ERIE SHORES couldn't save much ground, passed foes in the stretch but was never a threat when finishing fifth by nearly 15 lengths in his seasonal debut on July 26. We'll see if he can step forward in his second start off of the bench.

#6 SUNDAY FINERY made a wide bid on the turn and ran on to be third when debuting on July 18. Hernandez retains the mount; could offer an okay price in his turf debut. #5 CATTRALL set the pace and was nabbed at the wire by stablemate Sakpe in his debut on the inner turf on July 26. We'll see how far she can take them; could set easier fractions with the stretch out to 6 ½ furlongs. #8 WORLDLY CHARM debuted in the My Dear where she raced wide but finished strongly to be third. Unfortunately she draws an outside post again; hopefully she can save some ground and come running down this long stretch. #1 CRAZY BUSY (JPN) was purchased for over \$400,000 USD in Japan as a weanling. The sire, Lord Kalaloa was a multiple Grade 1-winner in Japan and Hong Kong; the worktab looks sharp.

#6 CELEBRITY WARRIOR (IRE) couldn't find the rail on a day where it was a good place to be, tried to rally turning for home but lost some momentum when checked in early stretch when making her local debut on July 4. Stakes-placed on turf and thought enough of to be given a shot in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies' Turf last year. I could see her firing with a better effort getting back to turf. #4 SOUPER GIN'S WORLD set the pace, was challenged on the far turn, kept the lead into the stretch but flattened out to be fourth when getting out to a mile on July 26. She makes just her third lifetime start here and gets a slight cutback. #2 LAPIN DE PLAGE tracked

Super Gin's World, made her challenge on the far turn and kept on gamely to be third, outnodding the aforementioned rival while being passed by closers. She draws well here. #5 DYNA fell well back and ran on belatedly to be fourth as the favourite on July 25. She showed a lot of potential at two but has not lived up to it; hopefully she can find better early position this time.

#5 UNCLE DODO ran a huge race on debut when flying to be third against a major inside/speed bias, then was able to prove best second time out in the Victoria despite the rider losing the whip in deep stretch. If he is as good on turf as he has been on the Tapeta, he should be tough here. #6 SPEAKER'S SPEECH is one of two first-timers from the Casse barn entered in this spot. An \$875,000 purchase at the OBS April Sale where he breezed a furlong in 9 $\frac{1}{5}$, he is from the first crop of Speaker's Corner, who has produced Schuylerville-winner Harper's Corner. #8 THROUGH THE YEARS (IRE) showed speed for the first half of the Norfolk Stakes at Royal Ascot but emptied out first of the pacesetters. An easy winner in New York prior to her English adventure, she could rebound returning to a North American course. #2 QUIPSTER tracked the pacesetter before kicking on to win his debut on June 28. In a race with speed to his outside he could land a perfect inside stalking trip.

#8 NOTORIOUS GANGSTER looked very good when winning his seasonal debut in an N3X/\$80,000 over seven furlongs but finished evenly after racing wide in the Dominion Day. Aside from the Coronation Futurity, all of his wins have come in sprints, so he definitely is intriguing taking on this kind of company around one turn. #2 POULIN IN O T put away the other speed and held off the late charge of Awesome Bourbon when winning the Pink Lloyd on July 5. After being put away early last year he has returned this season in tremendous form and definitely deserves a look in his first try against Graded Stakes company. #4 ITS BOURBON THIRTY battled on the lead before giving way to be fifth by 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ lengths in the Jacques Cartier. His last two allowance wins in Kentucky came from stalking roles; I can see him beating these with the proper setup. #5 G T FIVE HUNDRED was brought here with the idea of sprint campaign but took a shot around two turns on the inner turf in the Connaught Cup and got a perfect trip en route to a 31-1 upset. Already a multiple Stakes-winner in Tapeta sprints, he is crossed entered in the King Edward; we'll see what direction they choose.

#4 EPONINE (IRE) has been brought to Saratoga twice since joining the Kevin Attard outfit, winning an N1X over a mile in her most recent outing on July 4. Group 2-placed in France and Grade 2-placed at Saratoga last year, she is clearly a quality filly who should be able to win a Graded Stakes sooner or later. #6 PROCTOR STREET didn't have a great trip while racing rank and never got involved when last racing in the De La Rose at Saratoga on July 17. She hit the board in three consecutive Graded Stakes before that and won the Cardinal at Churchill last fall; very hard to ignore. #1 LUPA (IRE) was allowed a very easy lead and got brave in the stretch when missing by a head at 12-1 in the Trillium on July 25. She broke her maiden on turf and catches another field where she could get a fairly easy lead. #7 POWER OF DESTINY (GB) has taken well to North American racing, hitting the board in three of four starts including an N1X/\$32,000 win over this course before a good third in an N2X/\$80,000 at Saratoga. I think she is a bit of a grinding type who can do her best running with a bit more distance.

#2 ROYAL FOXTROT stalked the pace and finished gamely to be second by $\frac{3}{4}$ lengths to the daughter of Flightline, Go for Launch, when debuting on the inner turf on July 25. One of three Casse entrants here, I am definitely intrigued to see her develop. #3 MELONI was a very impressive debut winner, battling on the lead before shaking off the challengers. Daughter of American Pharoah had a blazing breeze over the training turf on July 24. #5 GHOST ME looks to be a perfect three-for-three after shipping up and rallying to win the My Dear on July 12. This looks like her toughest test to date, but she's already proven she can win with different circumstances, on or off the lead and on both turf and Tapeta; seems like a true racehorse. #1 LIBERTY BEACH broke her maiden in her second attempt, going gate to wire after running third against the boys on debut. Omaha Beach has been a solid turf sire; the dam has produced a couple of turf winners.

#1 LUSTER absolutely dominated the competitive in the Woodbine Oaks, showing she is in a league of her own compared to the other Canadian bred fillies this season. Of everyone in this field, she is the one who gives the impression that she could have a Graded Stakes career south of the border. #12 MILITARY TIME took a long time to get going and lugged in while rallying to be third in the Plate Trial. I think he has more talent than we're seeing; the blinkers are being added and we'll have to see if he can avoid getting hung too wide from the outside draw. #7 MAGICAL FACTOR was getting a perfect trip and looked like he was going on to an easy win in early stretch but could not hold off the charge of Brachetto when second in the Marine. He may simply be a bit better on turf than the Tapeta, but I think he may be the type who can't hit the front too early; I've been a fan and I remain interested. #10 VERY SPECIAL acted up at the gate in the Plate Trial and had to be scratched, but now returns to take a shot at the big prize. The blinkers are being added, and while I'm not sure he is a serious win contender, he seems like the type who can outstay some of the lesser types who overrace early and could grind his way into the tri or super at a decent price.

#1 IRISH ACES rallied strongly but came up a half-length short to the perfectly-tripped G T Five Hundred in the Connaught Cup. He gets an inside draw today and looks as good as anyone here. #3 GAS ME UP makes his return to Woodbine after staying in California for a winter campaign after the Breeders' Cup Mile, during which he was able to win the Grade 2 Juan Hernandez on the downhill turf at Santa Anita. Third to Notable Speech in last year's Woodbine Mile, he is the class of this field and arguably the one to beat in his first start in 161 days. #5 WYOMING BILL dropped back to be near the back, swung wide and rallied to be fifth by 2 ½ lengths in the Connaught Cup. Second to Gas Me Up in last year's edition of this race, he may not get the pace setup he needs here but I certainly think he has legitimate Graded Stakes talent. #2 G T FIVE HUNDRED was brought here with the idea of sprint campaign but took a shot around two turns on the inner turf in the Connaught Cup and got a perfect trip en route to a 31-1 upset. Already a multiple Stakes-winner in Tapeta sprints, he is crossed entered in the Bold Venture; we'll see what direction they choose.

#6 MASTERFUL MOMENT broke his maiden for this tag on the Tapeta in May then failed to fire in a very tough N1X/\$32,000 on the inner turf on June 7. He has had some time to reset, gets back to a more reasonable level and returns to the main track; could be worth a look as an upset threat. #9 AWESOME BEAT looked very good in his maiden score on June 18, then came back to be a good third behind repeat-winner Cash the Money on July 6. Stakes-placed at two, he seems to be coming into himself this year and looks very live for the red-hot Sid Attard barn. #2 DECADENT DANISH finished very strongly when dead-heating for fourth on the inner turf on July 26. He has never run a bad race in six starts to date in his career; blinkers are being added for the first time. #5 DEPUTY CURLIN disappointed in two starts at the N2L allowance level to begin his three year old campaign. He drops in for \$40,000 after 2 ½ months off.

#1 MISTER DUDE had a wide trip and was a bit keen but kept on well despite showing some greenness in his debut on July 19. I could see him improving this time with a covered up trip from the inside. #7 FORESTERS LASTLOVE showed finishing interest in his debut on June 7 and came back around last time when getting onto the turn, finishing a game second in the same race that Mister Dude exits. He is very unlikely to offer the same 23-1 value as last time. #9 PROUDLY CANADIAN raced wide and rallied to be second behind the runaway Maker's Flatter when making his turf debut on July 5 and should be able to pick up another check. #12 KEYNOTE SPEAKER was a half-length behind Proudly Canadian last time. I've thought he has had a couple of trip excuses but unfortunately draws a tricky post here. #4 PADDY HOLIDAY has raced very well in both of his starts to date and deserves a look, but is by a sire who has not been great with turf runners and may be a shorter price than you'd want to take for a win bet.

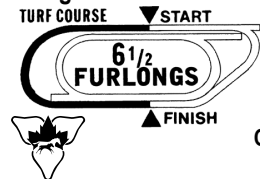
